DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a plan view from the top of the vehicle sensor module.

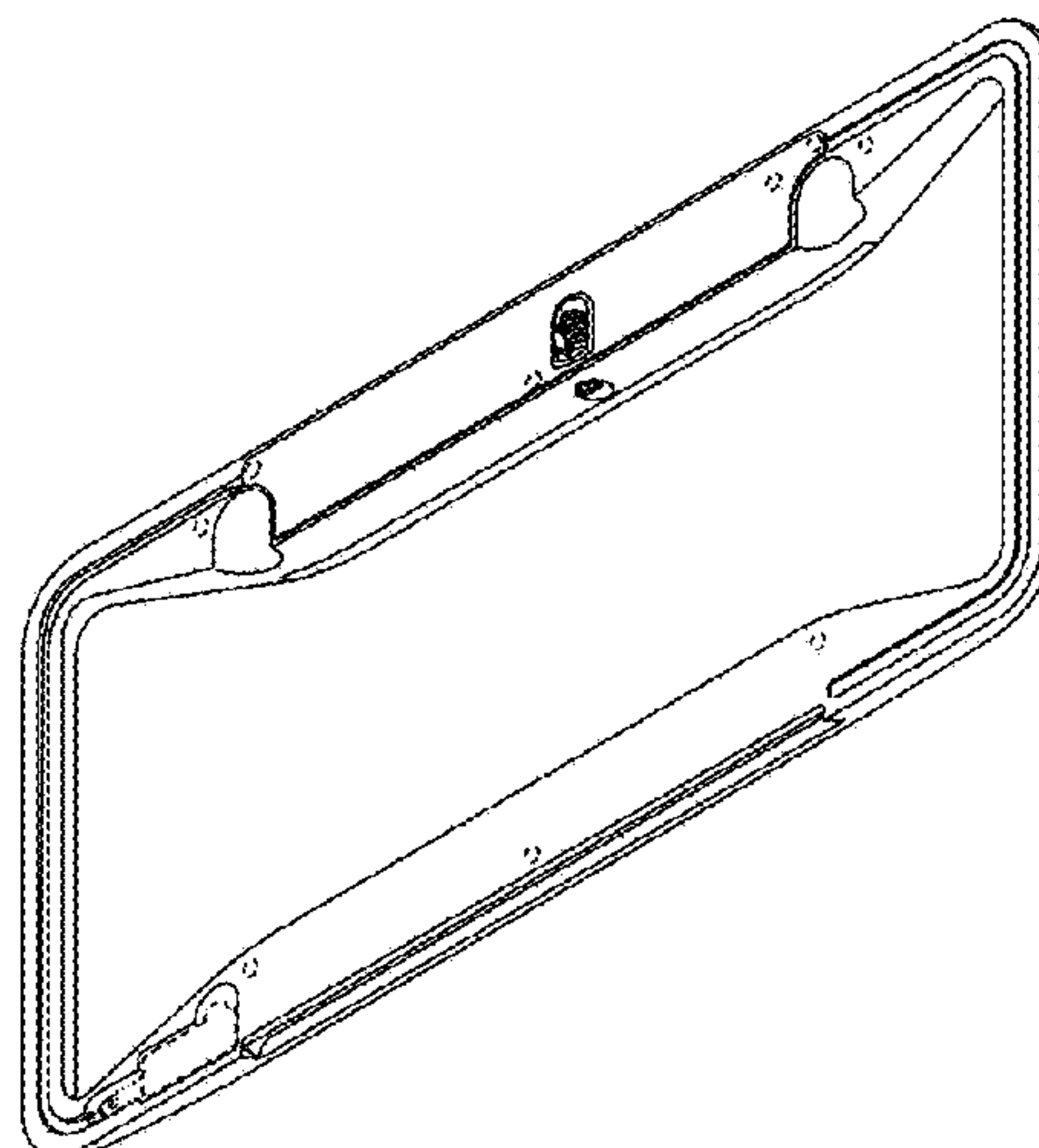
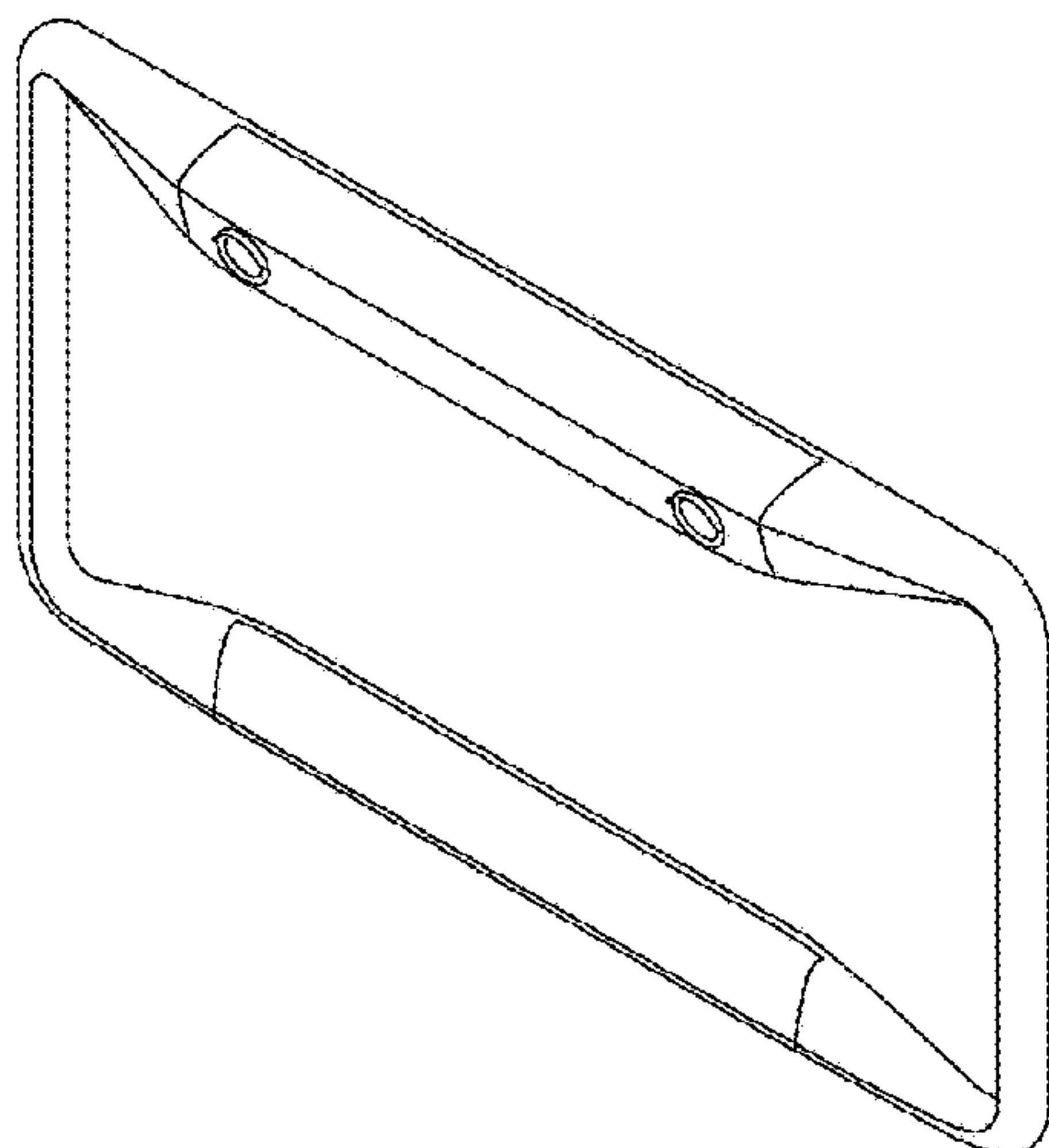
FIG. 6 is a plan view from the bottom of the vehicle sensor module.

