FIG. 6 is a magnified view of the portion identified in FIG. 1.

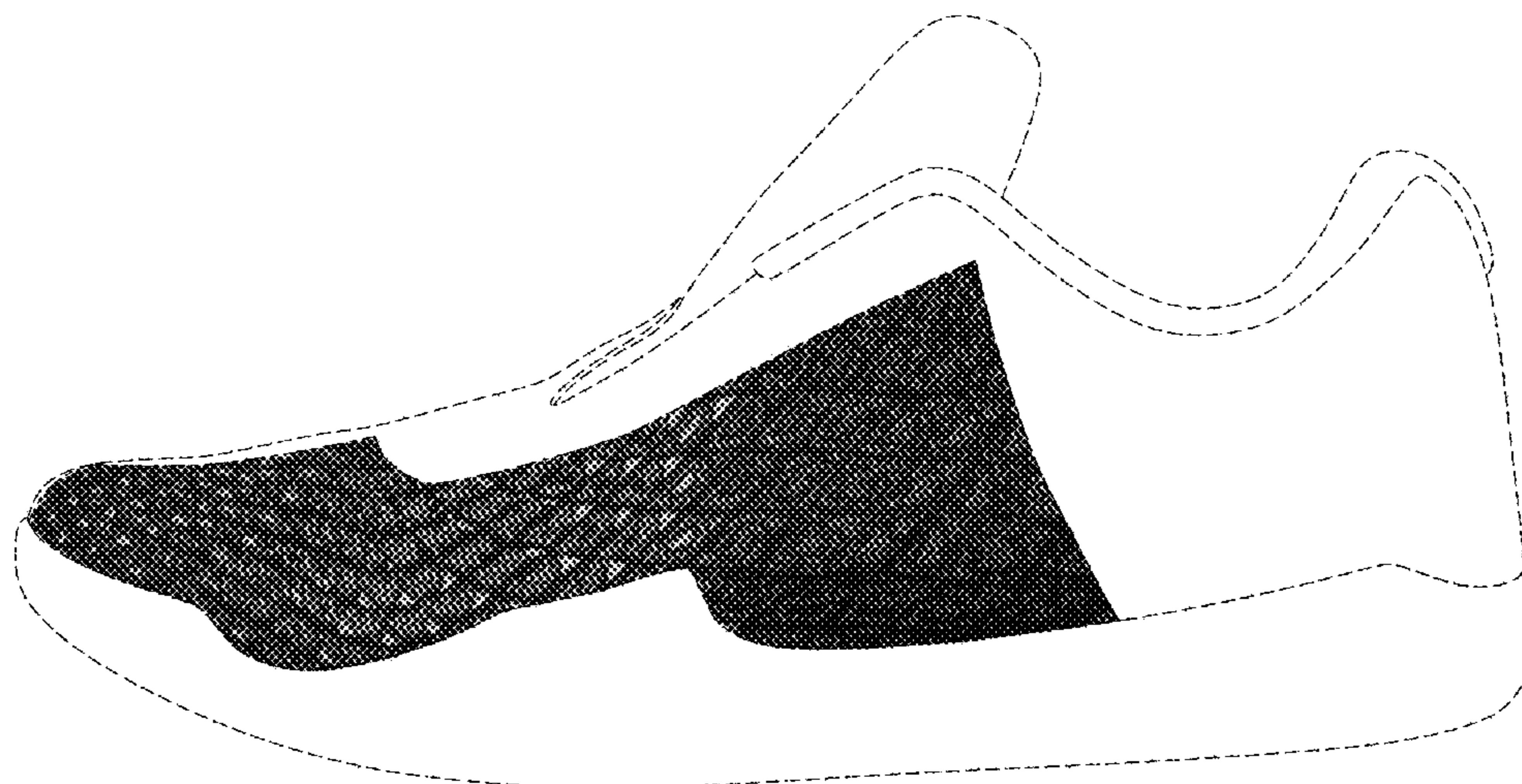

