(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a peep hole cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of a peep hole cover of our invention in use on a door shown in phantom.

FIG. 2 is a side view of a peep hole cover of our invention, in use on a door shown in phantom.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of a peep hole cover of our invention in use.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof, based on FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a front plan view thereof, based on FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a rear plan view thereof and a reverse view of FIG. 5.

FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof, based on FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is a right side view thereof, and a reverse view of FIG. 7.

FIG. 9 is a perspective, exploded view of a peep hole cover of our invention.

FIG. 10 is a front view of a peep hole cover showing our new design, the only difference being the elliptical shape;

FIG. 11 is a front view of a peep hole cover showing our new design, the only difference being the octagonal shape;

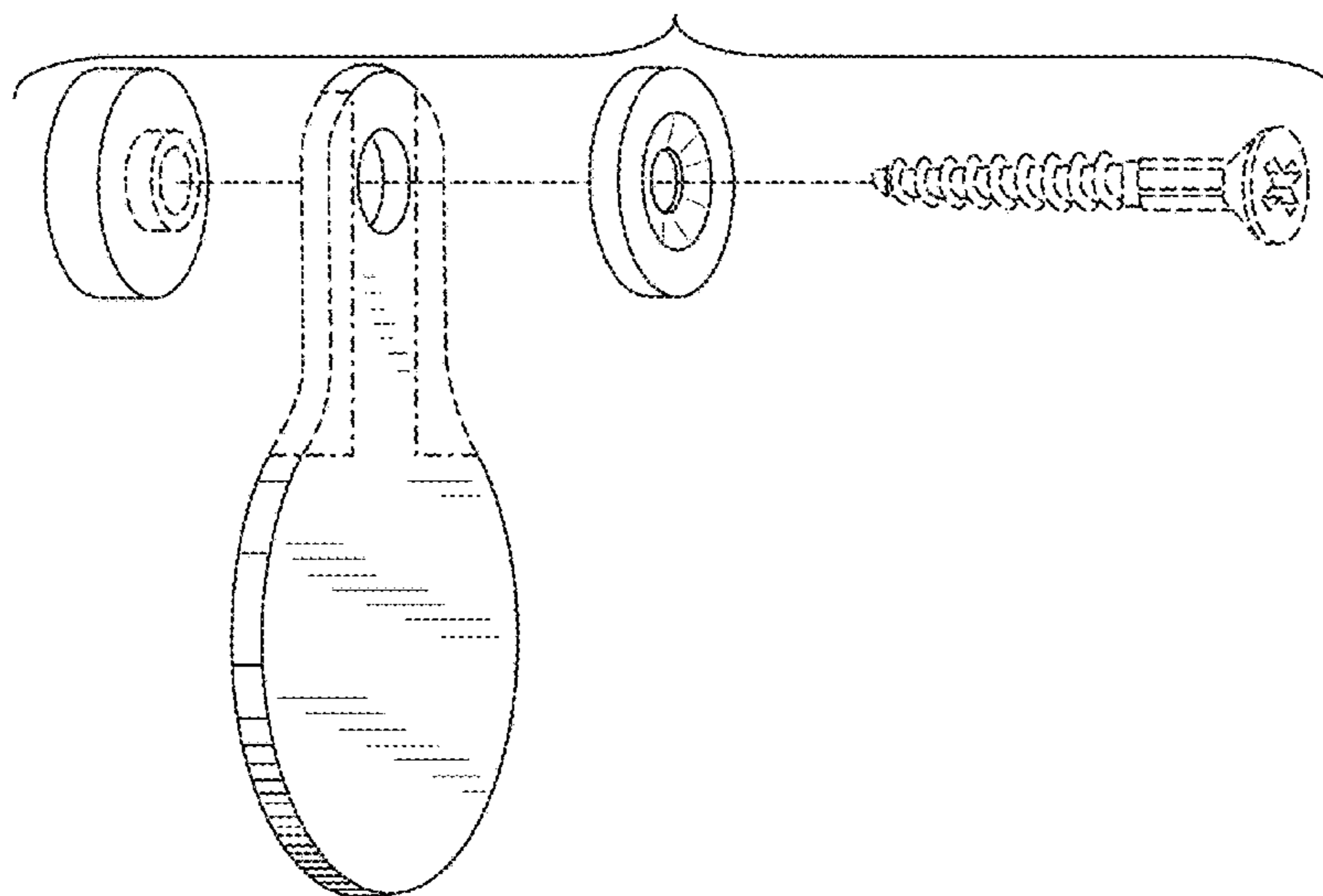
FIG. 12 is a front view of a peep hole cover showing our new design, the only difference being the diamond shape;

FIG. 13 is a front view of a peep hole cover showing our new design, the only difference being the square shape; and,

FIG. 14 is a front view of a peep hole cover showing our new design, the only difference being the triangular shape.

The broken lines immediately adjacent the shaded areas represent bounds of the claimed design while all other broken lines depict environment that forms no part of the claimed design.