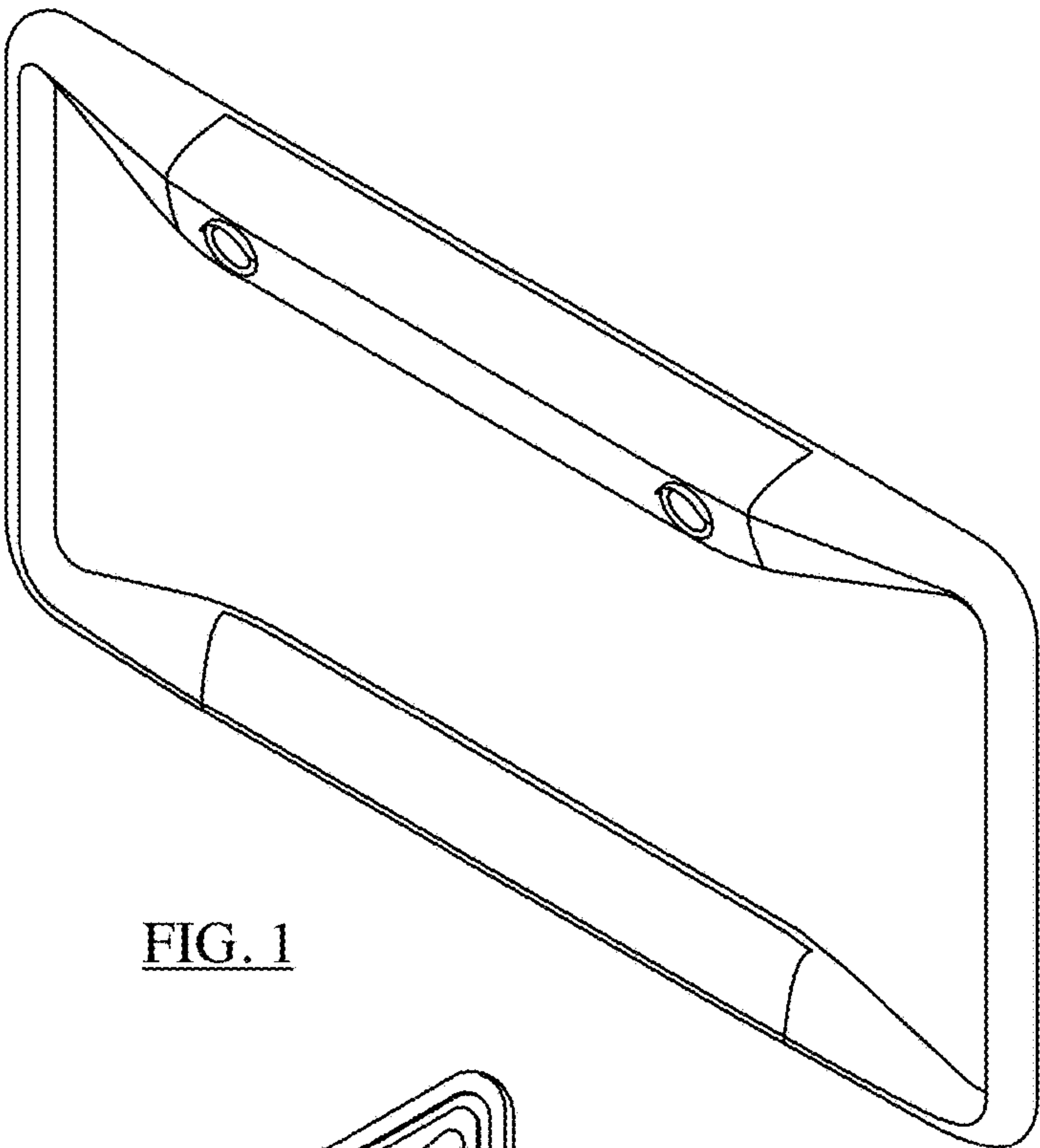

