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FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of the light fixture.

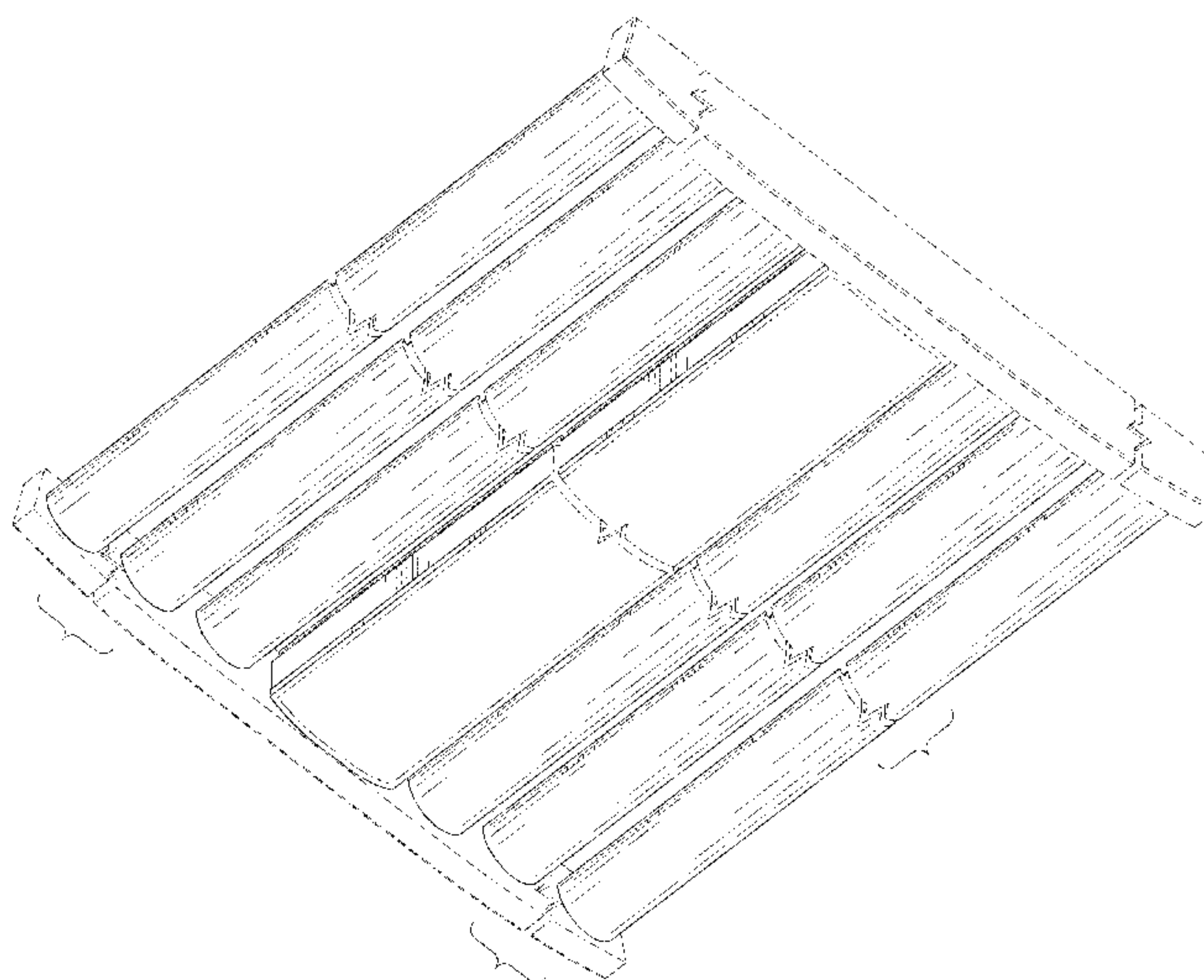
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view of the light fixture of FIG. 1.

