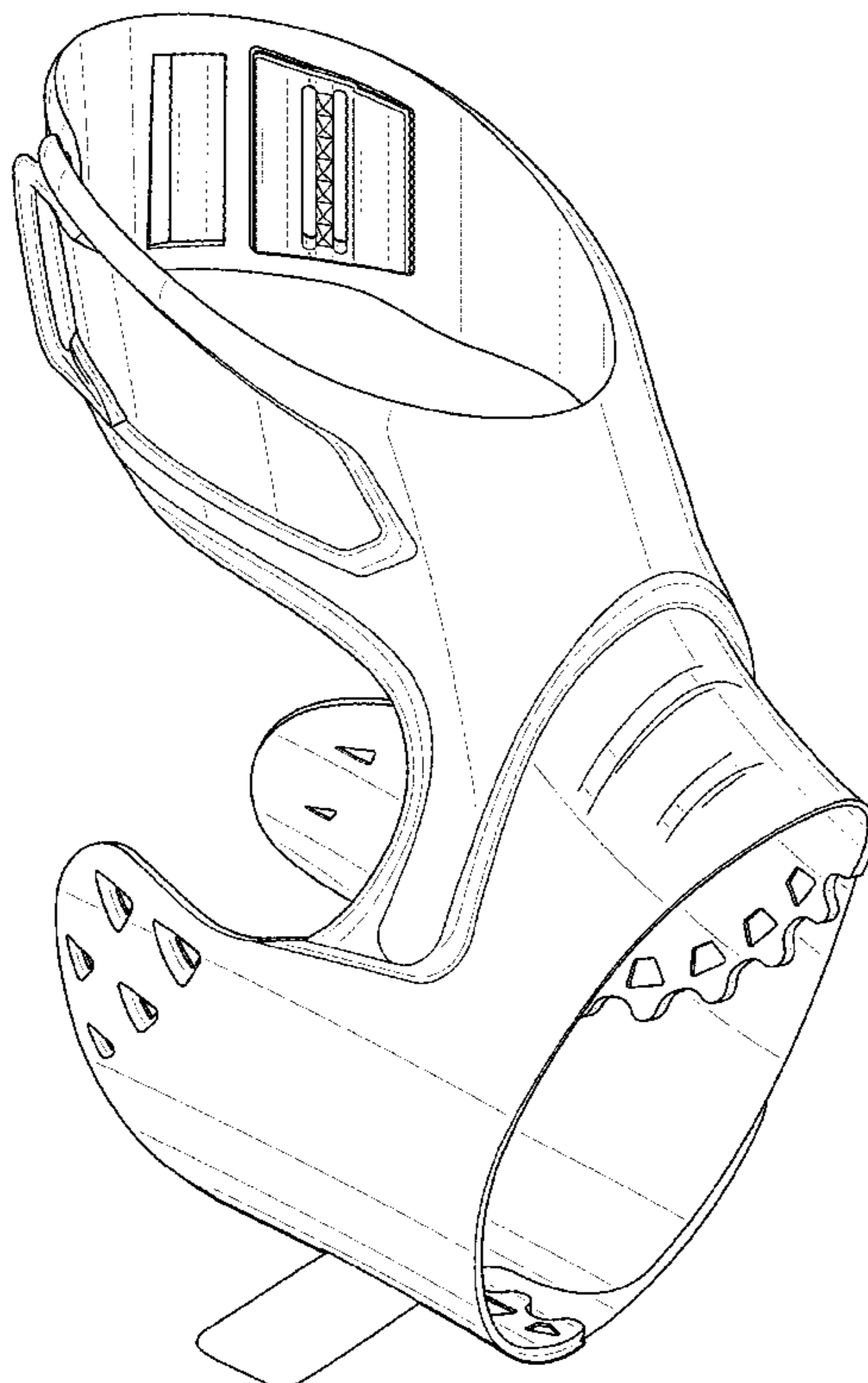
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for ankle support, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an ankle support;  
FIG. 2 is a lateral side view of the ankle support;  
FIG. 3 is a front view of the ankle support;  
FIG. 4 is a medial side view of the ankle support;  
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the ankle support;  
FIG. 6 is a top view of the ankle support; and,  
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the ankle support.

