(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foldable easel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front left perspective view of a foldable easel, in folded condition.

FIG. 2 is a back view of the foldable easel of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a front view of the foldable easel of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the foldable easel of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a top view of the foldable easel of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a left side view of the foldable easel of FIG. 1.

FIG. 7 is a right side view of the foldable easel of FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is a front left perspective view of the foldable easel of FIG. 1, in unfolded condition wherein left and right wings extend forward from a back portion of the foldable easel.

FIG. 9 is a left side view of the foldable easel of FIG. 8.

FIG. 10 is a front view of the foldable easel of FIG. 8.

FIG. 11 is a back view of the foldable easel of FIG. 8.

FIG. 12 is a top view of the foldable easel of FIG. 8.

FIG. 13 is a bottom view of the foldable easel of FIG. 8.

FIG. 14 is a left side view of the foldable easel of FIG. 8 pivoted clockwise on the page approximately 90 degrees from FIG. 9, for example, for resting bottom edges of the left wing, right wing, and back portion on a horizontal surface. FIG. 15 is a front view of the foldable easel of FIG. 1 in folded condition and pivoted clockwise on the page 90 degrees from the position of FIG. 3 to place the top of the foldable easel toward the right of the page.

FIG. 16 is a front left perspective view of another embodiment of foldable easel, in folded condition.

FIG. 17 is a back view of the foldable easel of FIG. 16.

FIG. 18 is a front view of the foldable easel of FIG. 16.

FIG. 19 is a bottom view of the foldable easel of FIG. 16.

FIG. 20 is a top view of the foldable easel of FIG. 16.

FIG. 21 is a left side view of the foldable easel of FIG. 16.

FIG. 22 is a right side view of the foldable easel of FIG. 16.

FIG. 23 is a front left perspective view of the foldable easel of FIG. 16, in unfolded condition wherein left and right wings extend forward from a back portion of the foldable easel.

FIG. 24 is a left side view of the foldable easel of FIG. 23.

FIG. 25 is a right side view of the foldable easel of FIG. 23.

FIG. 26 is a front view of the foldable easel of FIG. 23.

FIG. 27 is a back view of the foldable easel of FIG. 23.

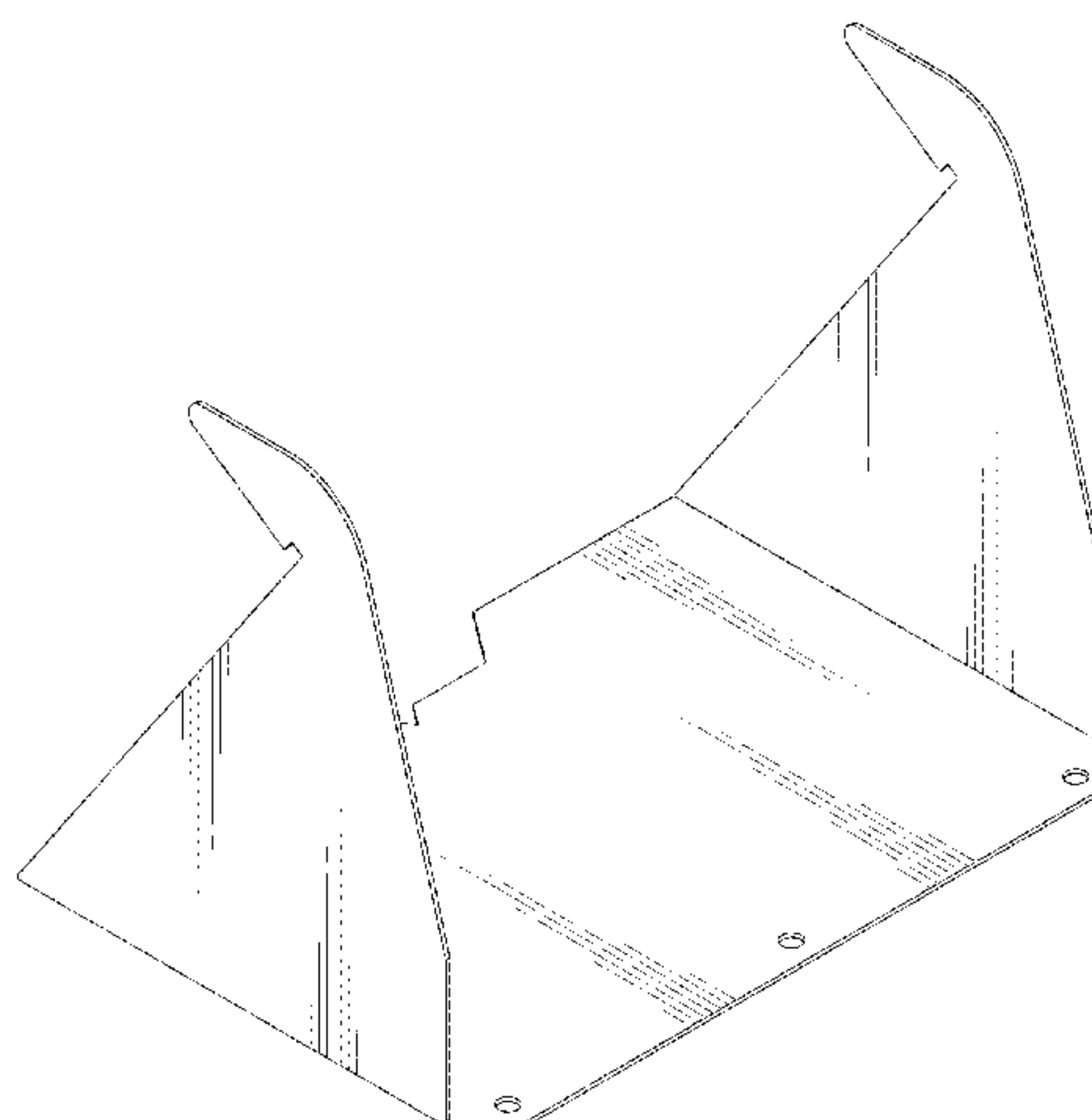
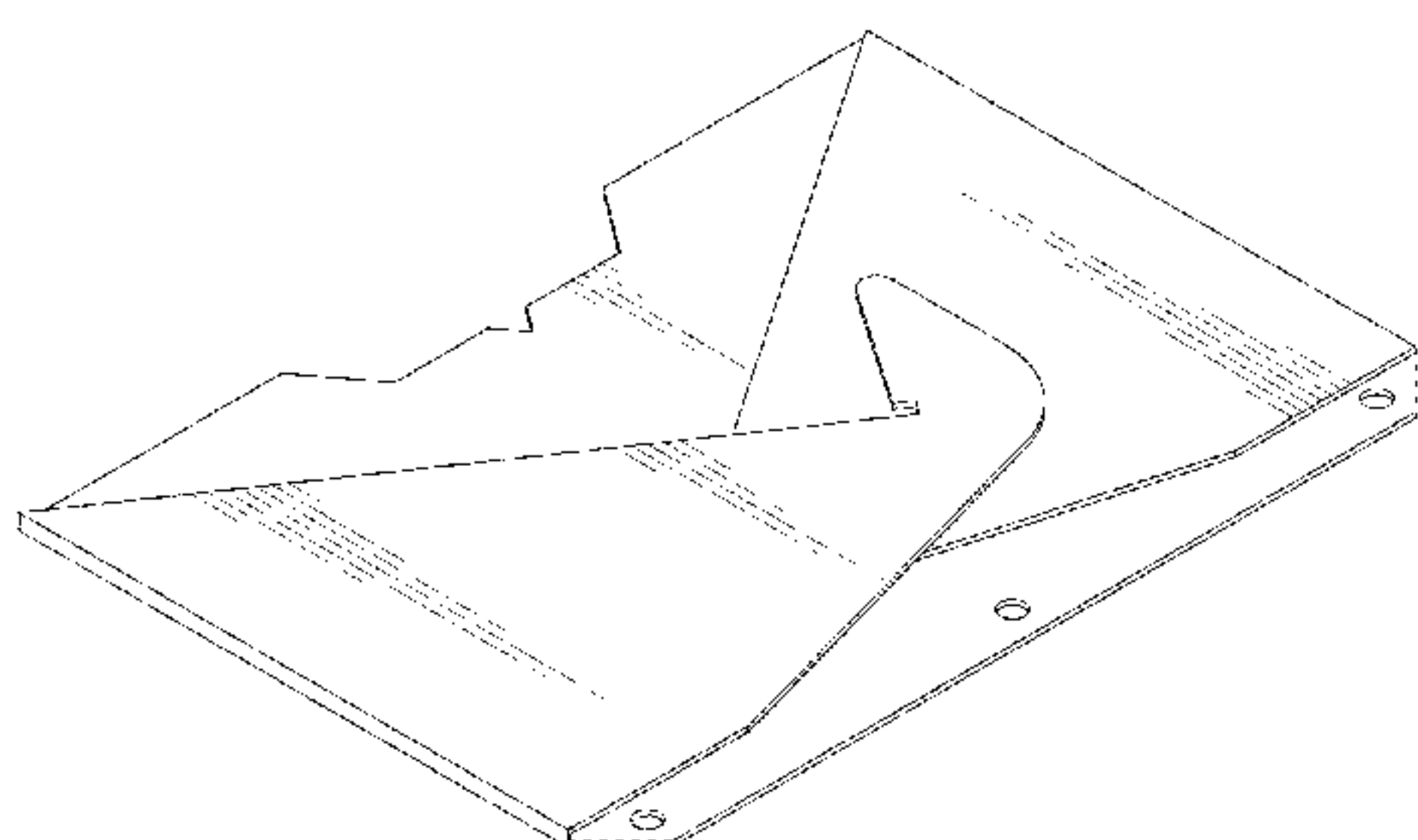
FIG. 28 is a top view of the foldable easel of FIG. 23.

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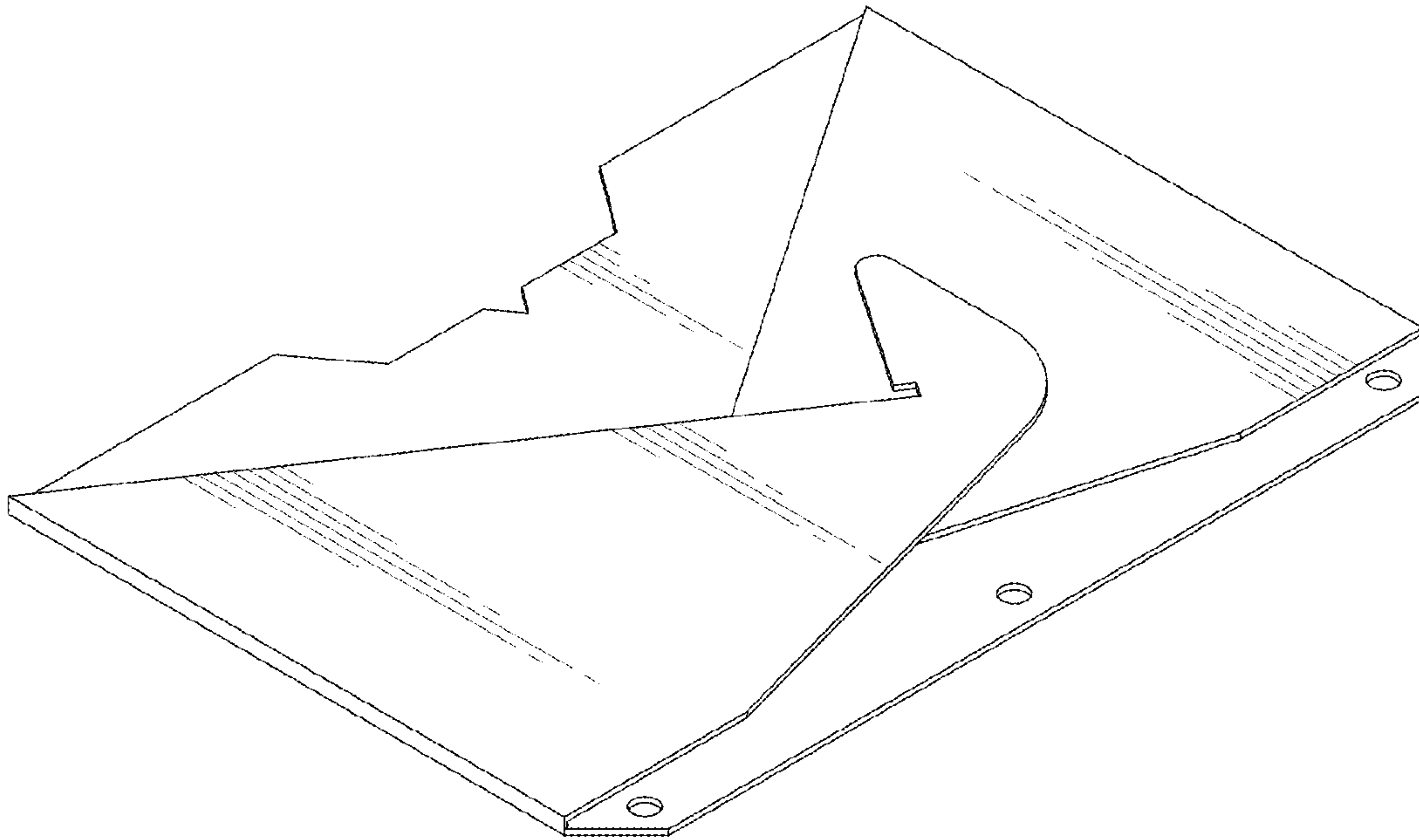