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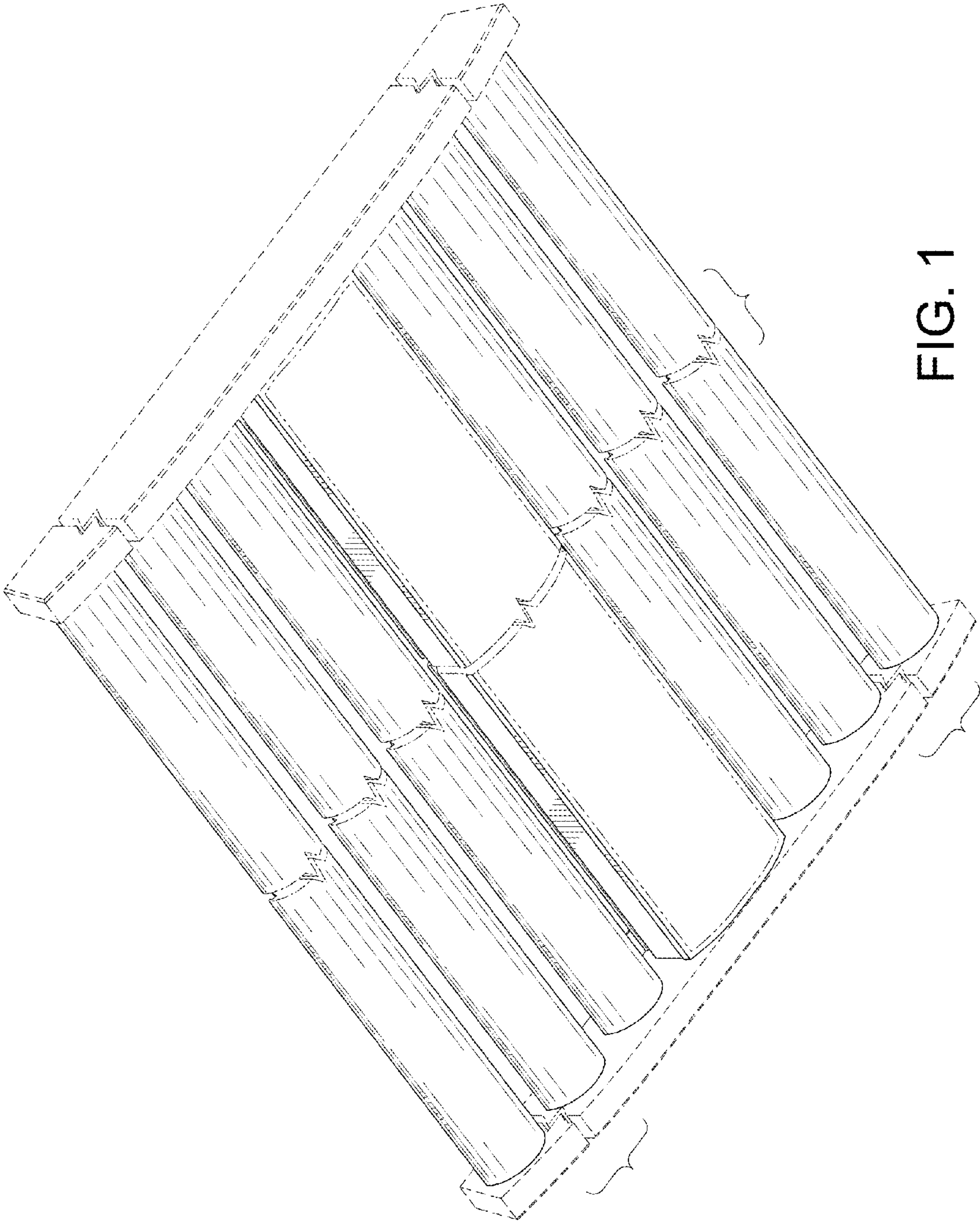