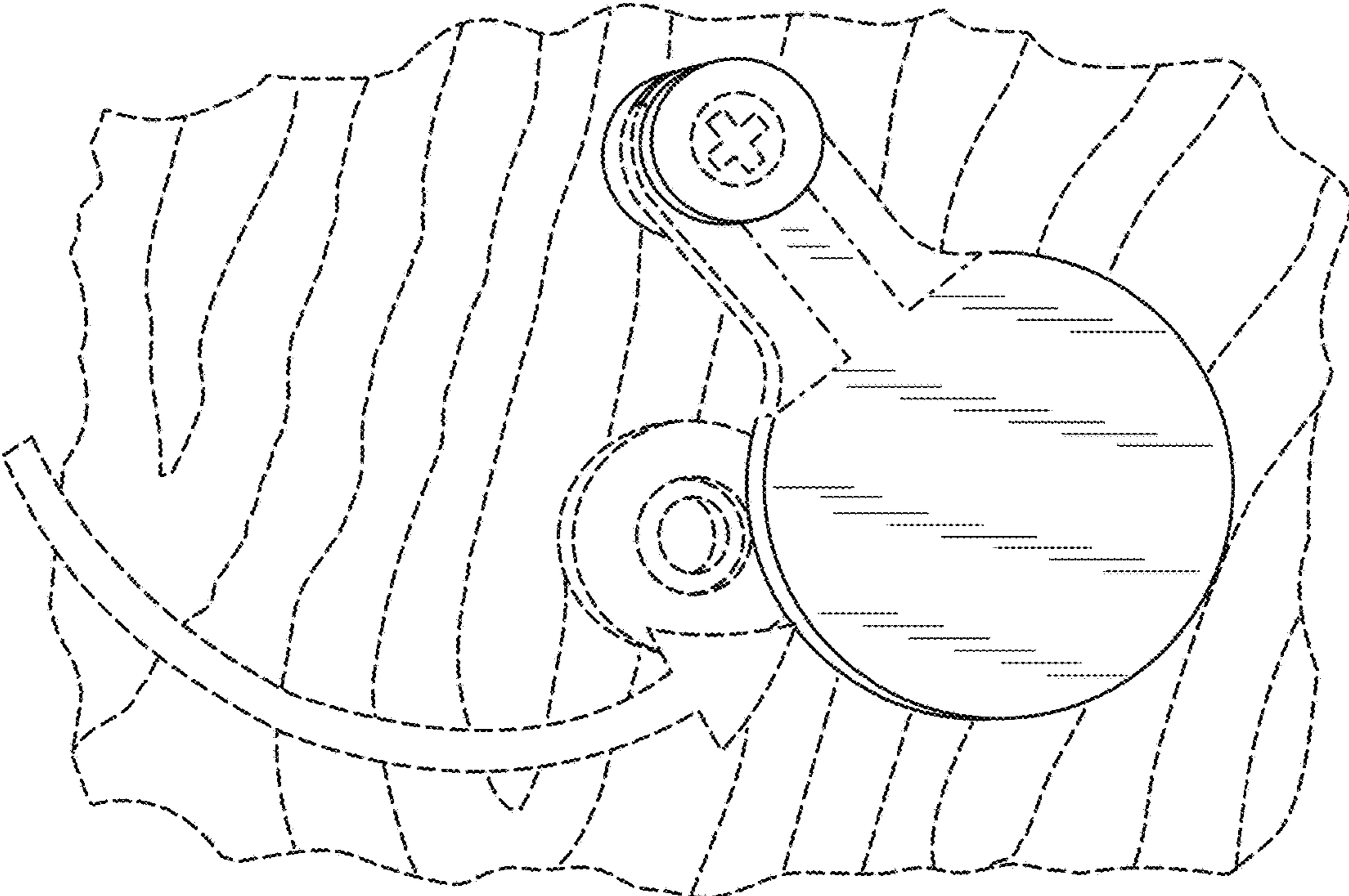

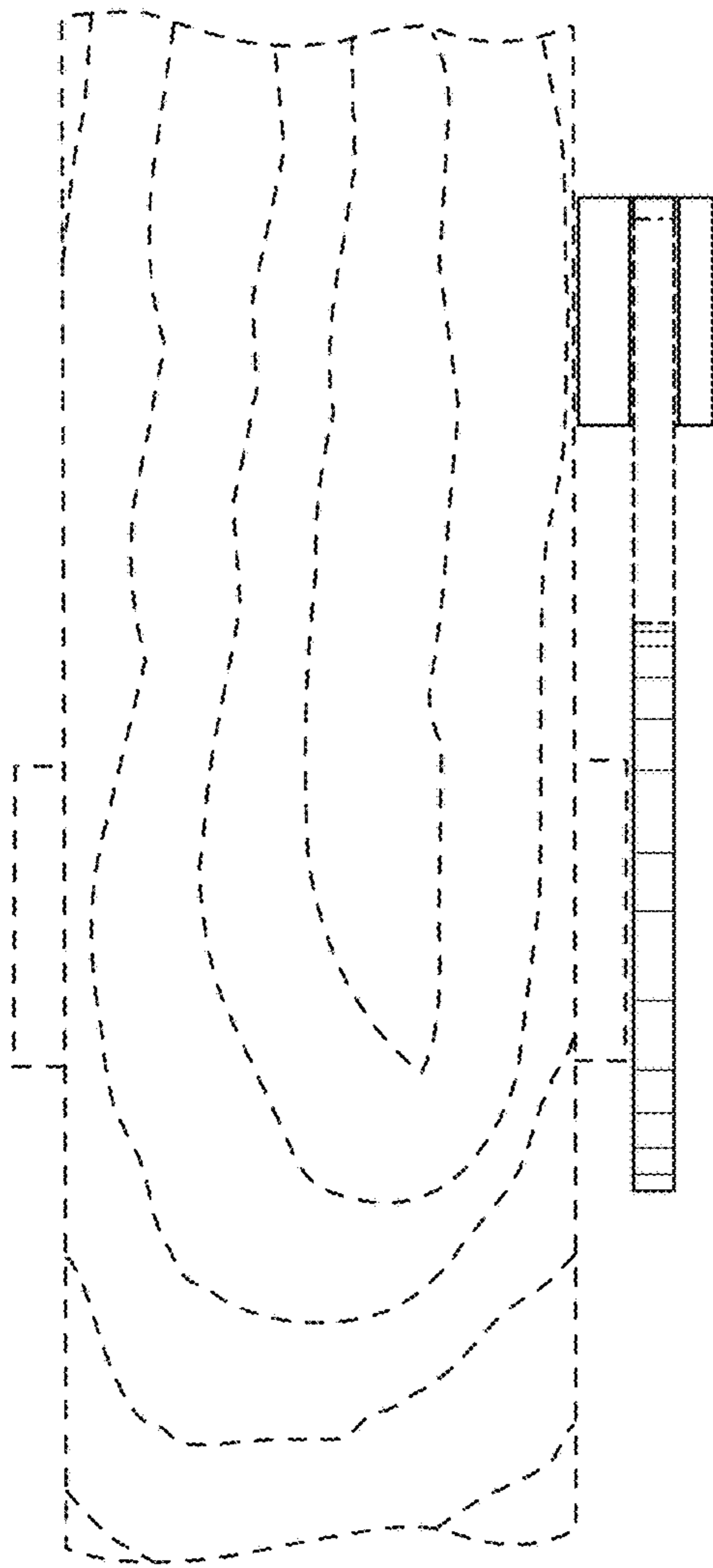

