FIG. 8 is bottom perspective exploded view thereof.

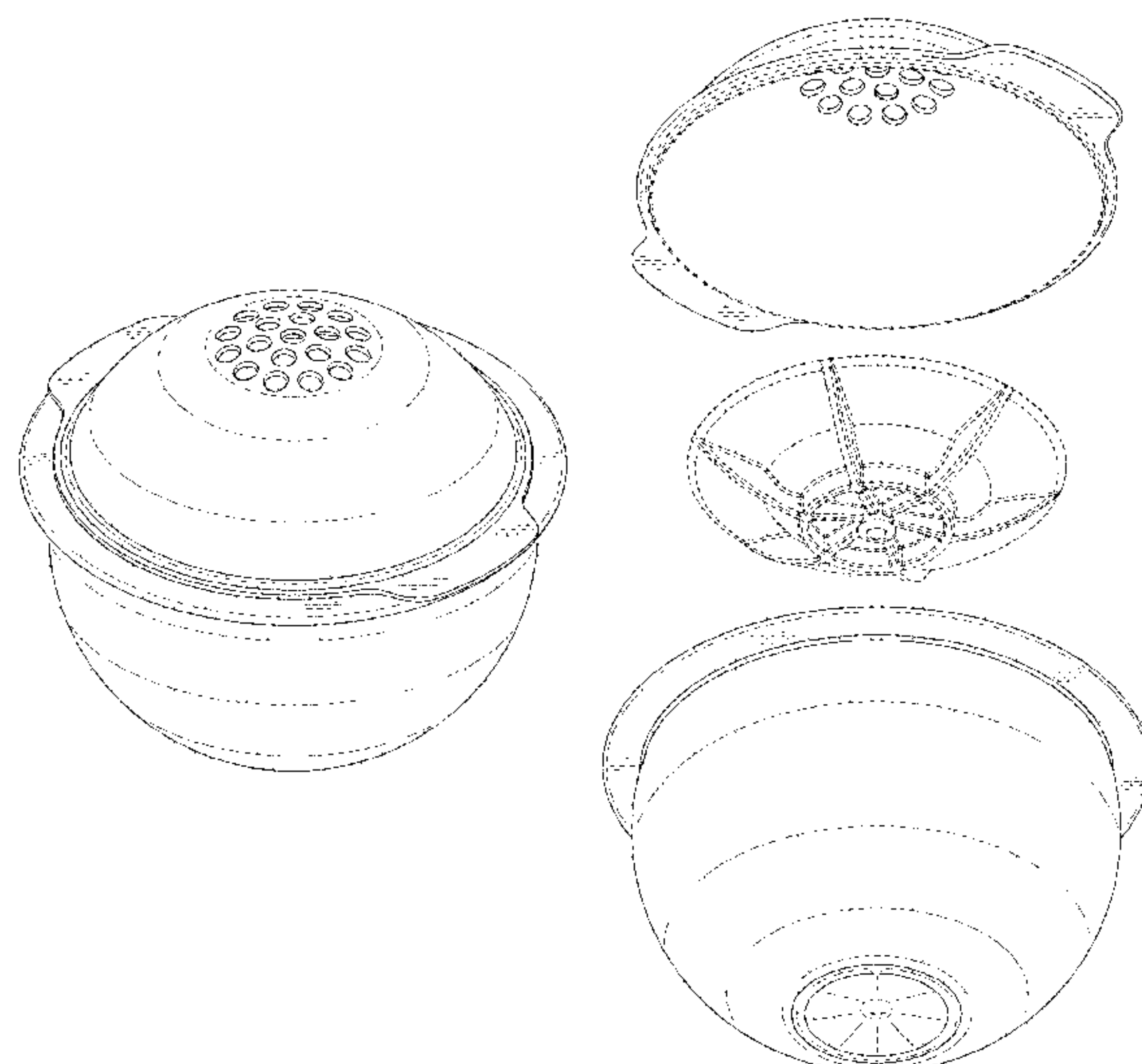
