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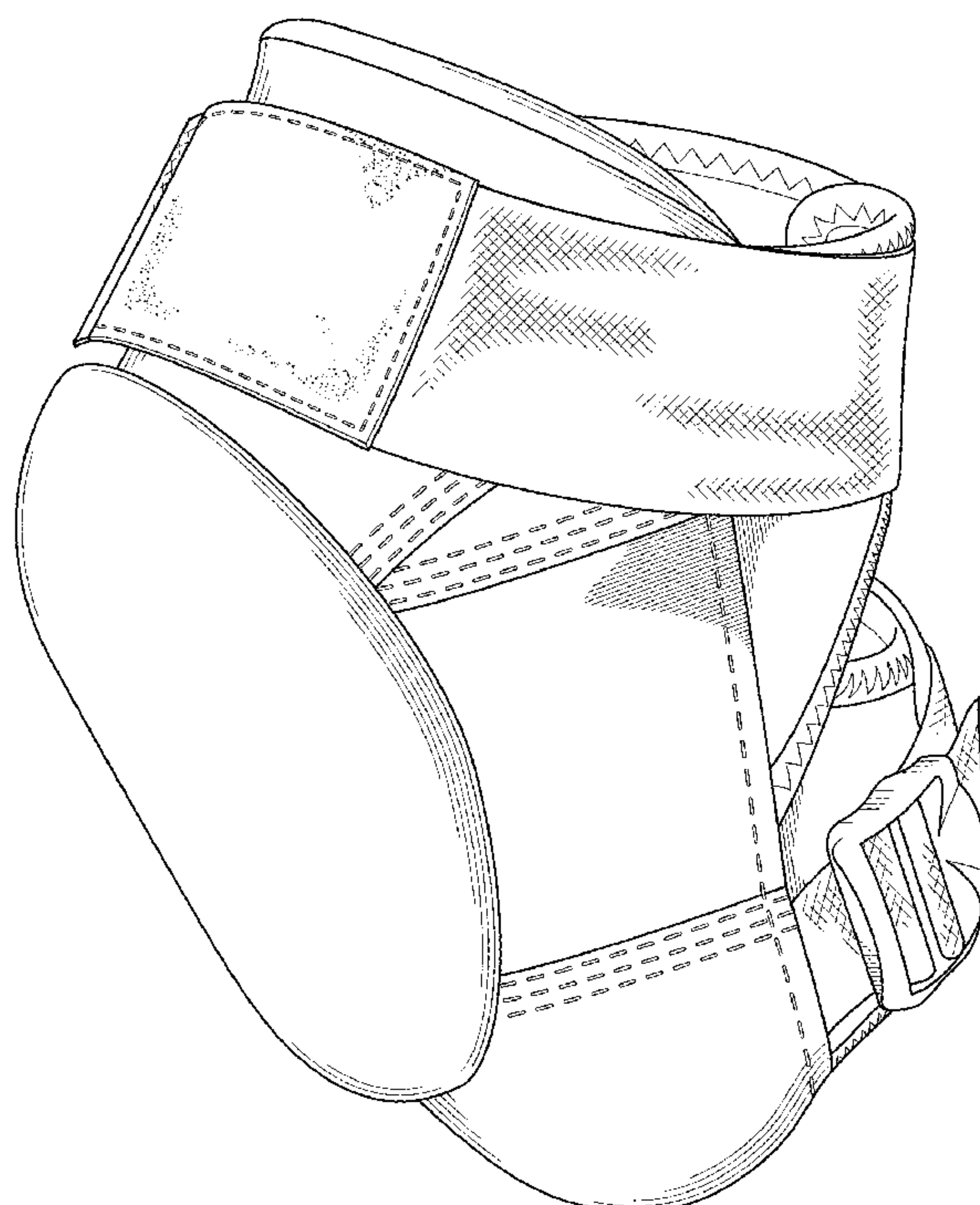
