shown in FIGS. 1 to 7.

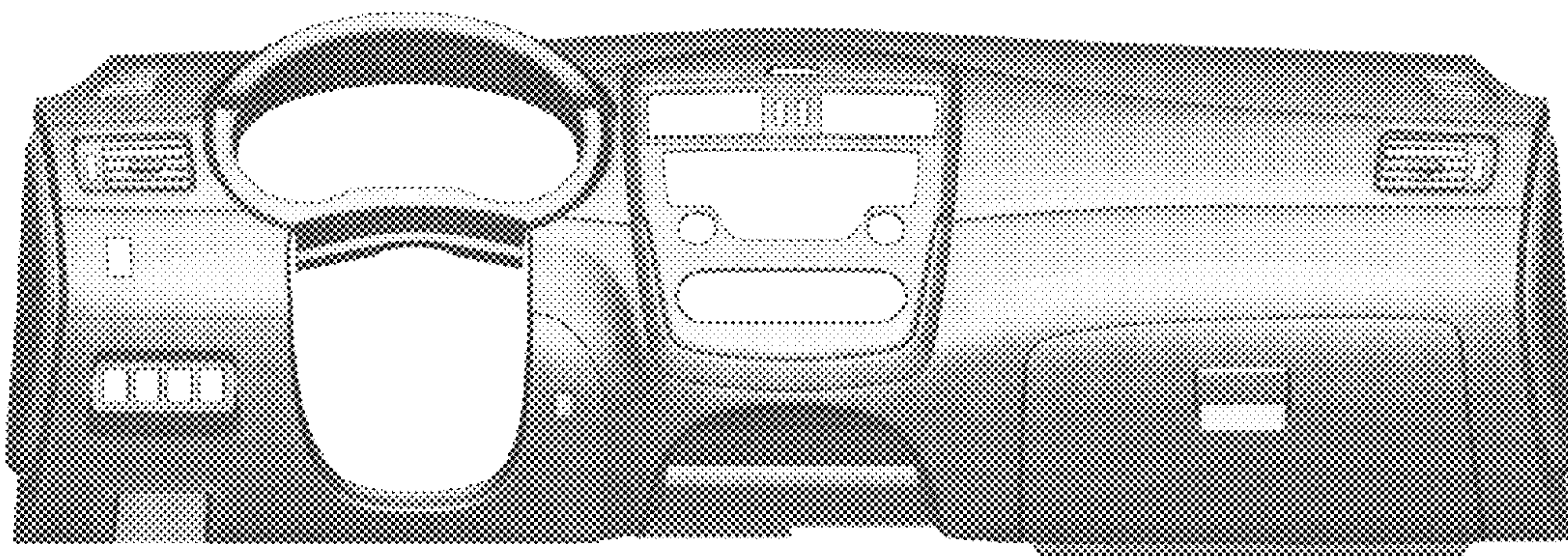
The rear view and rear surfaces of the instrument panel form

mounted to the automobile.