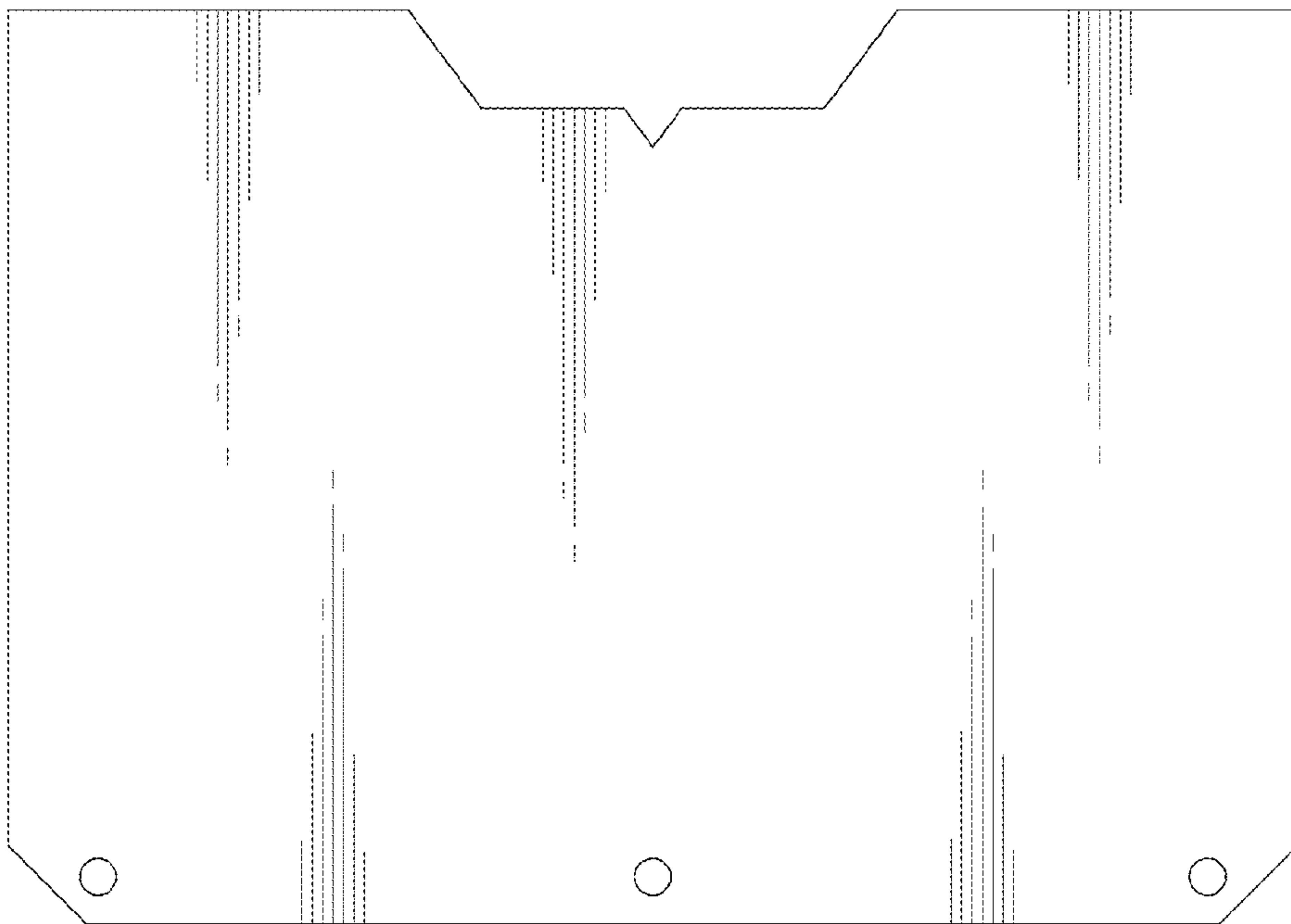

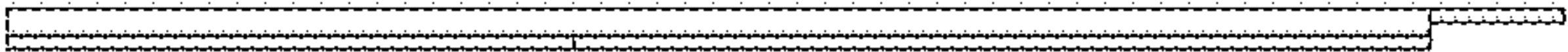

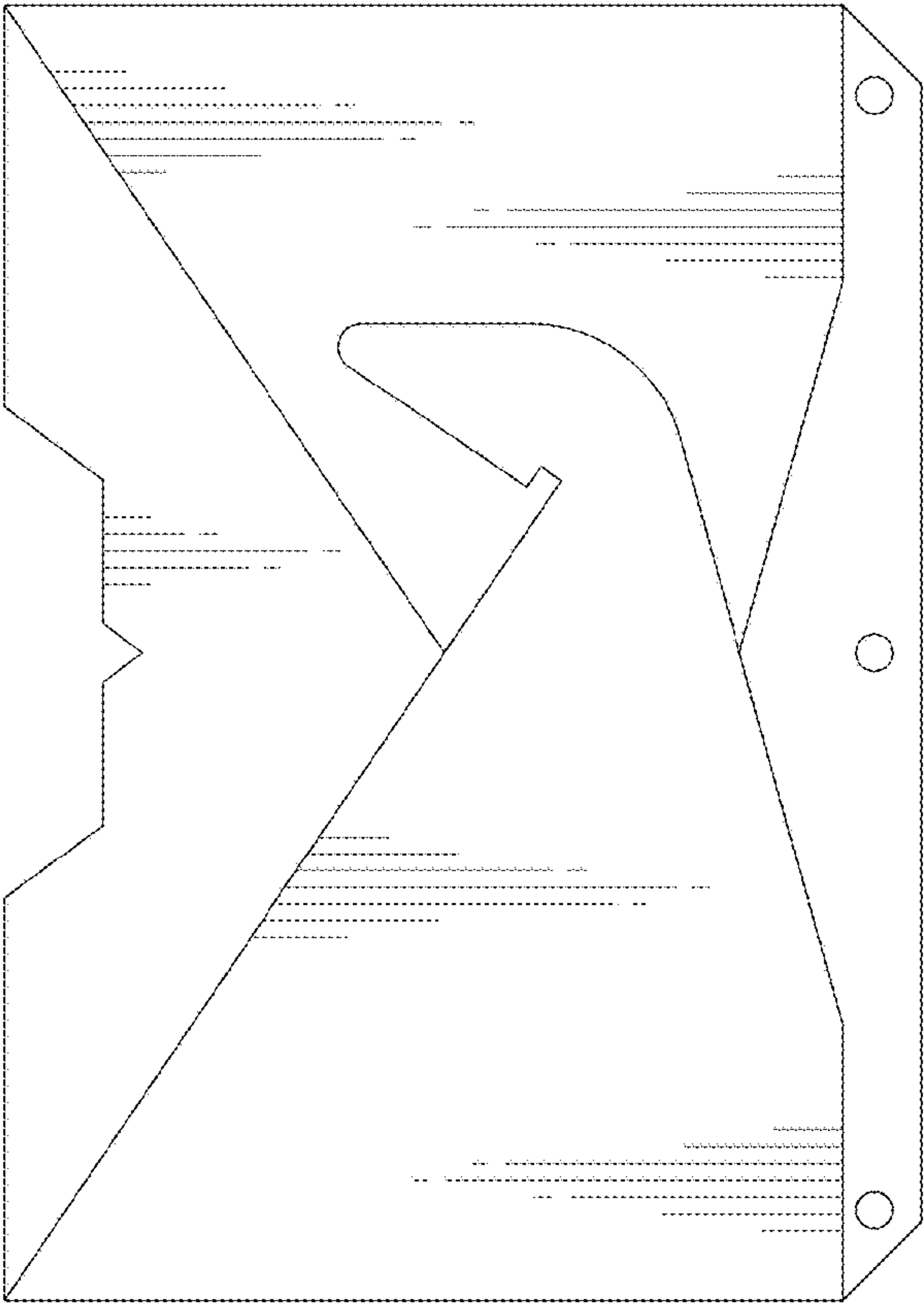

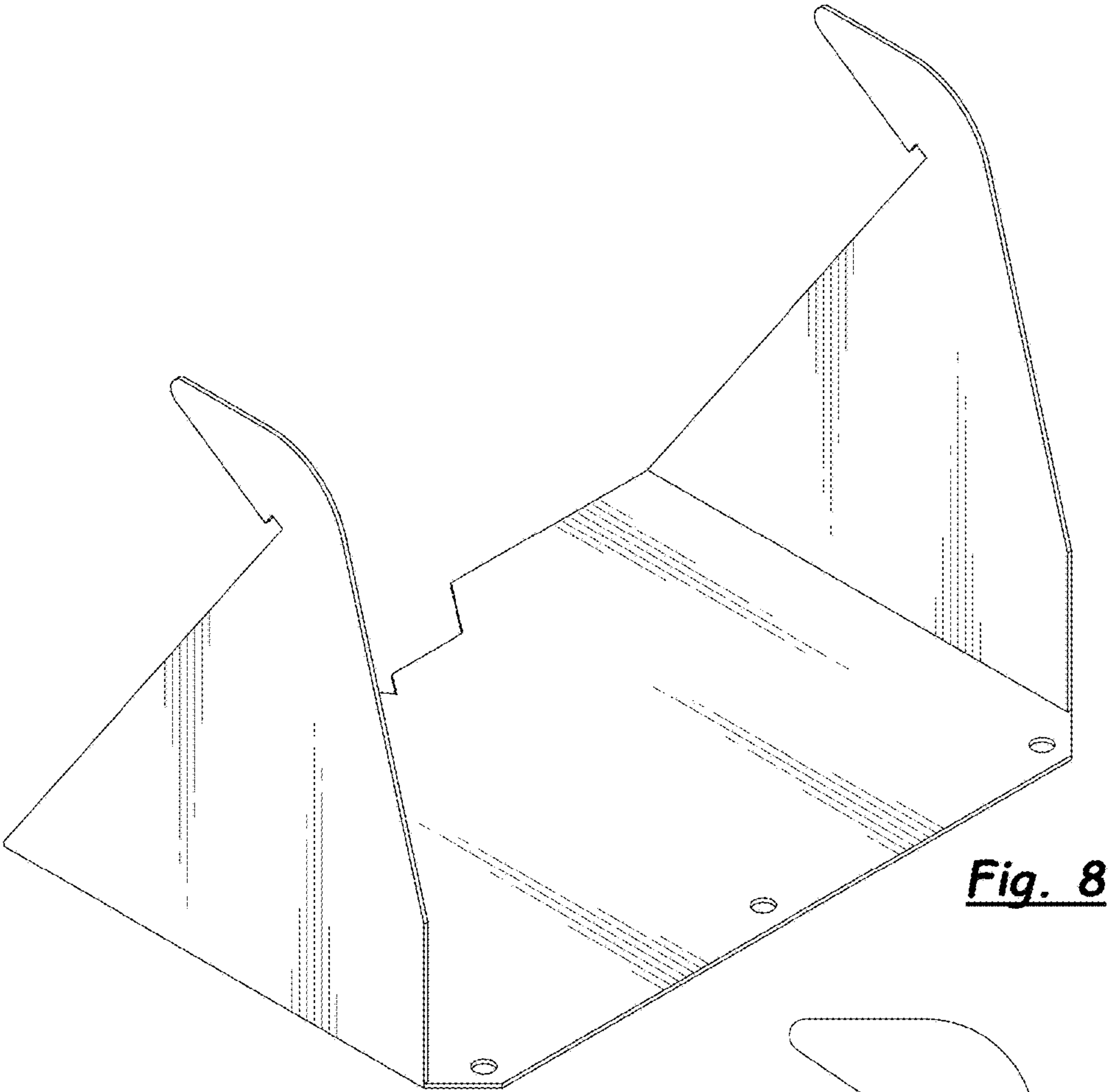
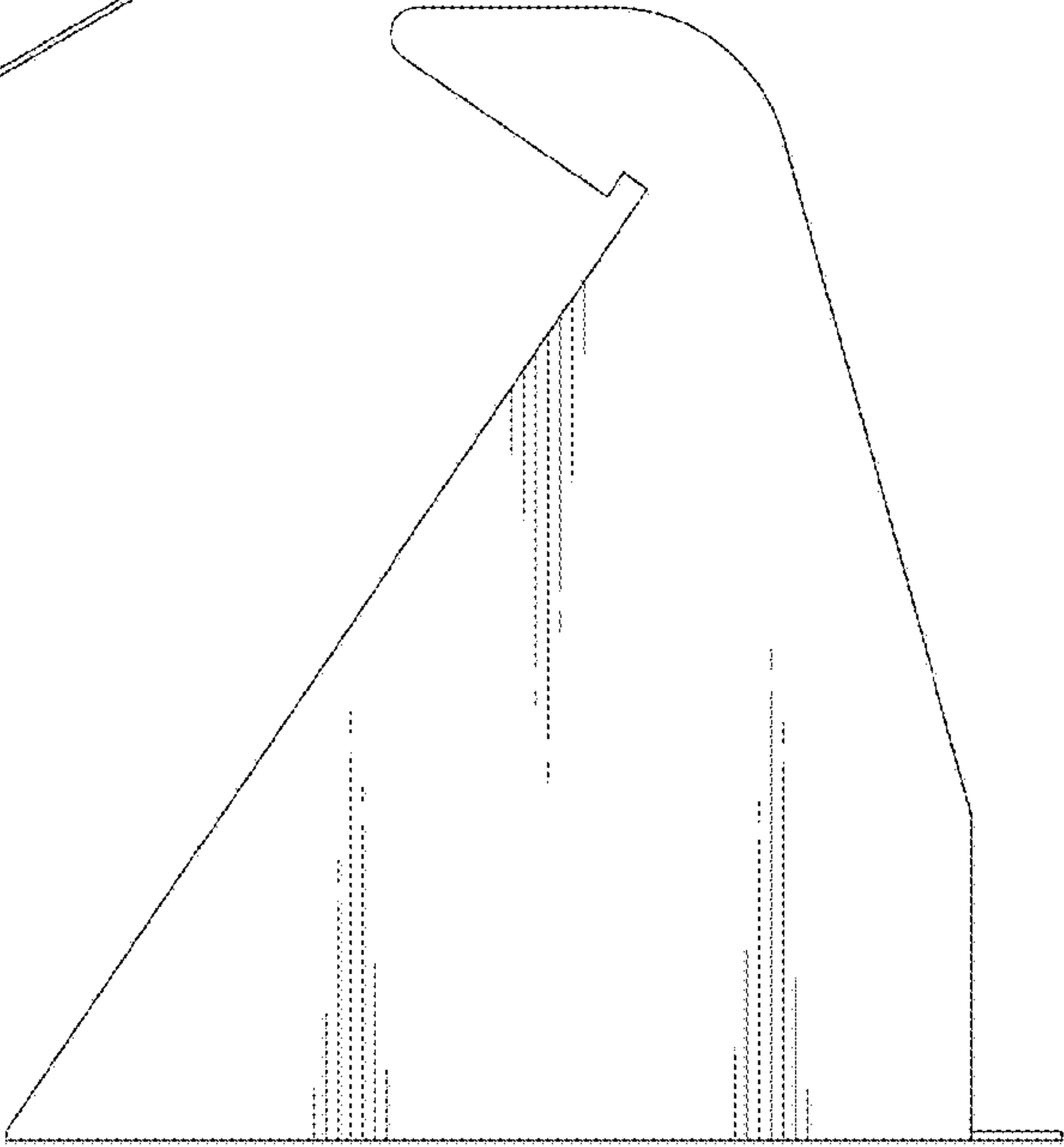

