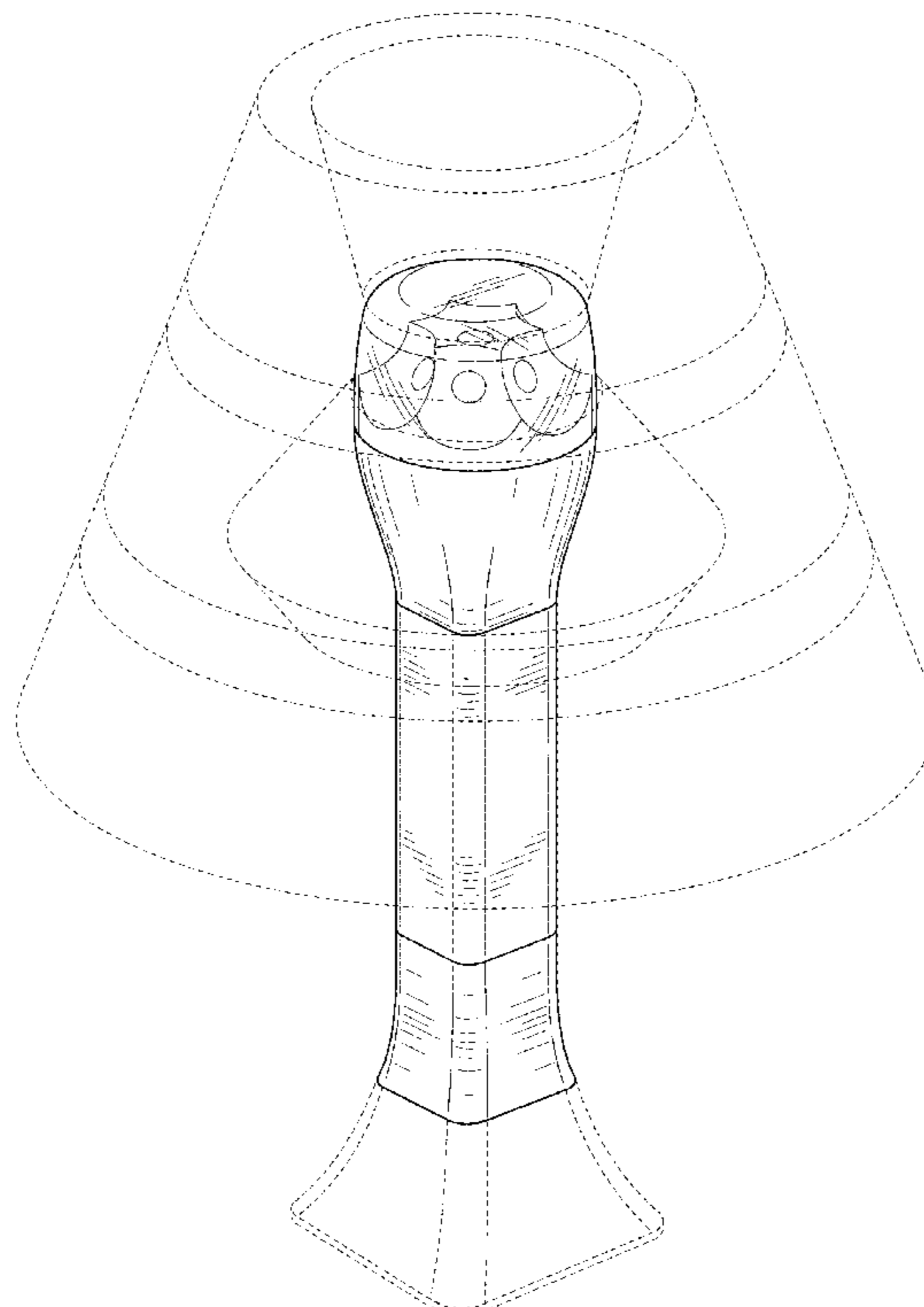
The ornamental design for a flashlight, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a flashlight configured for use with a base and a lampshade; FIG. 2 is a front view of the flashlight; FIG. 3 is a back view of the flashlight; FIG. 4 is a left view of the flashlight; FIG. 5 is a right view of the flashlight; FIG. 6 is a top view of the flashlight; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the flashlight.

