FIG. 5 is view of the opposite side thereof.

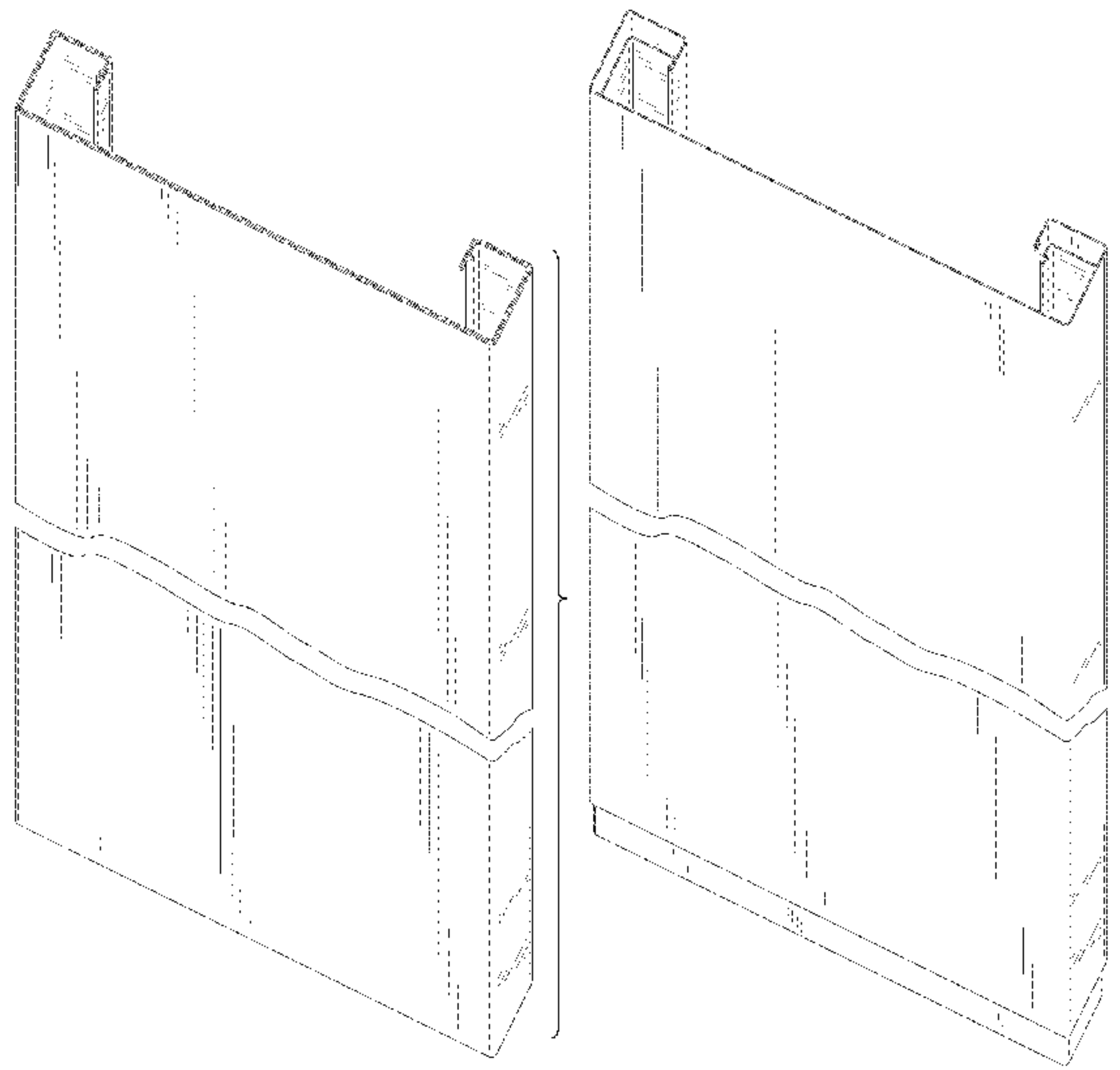
FIG. 6 is a front view thereof.