FIG. 9 is top view thereof where the top portion is shown as

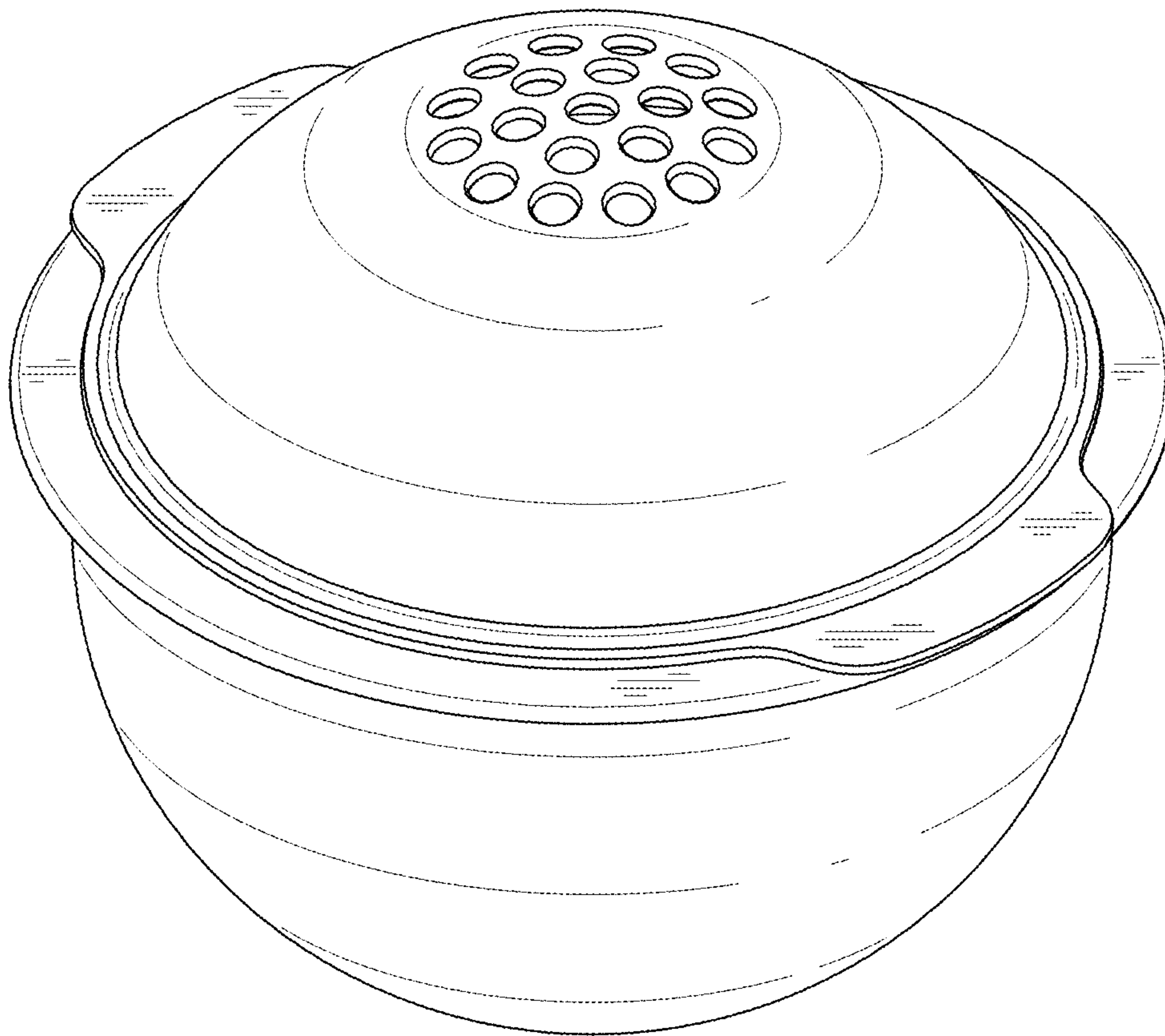

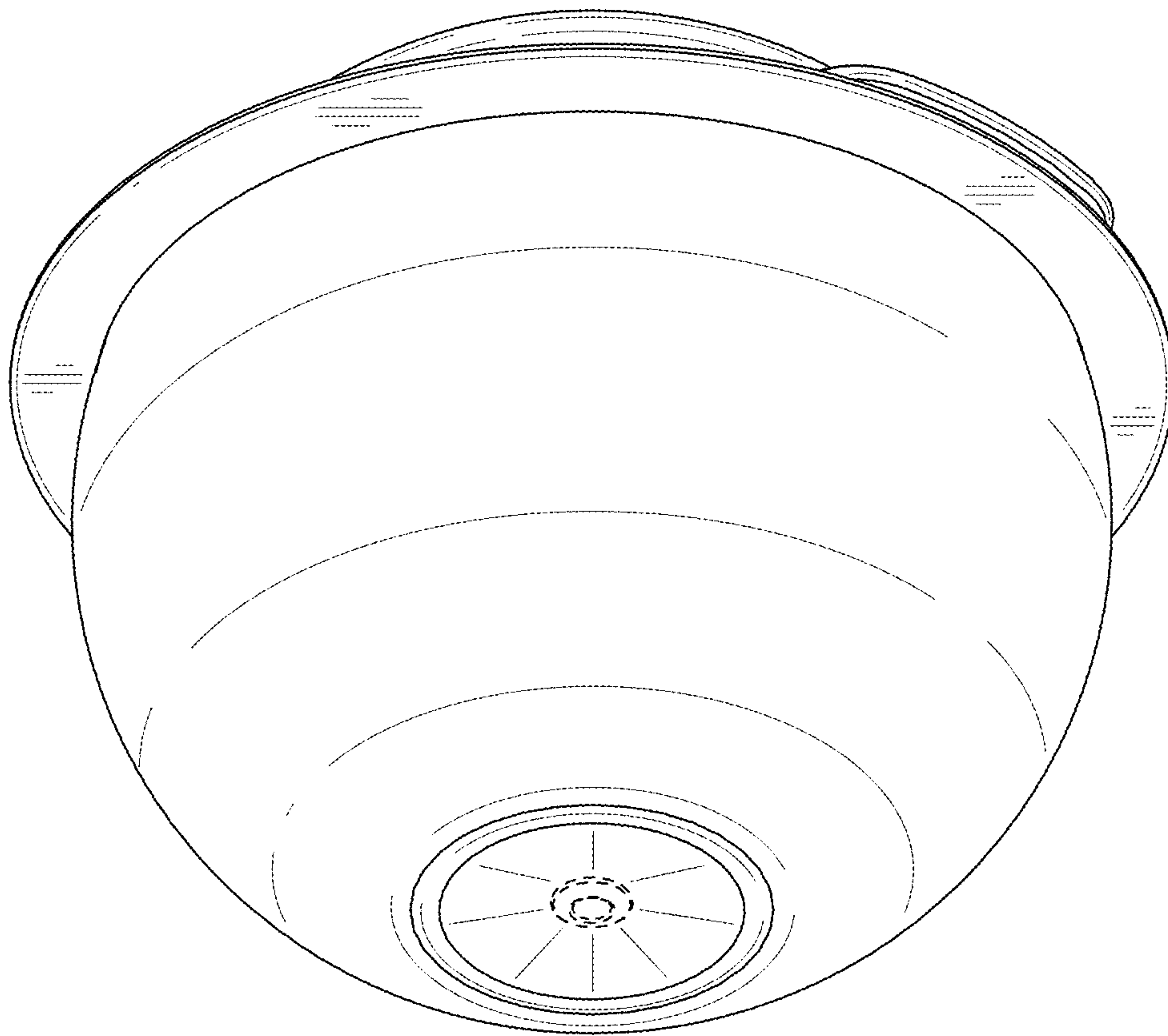

