DESCRIPTION

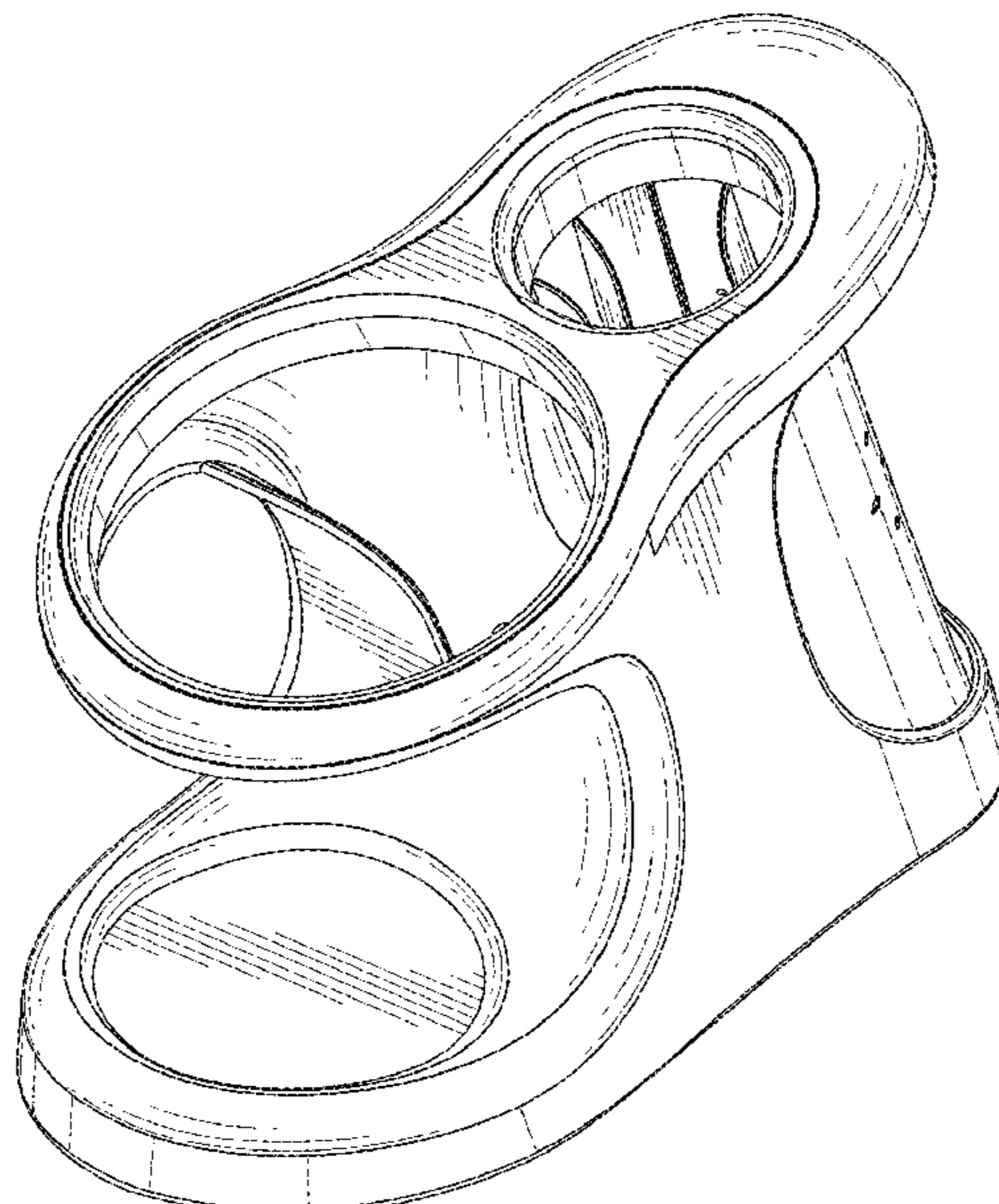

