DESCRIPTION

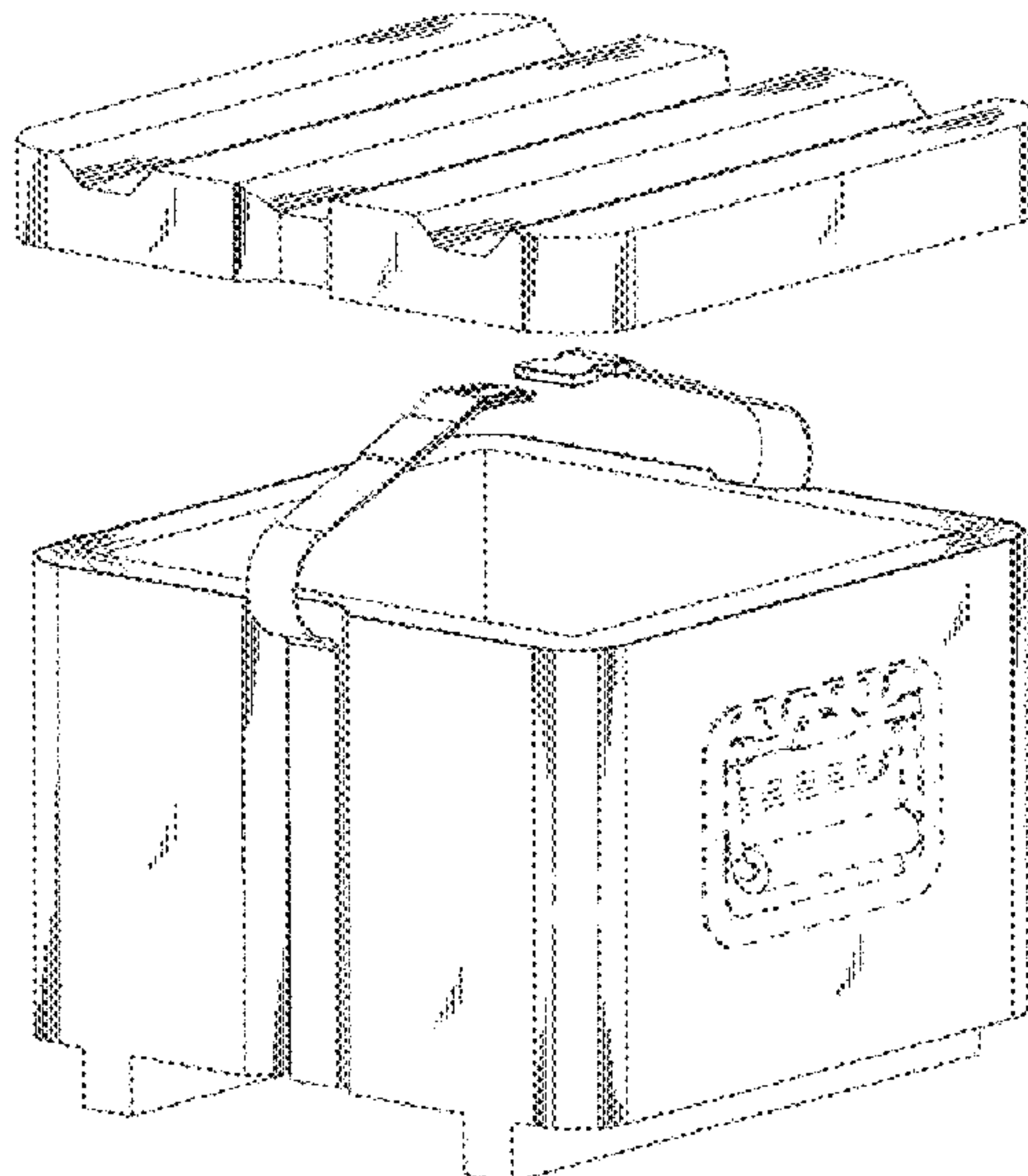
FIG. 1 is a