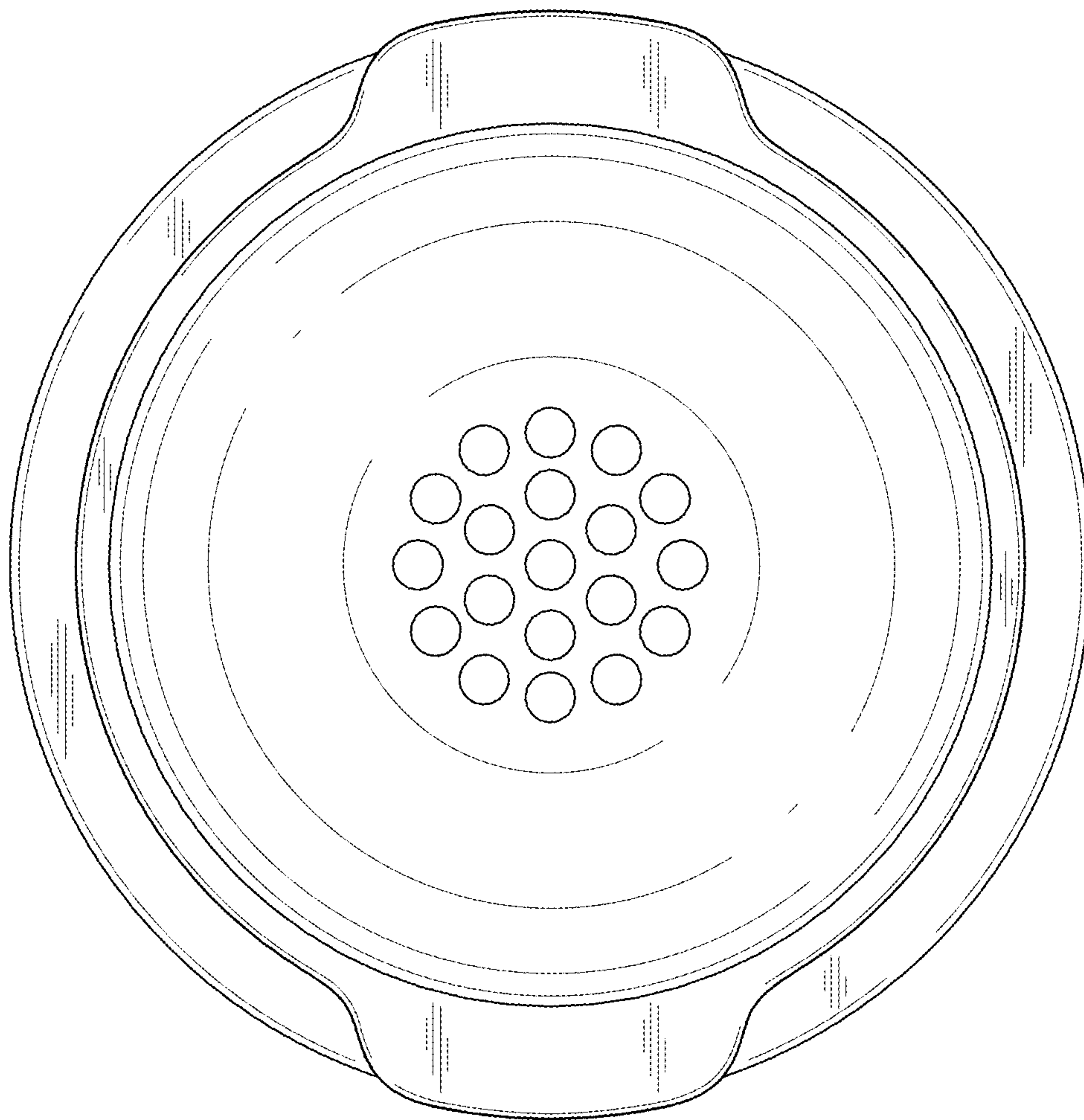

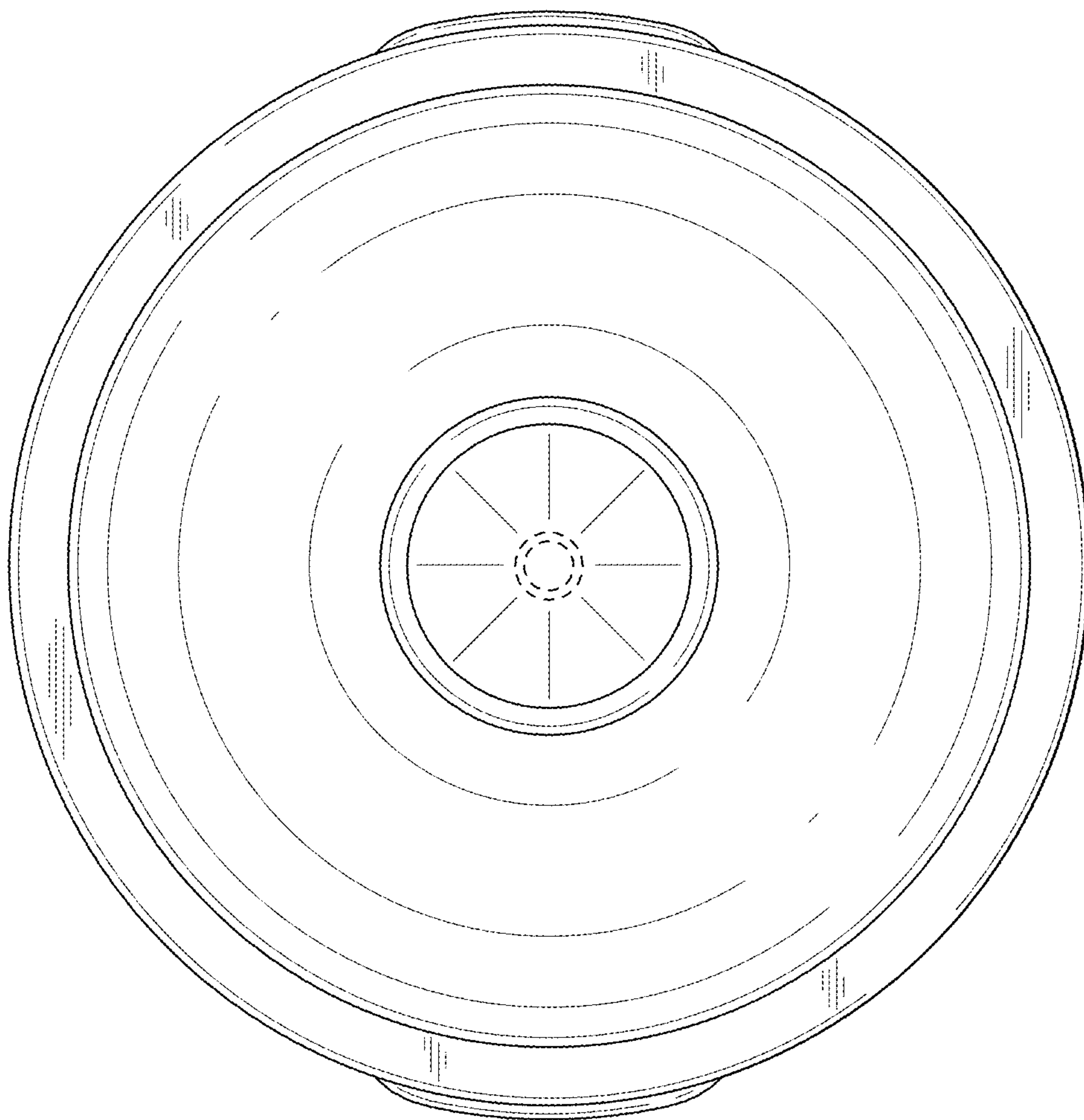