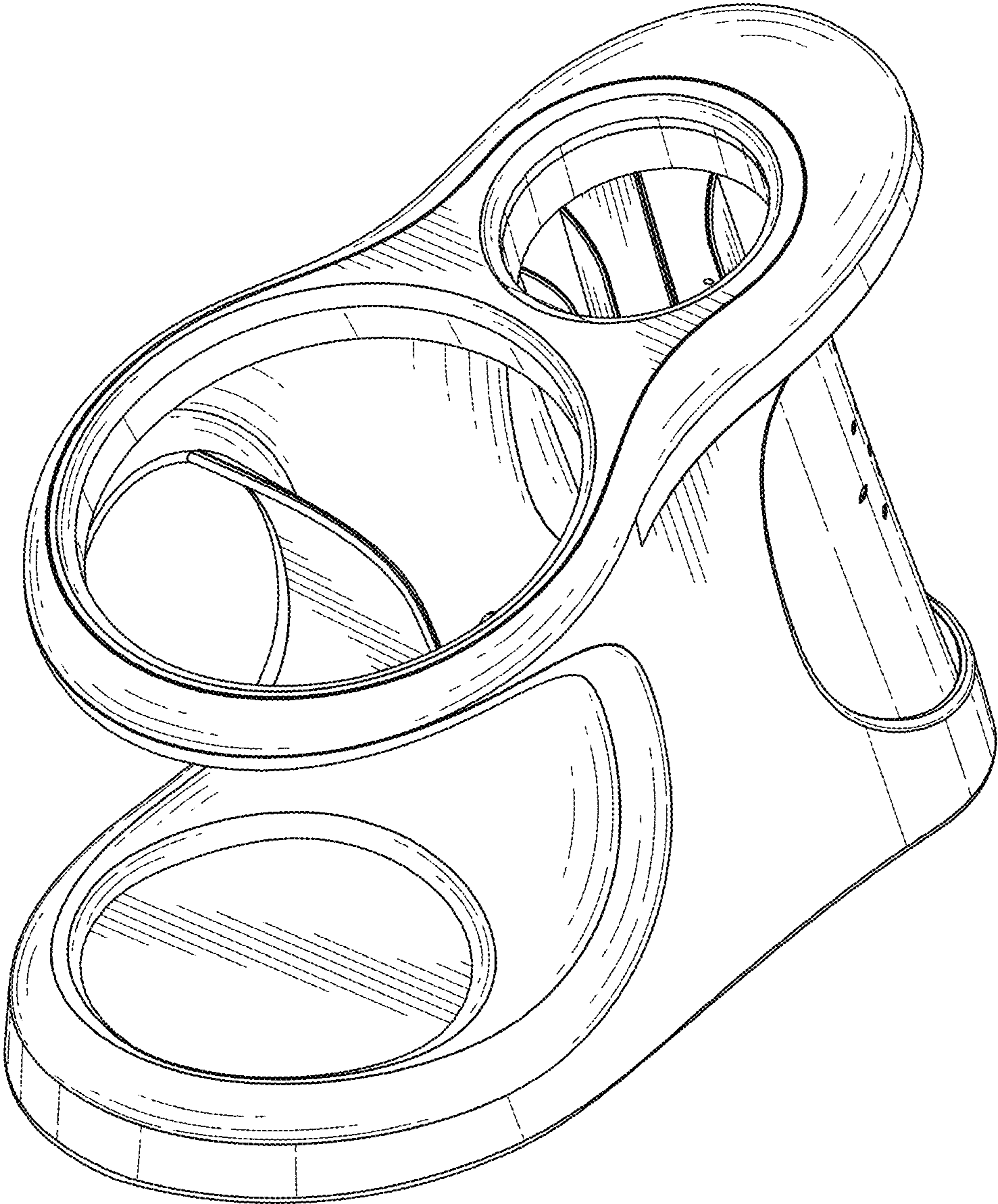

