(57) **CLAIM**

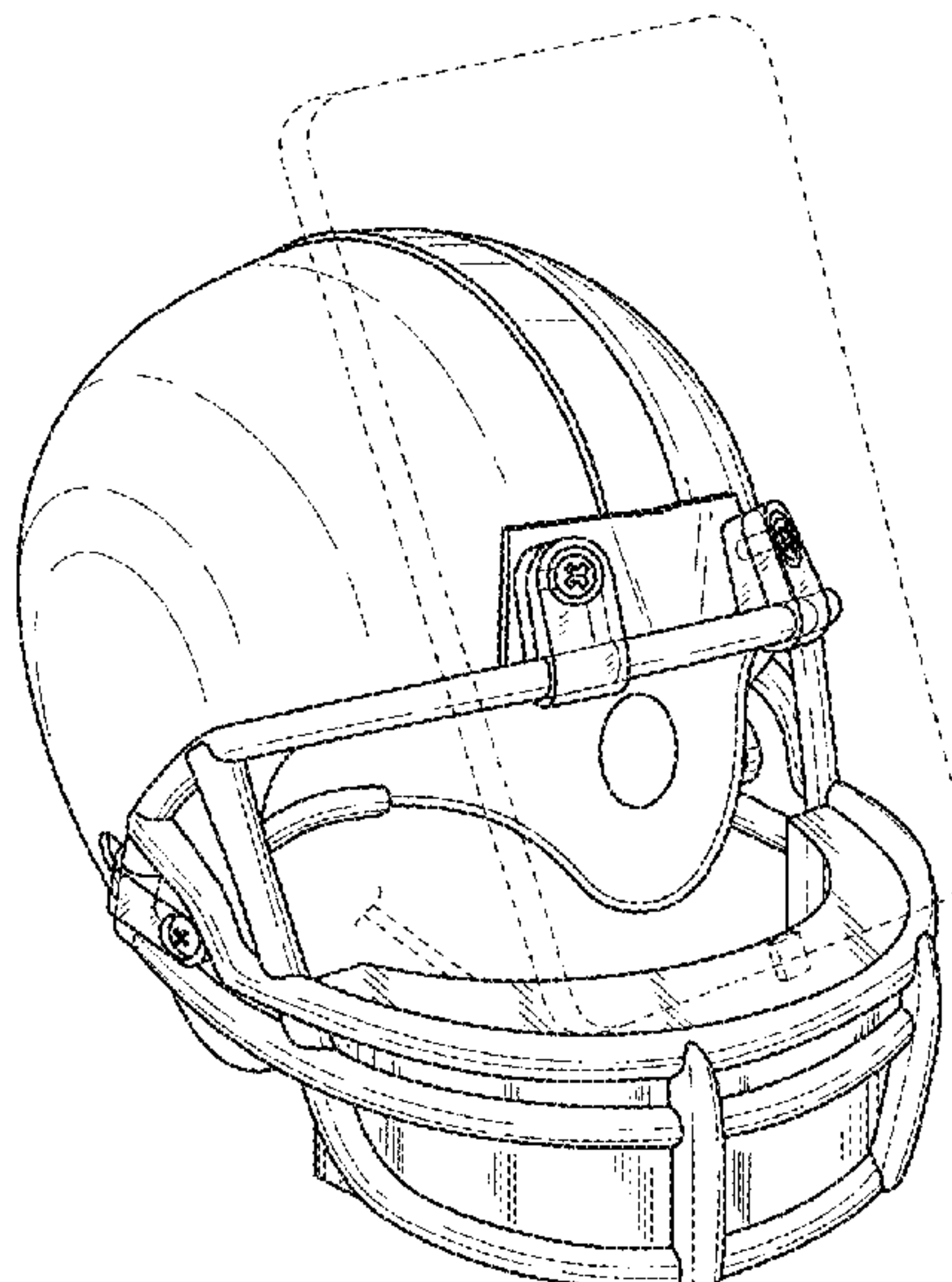
The ornamental design for a charging display stand for mobile device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a charging display stand for mobile device that has the design, with a mobile device, charging cable and connector shown in broken lines;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the stand for a mobile device;
FIG. 3 is a right side view of the display stand for a mobile device;
FIG. 4 is a rear view of the display stand for a mobile device;
FIG. 5 is a left side view of the display stand for a mobile device;
FIG. 6 is a top view of the display stand for a mobile device;
and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the display stand for a mobile device.

