The broken lines in the drawings showing portions of the jewelry-making disc are included for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.

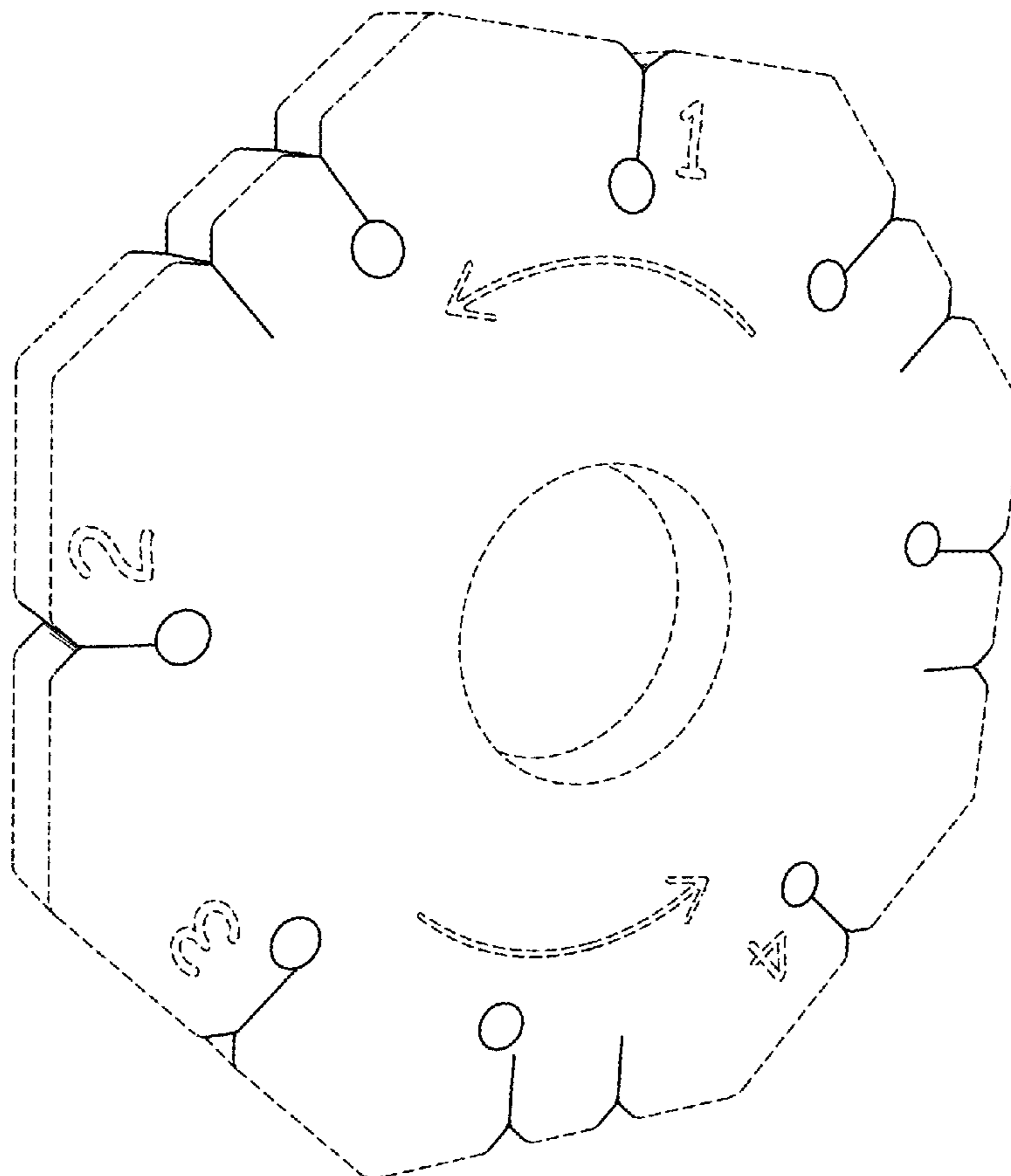