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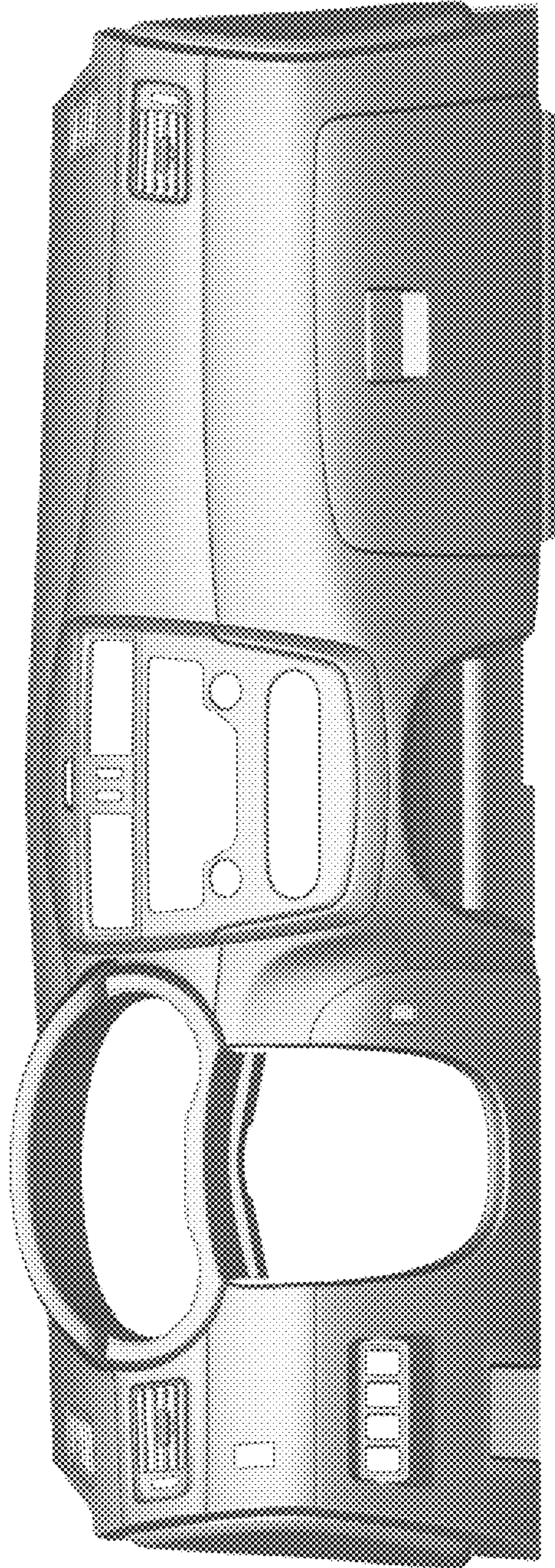