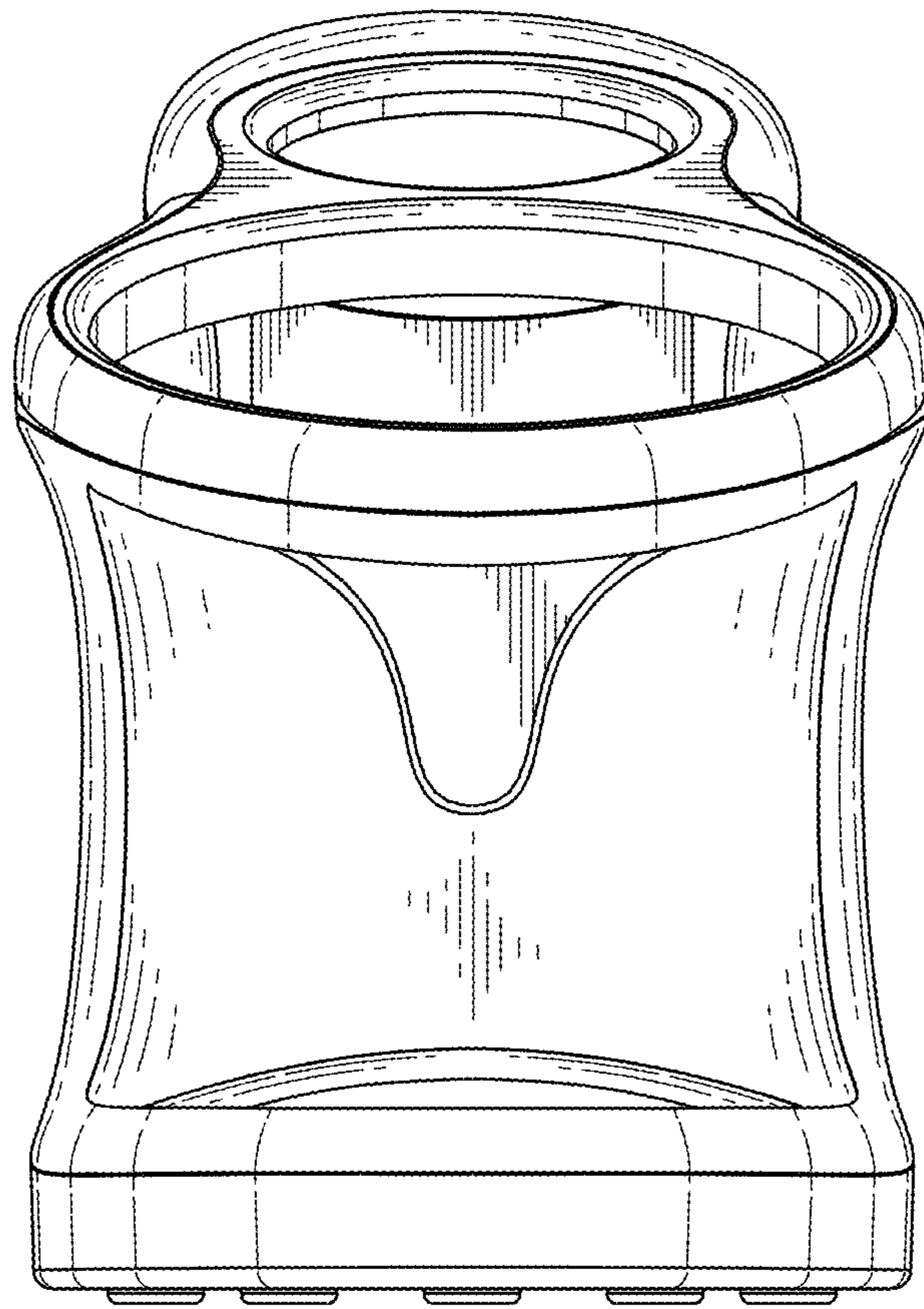

