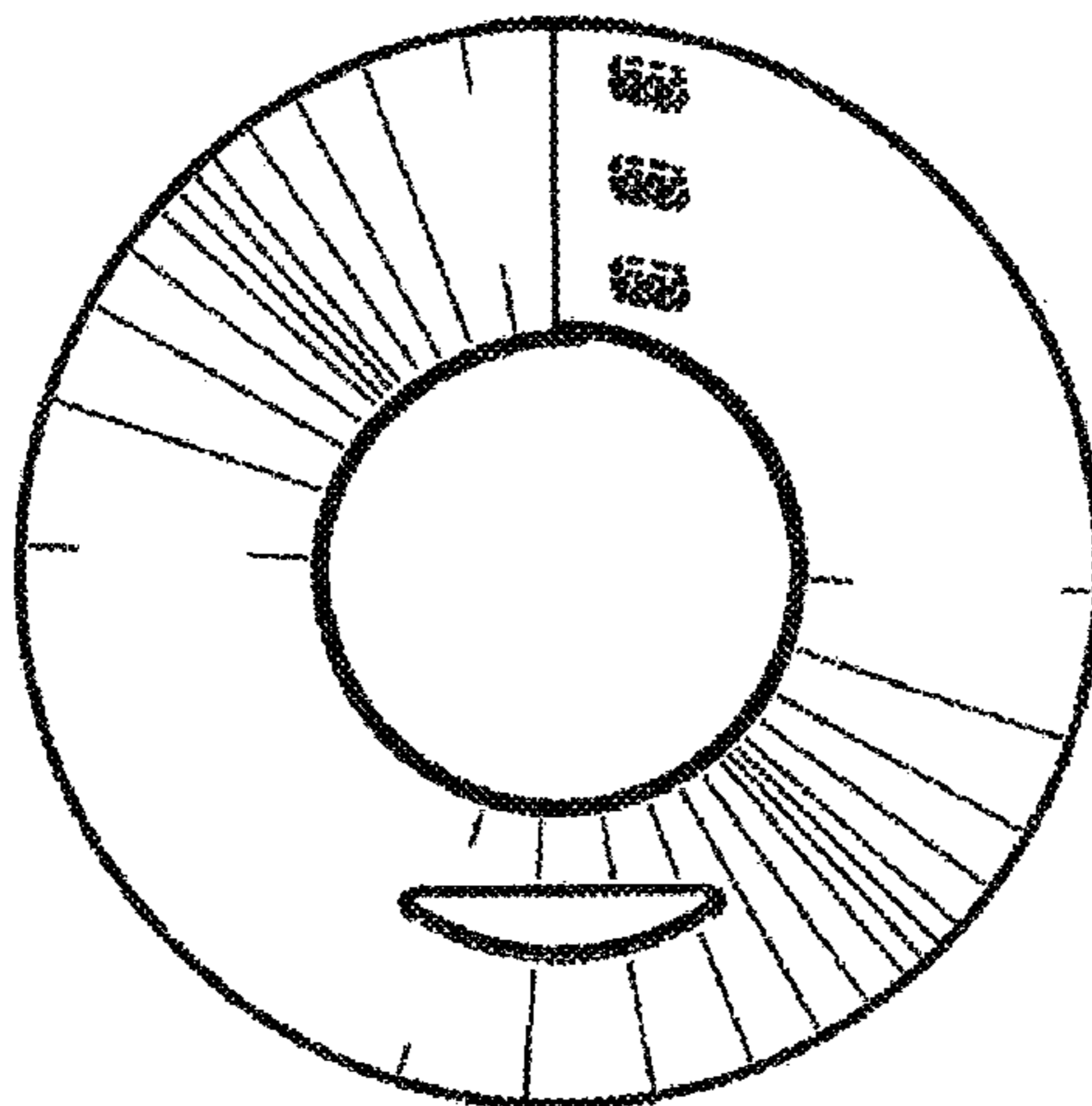
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a paddle ball game, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a paddle ball game showing my new design, shown in an unassembled configuration;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a paddle ball game;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 5;

 FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 5;
 FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of a paddle ball game;

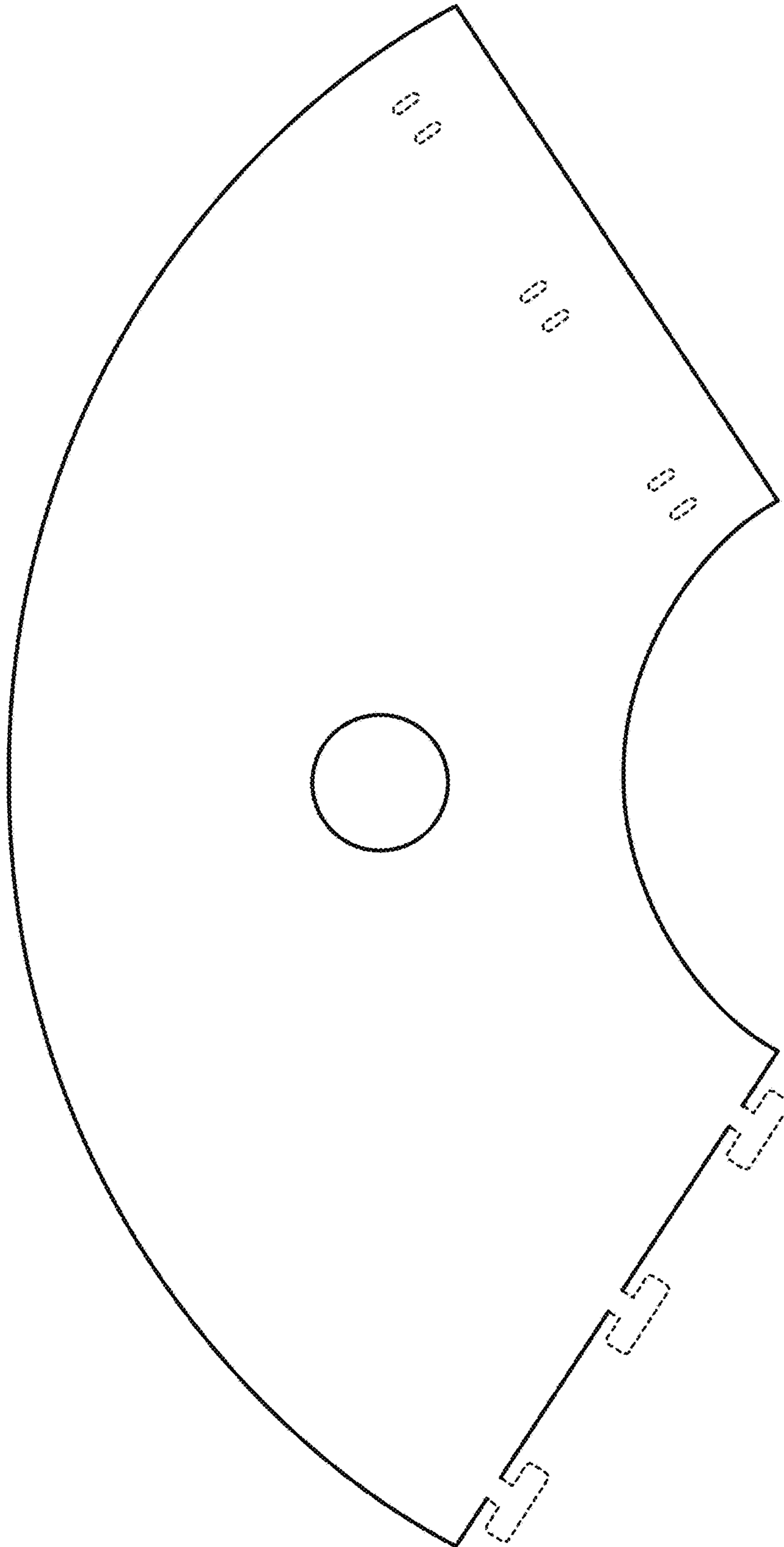

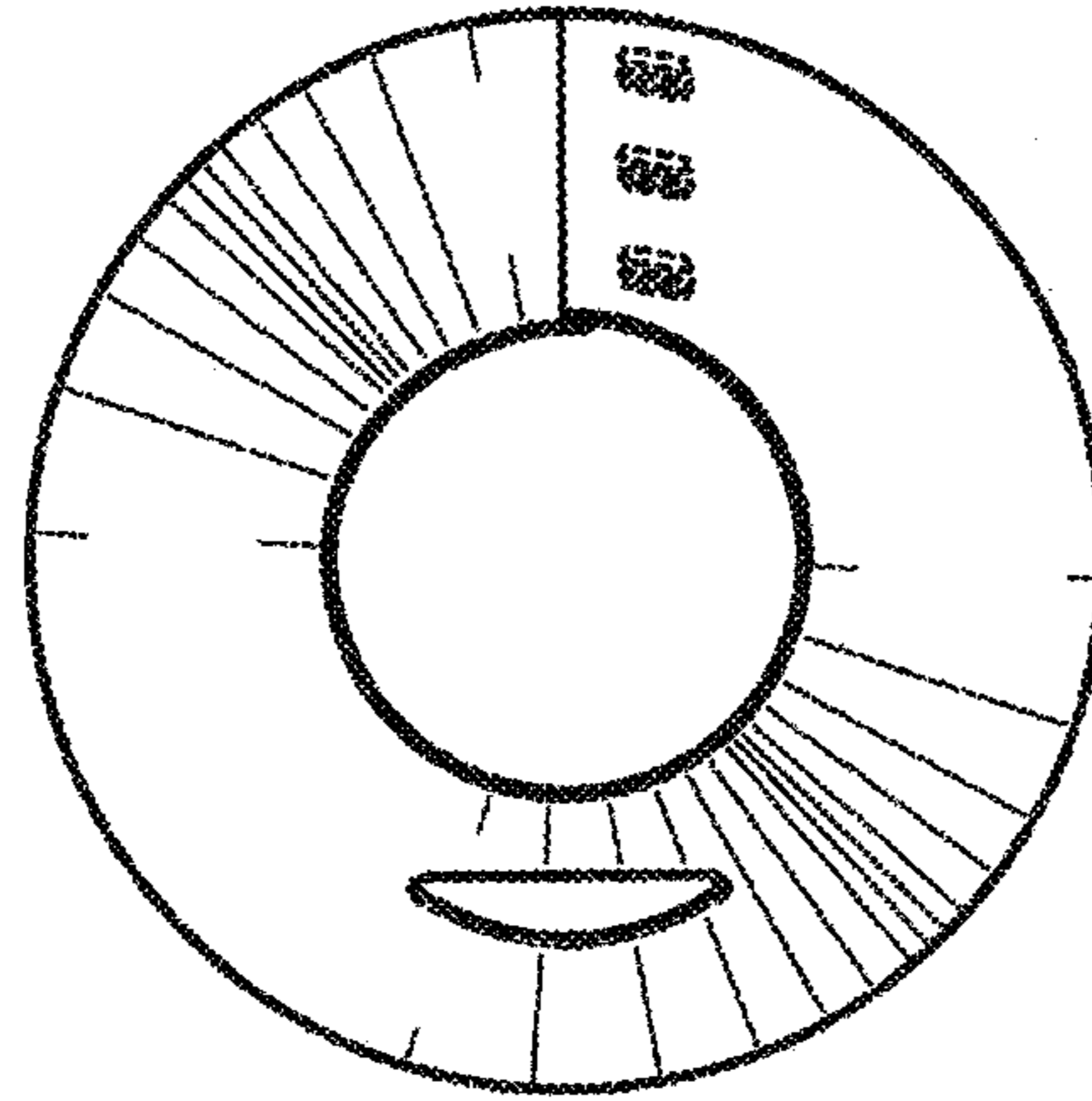

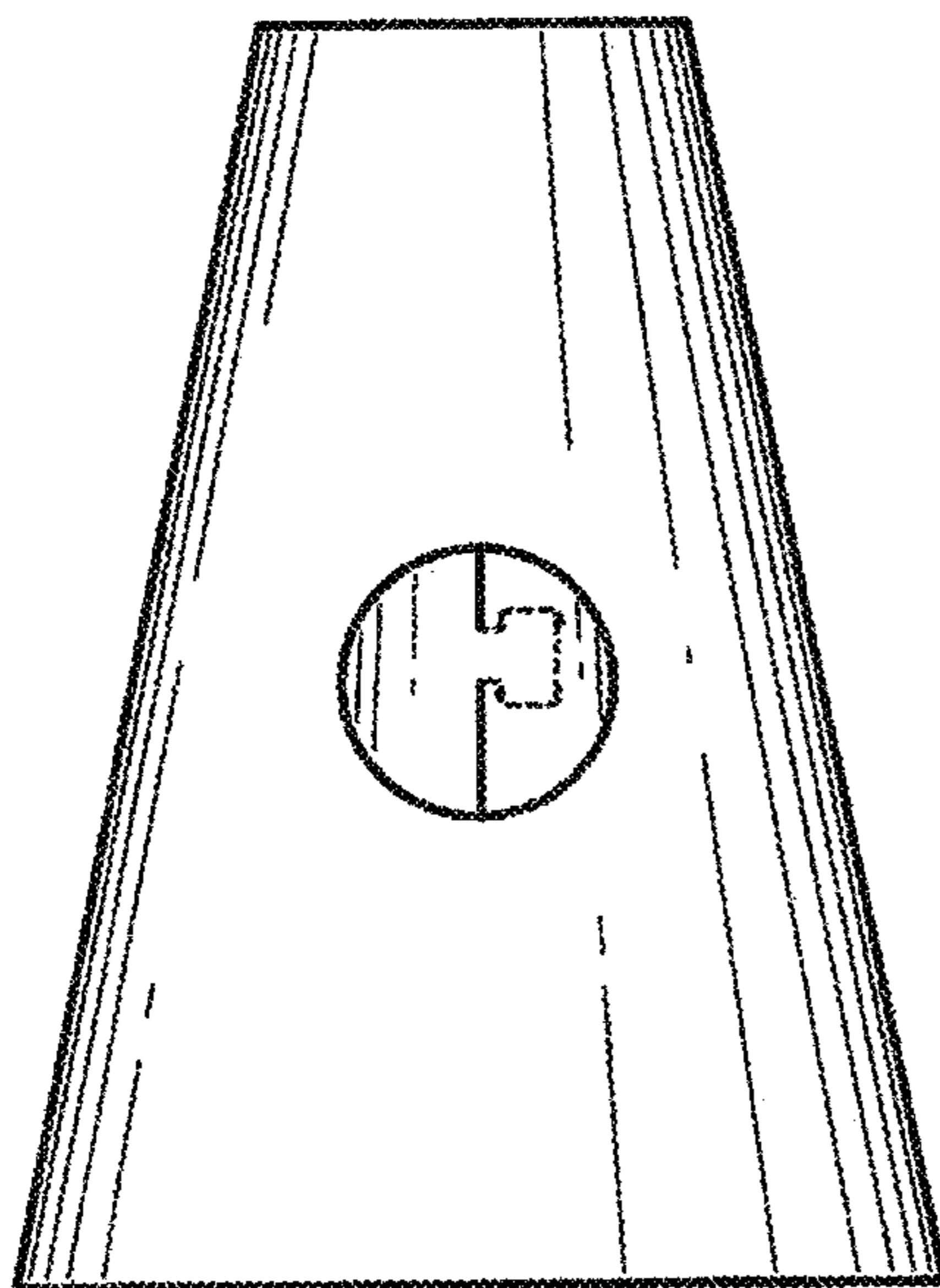

