The ornamental design for a handgun holster, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the handgun holster of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the handgun holster of the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the handgun holster of the present invention;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the handgun holster of the present invention;

FIG. 5 is a left side view of the handgun holster of the present invention;

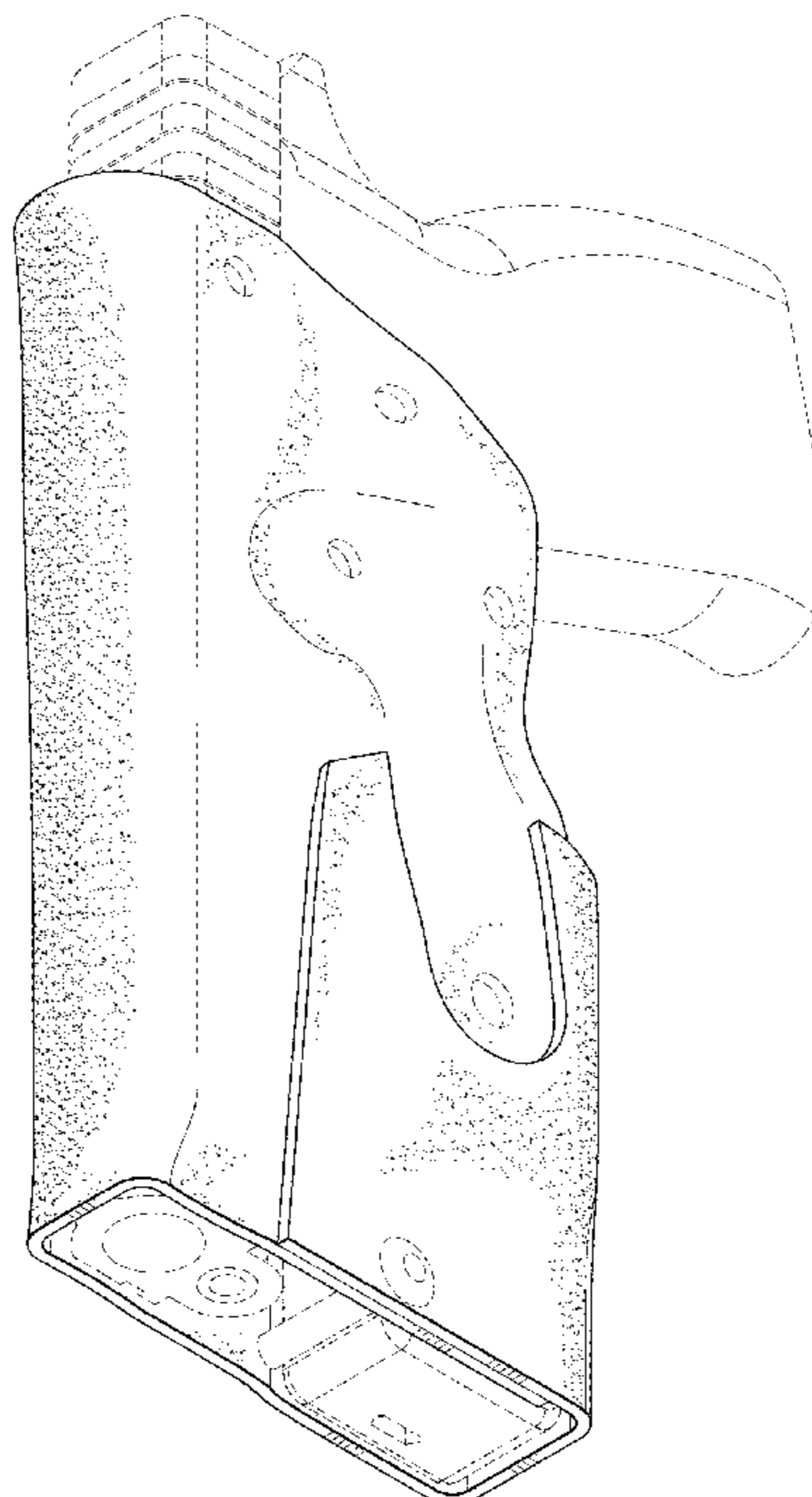
FIG. 6 is a top view of the handgun holster of the present invention;