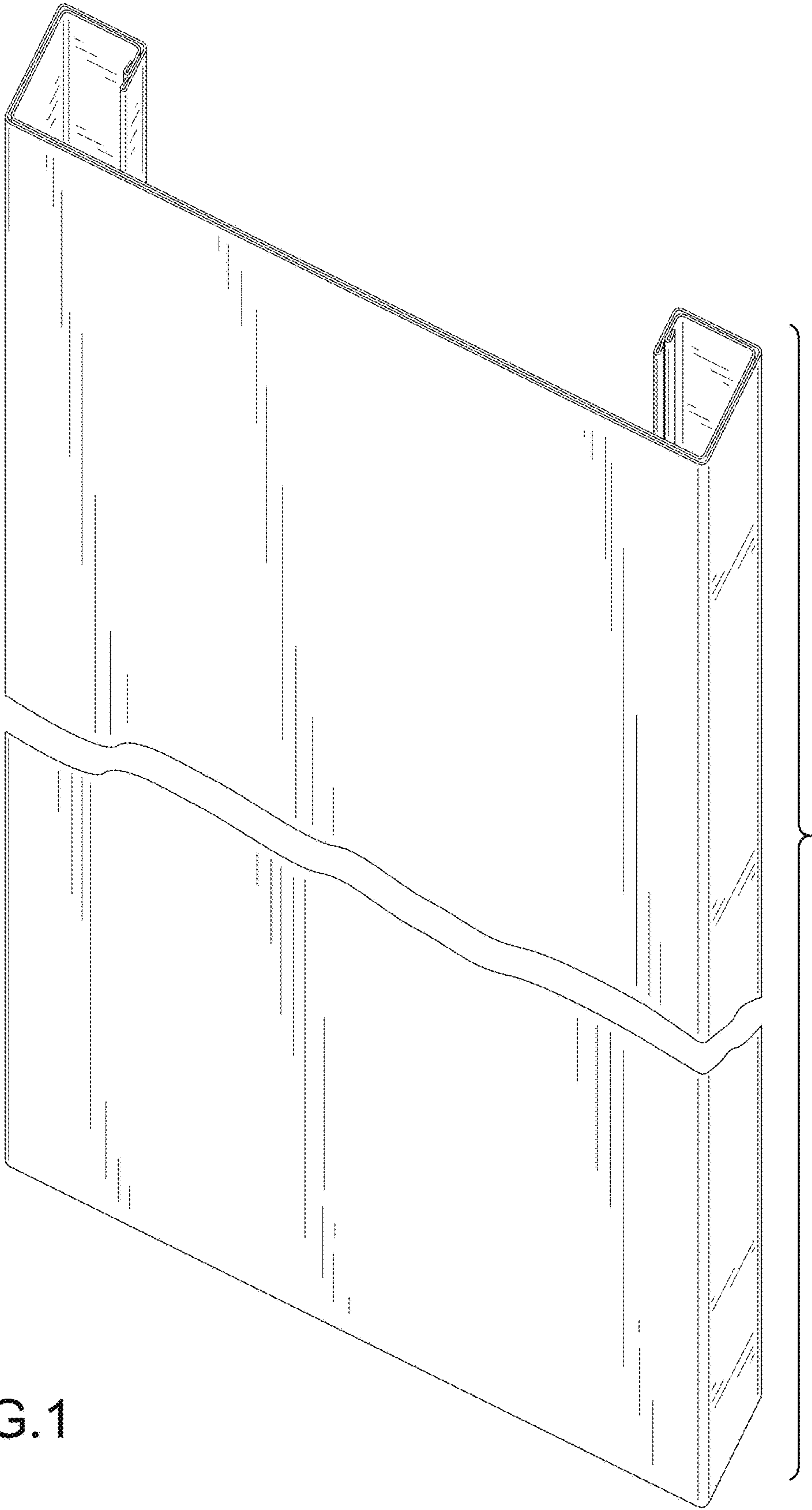