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a knee pad according to one embodiment of the present invention. FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of a knee pad according to the embodiment of the present invention shown in FIG. 1. FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of a knee pad according to the embodiment of the present invention shown in FIG. 1. 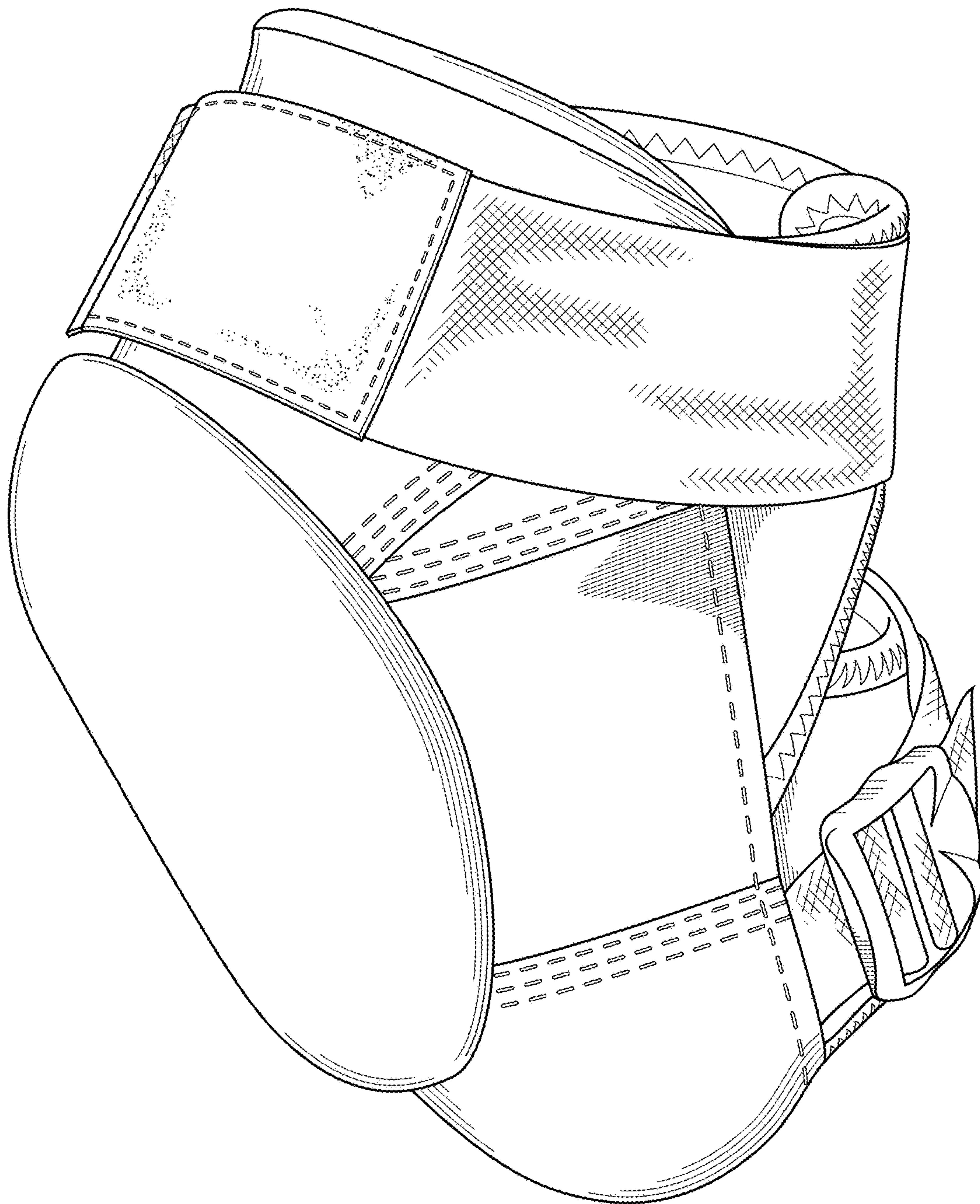

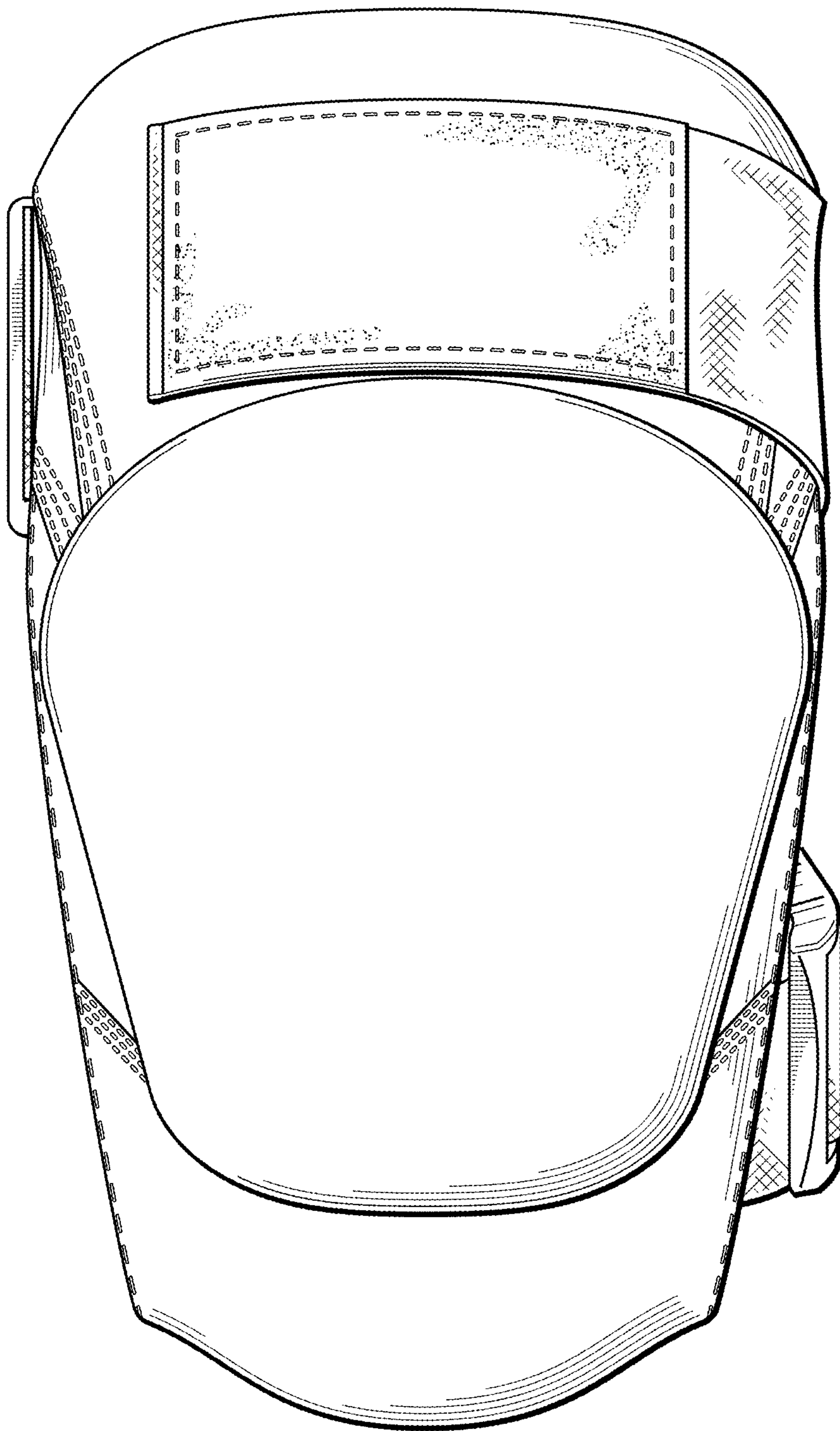