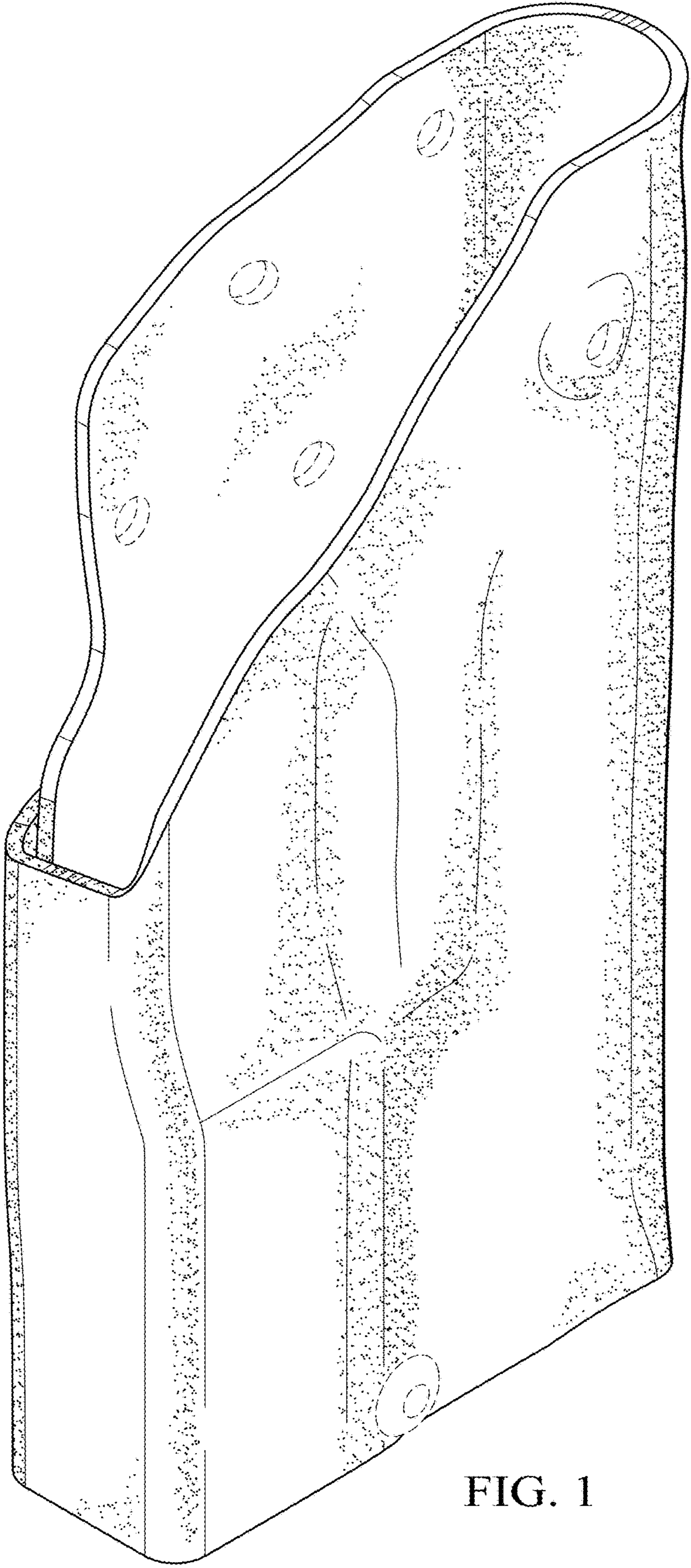

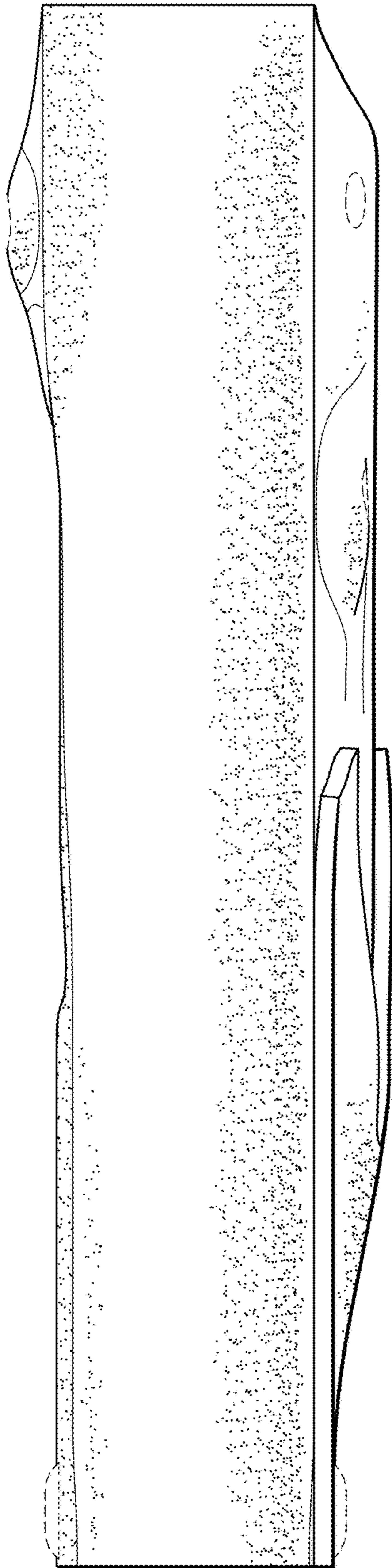

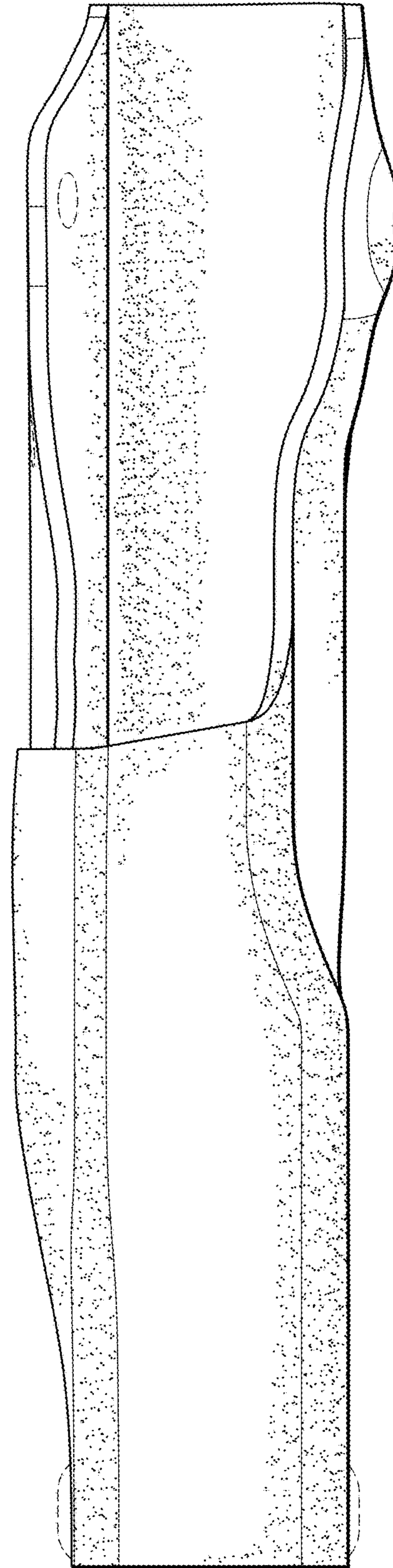

