The ornamental design for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

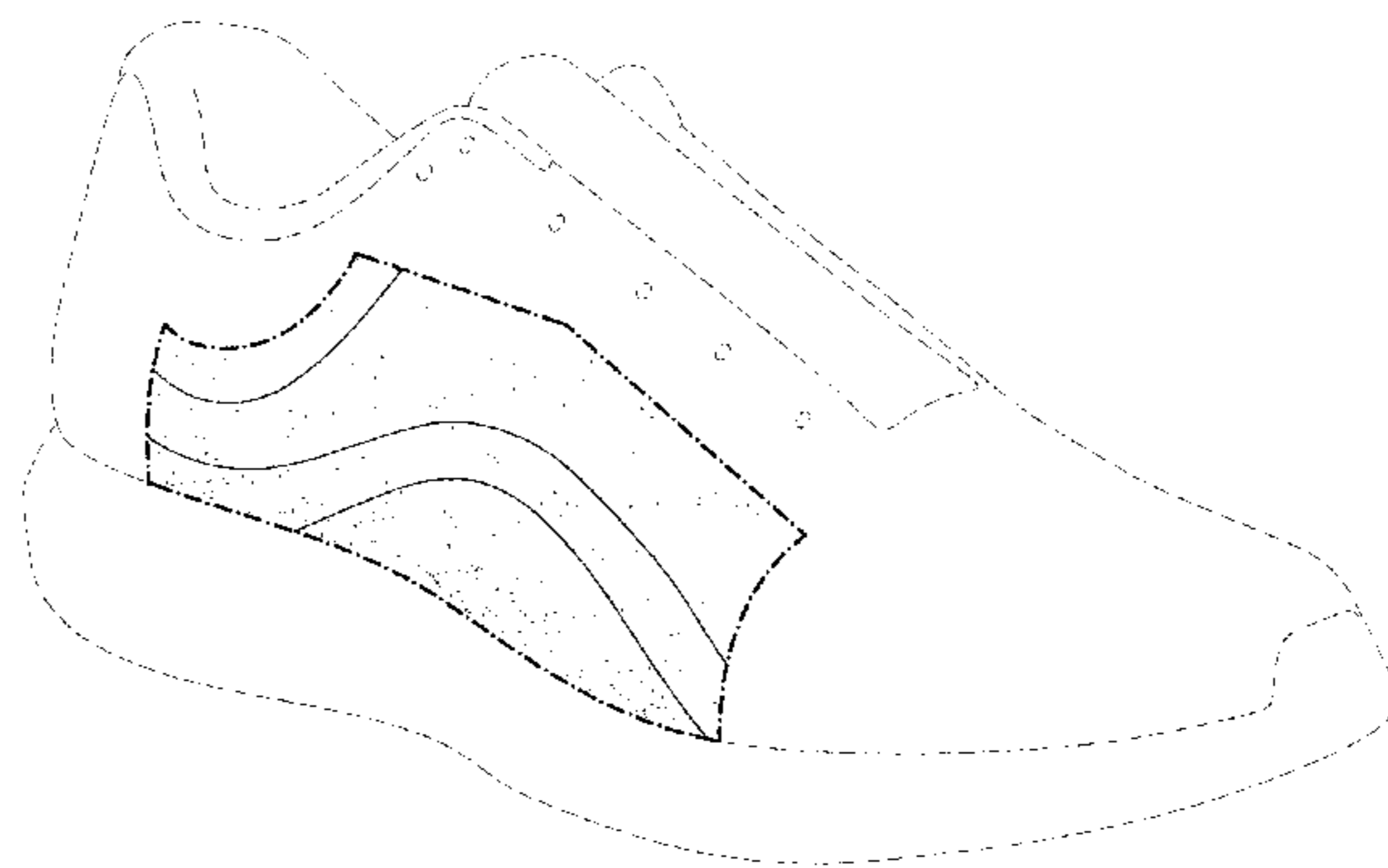
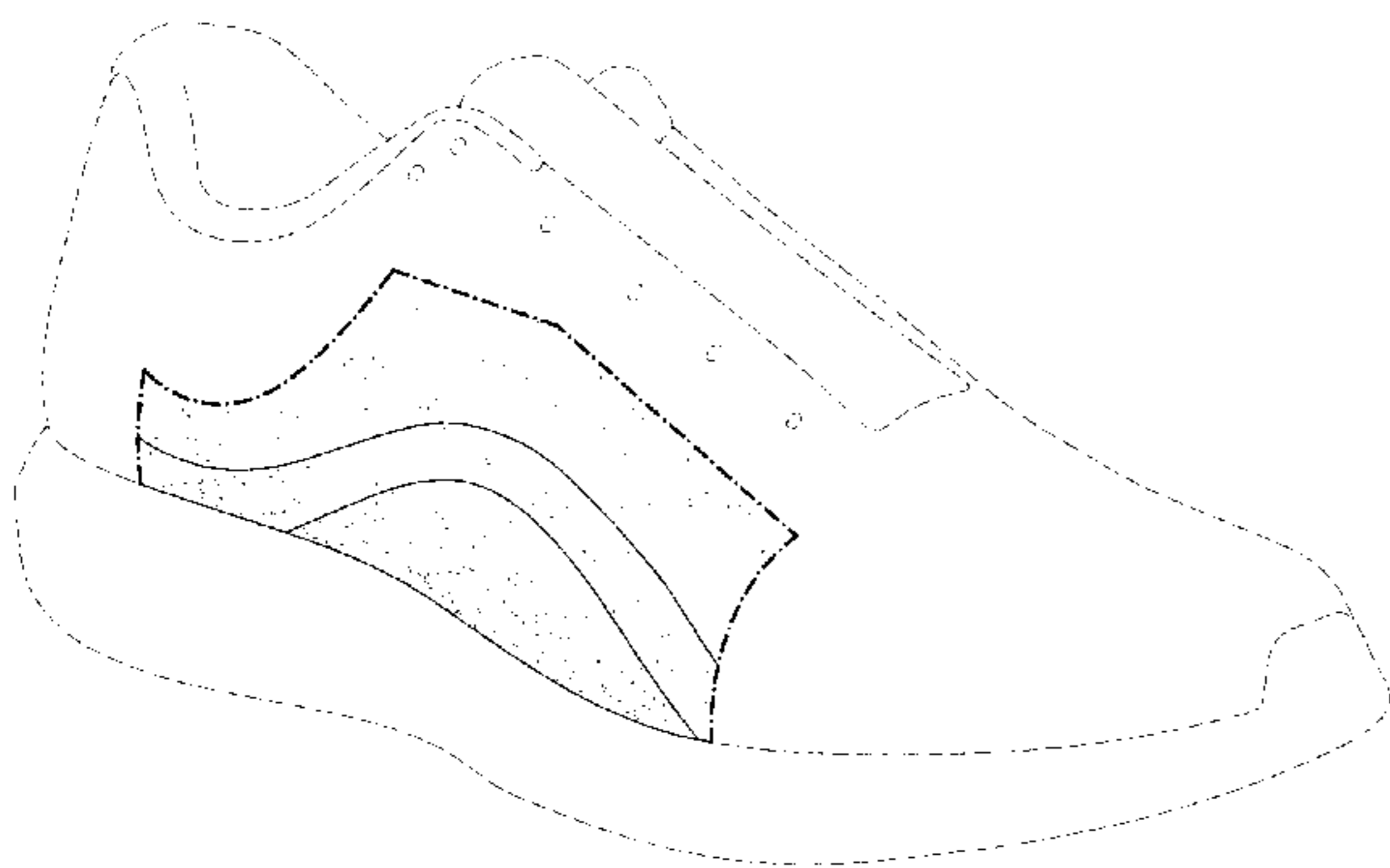
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe upper showing a first embodiment according to the present design; FIG. 2 is a side view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of a shoe upper showing a second embodiment according to the present design; FIG. 5 is a side view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view thereof.

