DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tiki torch holder in accordance with the new design, with broken lines showing an example of a torch and support, but forming not part of invention herein;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the tiki torch holder of FIG. 1 without broken lines;

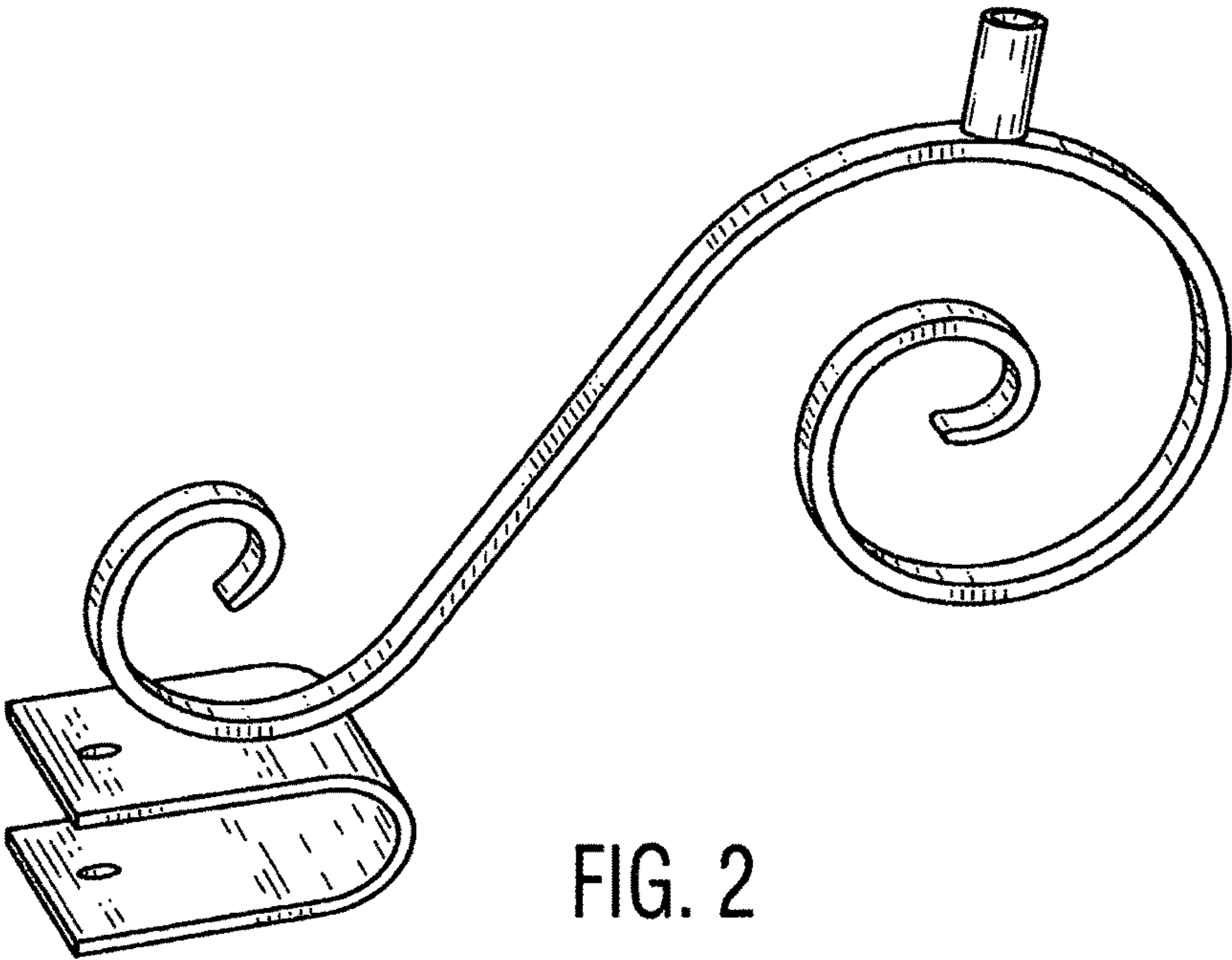

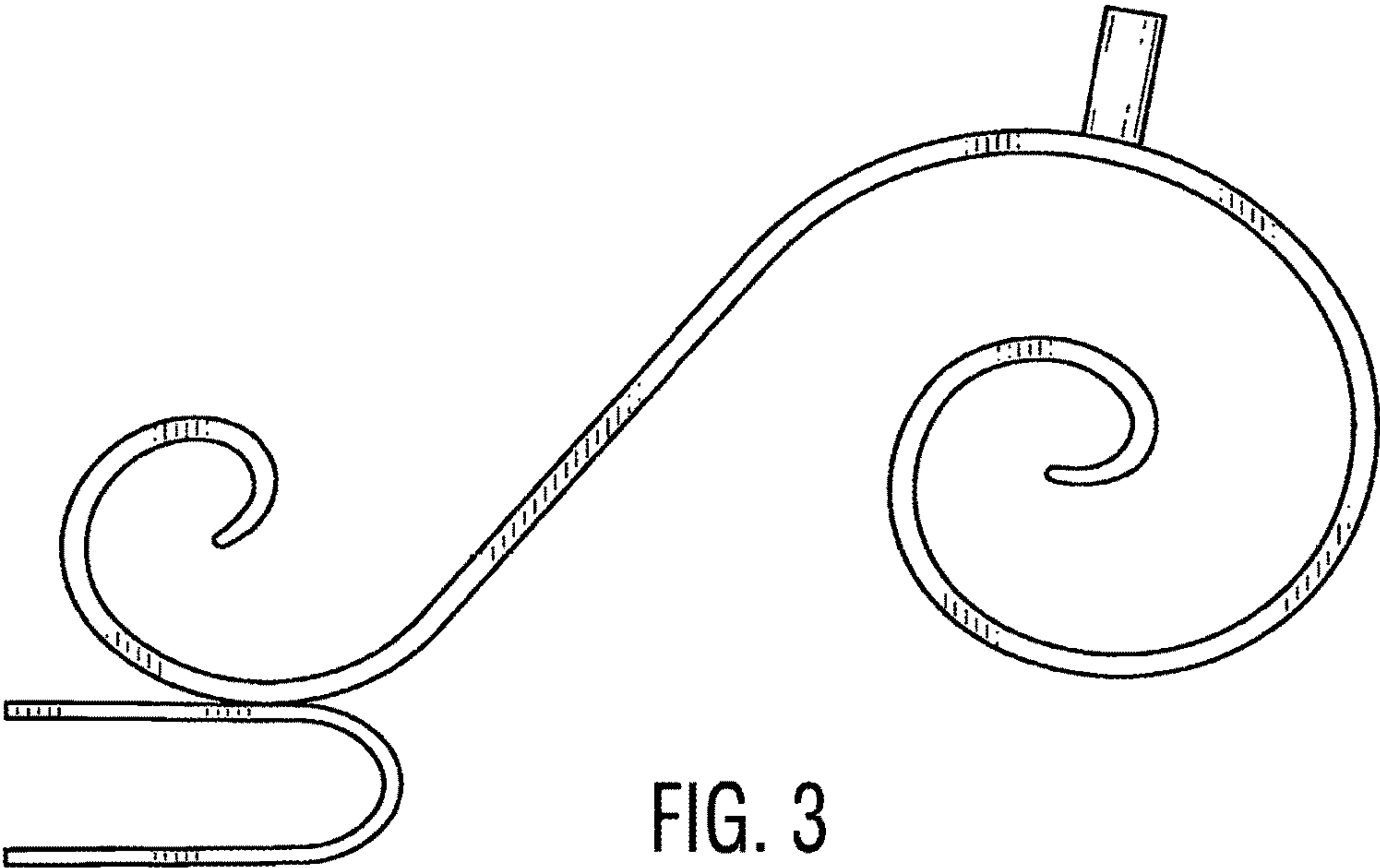

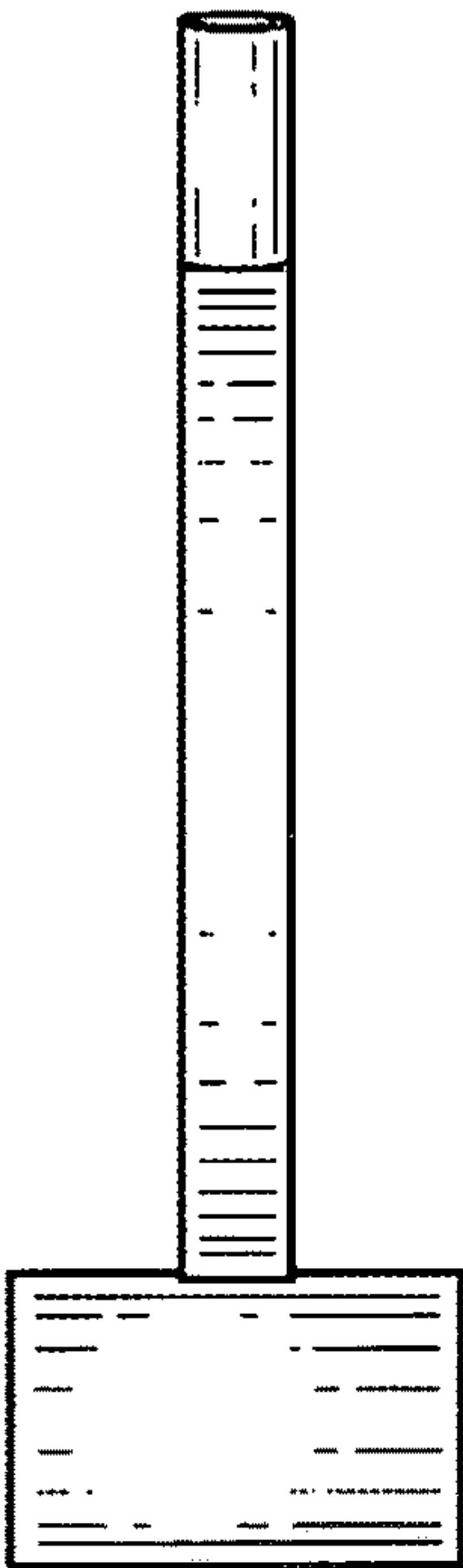

