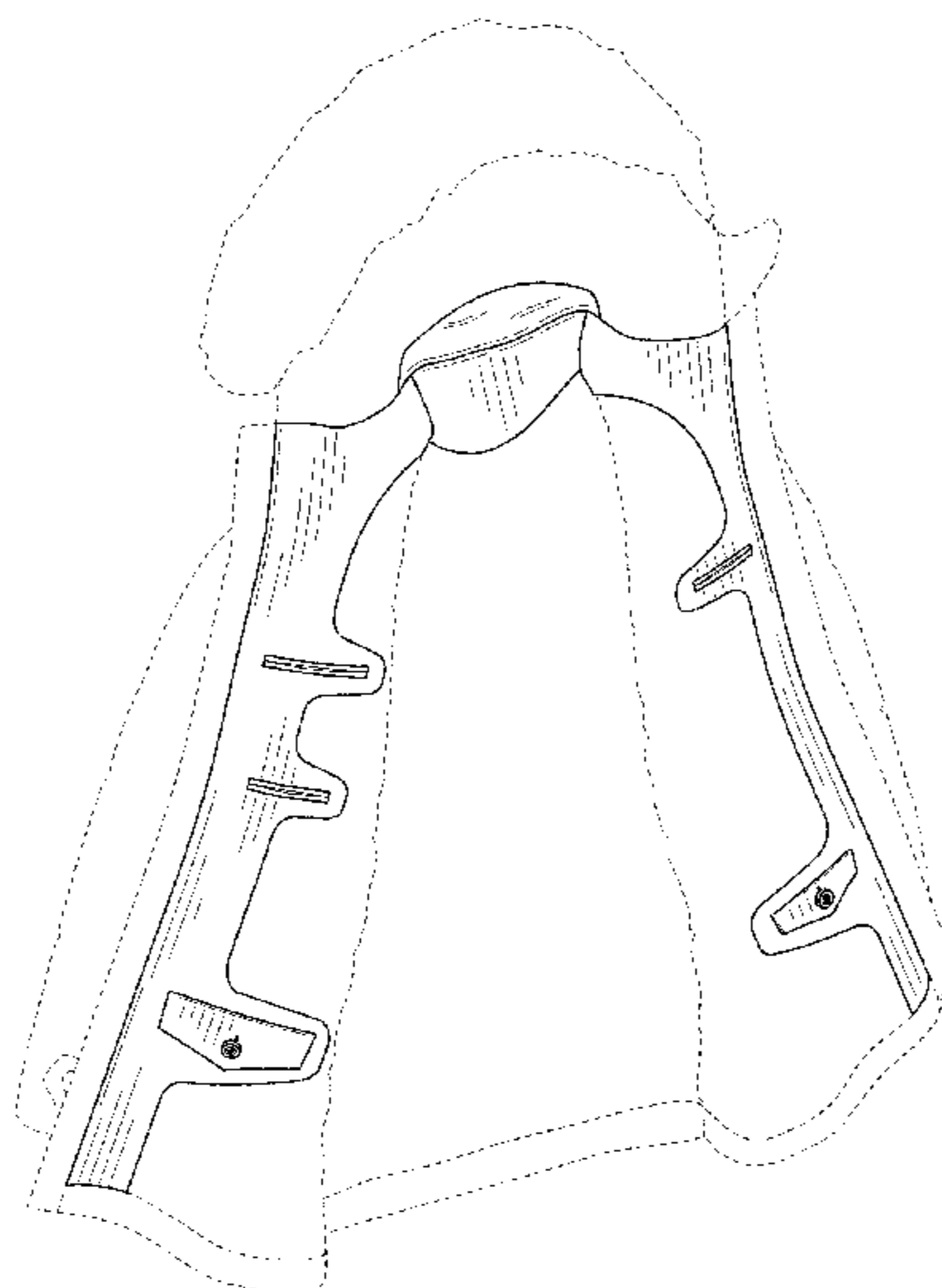

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the parka of the invention.
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the parka of the invention.
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of the parka of the invention.
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the parka of the invention.
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the parka of the invention; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the parka of the invention. The broken line showing of a parka is for the purpose of illustrating portions of the article and forms no part of the claim.