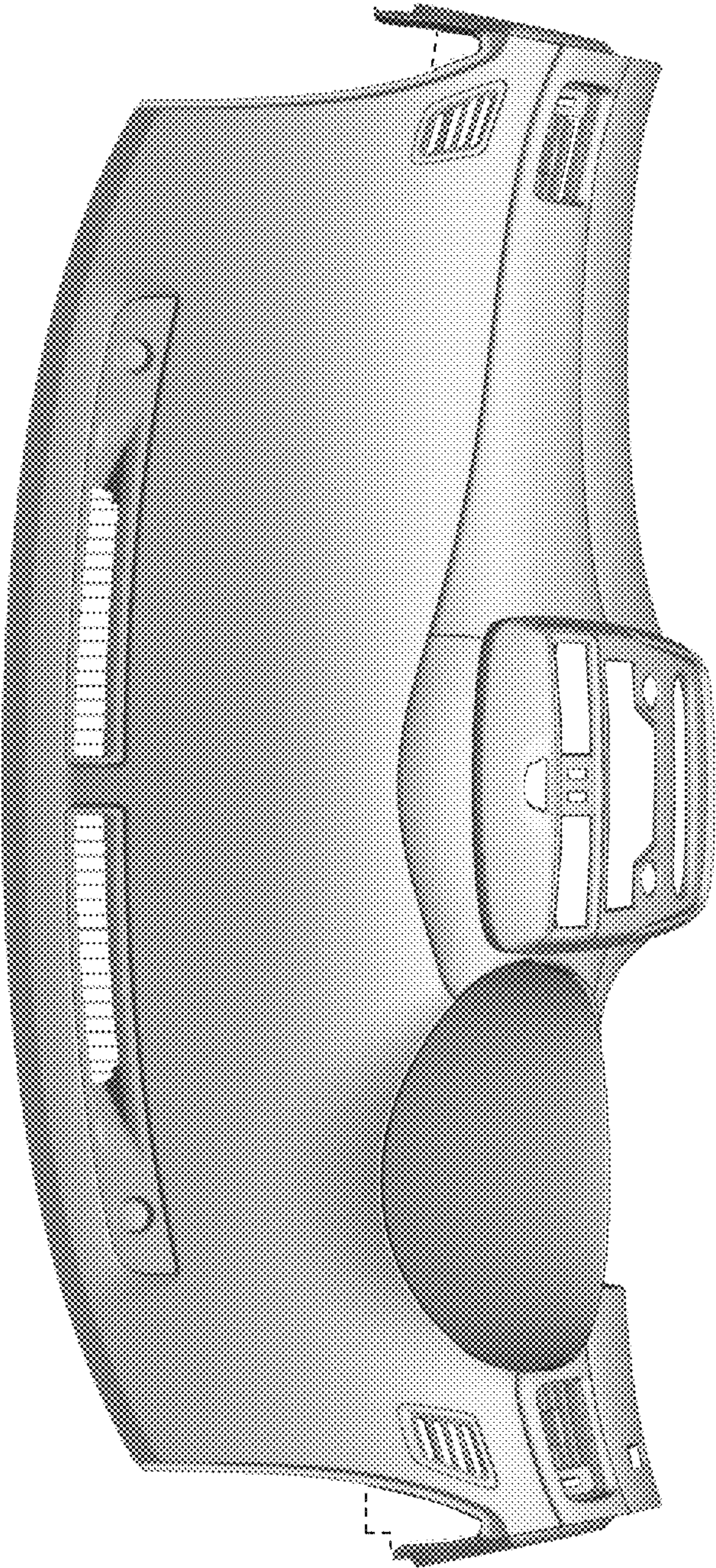

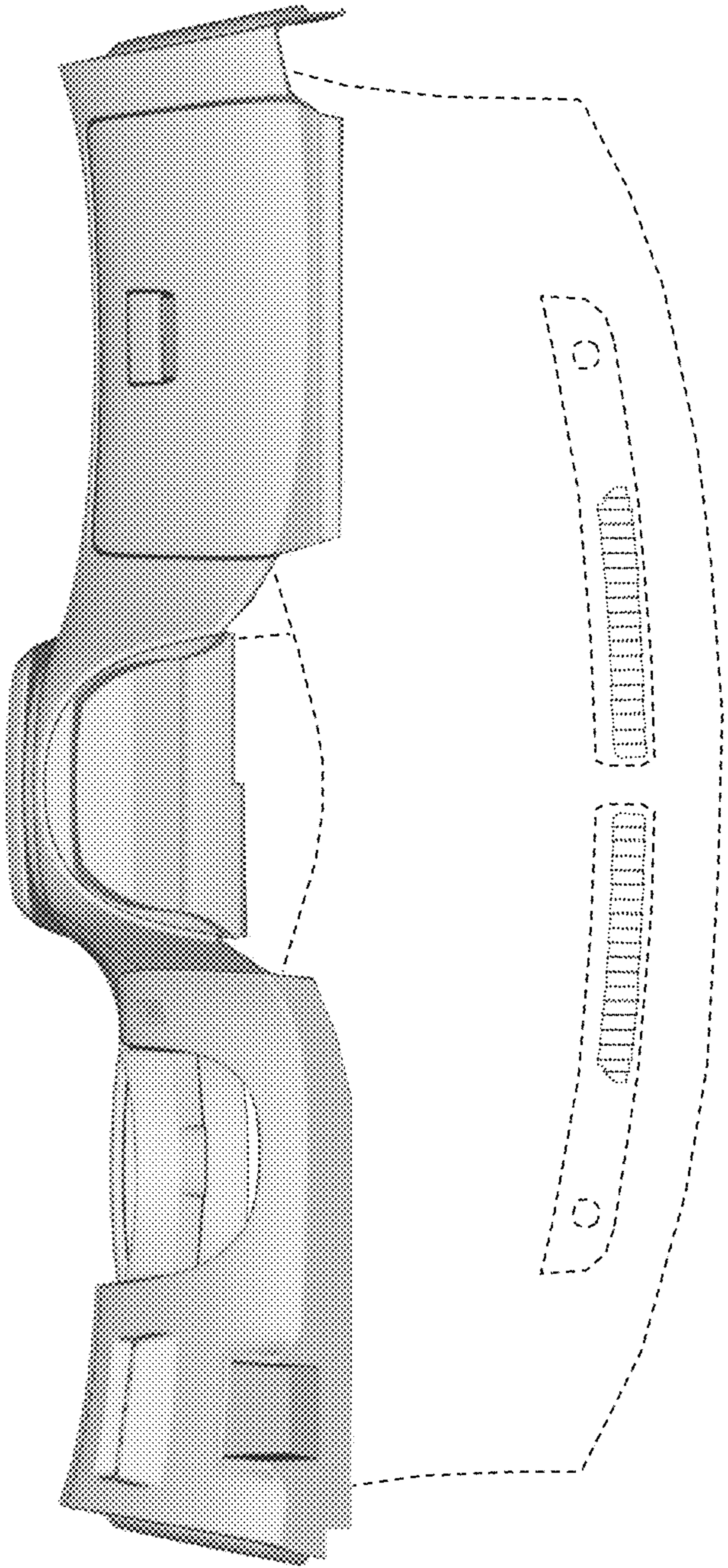