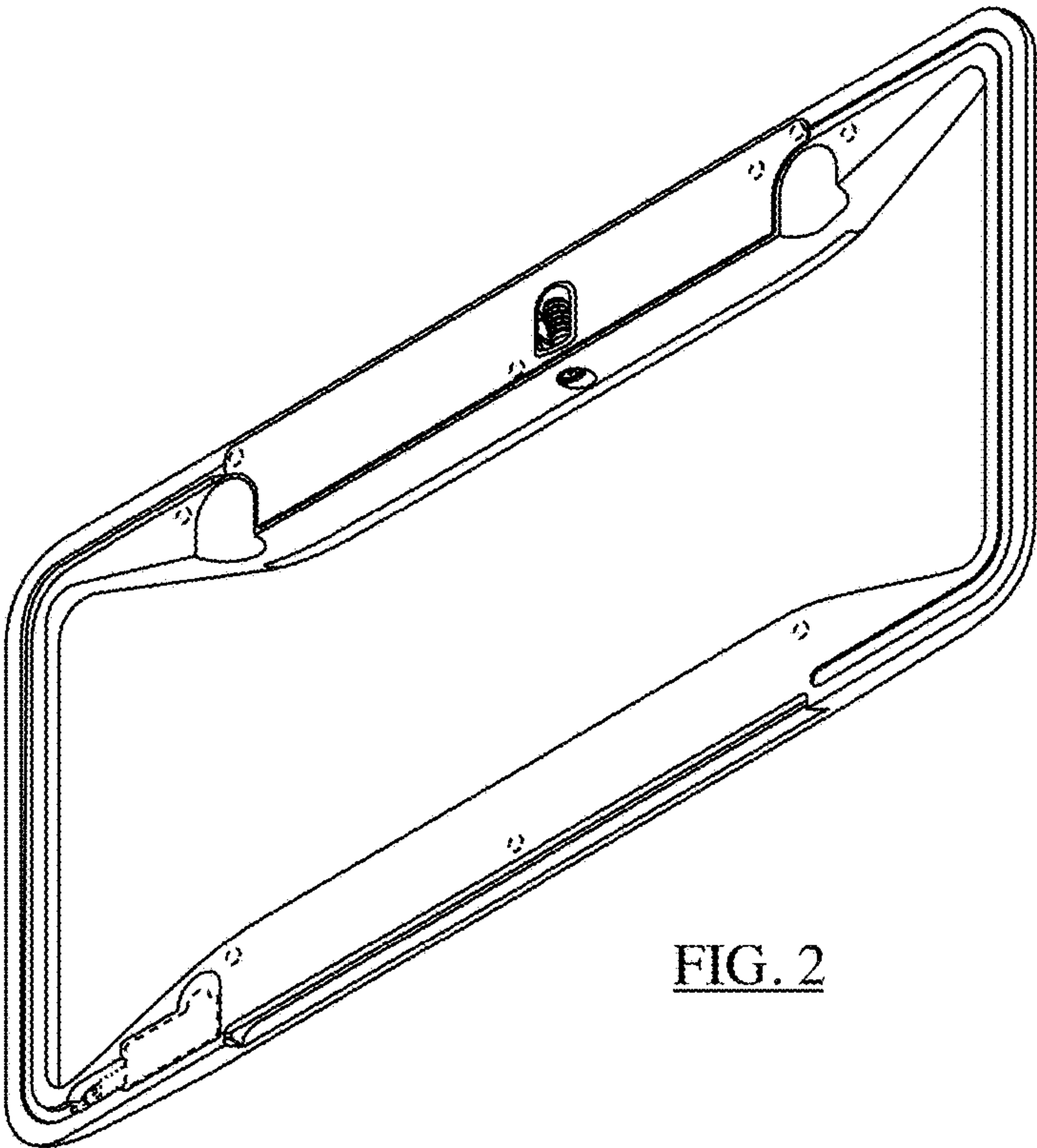

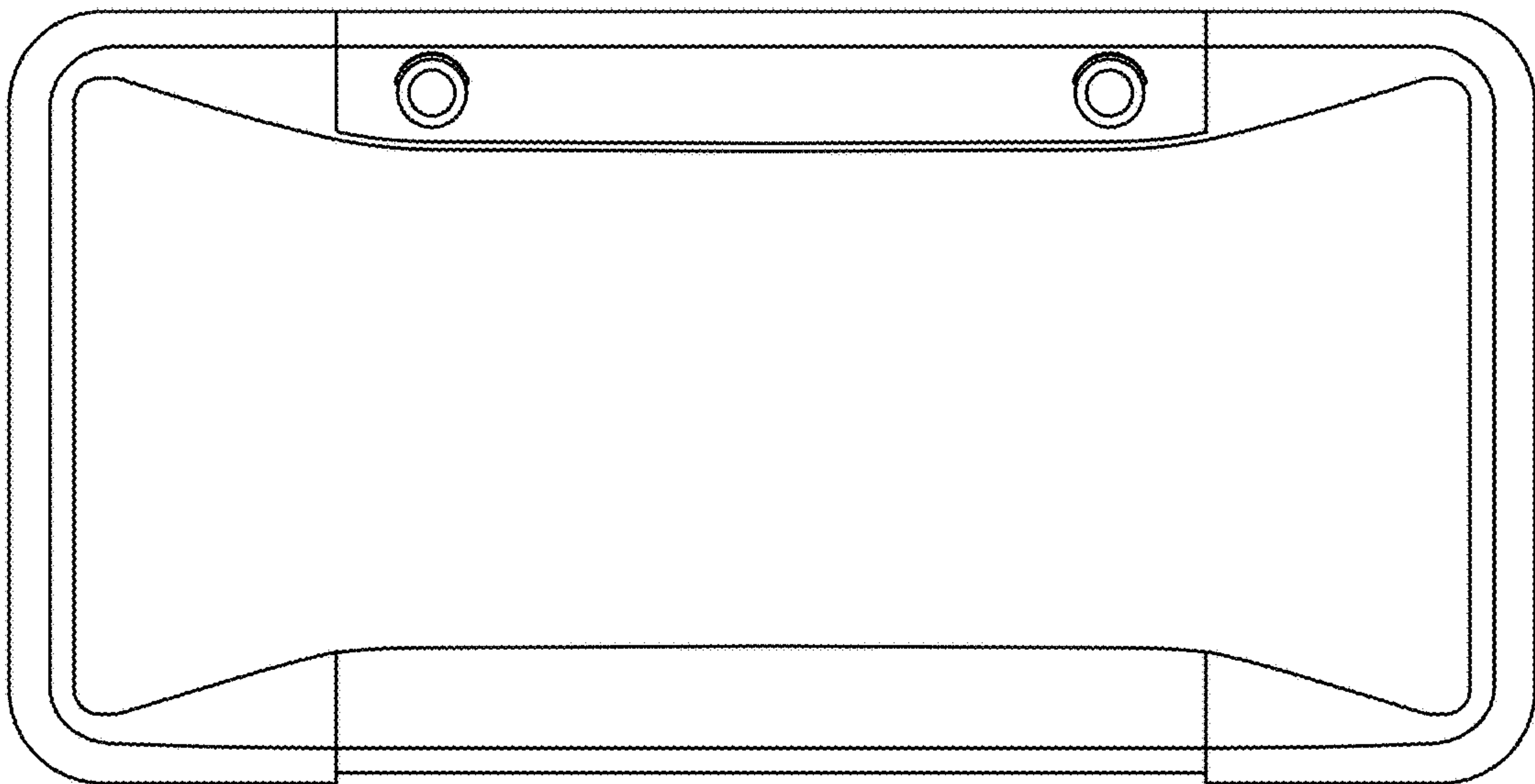