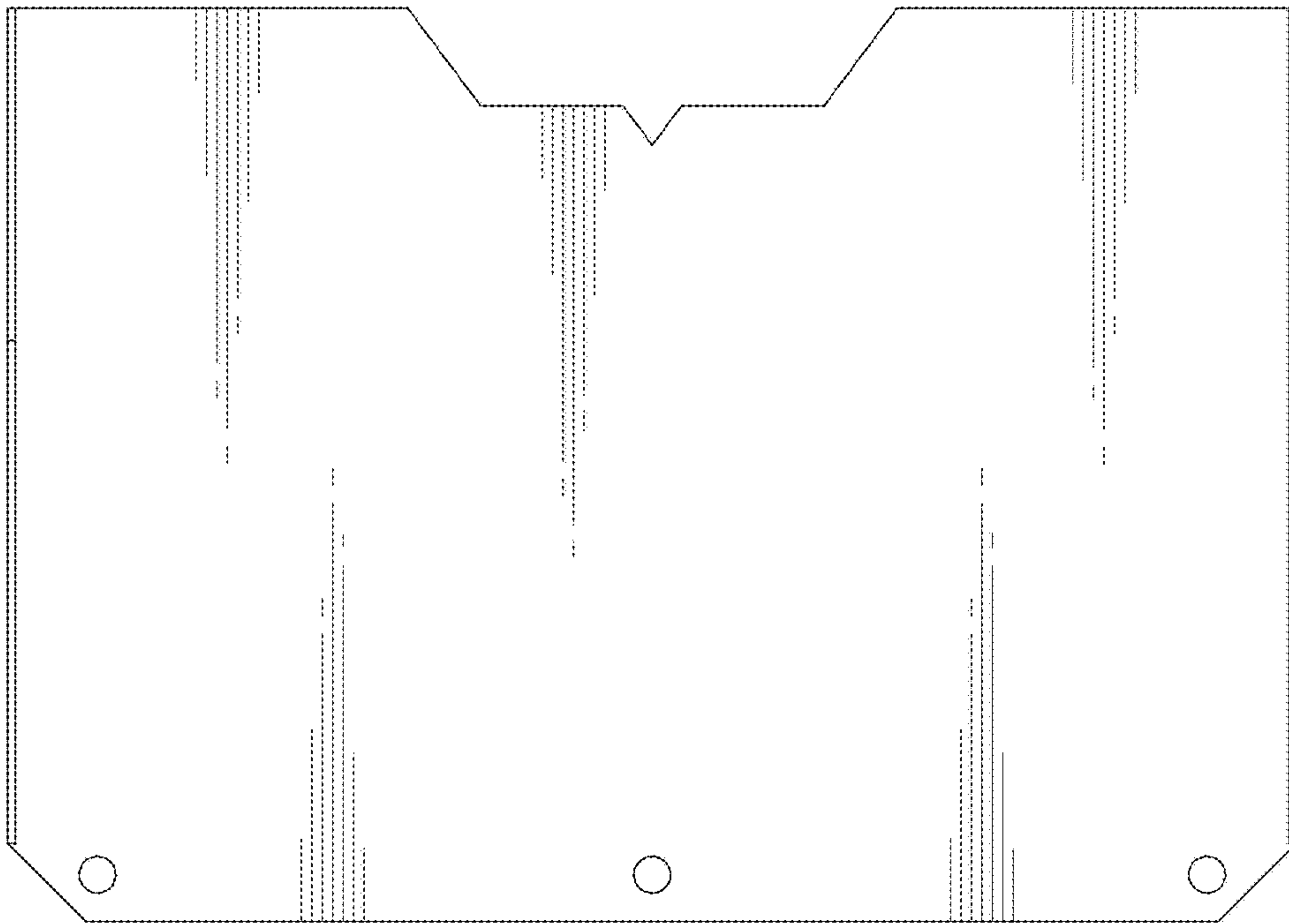

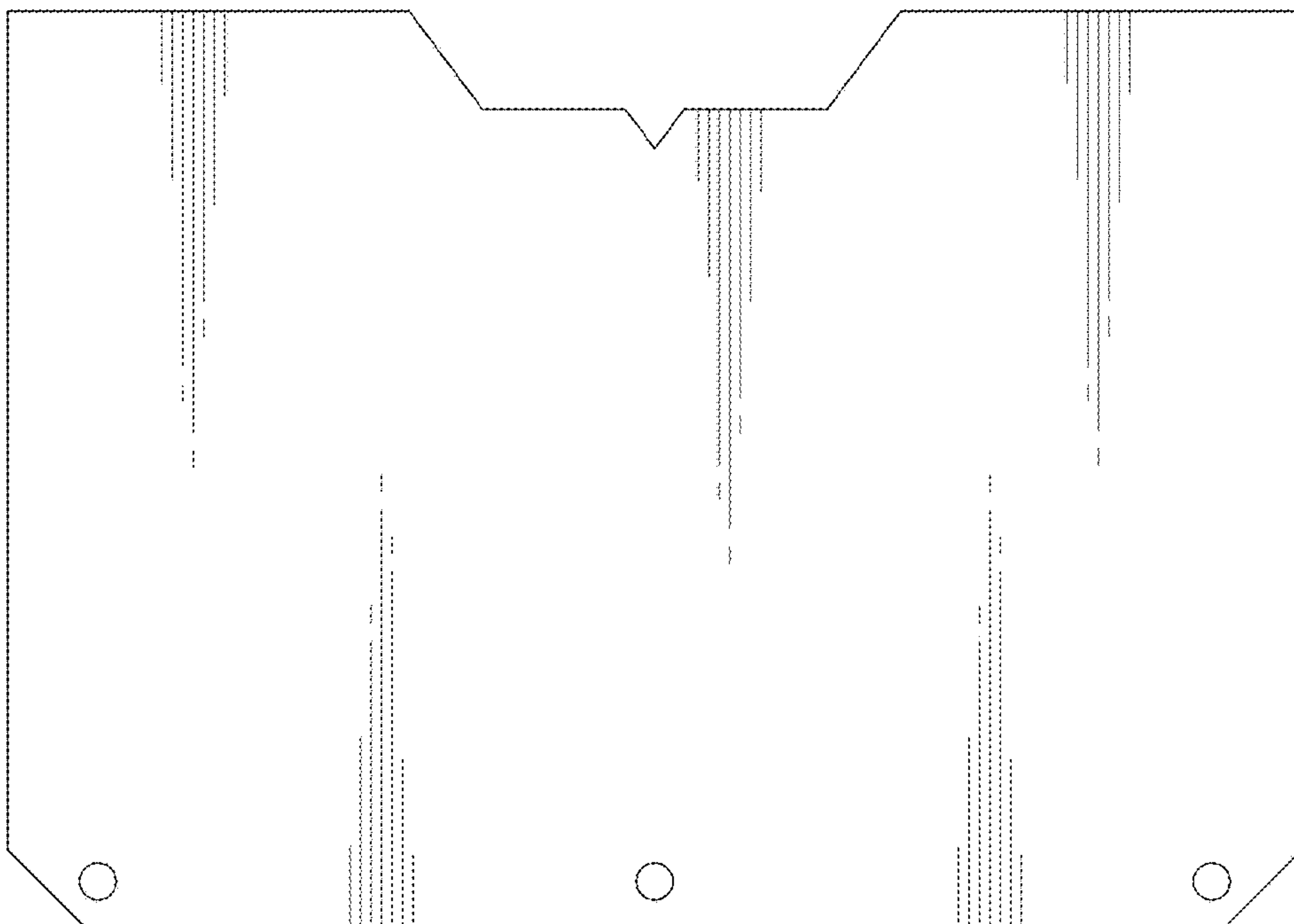

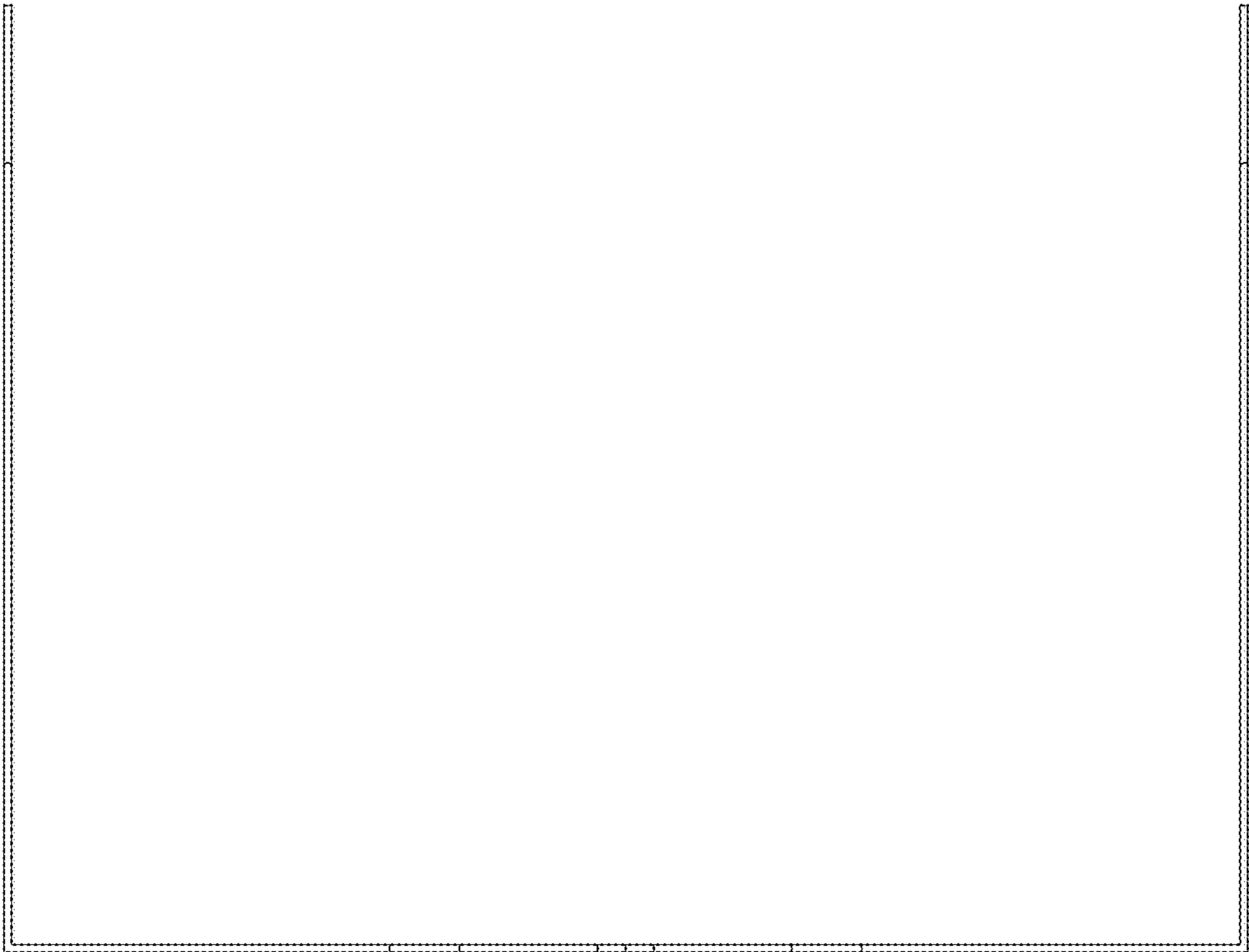