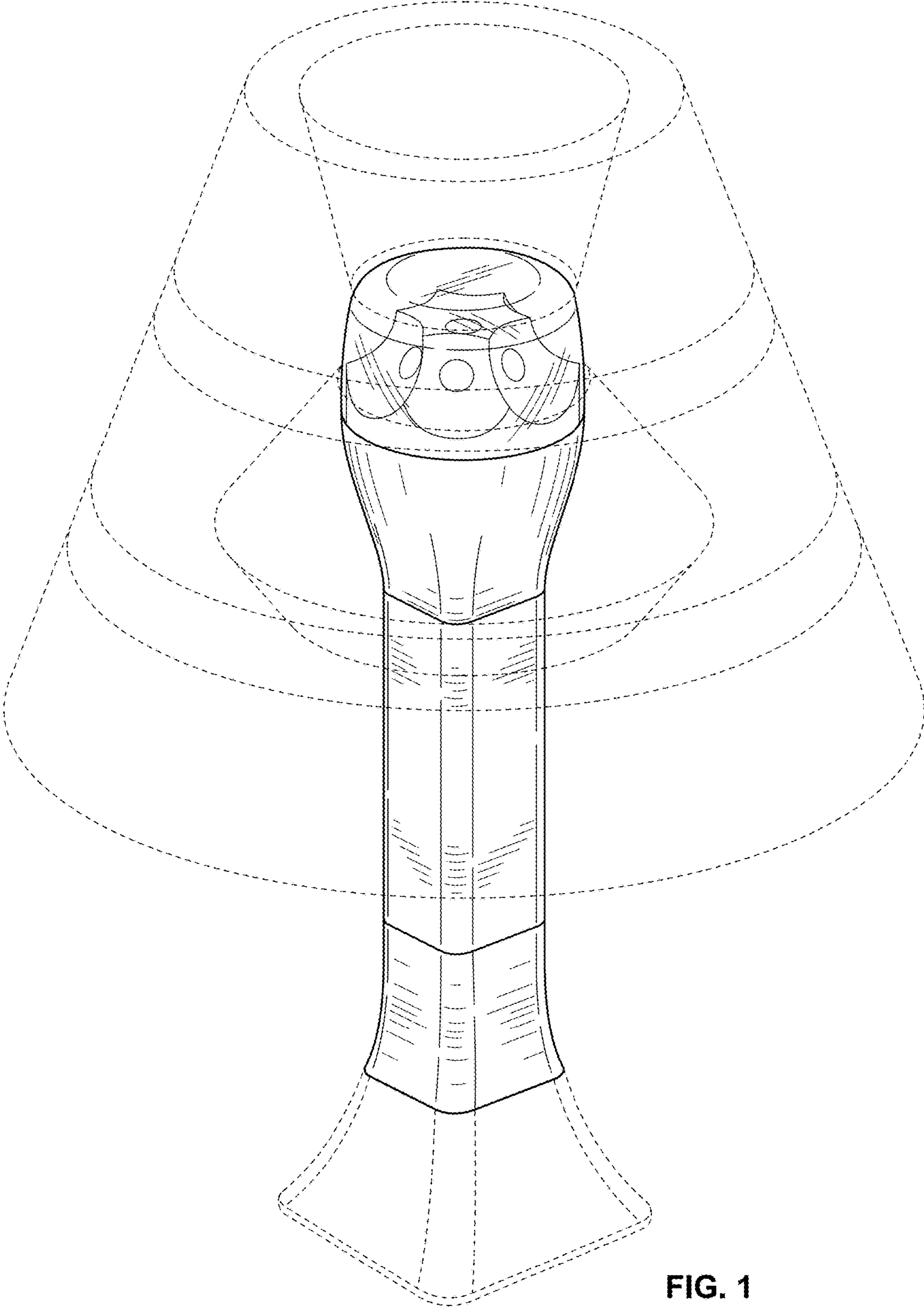