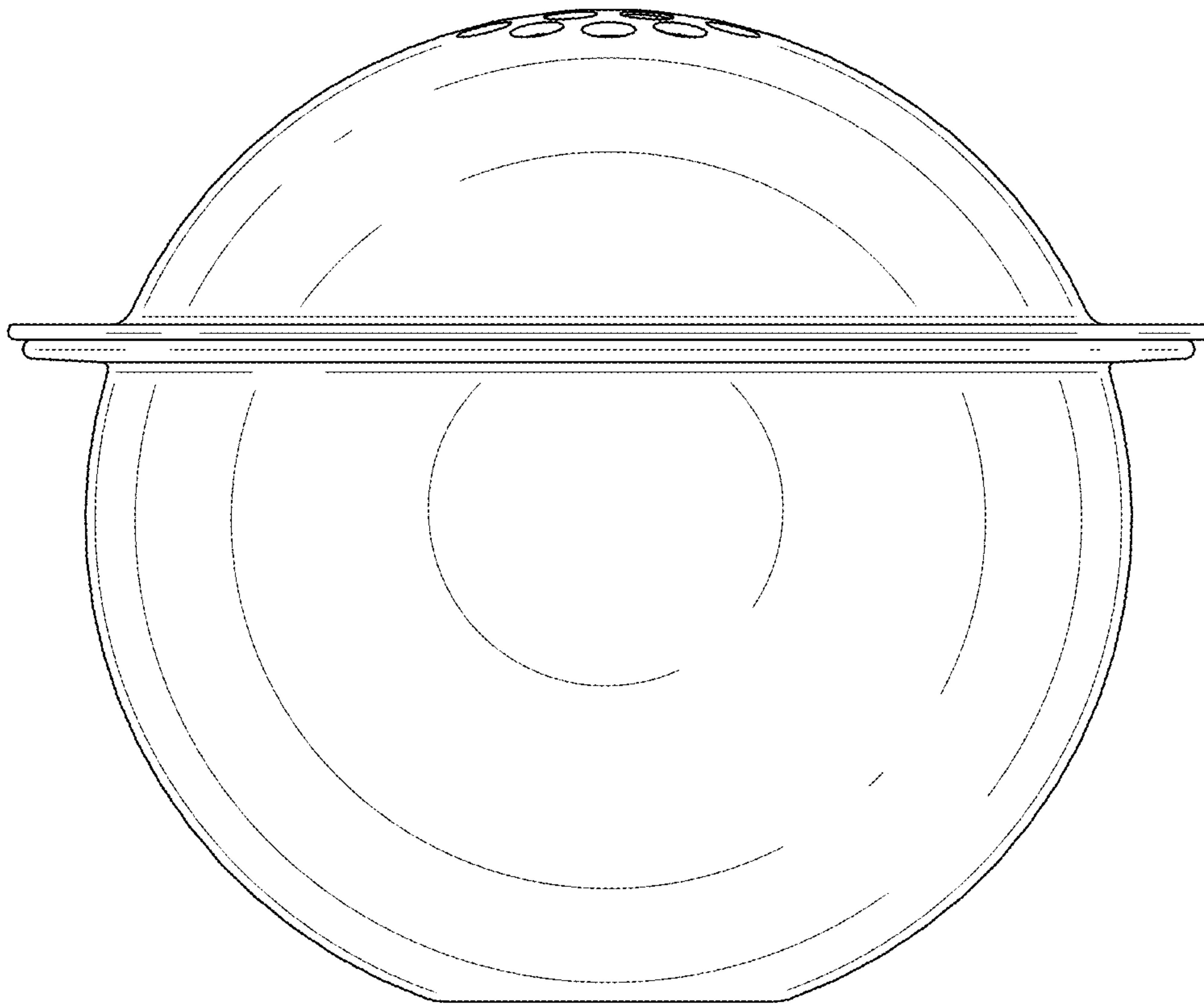

