FIG. 5 is the fifth image thereof;

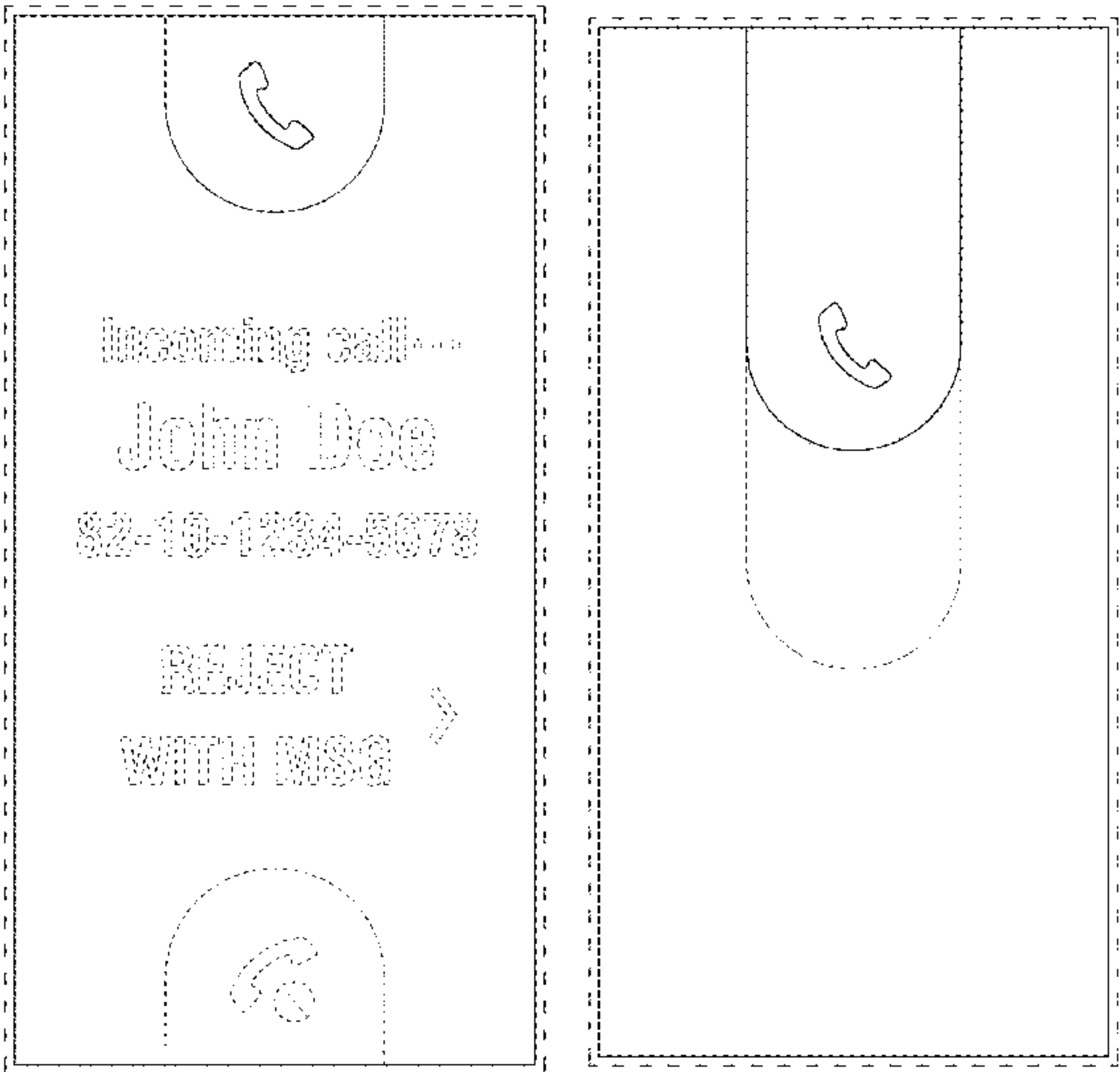
FIG. 6 is the sixth image