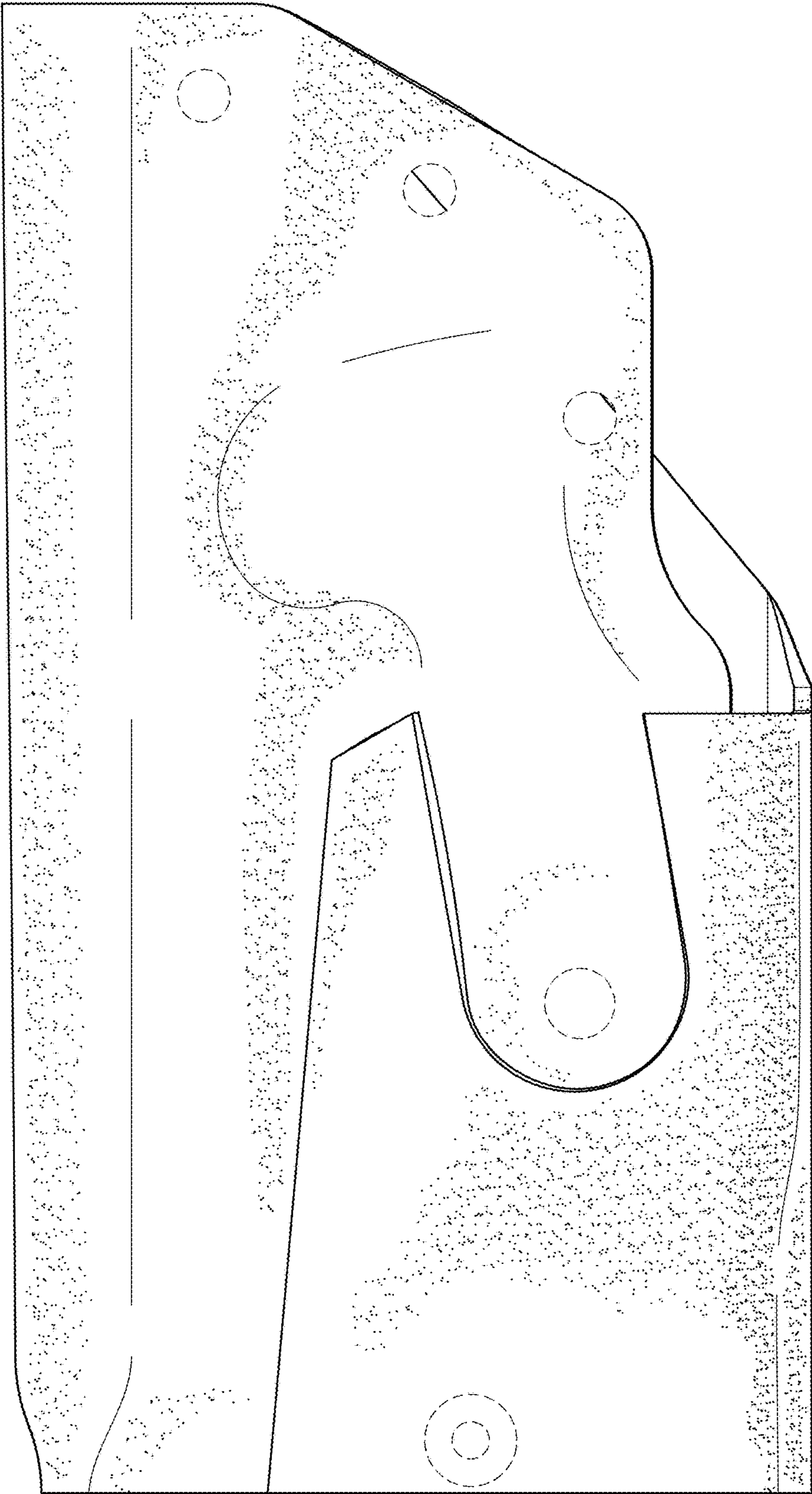

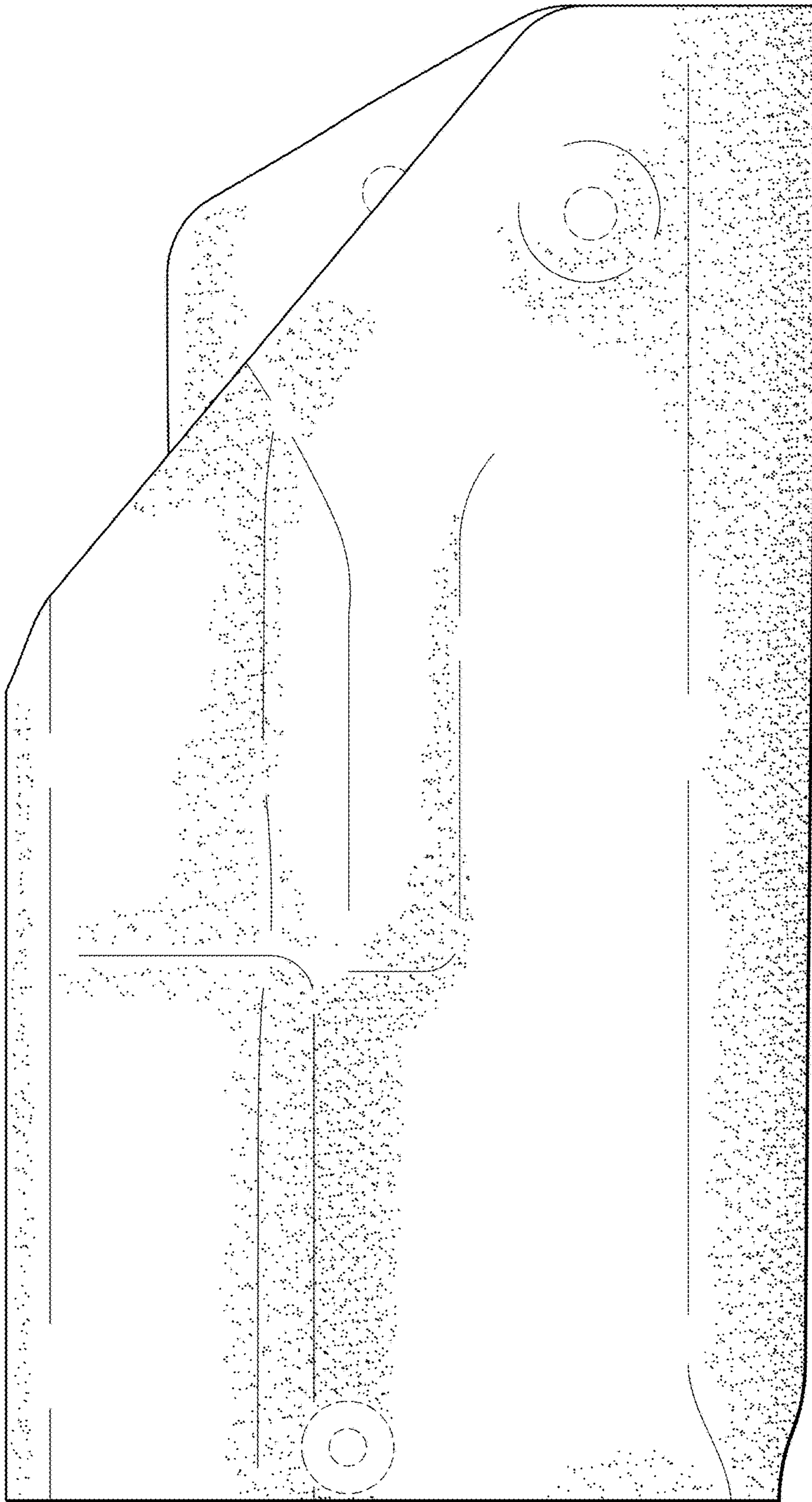