The outer broken lines in FIGS. 1-7 are intended to show positioning of a mobile device, charging cable and connector, are for environmental purposes only, and form no part of the claimed design.

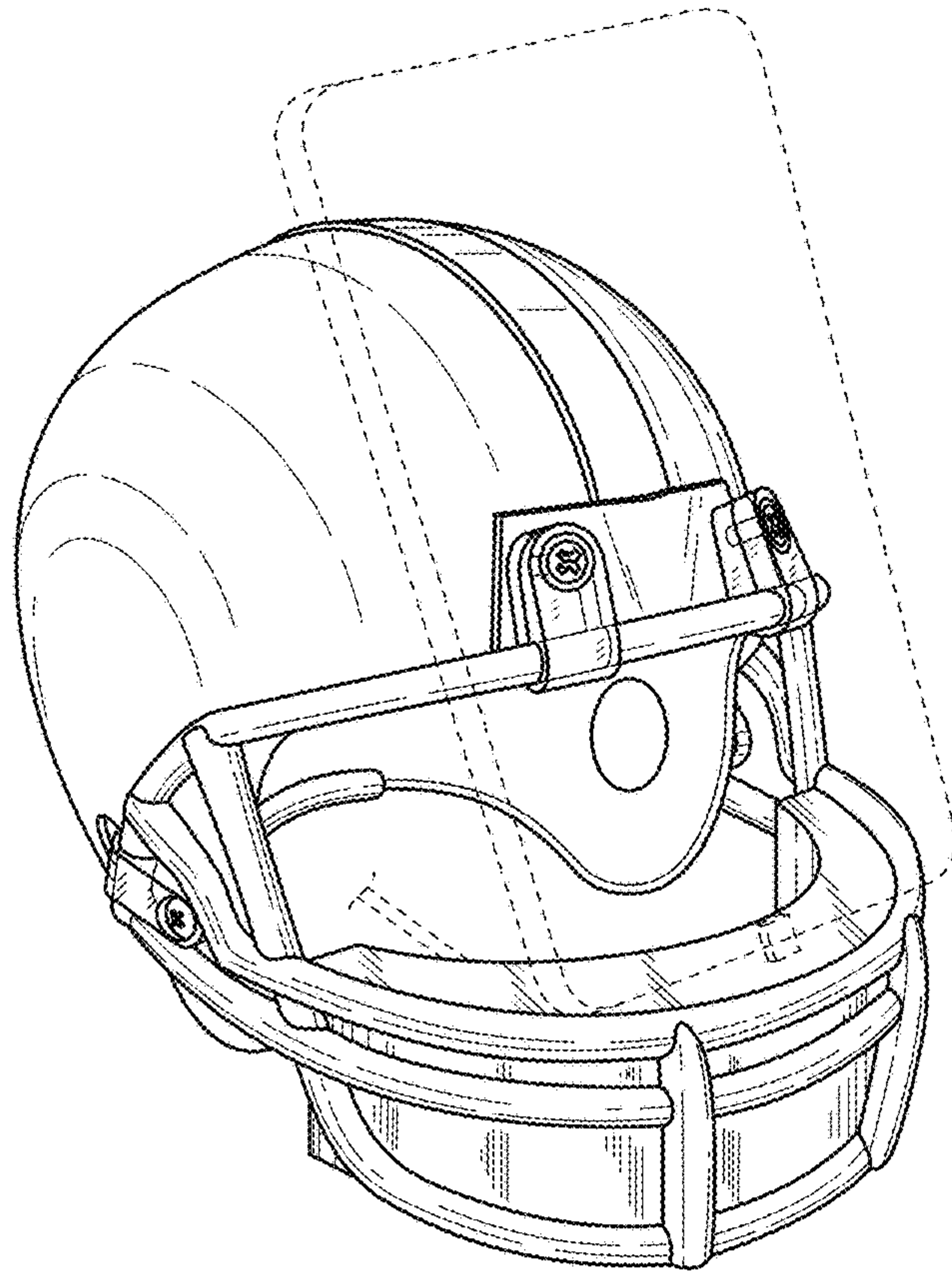

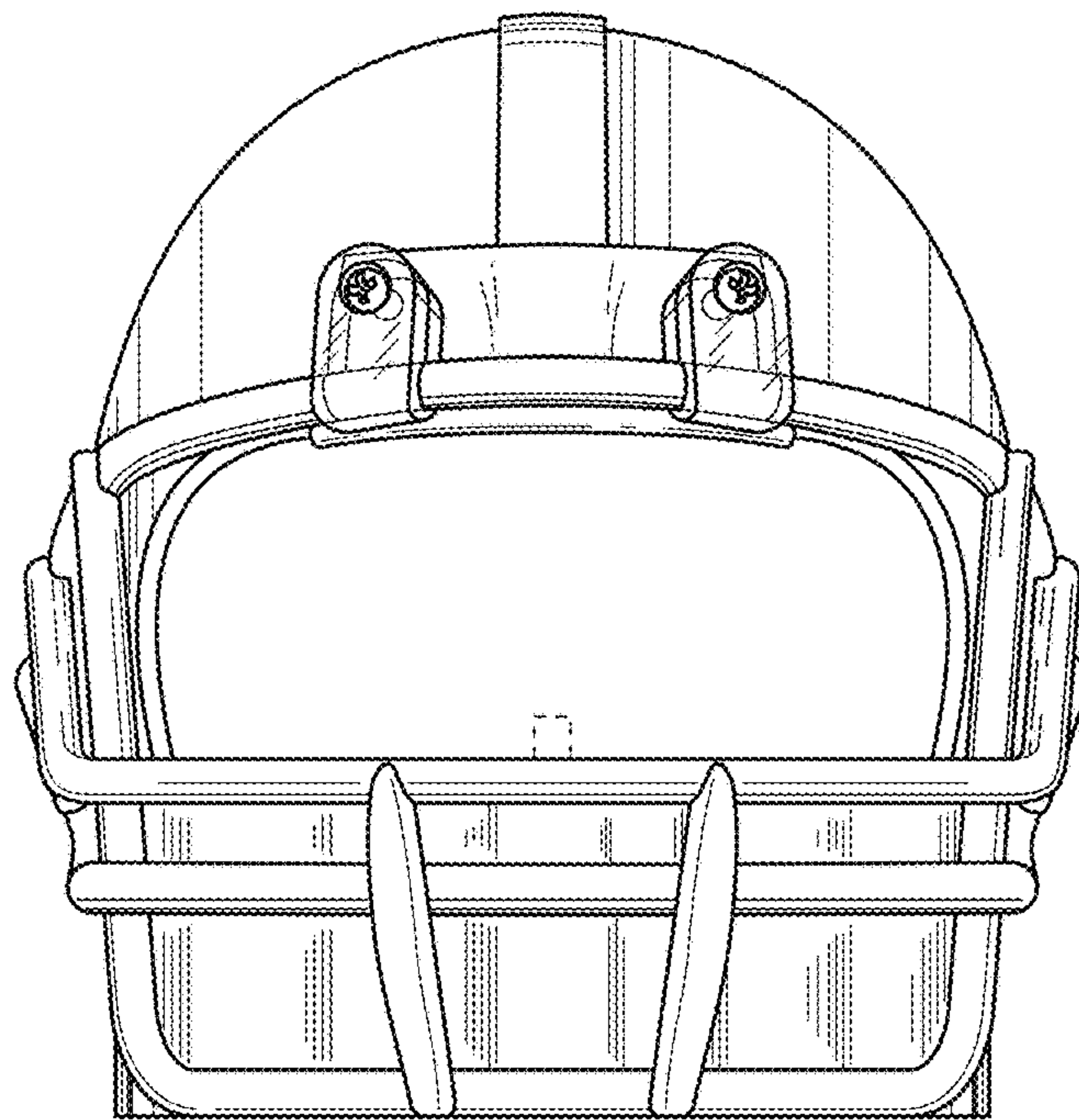