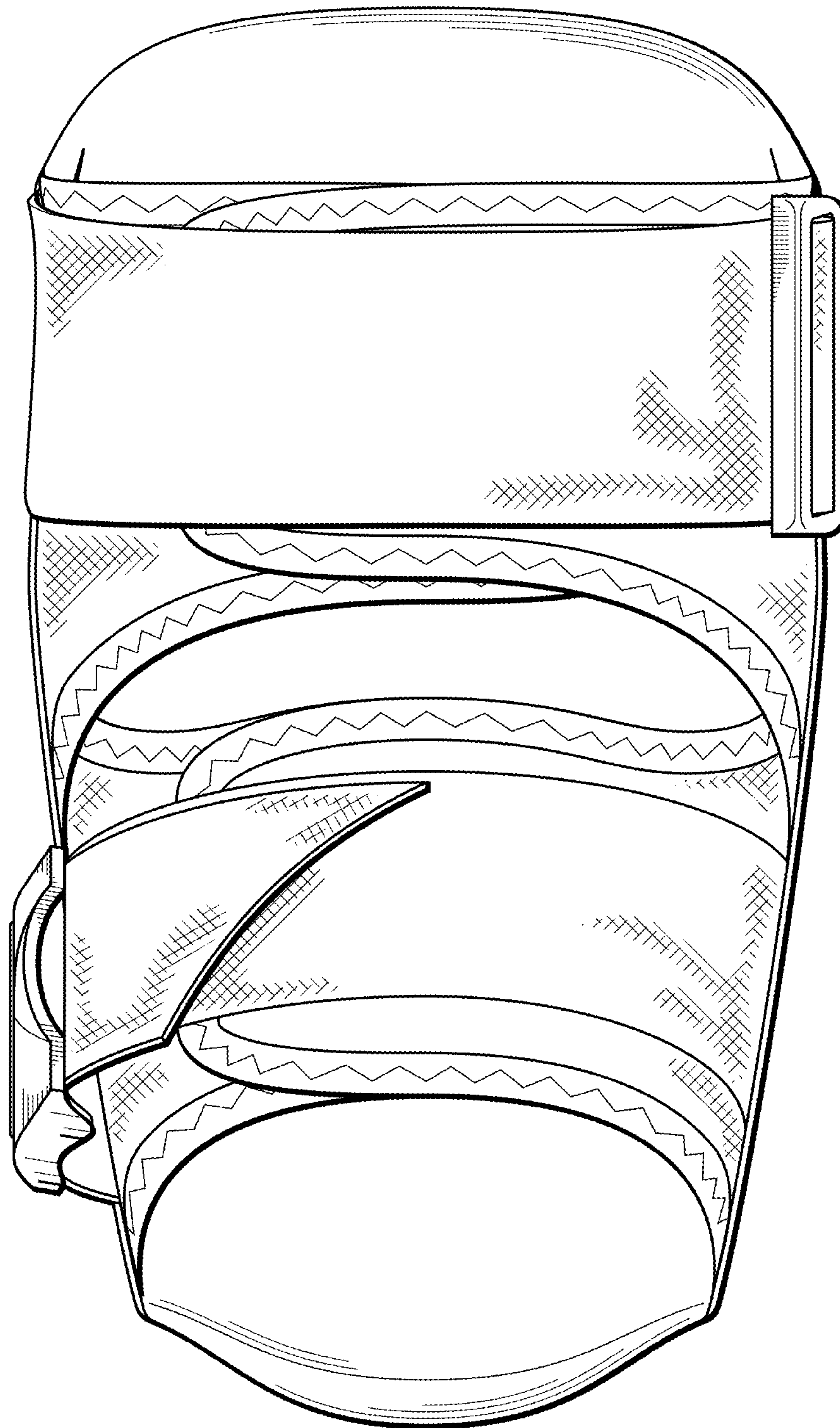

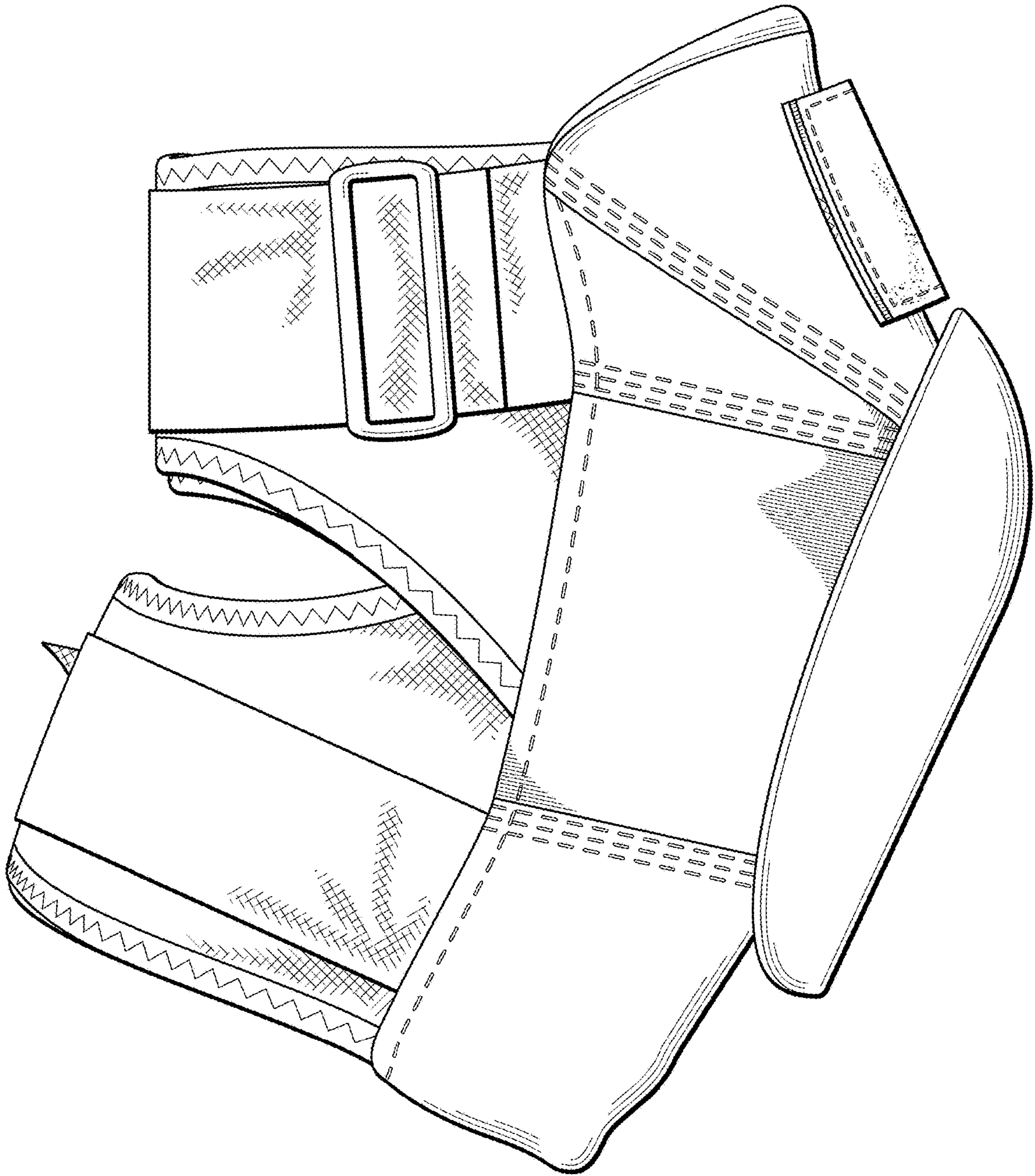

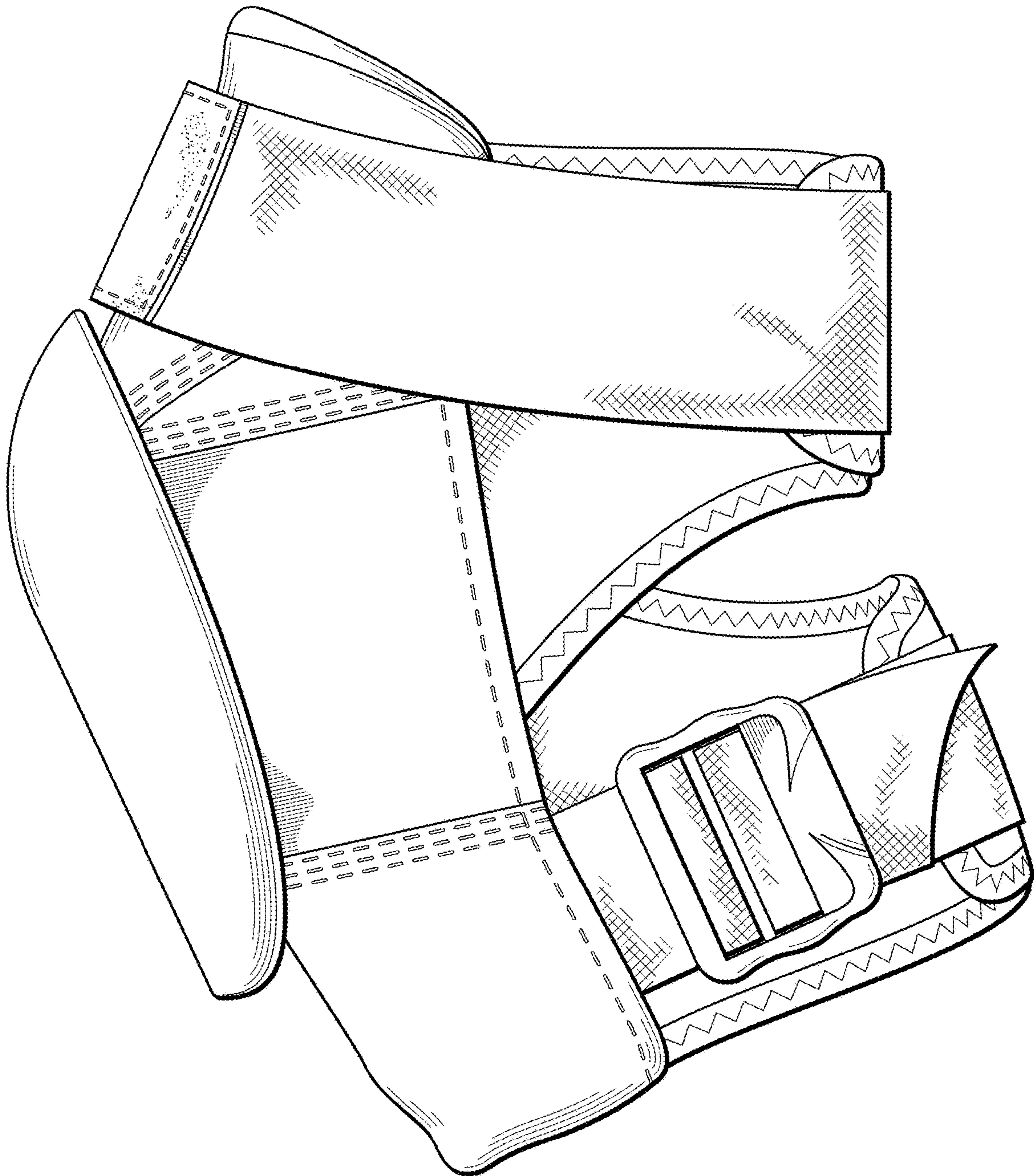

