FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a front end of a vehicle;

FIG. 2 is a left rear perspective view of the vehicle shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof.

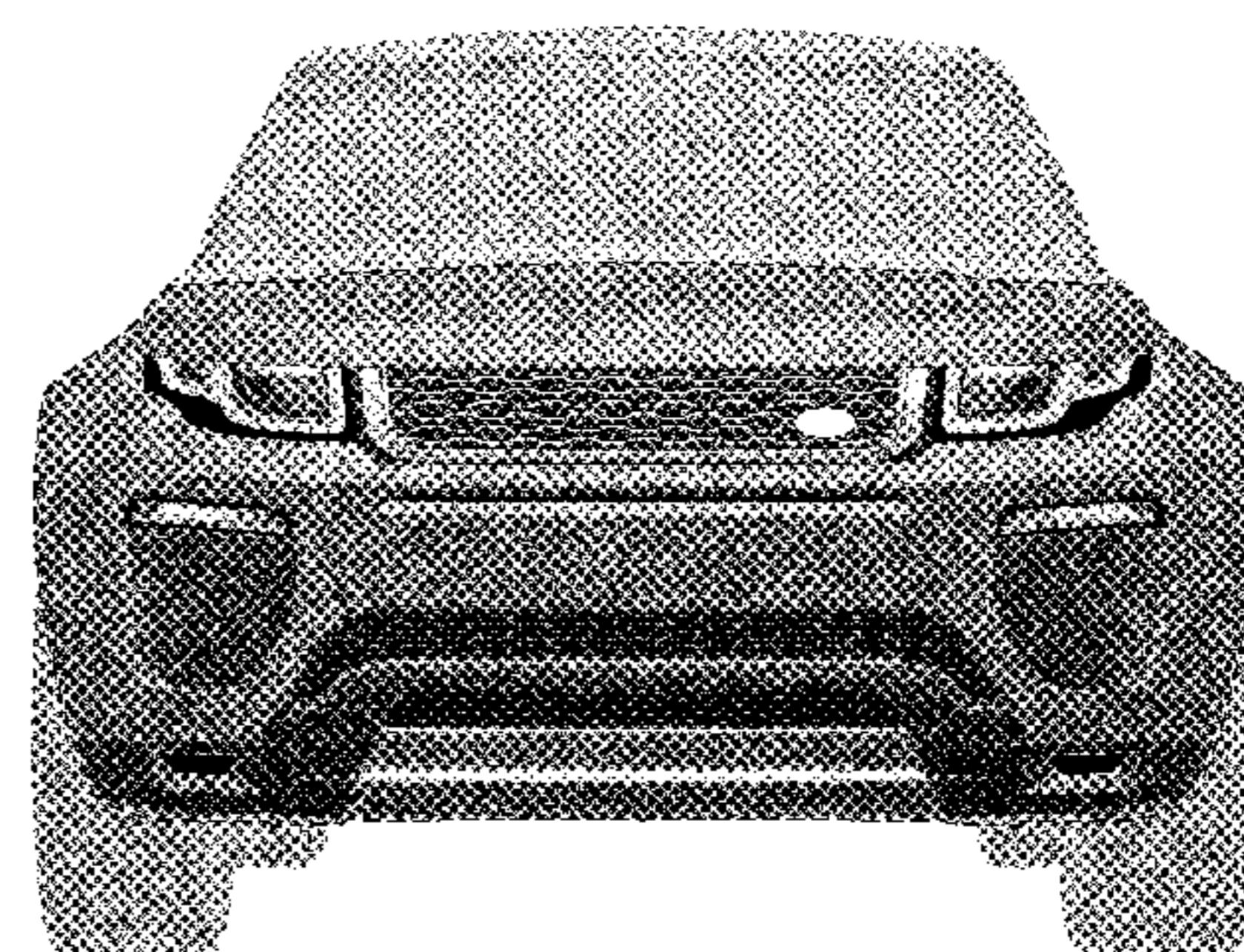
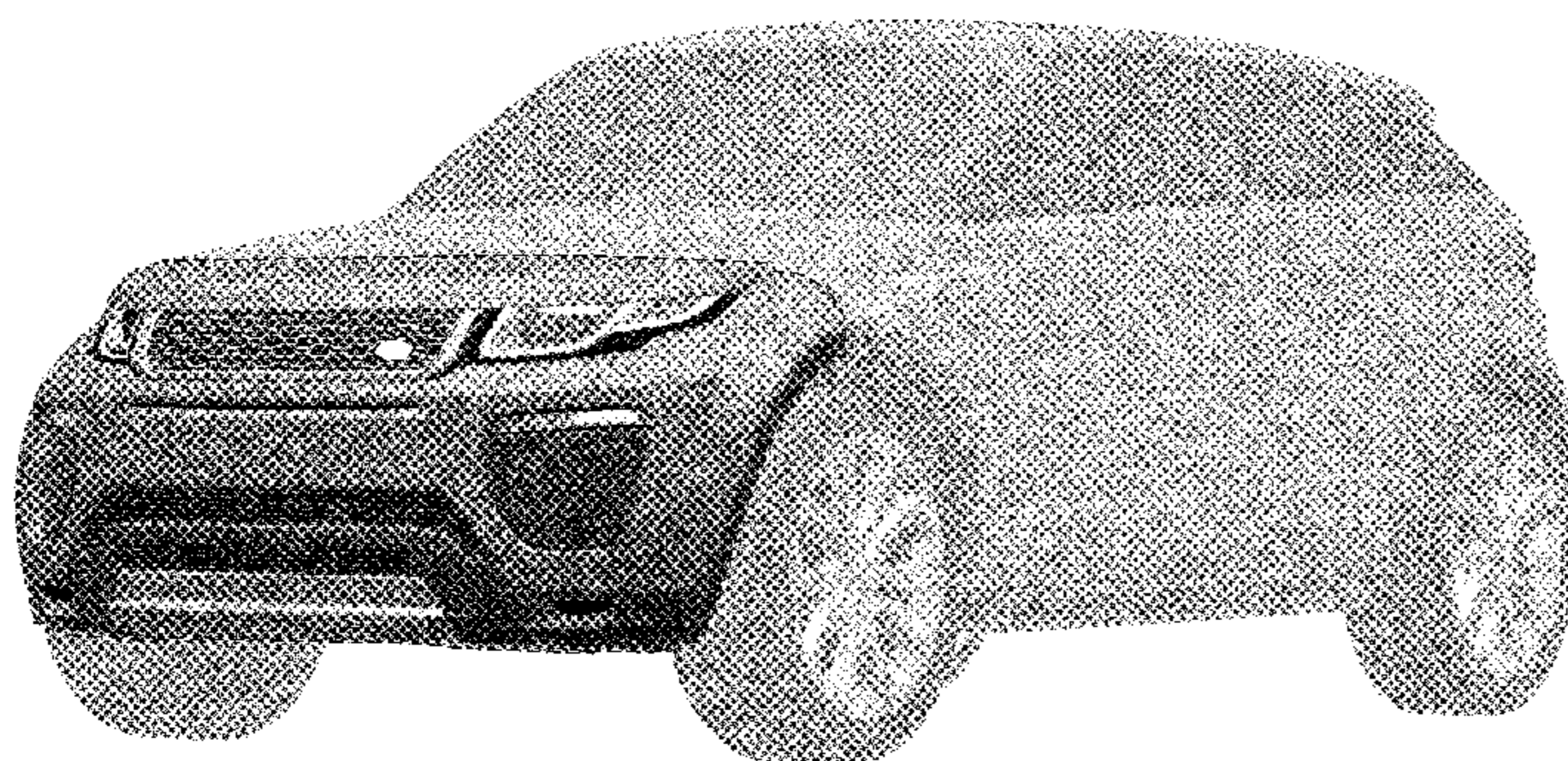
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof.