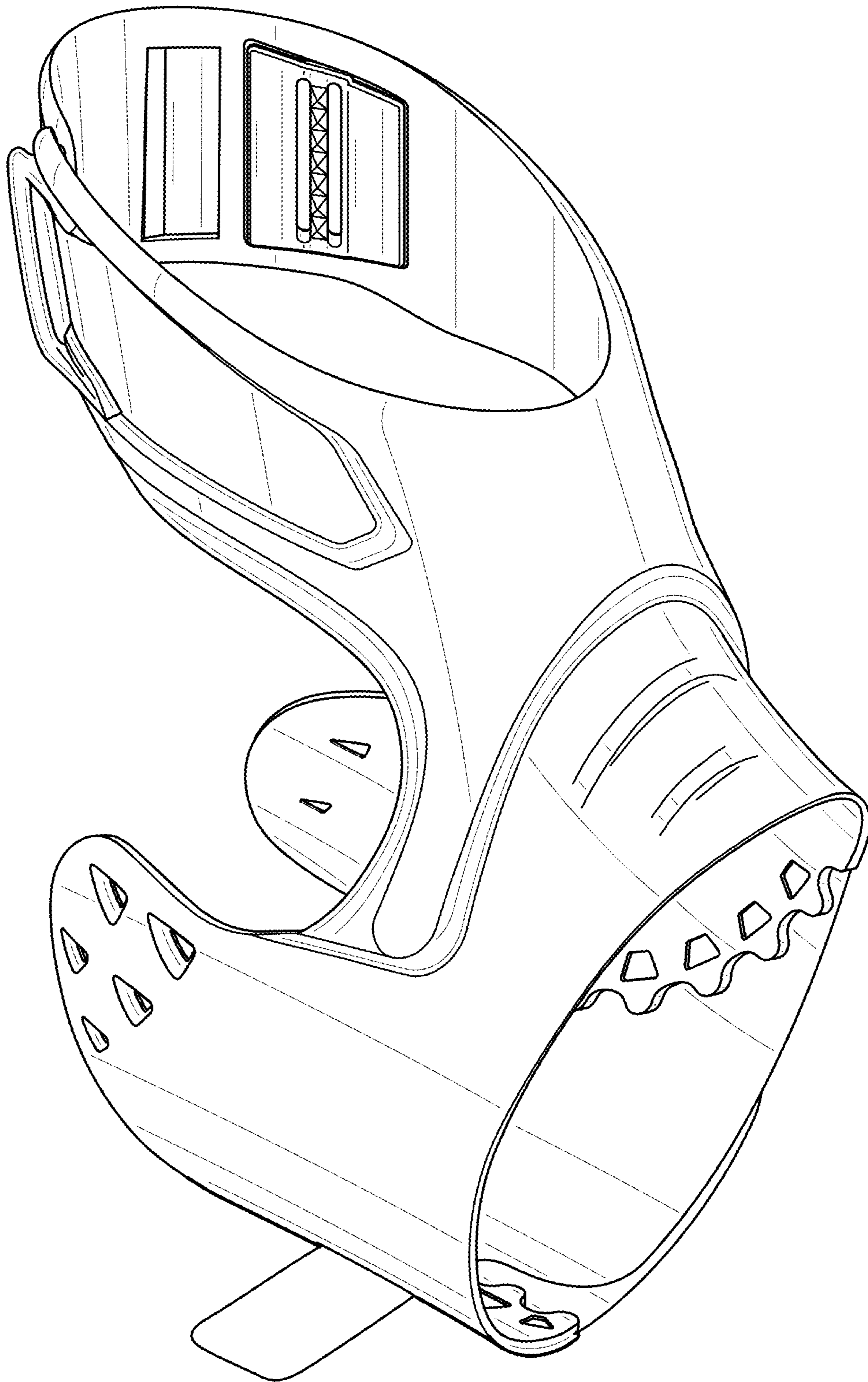

