FIG. 2 is an exploded front side elevation view thereof;

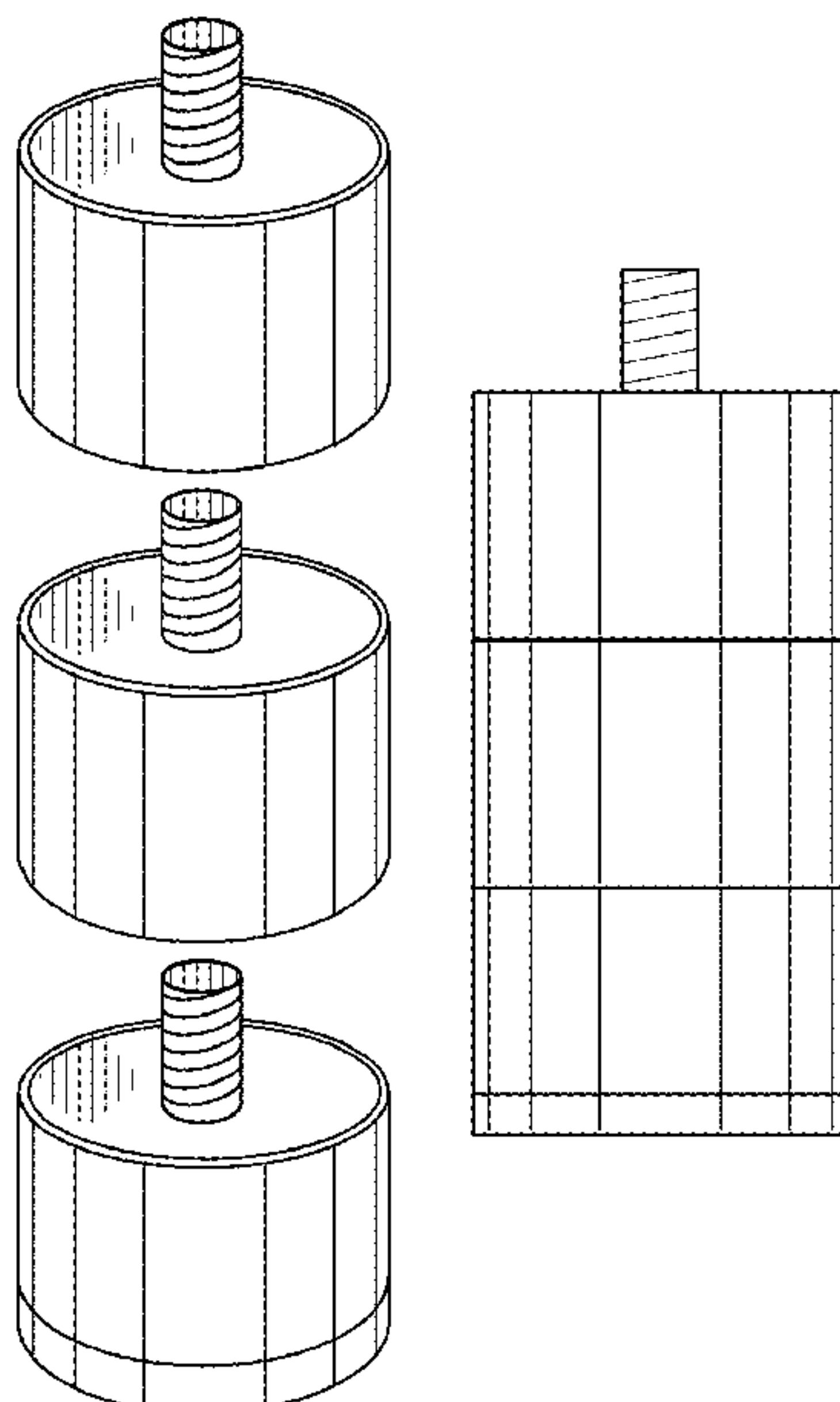
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