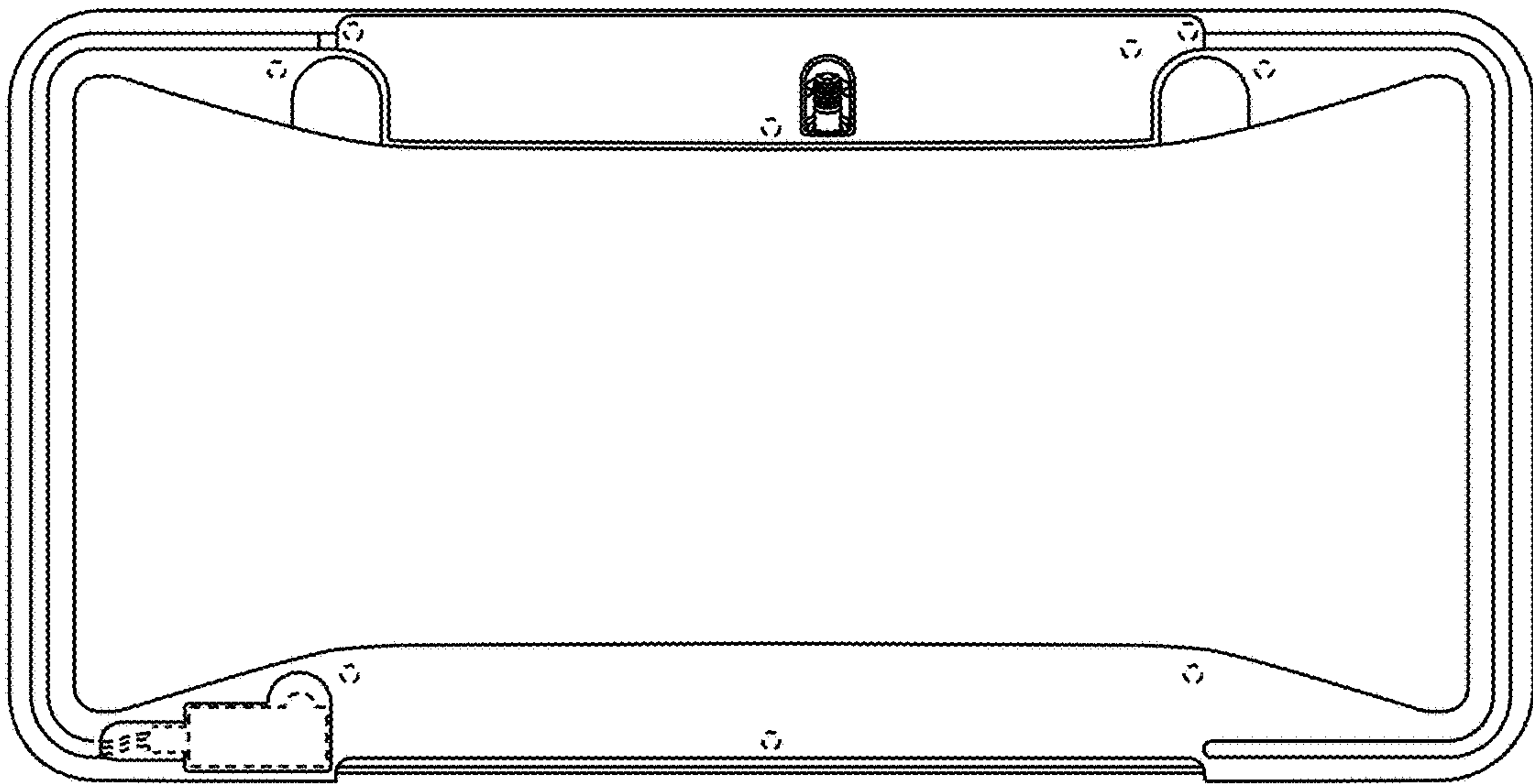