thereof; and,

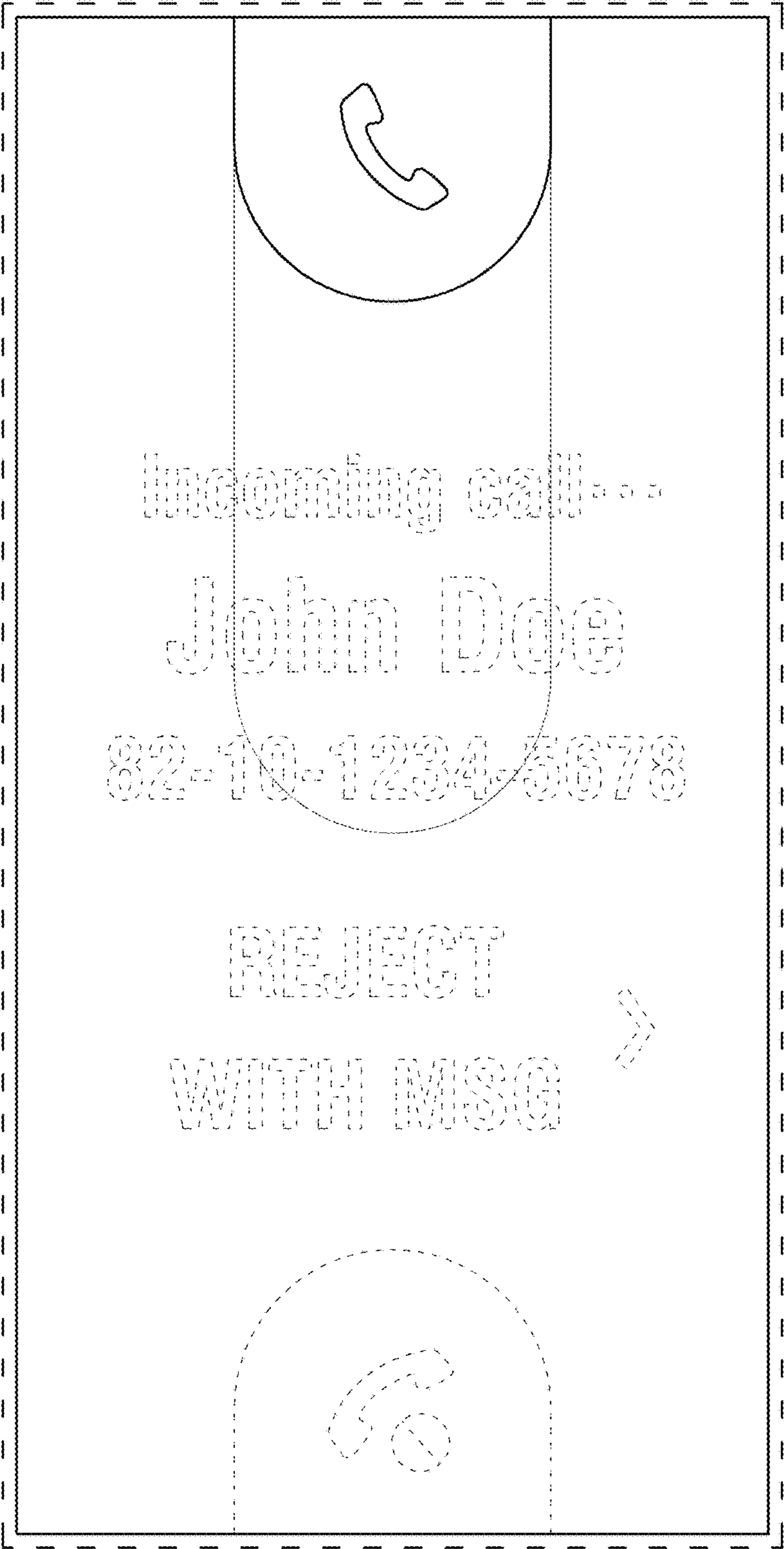