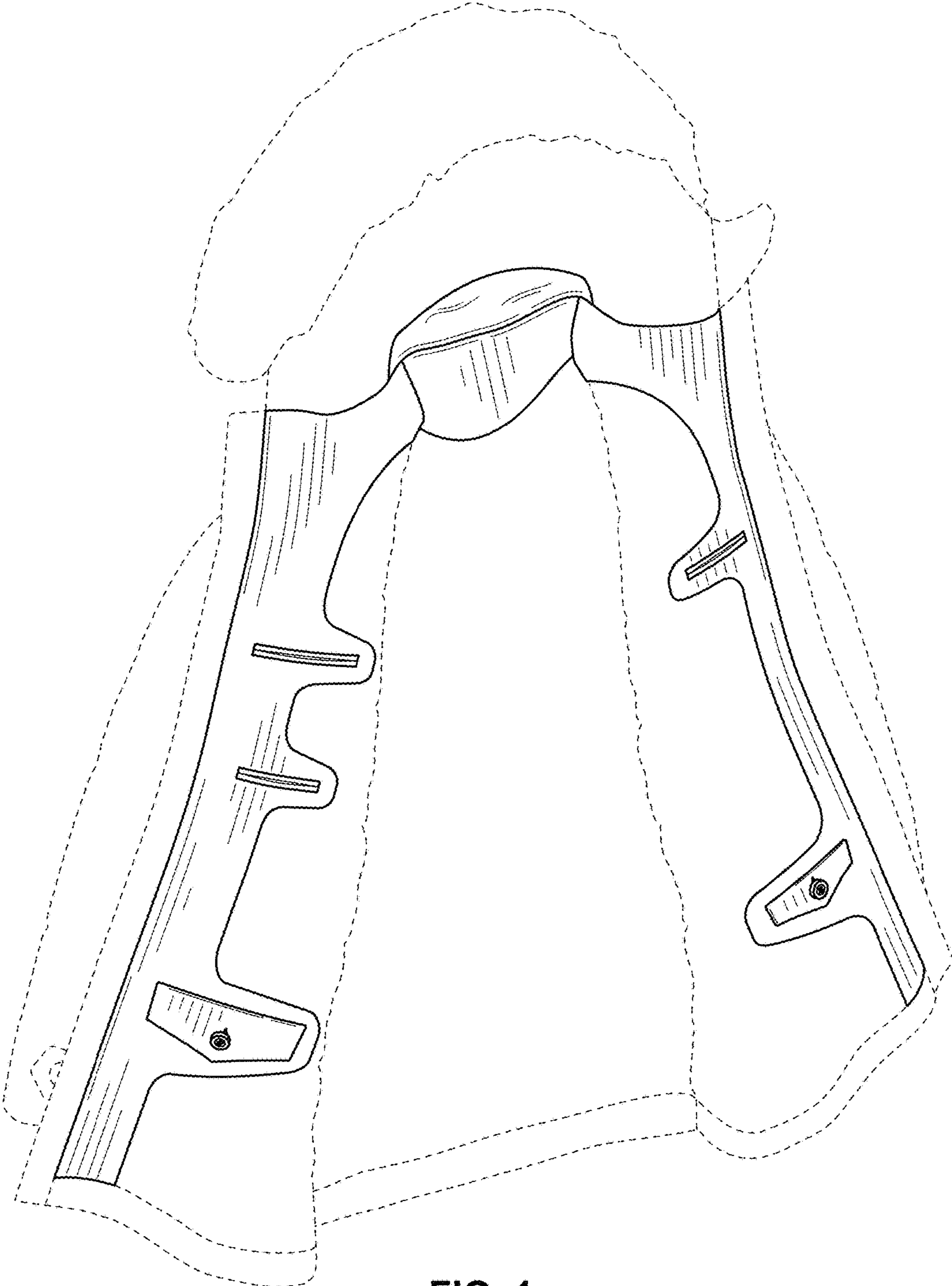

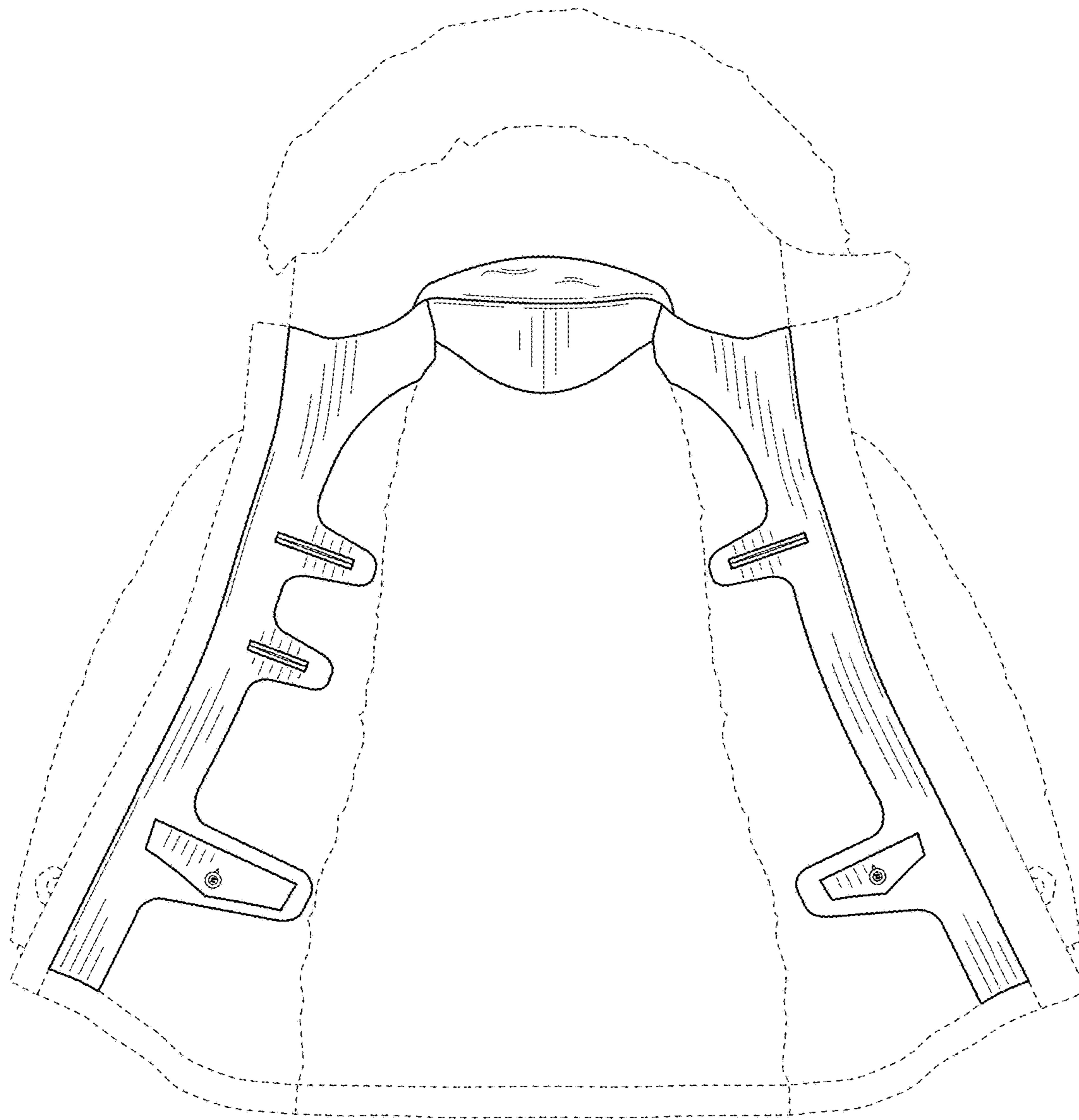