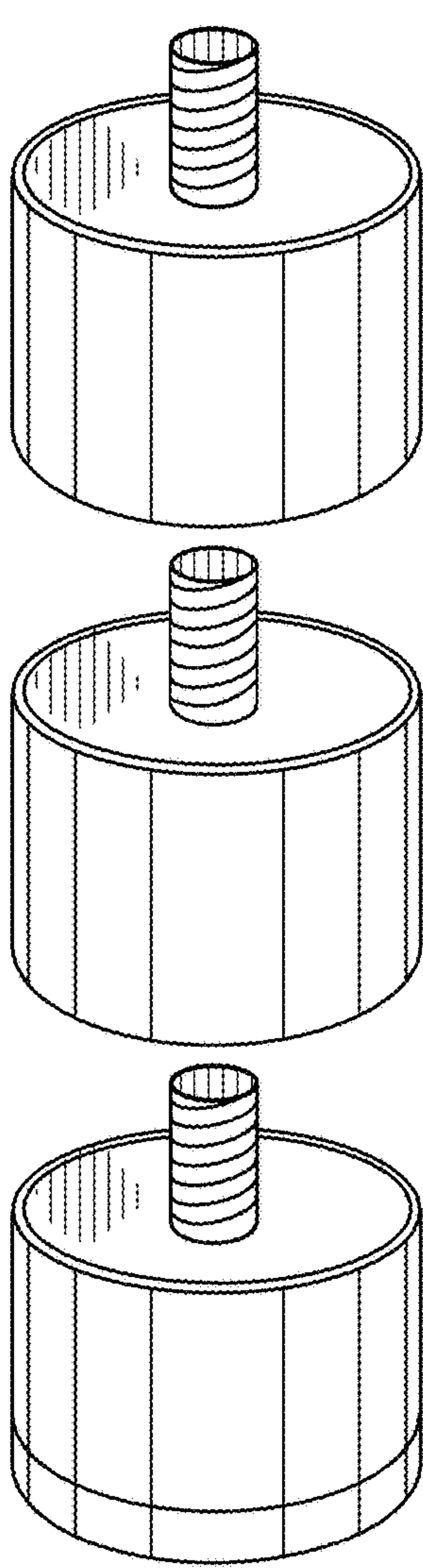

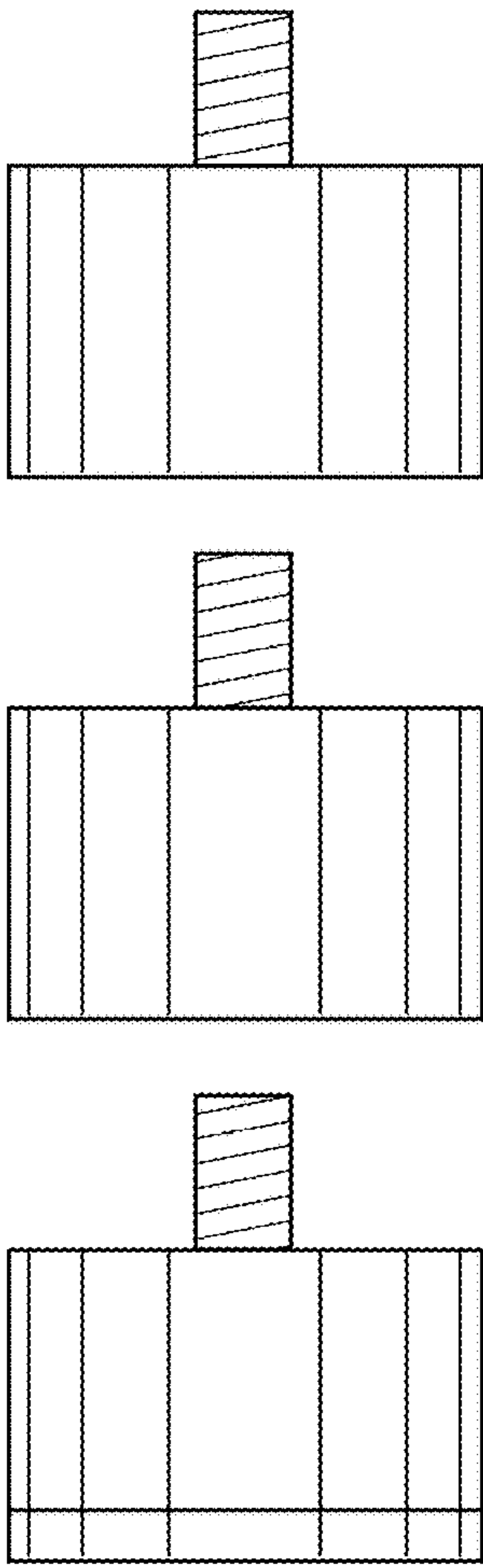