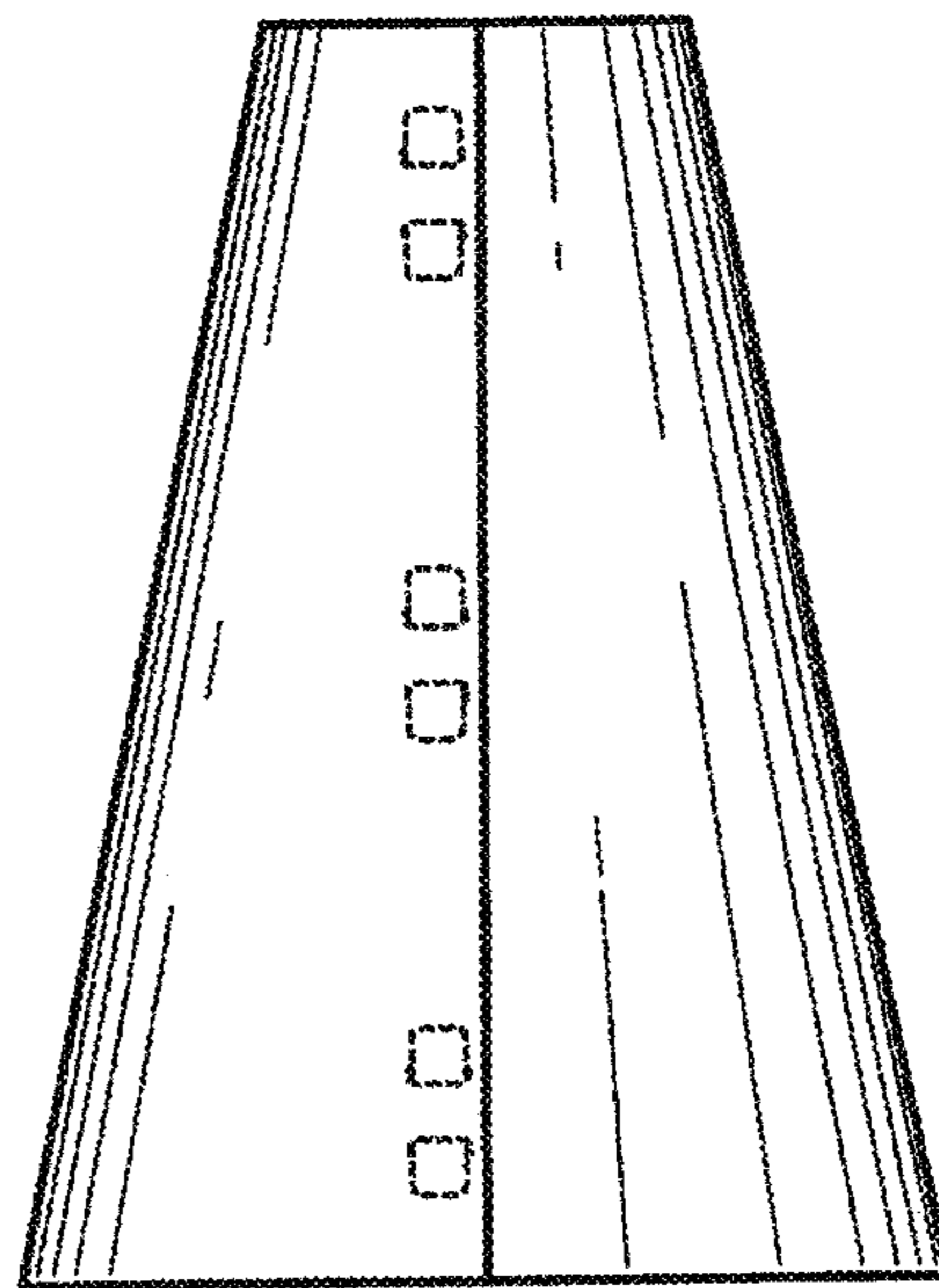

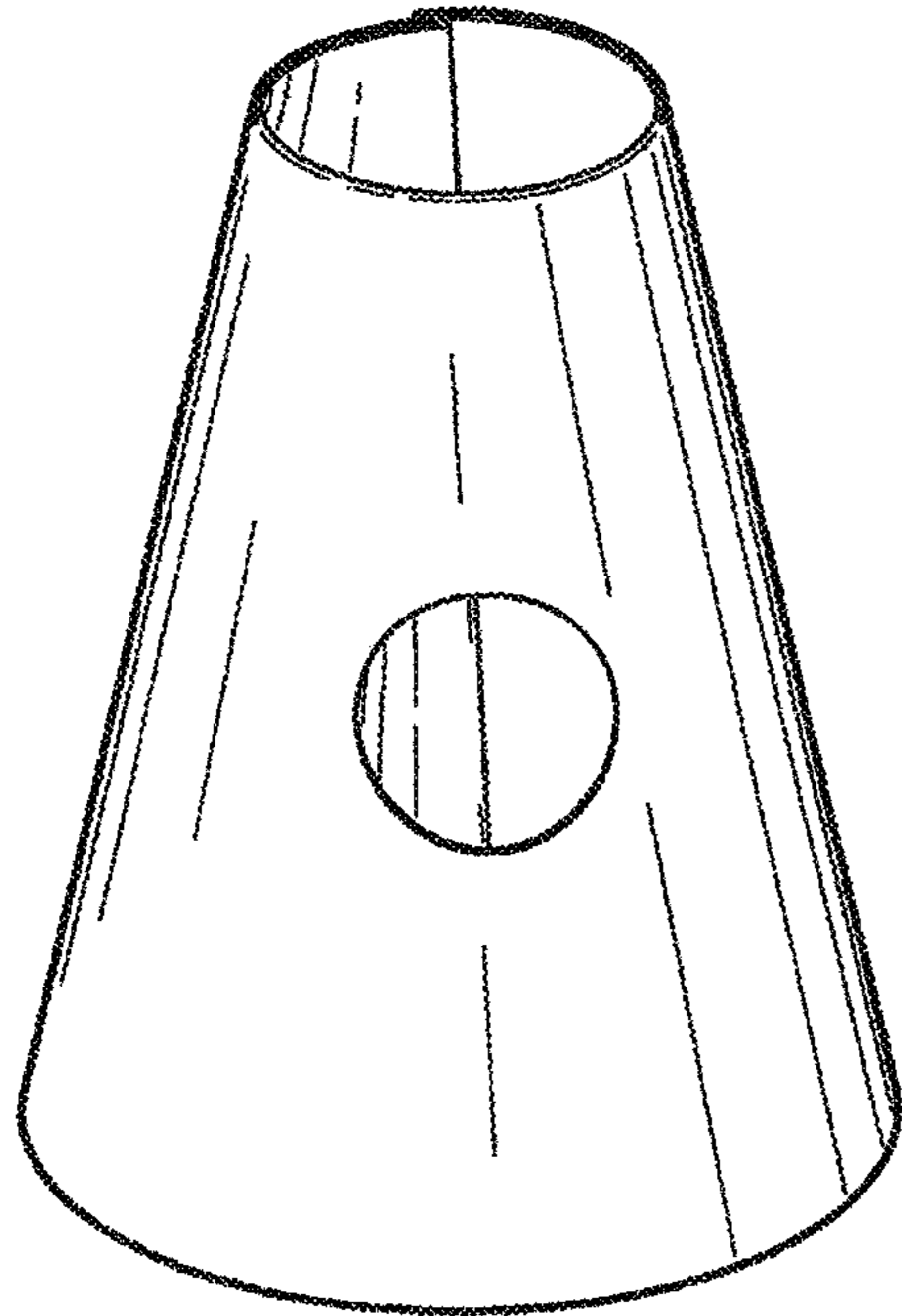

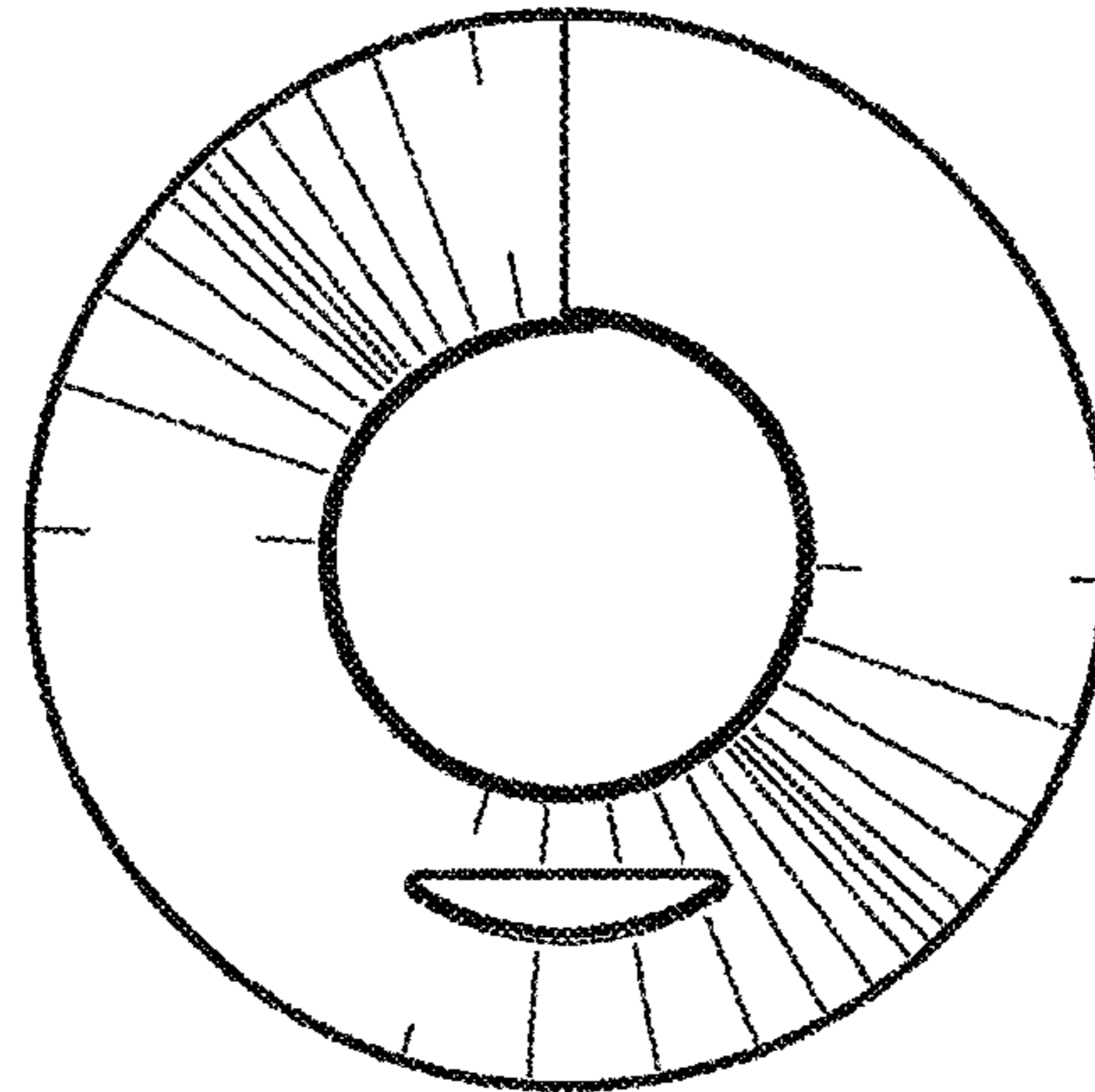

