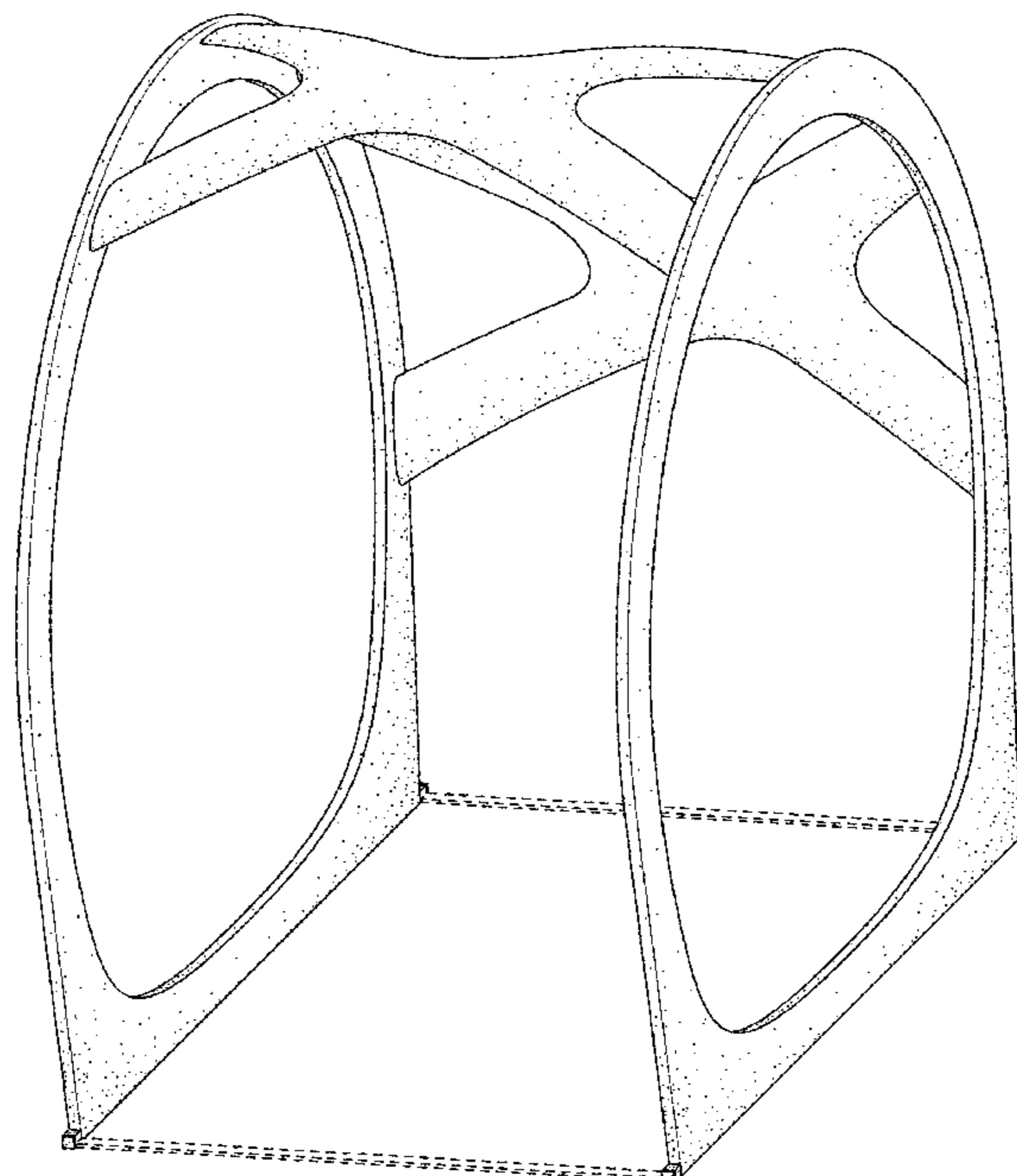
(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for an electromagnetic field apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and side perspective view of an electromagnetic field apparatus showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top, rear and side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof; the right side elevation view is a mirror image of the left side elevation view; and, FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof. The broken lines shown represent unclaimed subject matter and form no part of the claimed design.