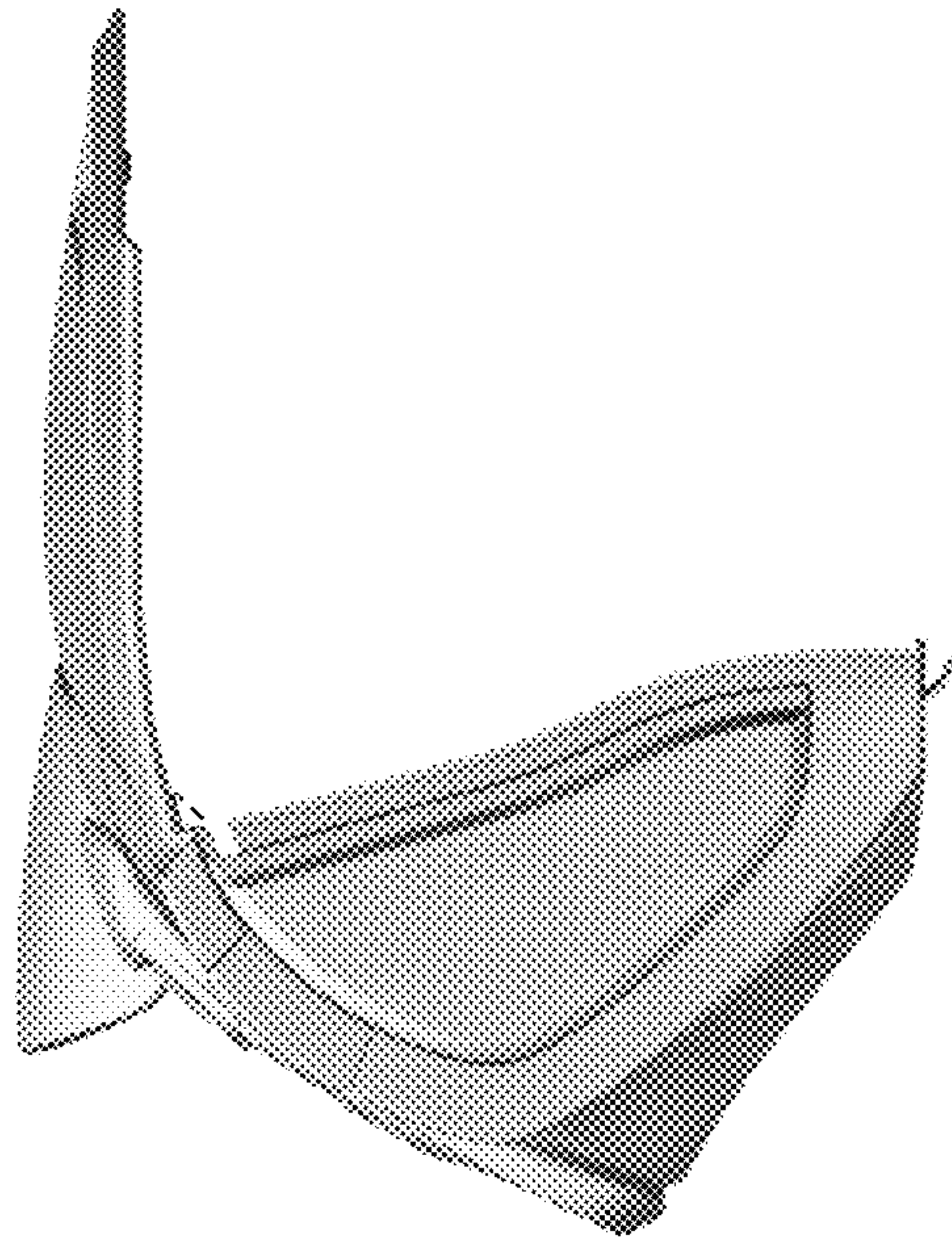