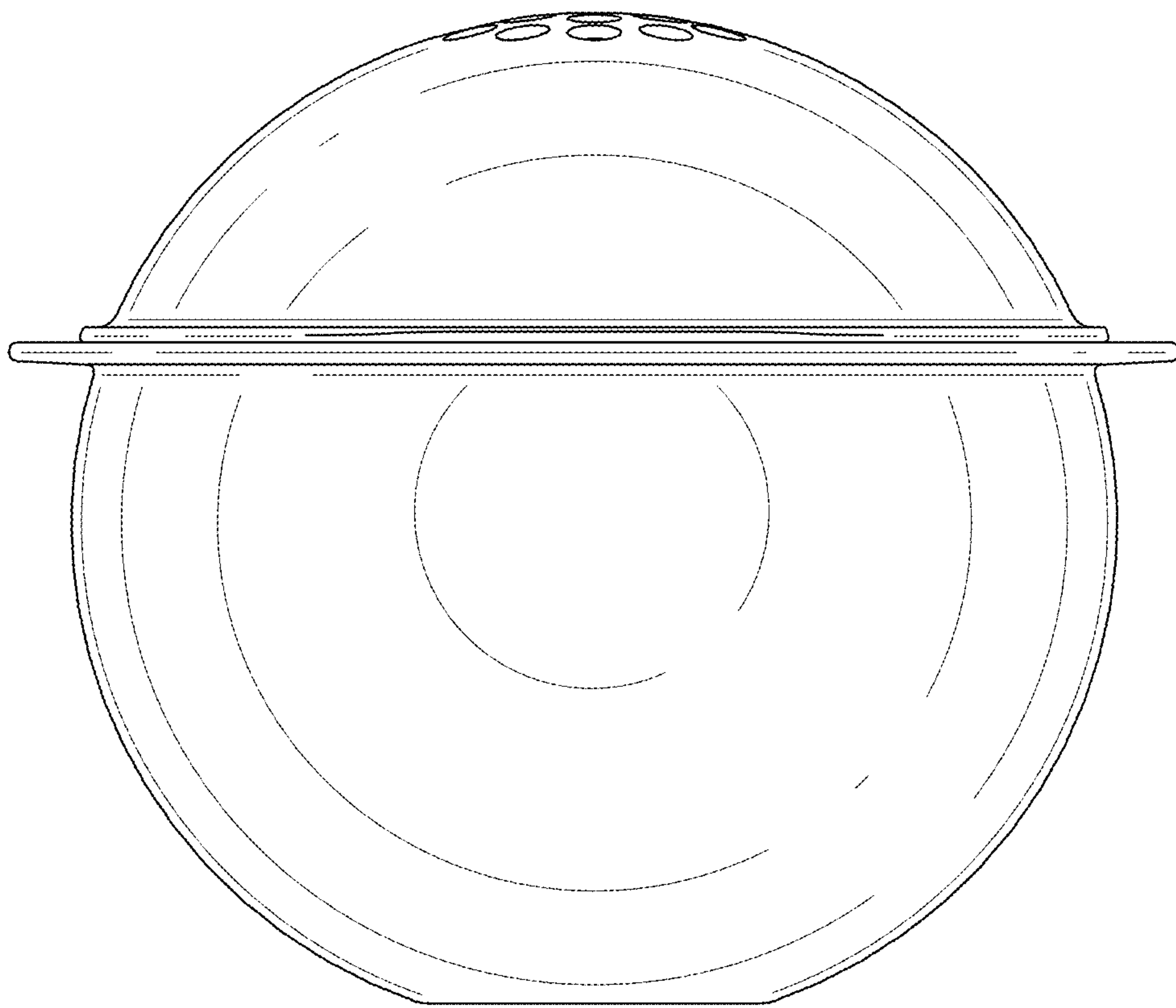

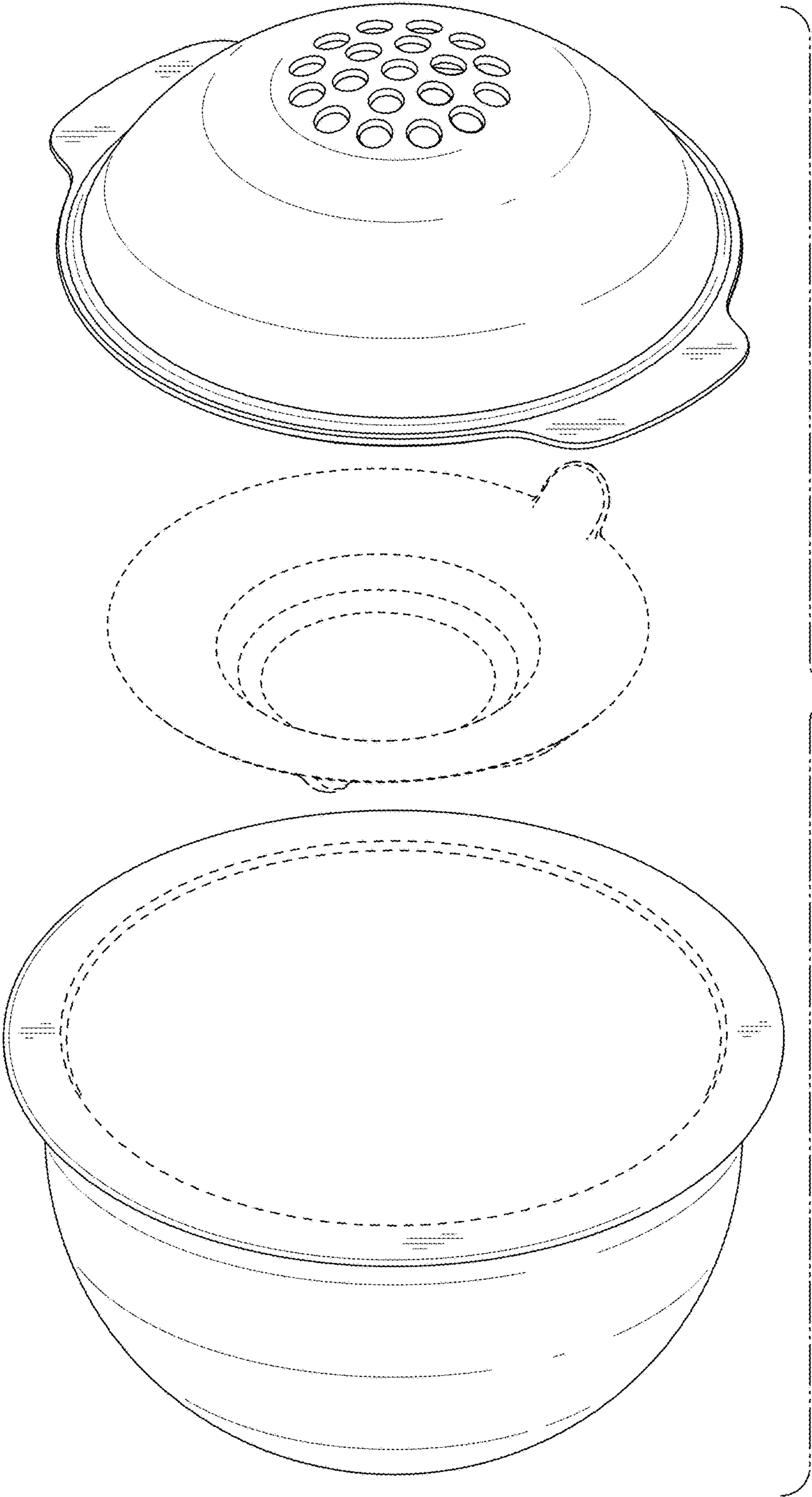