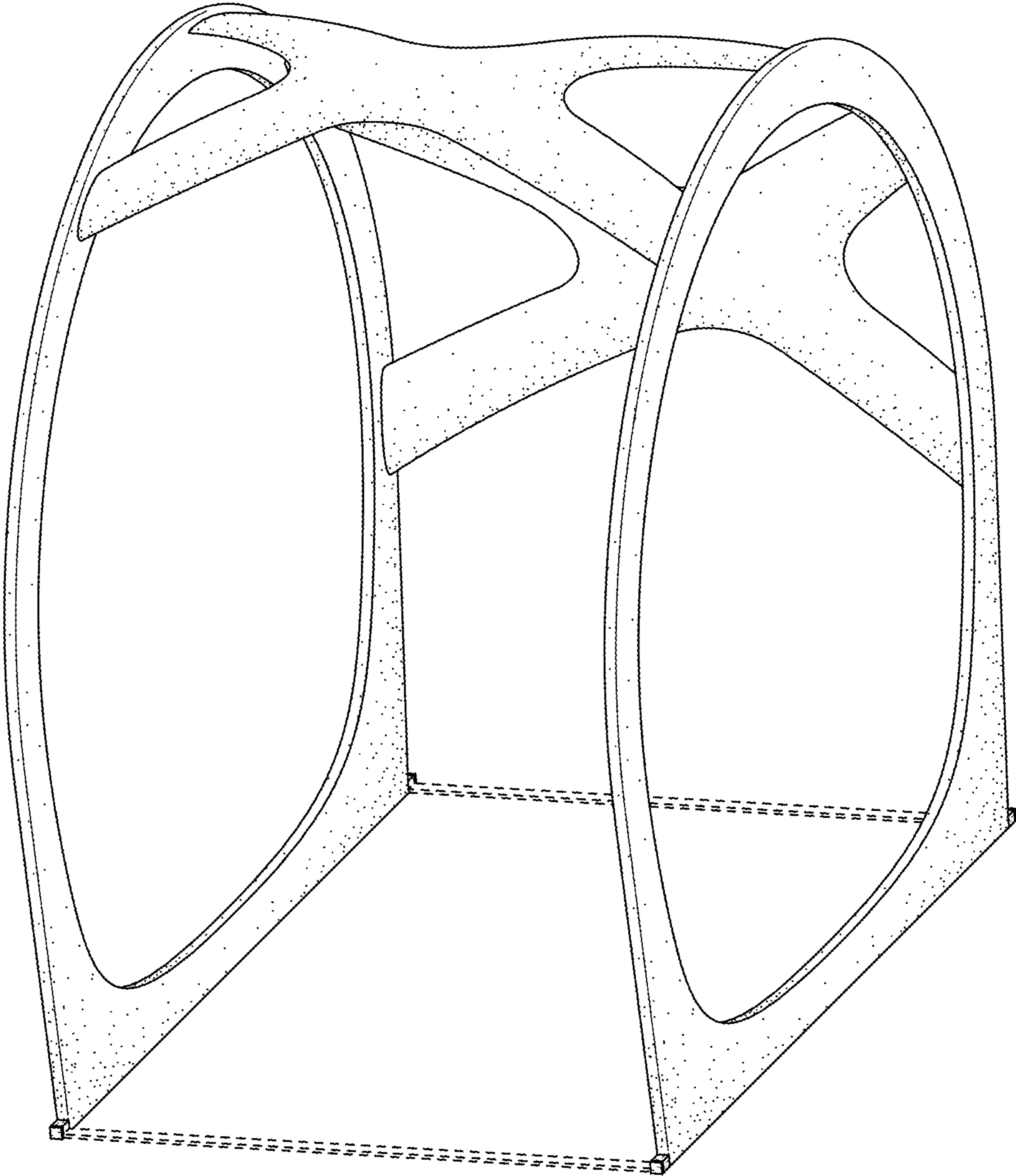

