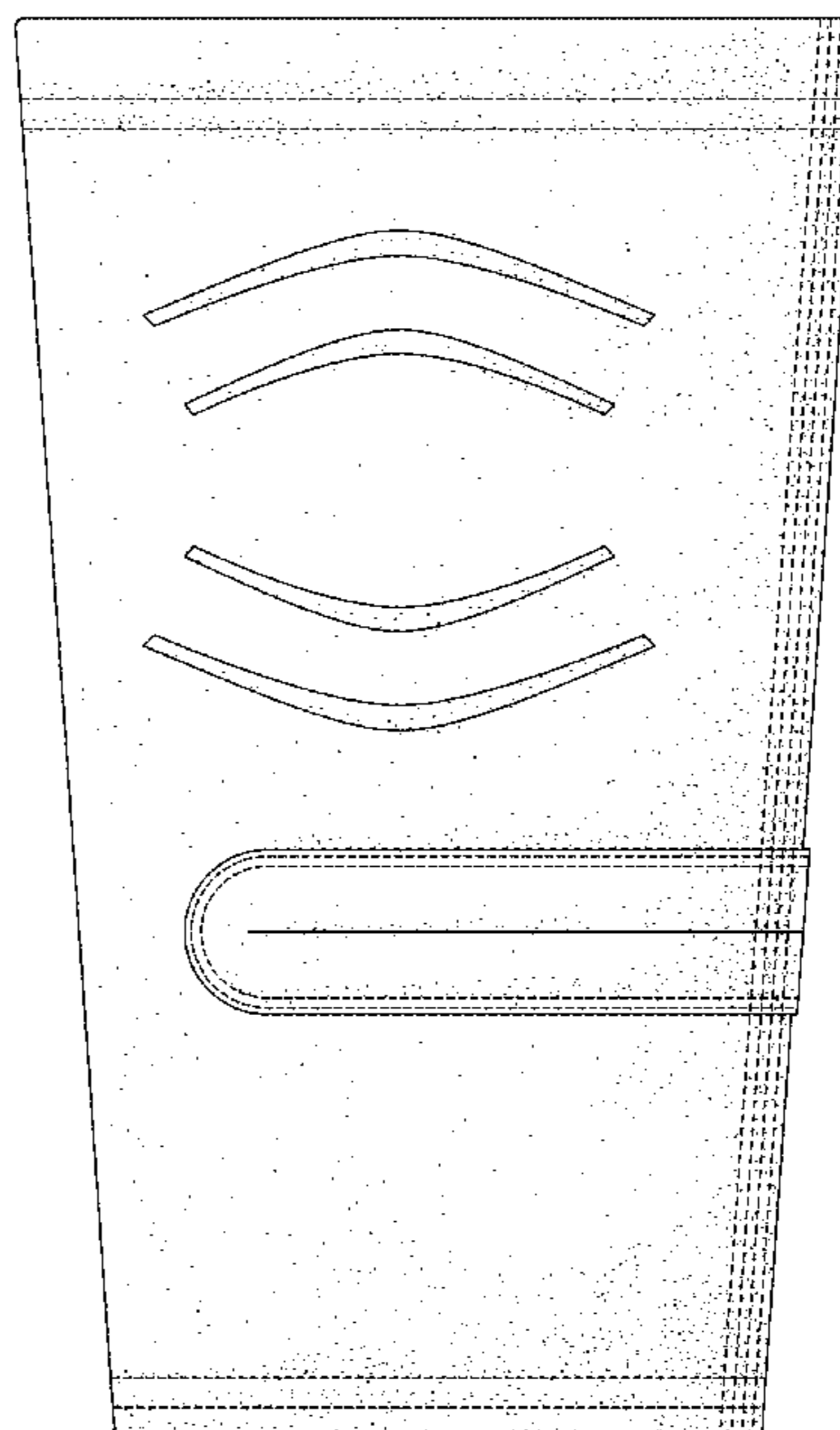
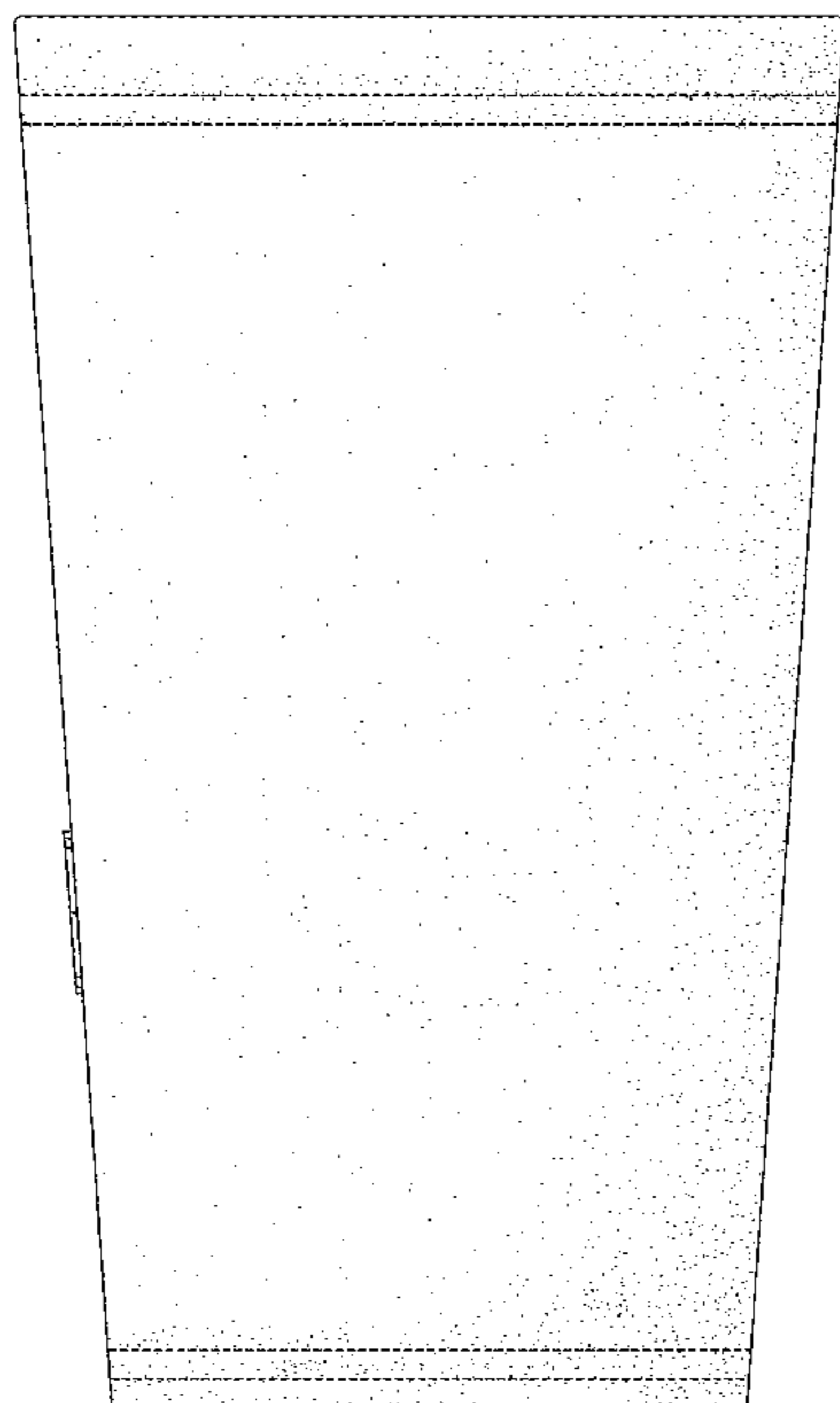