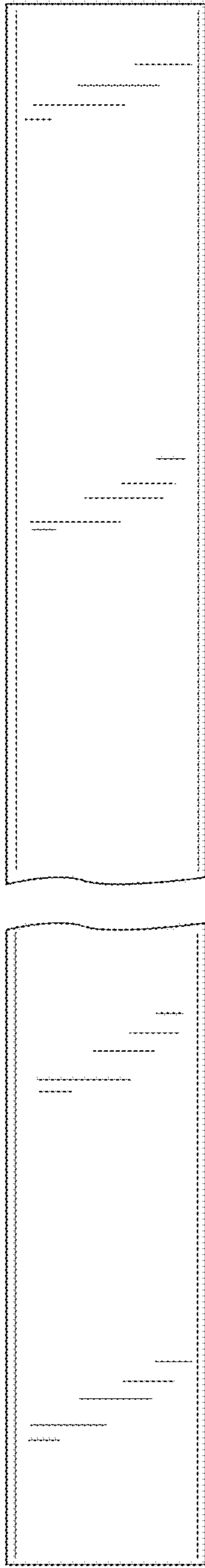

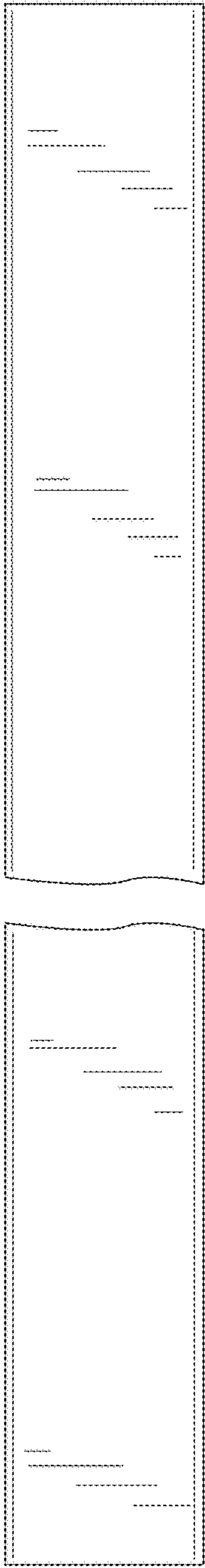

