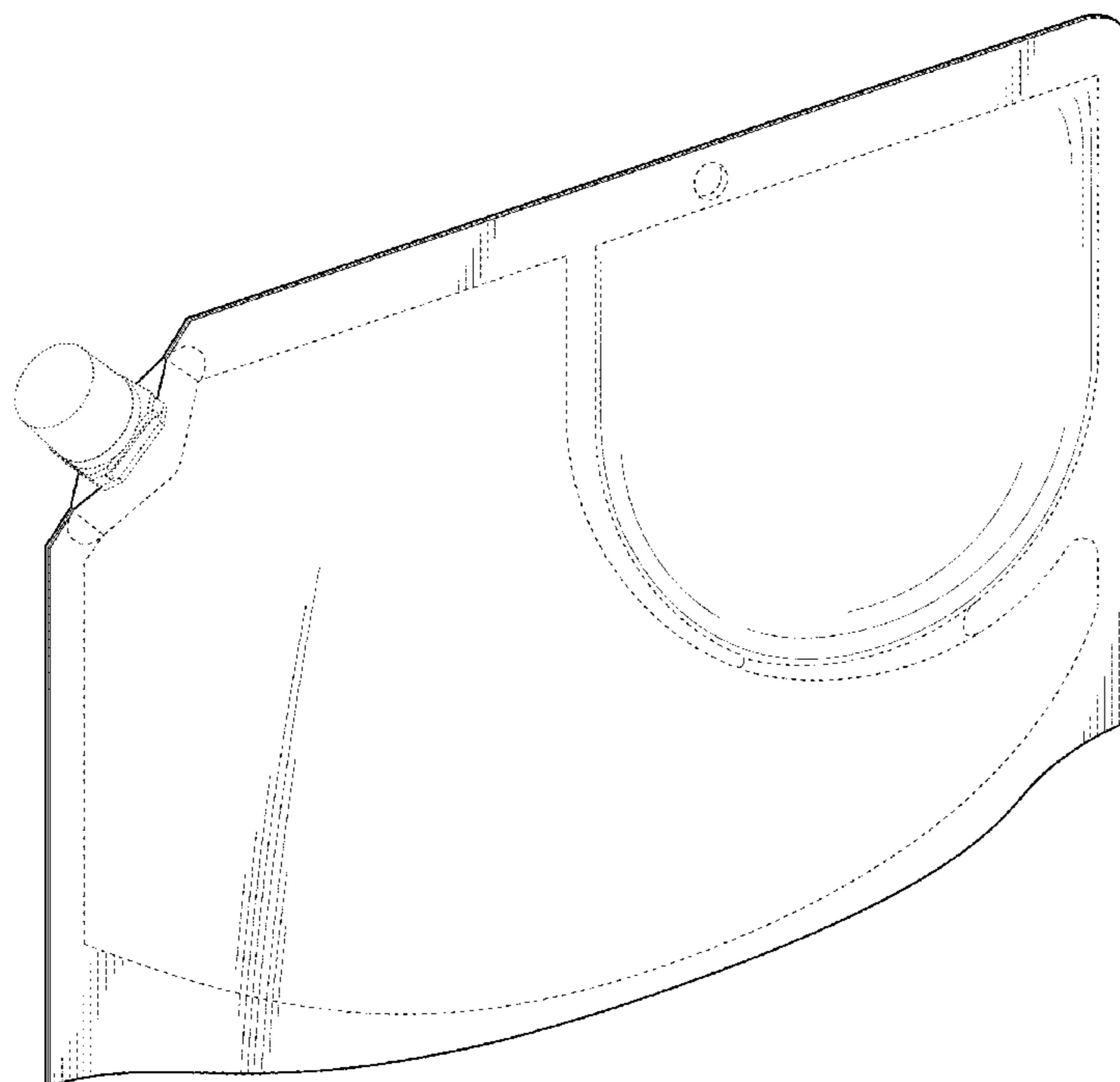
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front