The ornamental design for a lacrosse head, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a lacrosse head showing our new design;

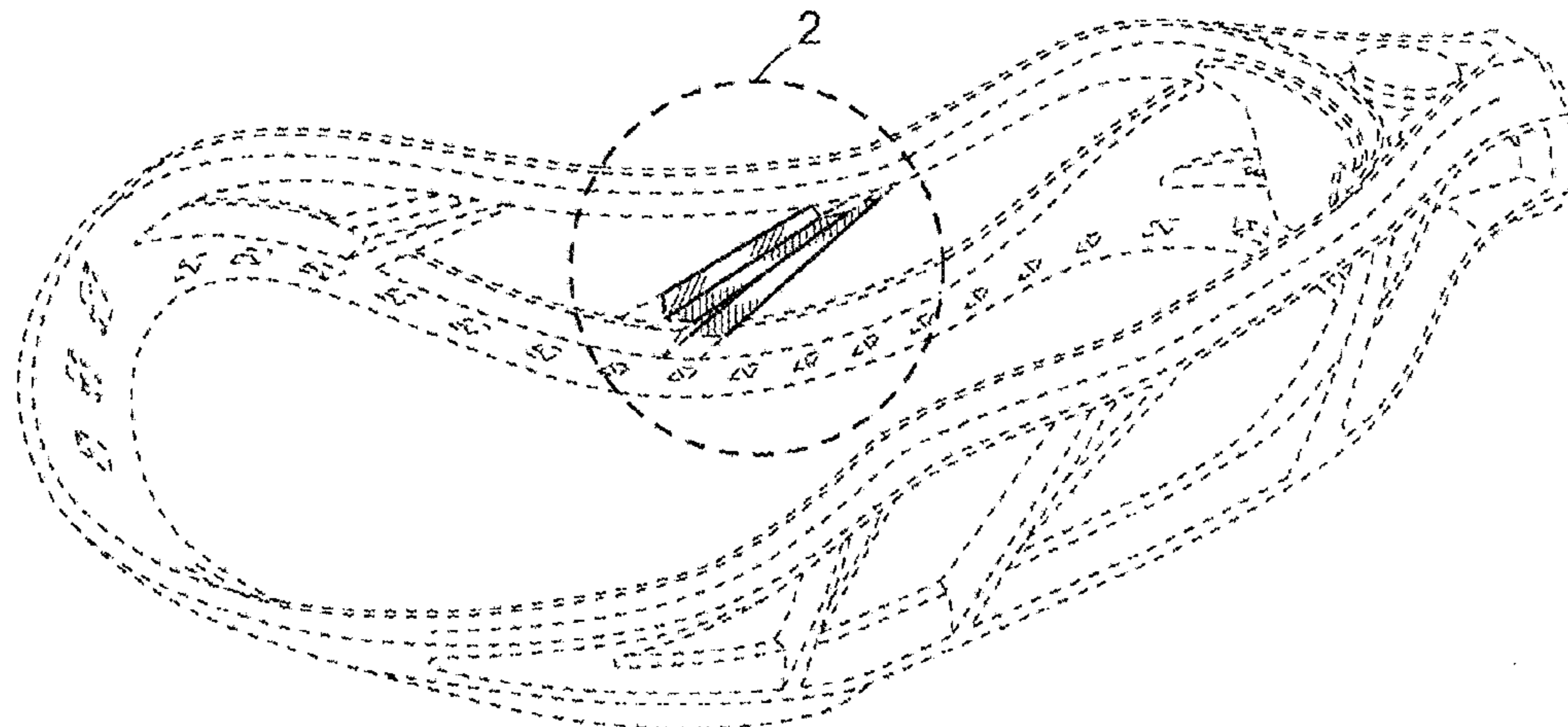
FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view of the portion shown with the circle area identified as 2 