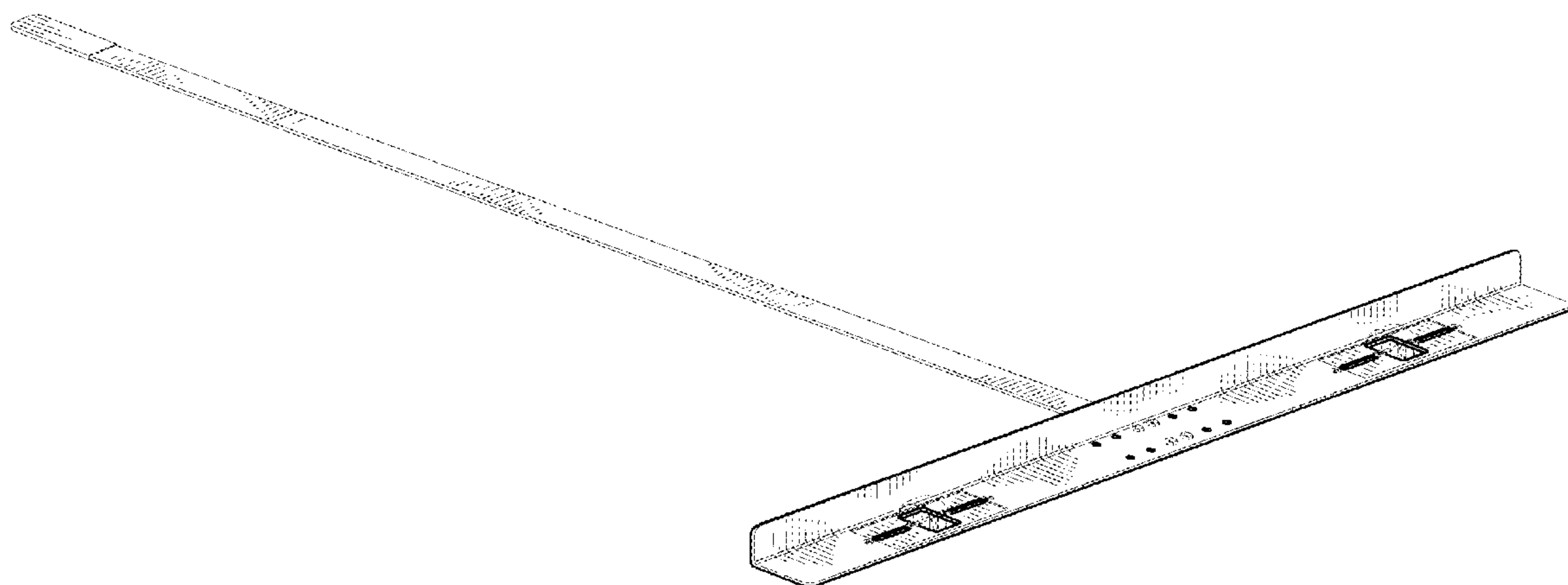
The ornamental design for a loading and unloading apparatus for truck