The ornamental design for a carpenter's pencil, as shown and described.

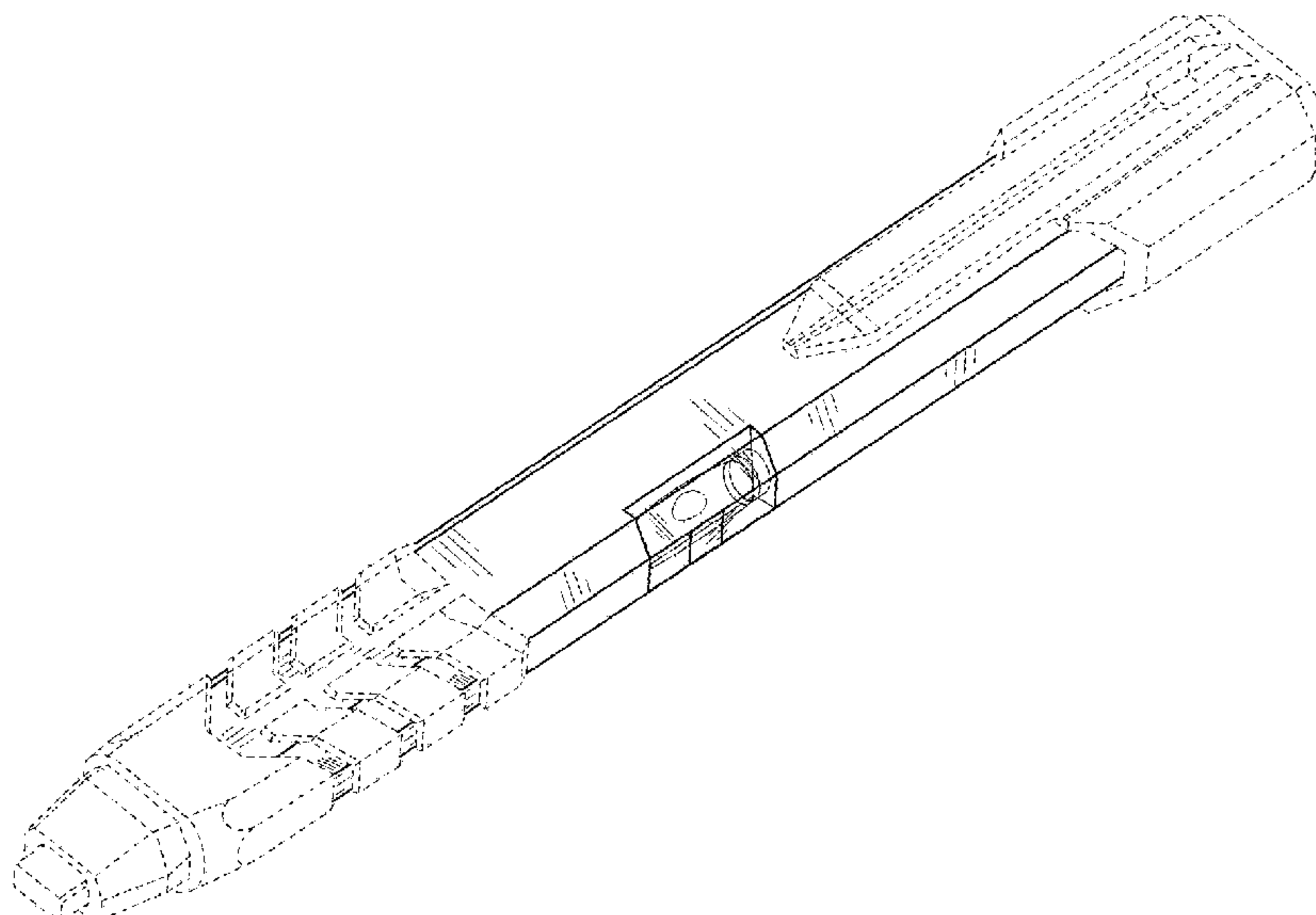
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a carpenter's pencil; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a carpenter's pencil; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of a carpenter's pencil; FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a carpenter's pencil; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of a carpenter's pencil; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of a carpenter's pencil; FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view of a carpenter's pencil; FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of a carpenter's pencil; and, FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of a carpenter's pencil.