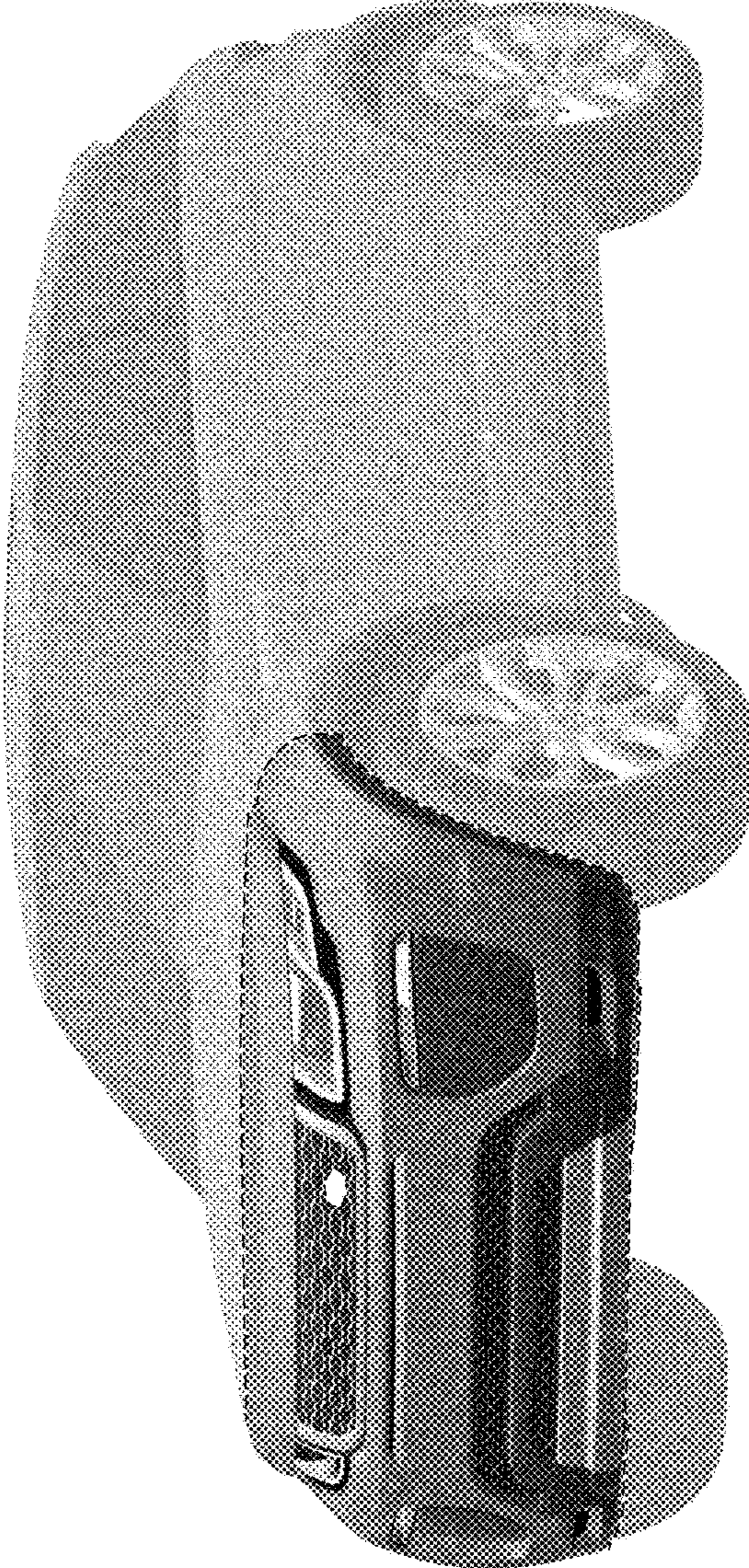

