FIG. 1 is a front view of the article in which the design is embedded;

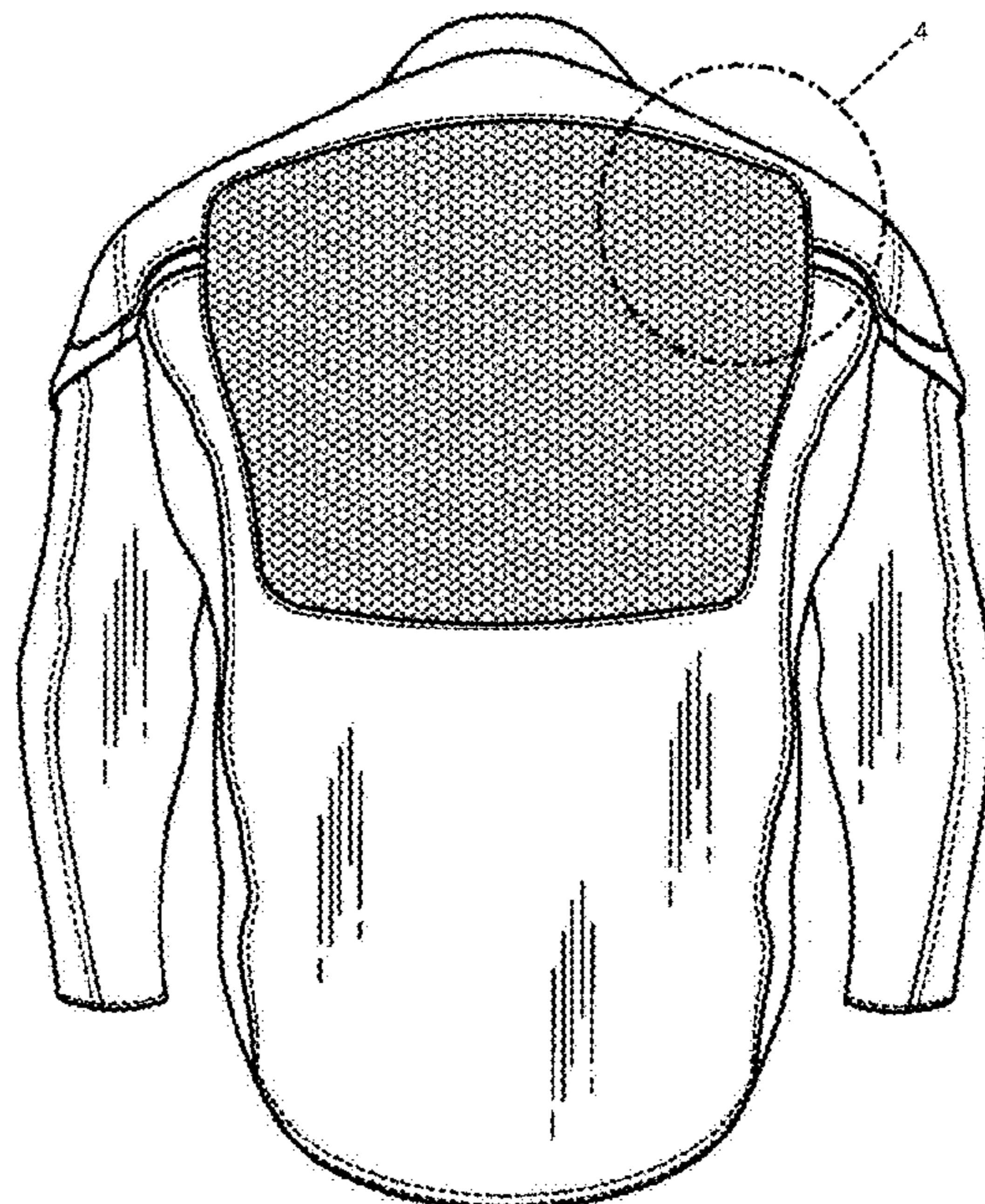