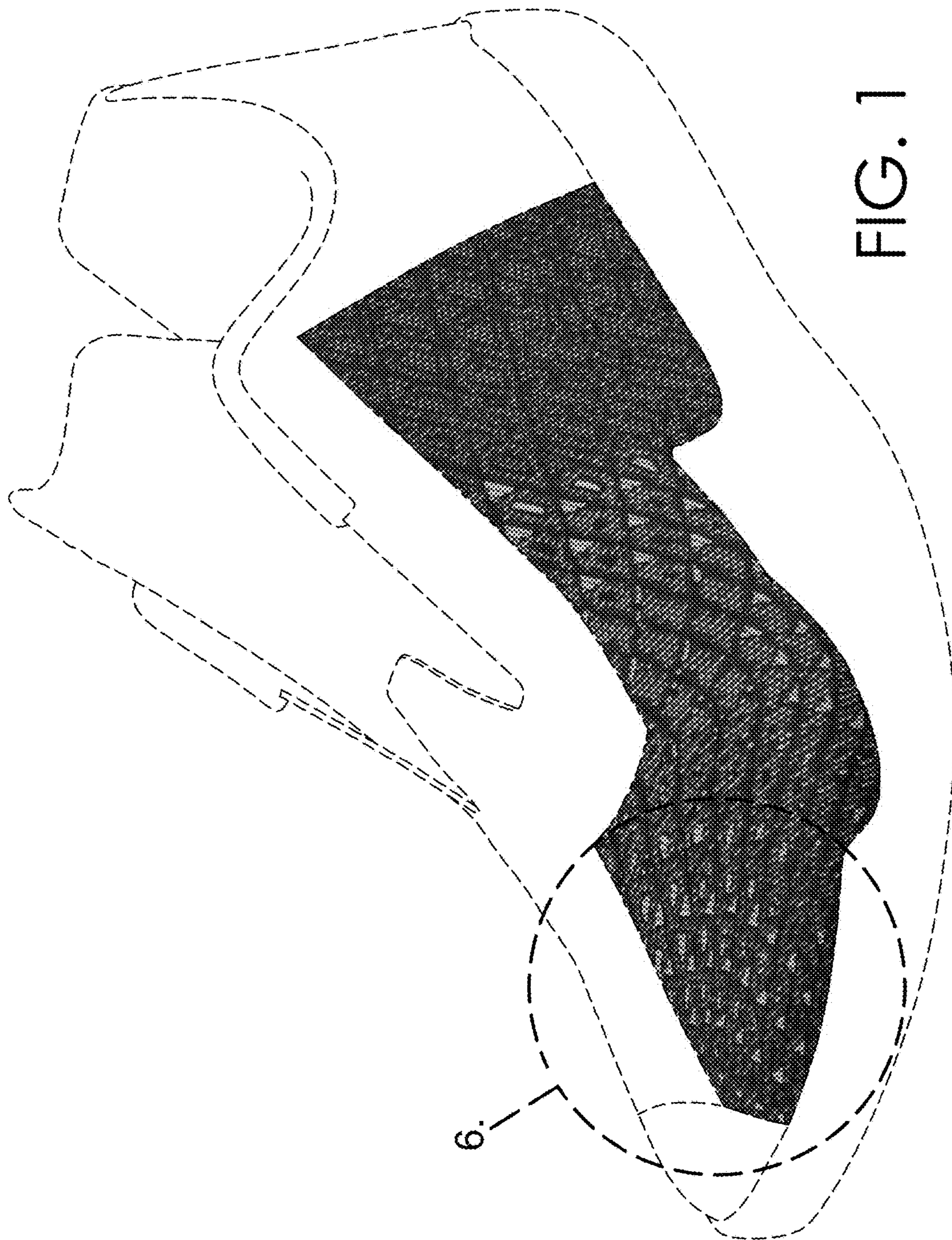

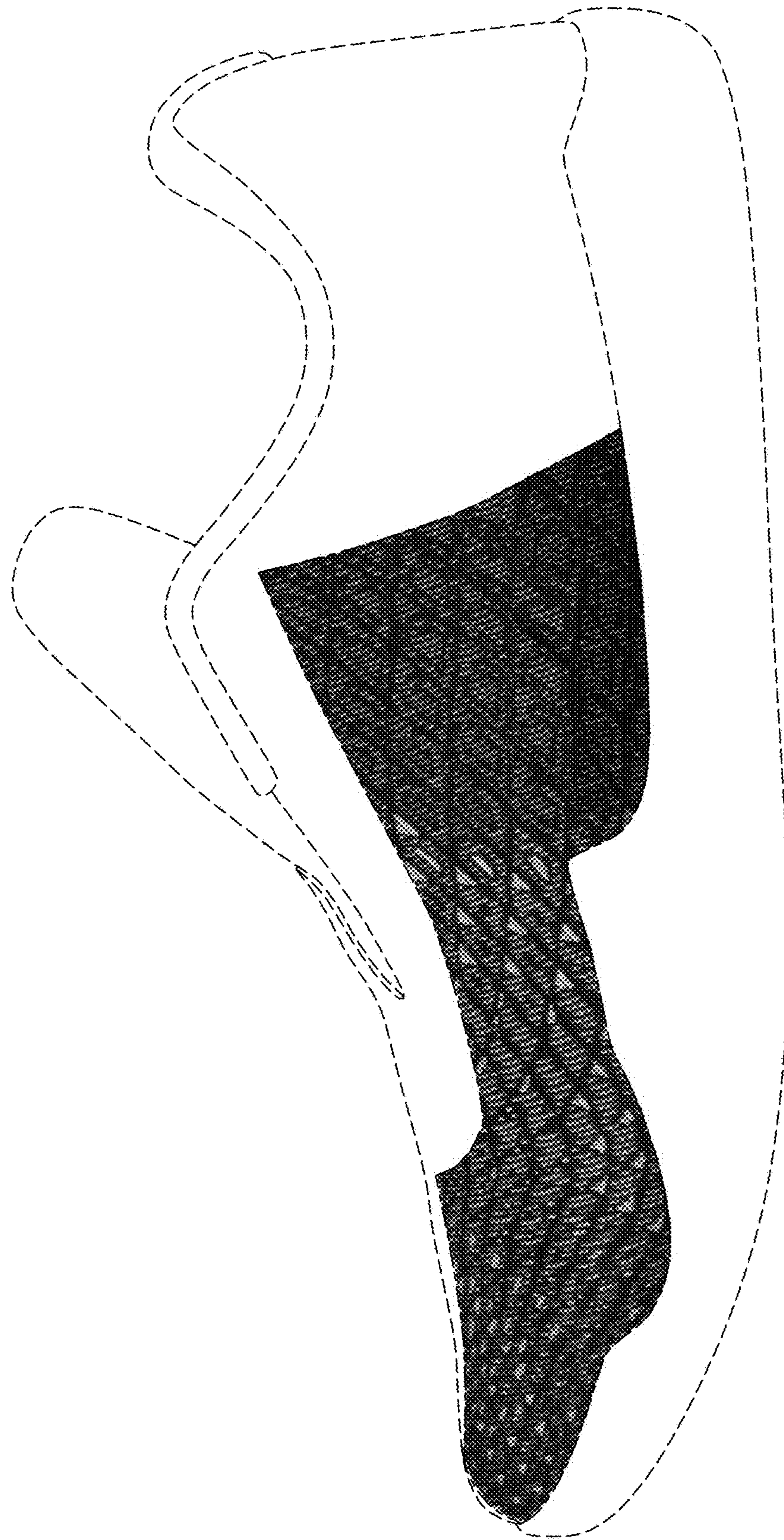