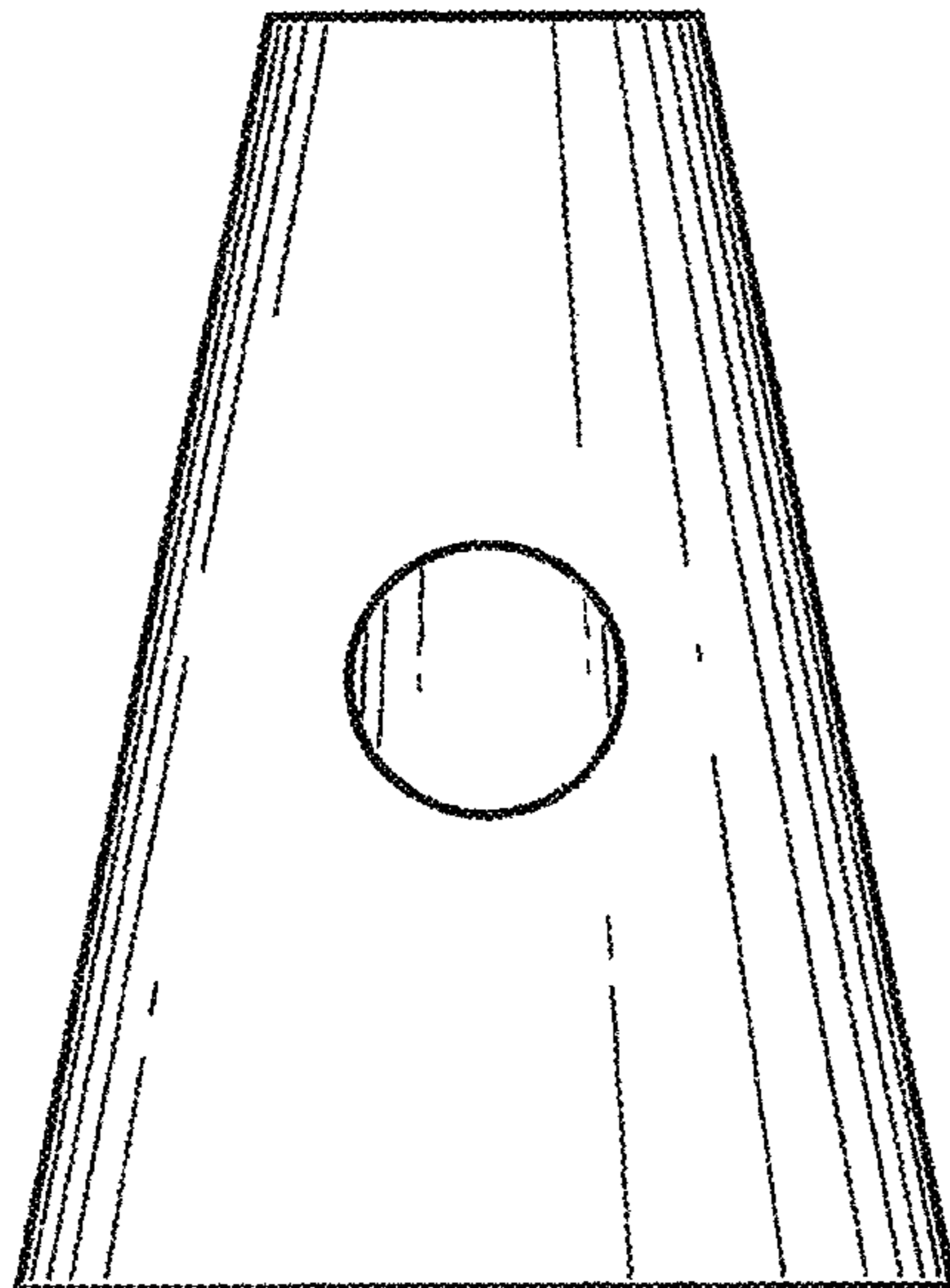

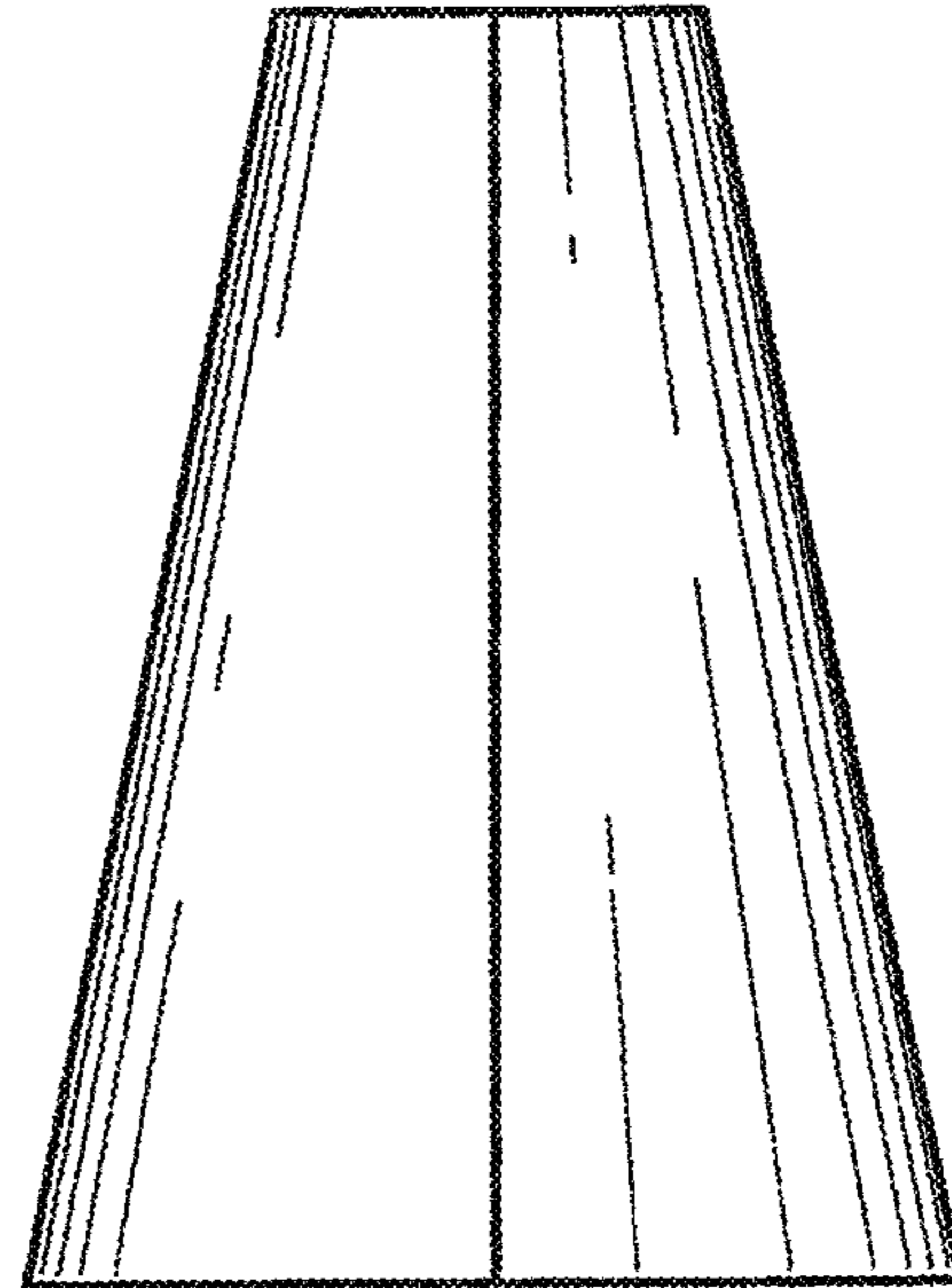

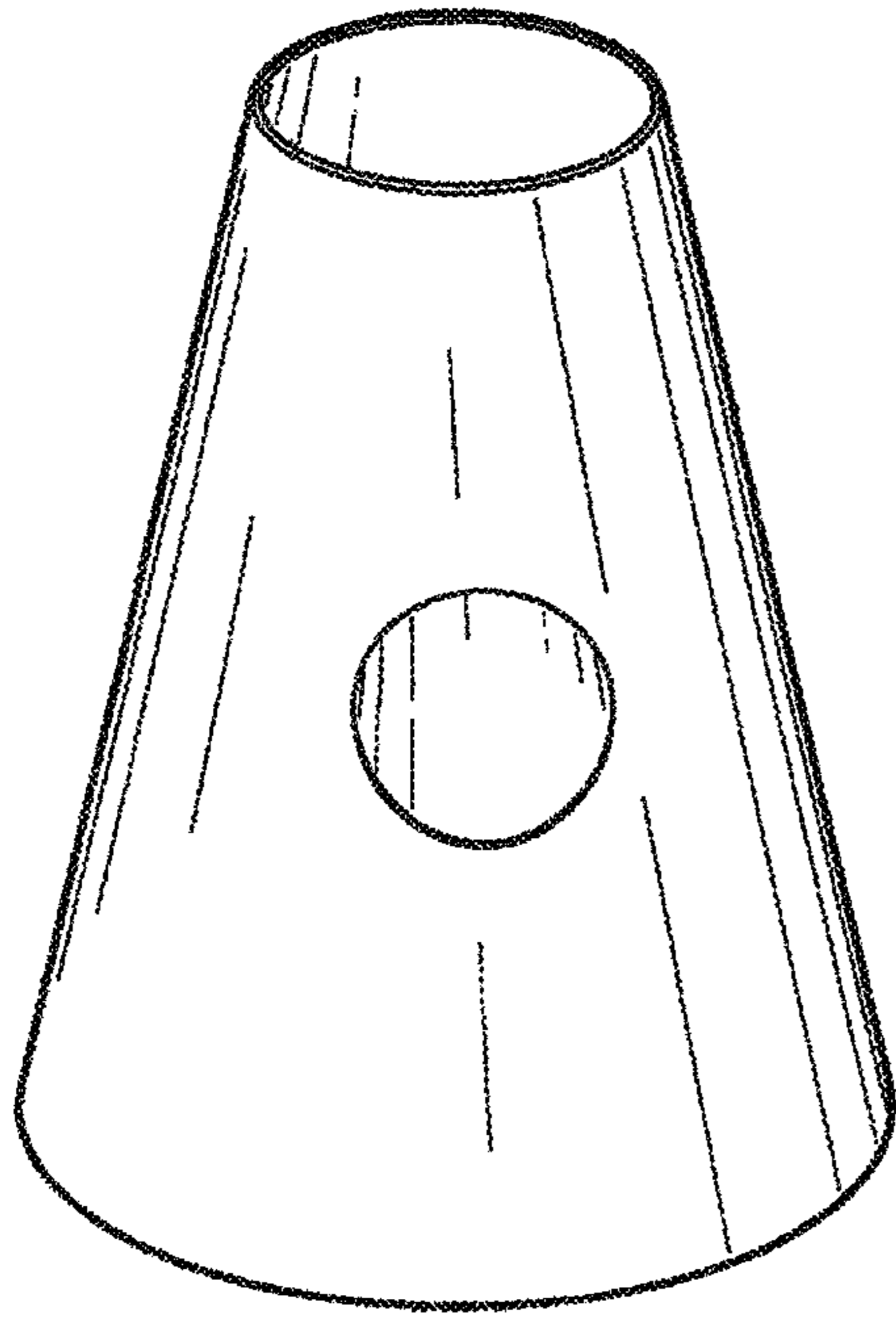