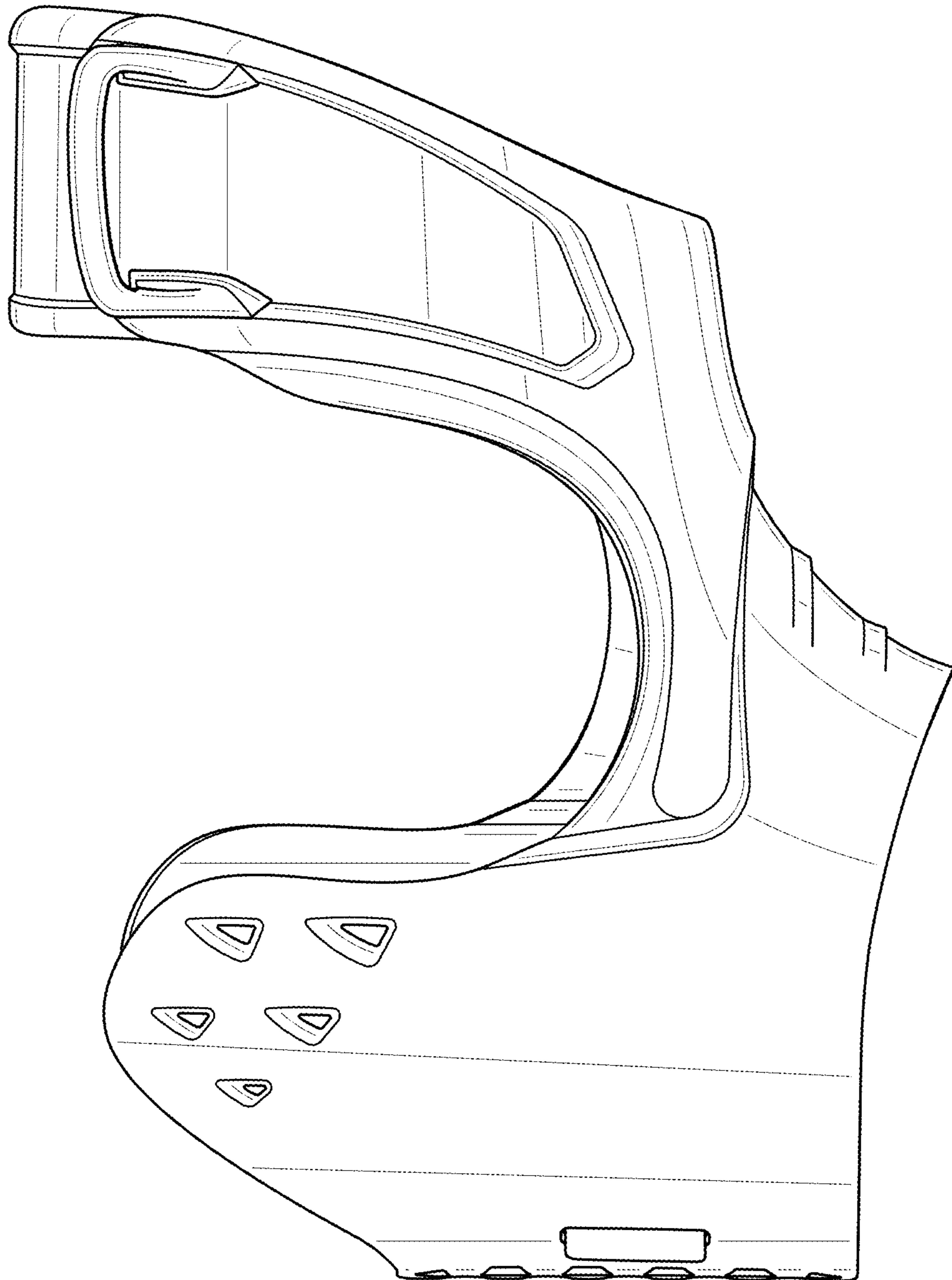