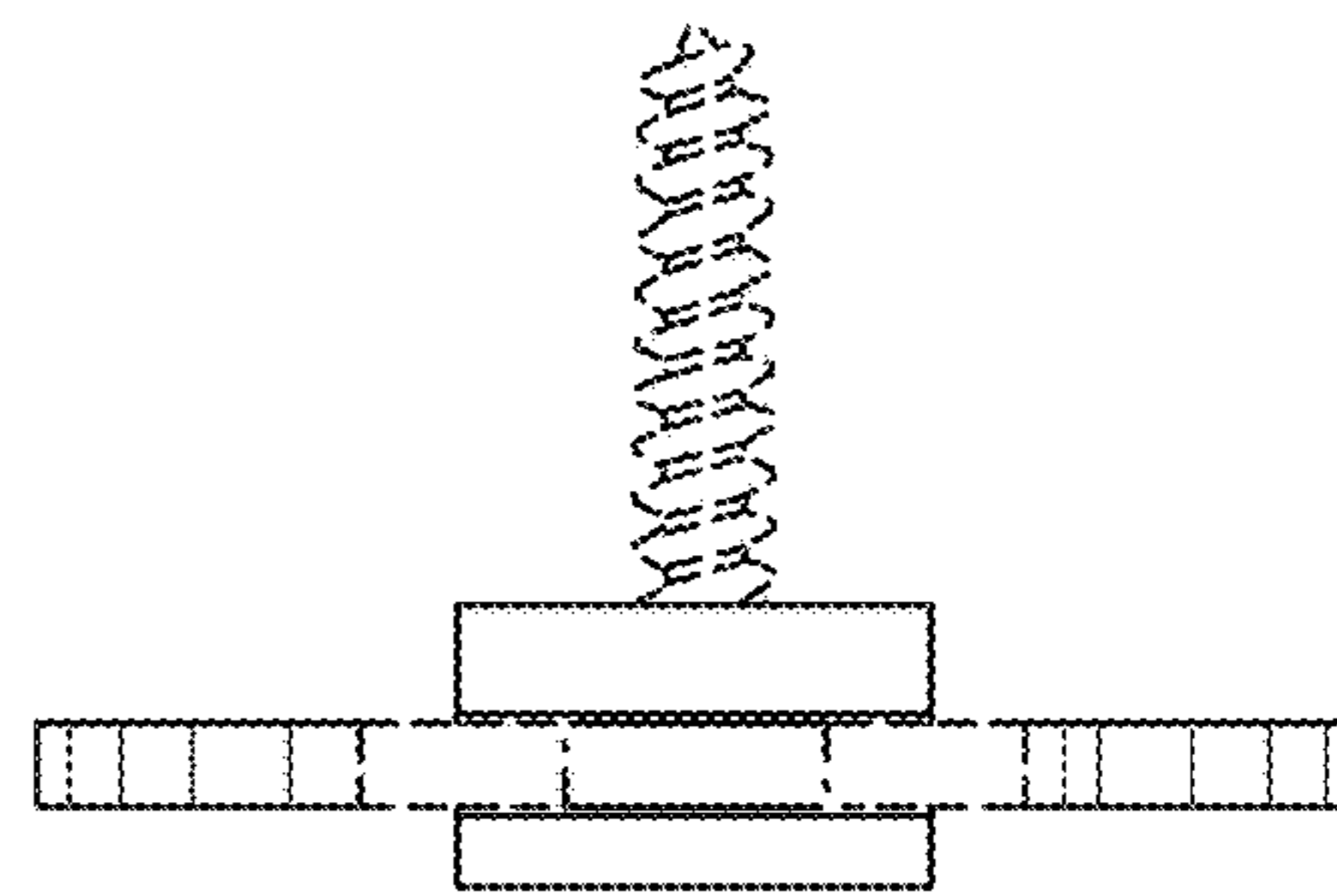

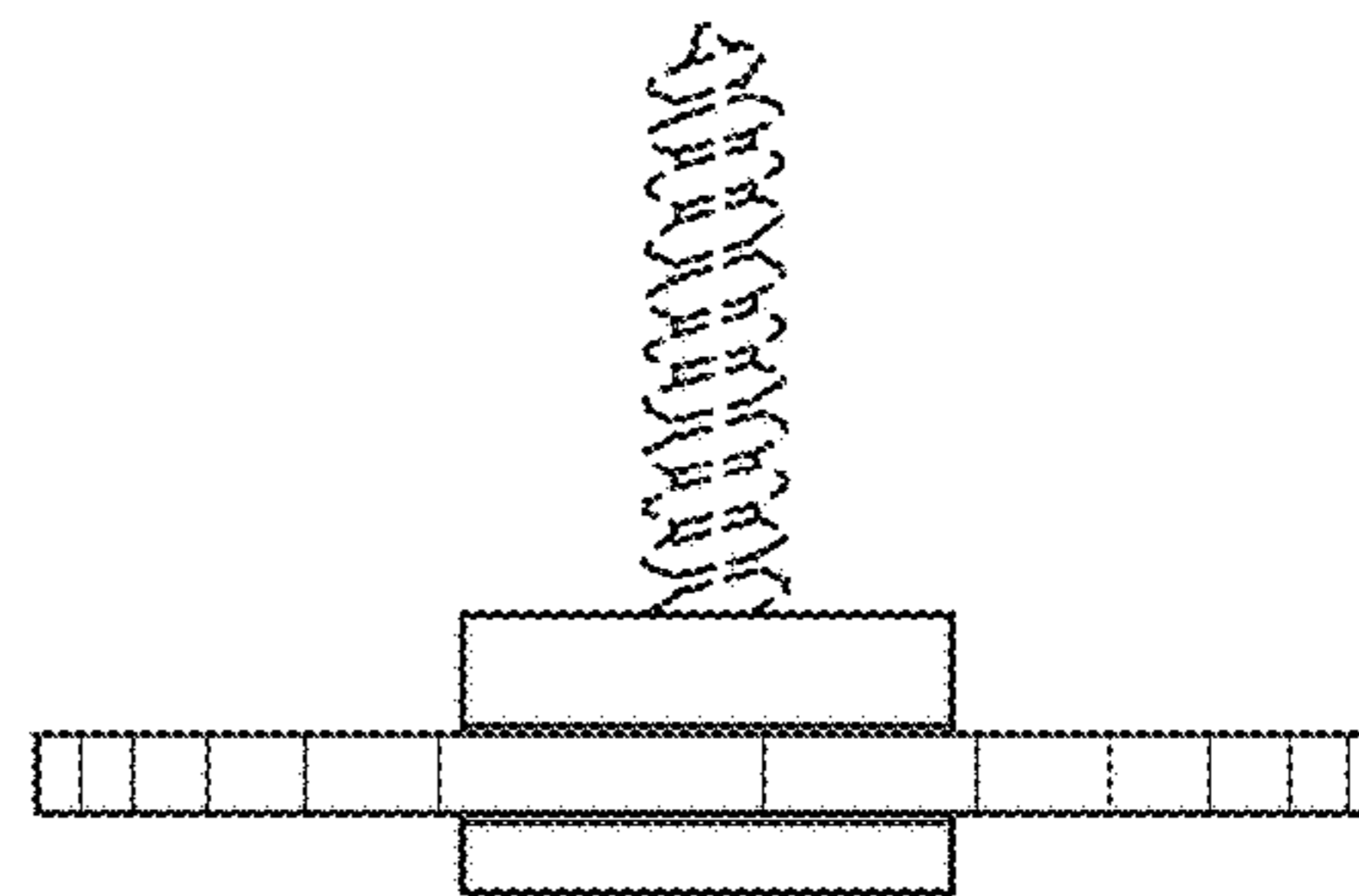