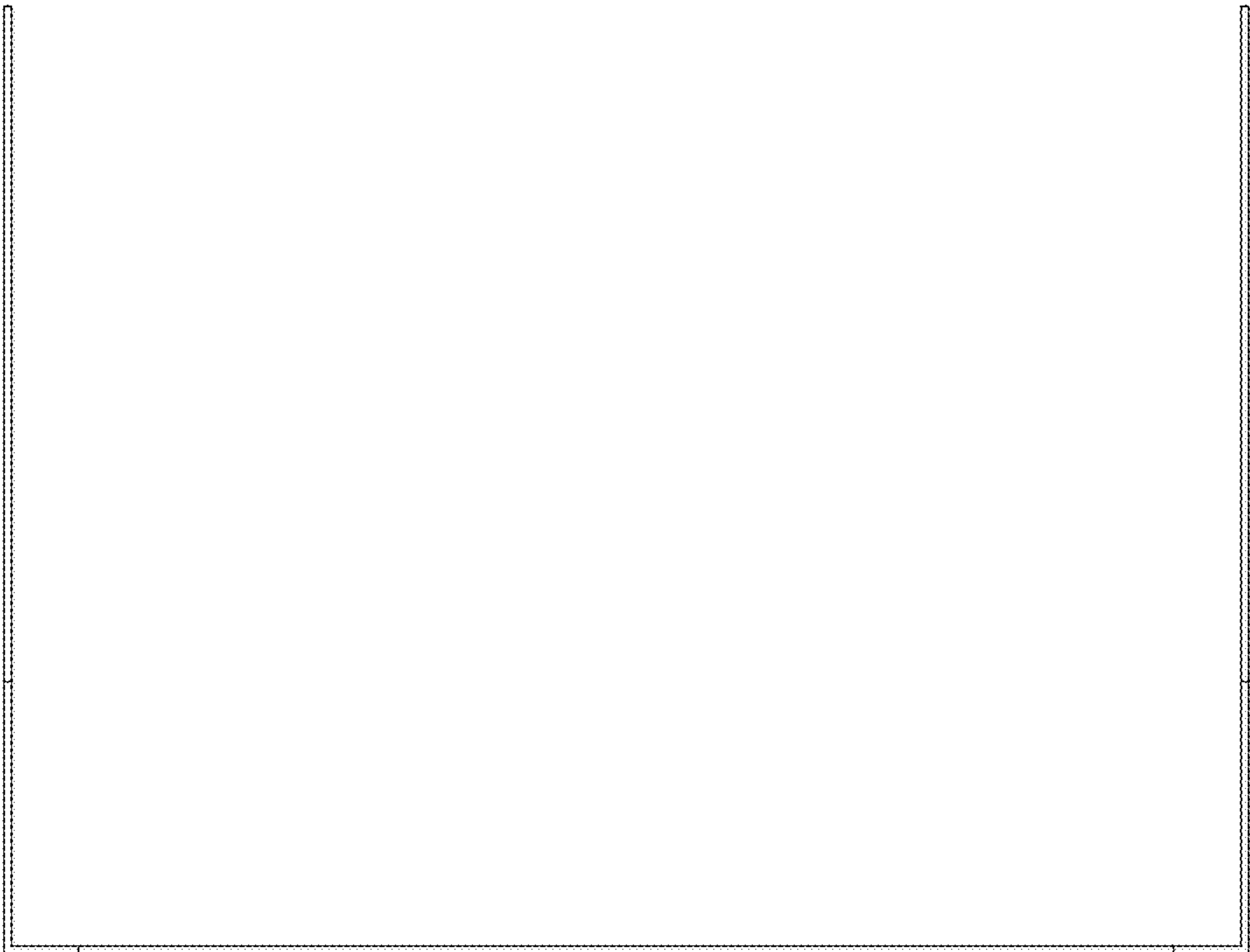

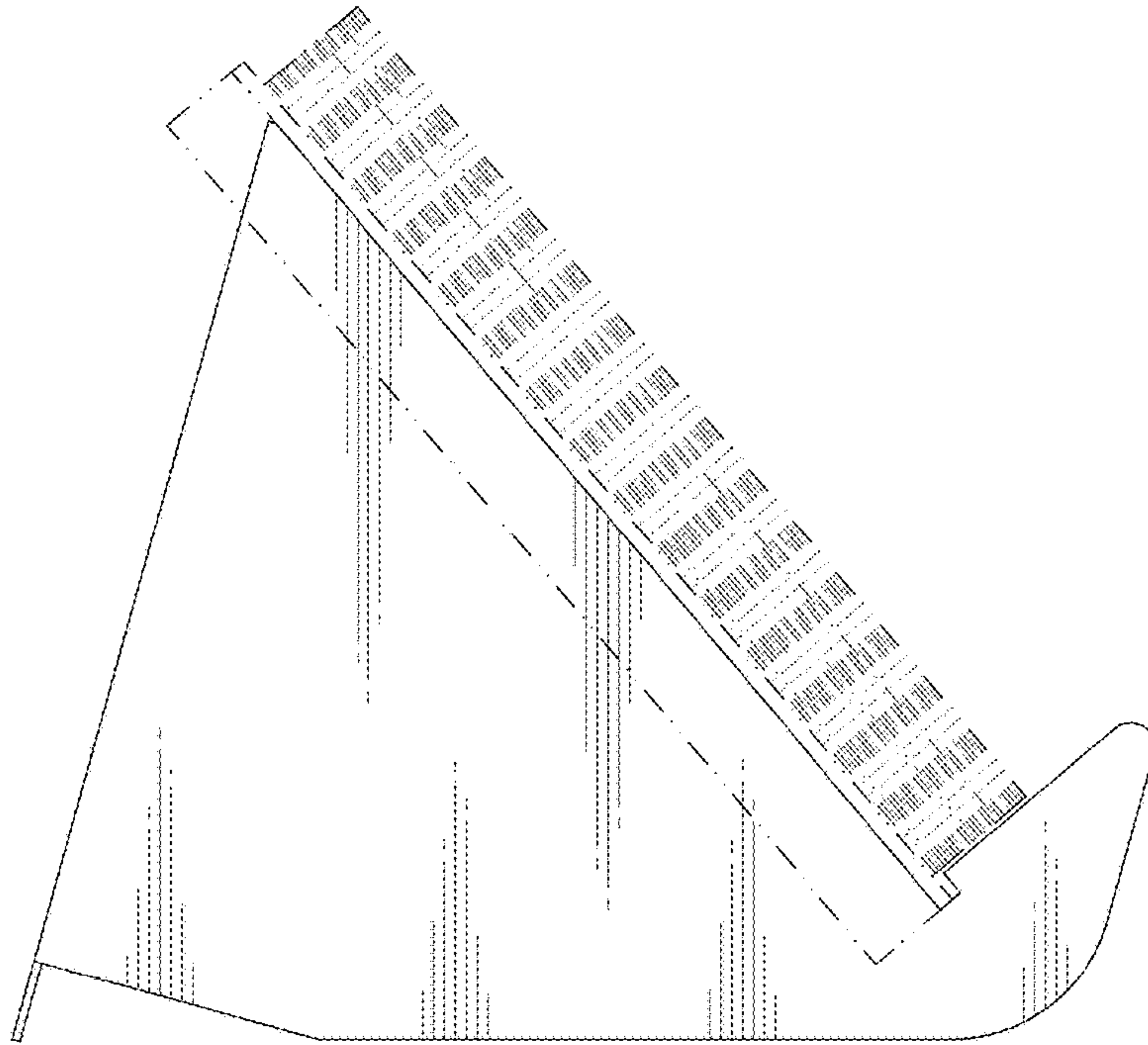

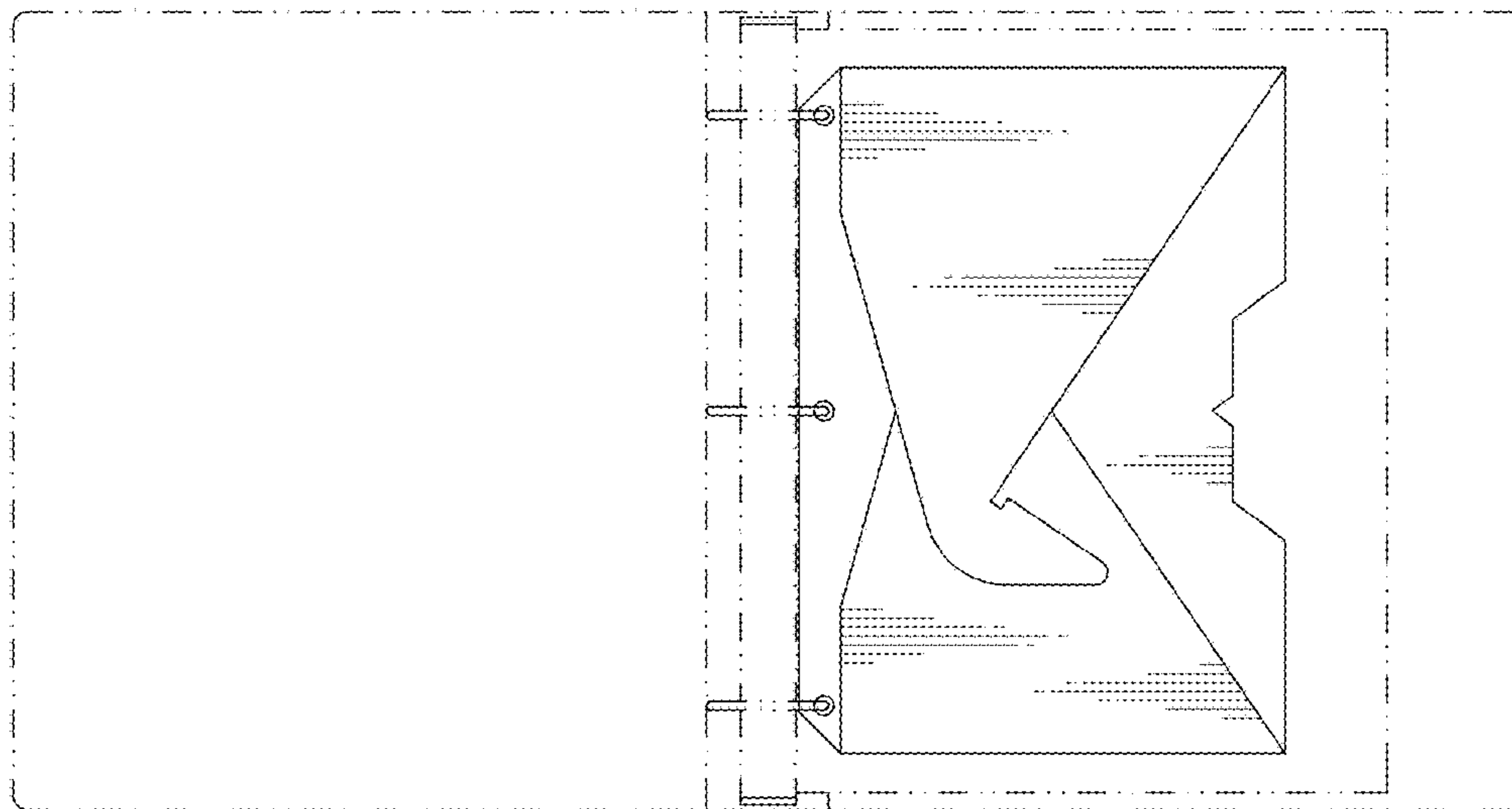