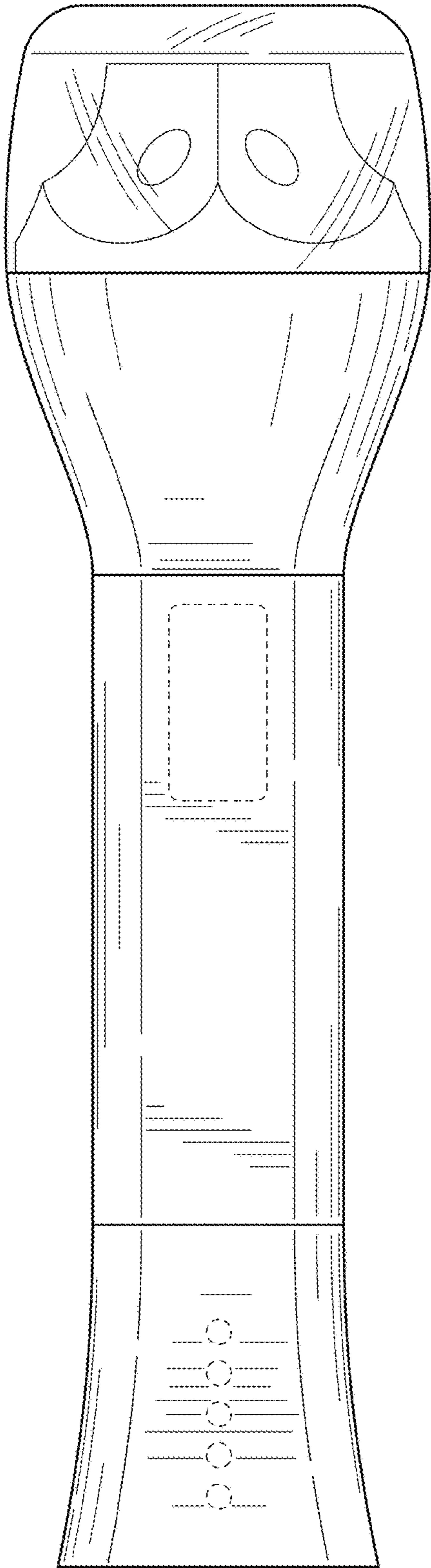

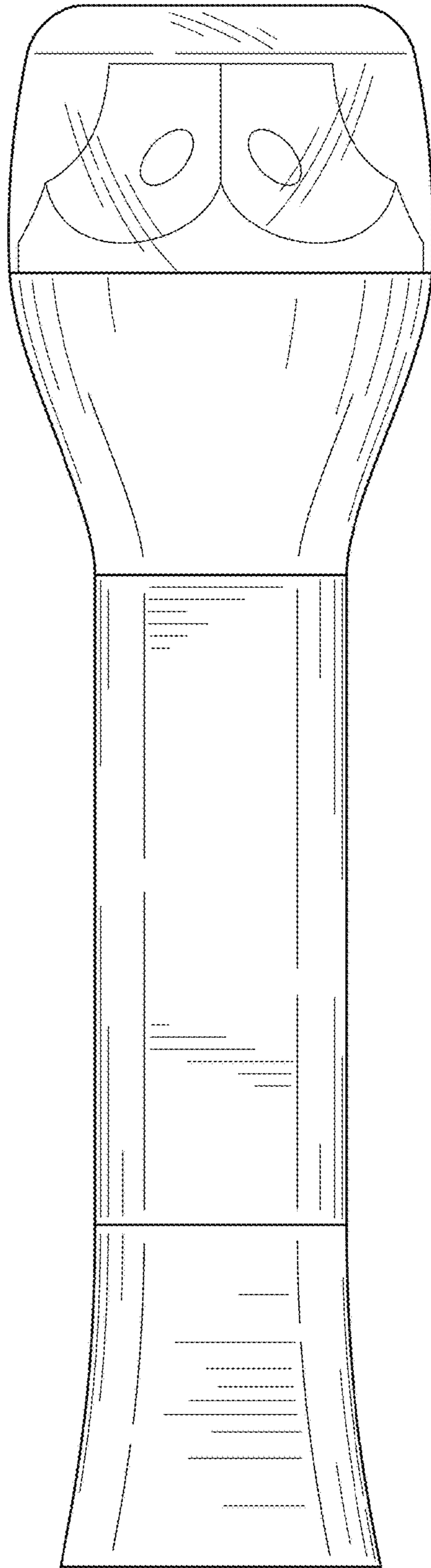