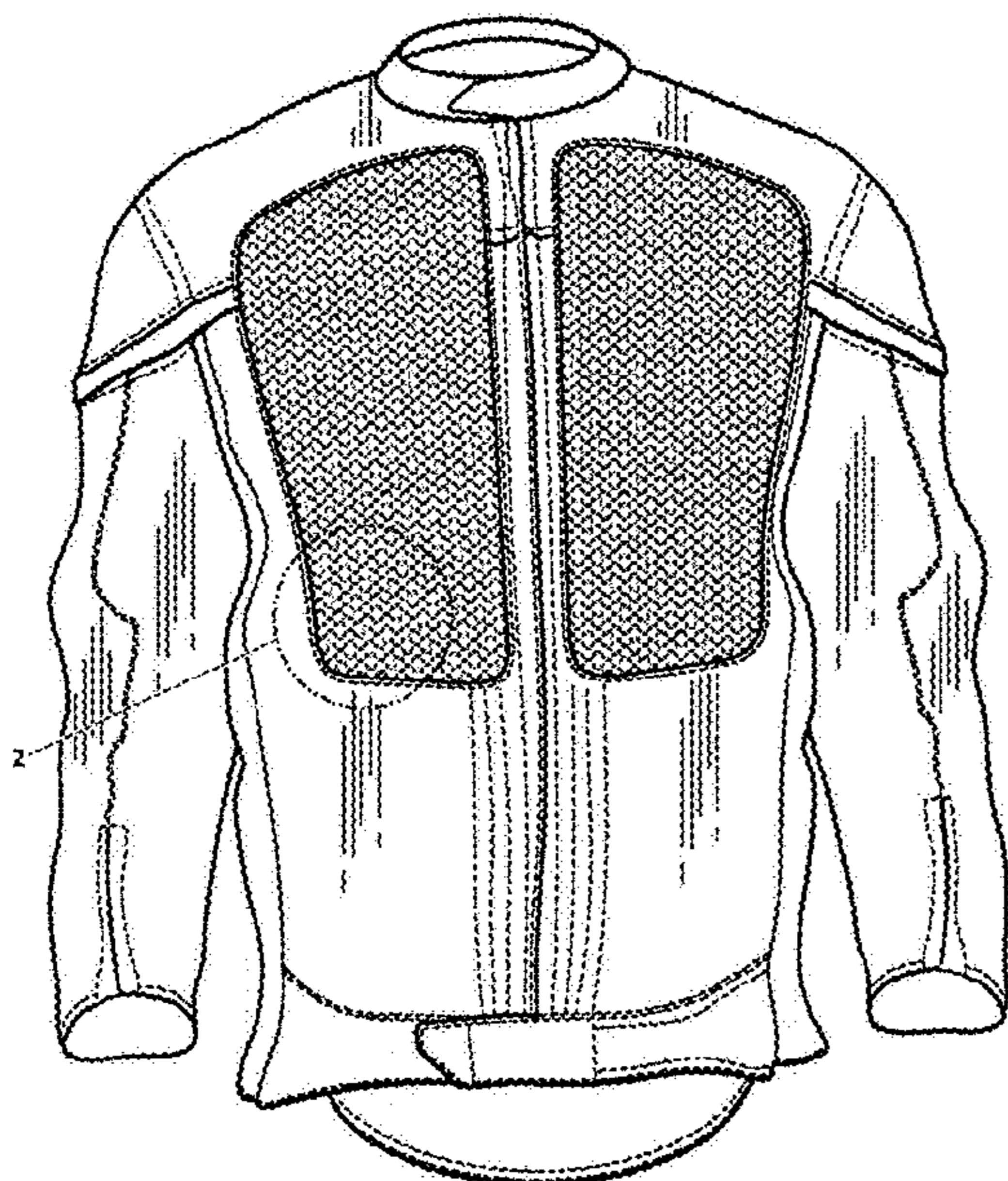
FIG. 2 is an enlarged detail view of