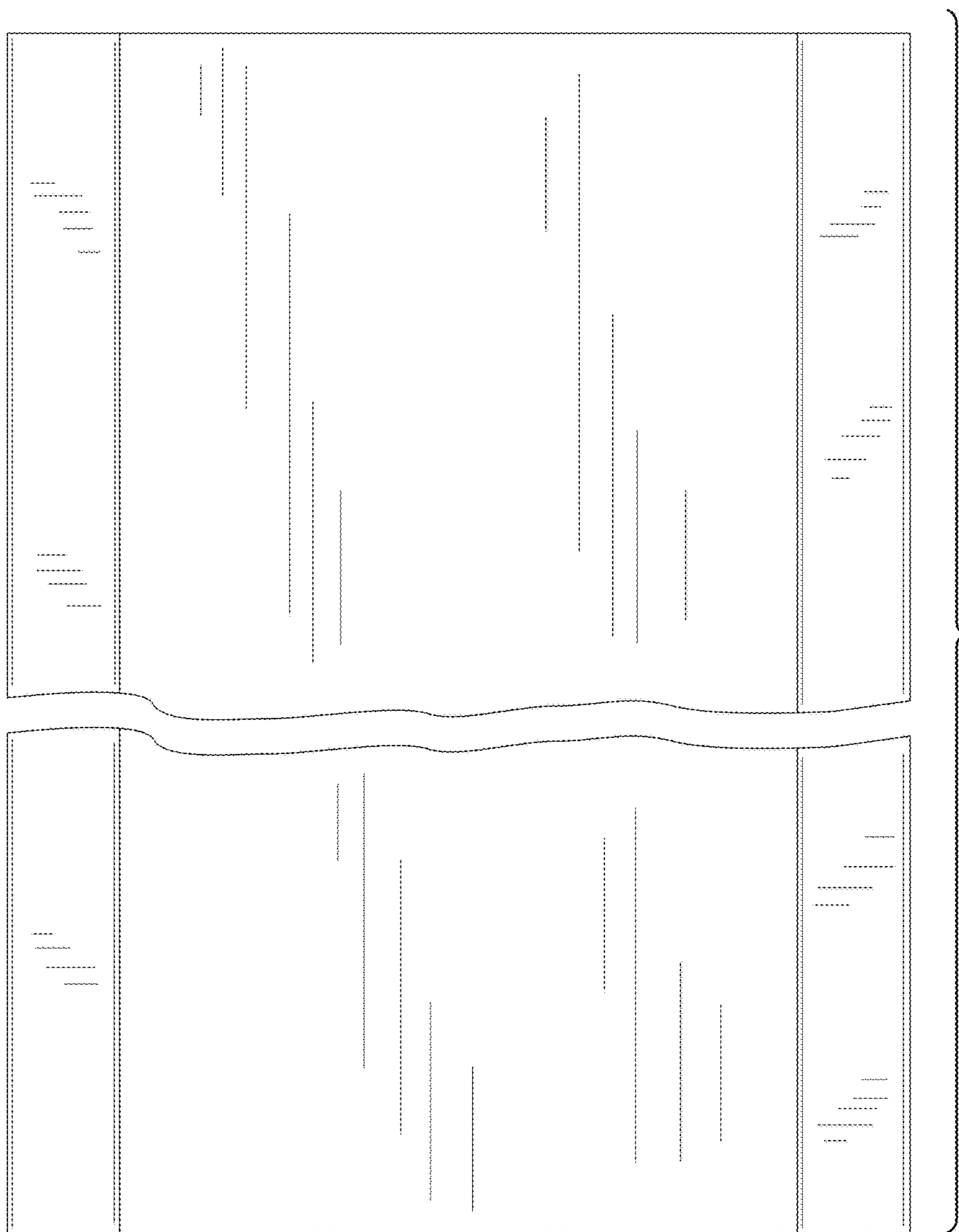