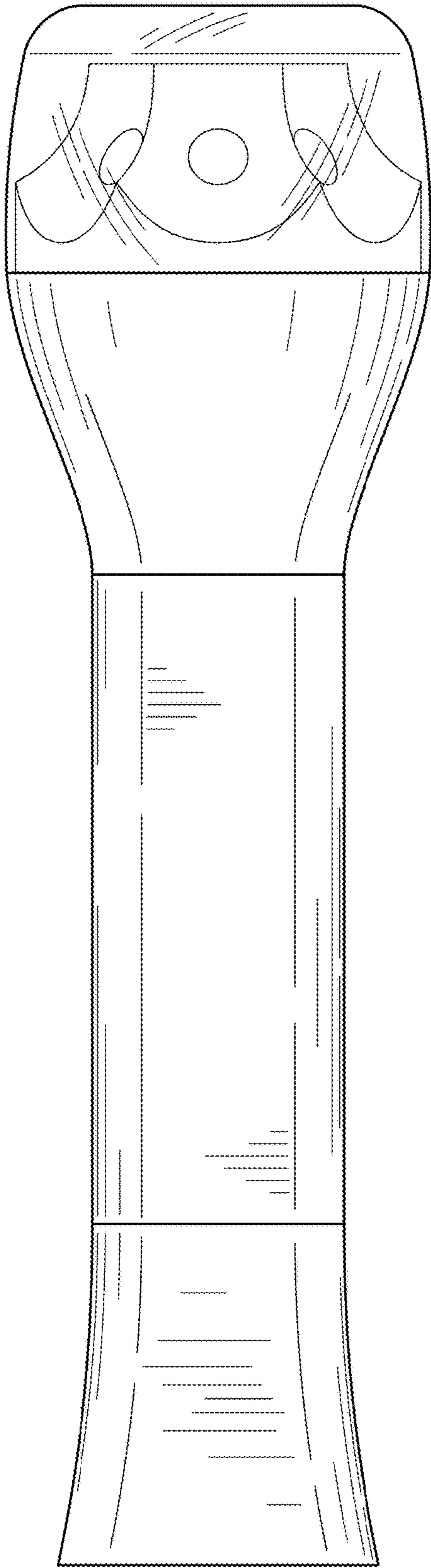