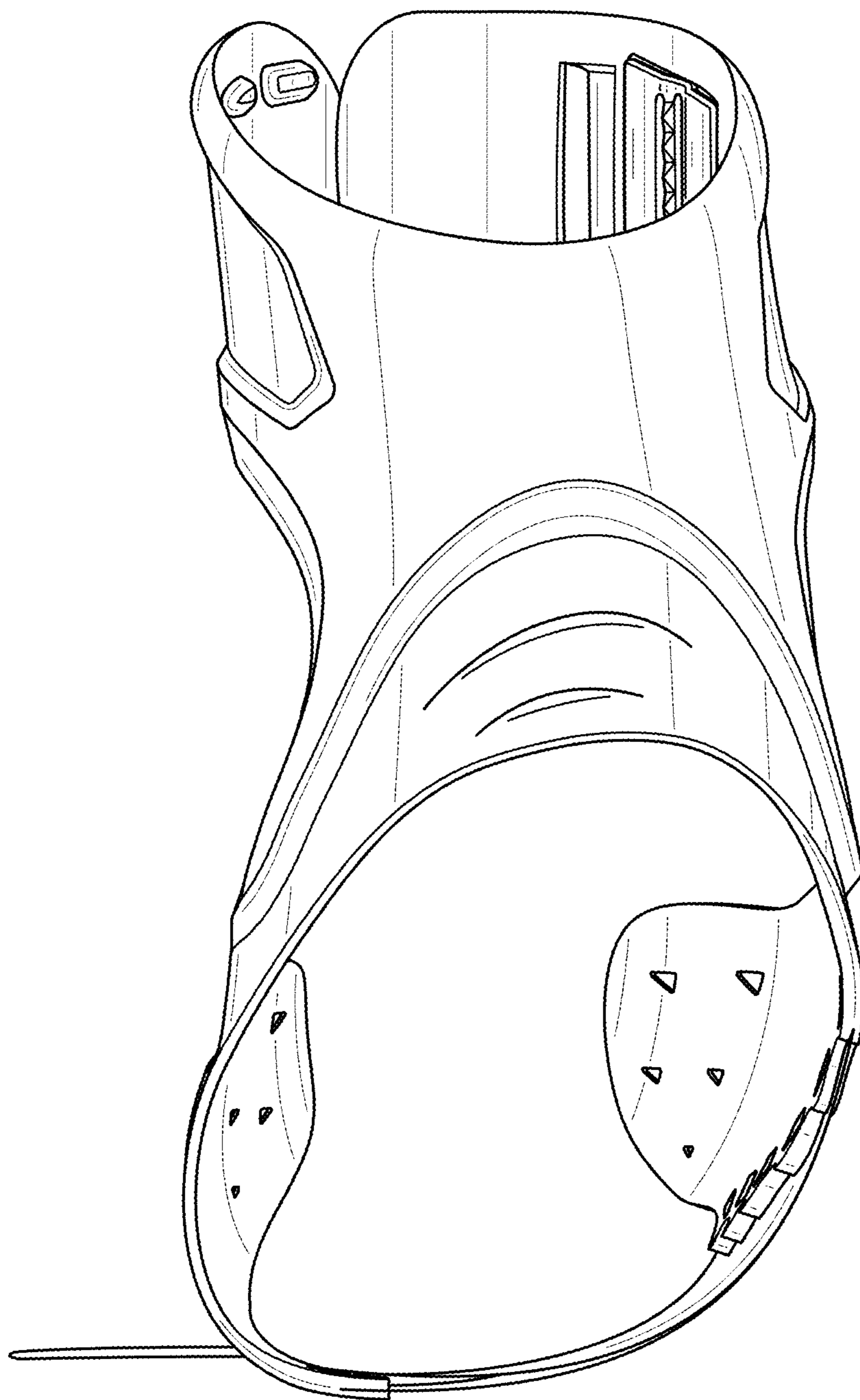