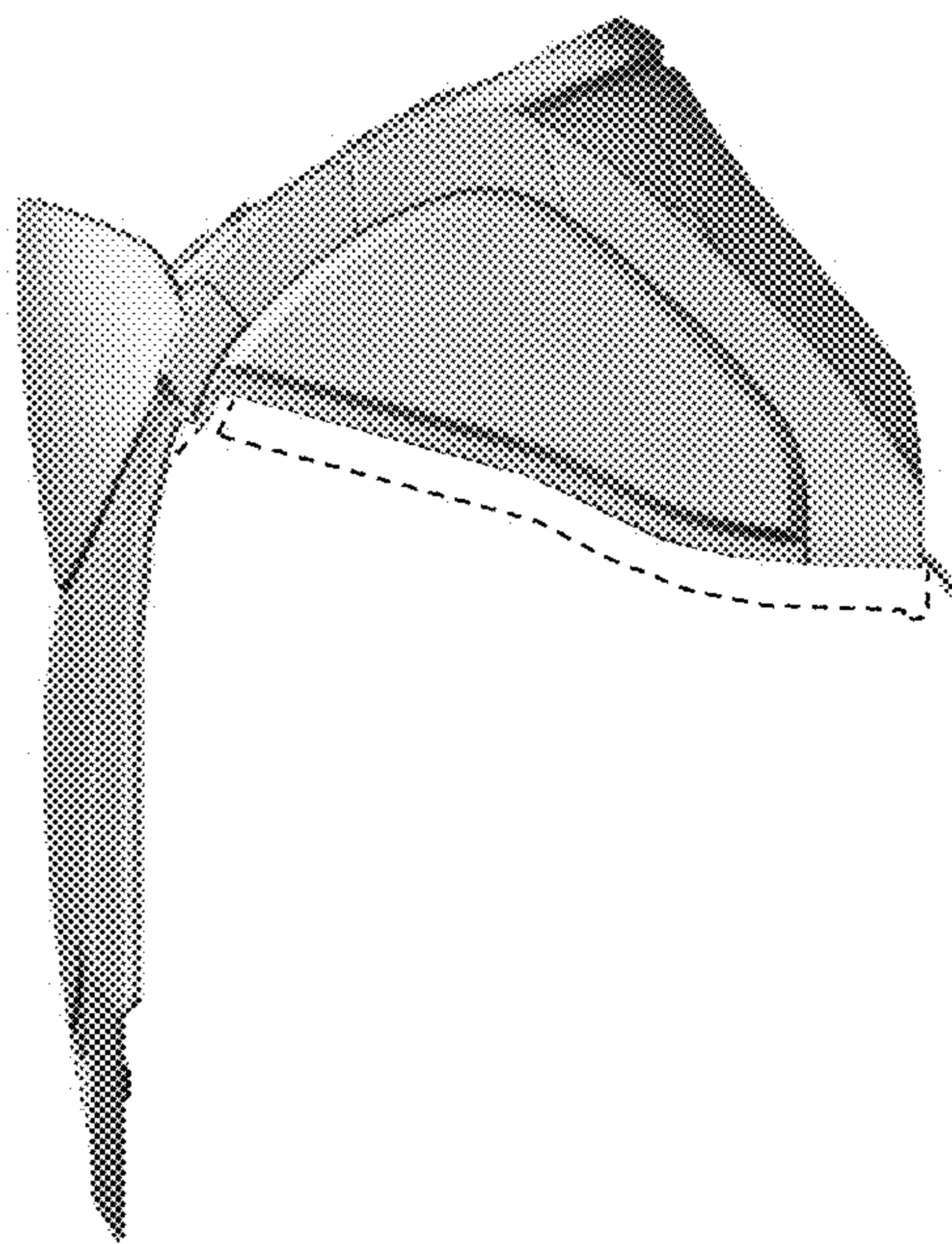

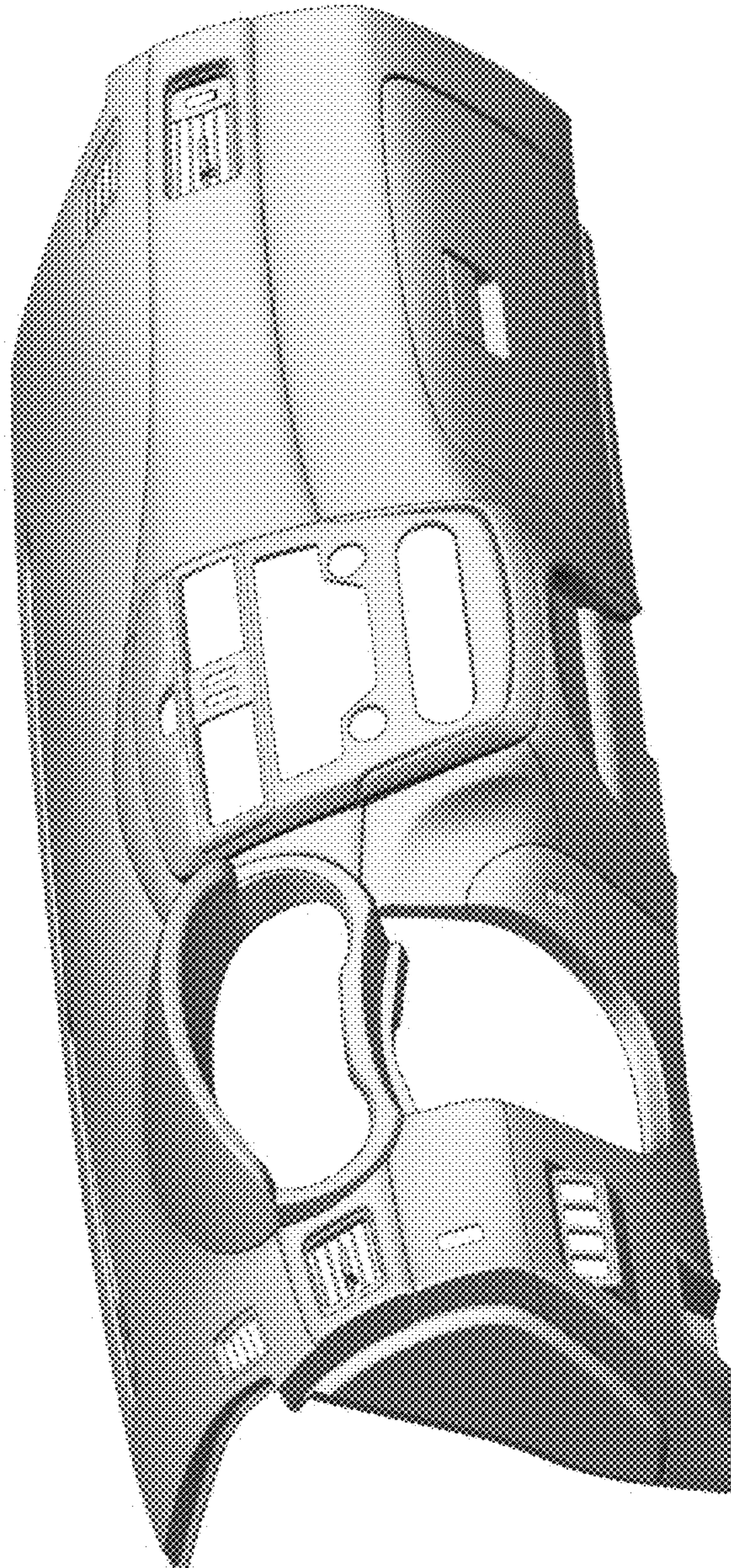