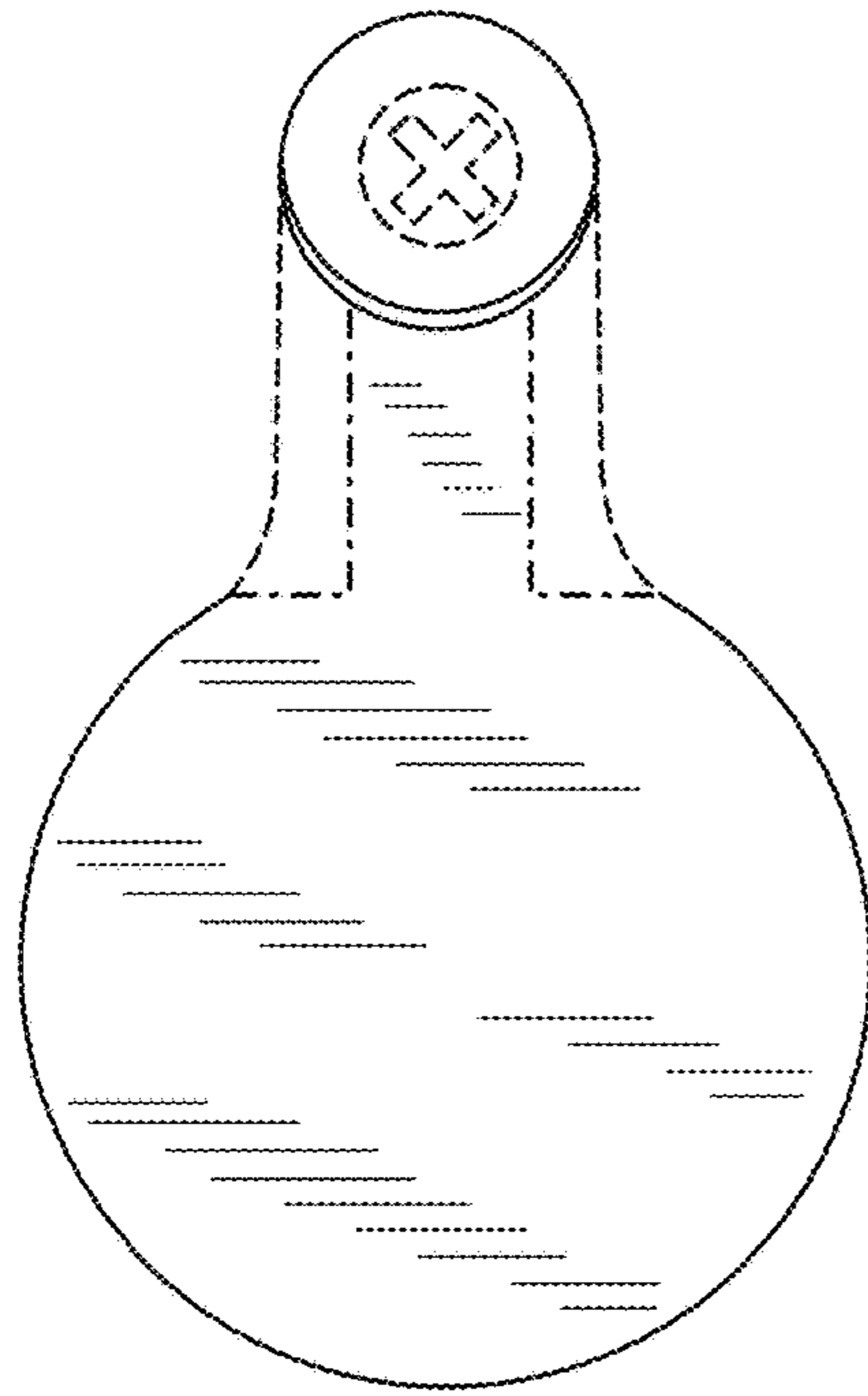