a portion of FIG. 1;

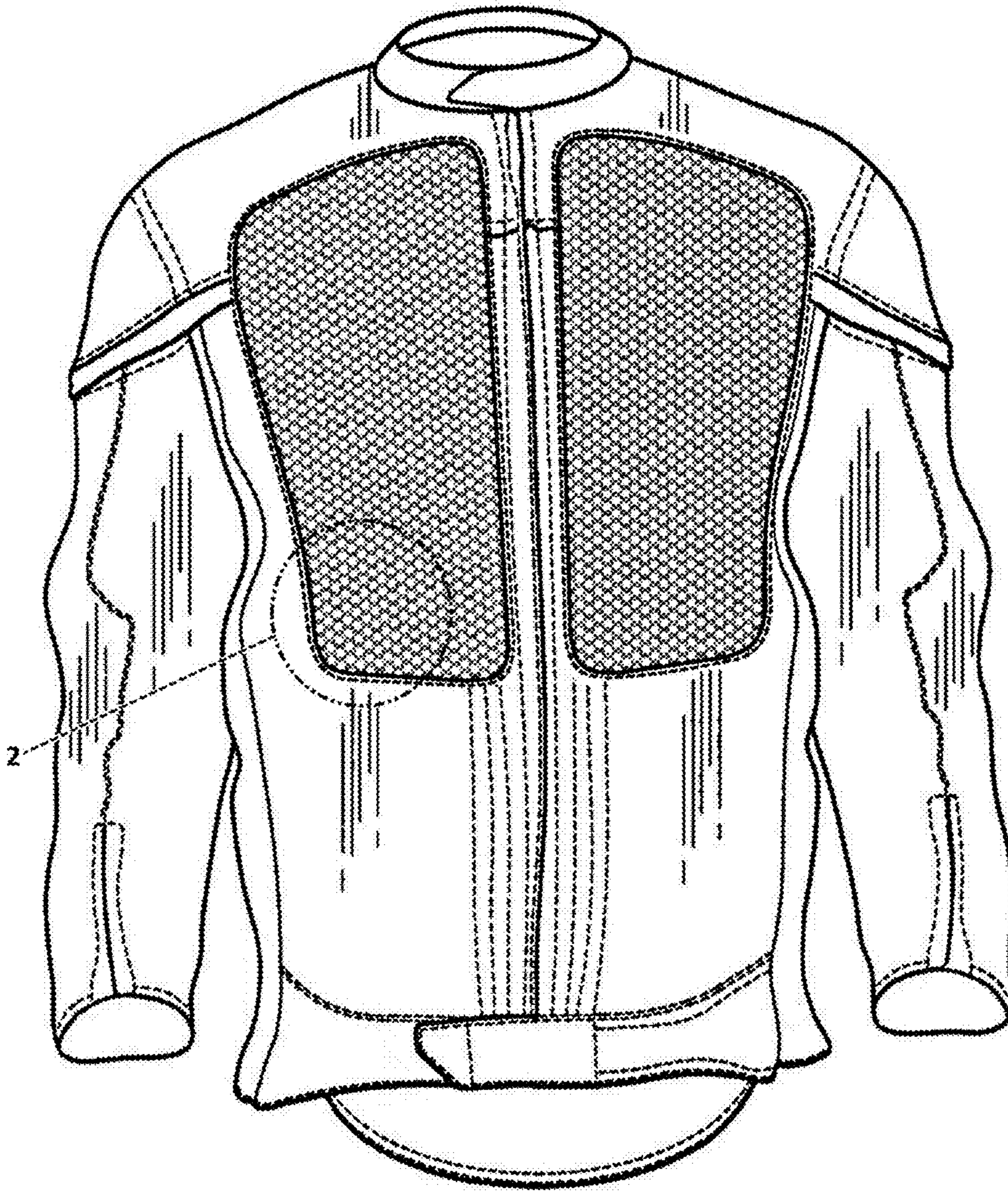

