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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an article of clothing with raised abrasion-resistant coating, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an article of clothing with raised abrasion-resistant coating showing our new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged front view of the portion 2 encircled in FIG. 1; and,

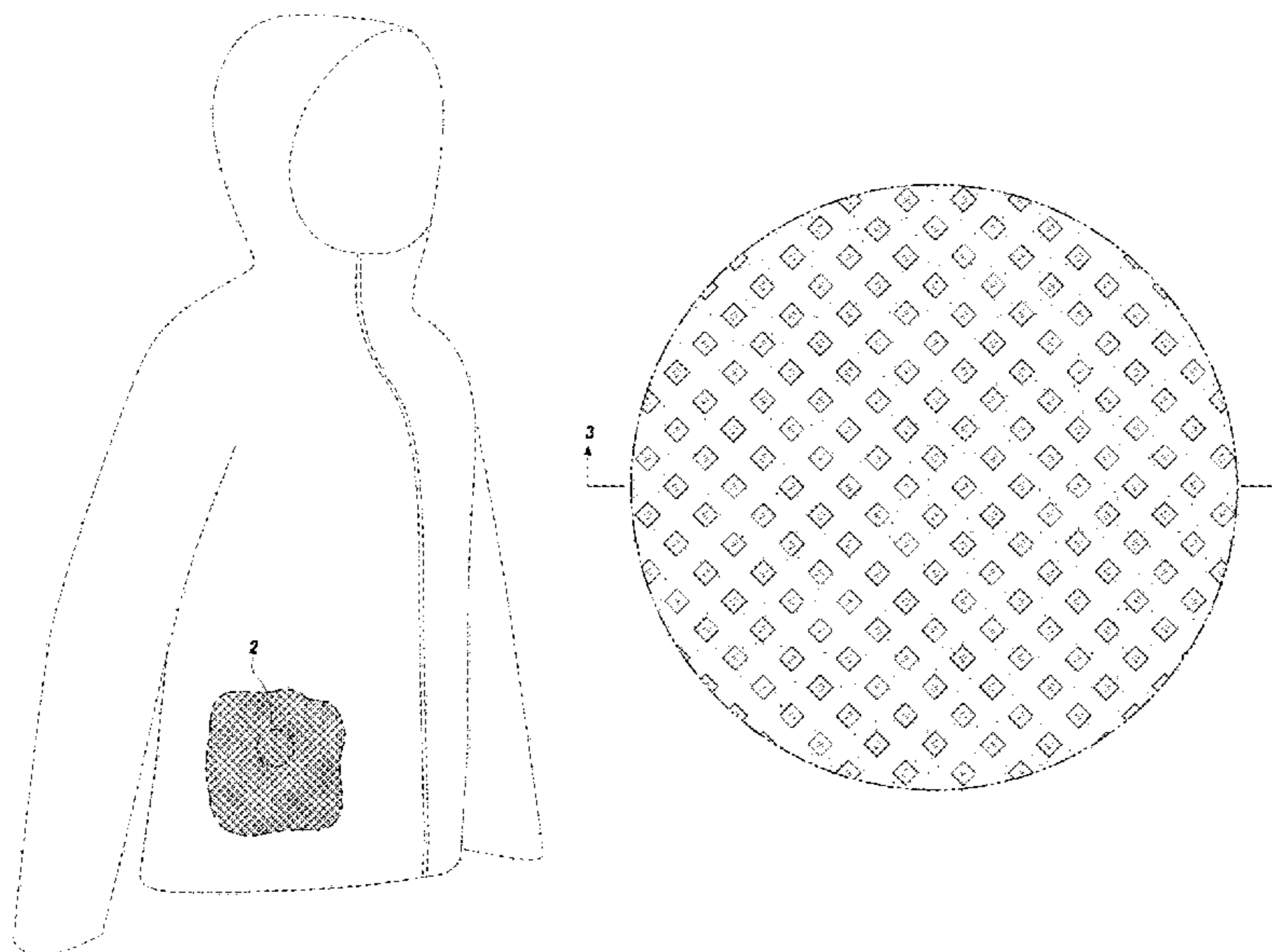
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 3-3 in FIG. 2.