of a pouch showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a back elevational view thereof;

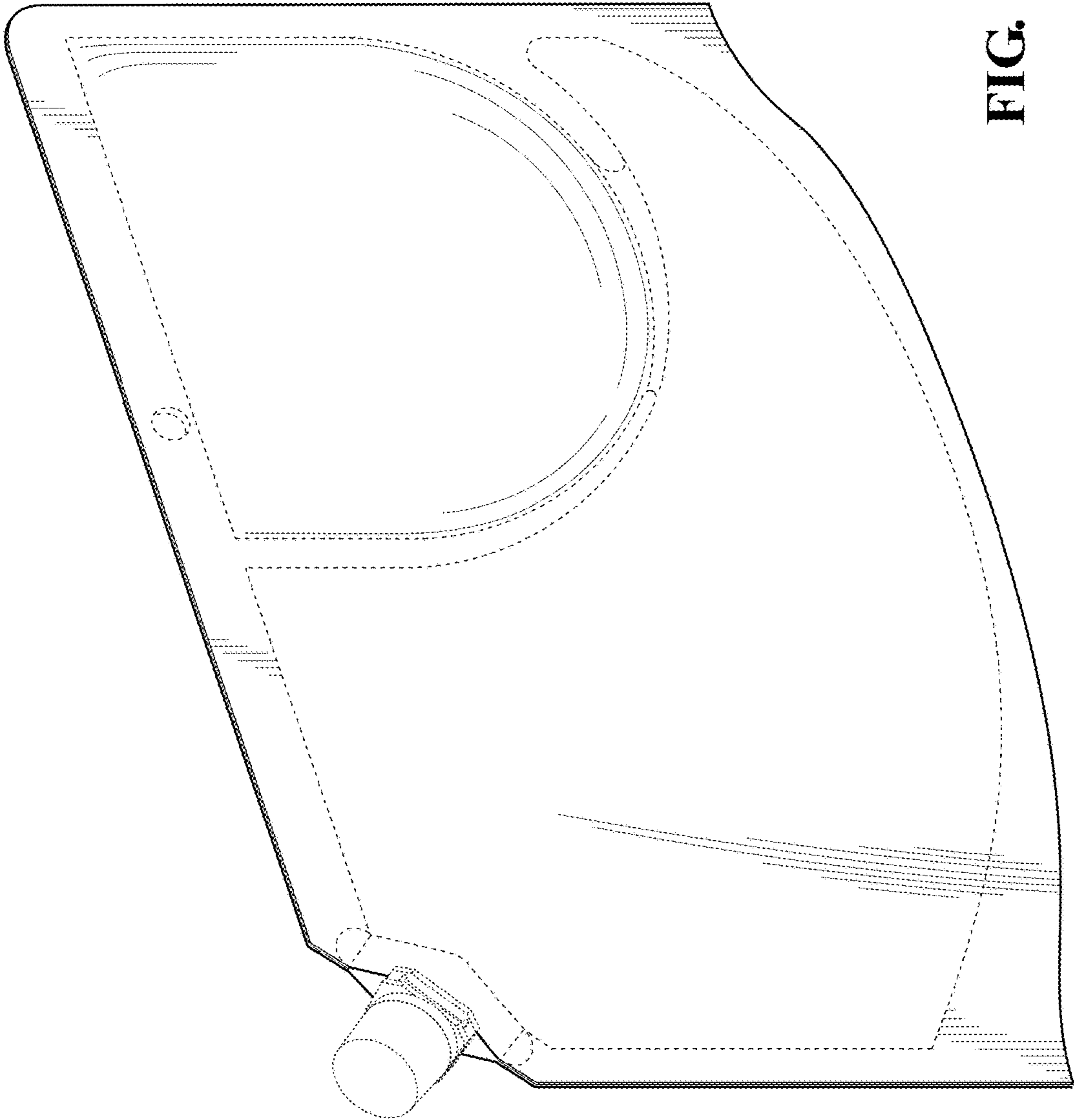

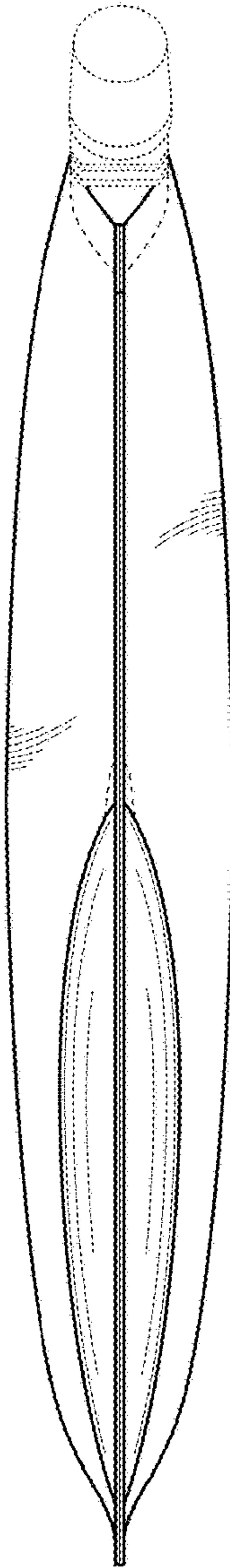