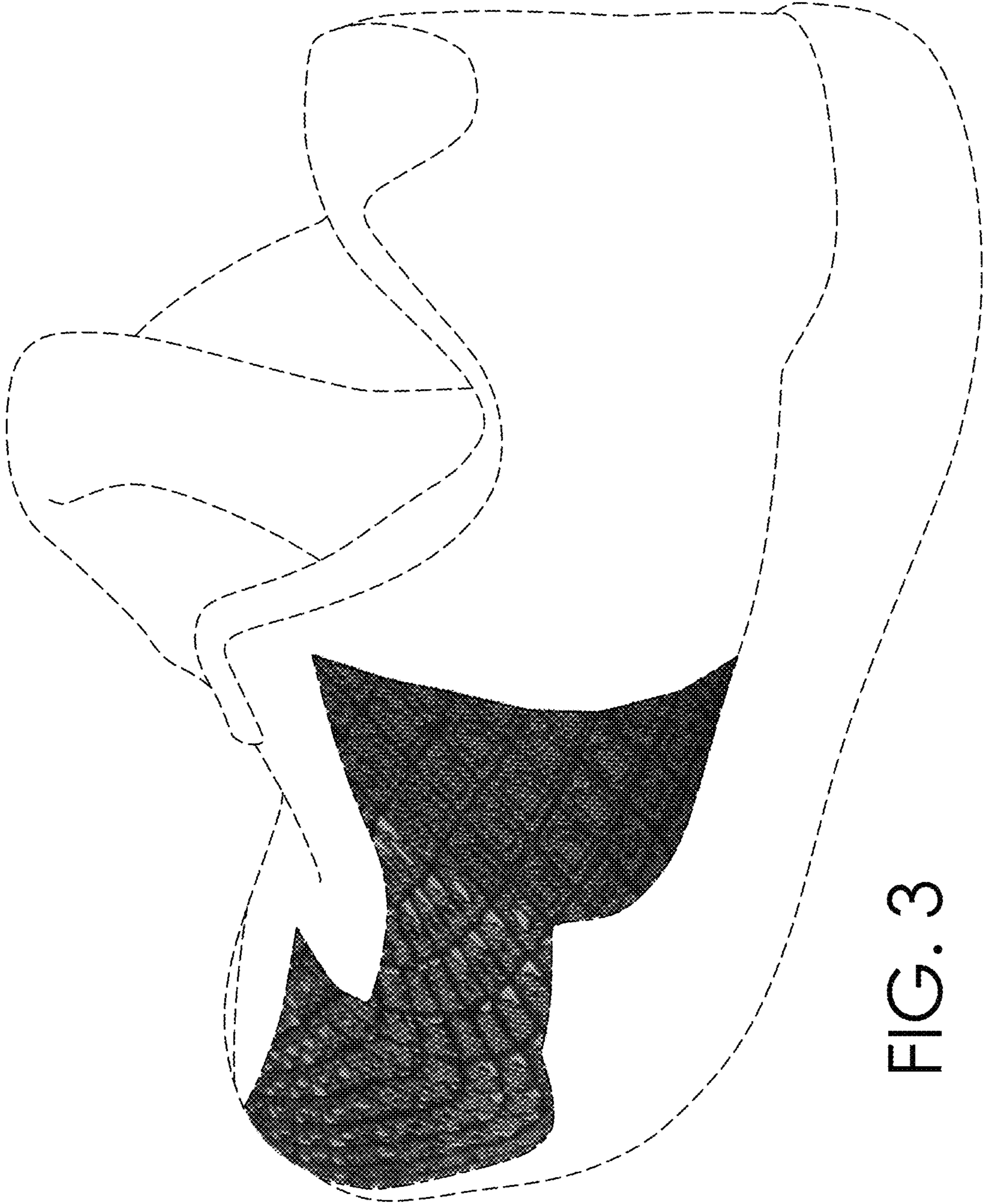