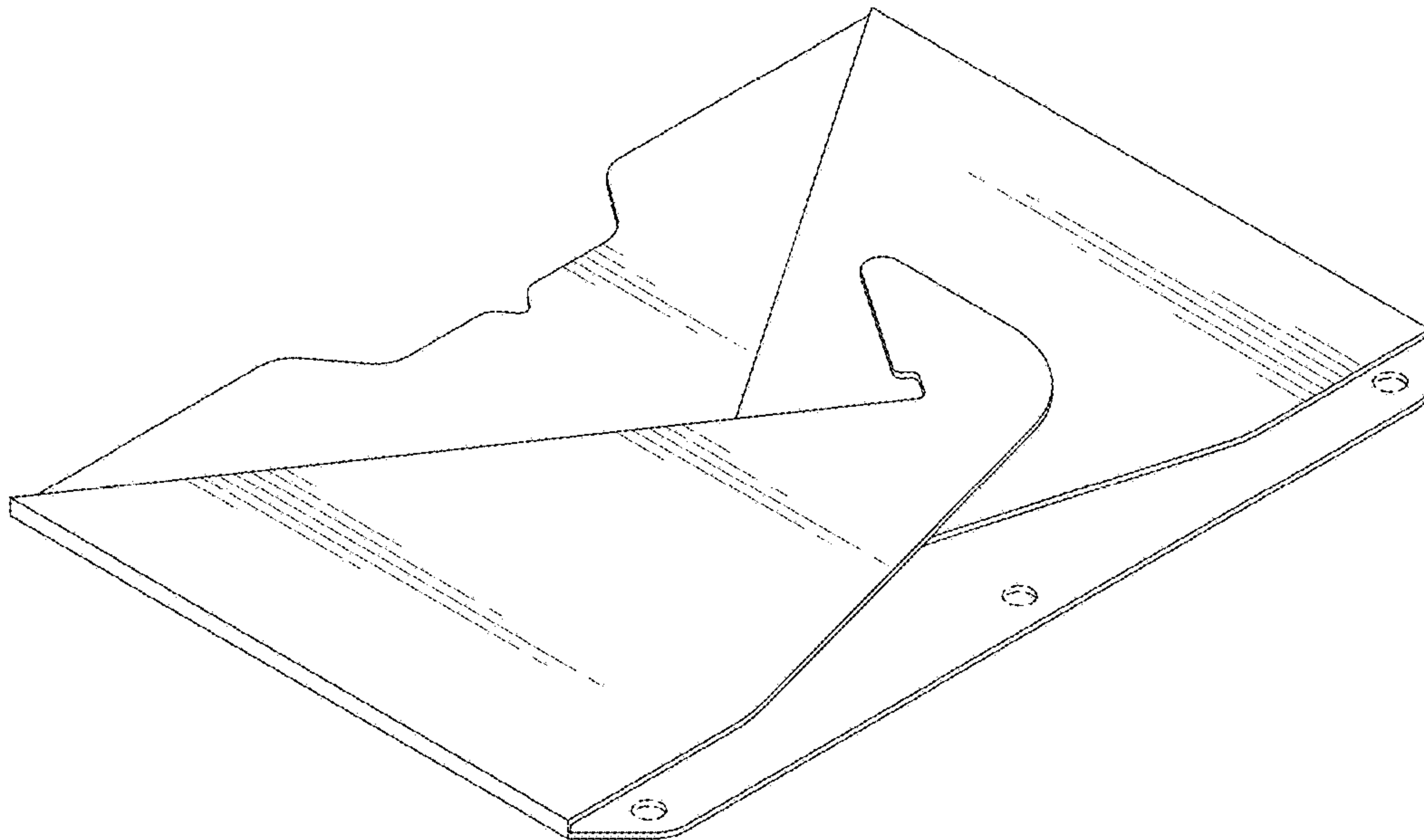

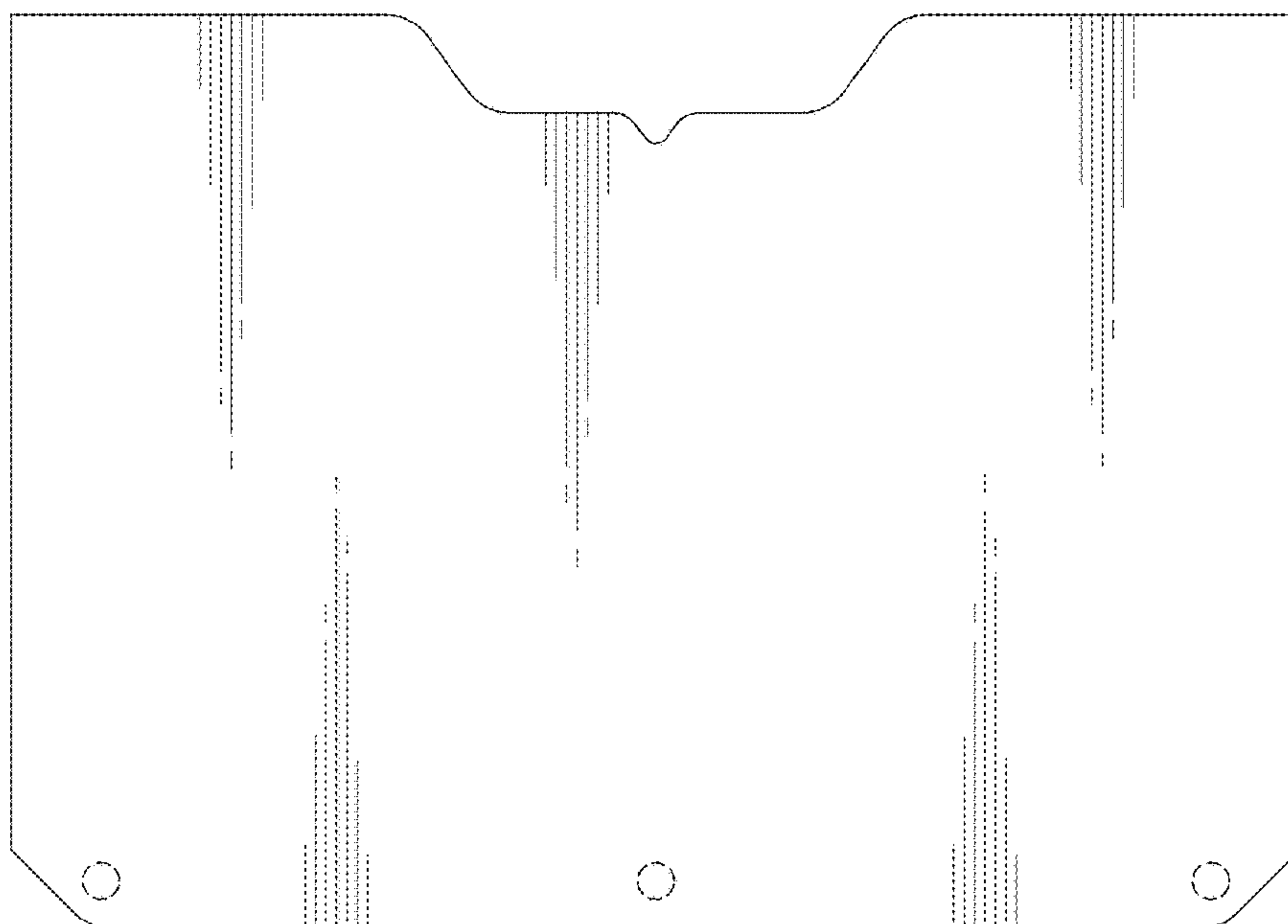

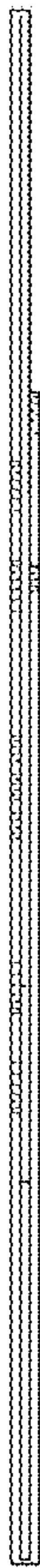