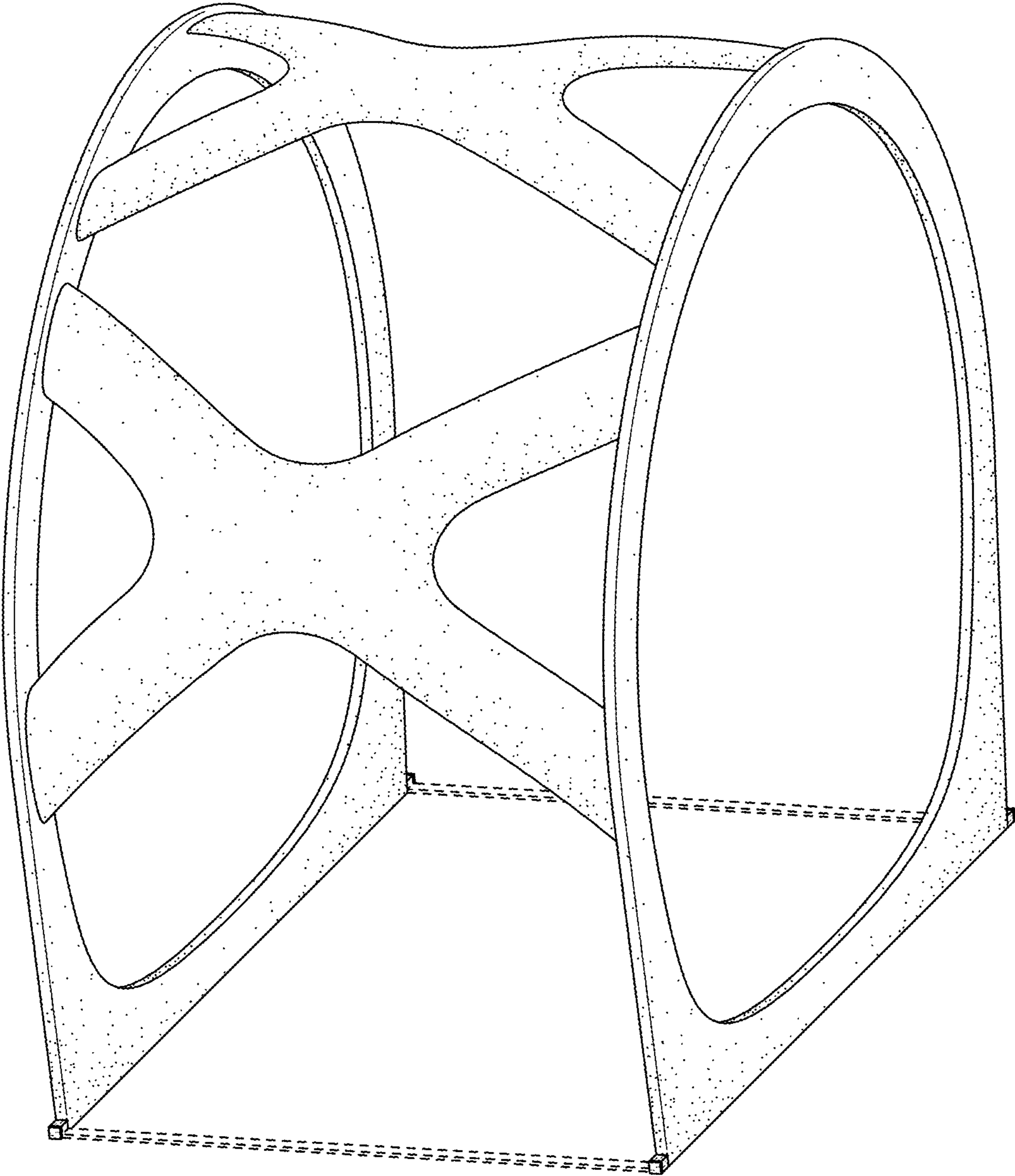