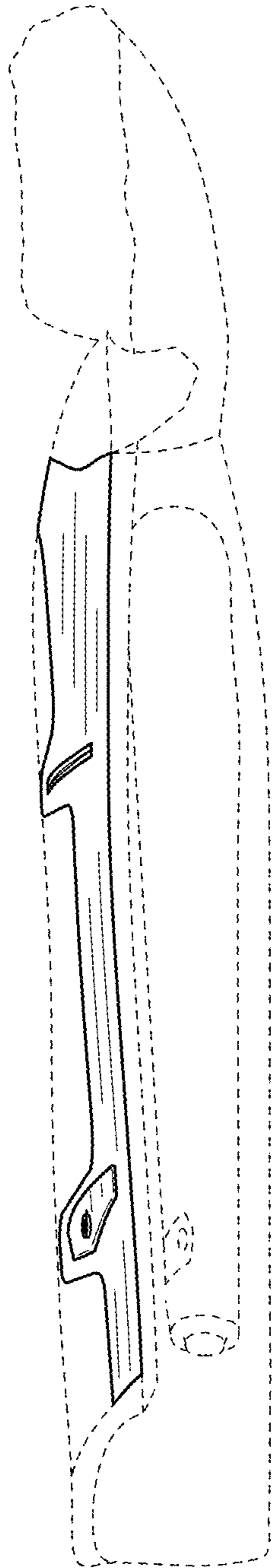

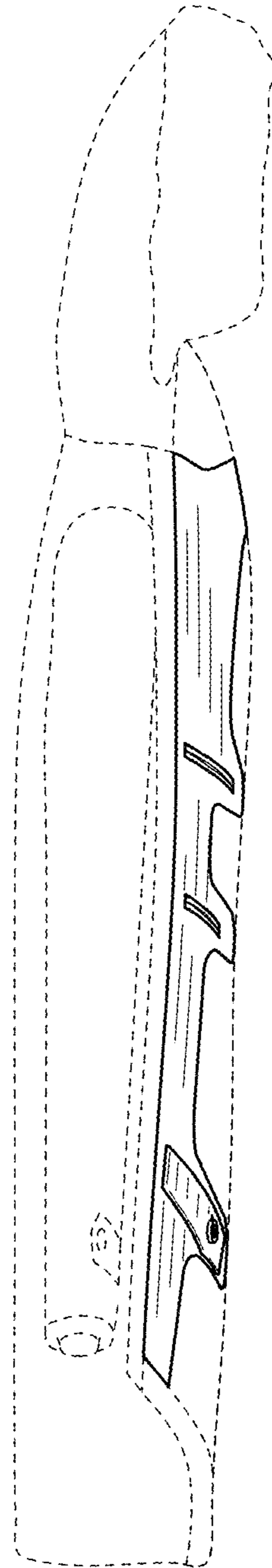