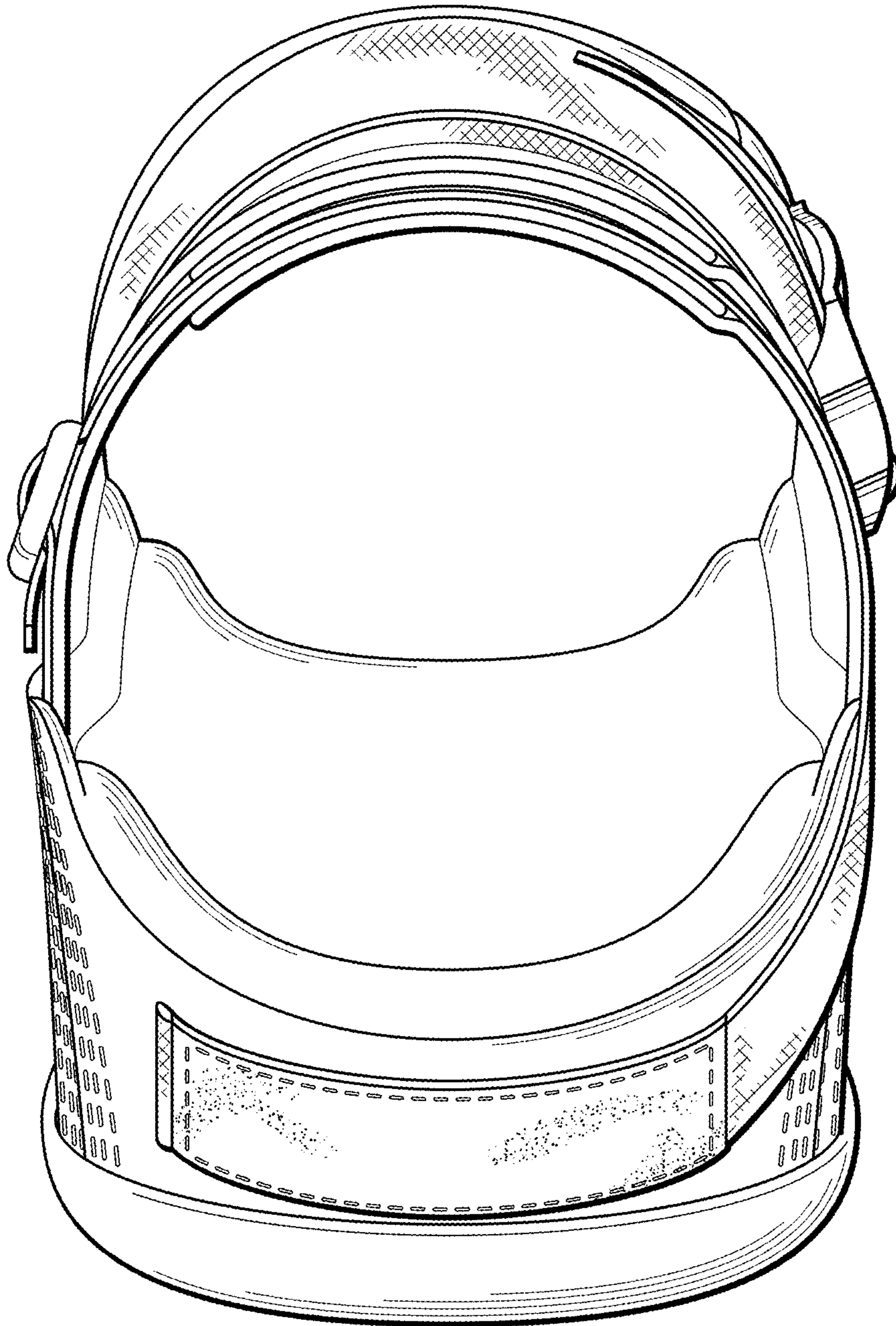

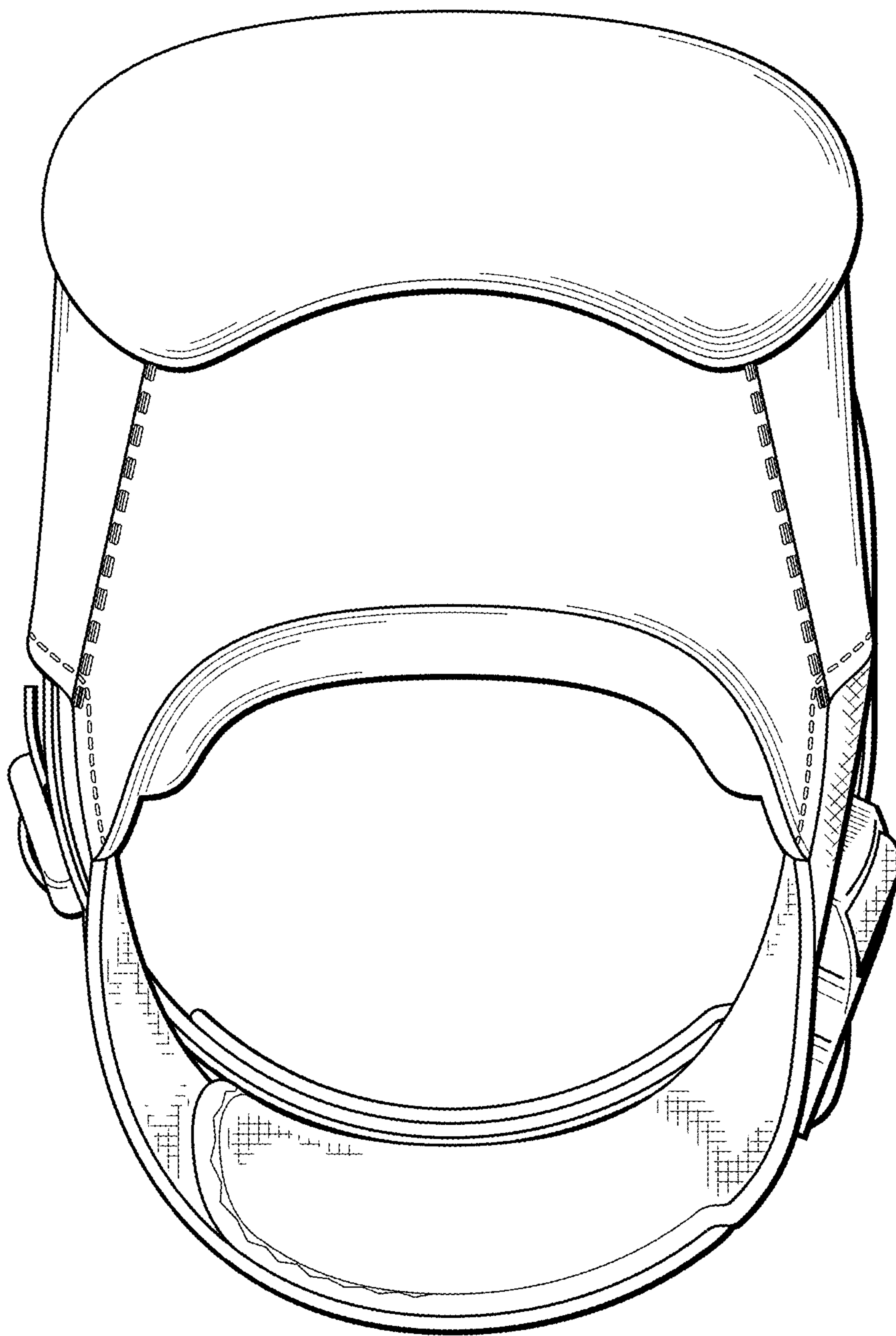