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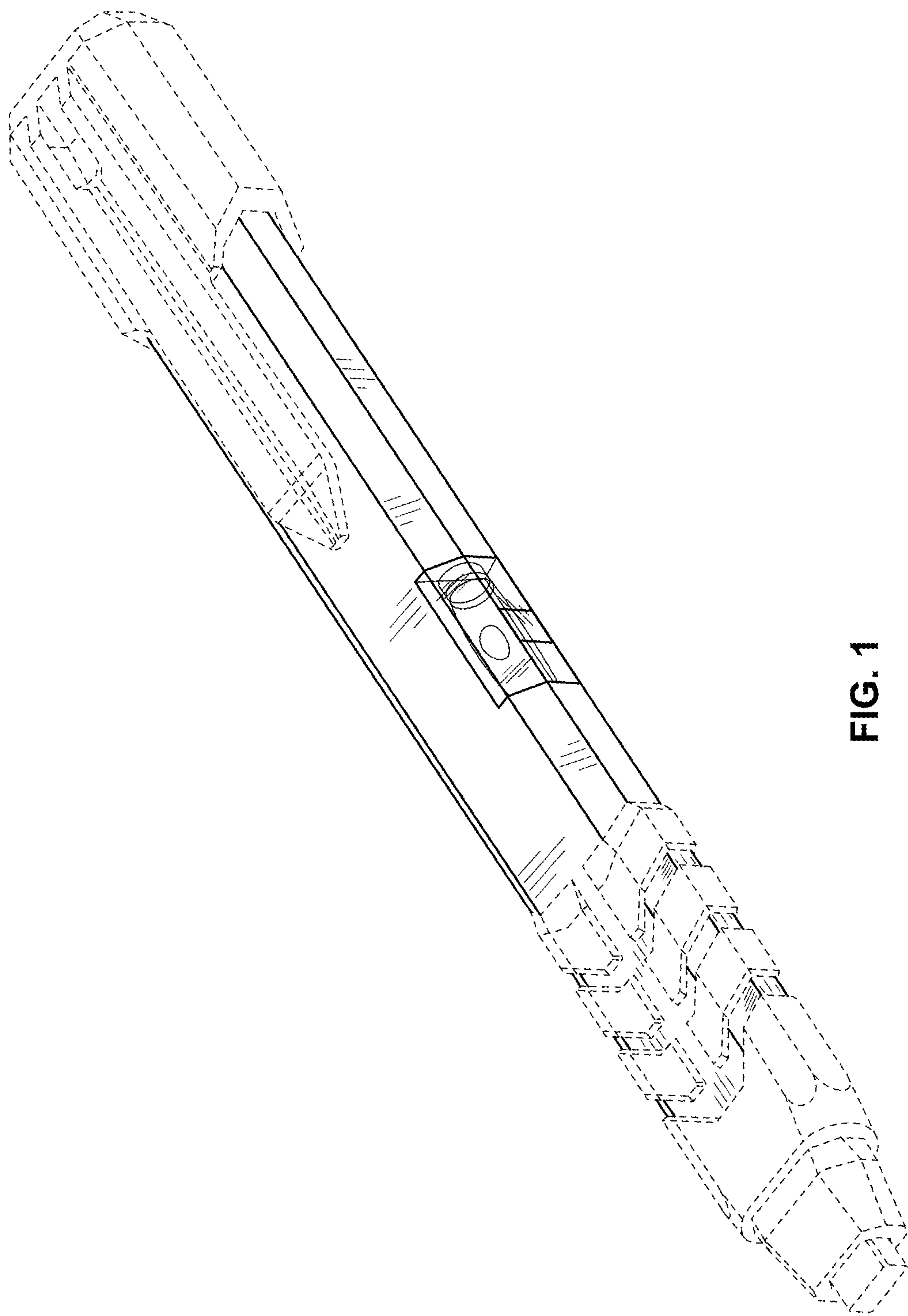