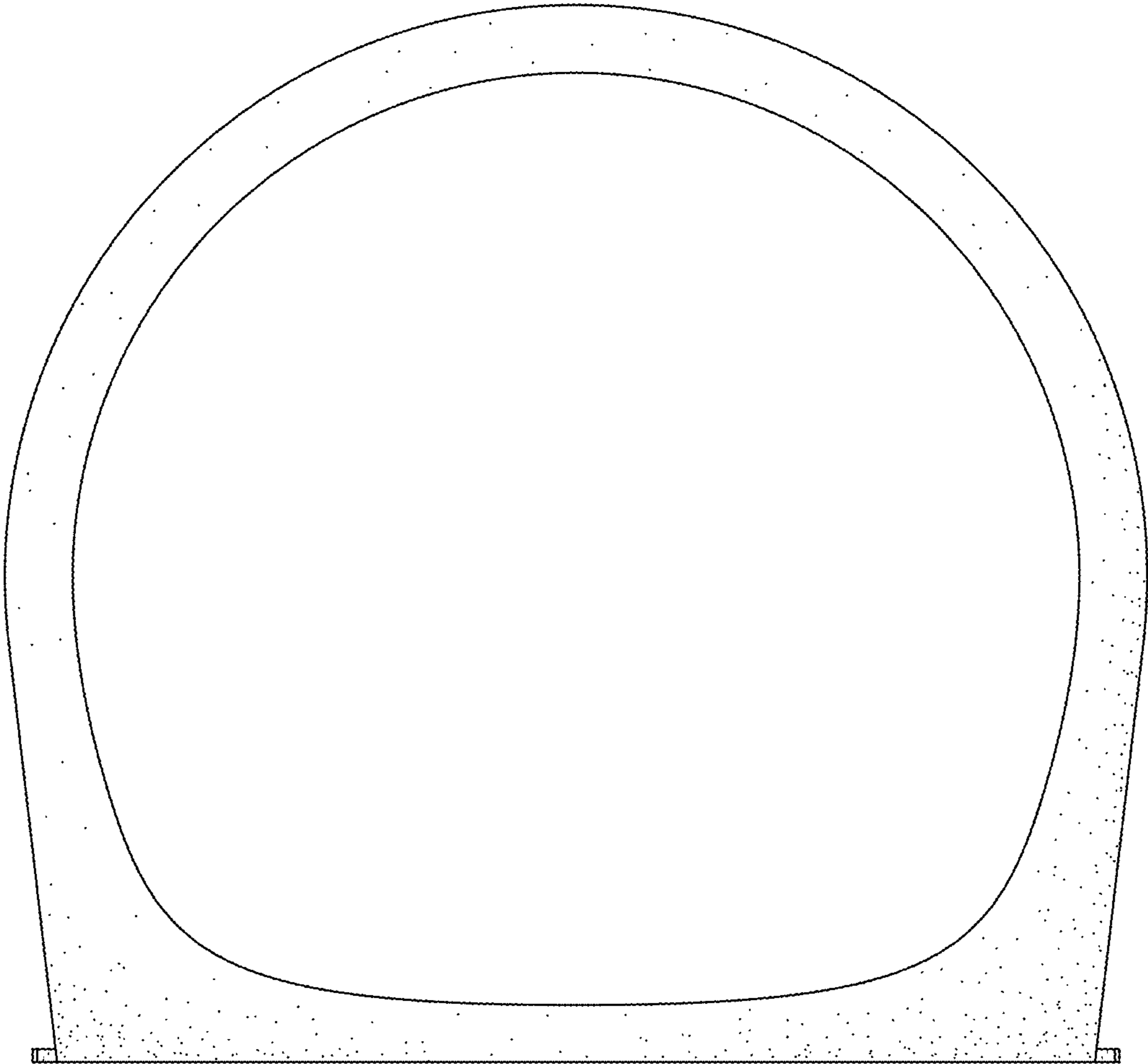