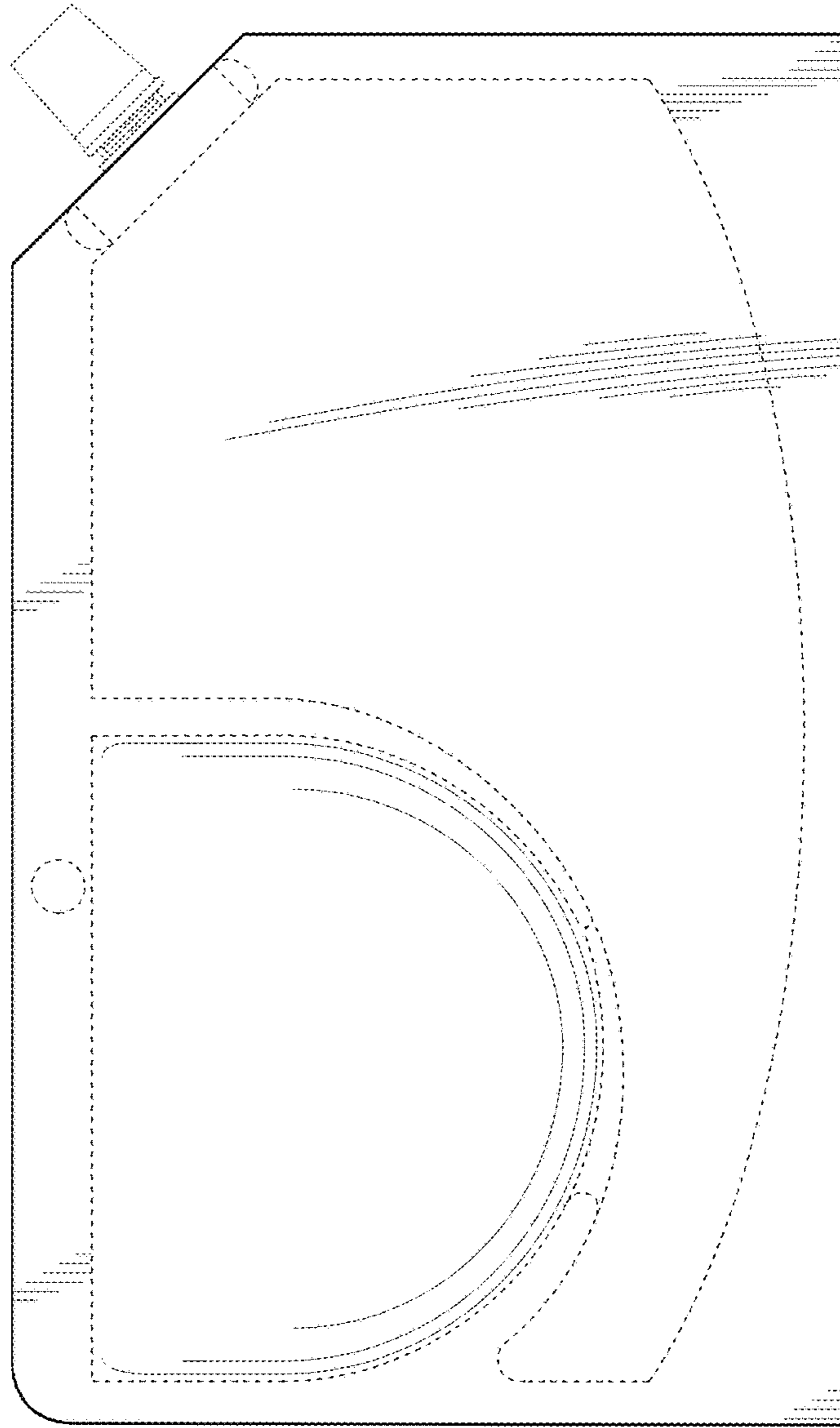

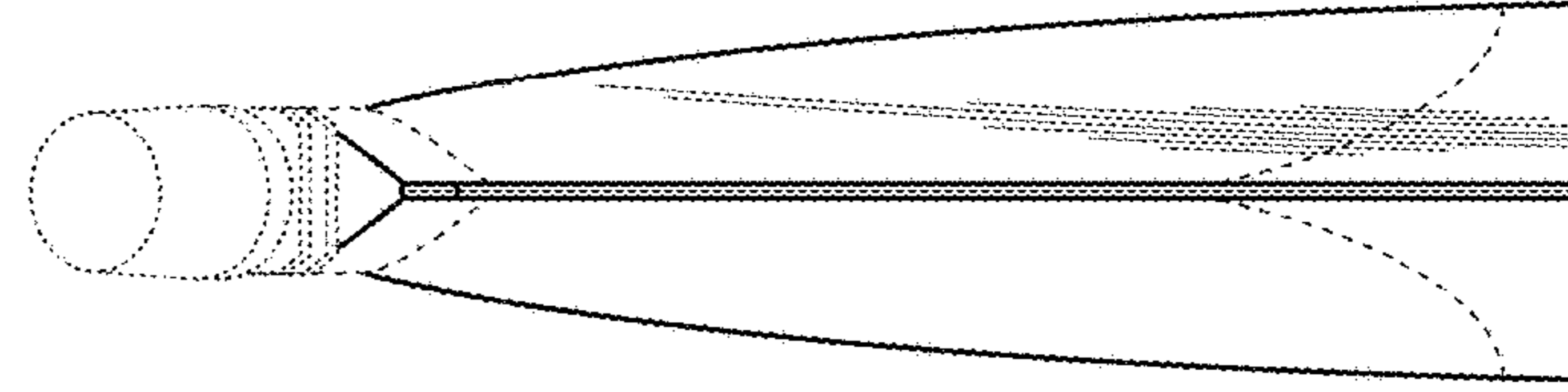