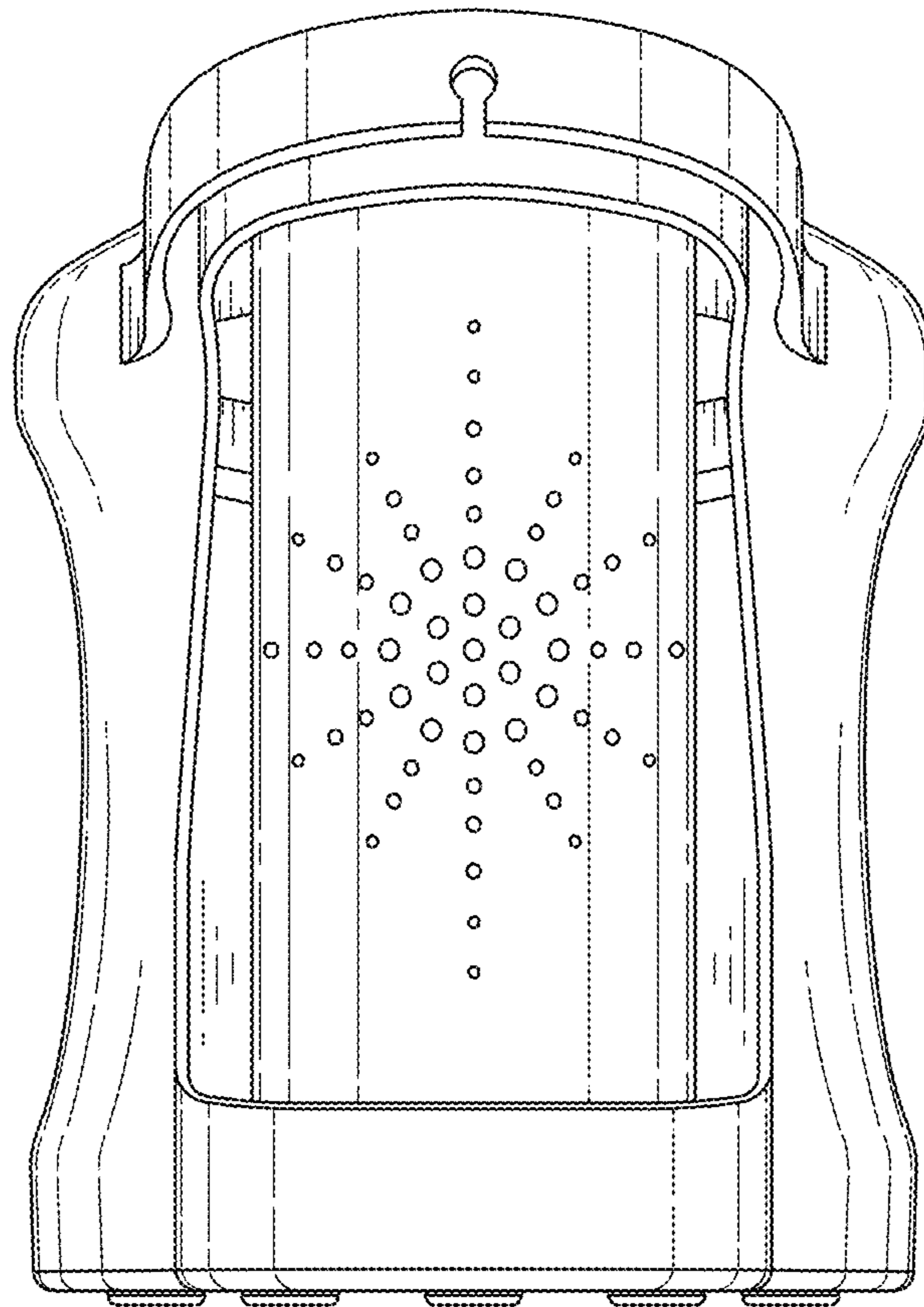