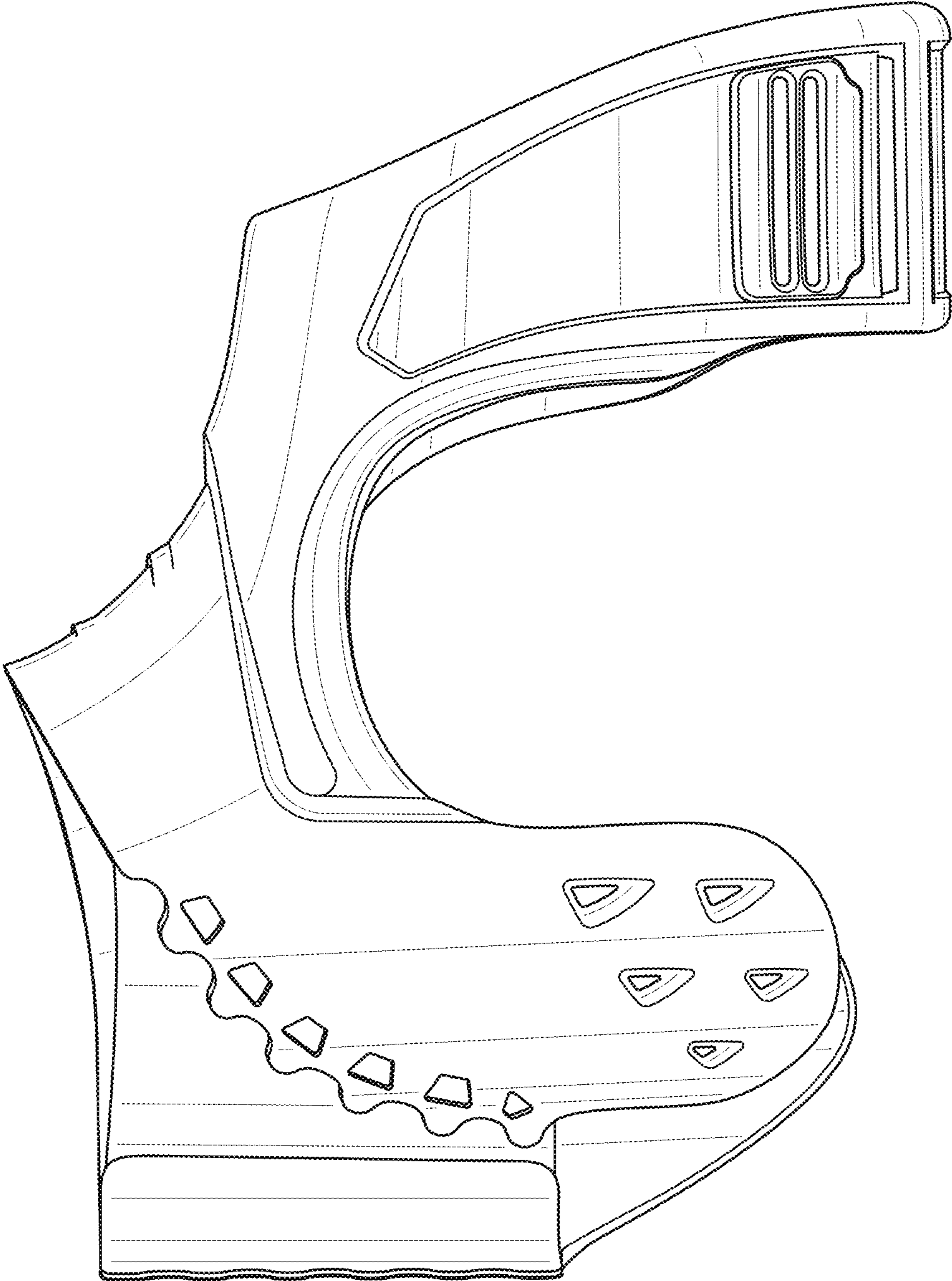