The dashed broken lines in FIG. 1 show portions of the article of clothing that form no part of the claimed design. The dot-dash broken lines in the drawings represent a boundary line that forms no part of the claimed design.

The dot-dot-dash broken lines in the drawings illustrate a portion shown in an enlargement and form no part of the claimed design.

The pair of wavy lines in FIG. 3 indicate the outer bounds of the enlarged cross-sectional view, and form no part of the claimed design.

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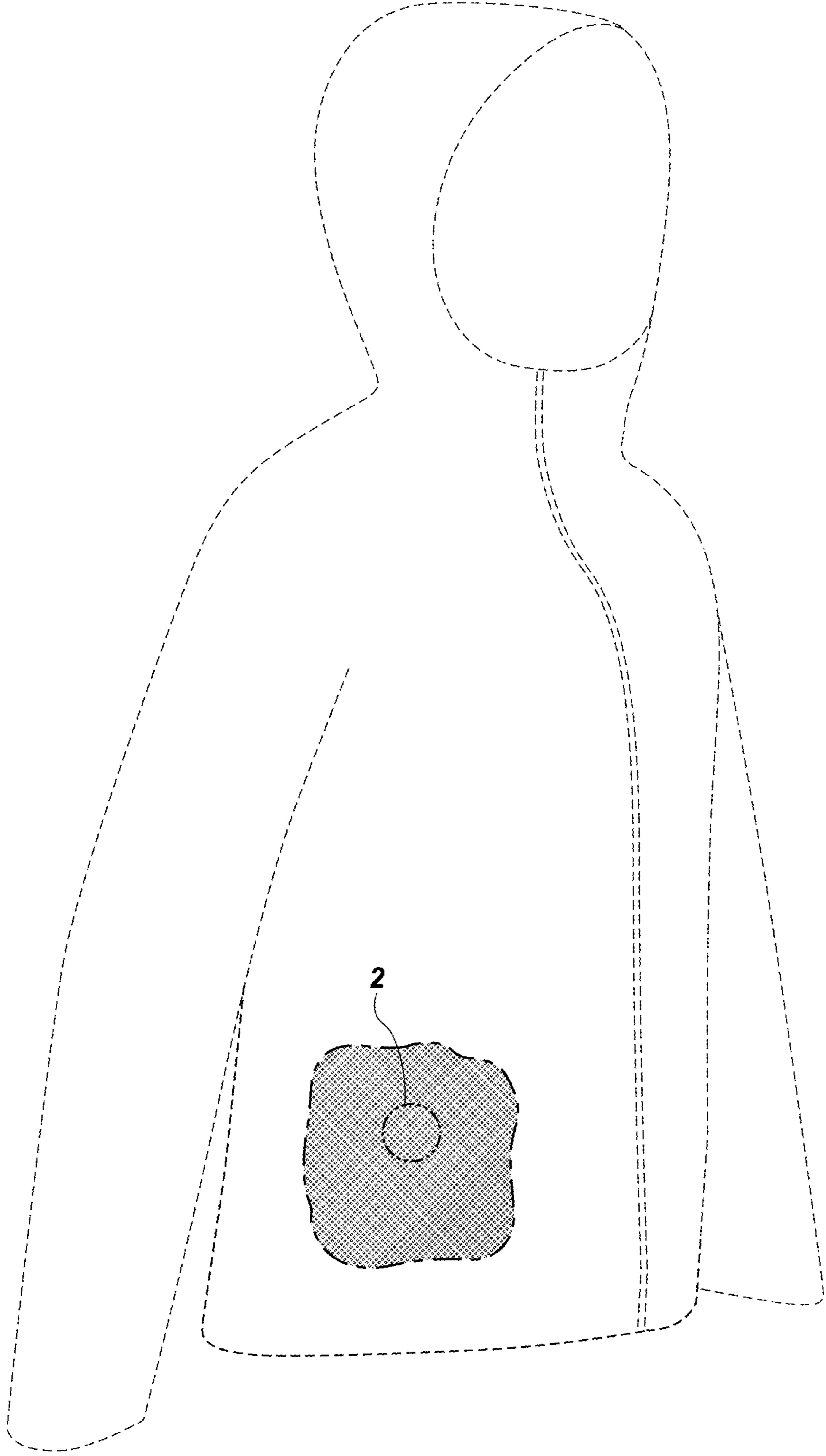