perspective view illustrating a stackable container of the invention, showing our new design;

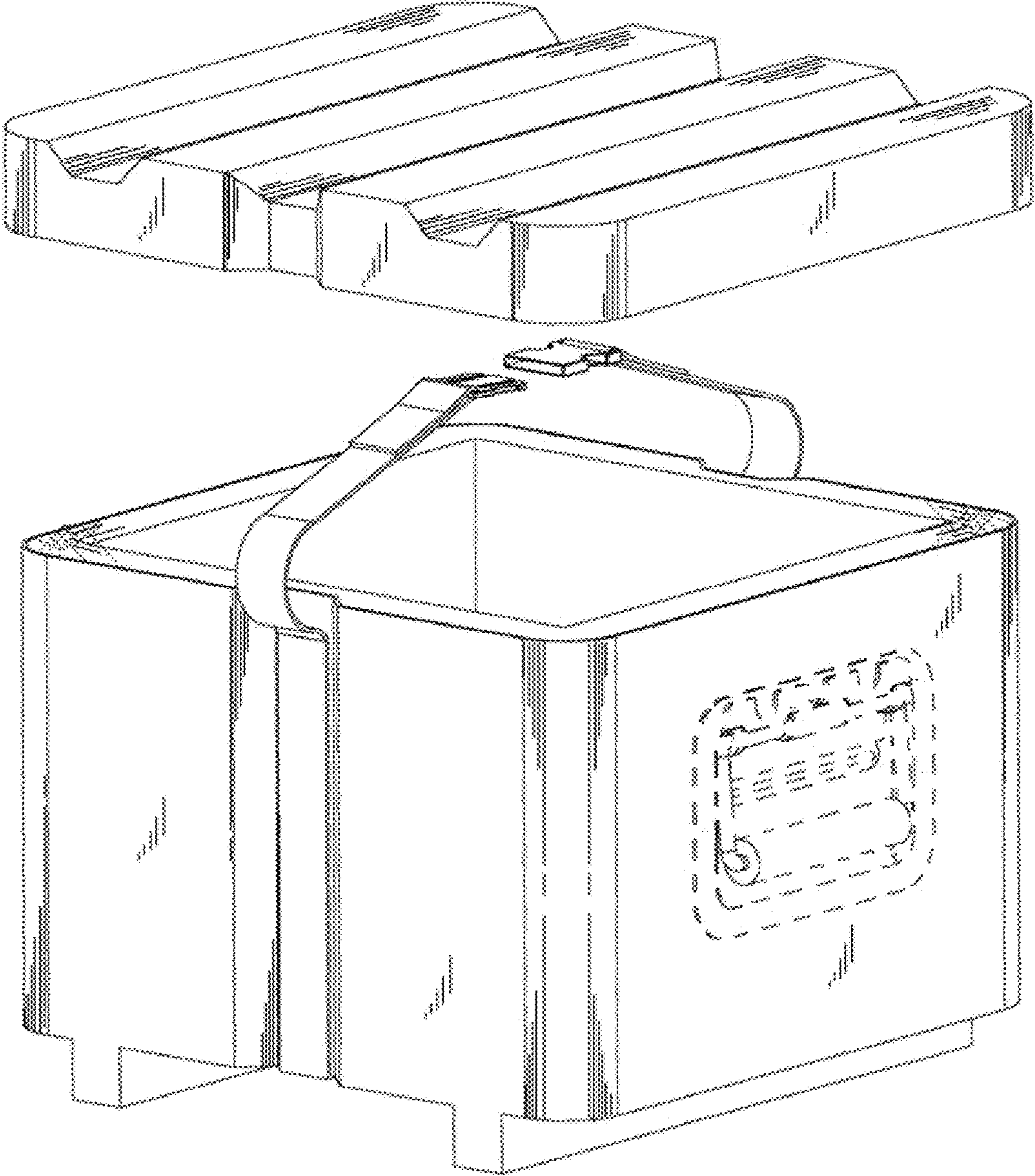