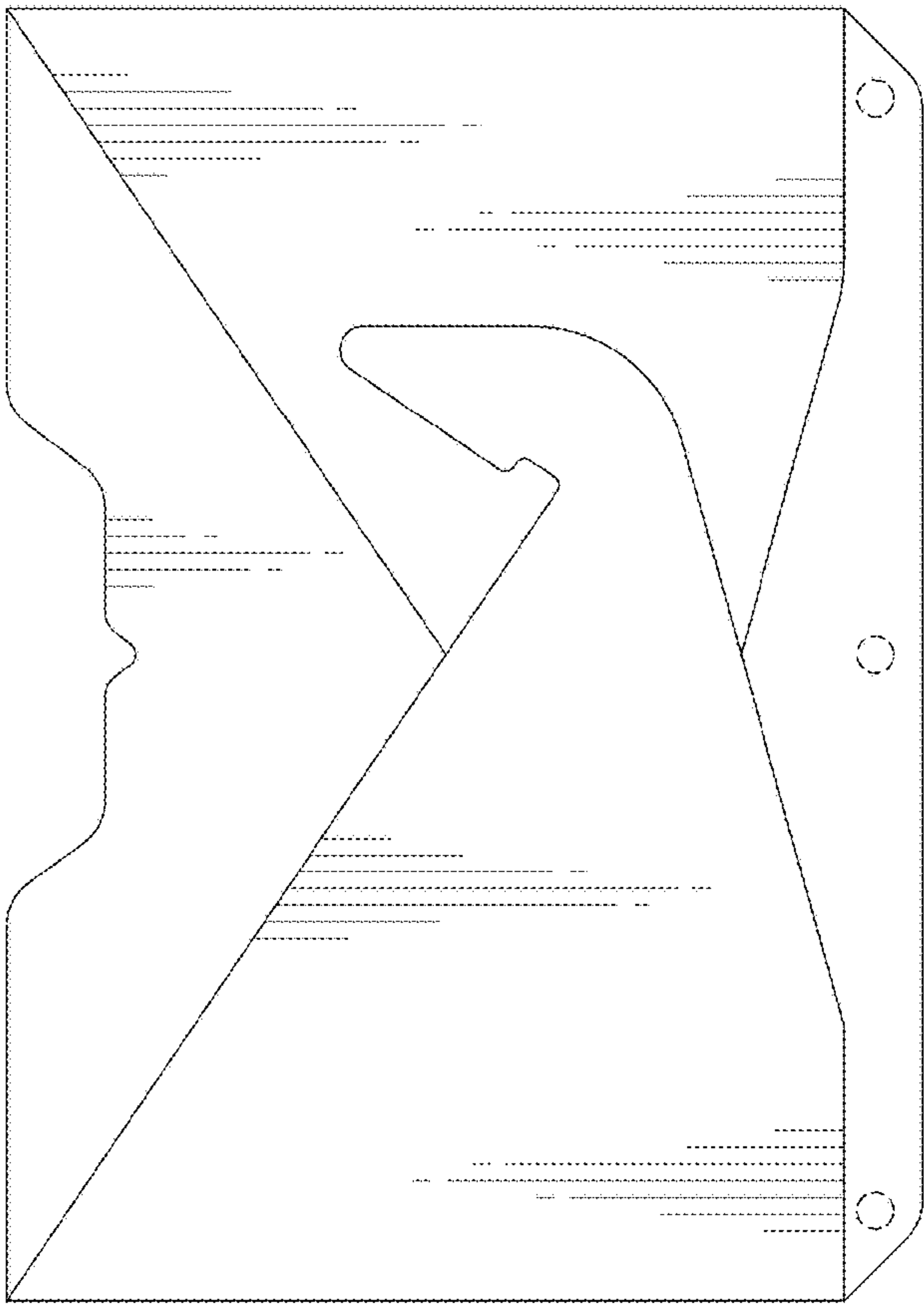

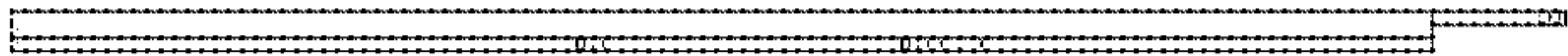

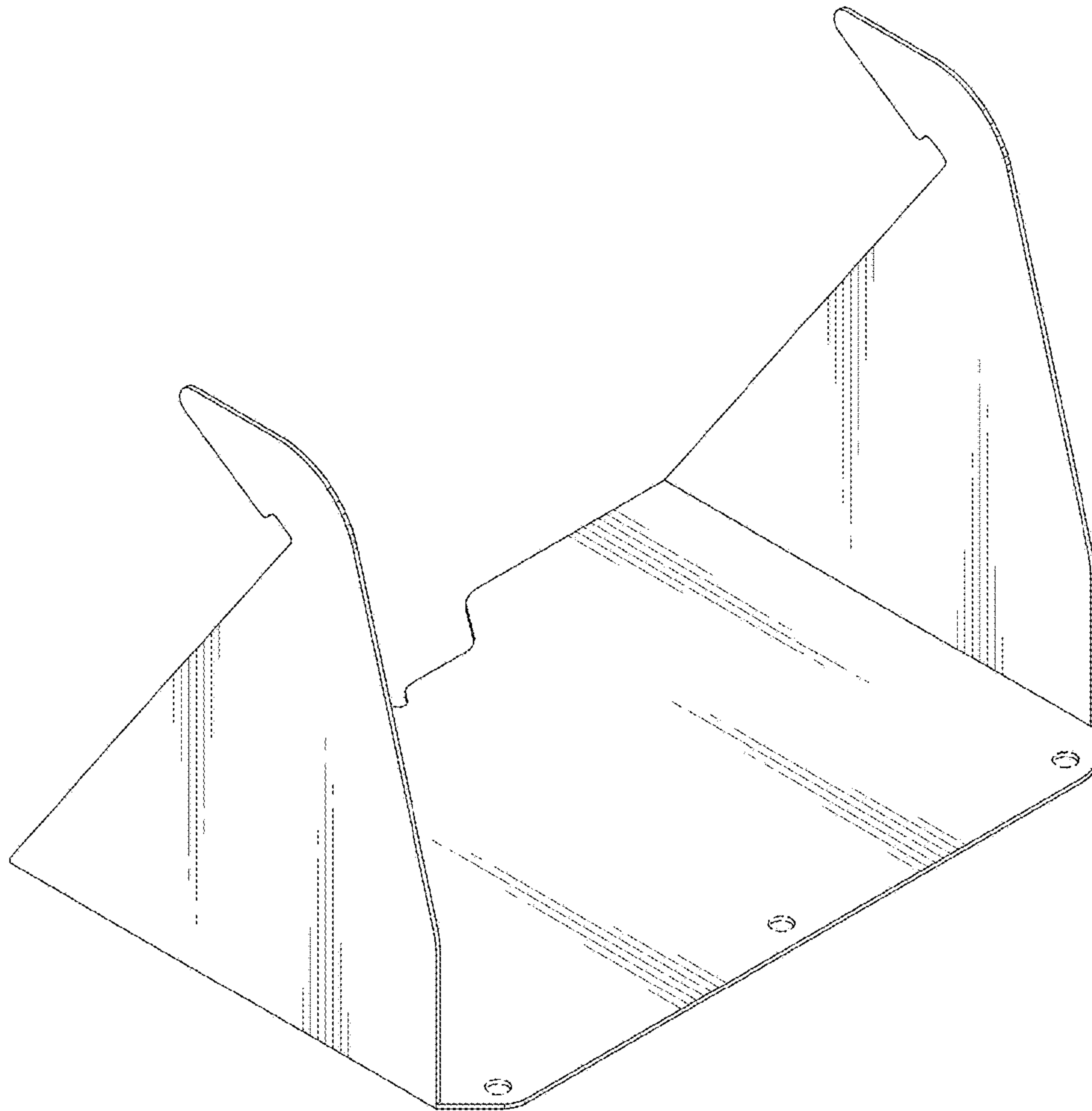

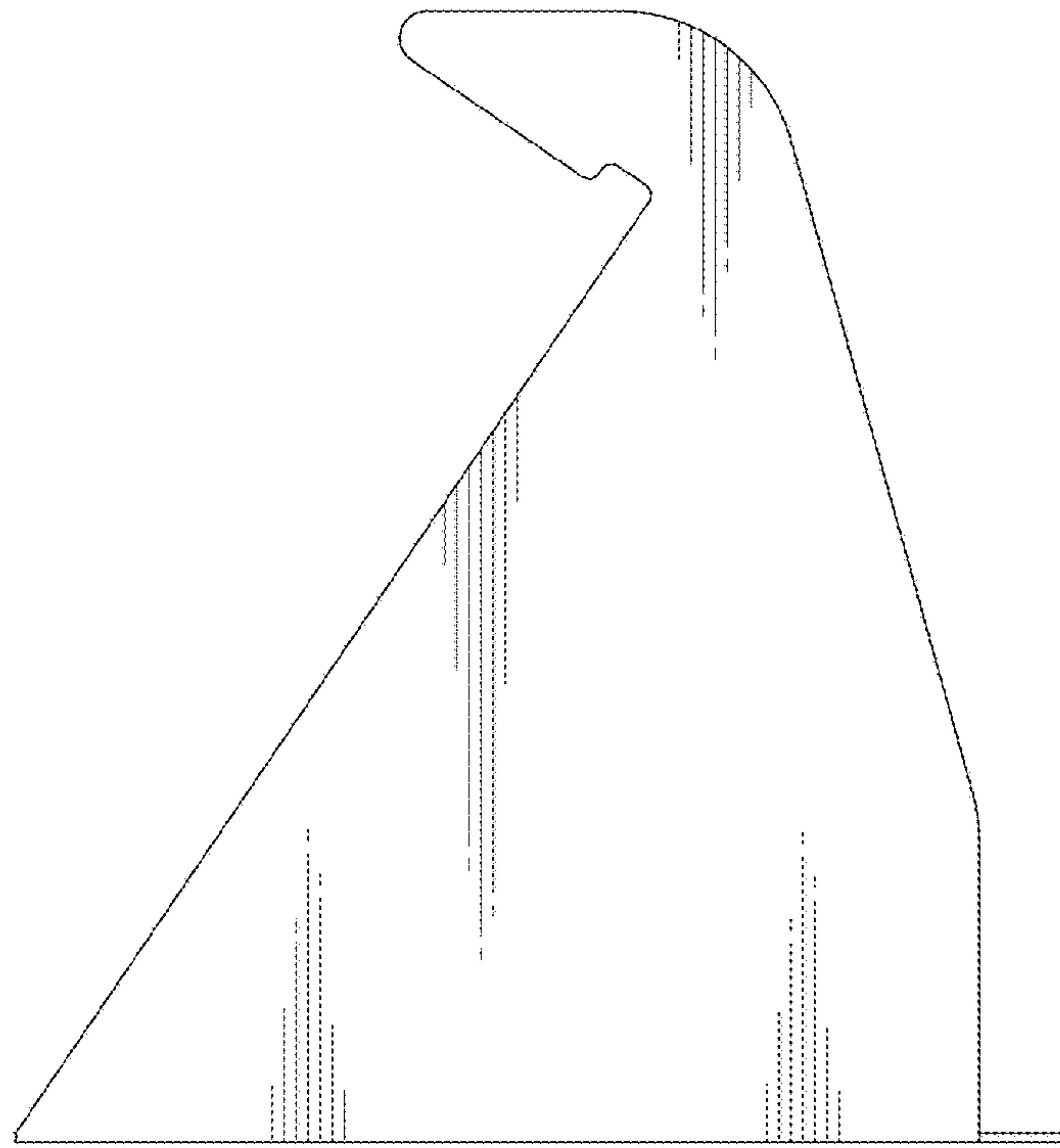