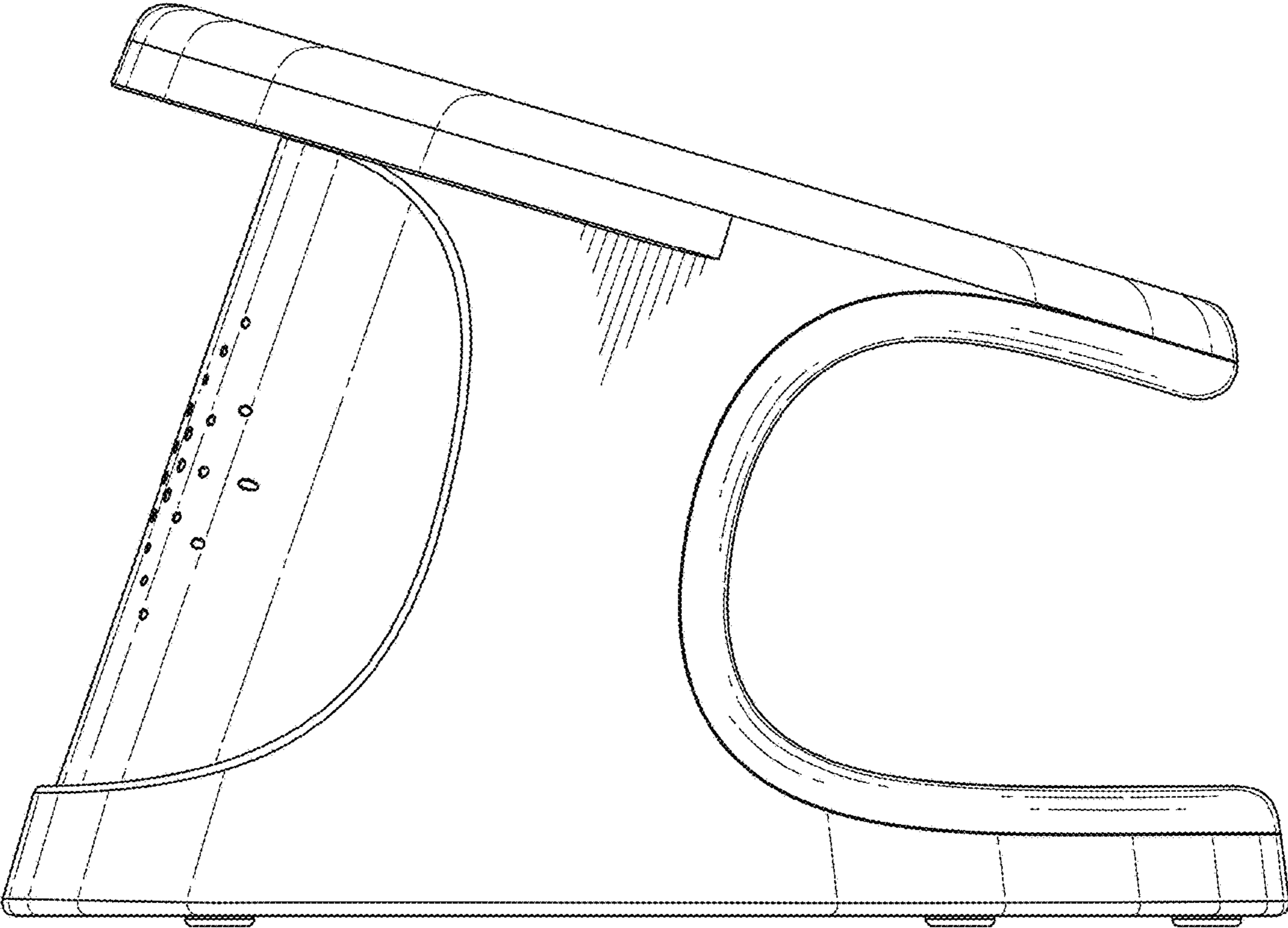