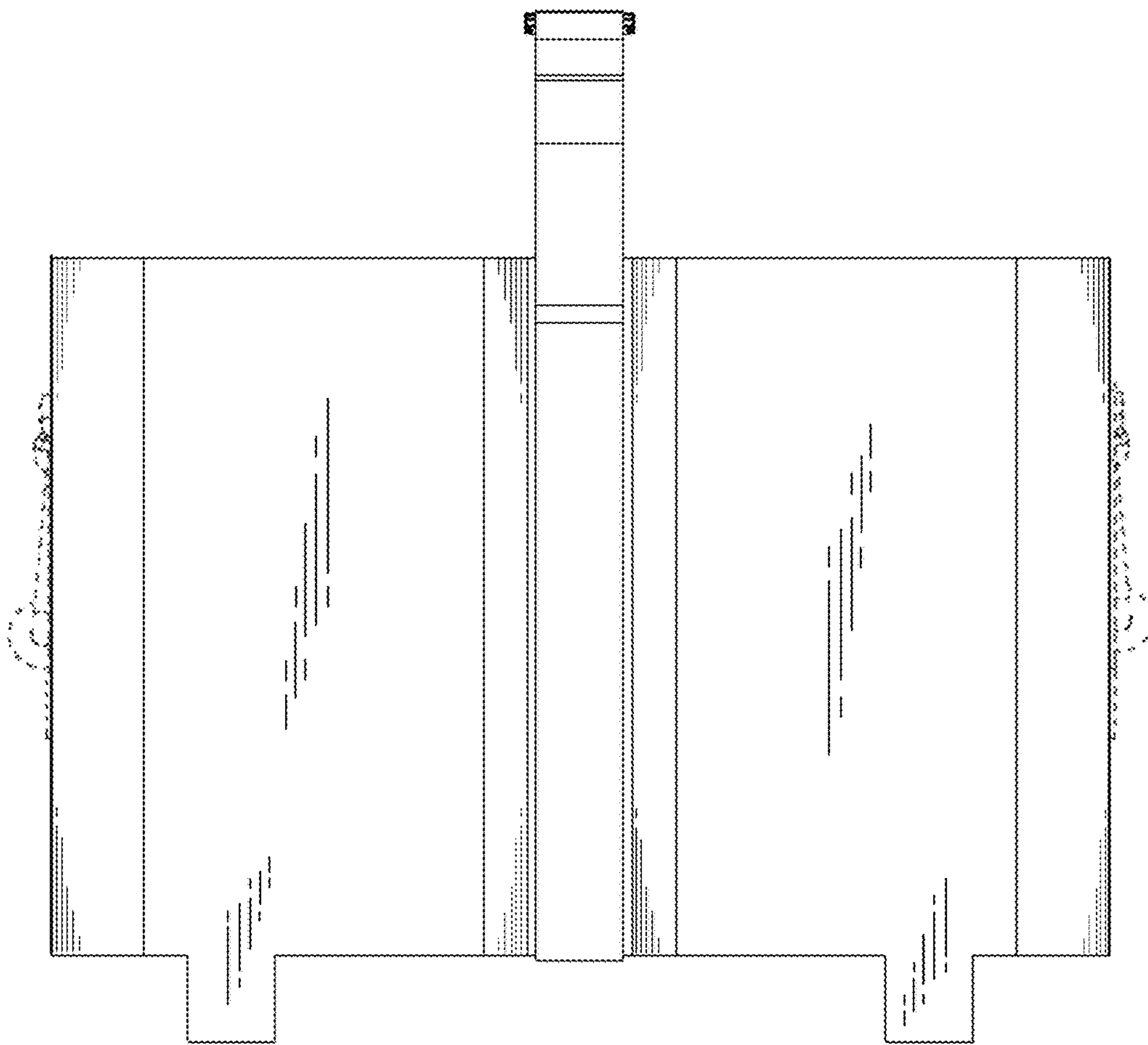
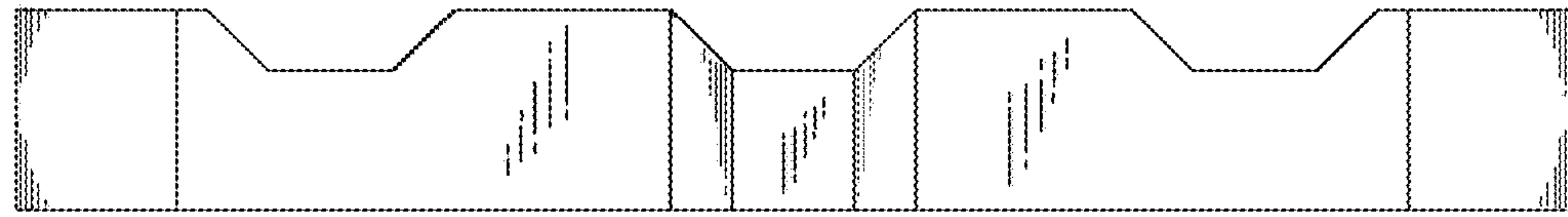