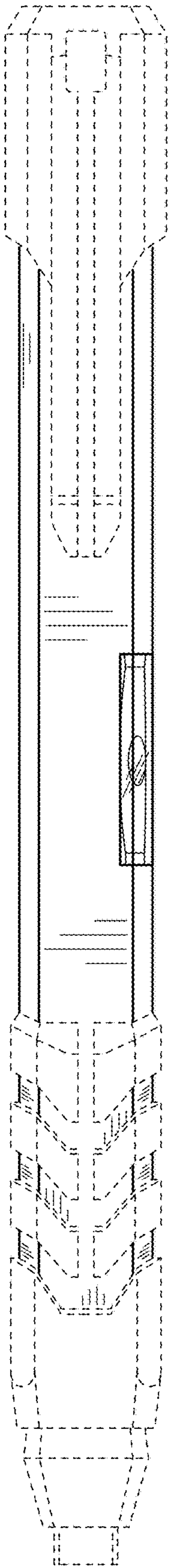

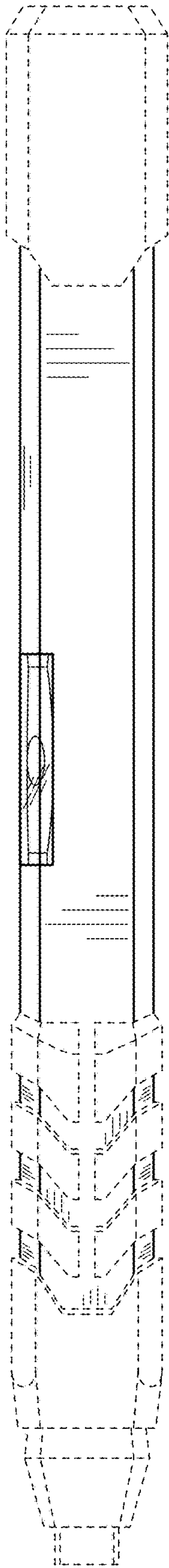

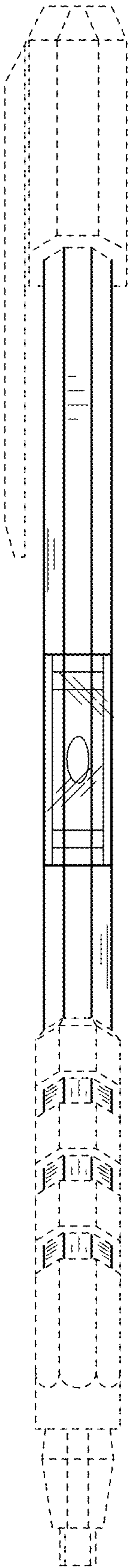

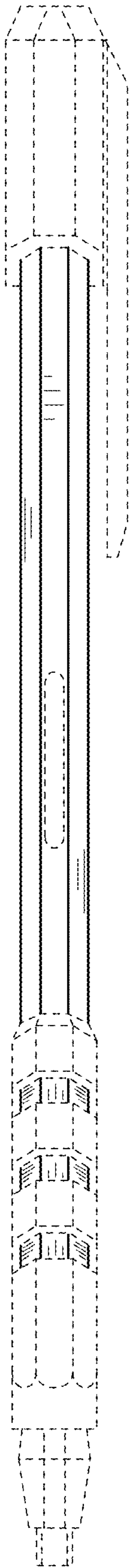

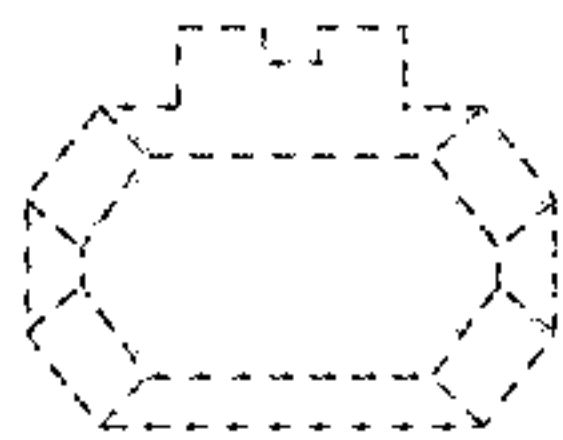

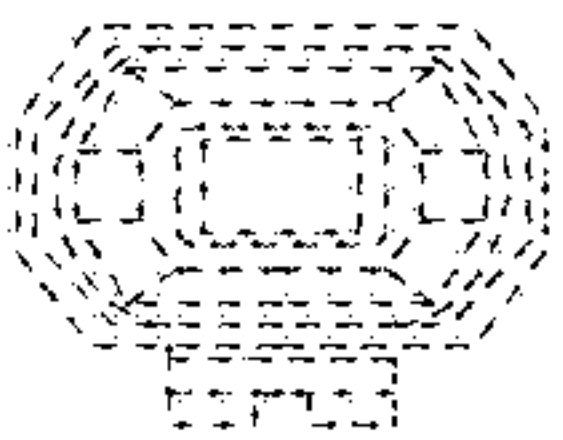

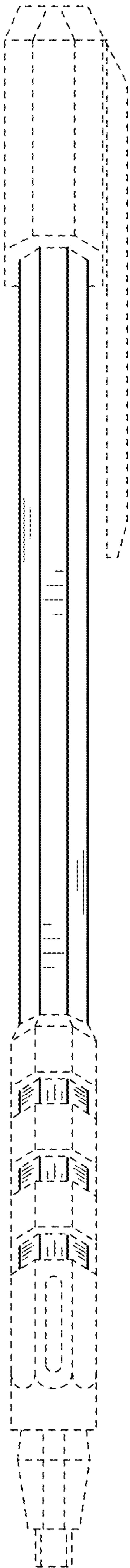

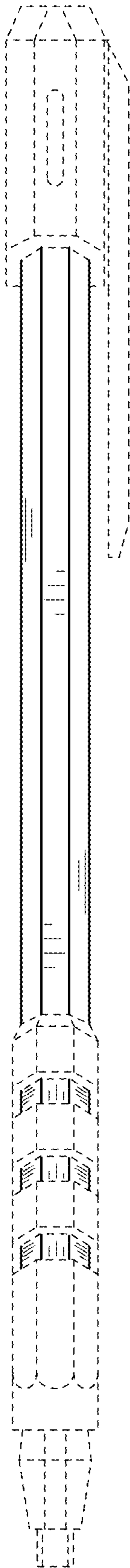