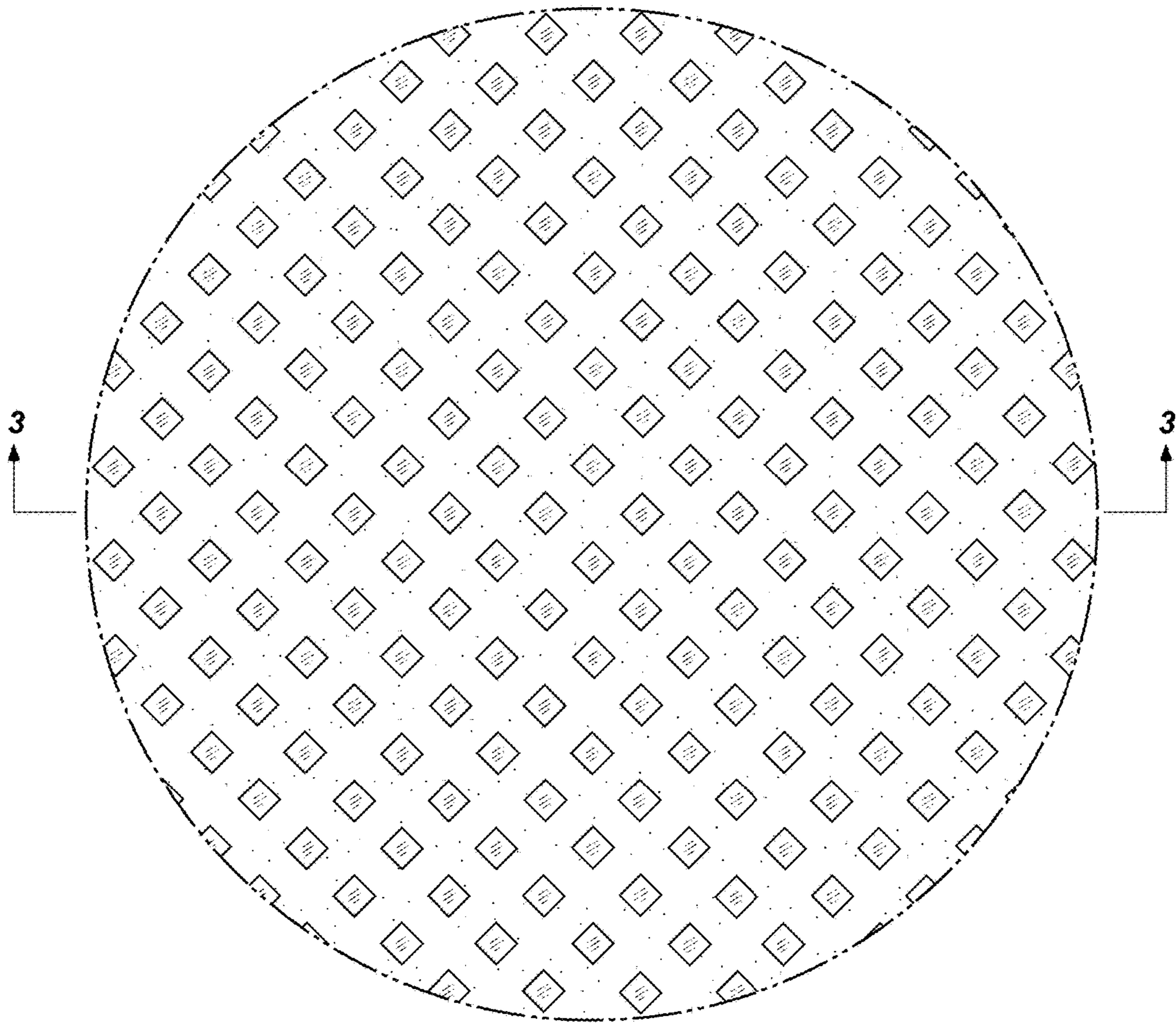