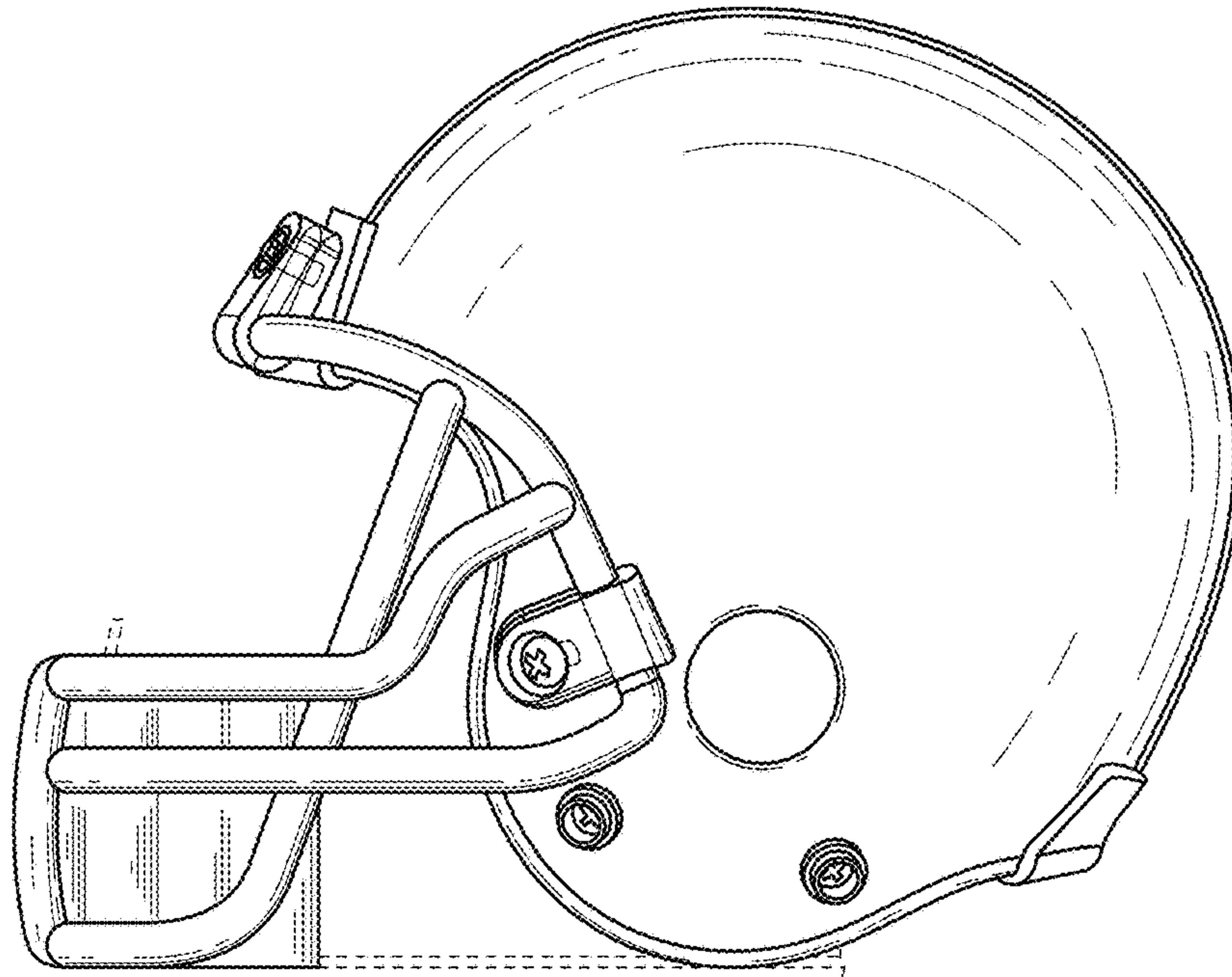

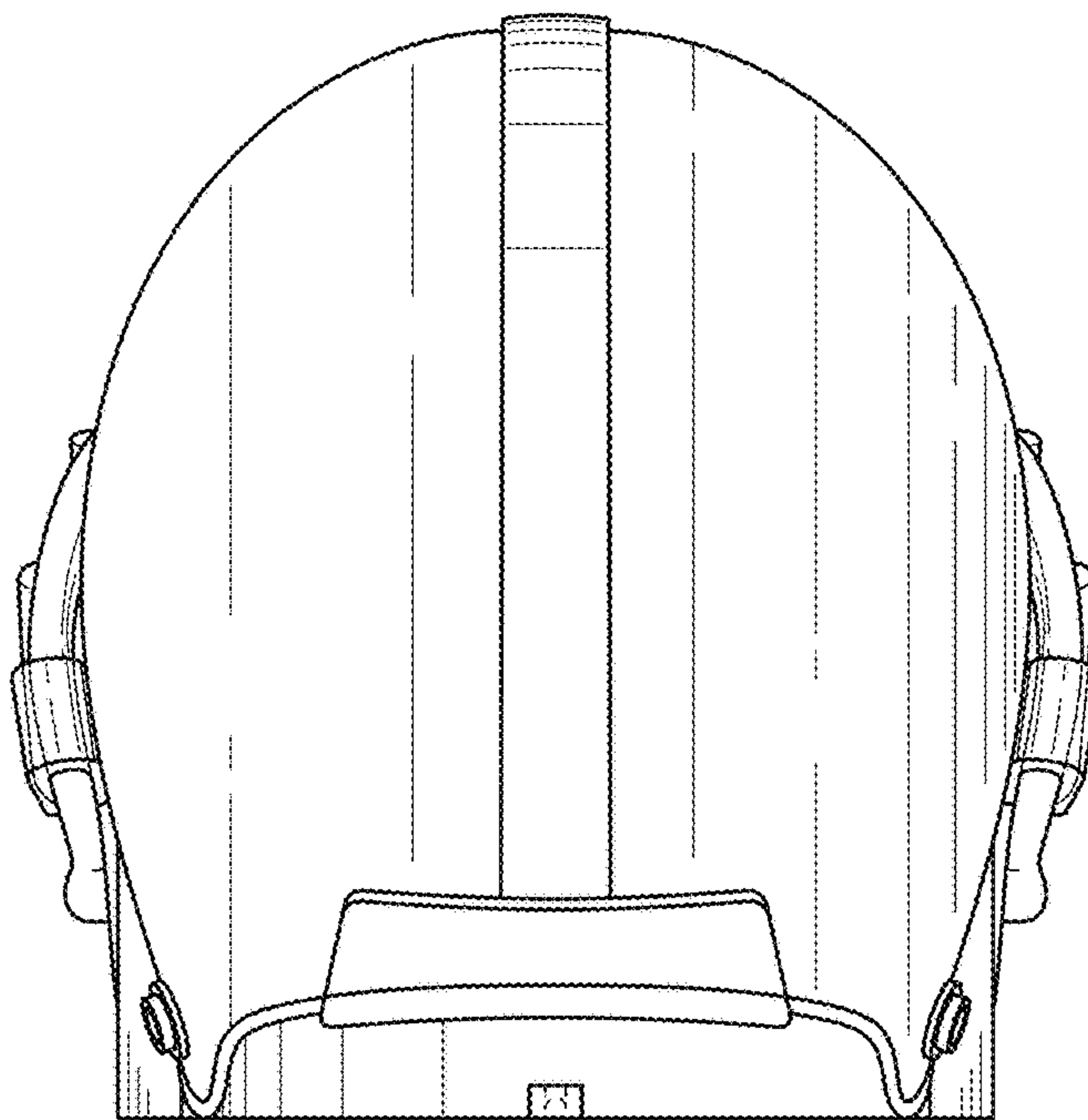