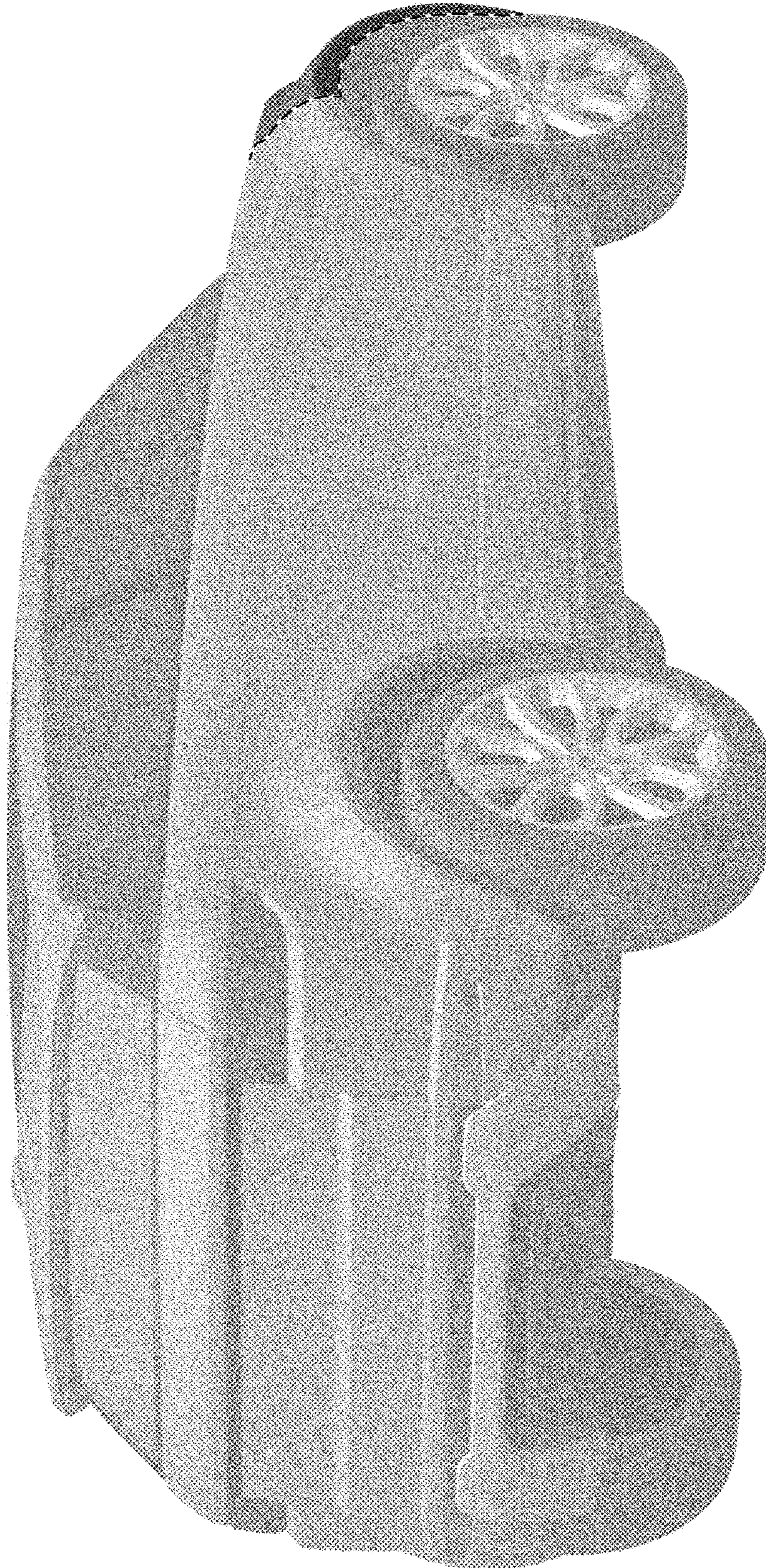