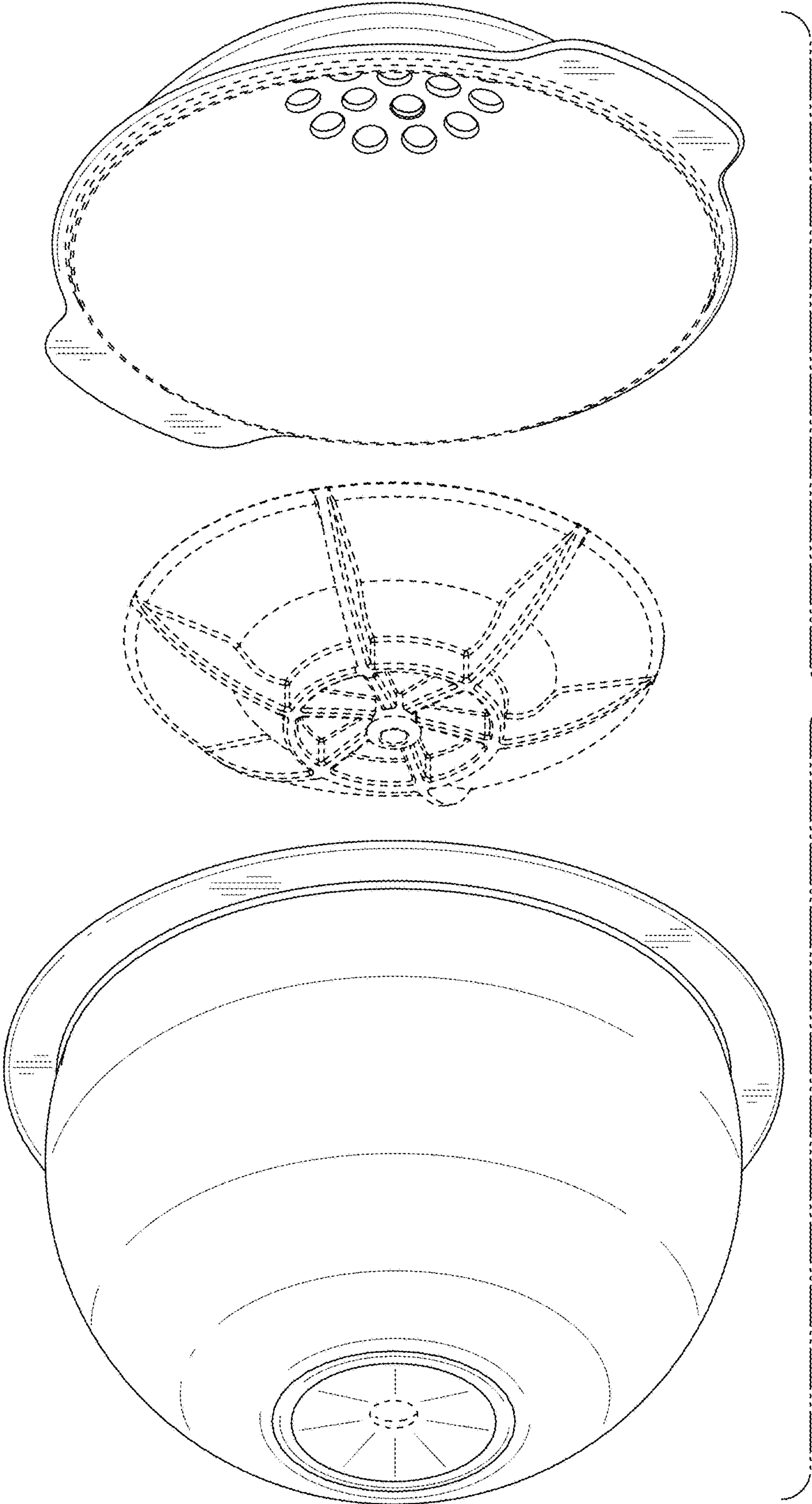

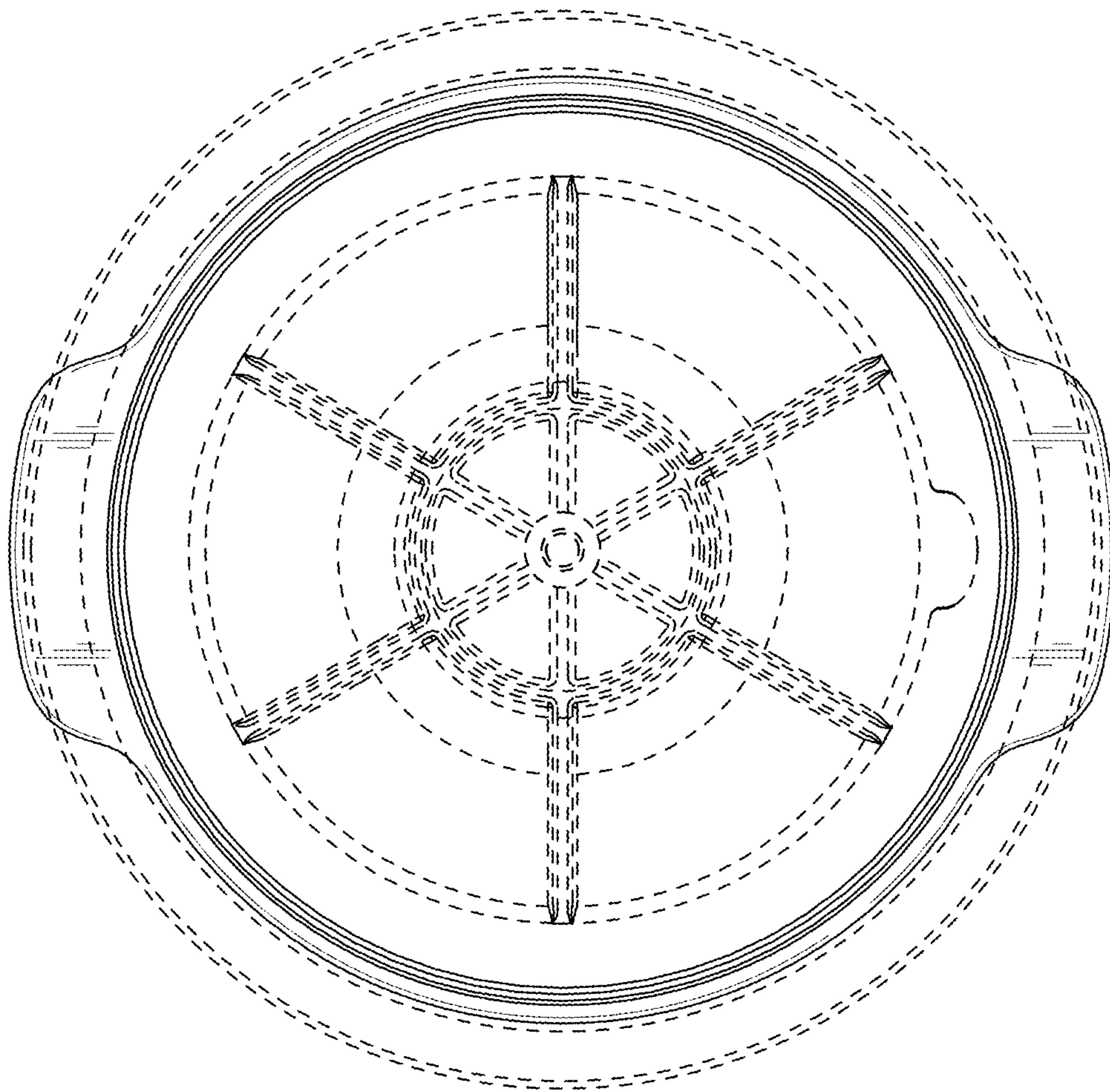