The evenly spaced broken lines shown in the drawings are directed to environment, are for informational purposes only, and form no part of the claimed design.

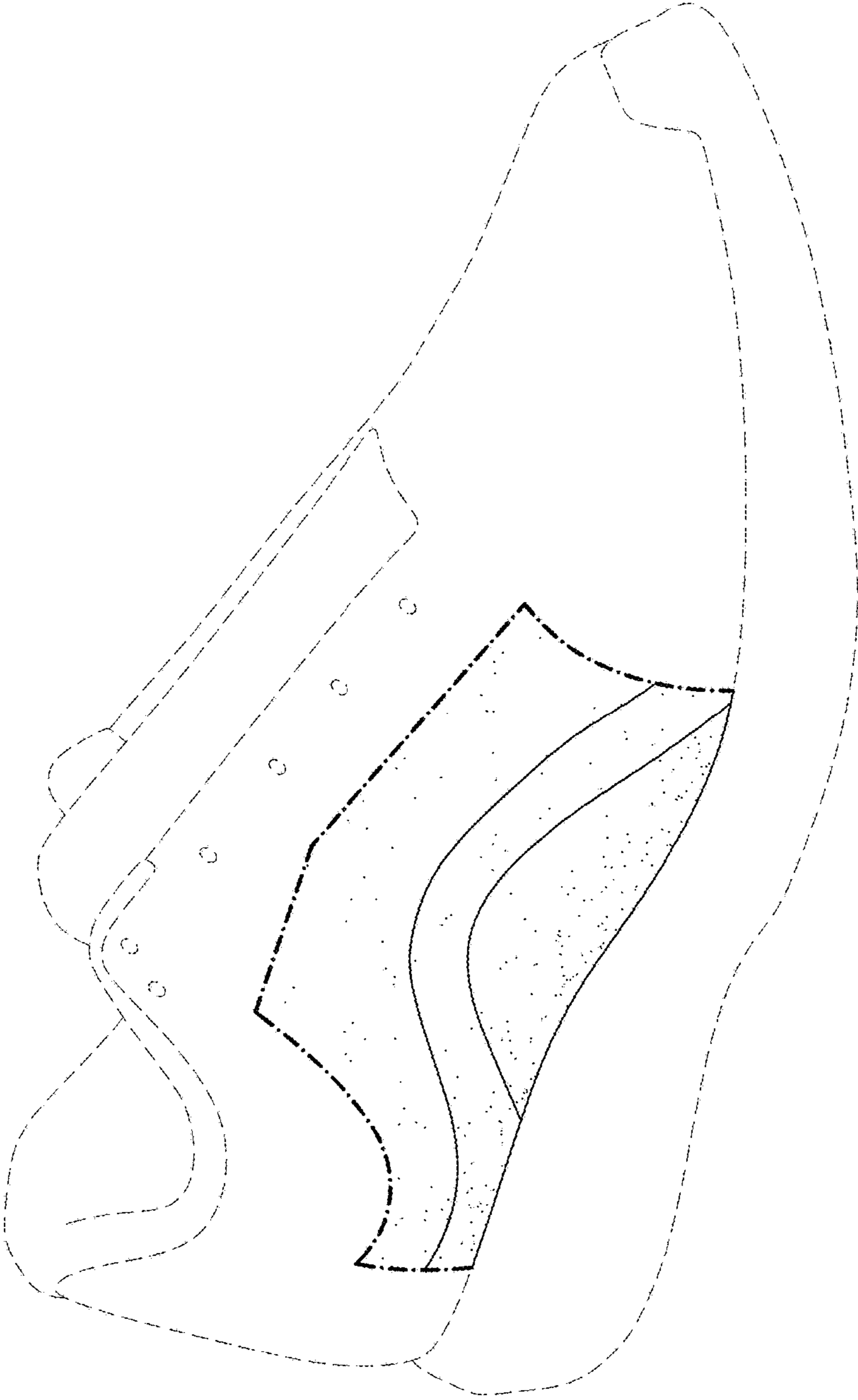