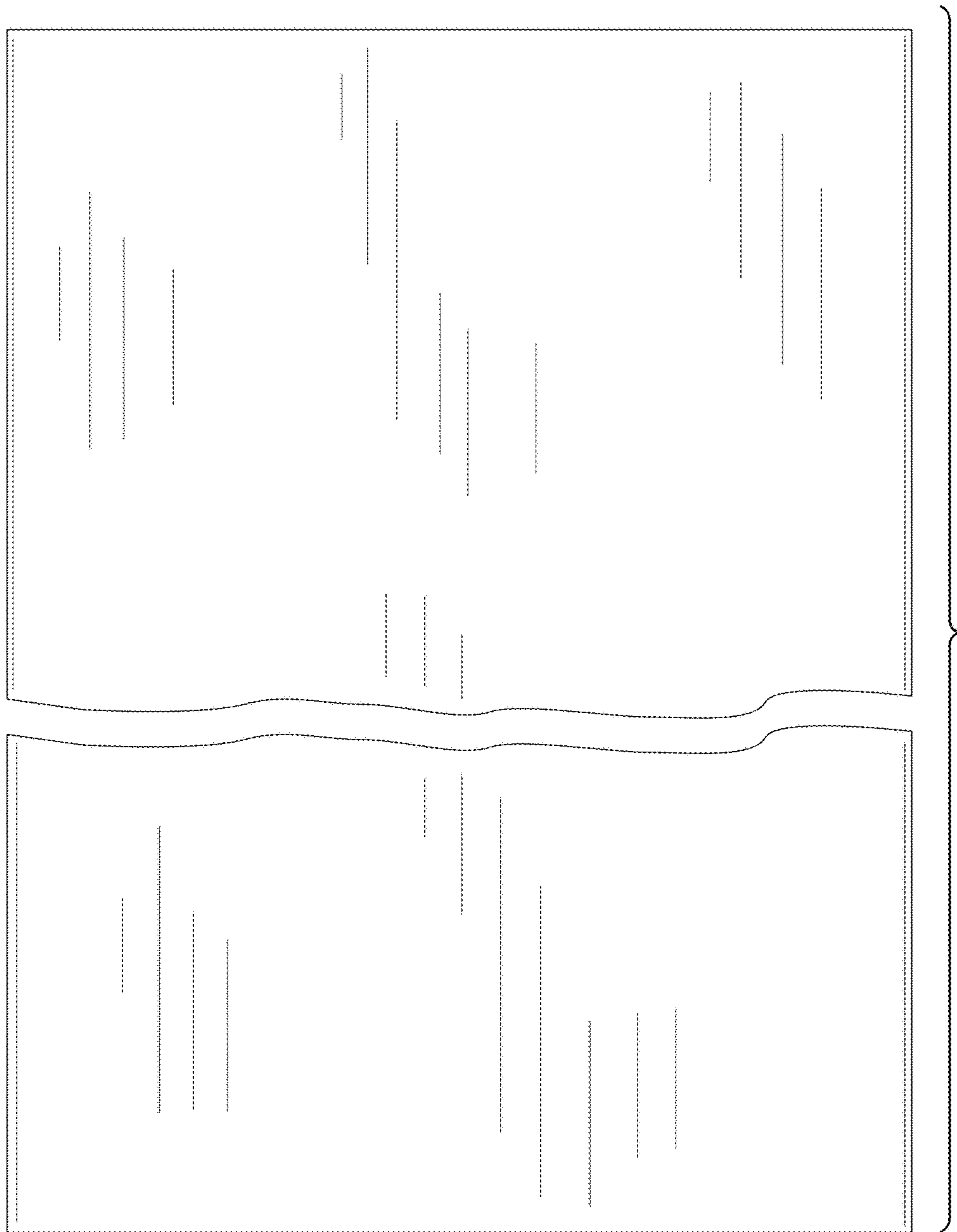

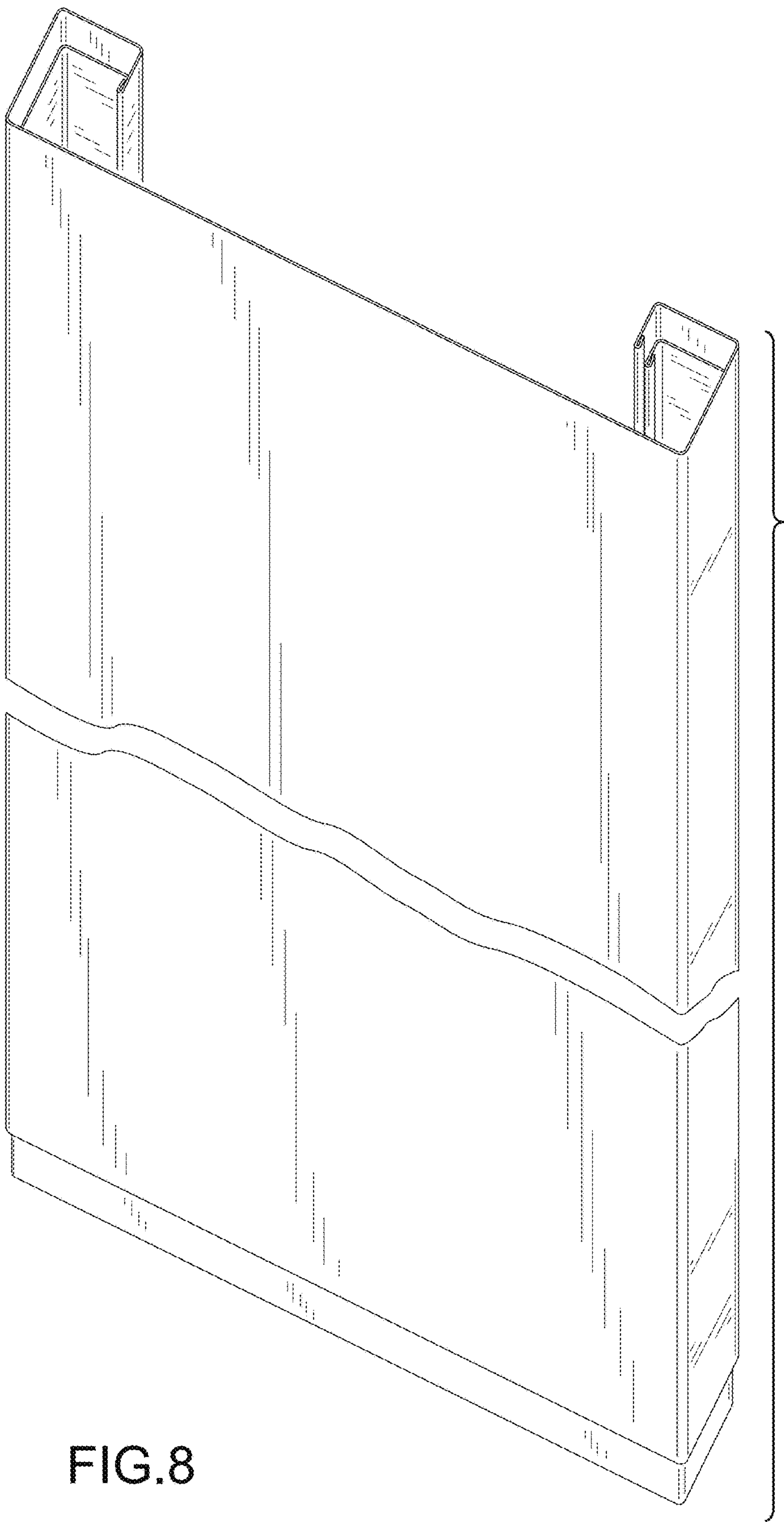