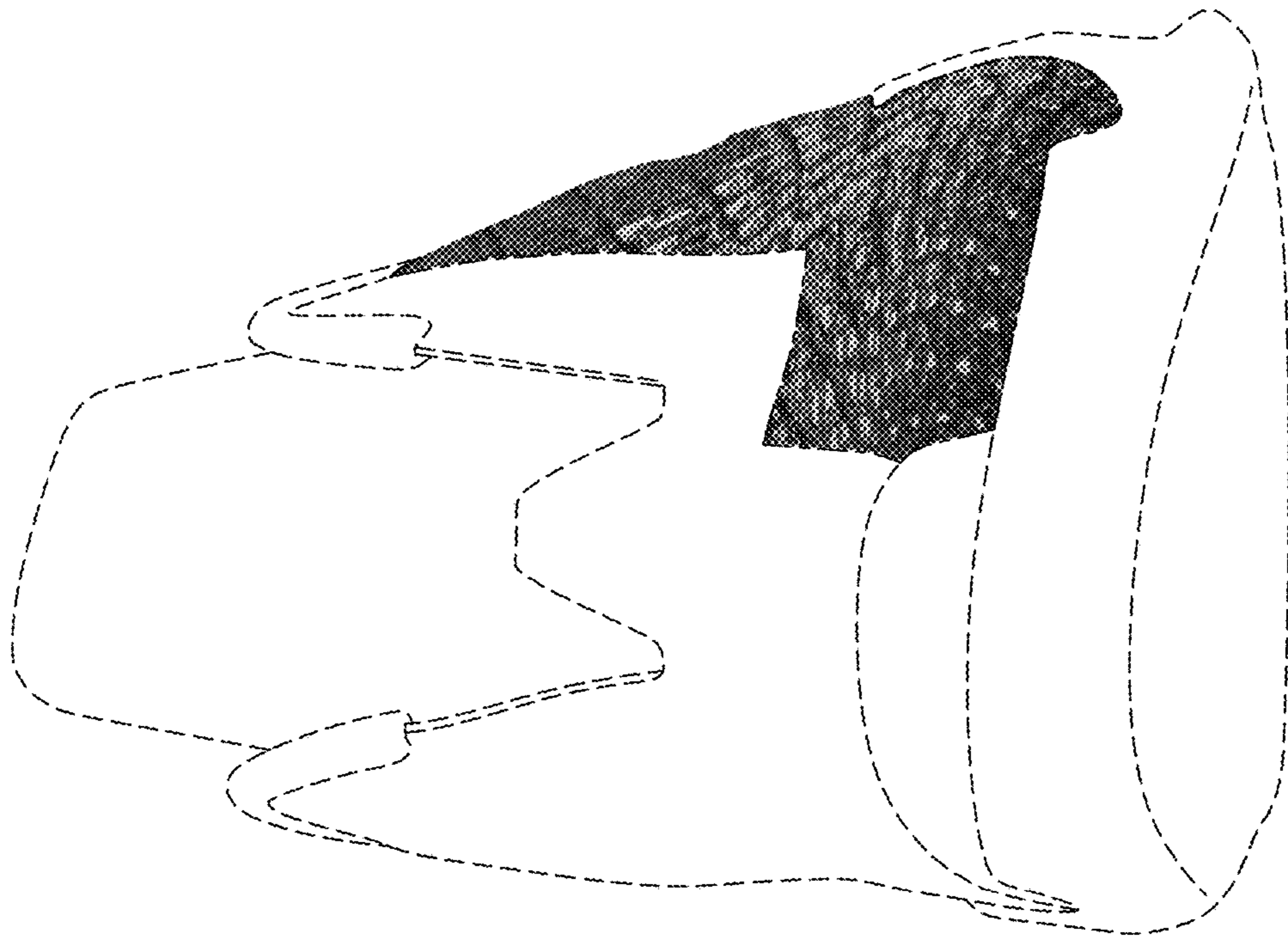

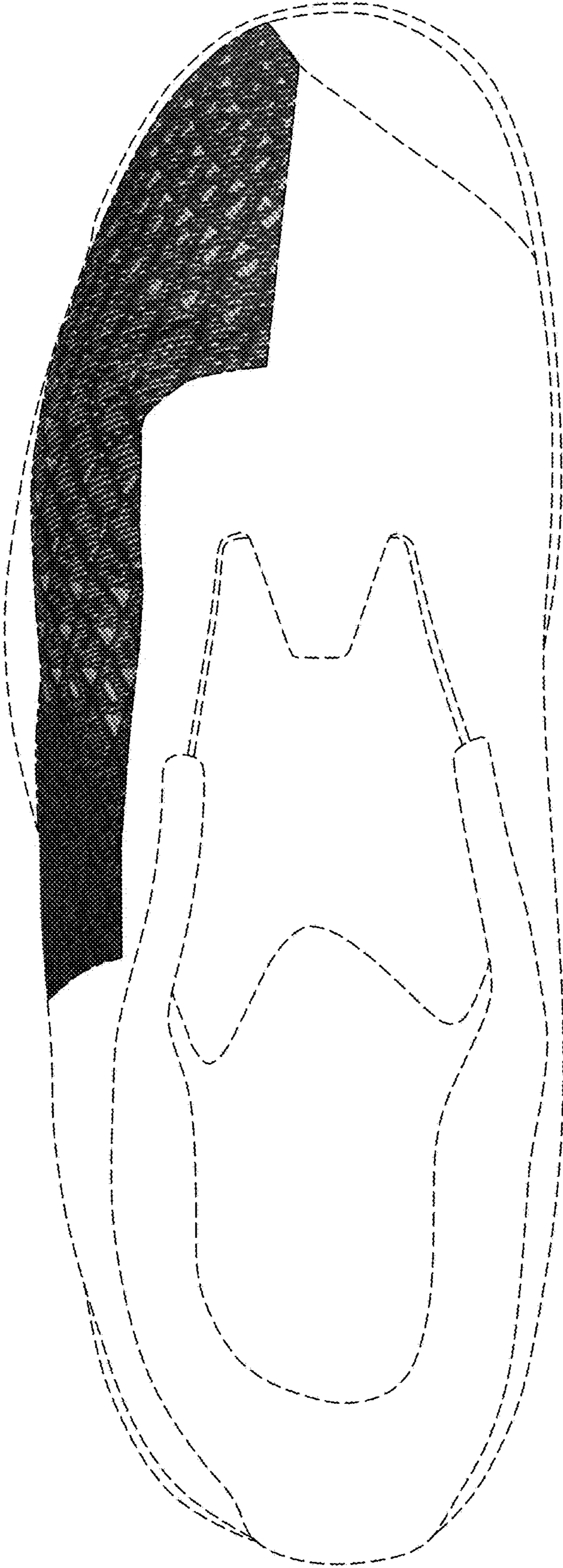