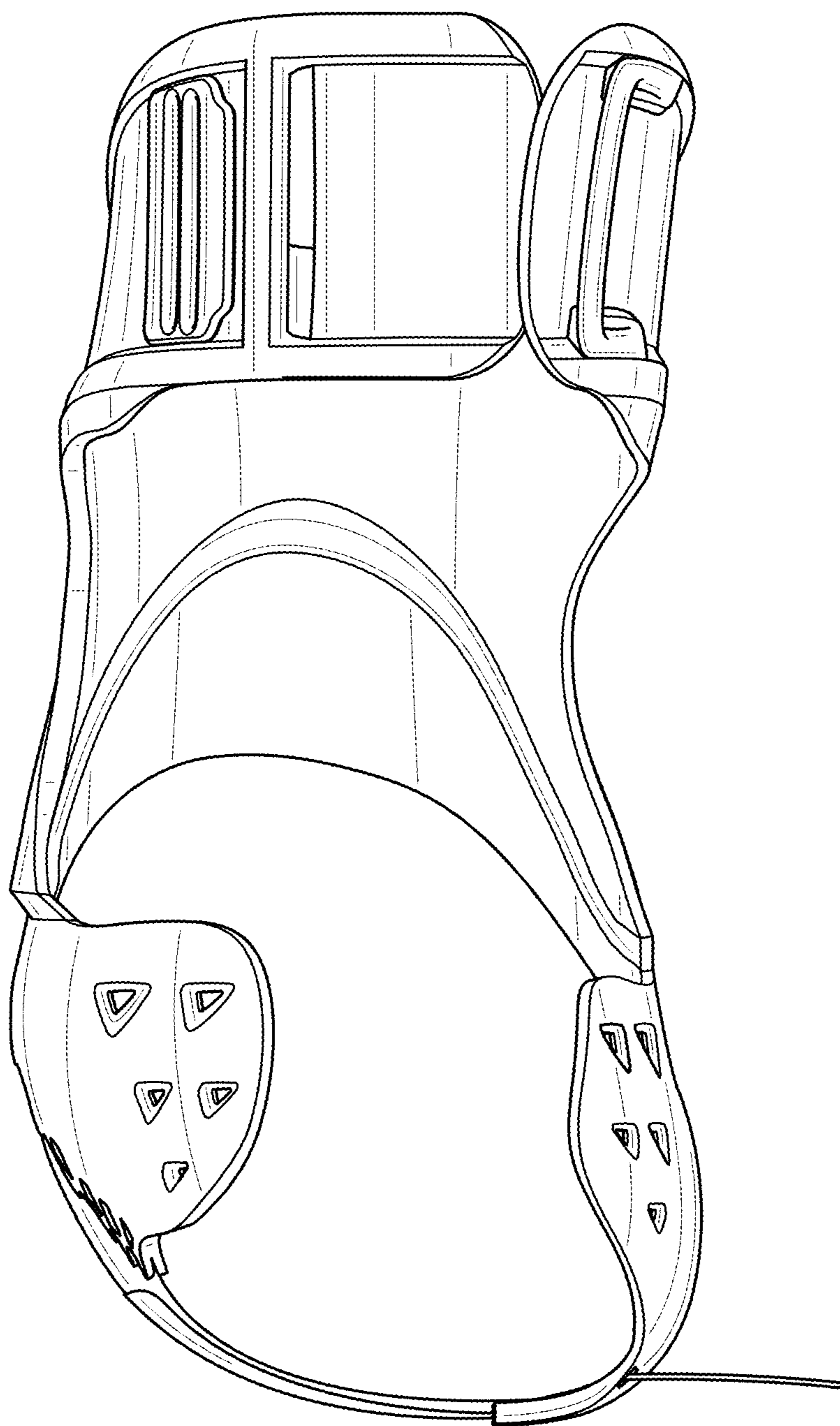