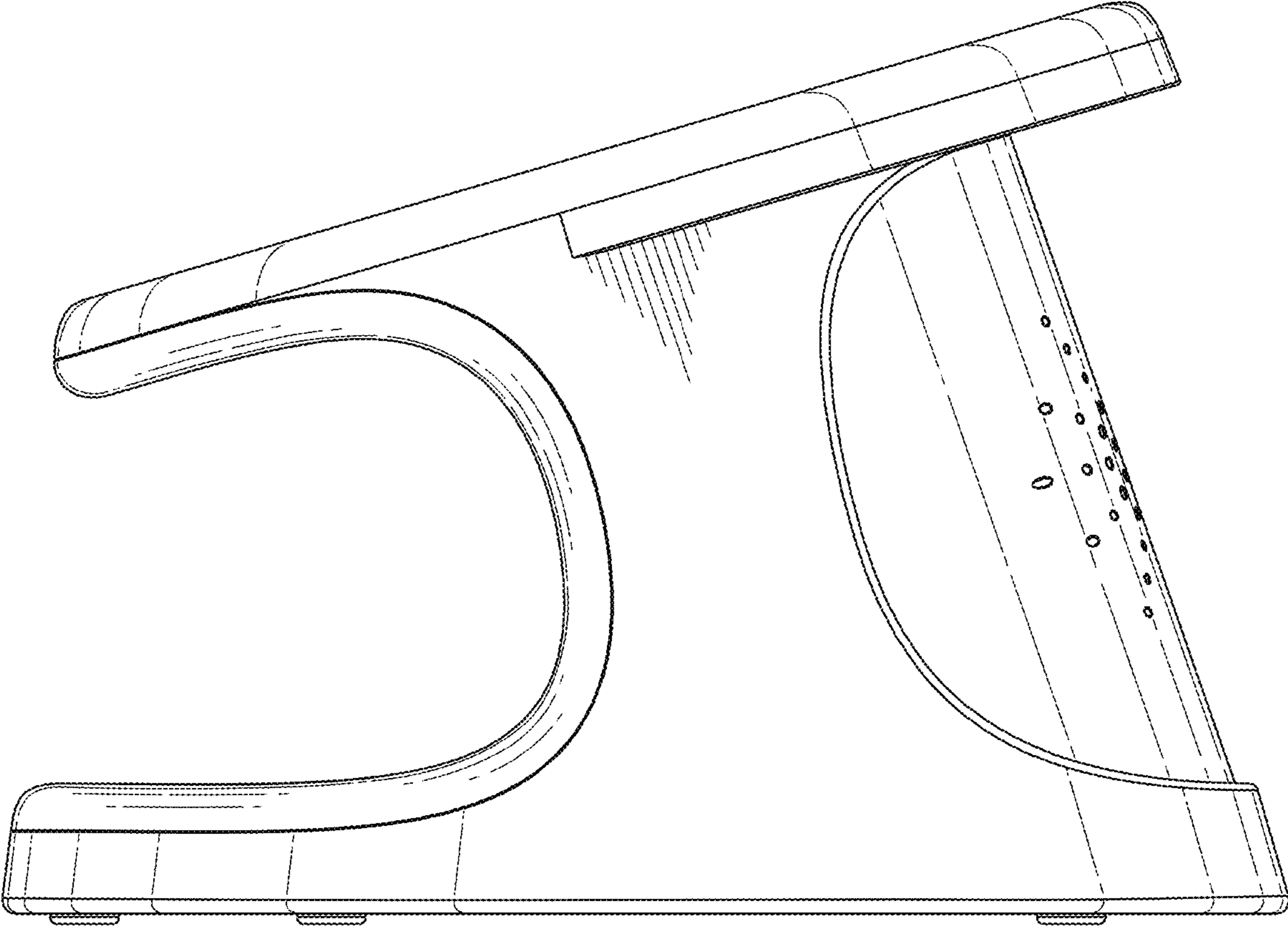