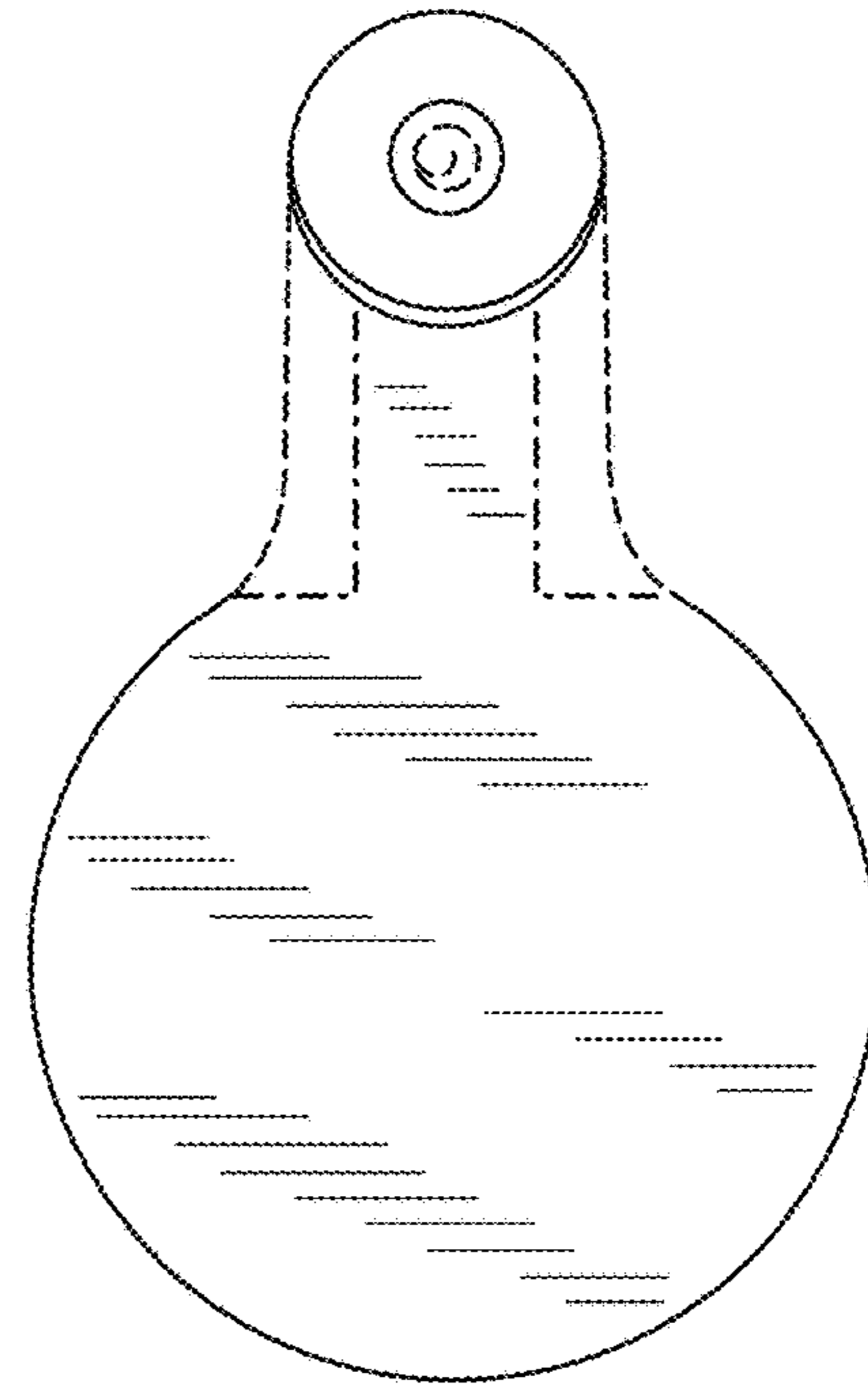

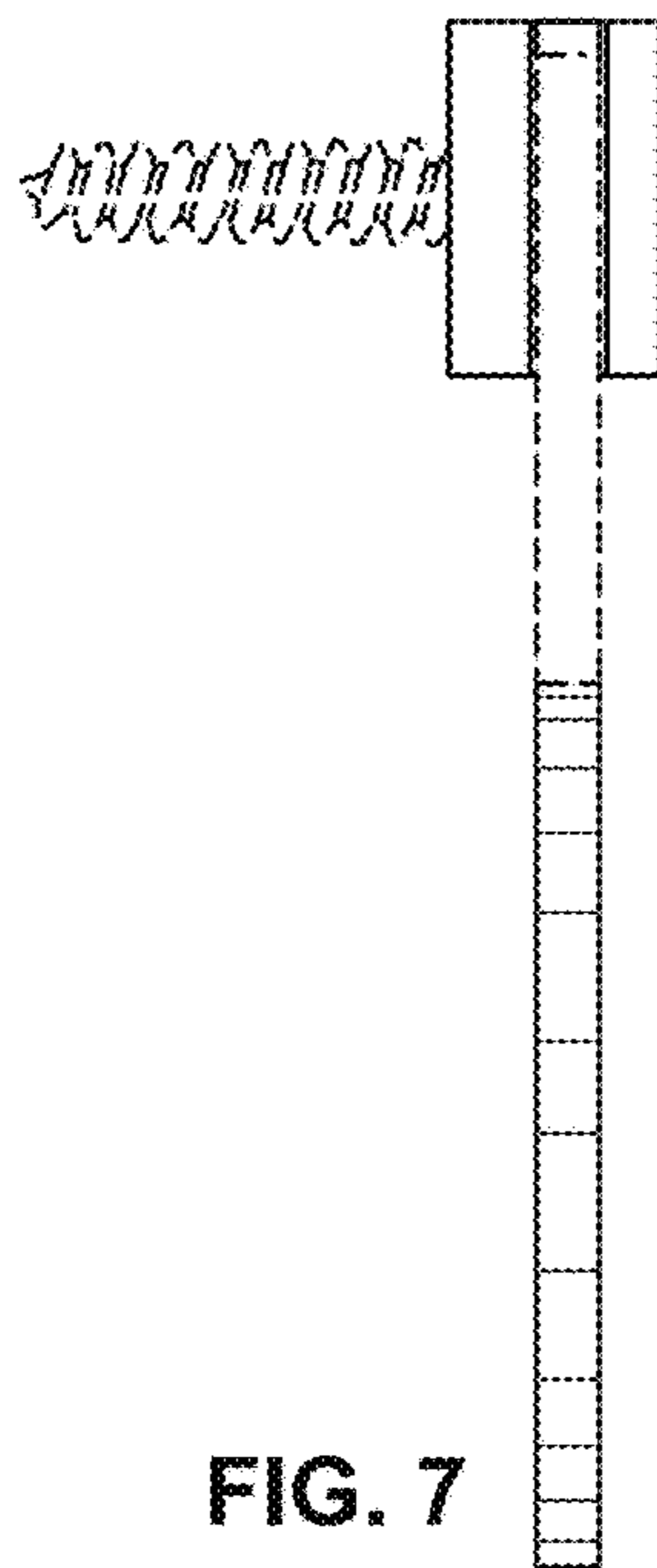