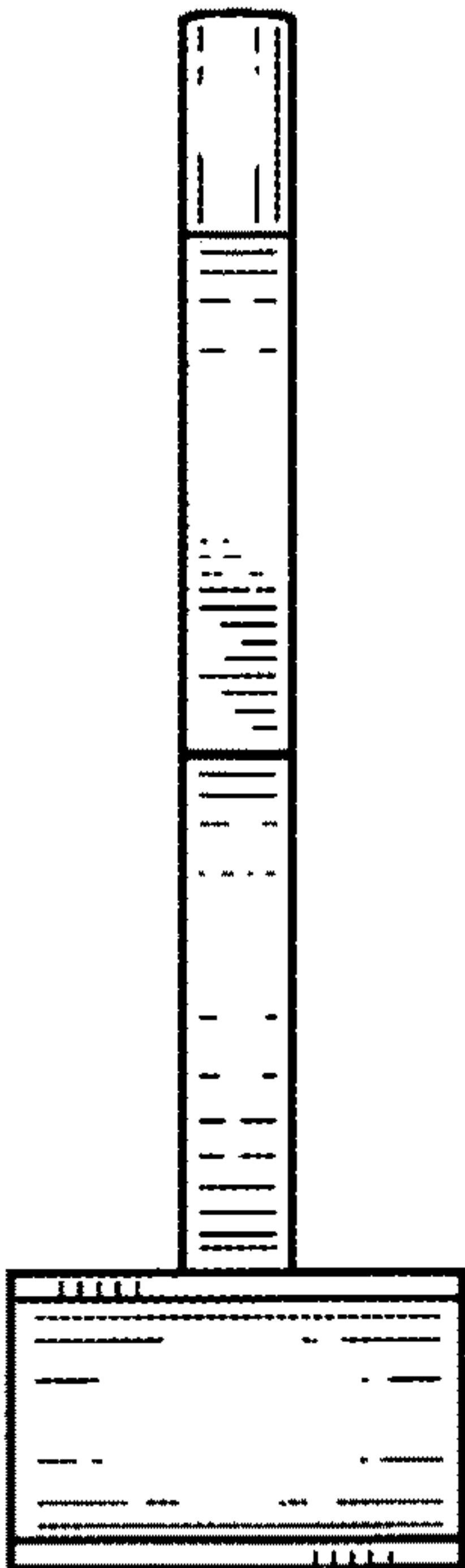

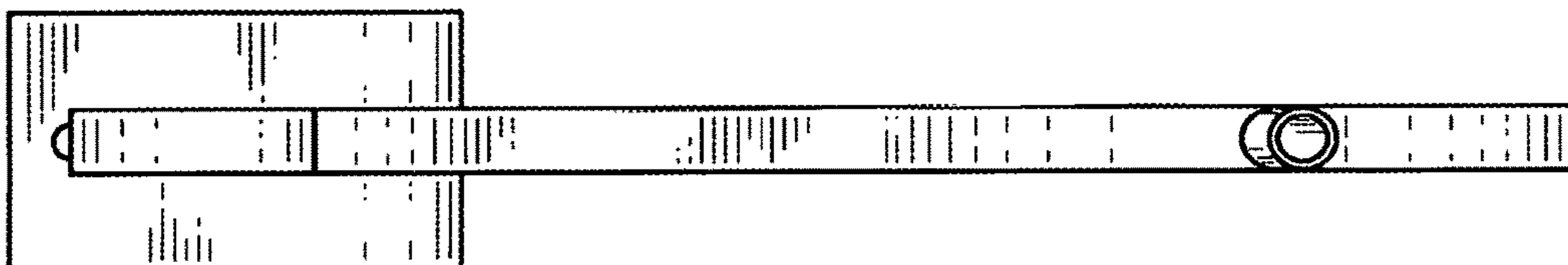

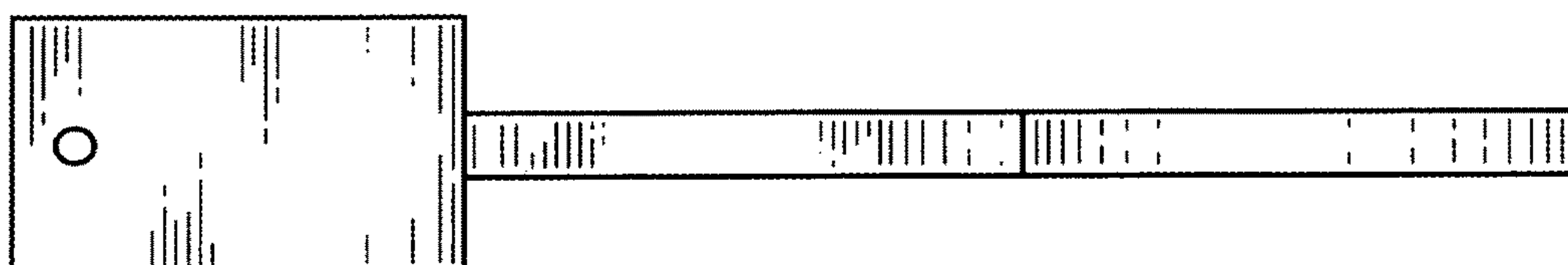