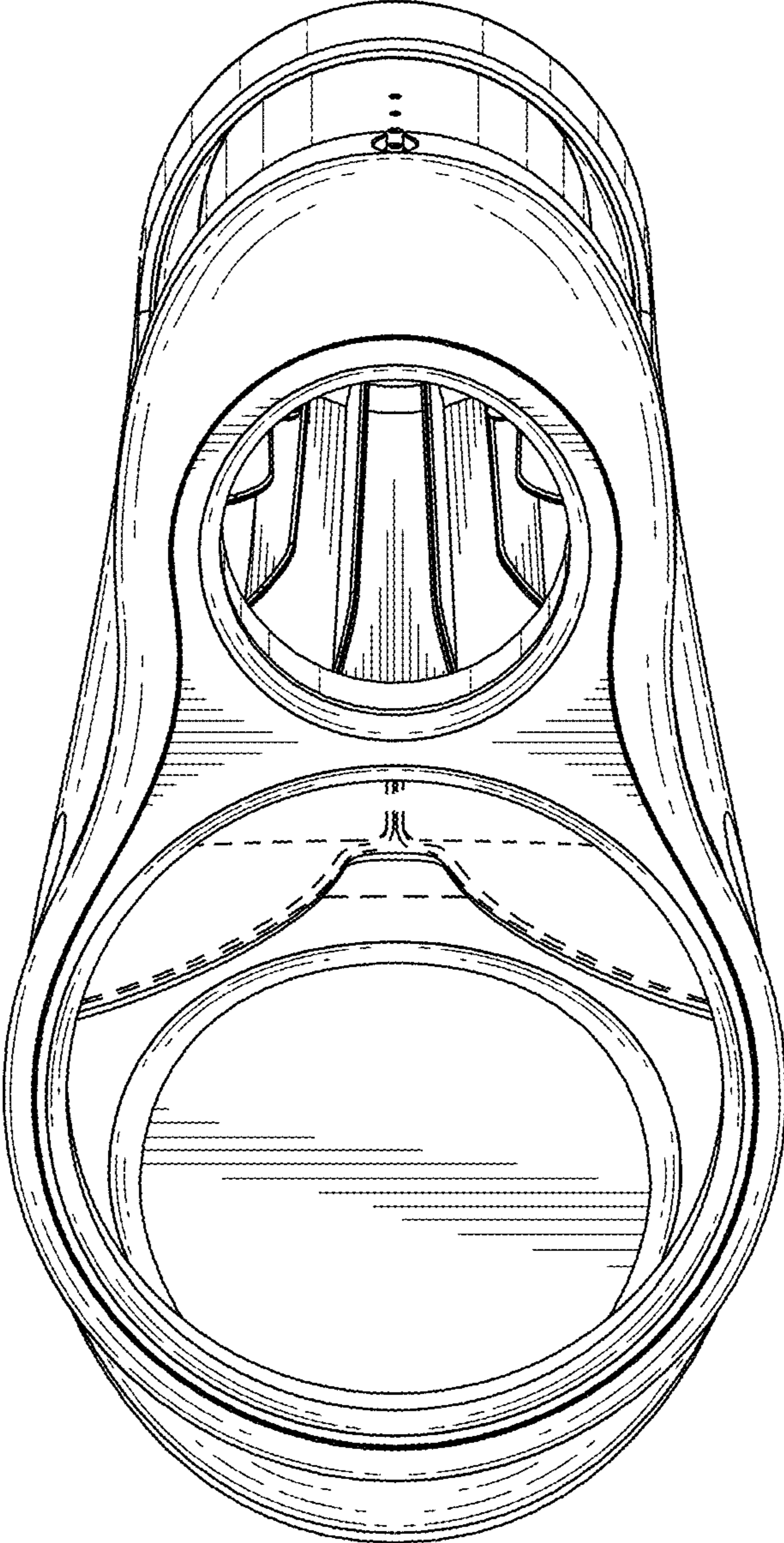