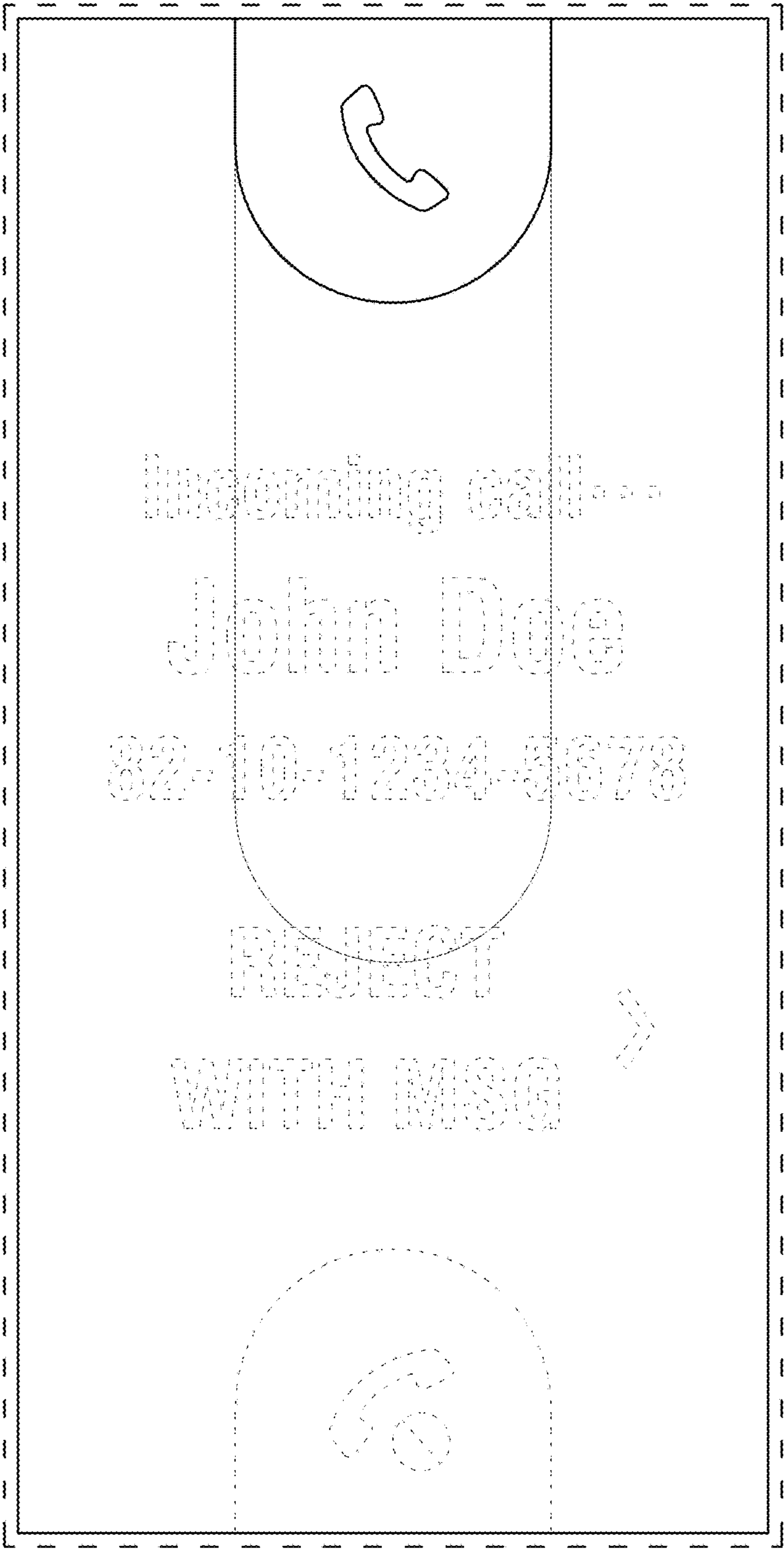