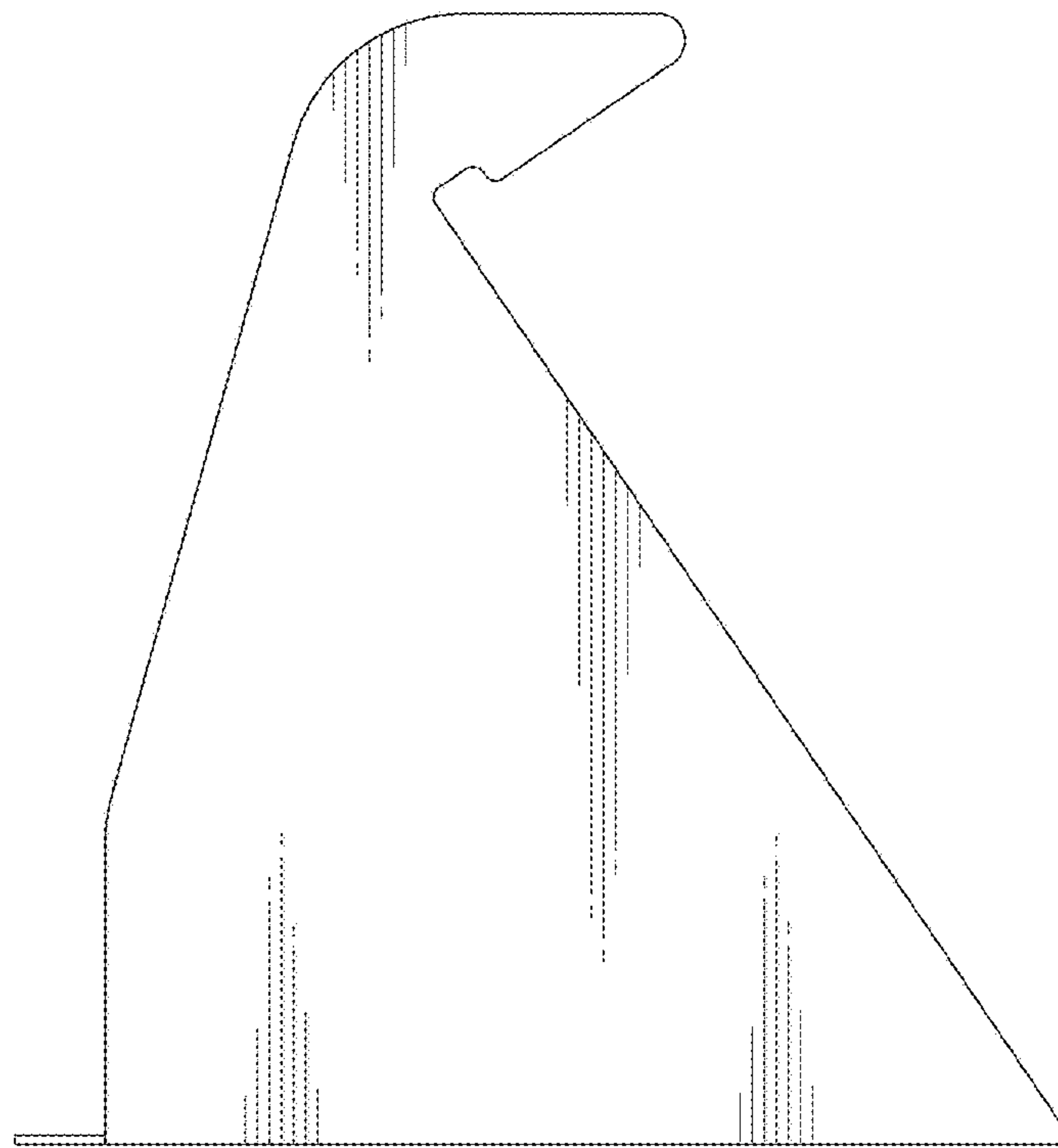

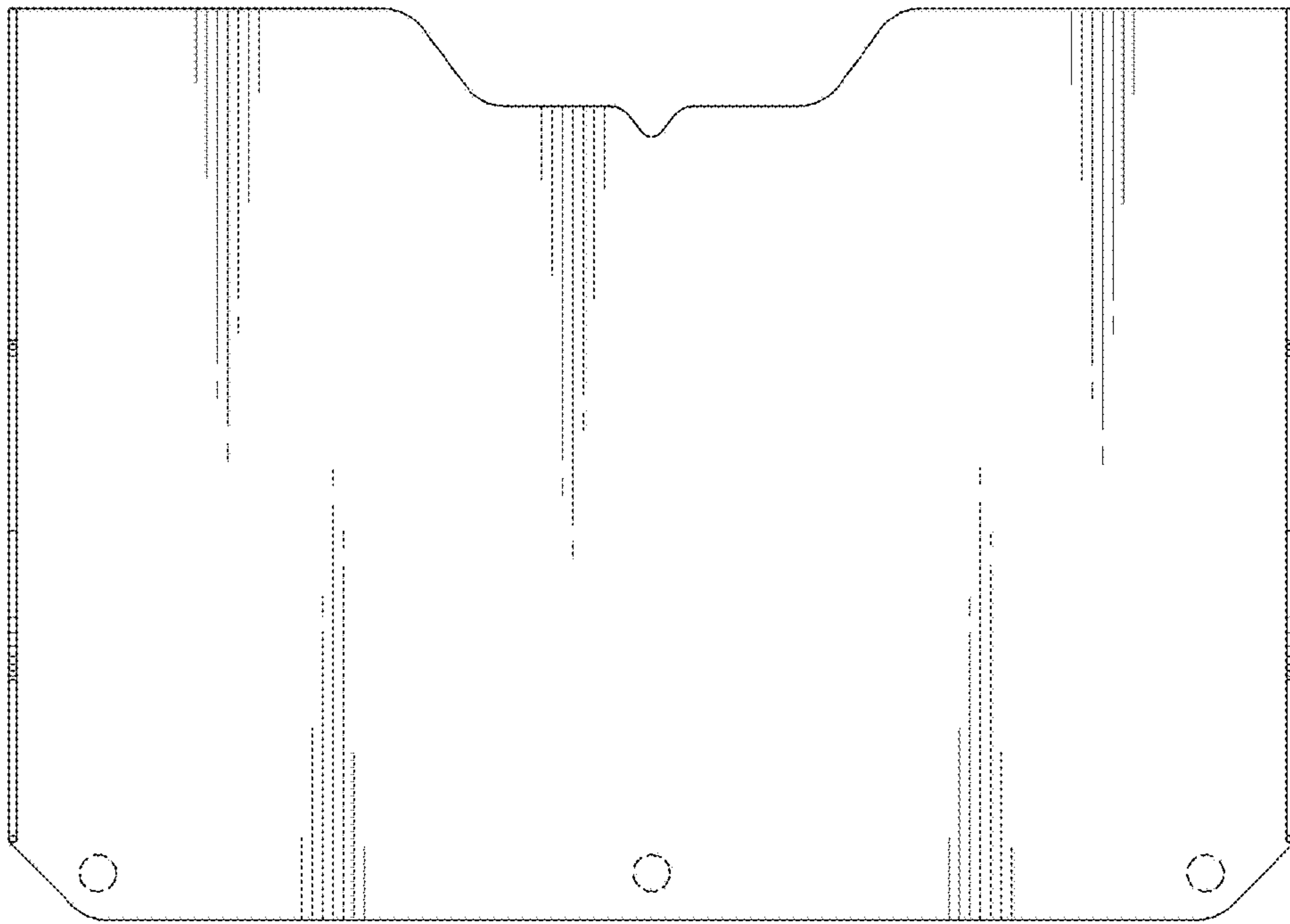

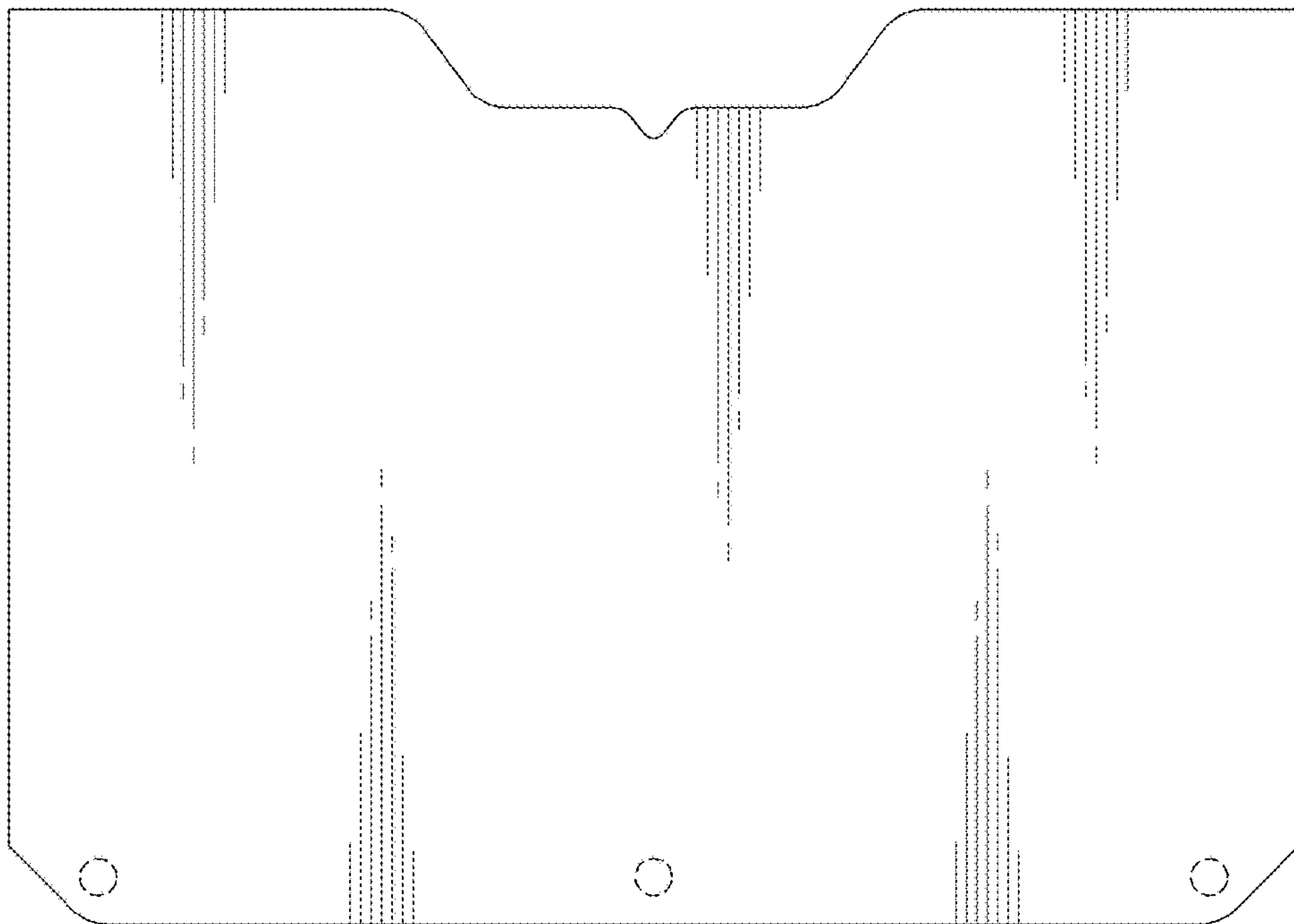