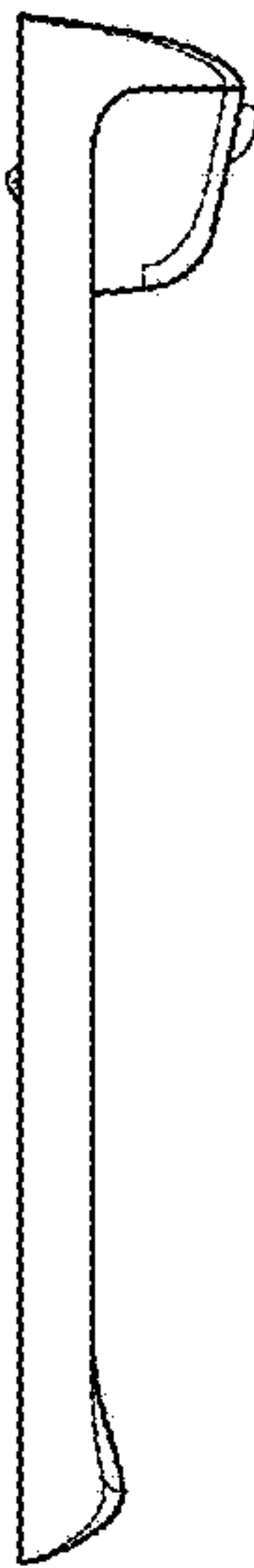

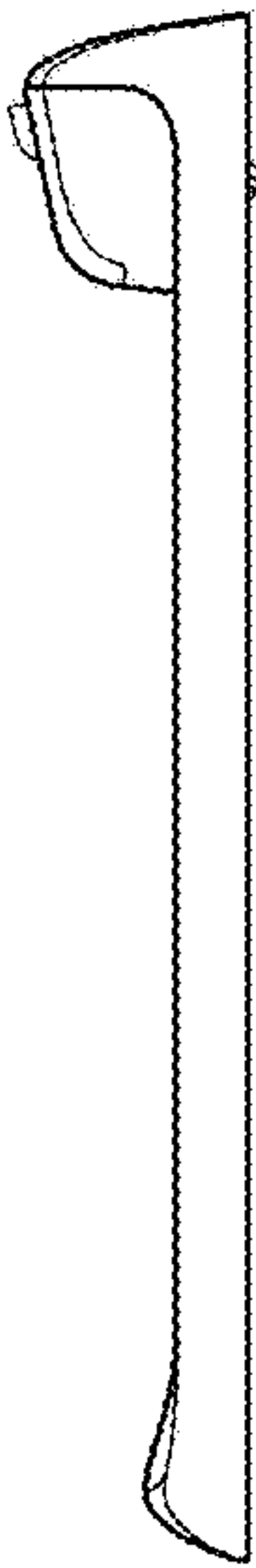