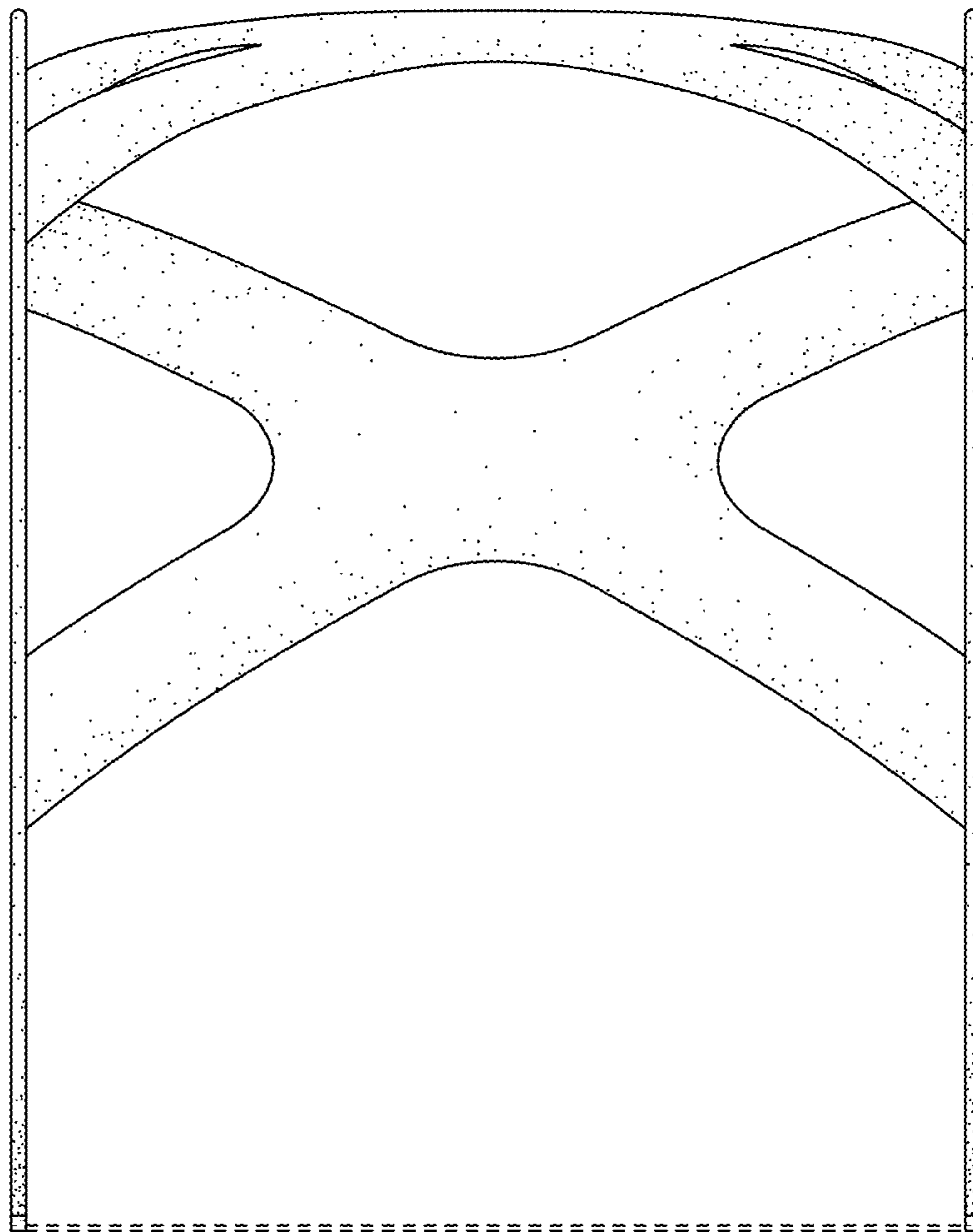