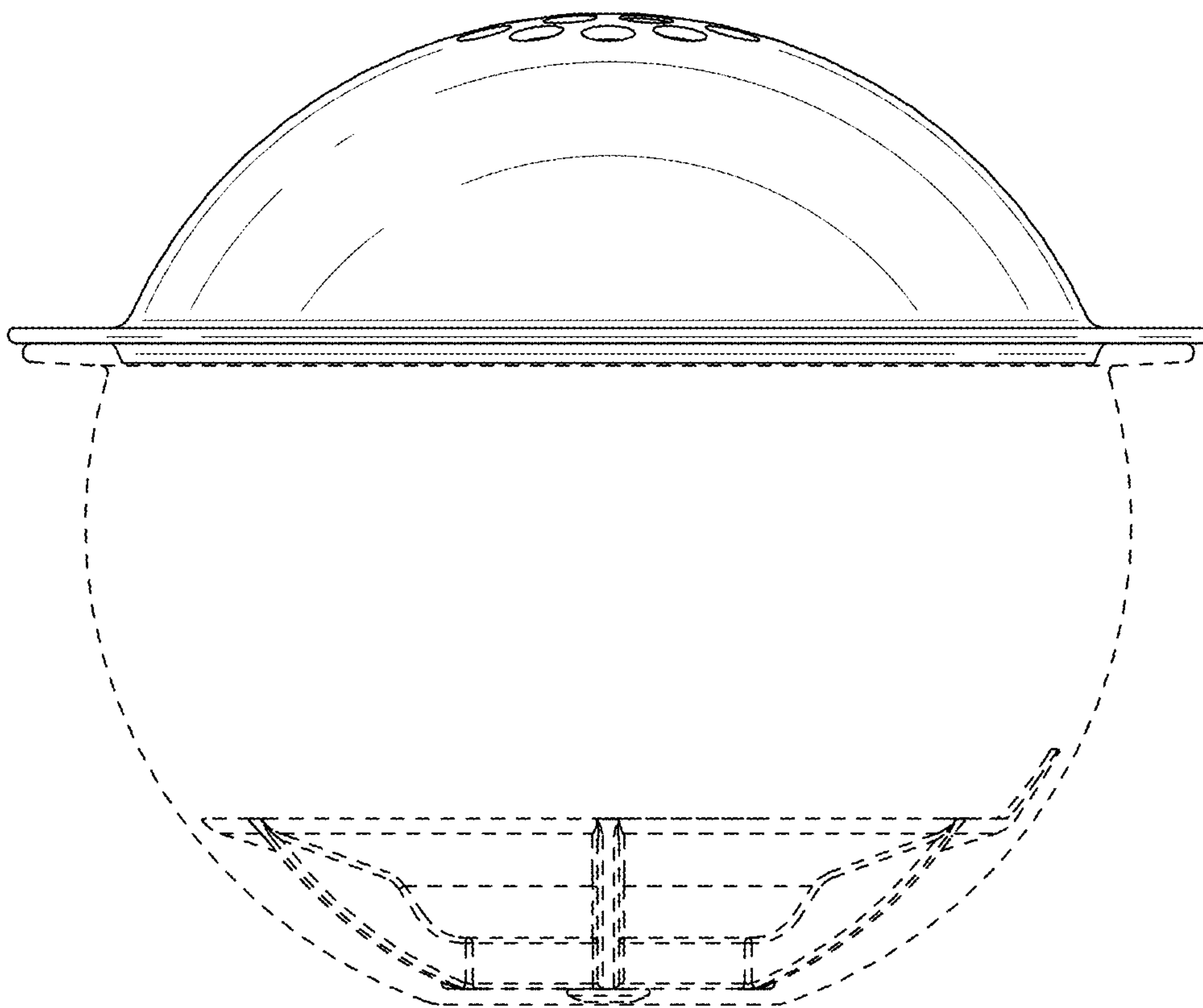

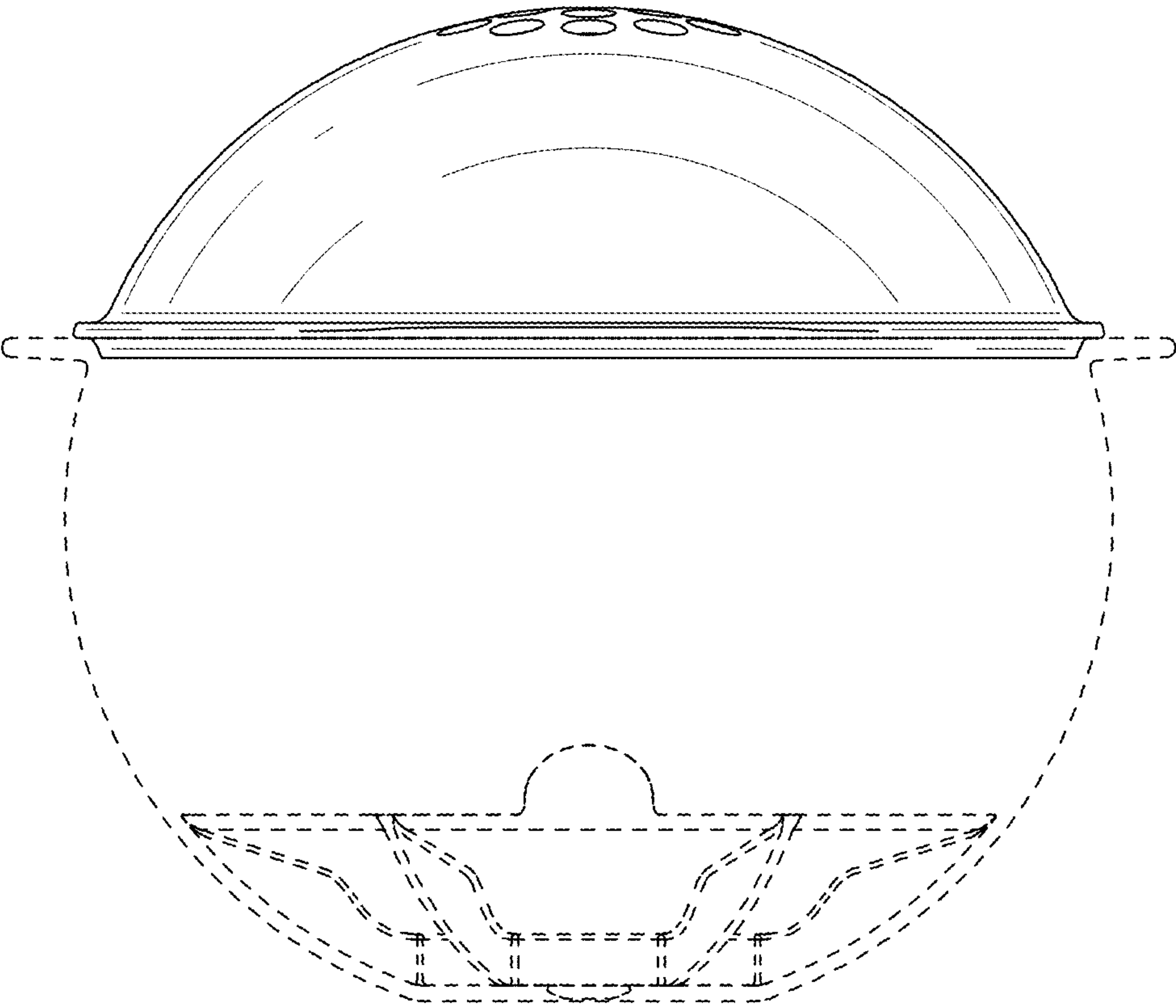