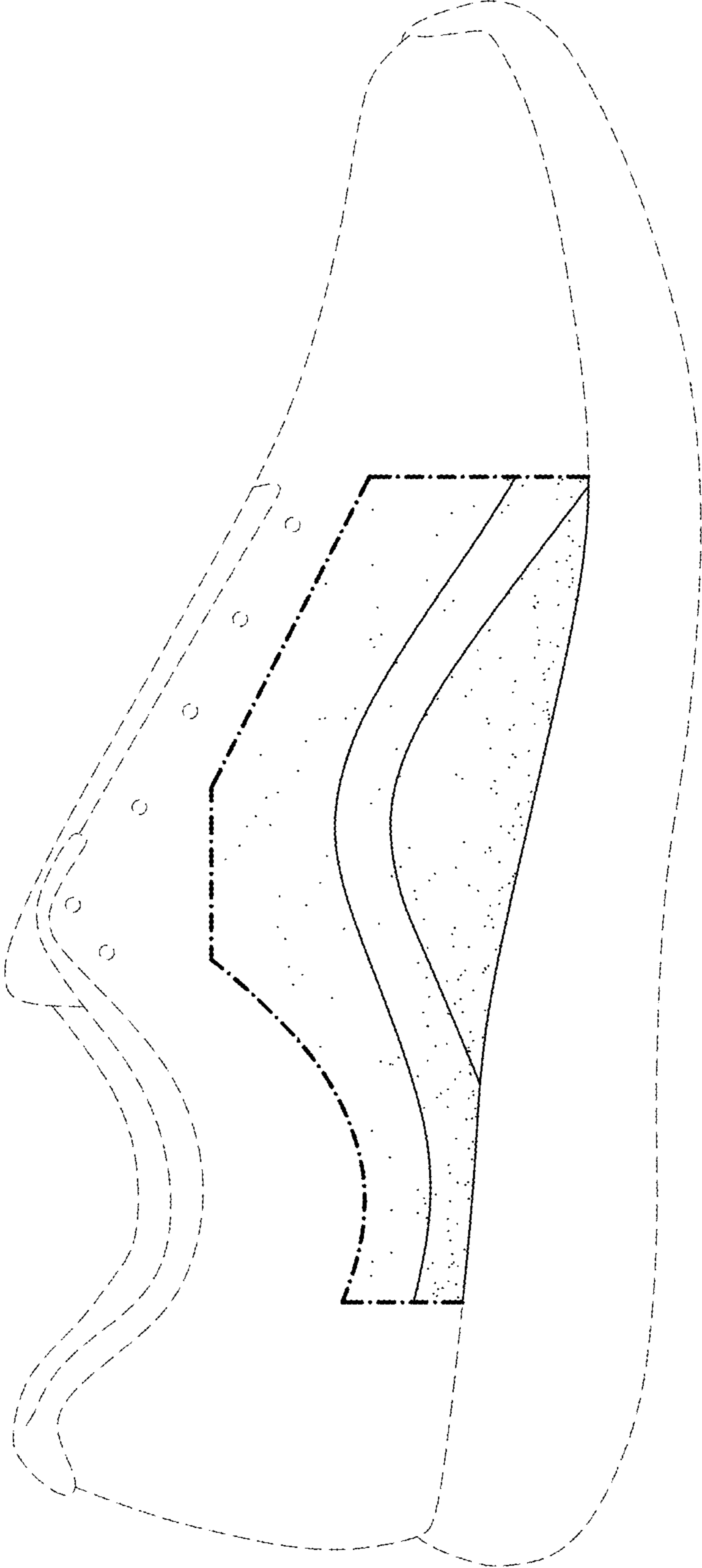

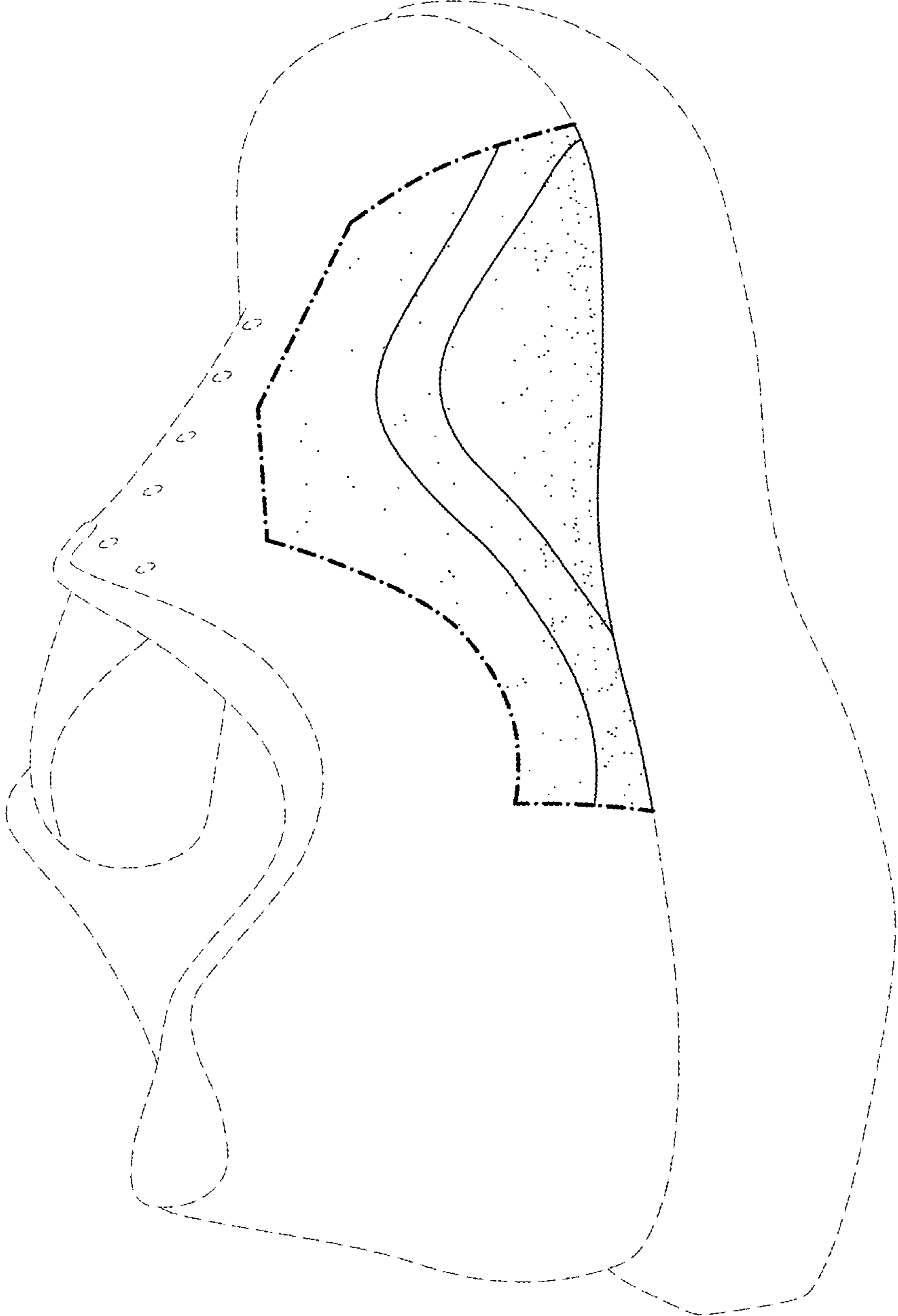