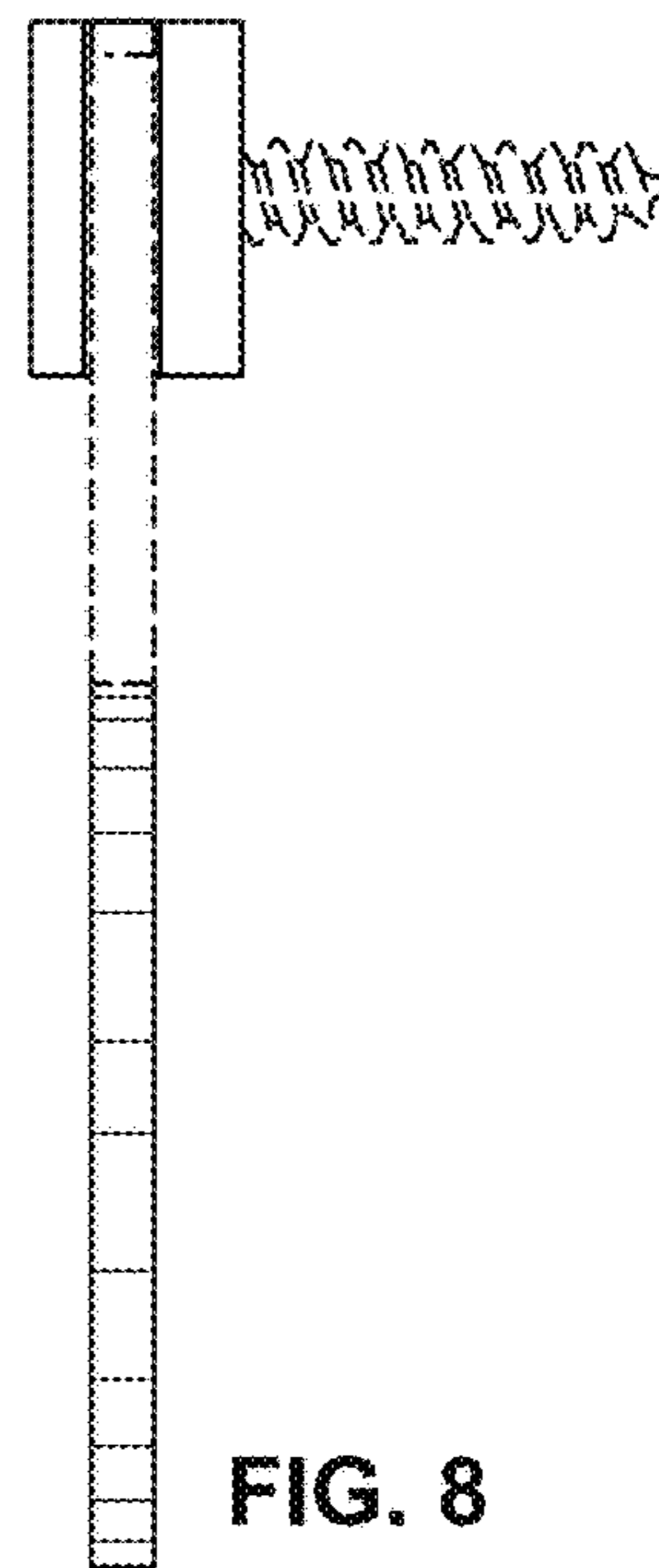
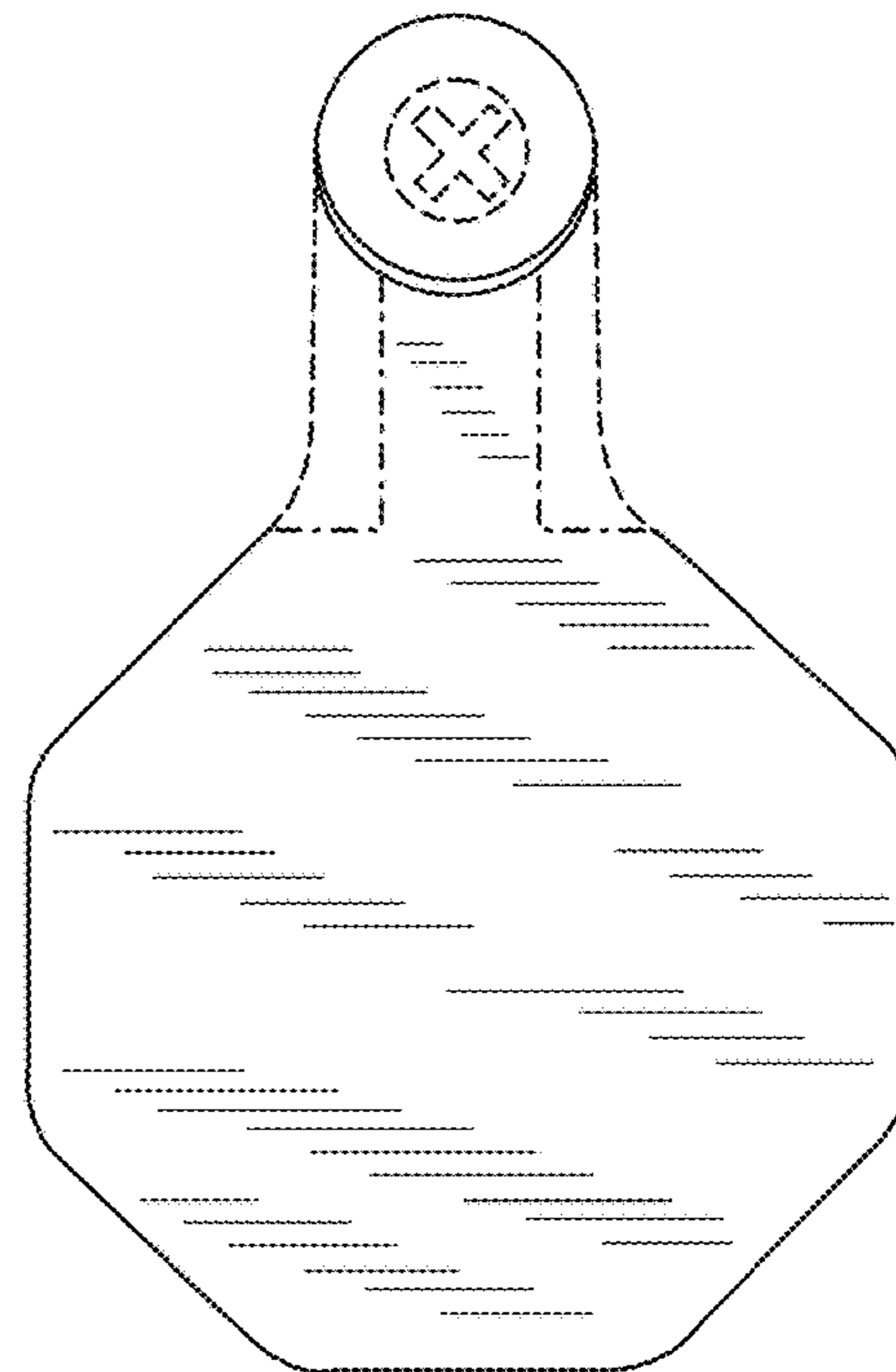