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an ankle sleeve of the present invention showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front side elevation view thereof;

 FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof;

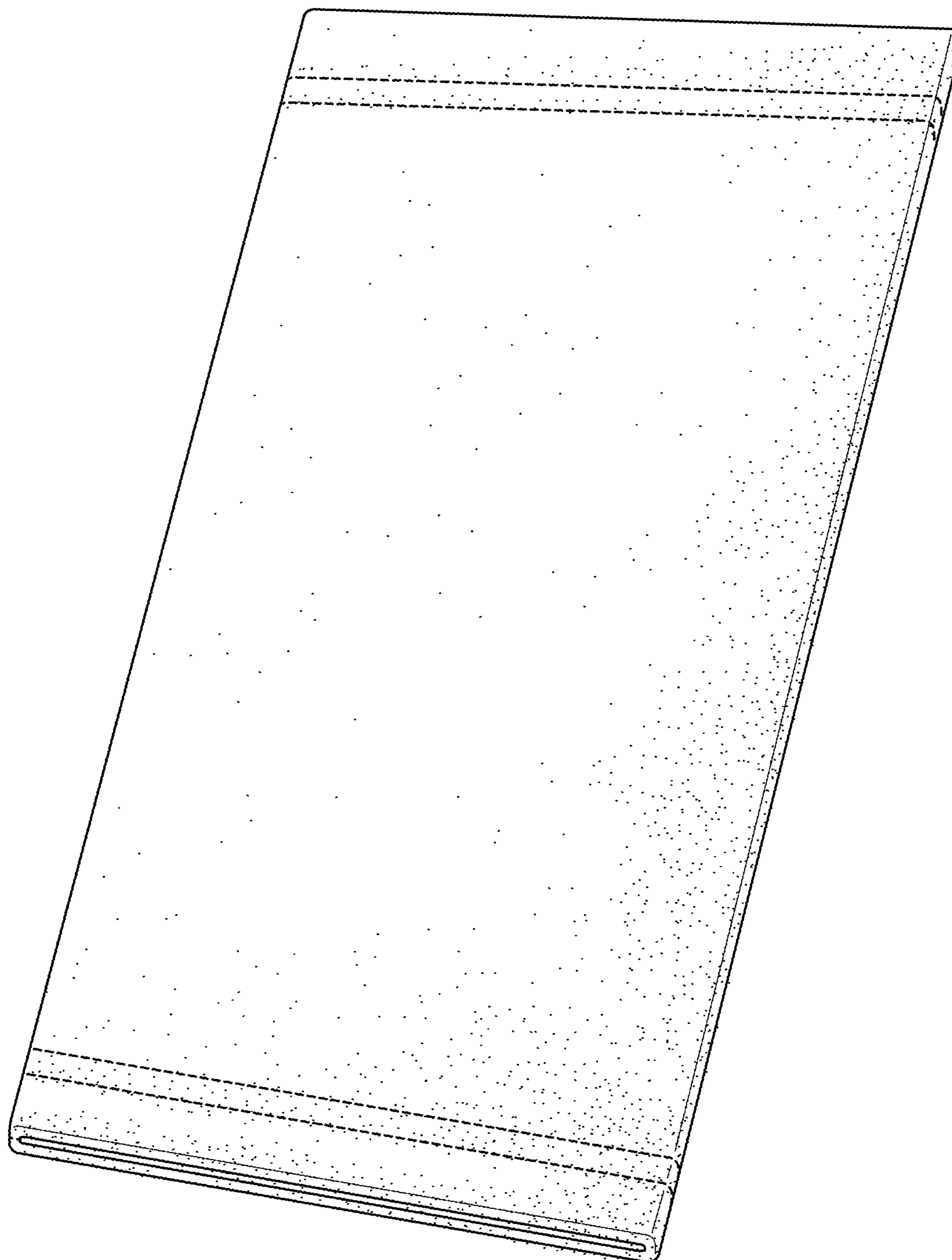