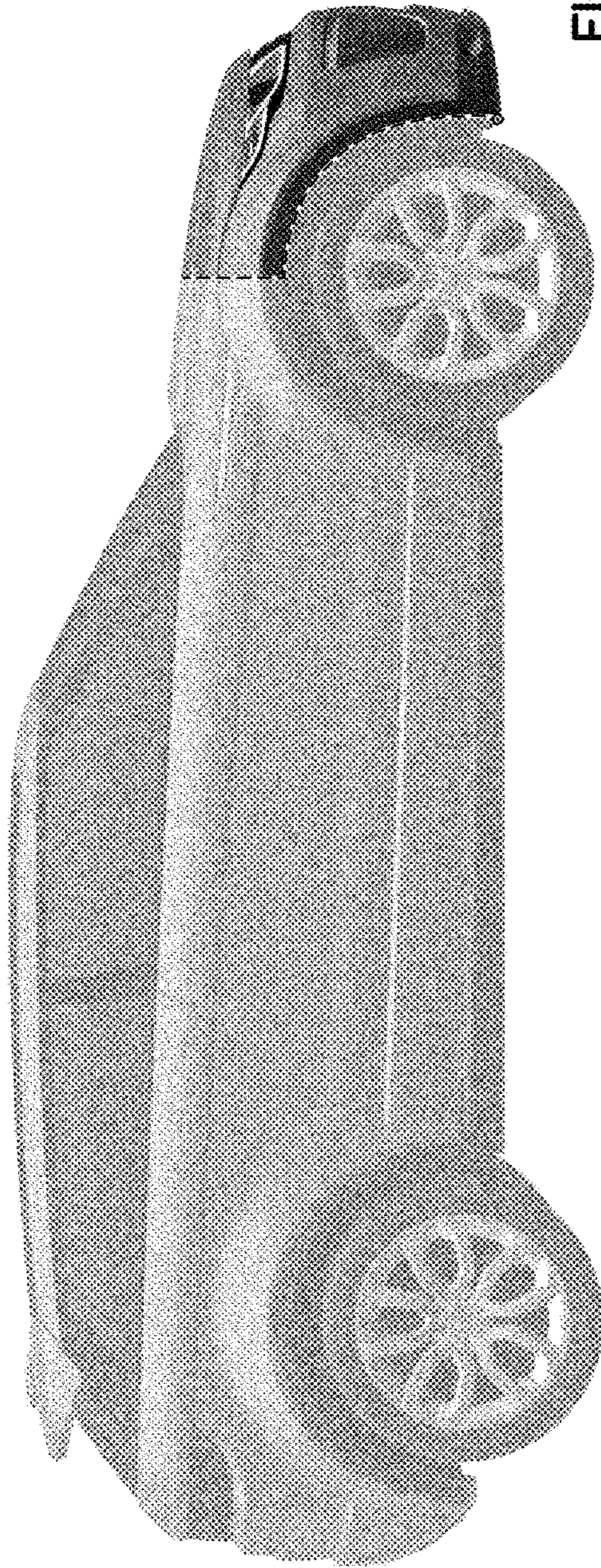

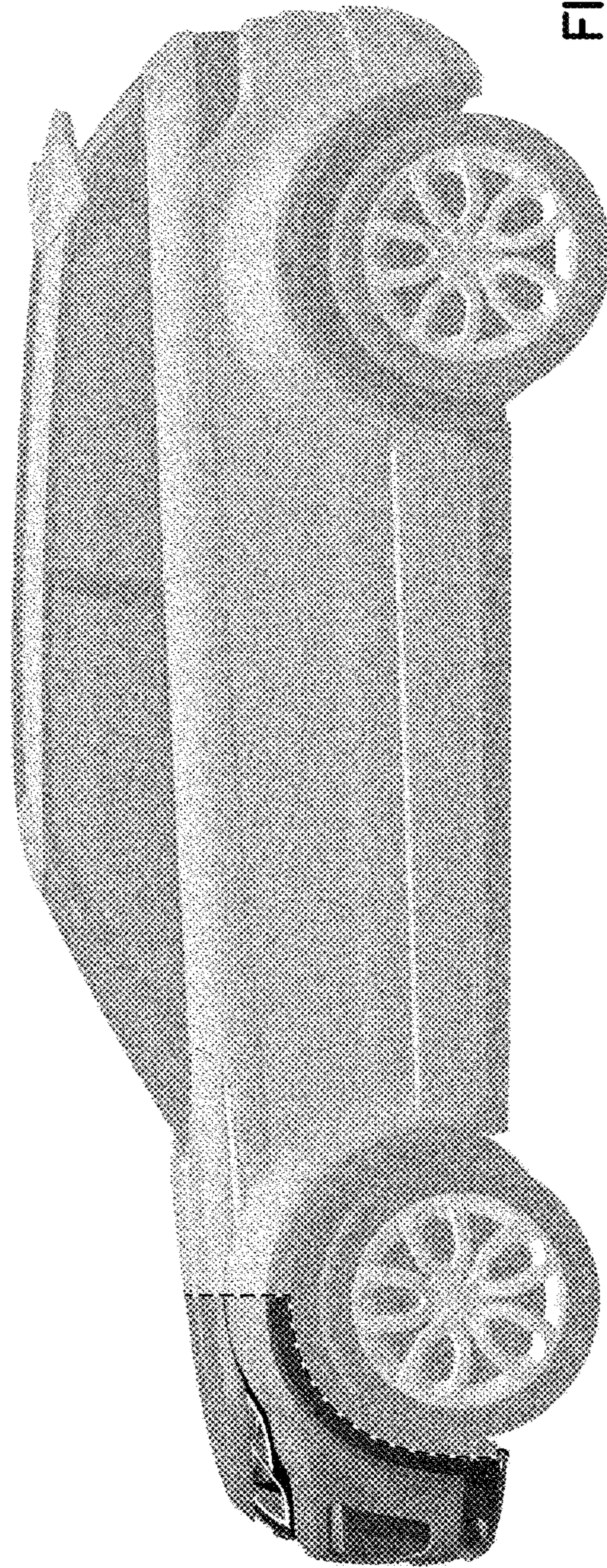