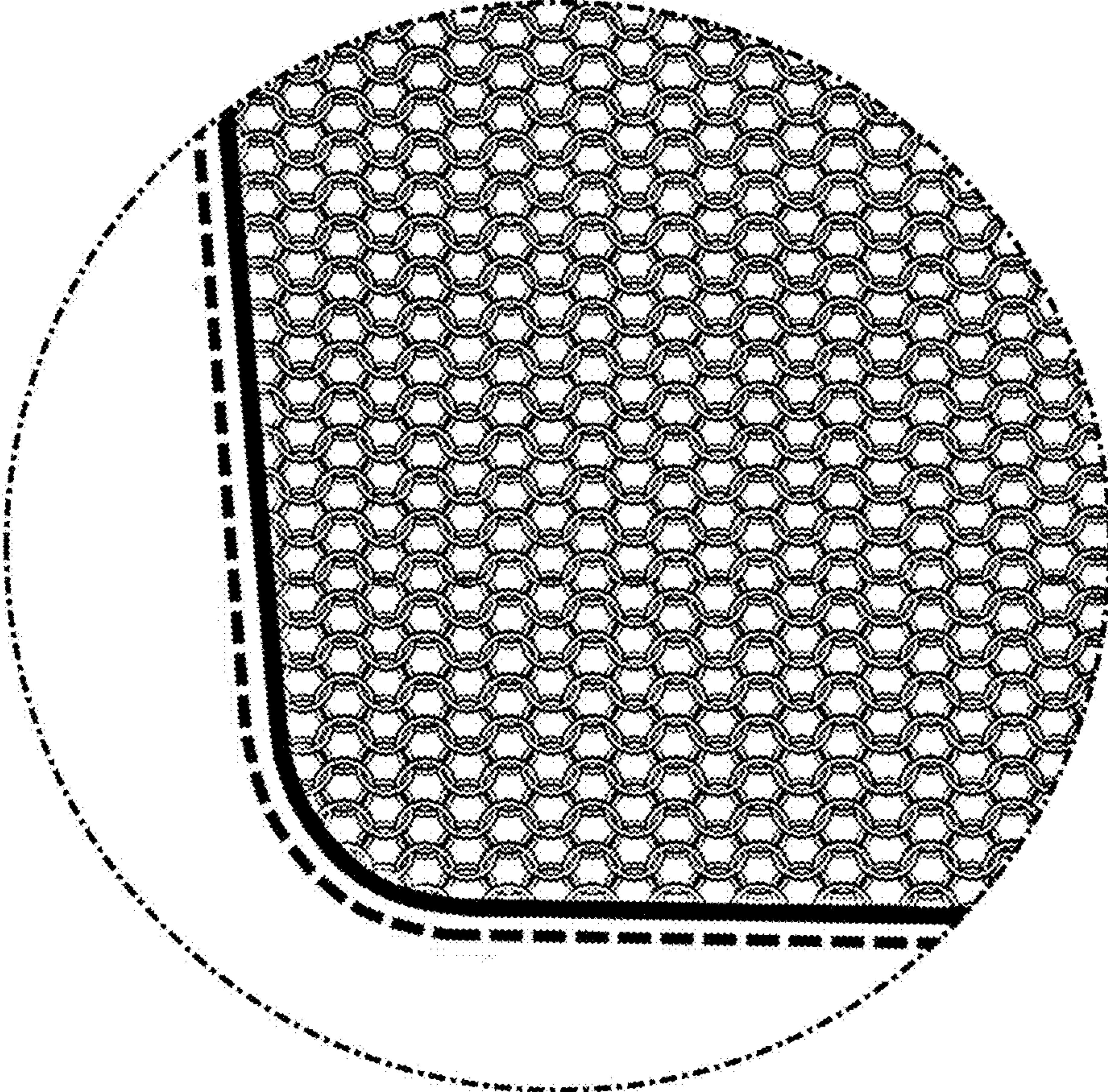