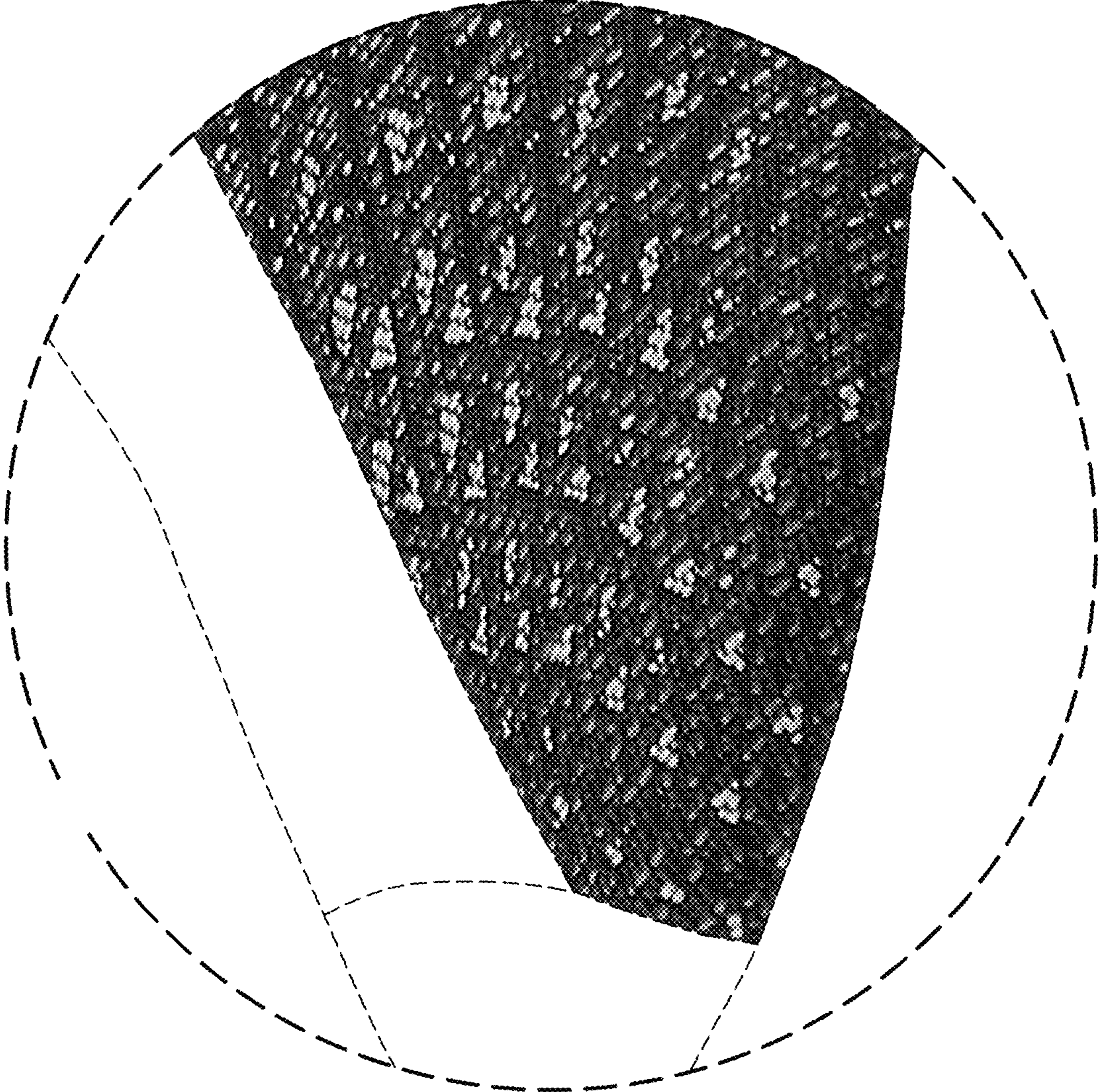