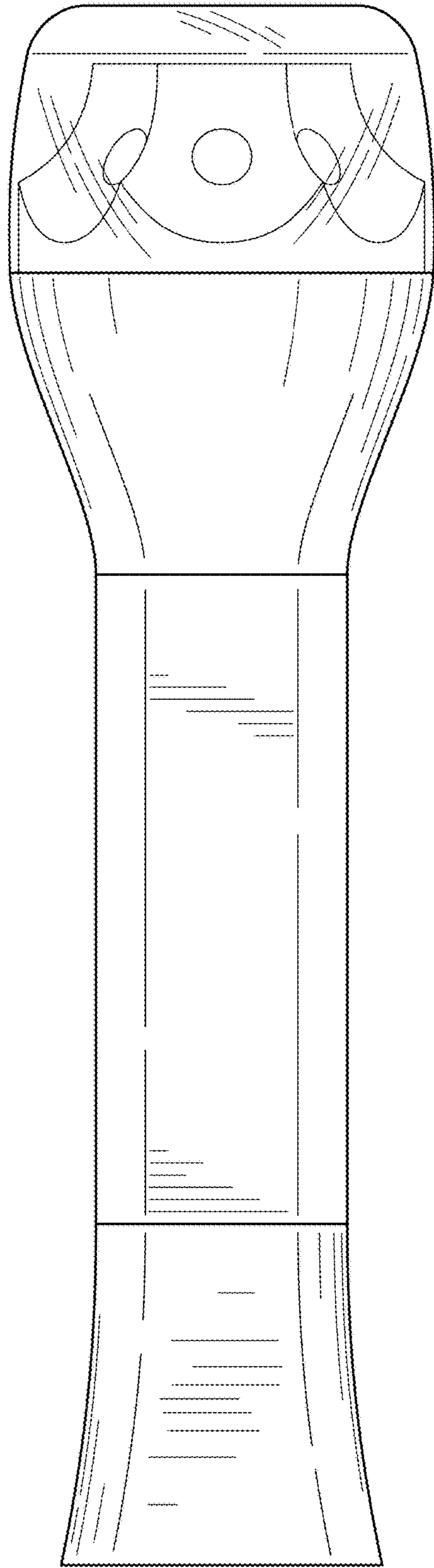

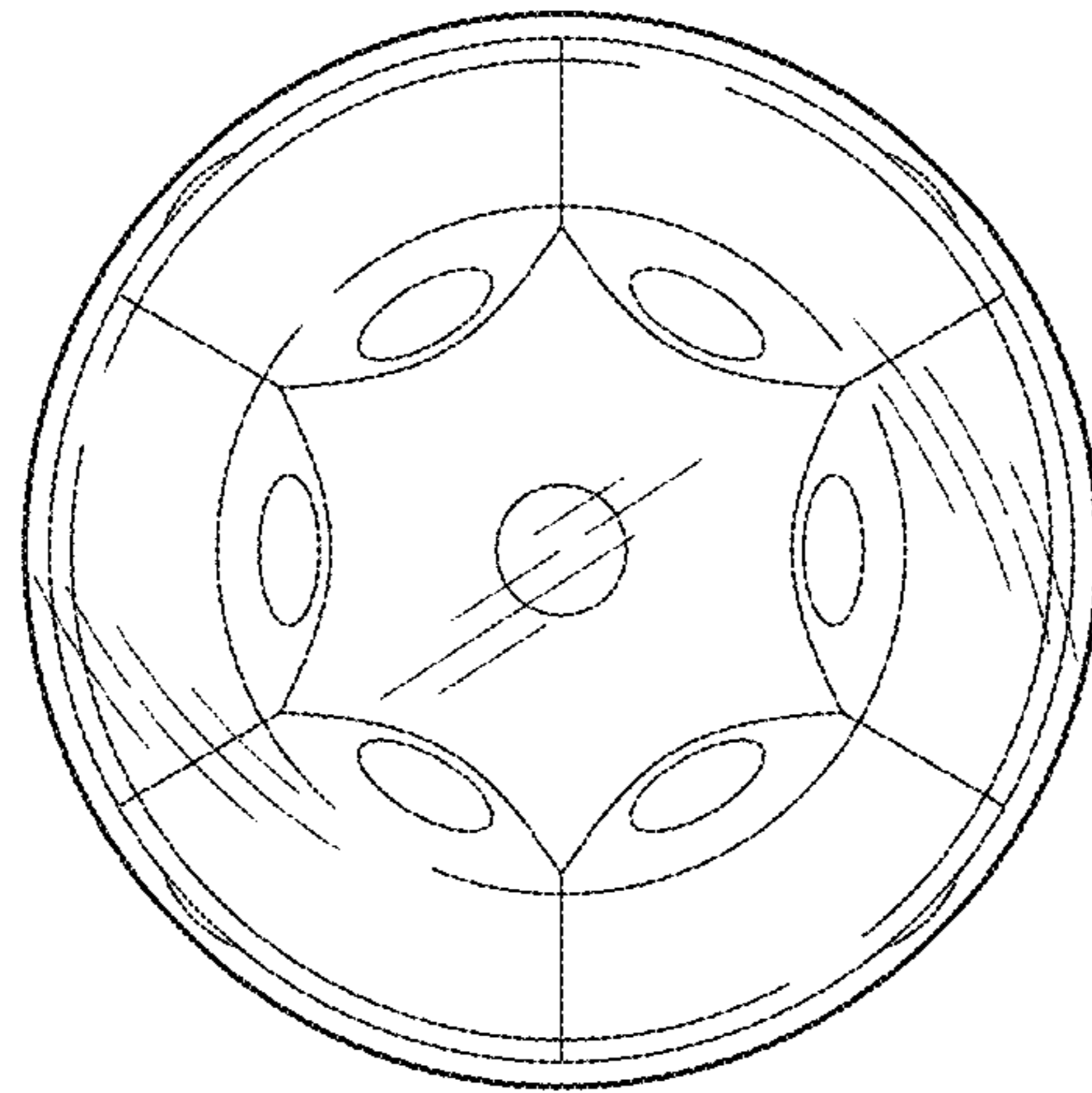