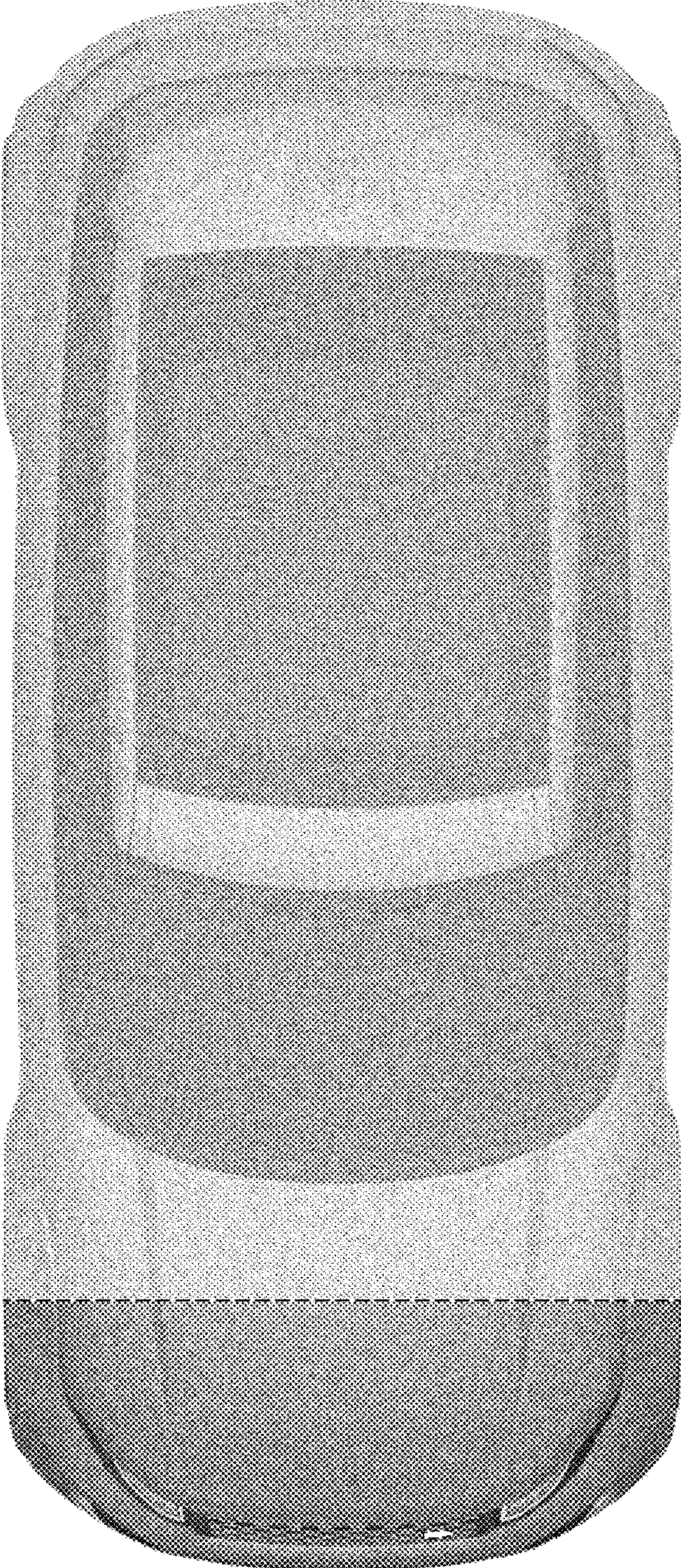