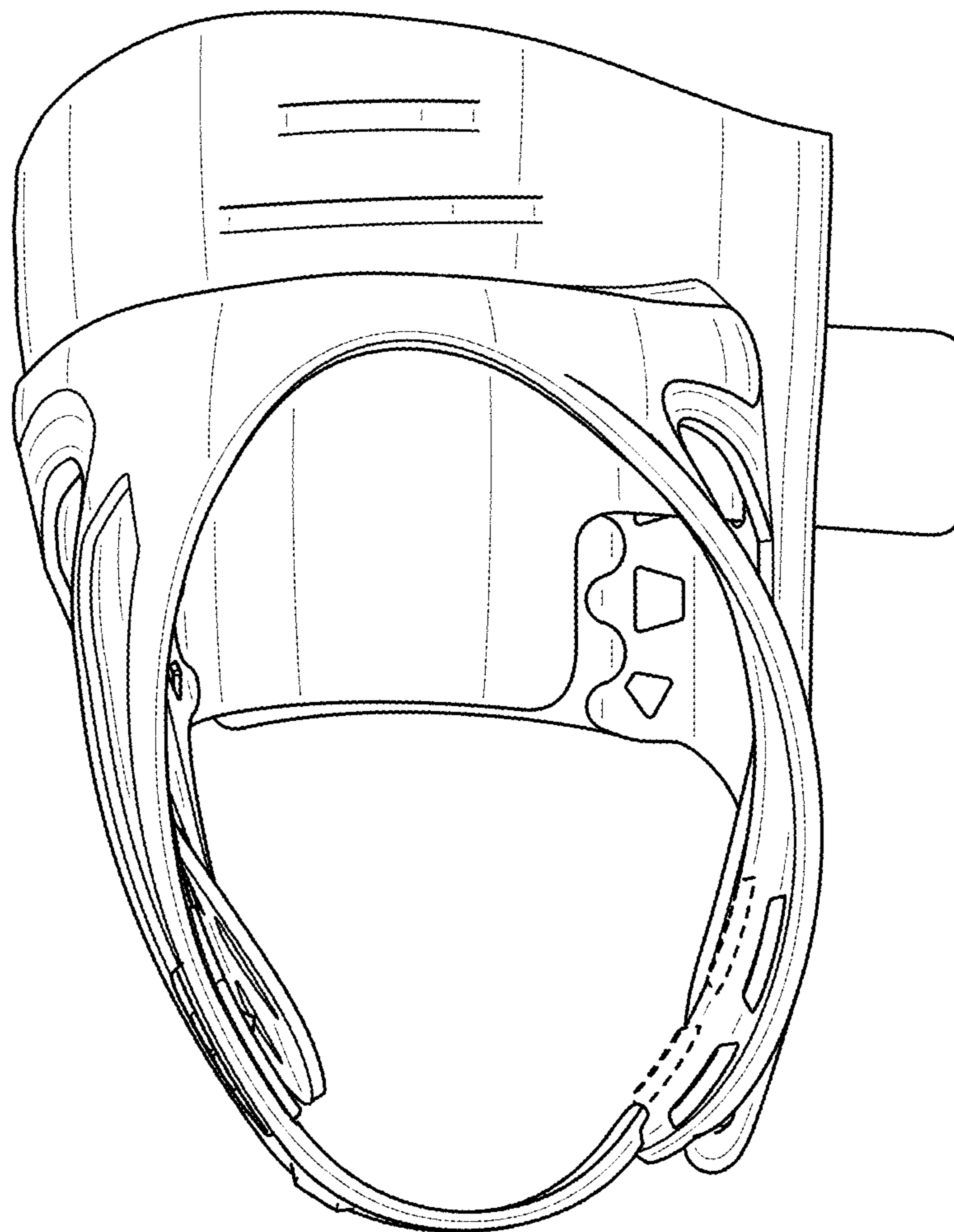