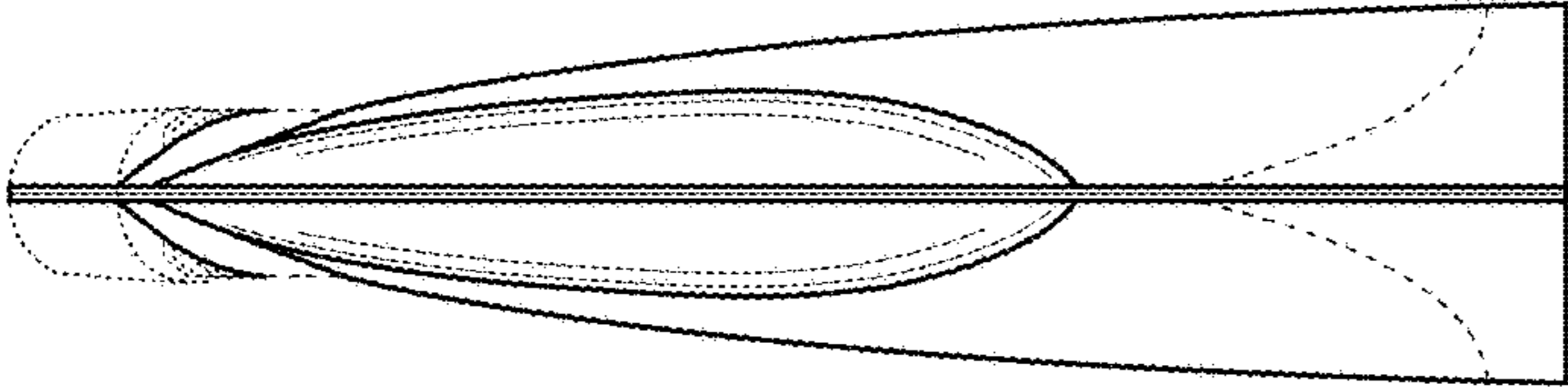
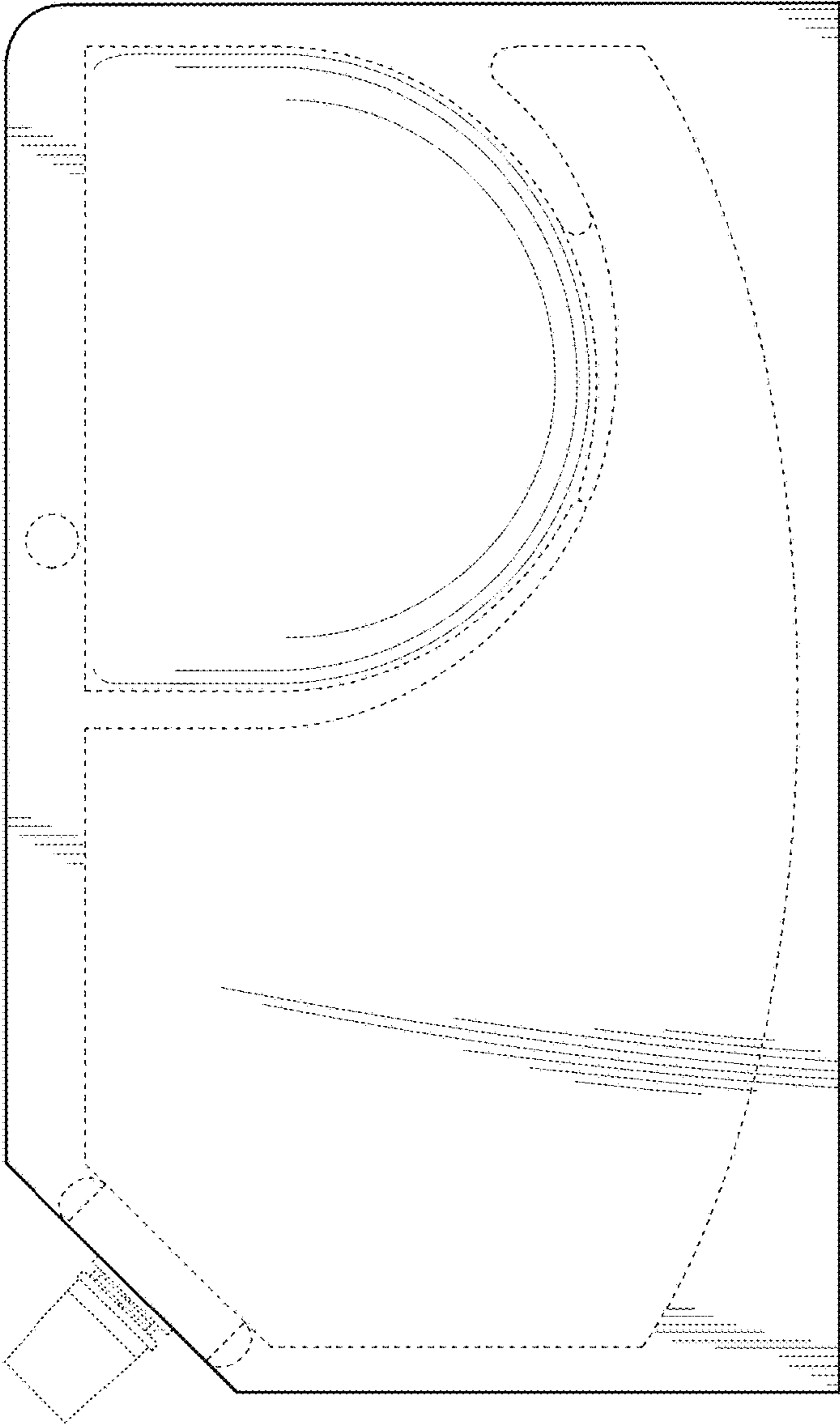