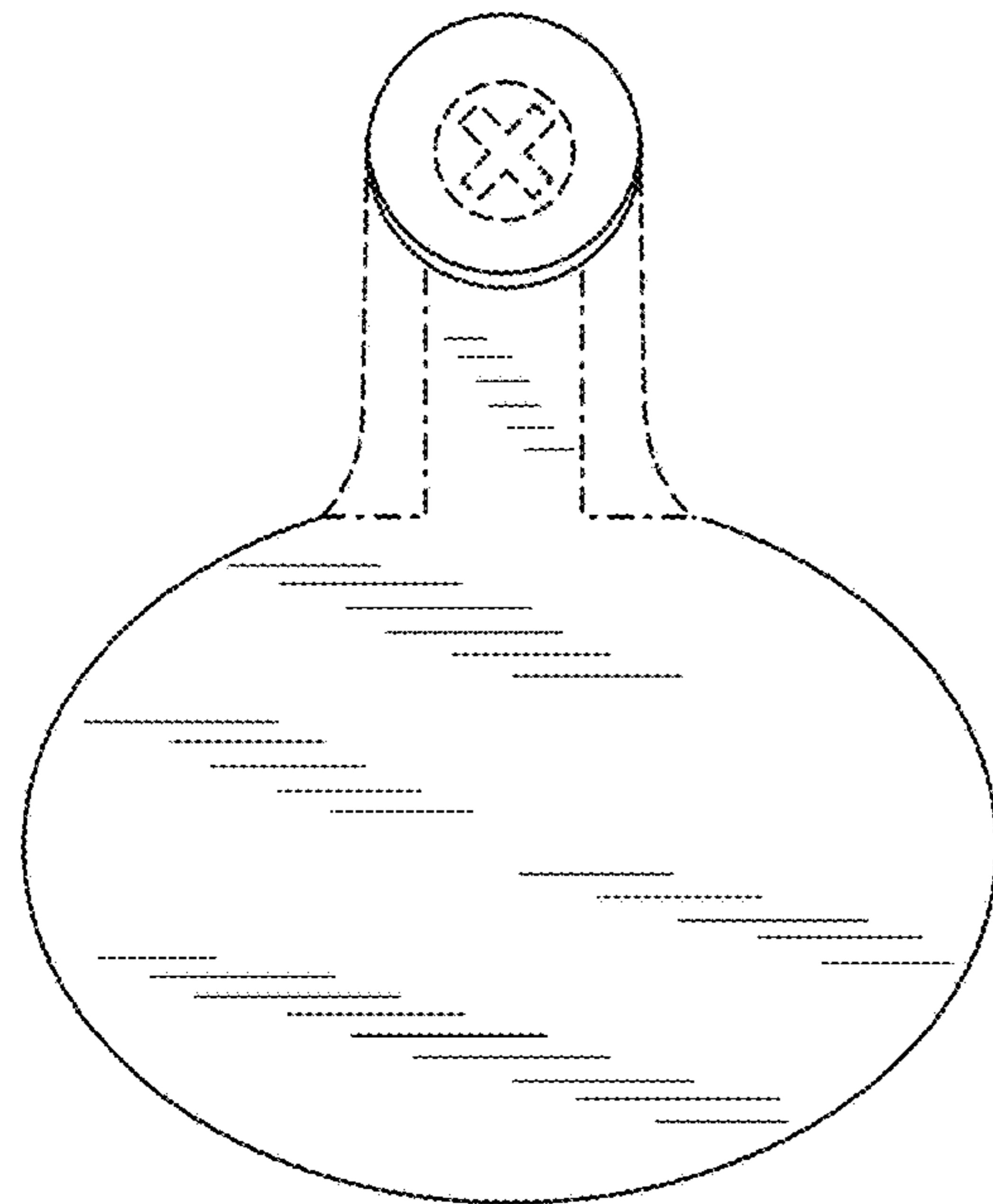
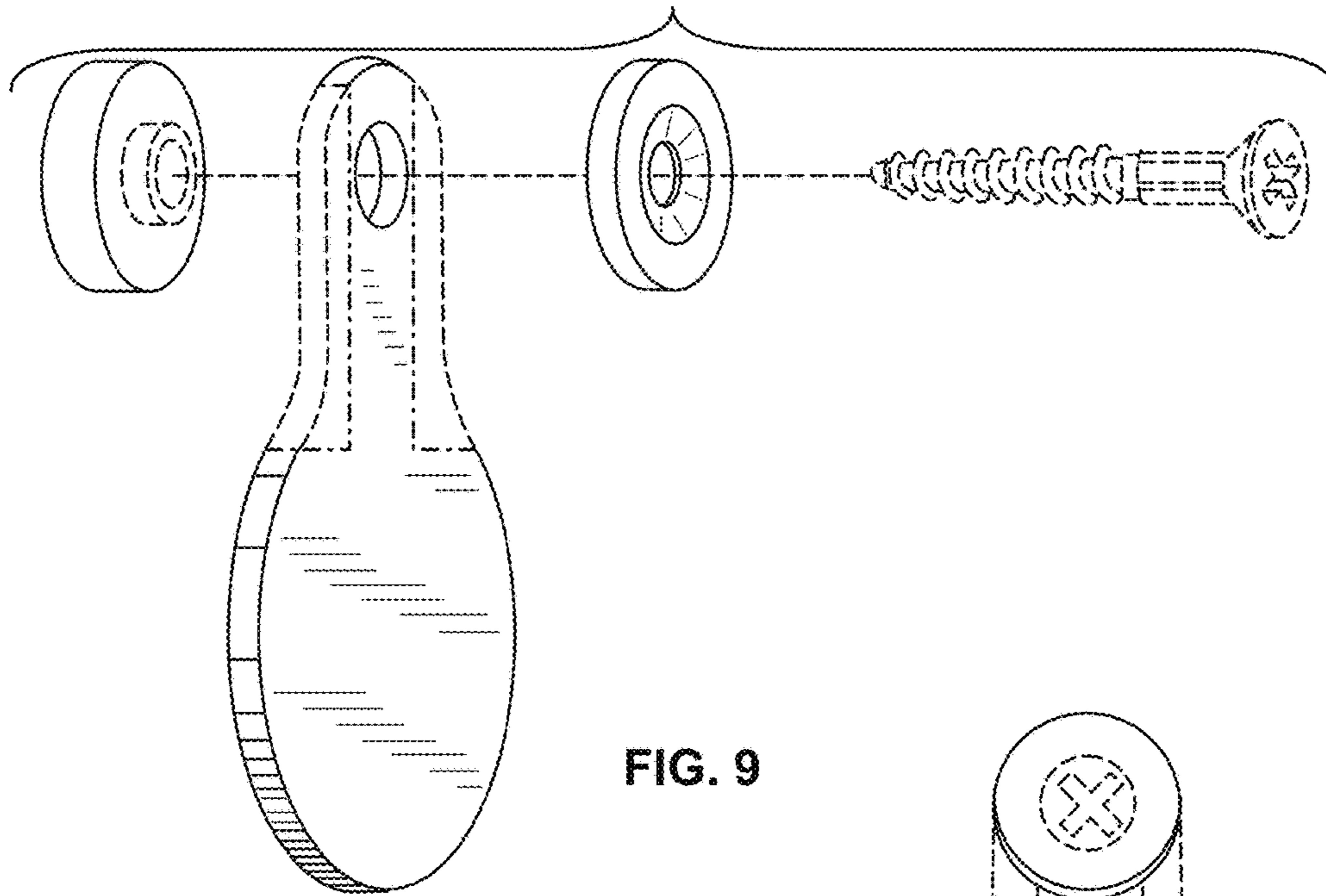