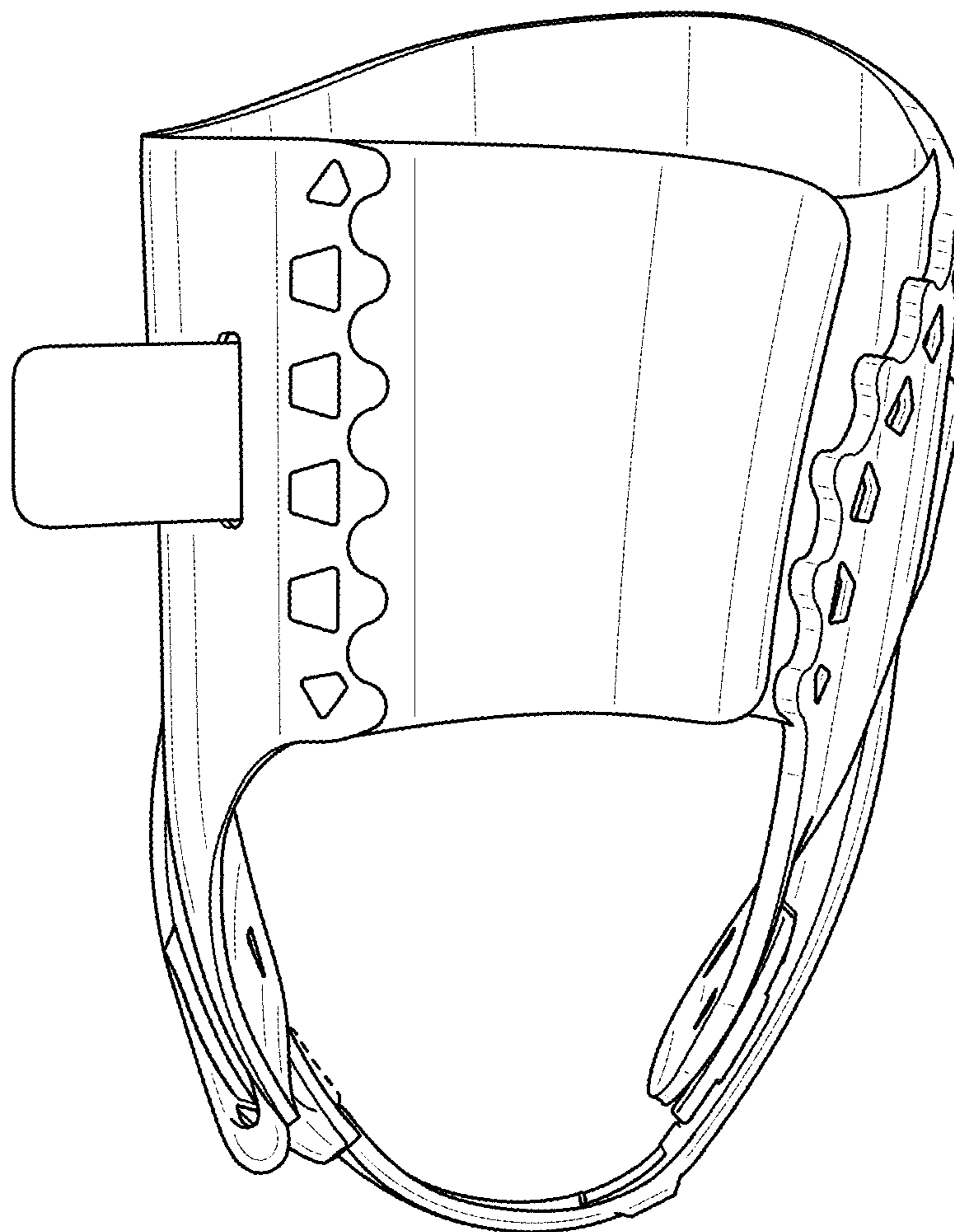