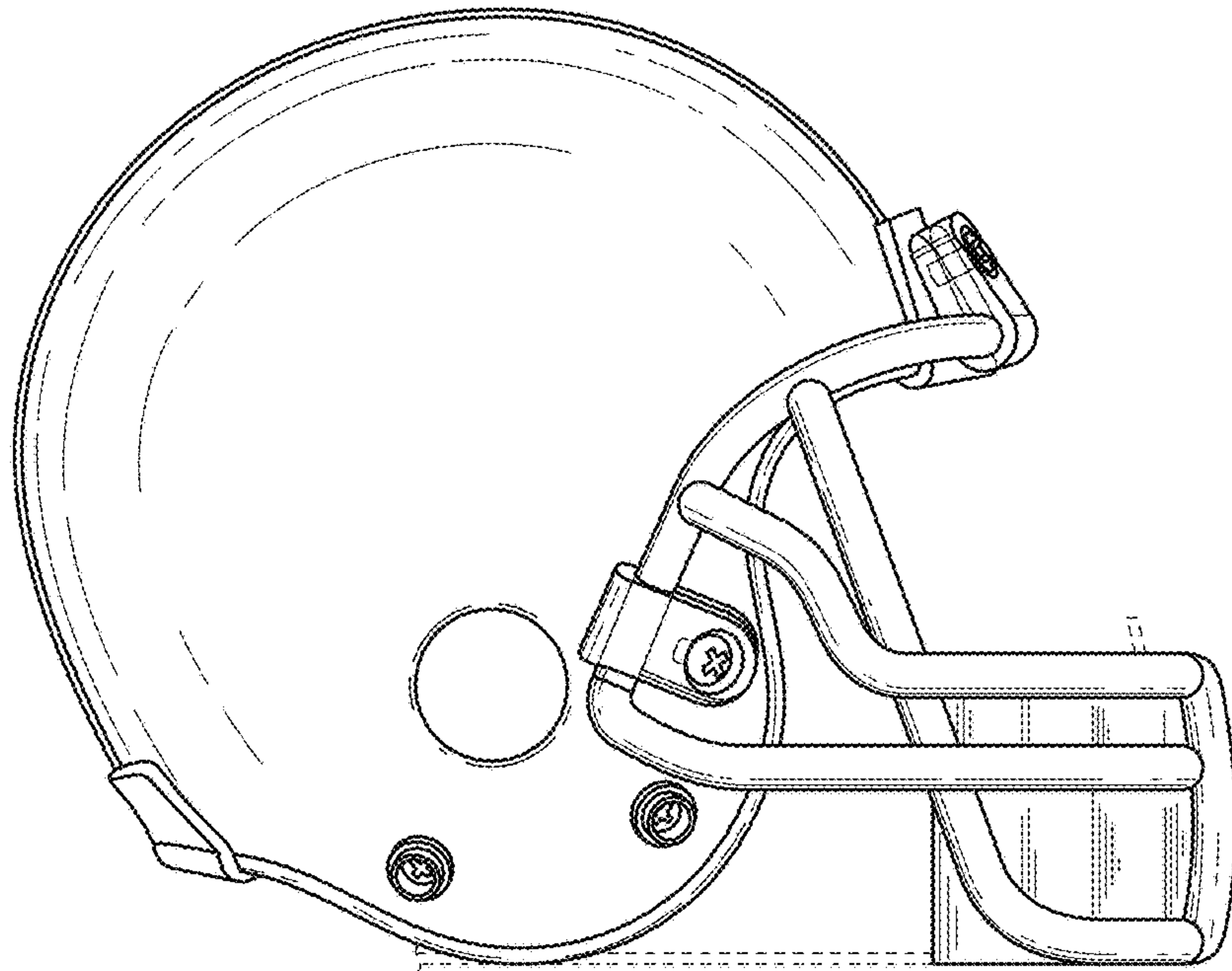