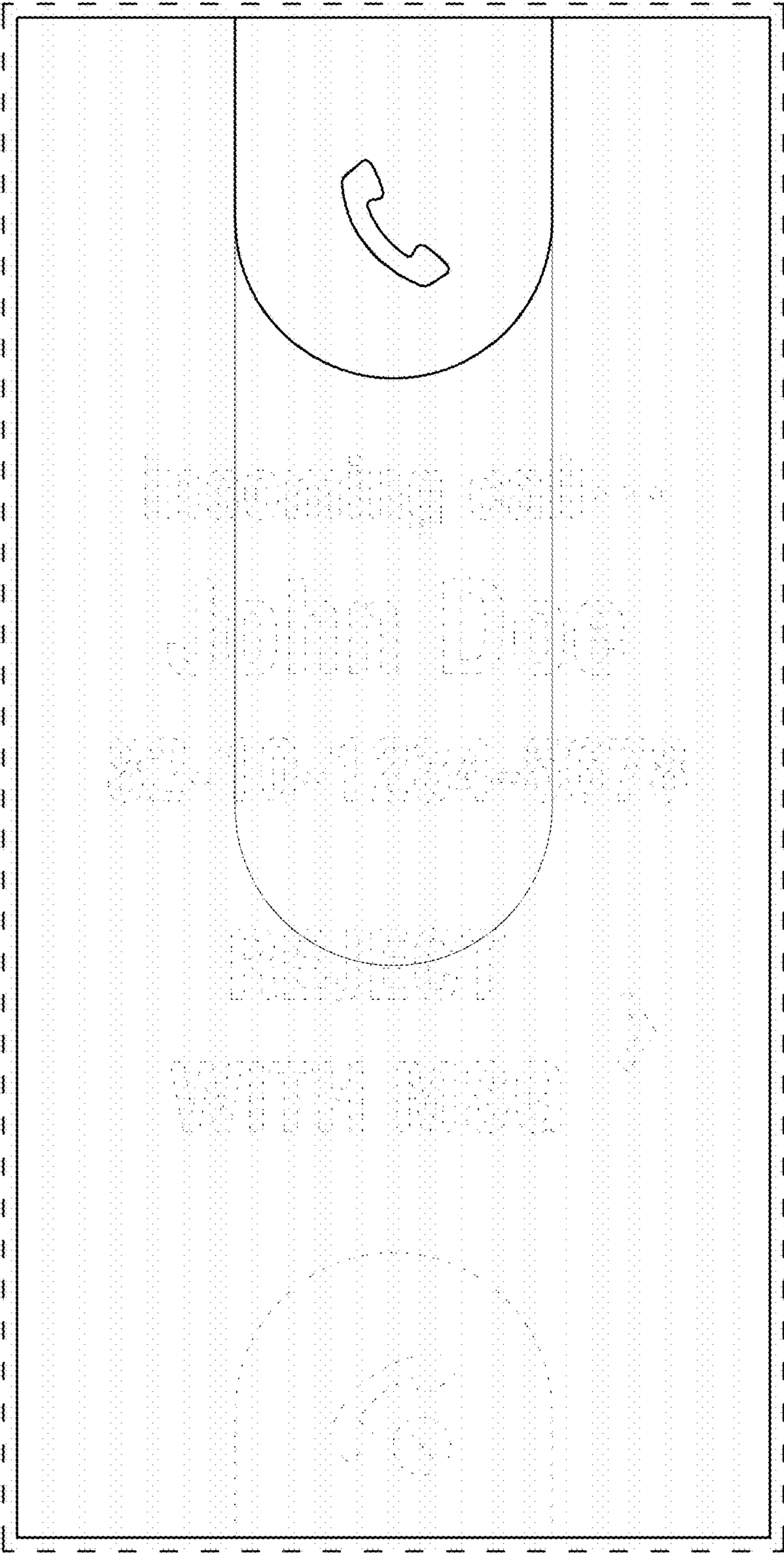

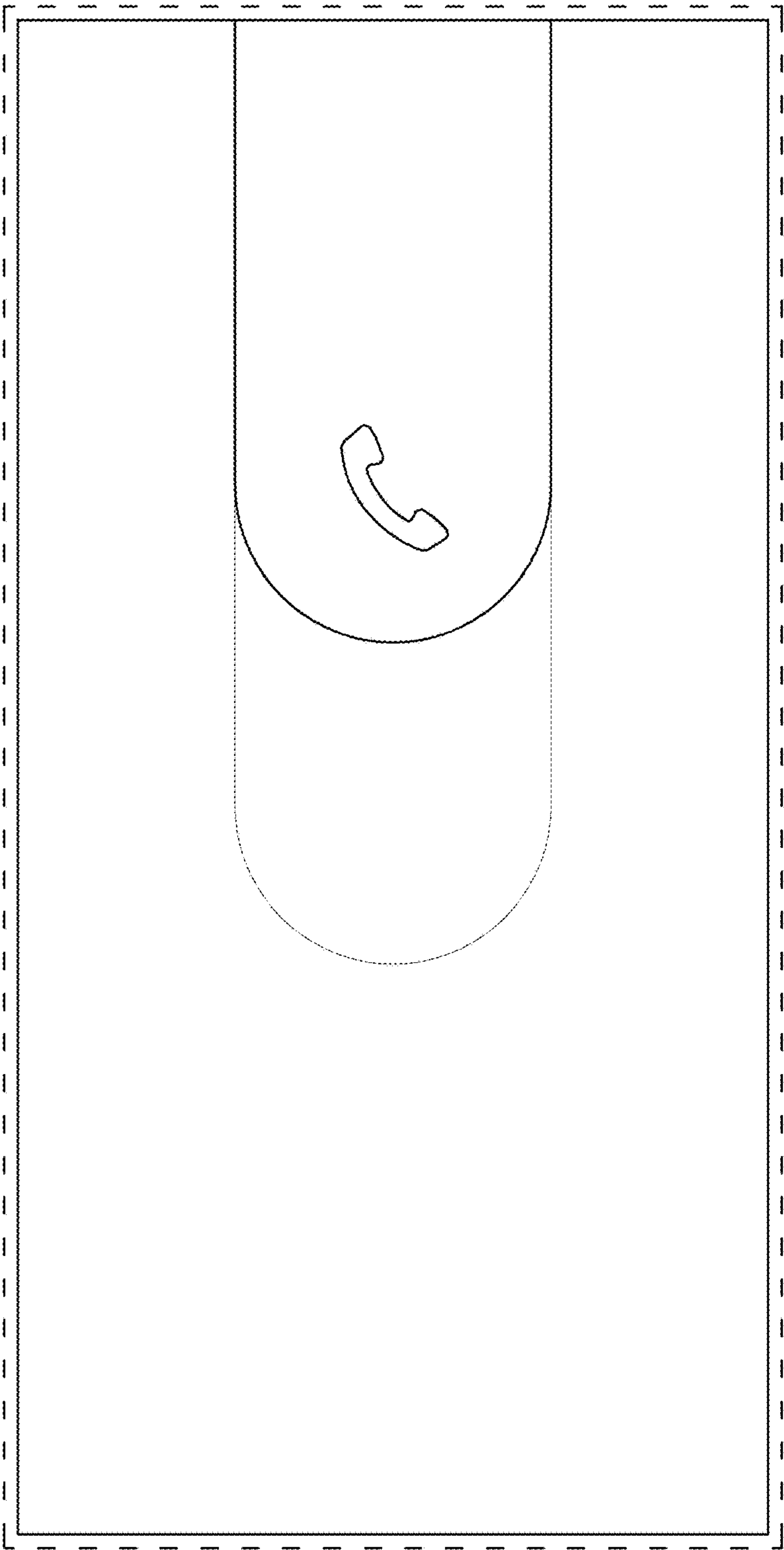