beds, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a loading and unloading apparatus for truck beds, showing our new design;

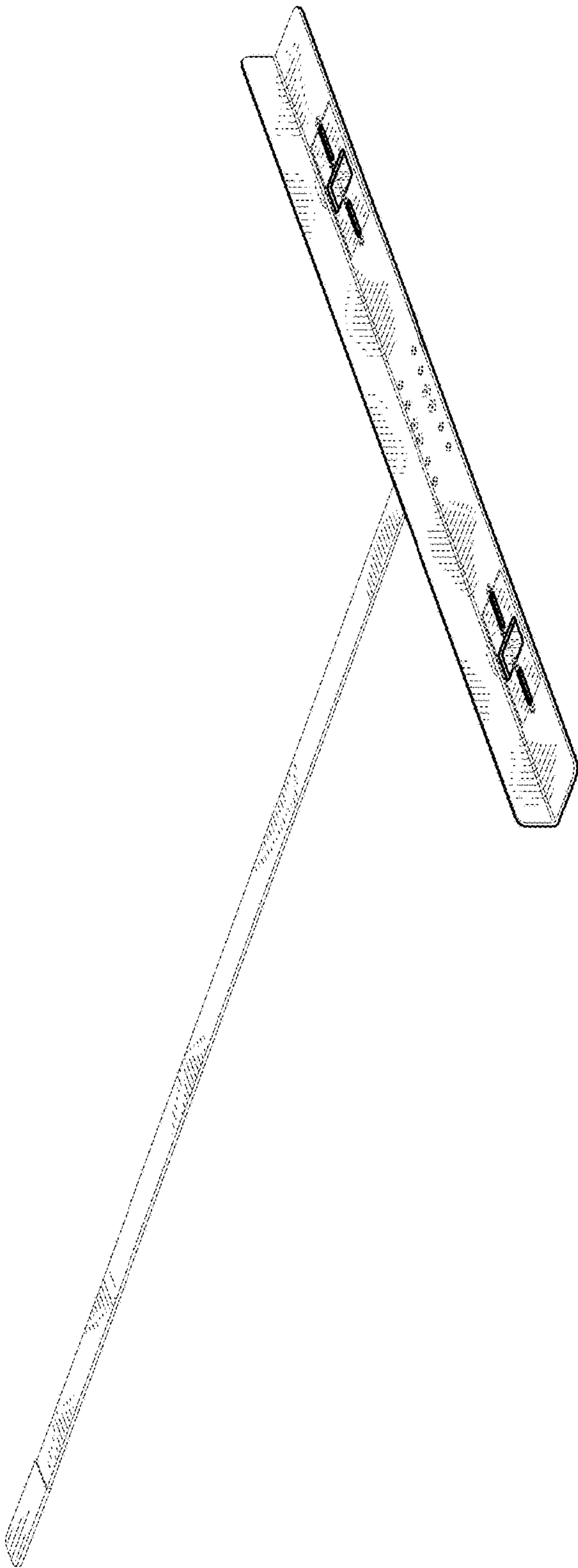

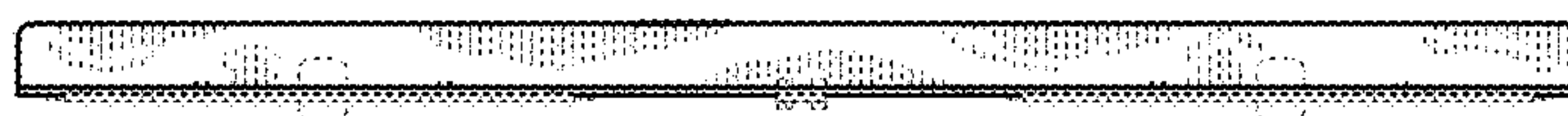

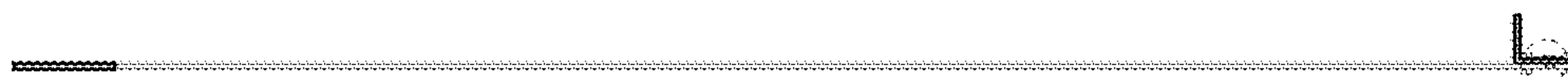