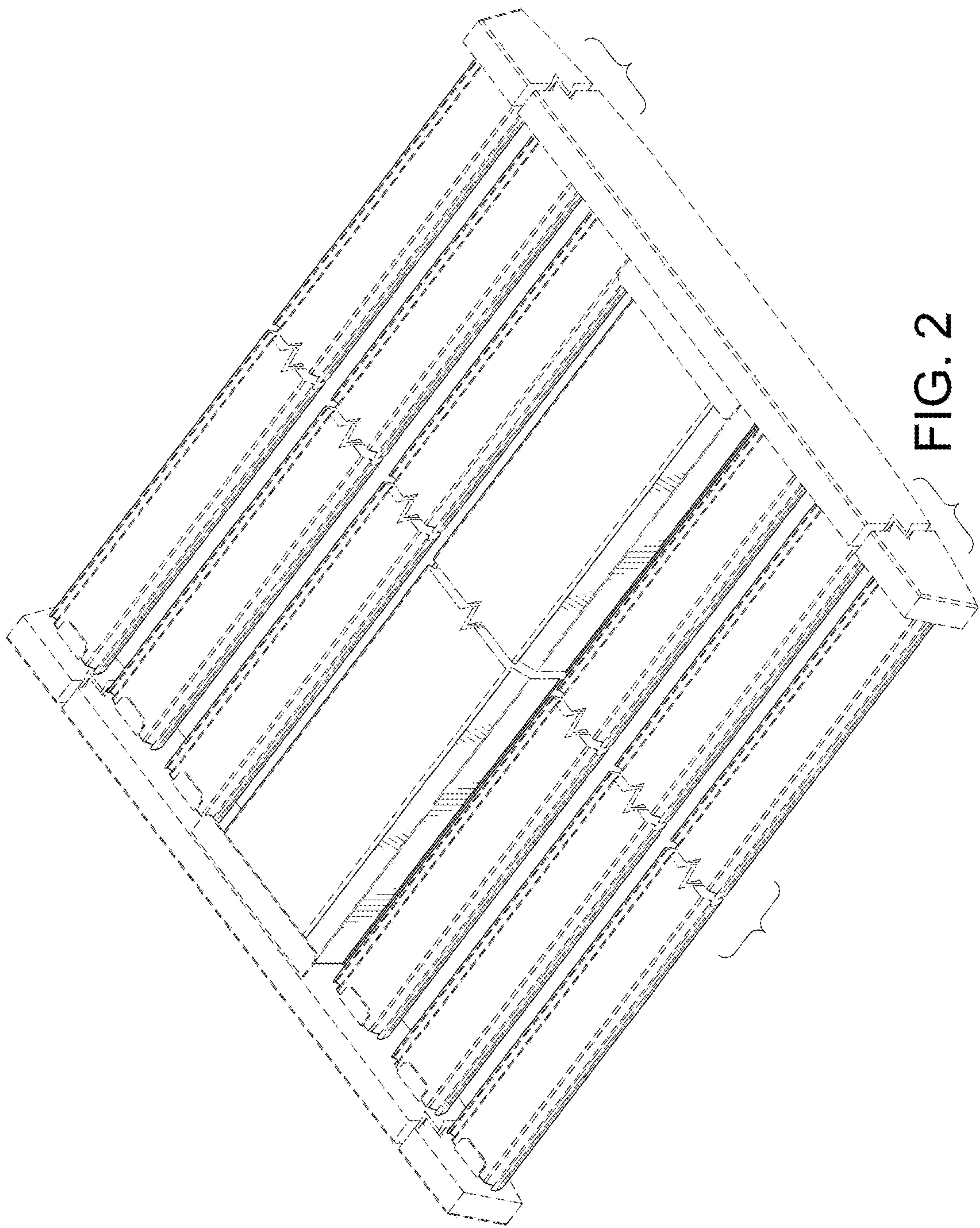