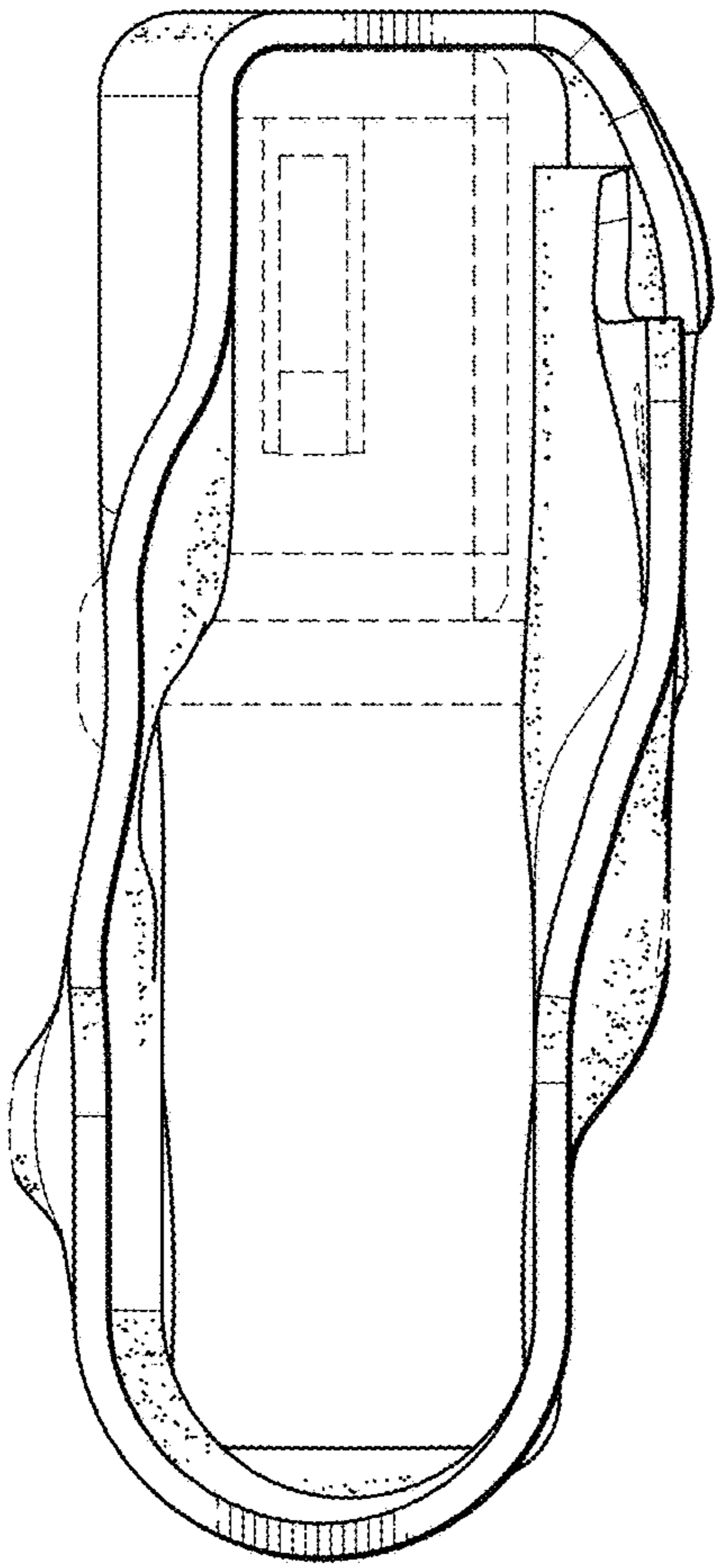

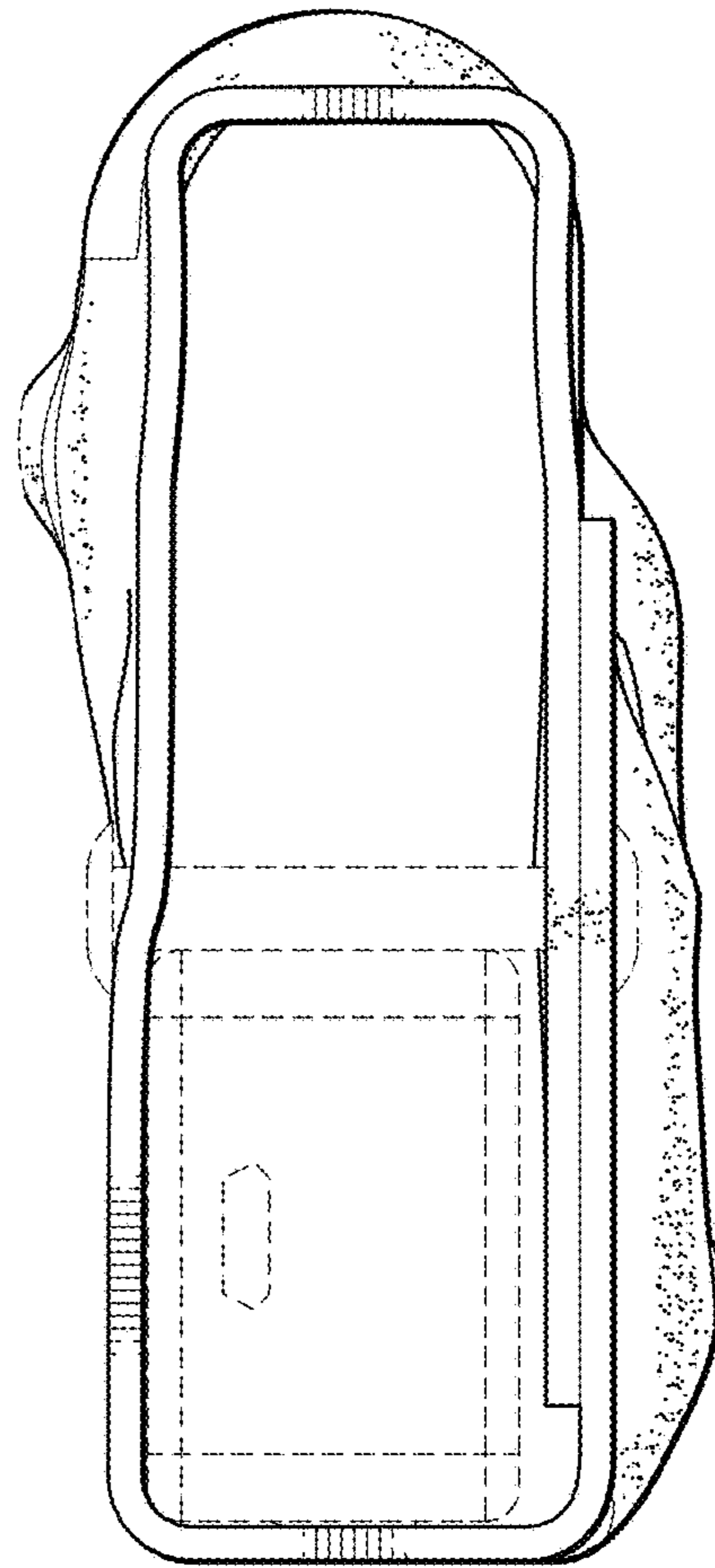

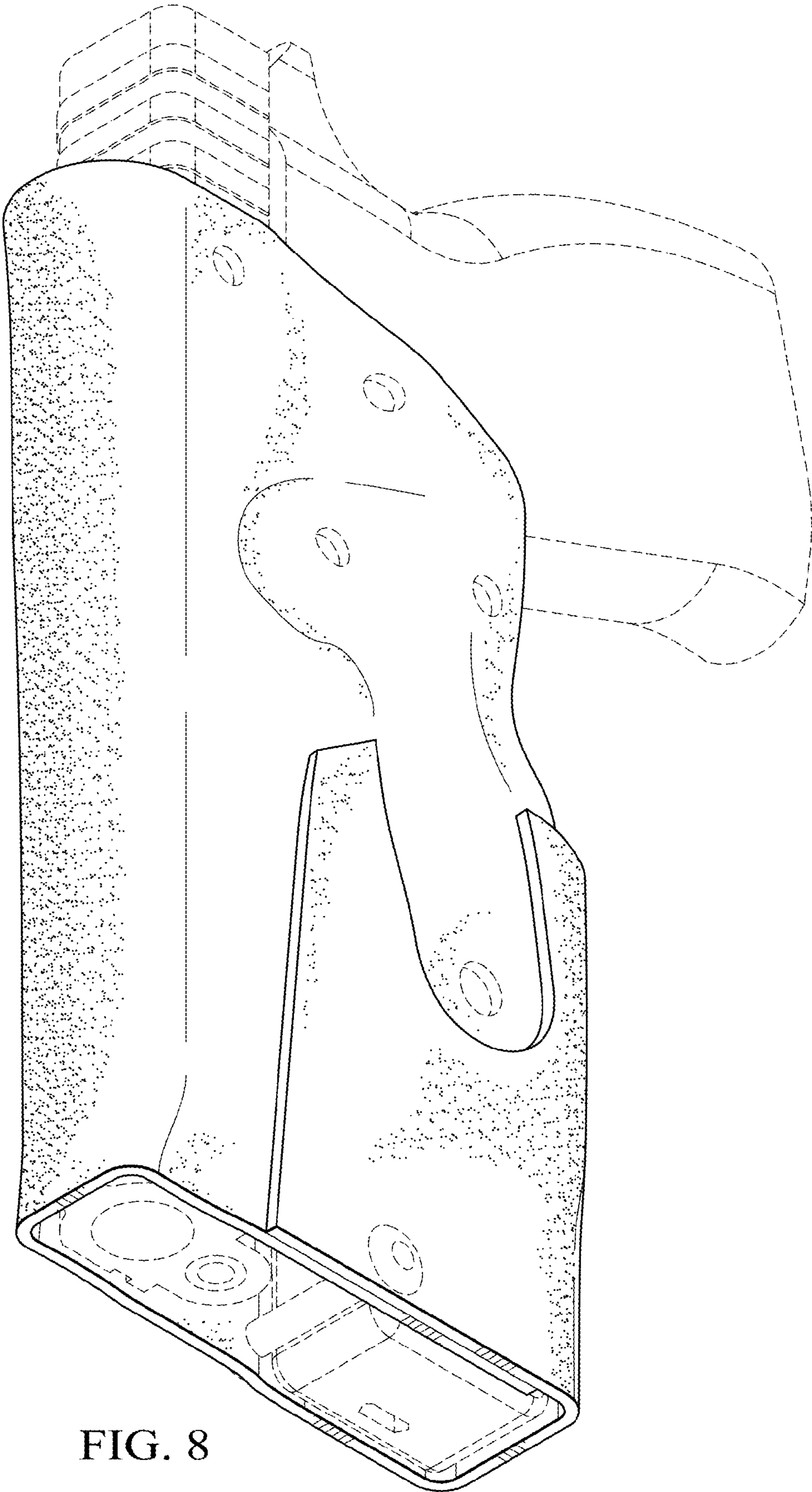