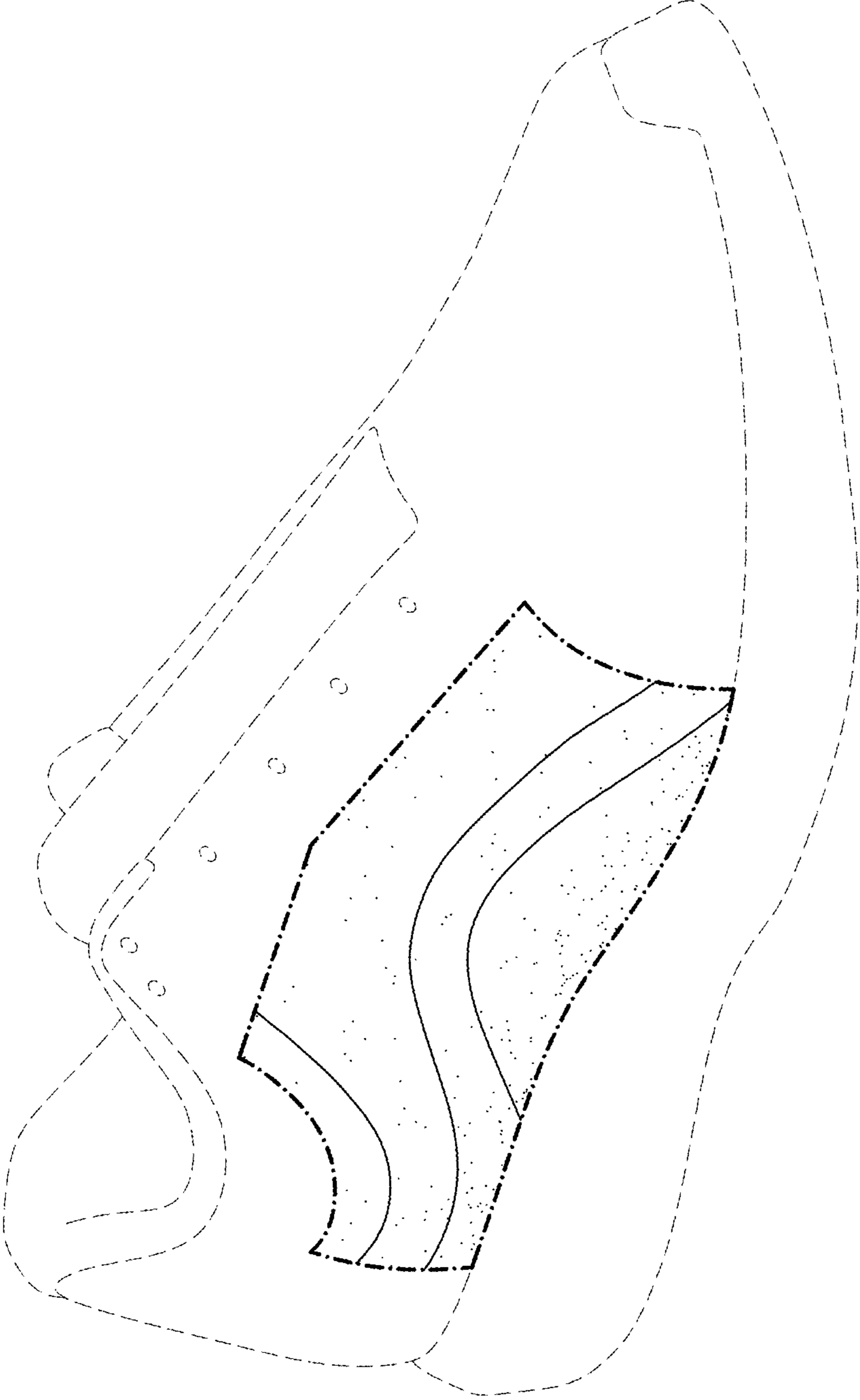