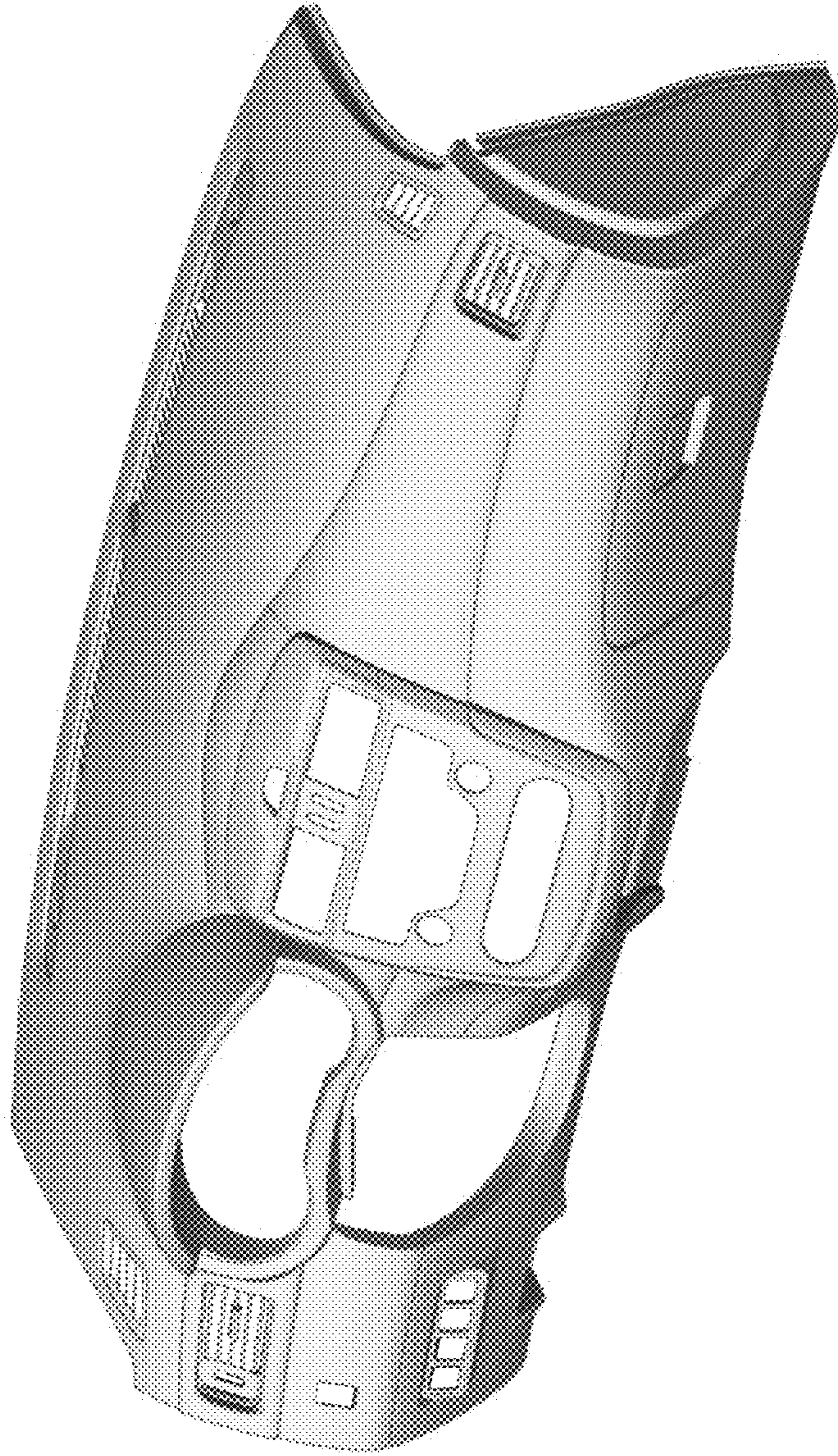