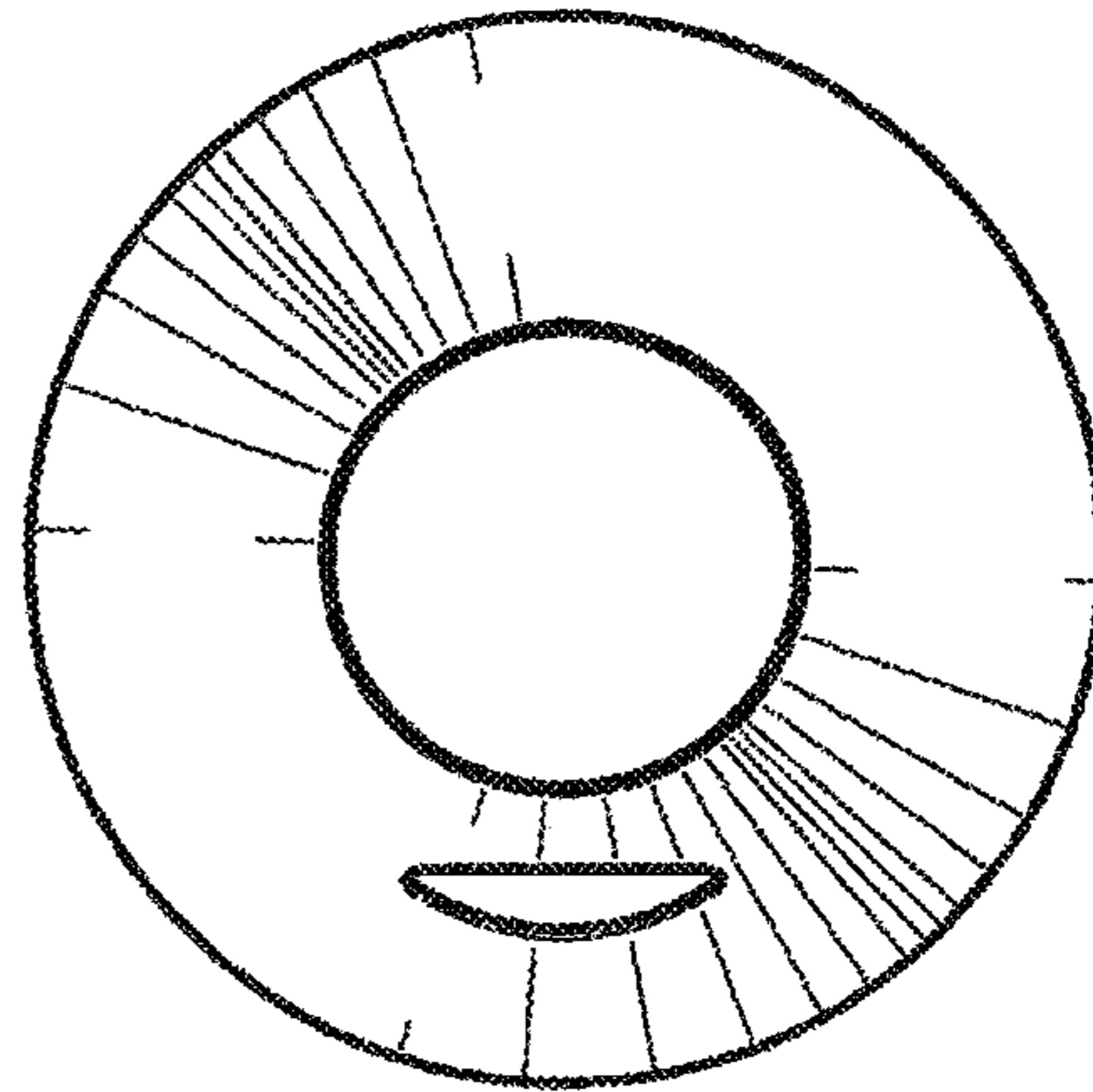

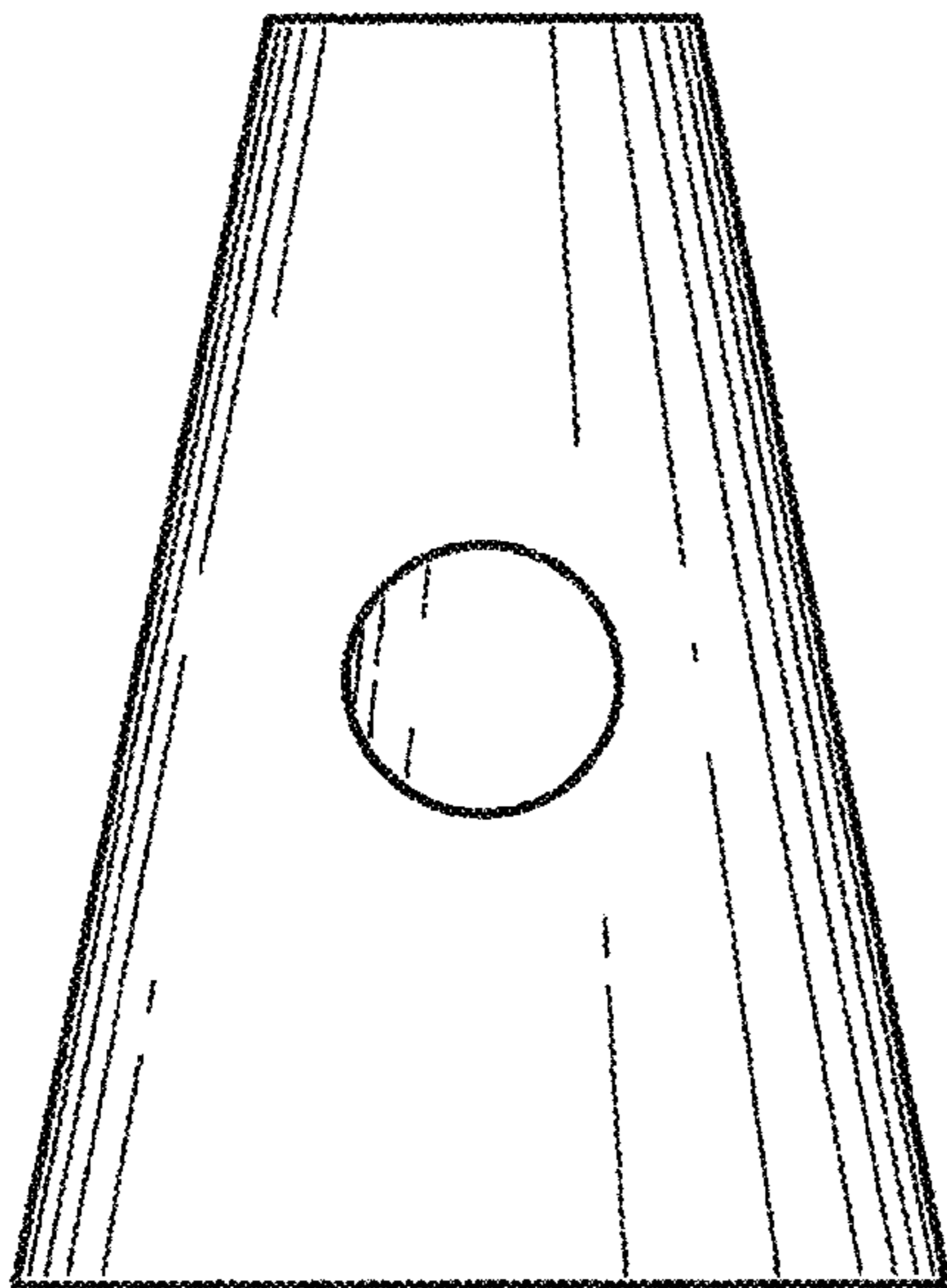

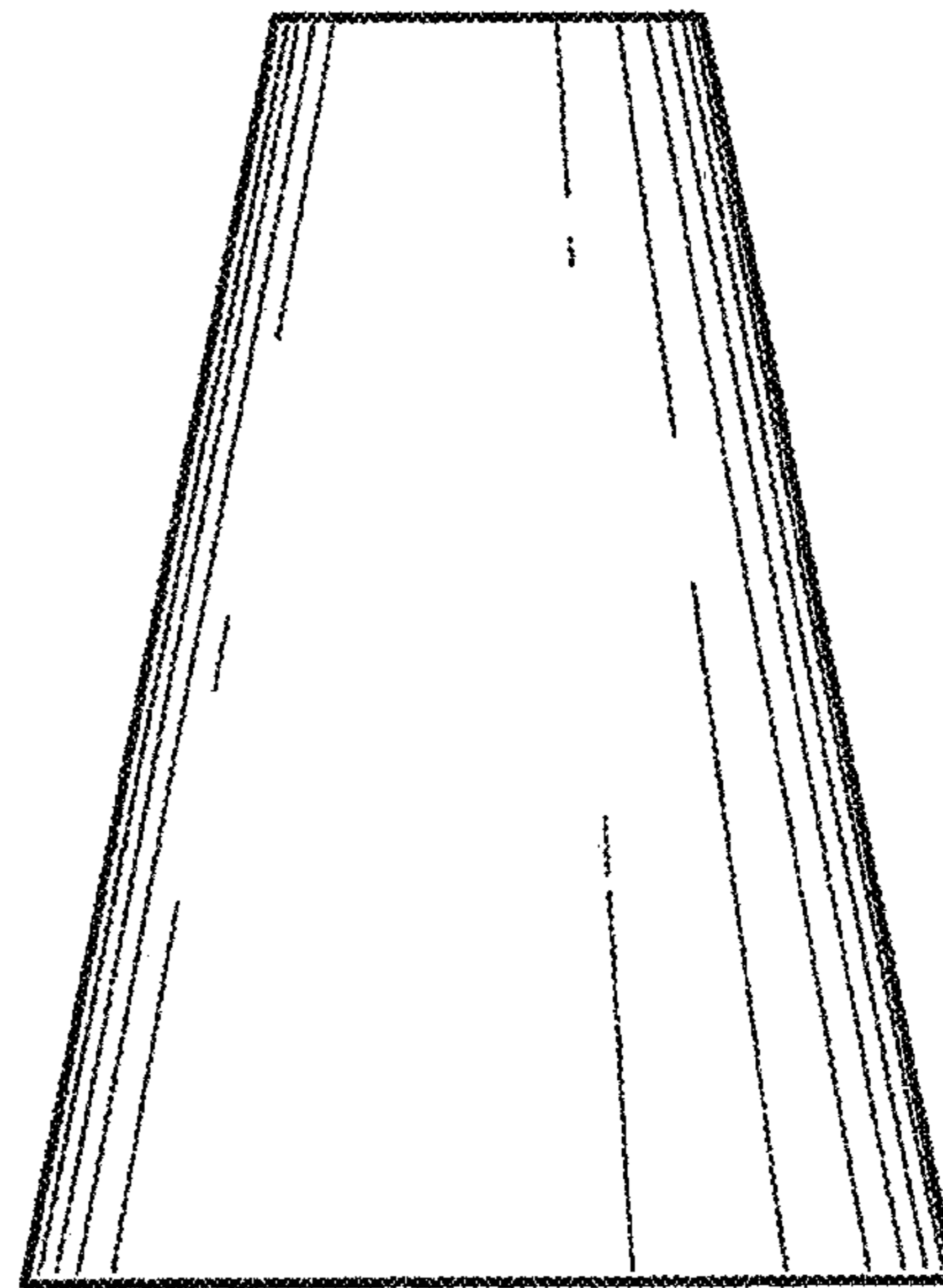