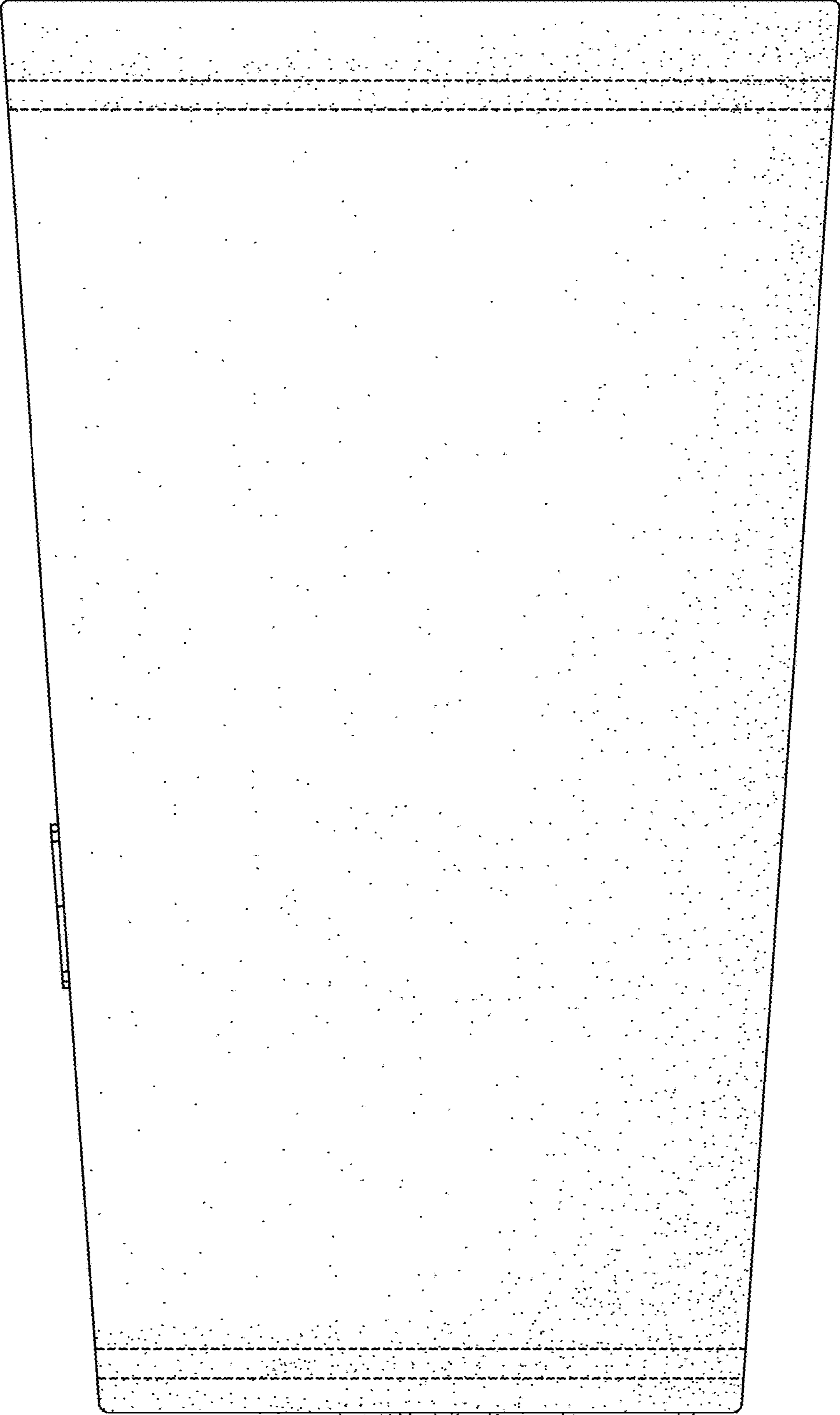

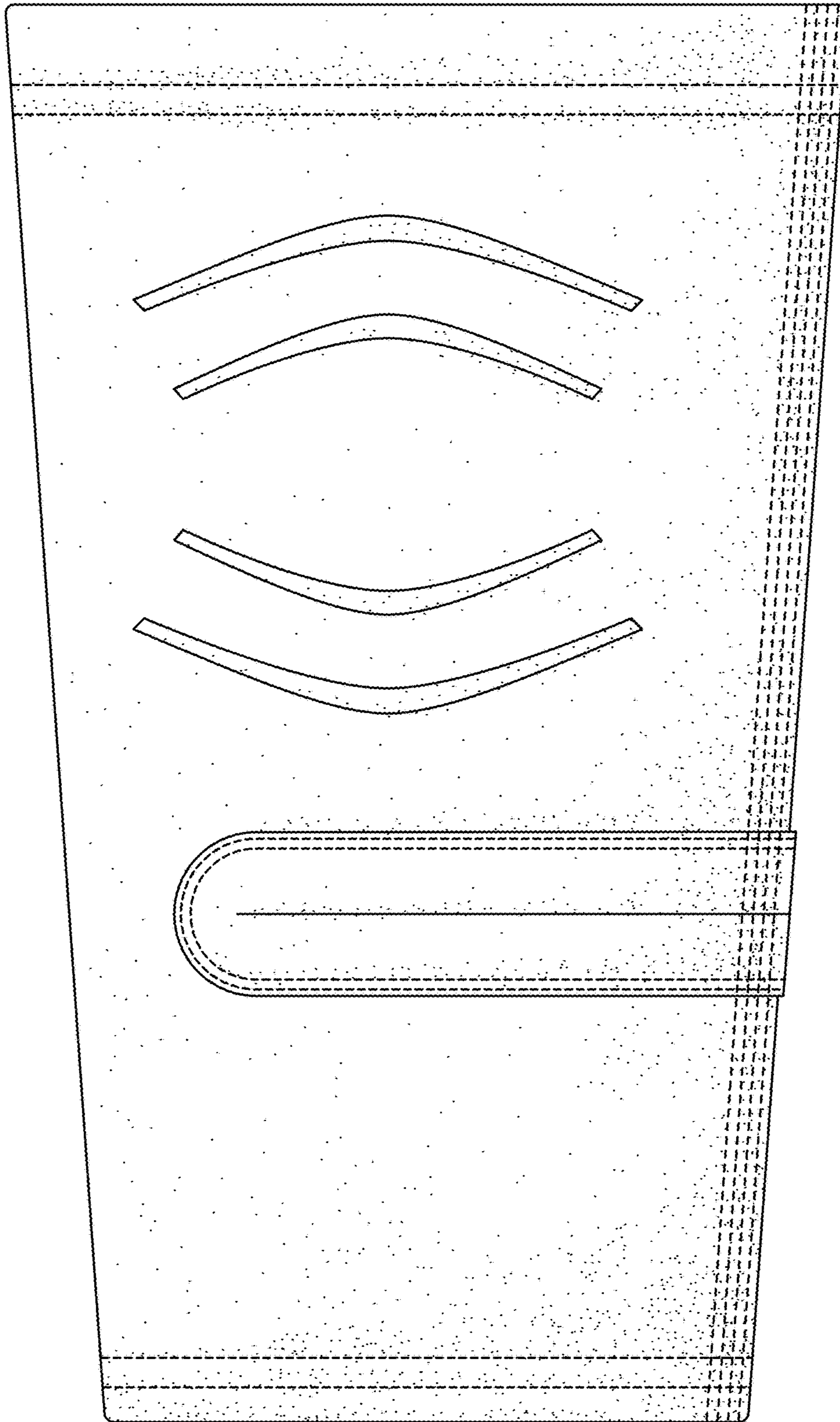

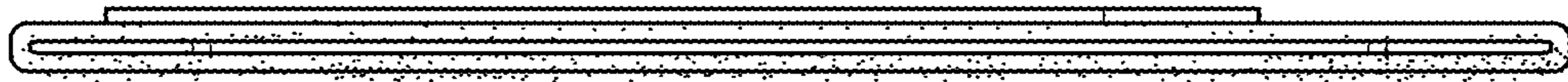