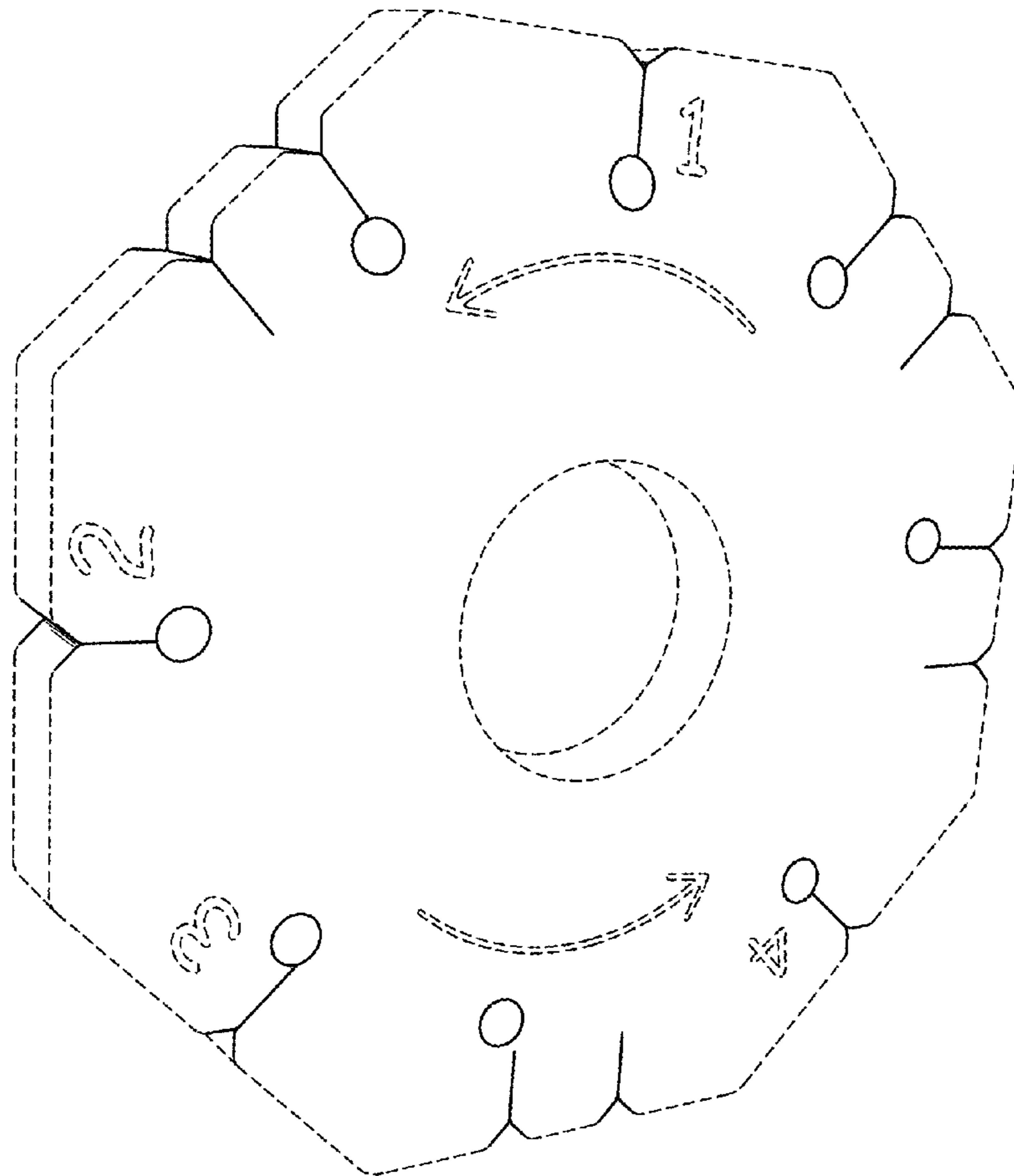

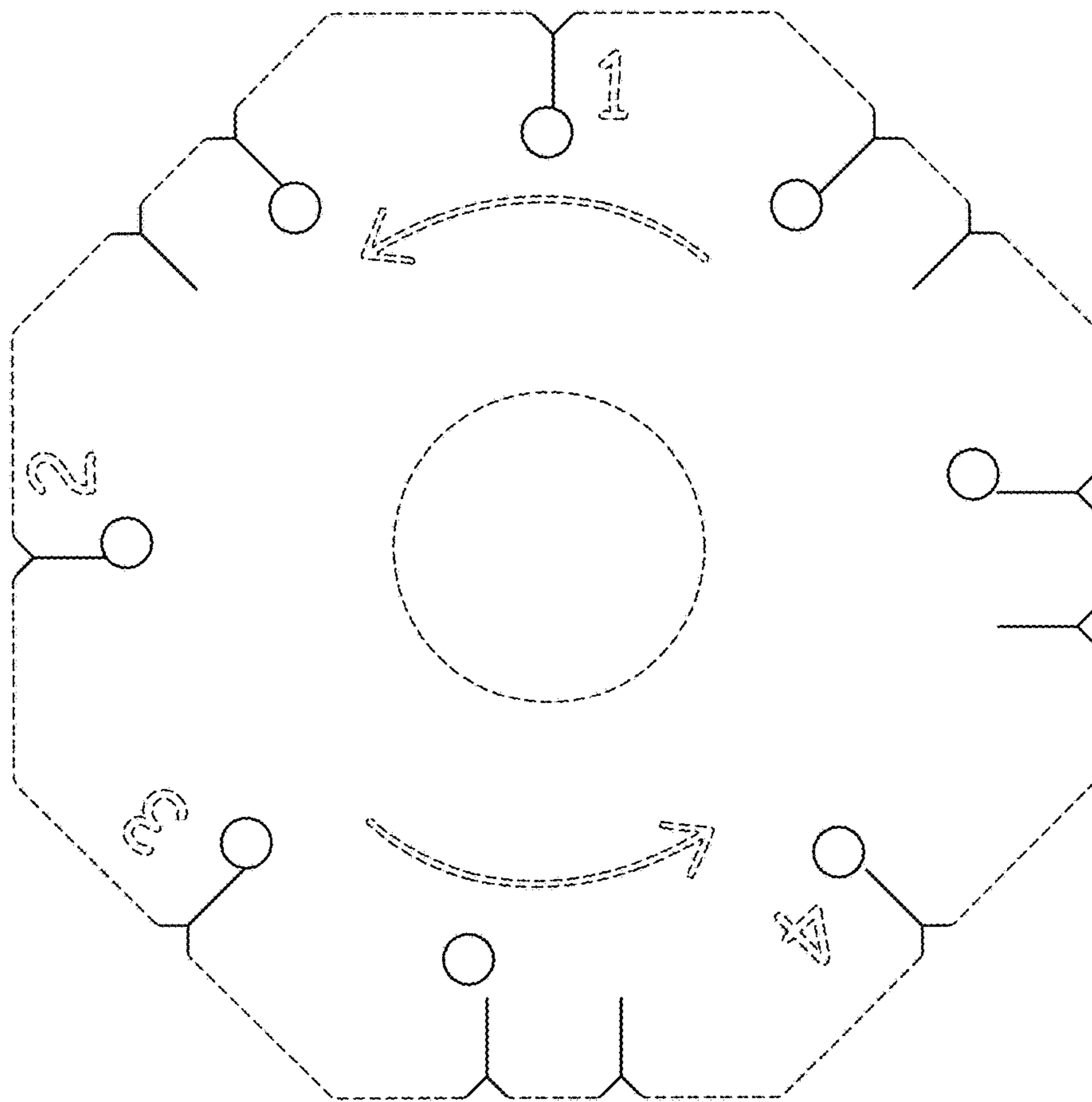

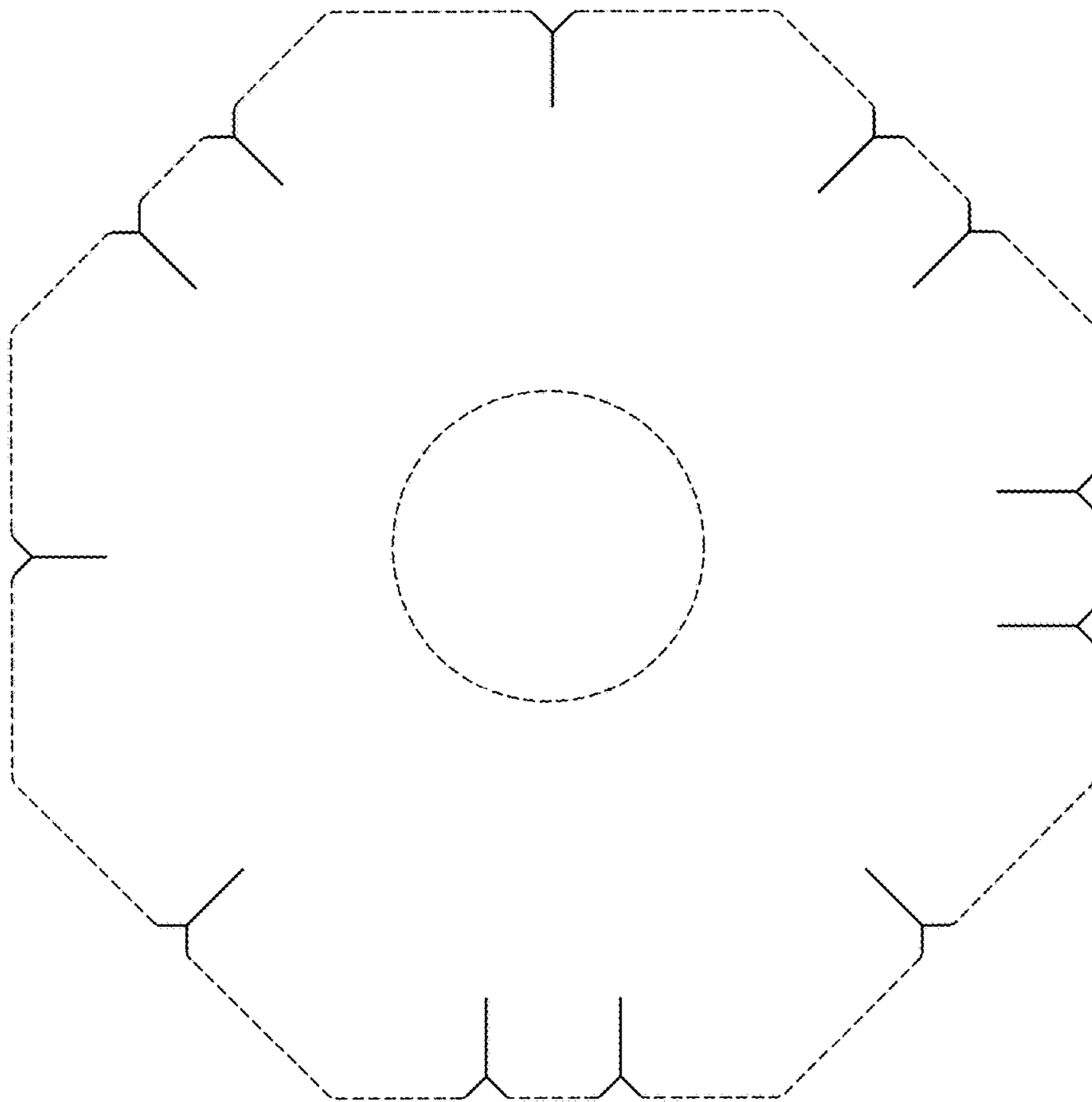