in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged, fragmentary, bottom, rear, left side perspective view of a portion of FIG. 1; and,

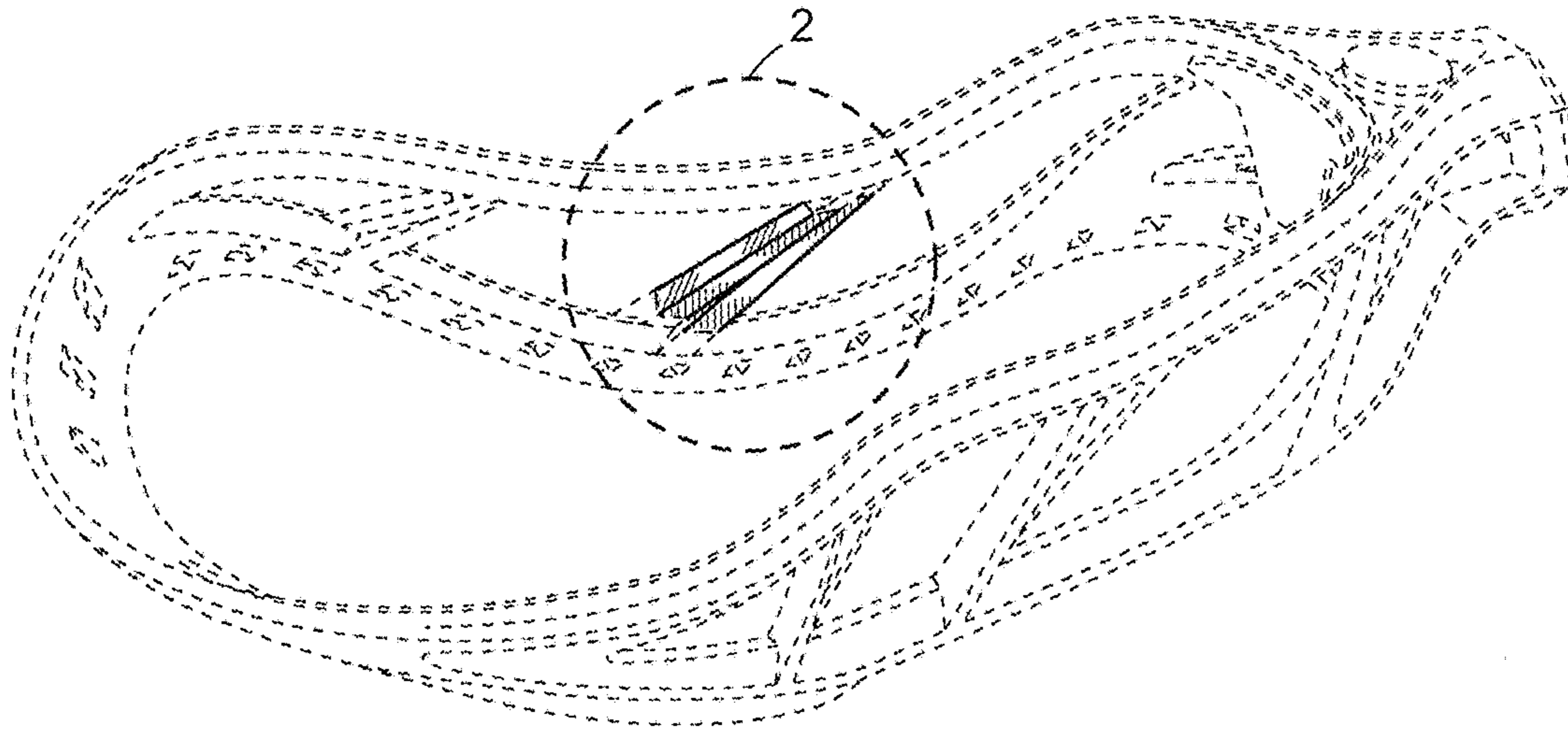

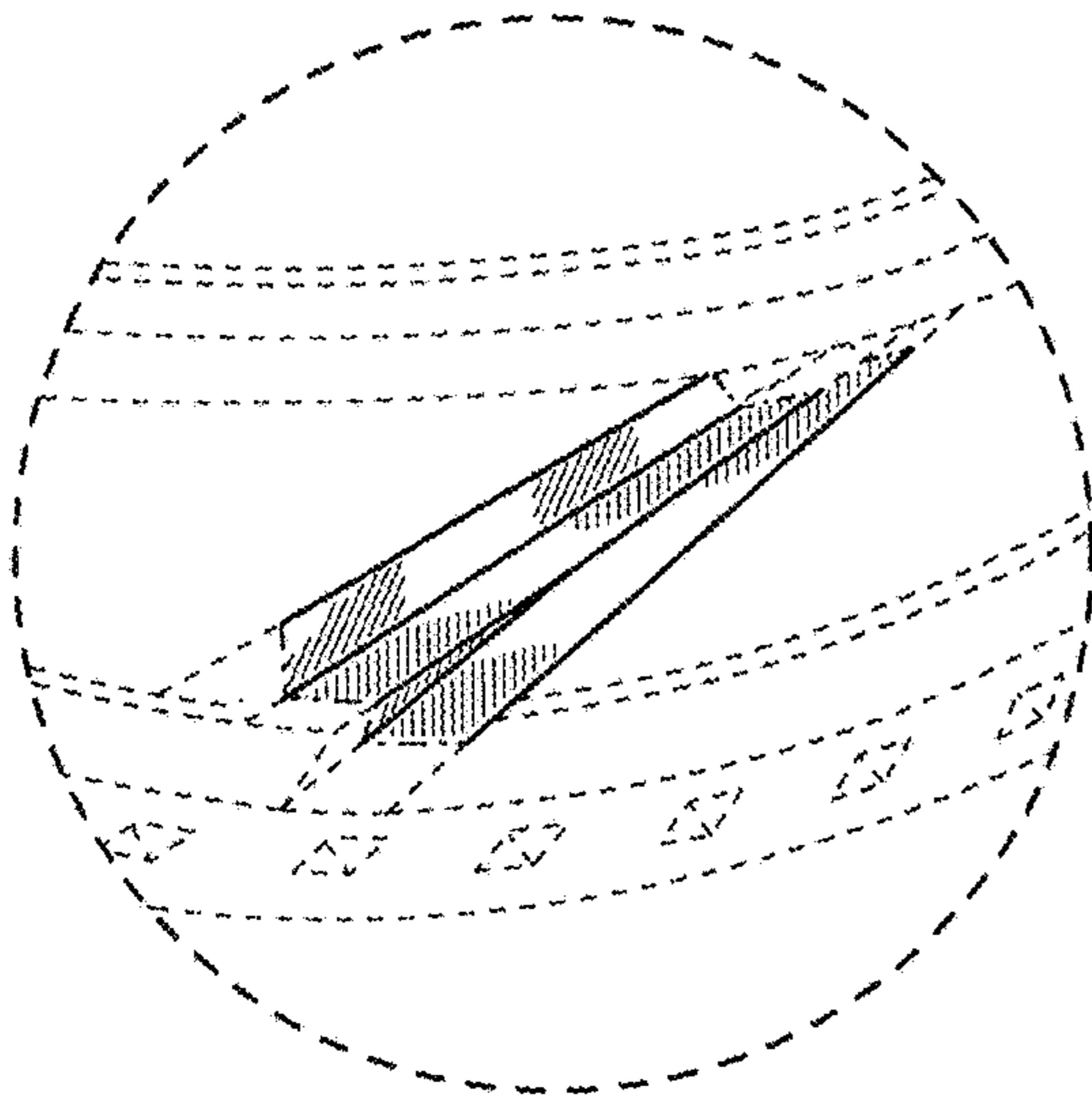
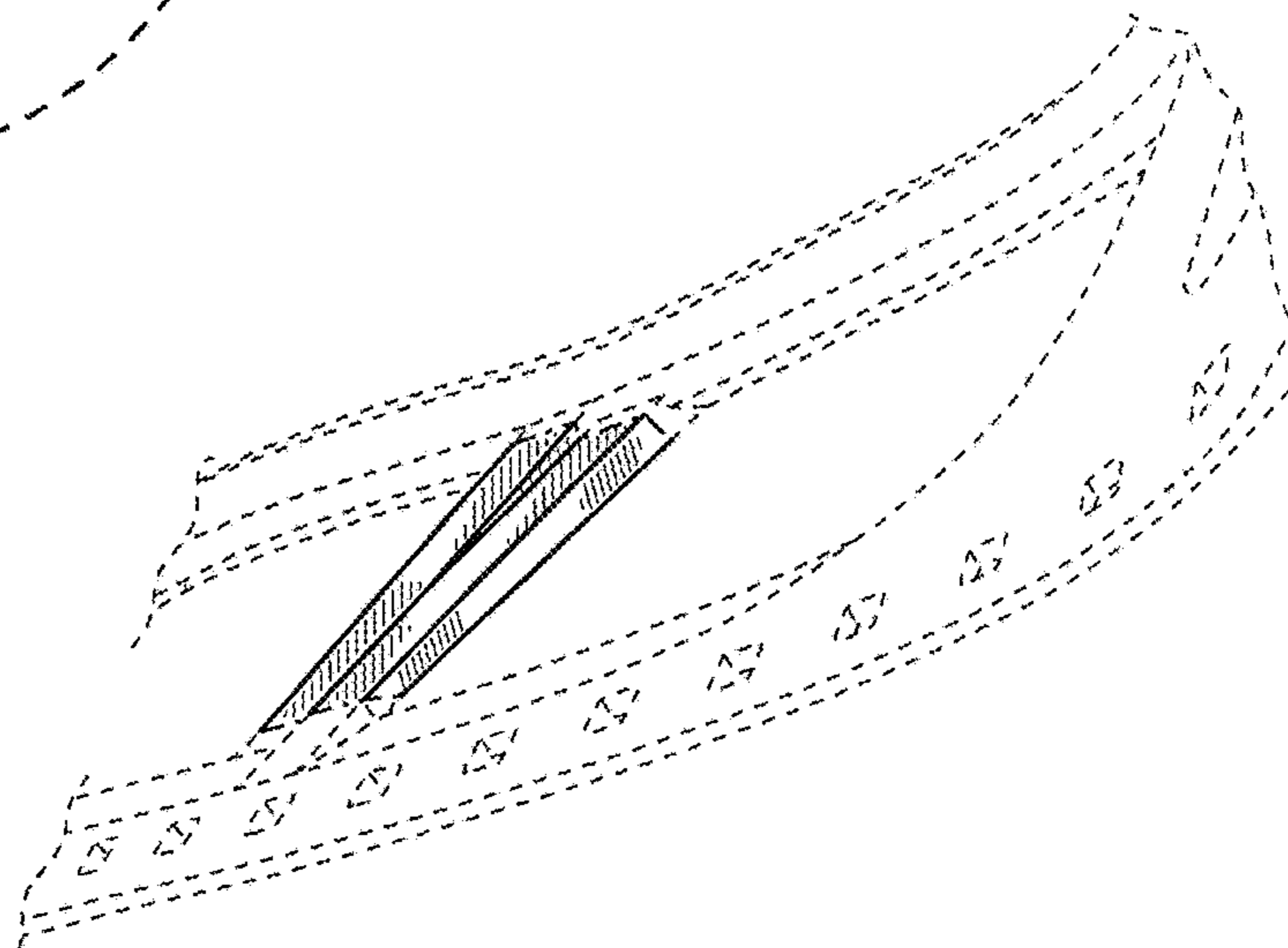

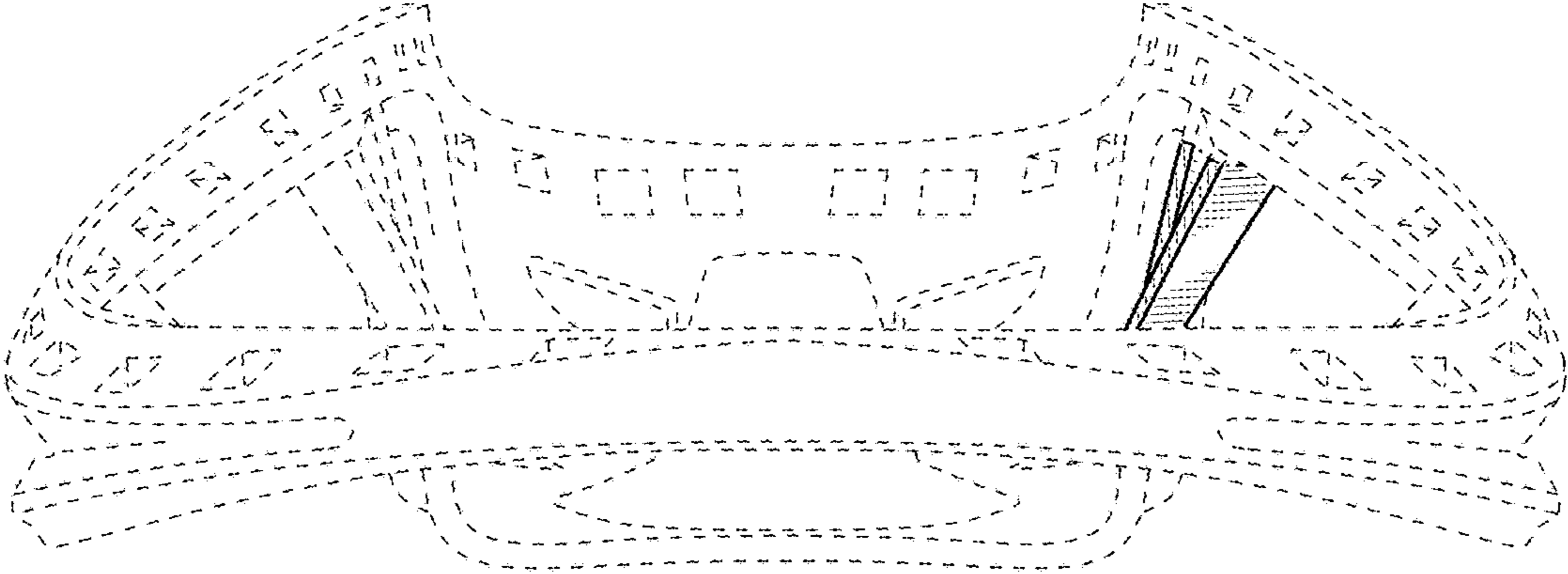