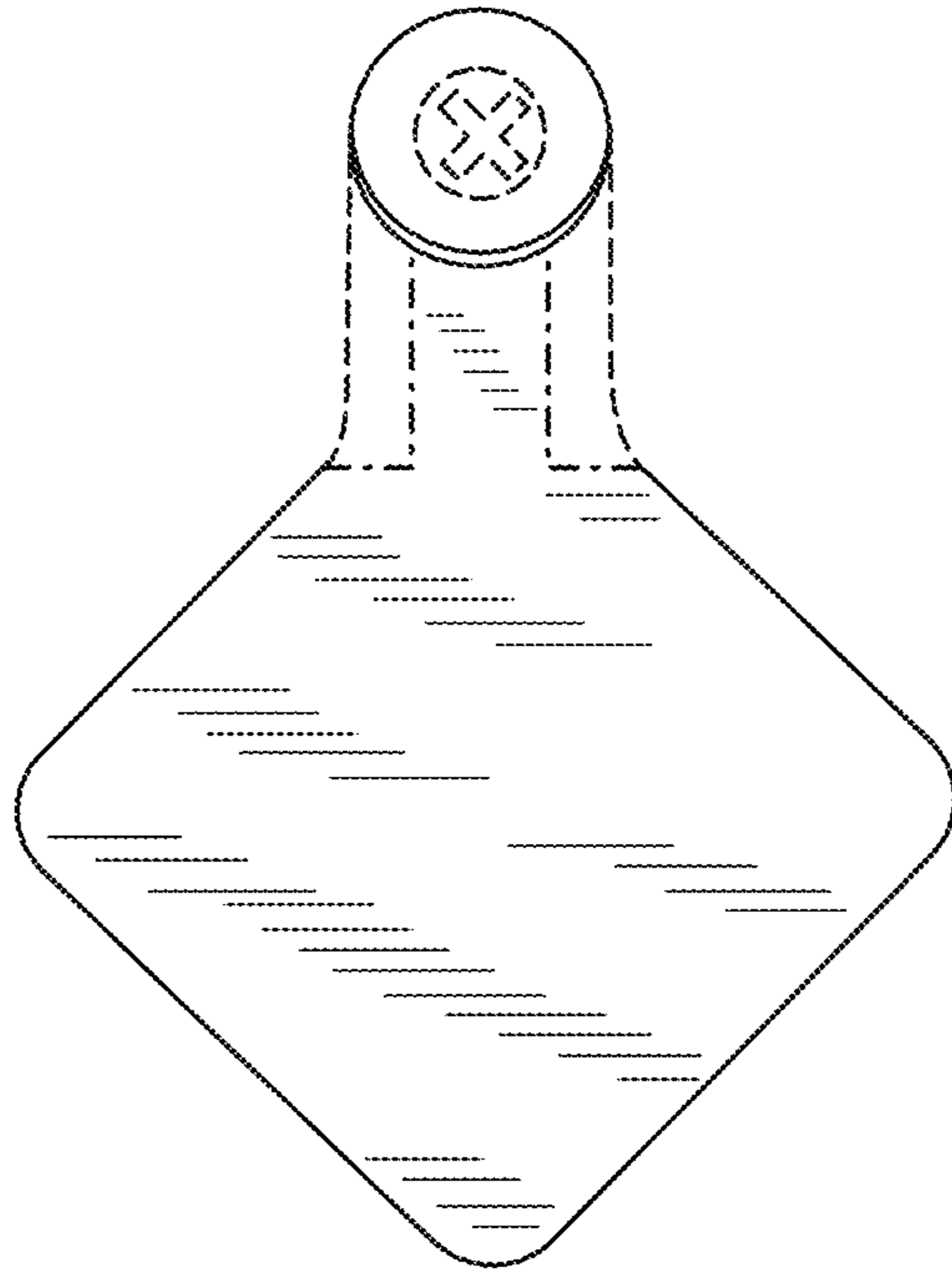

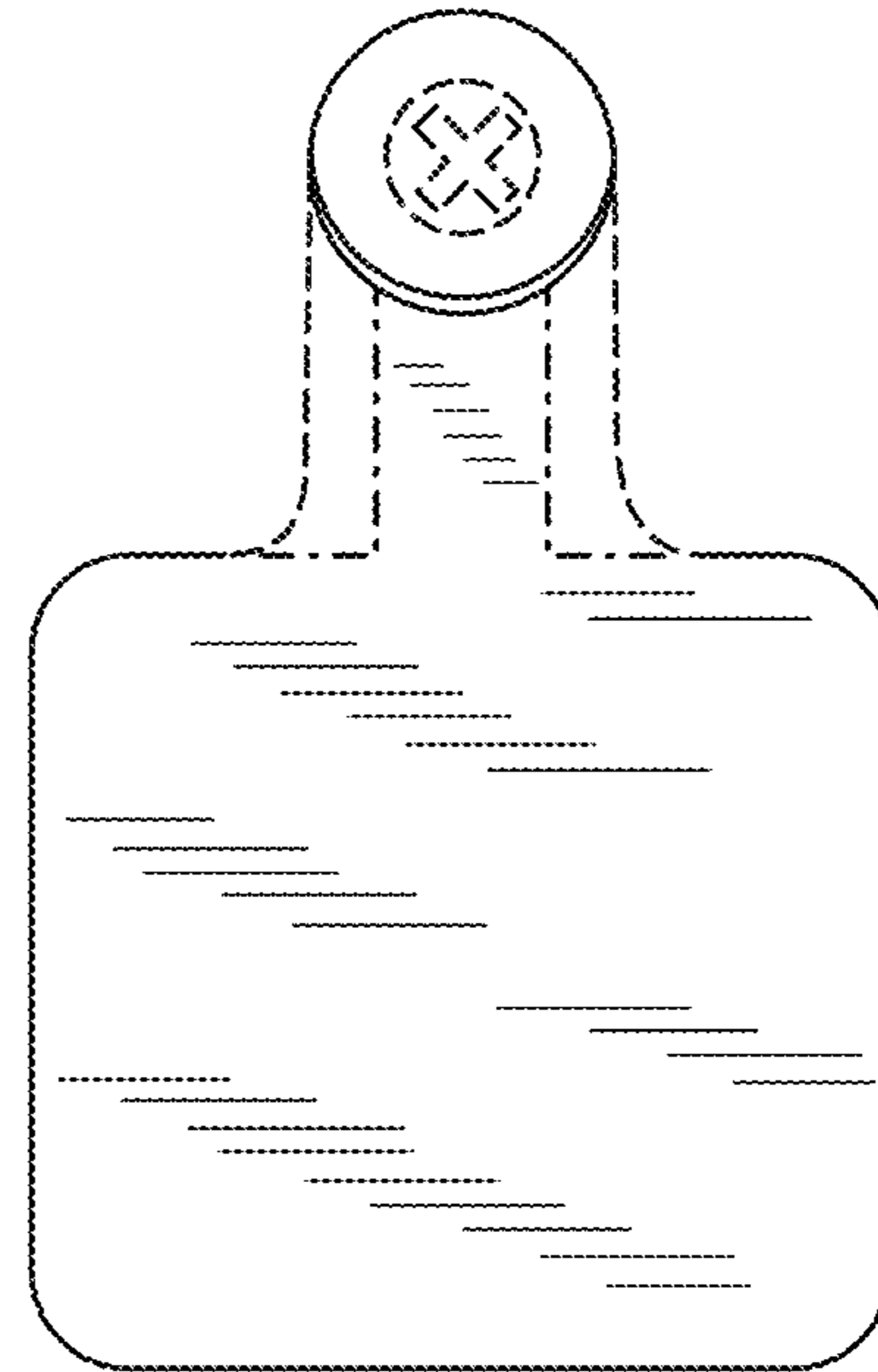

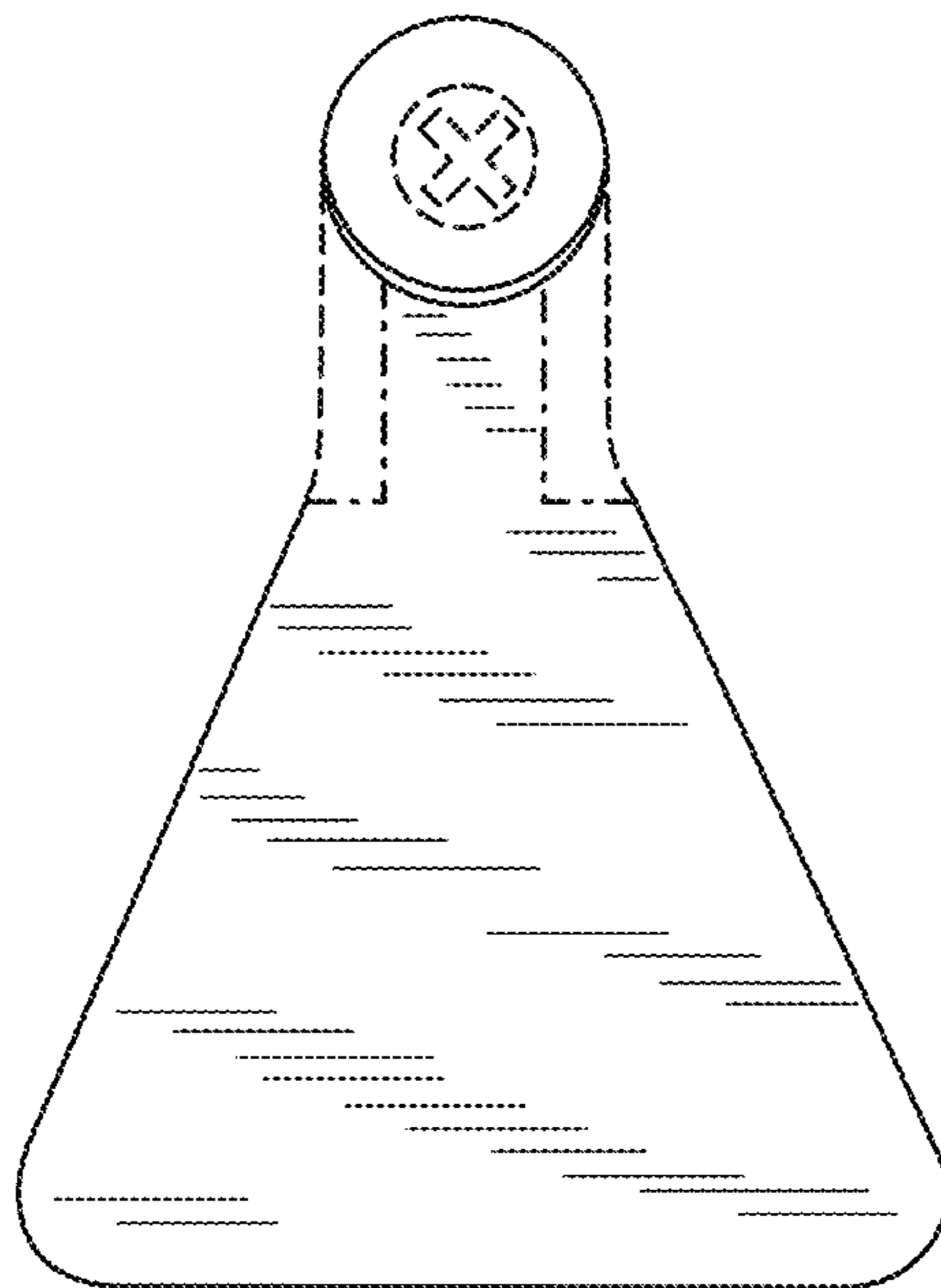