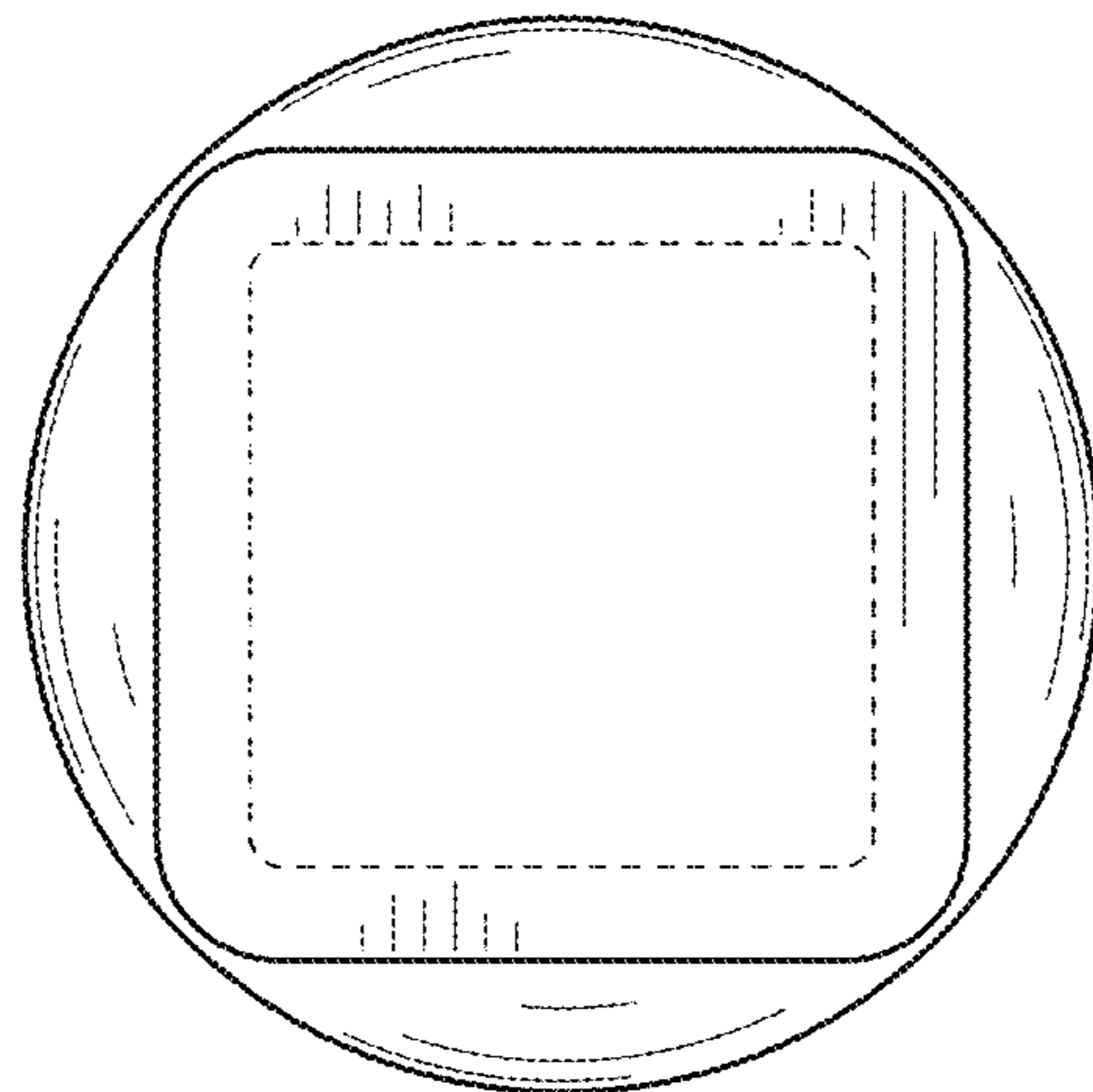