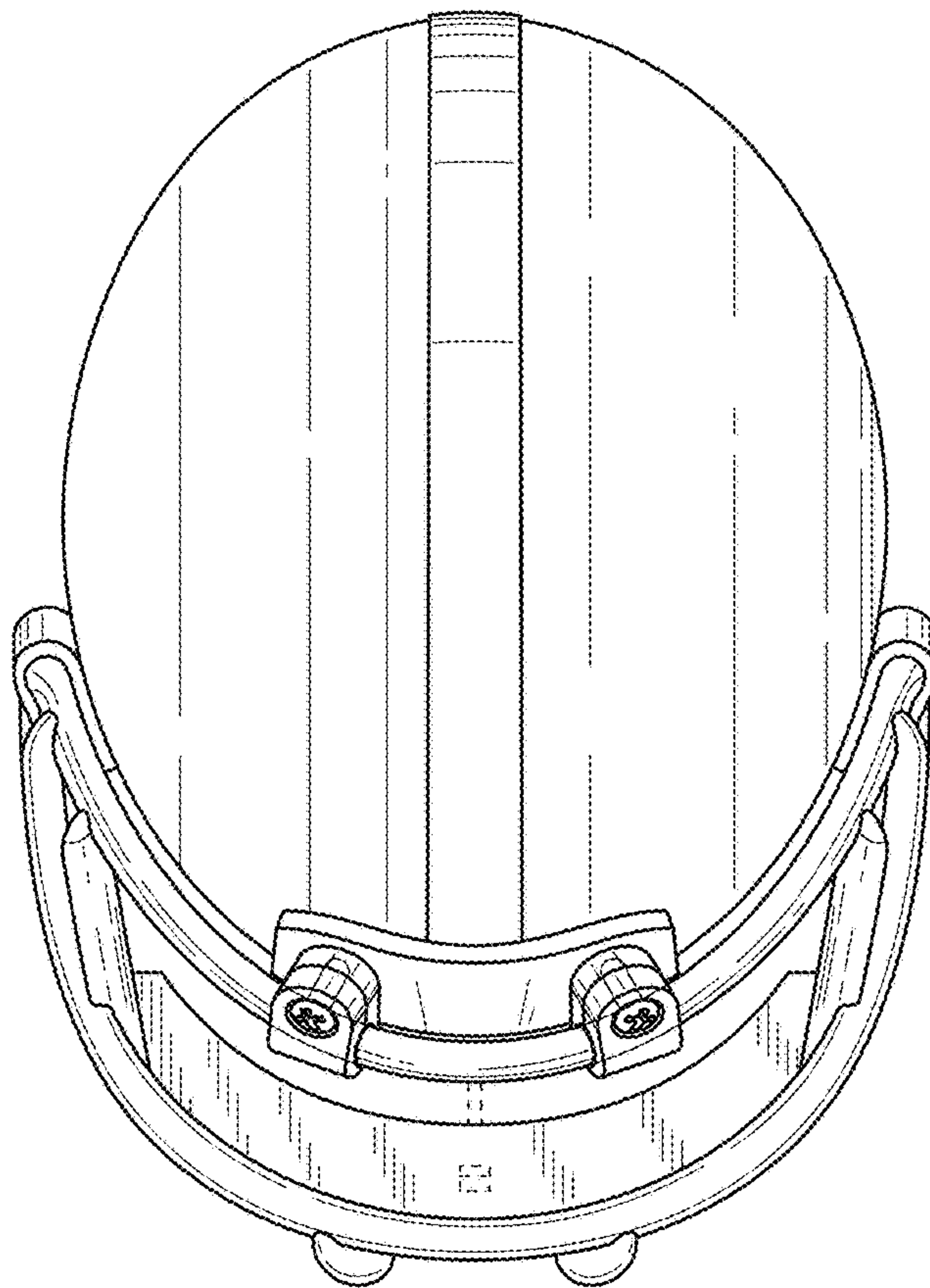

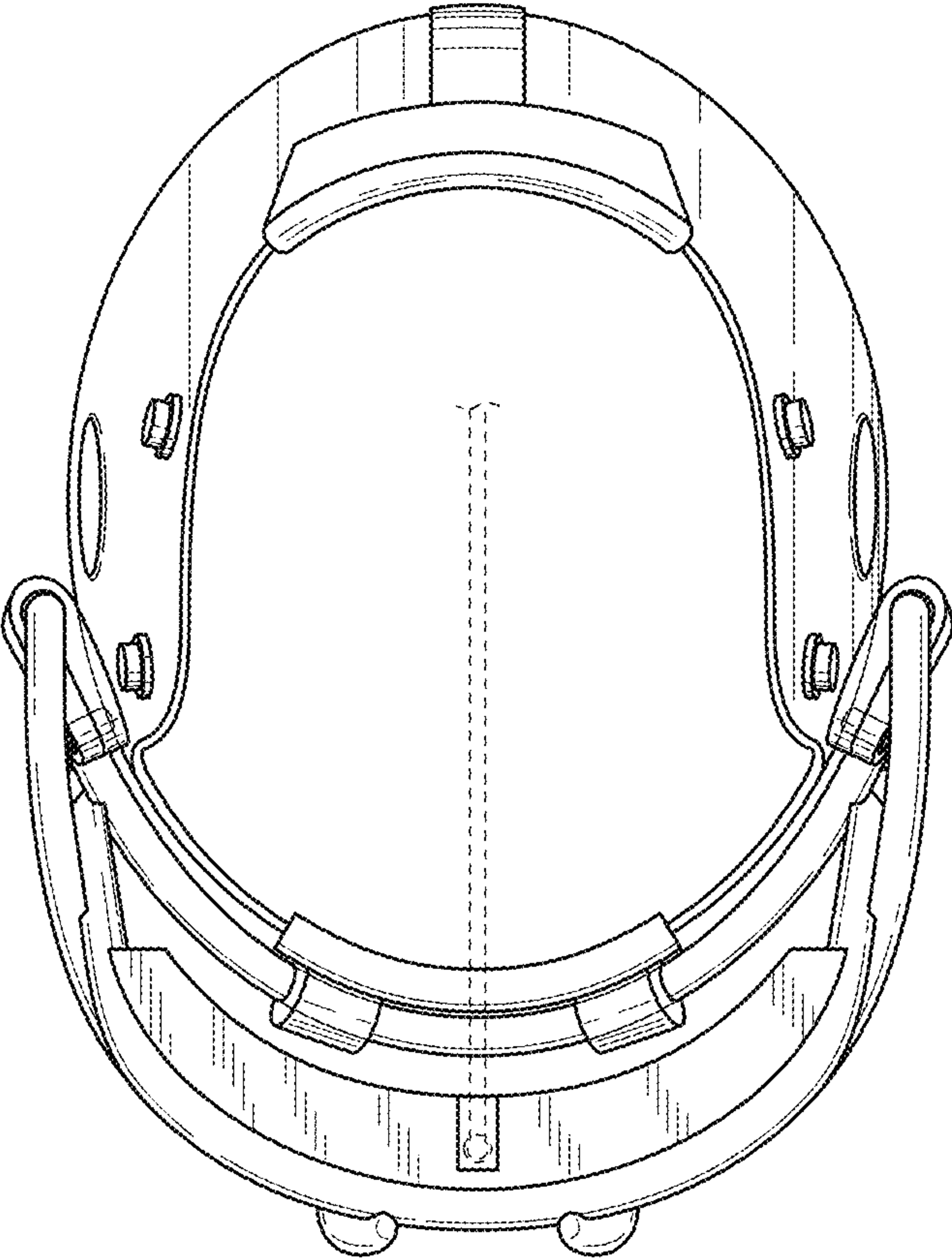