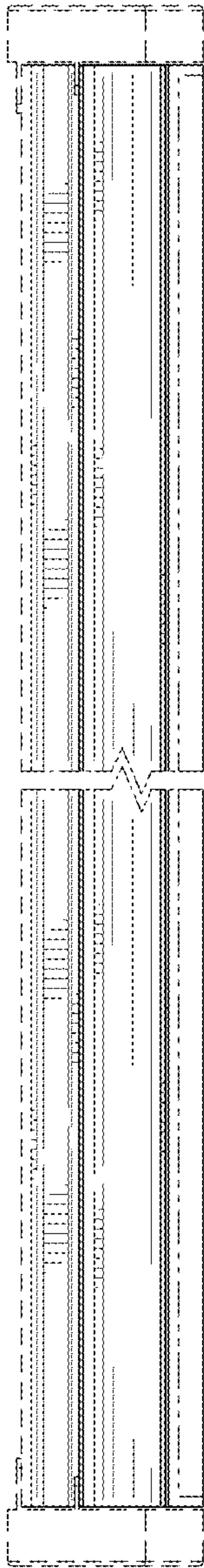

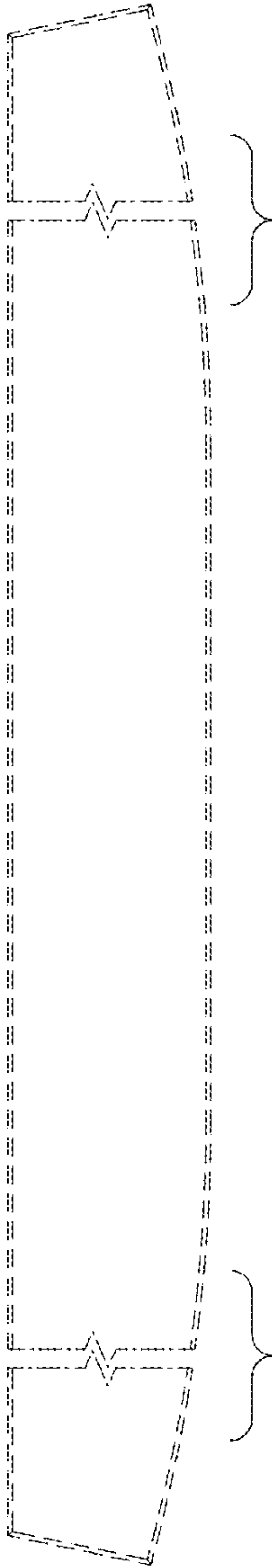