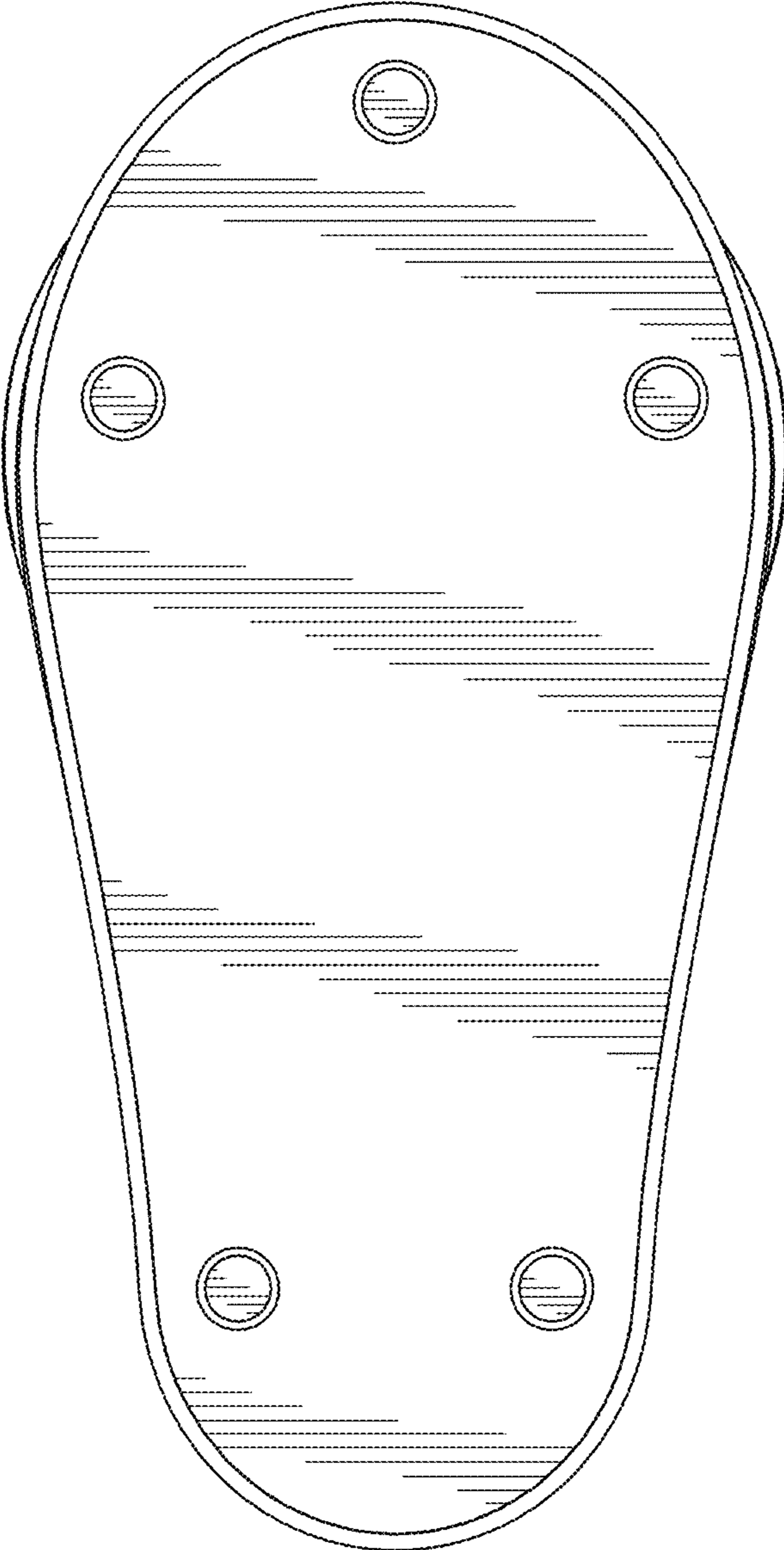