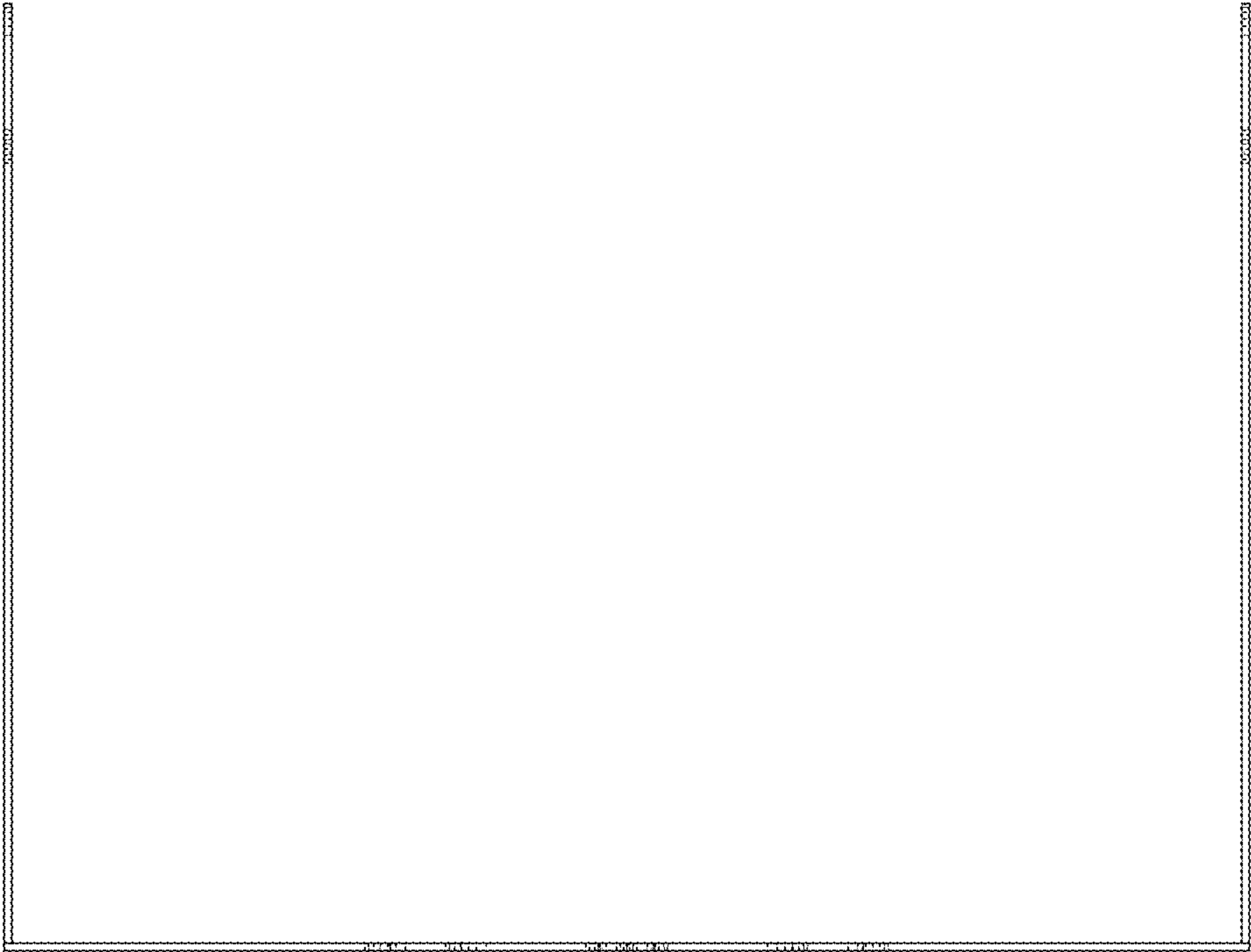

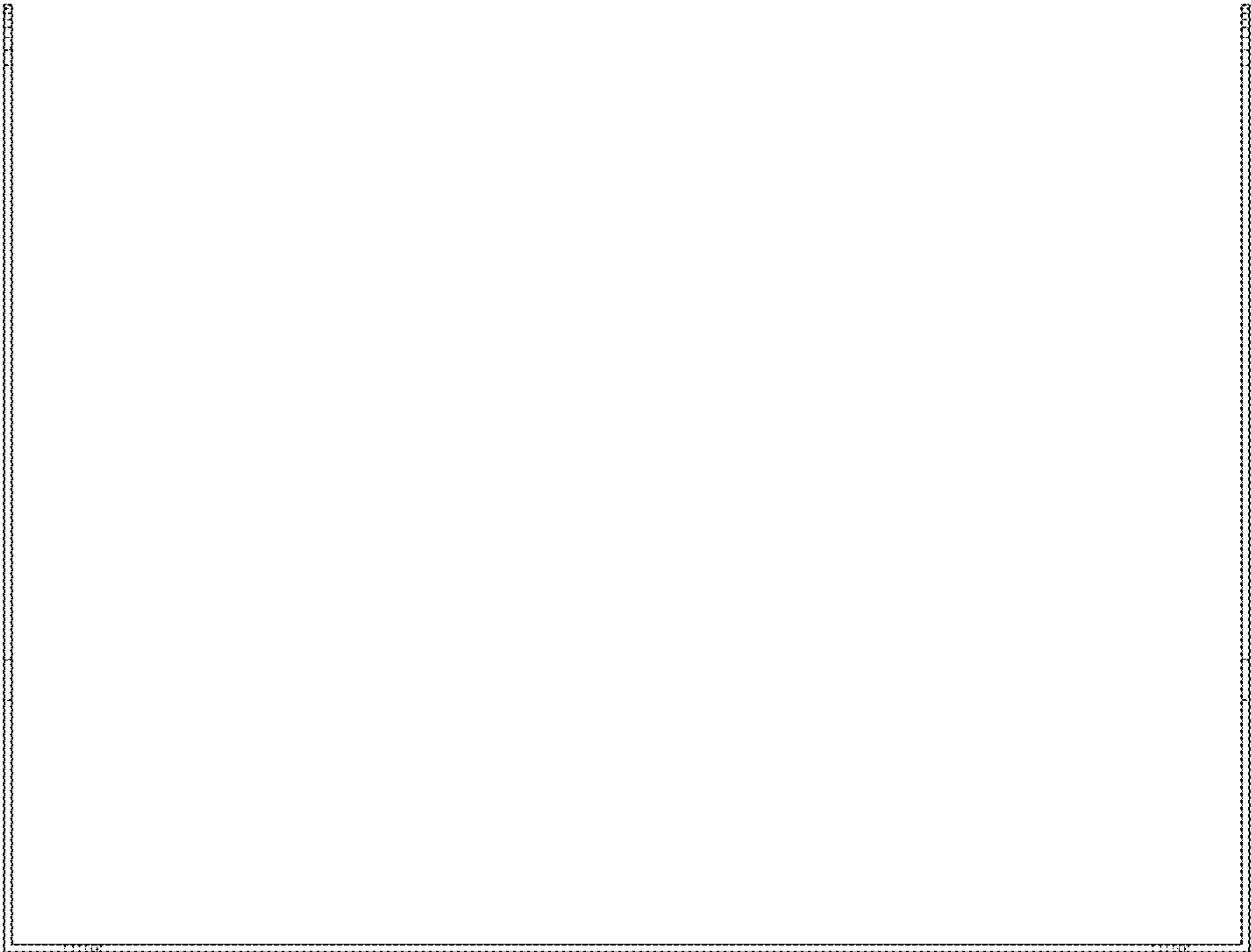

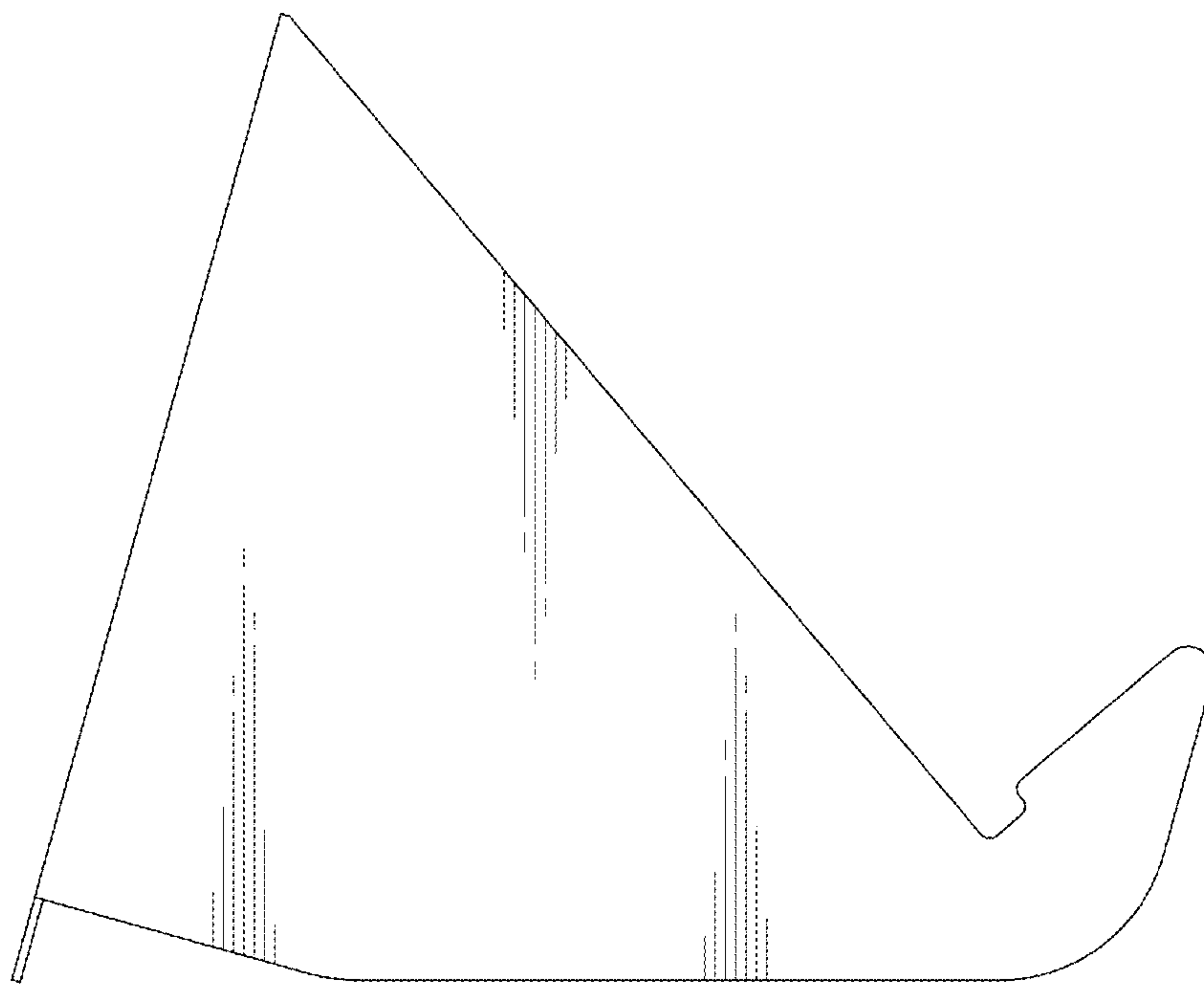