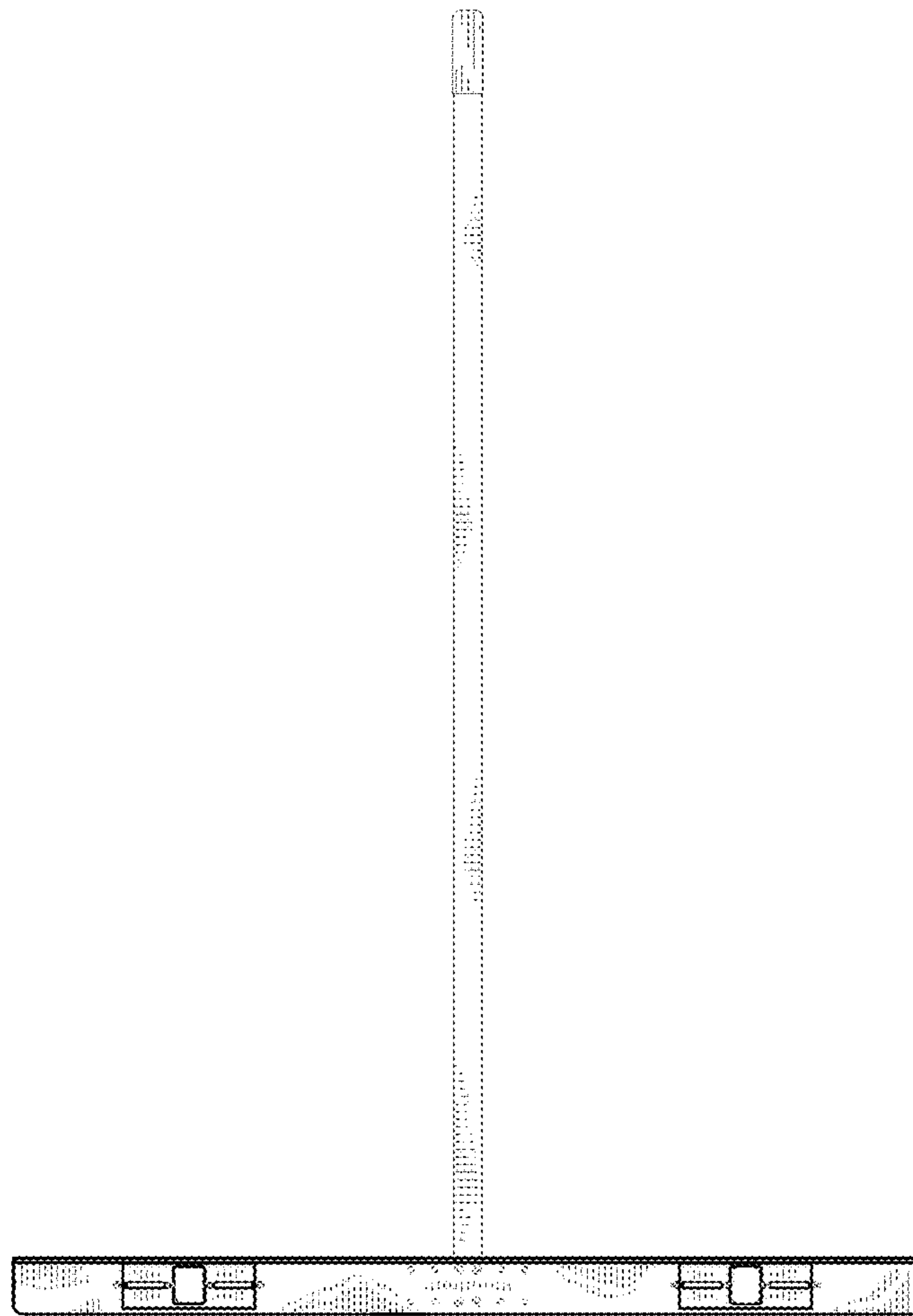

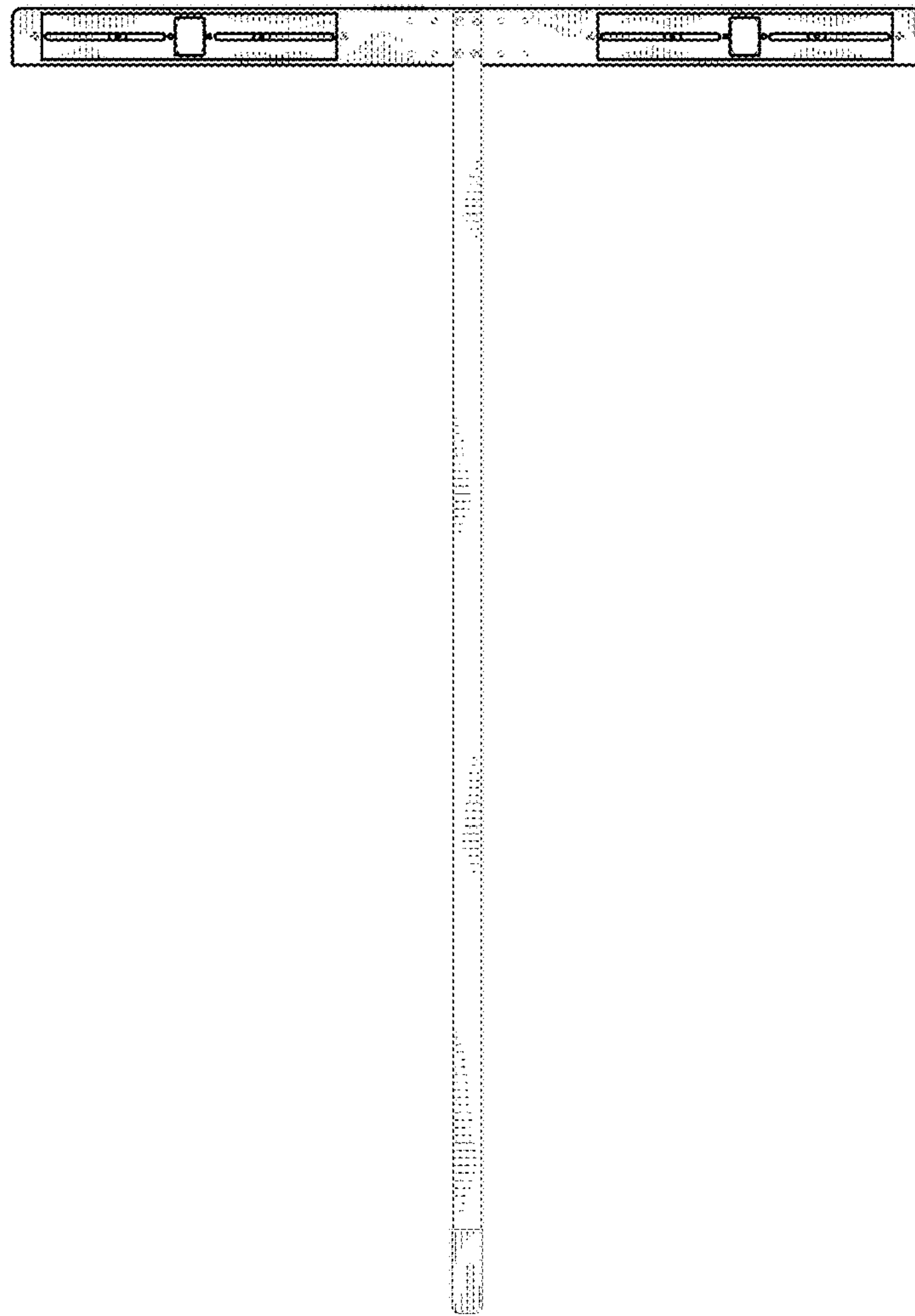

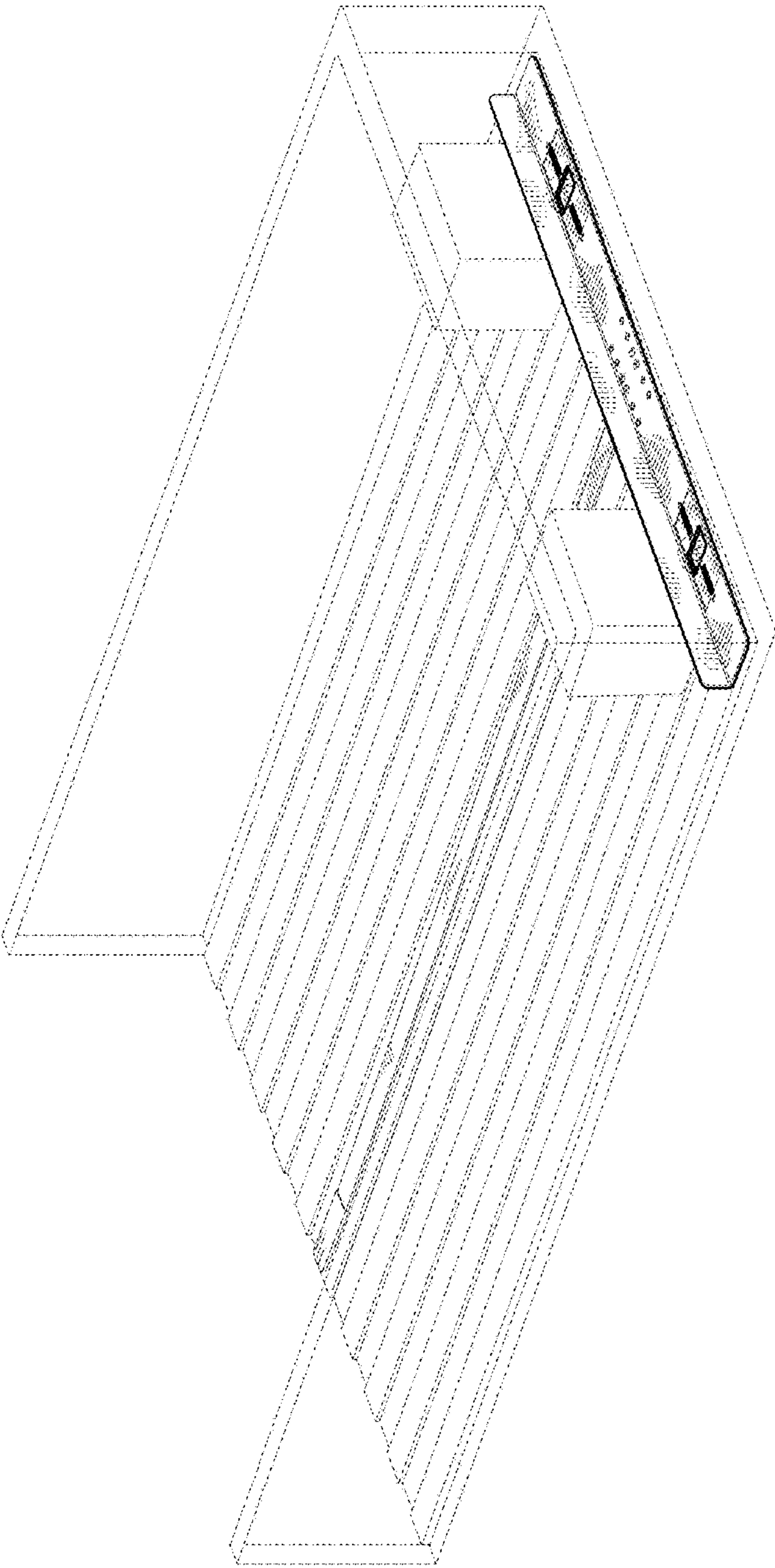