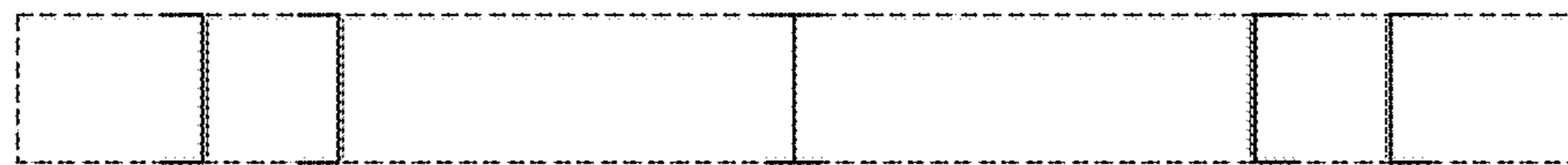

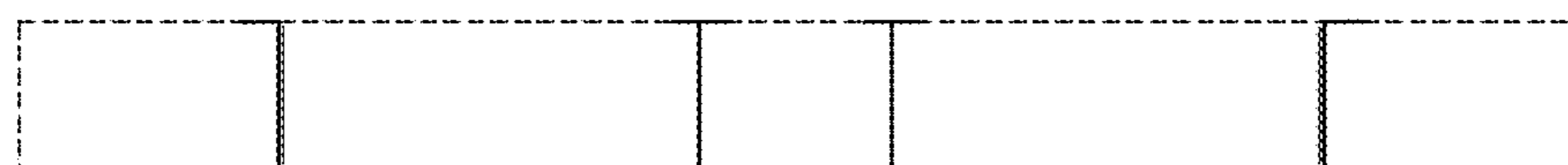