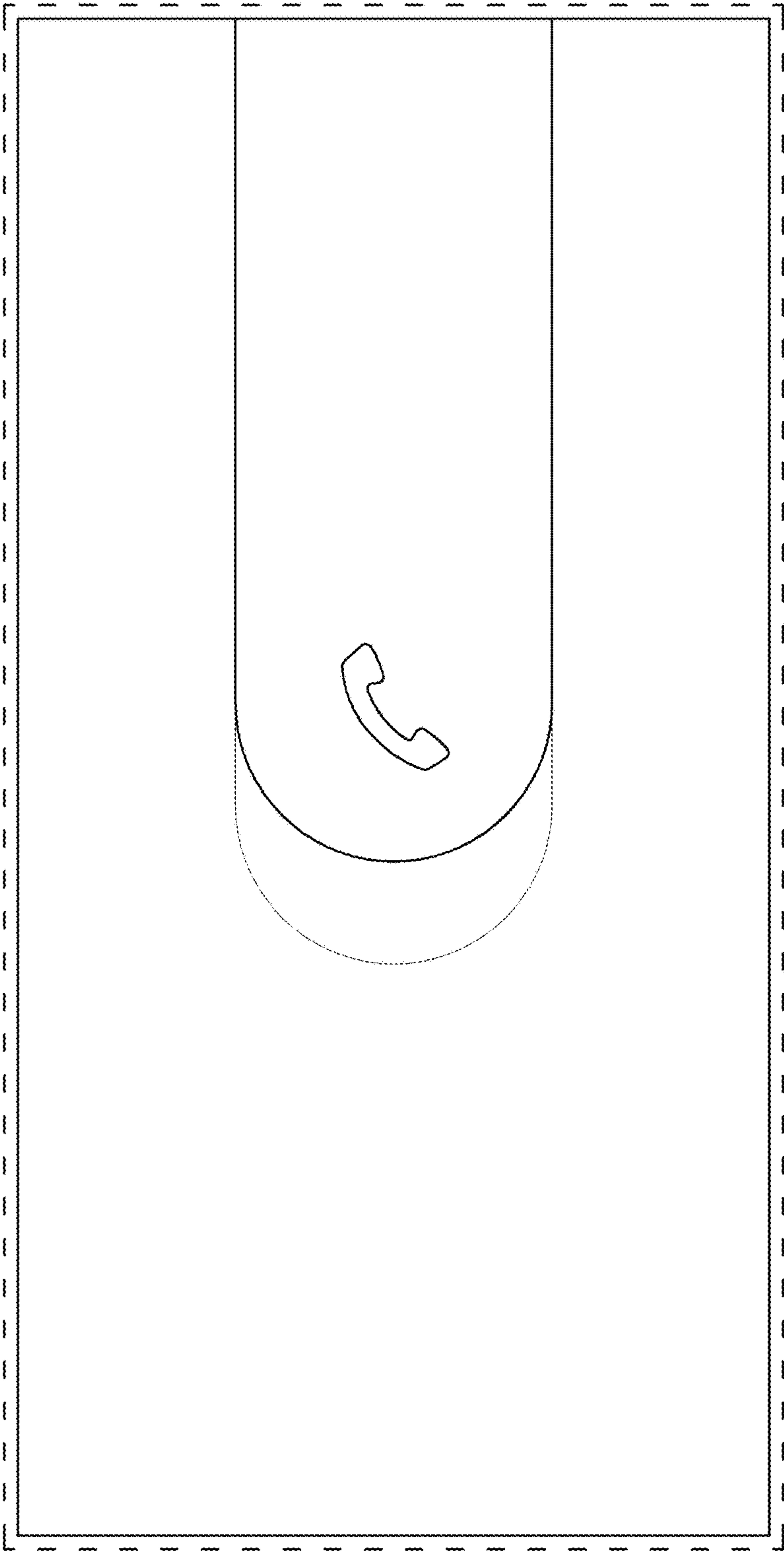