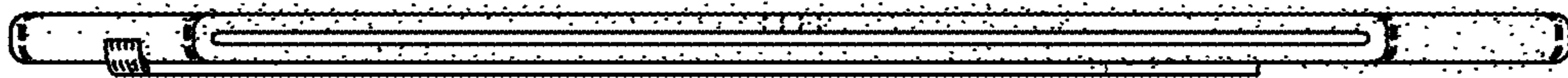

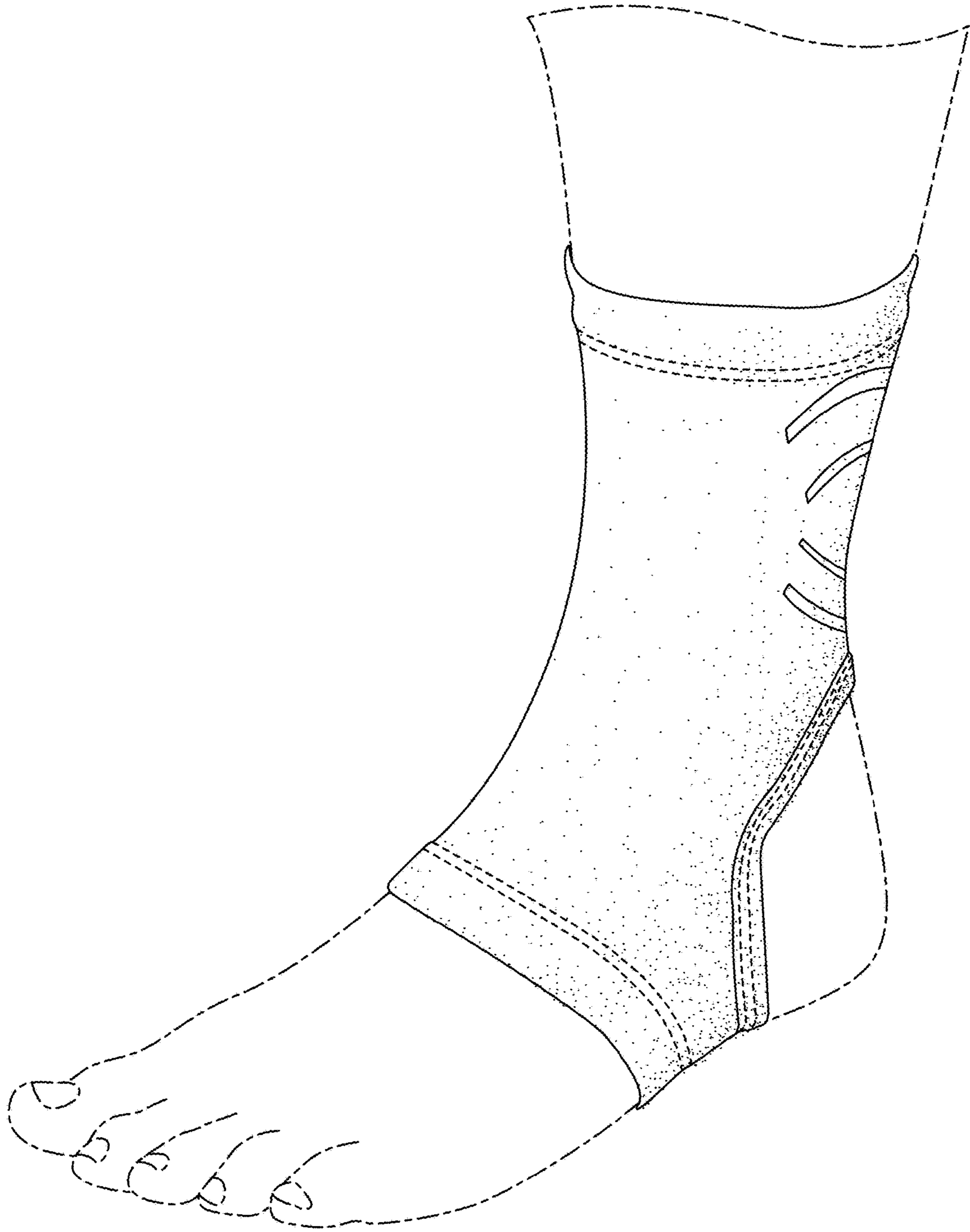