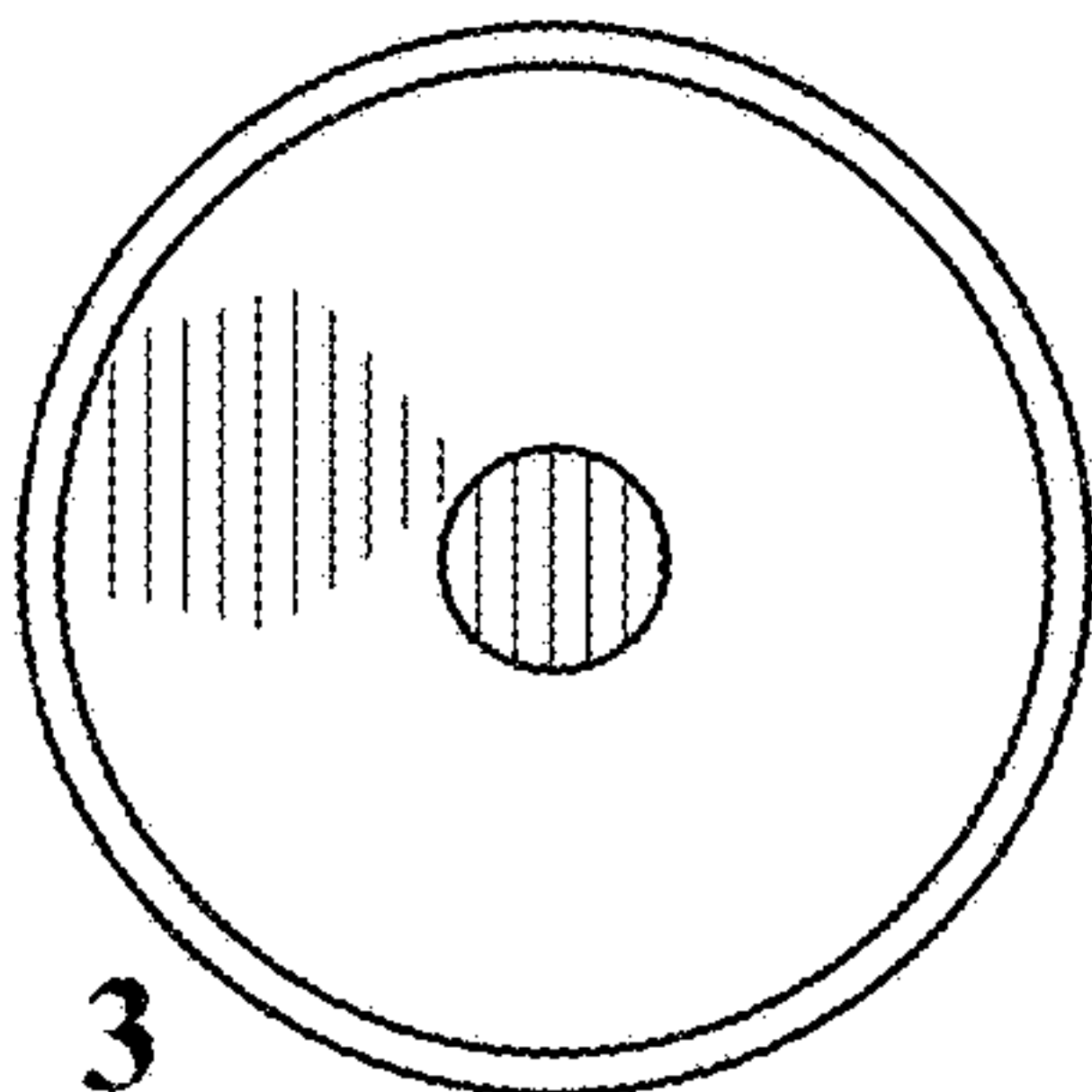