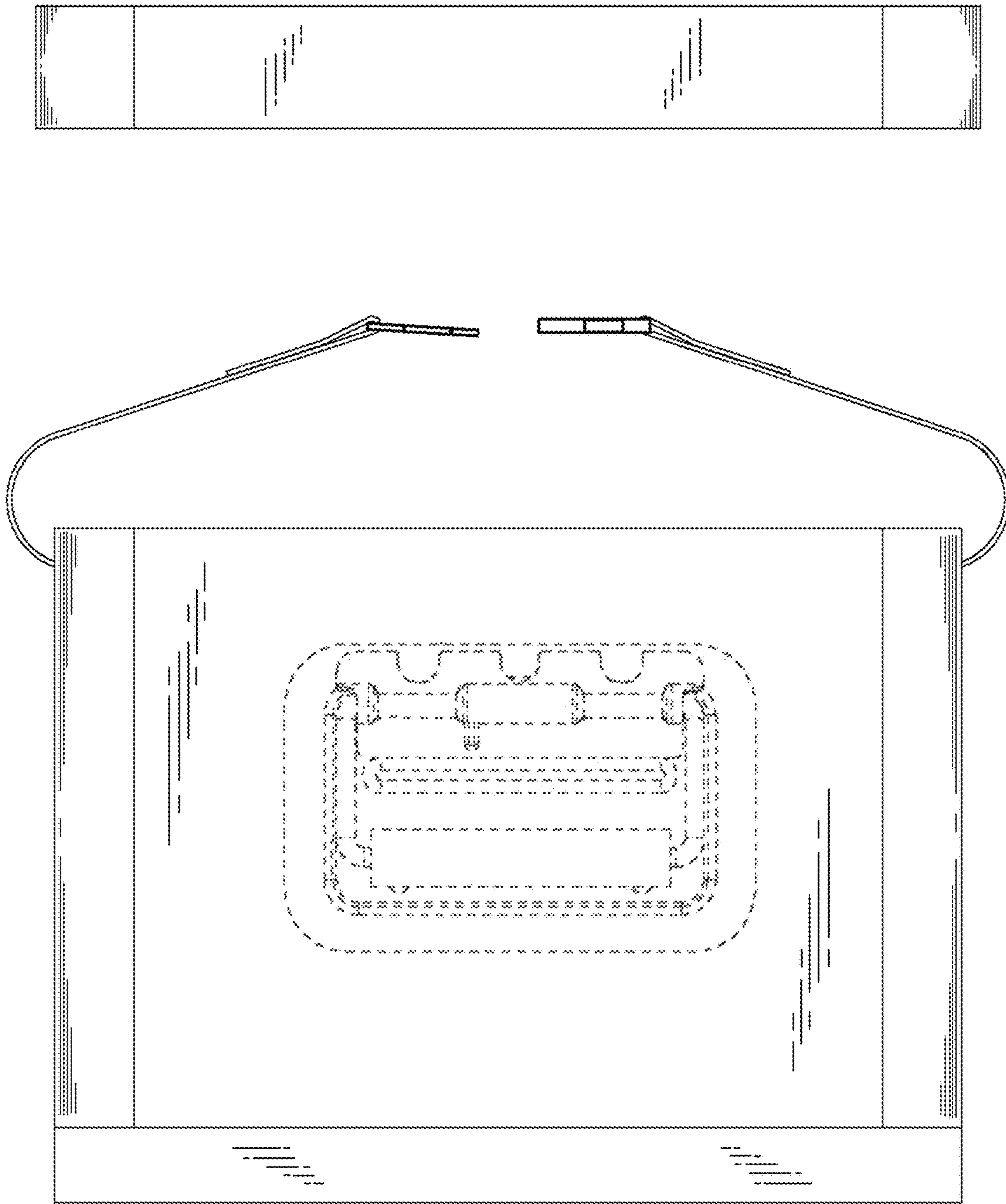