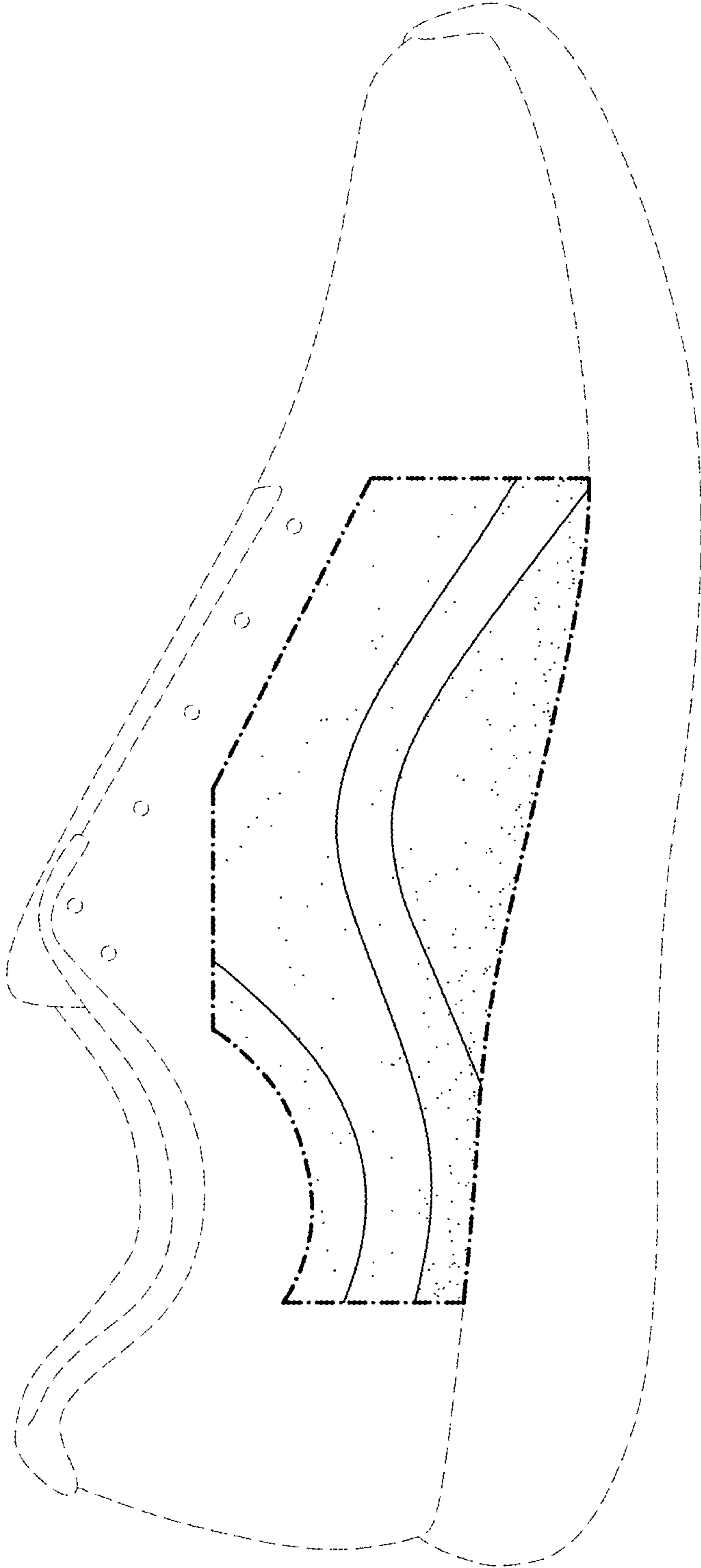

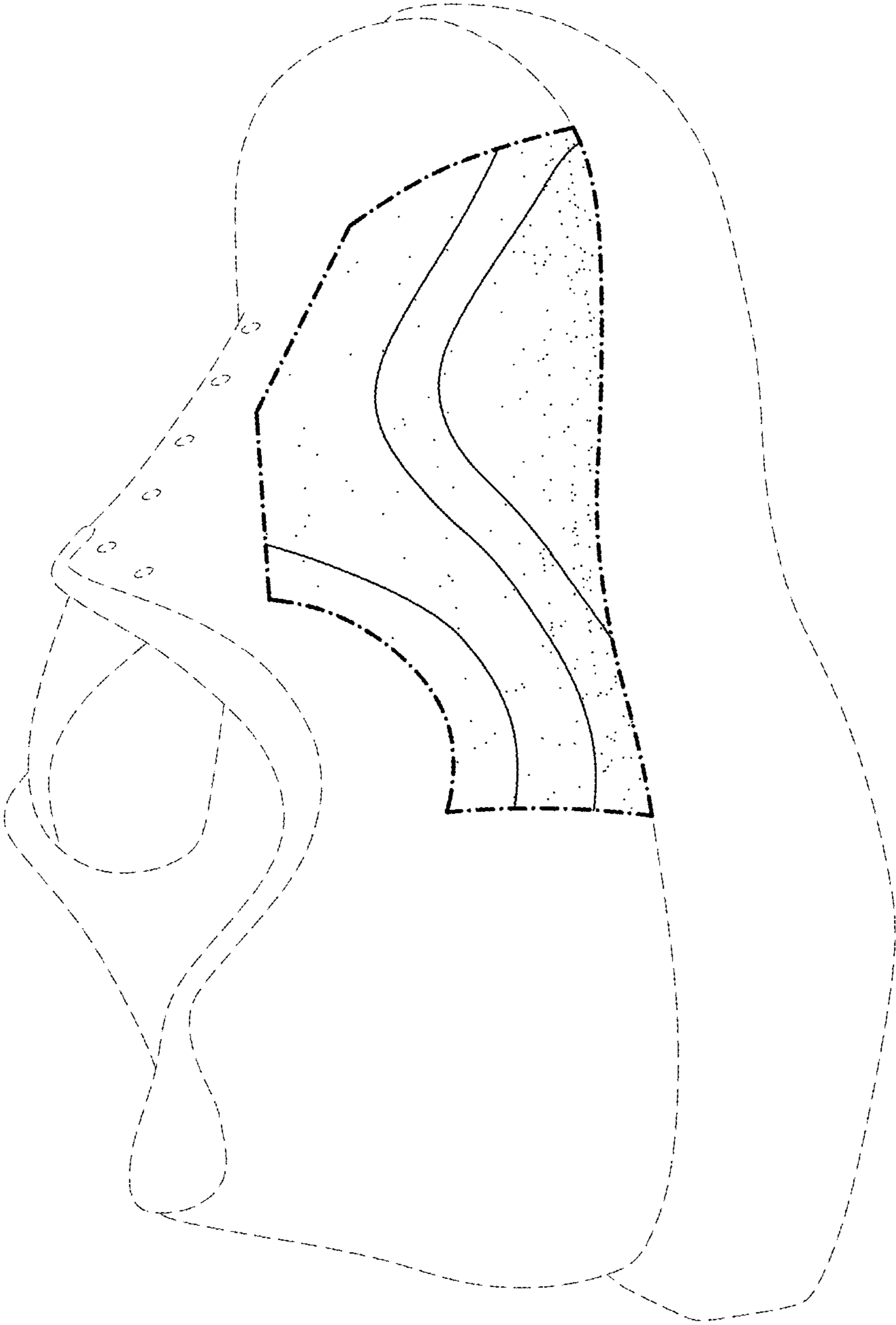