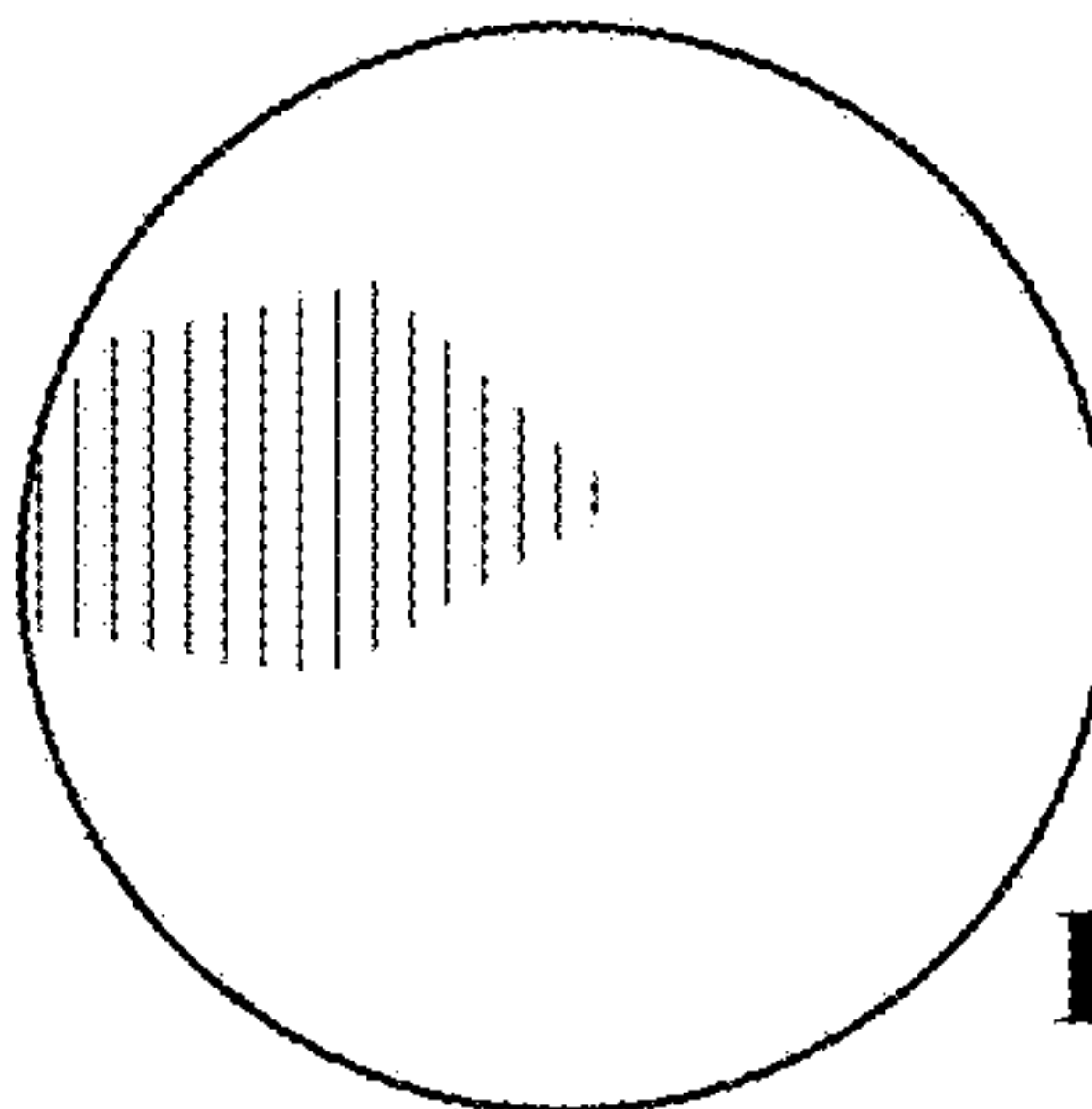

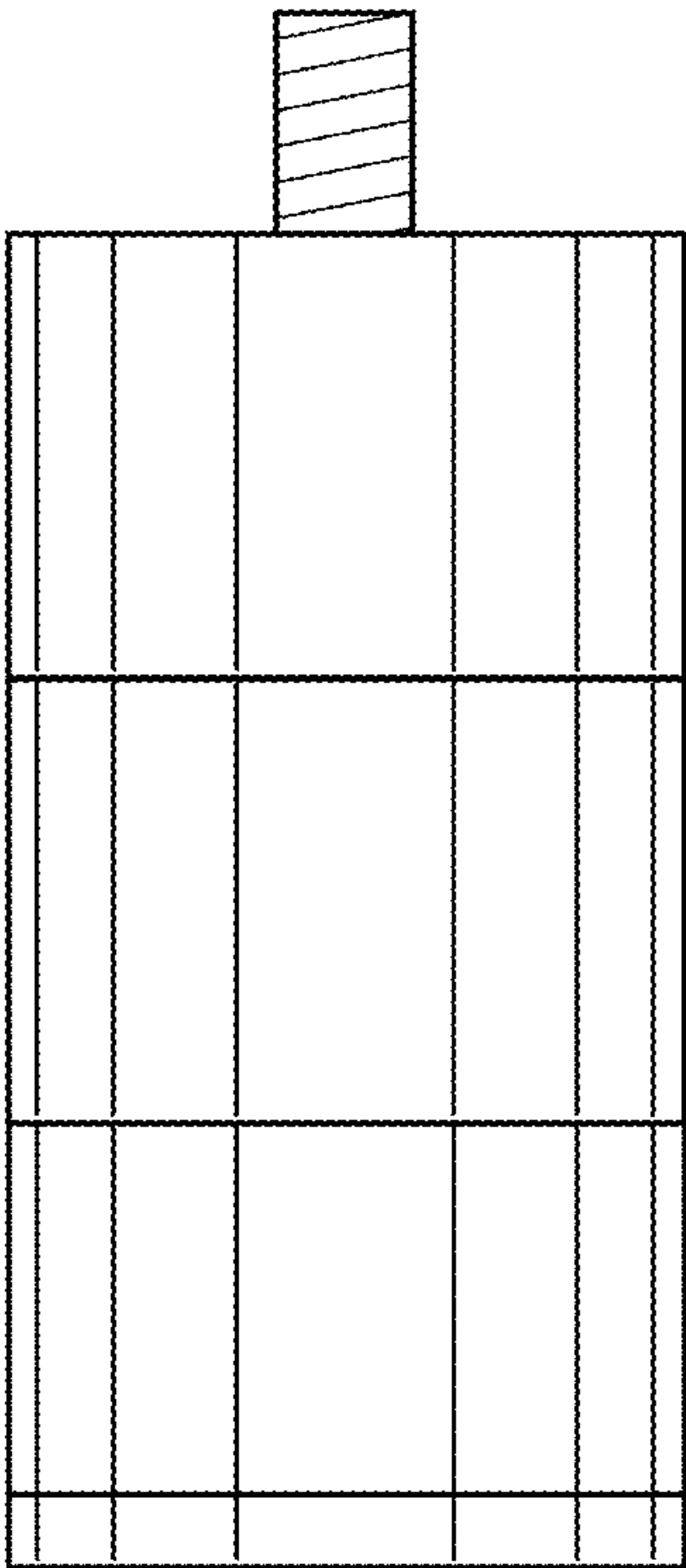