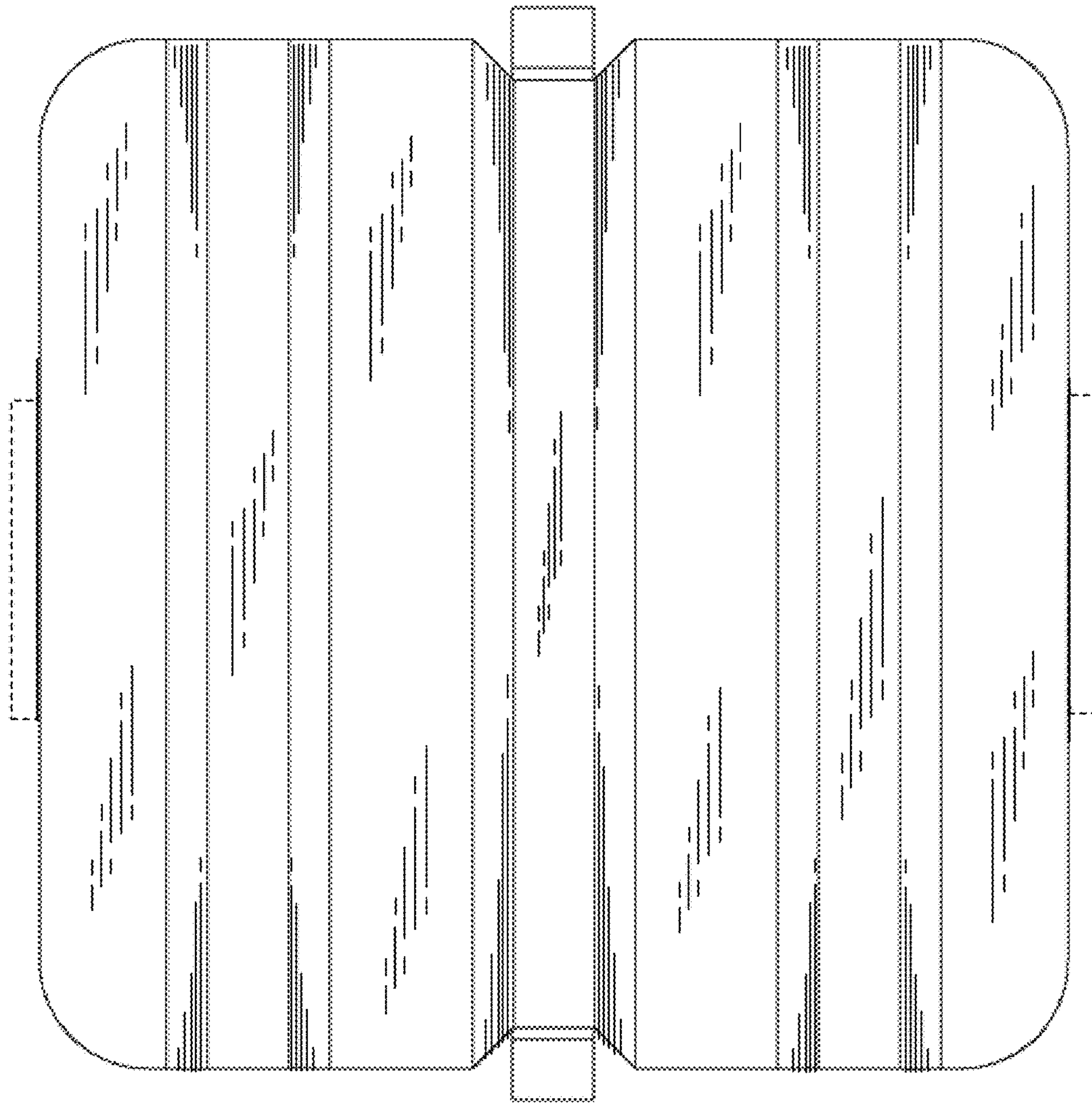

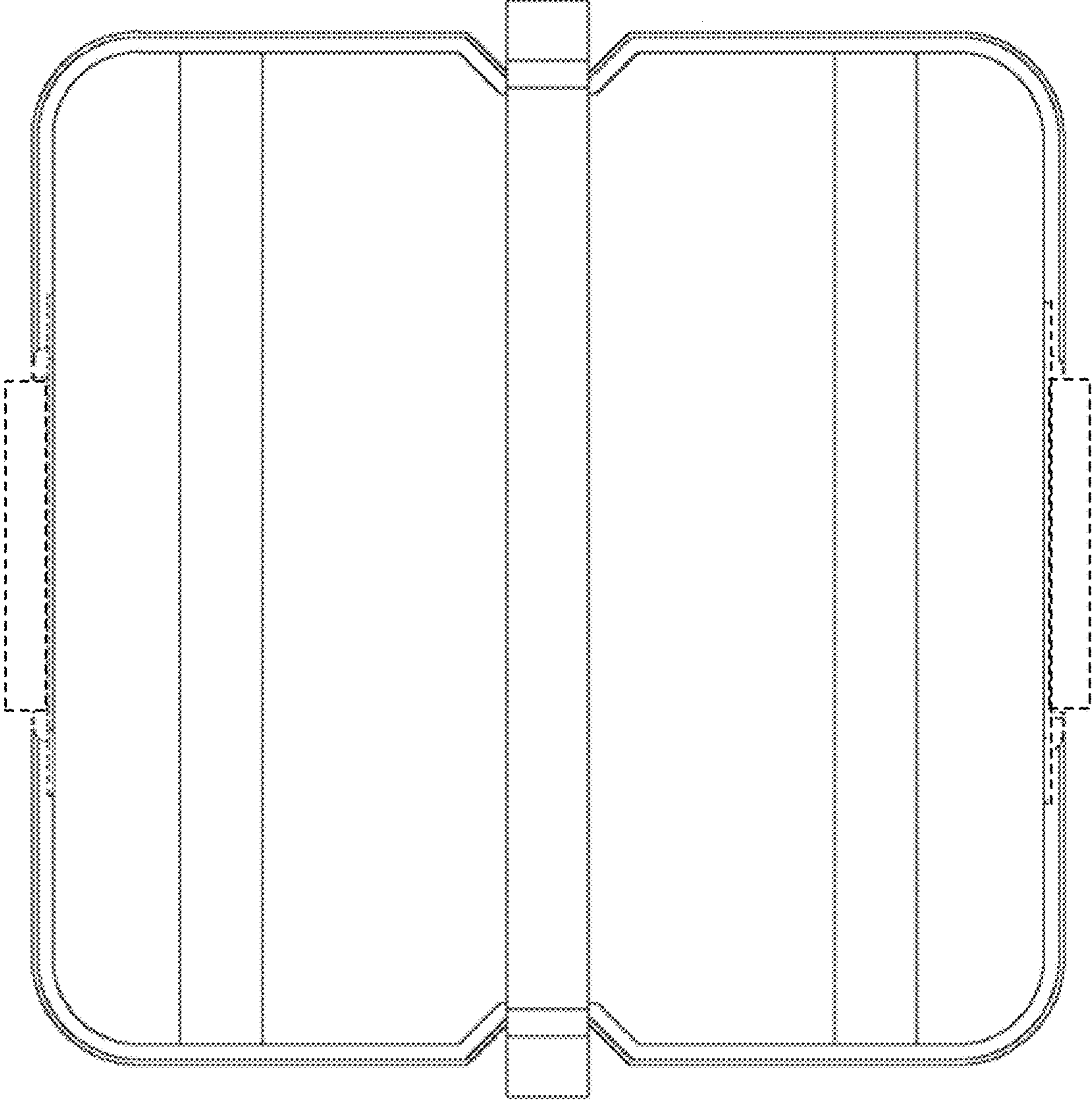