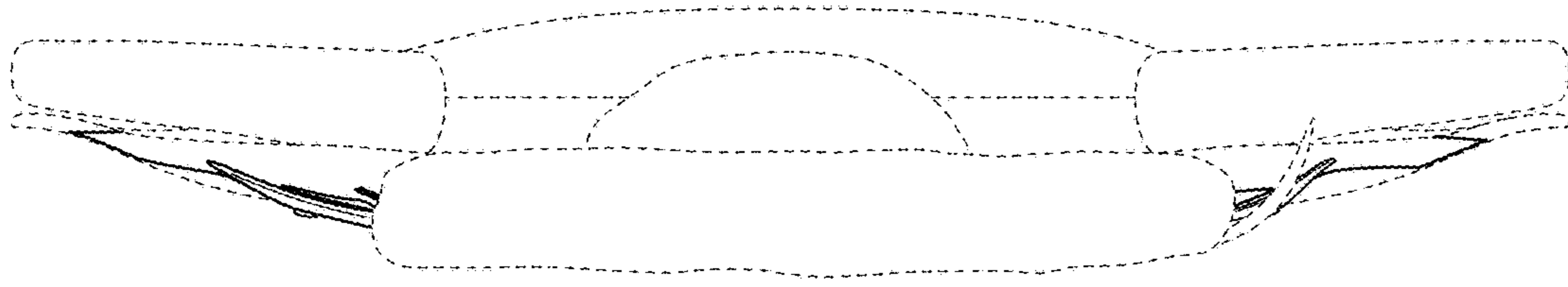

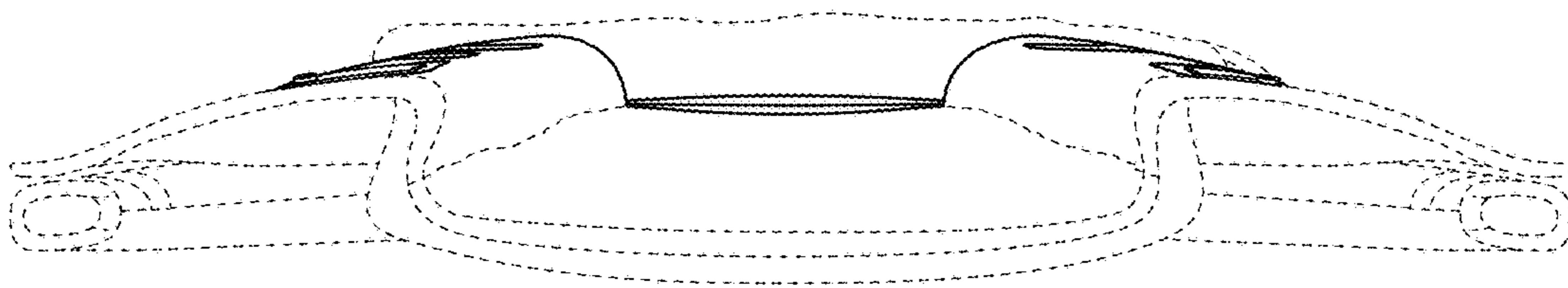