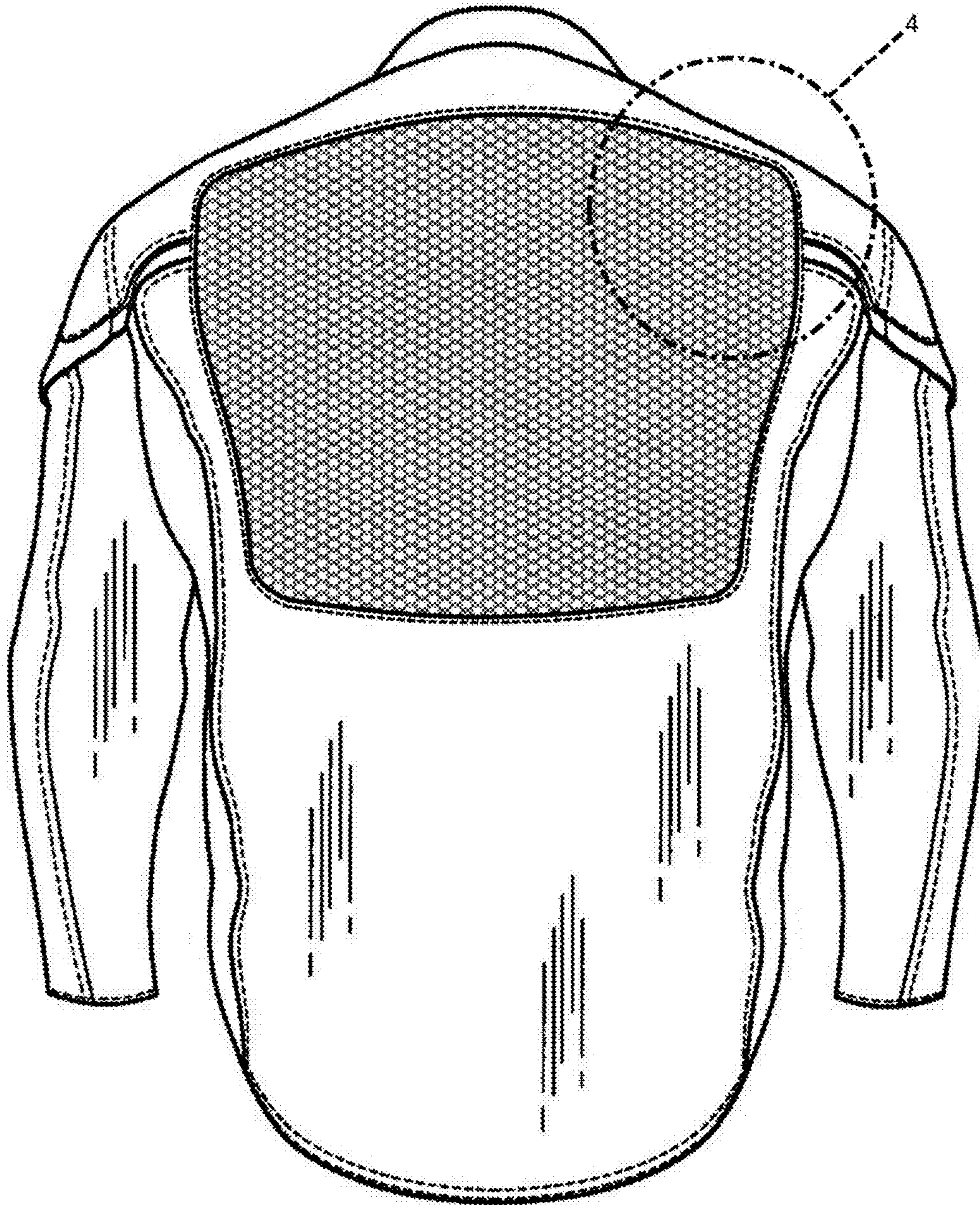

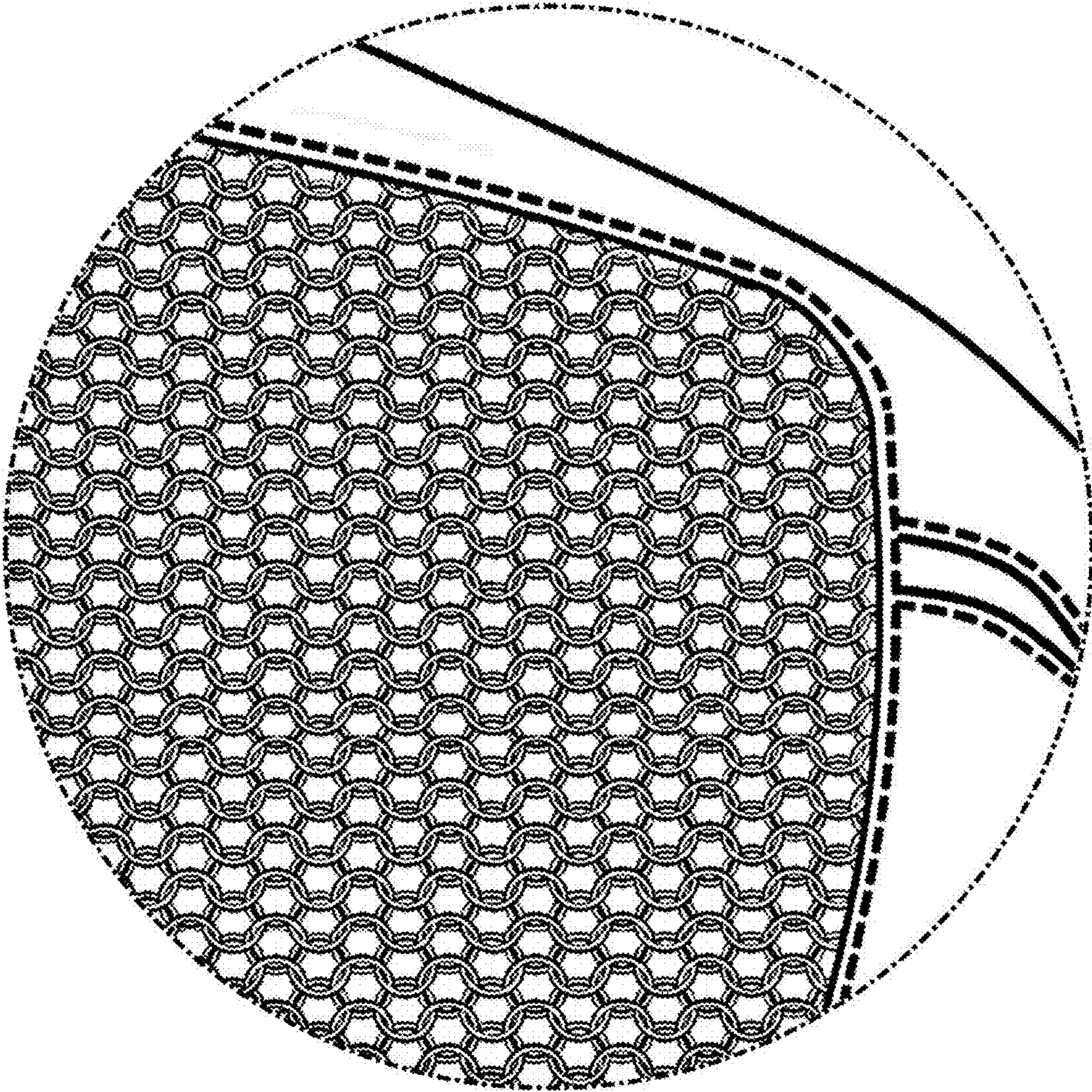