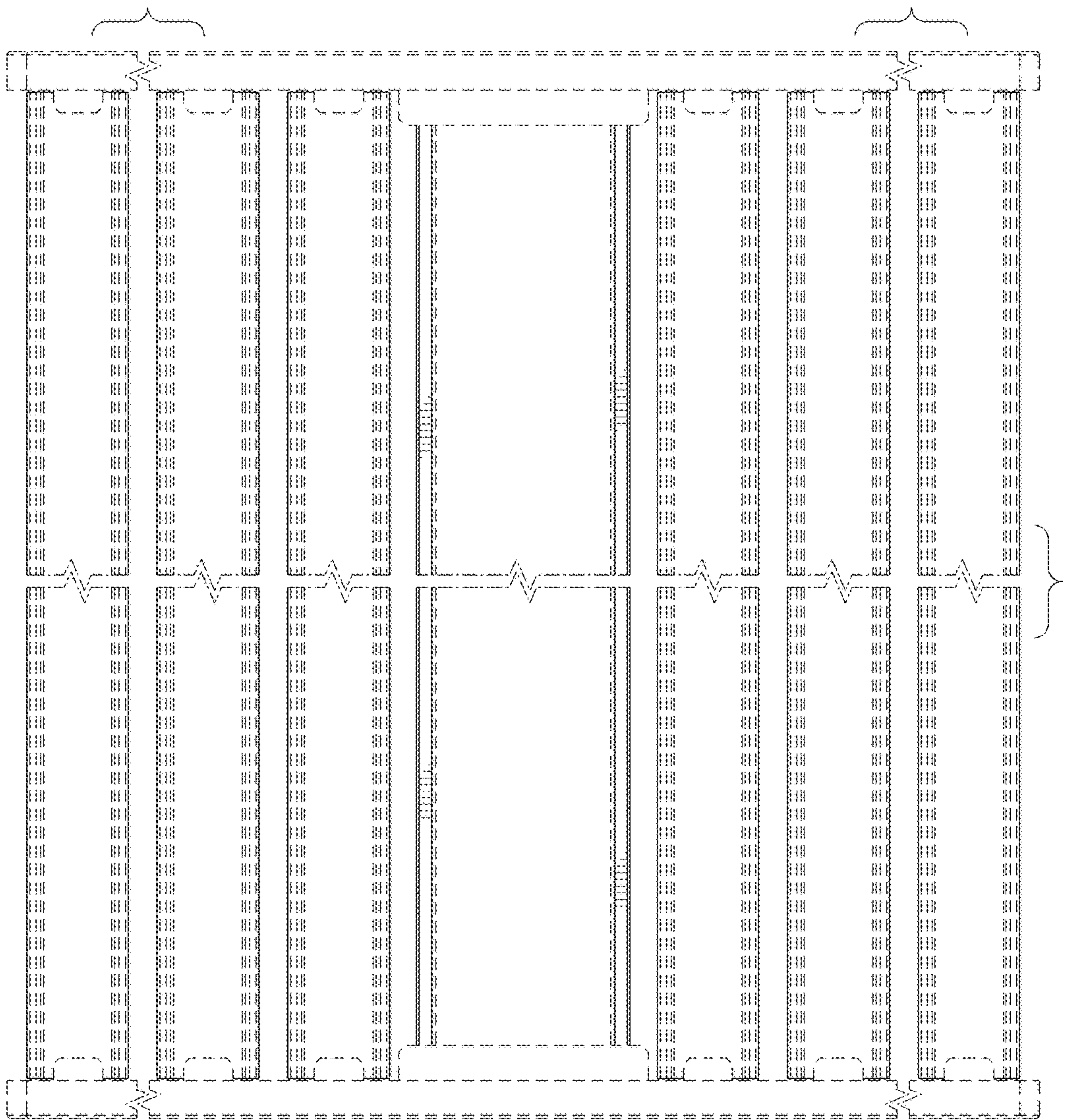

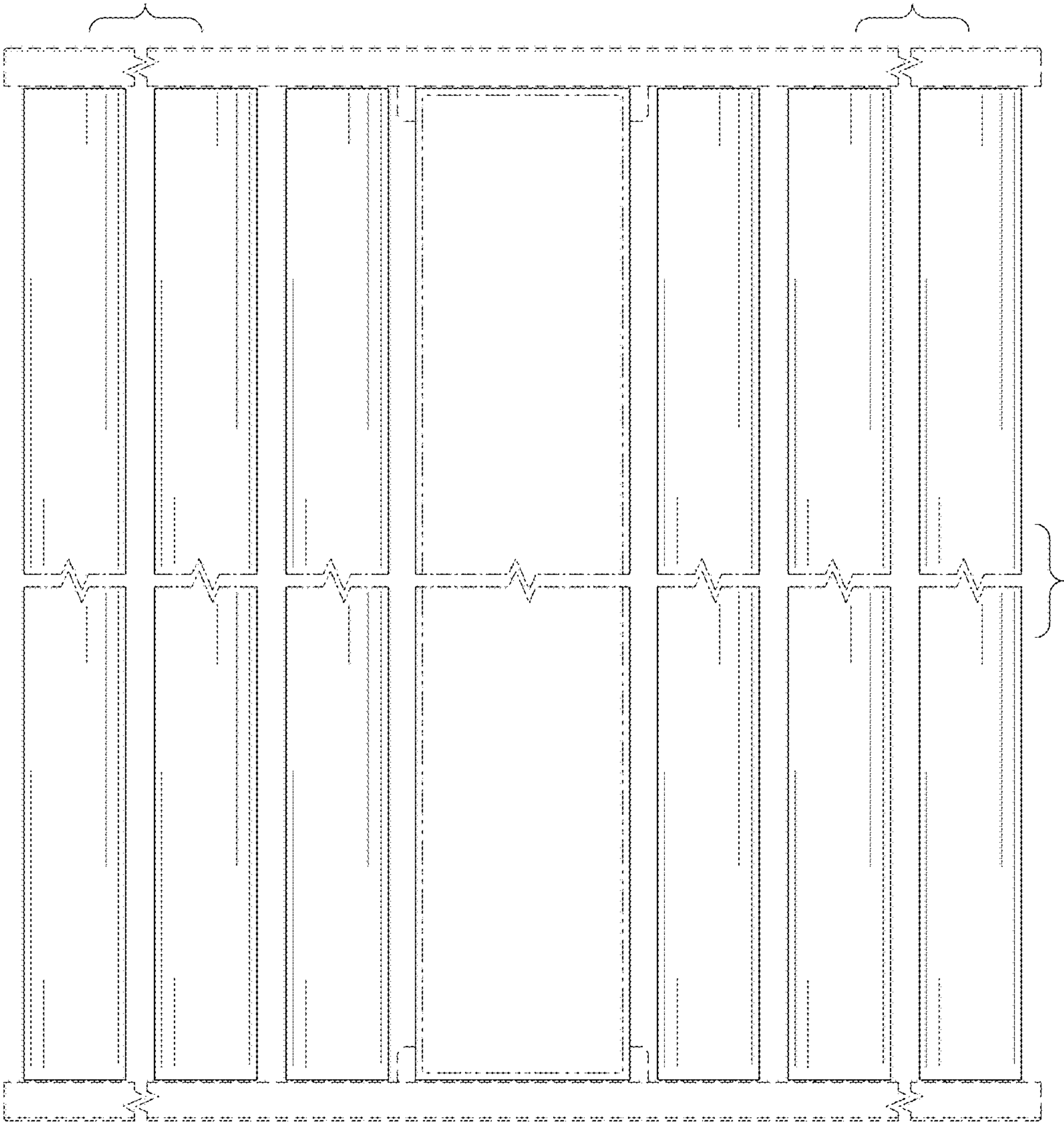
