(57) **CLAIM**

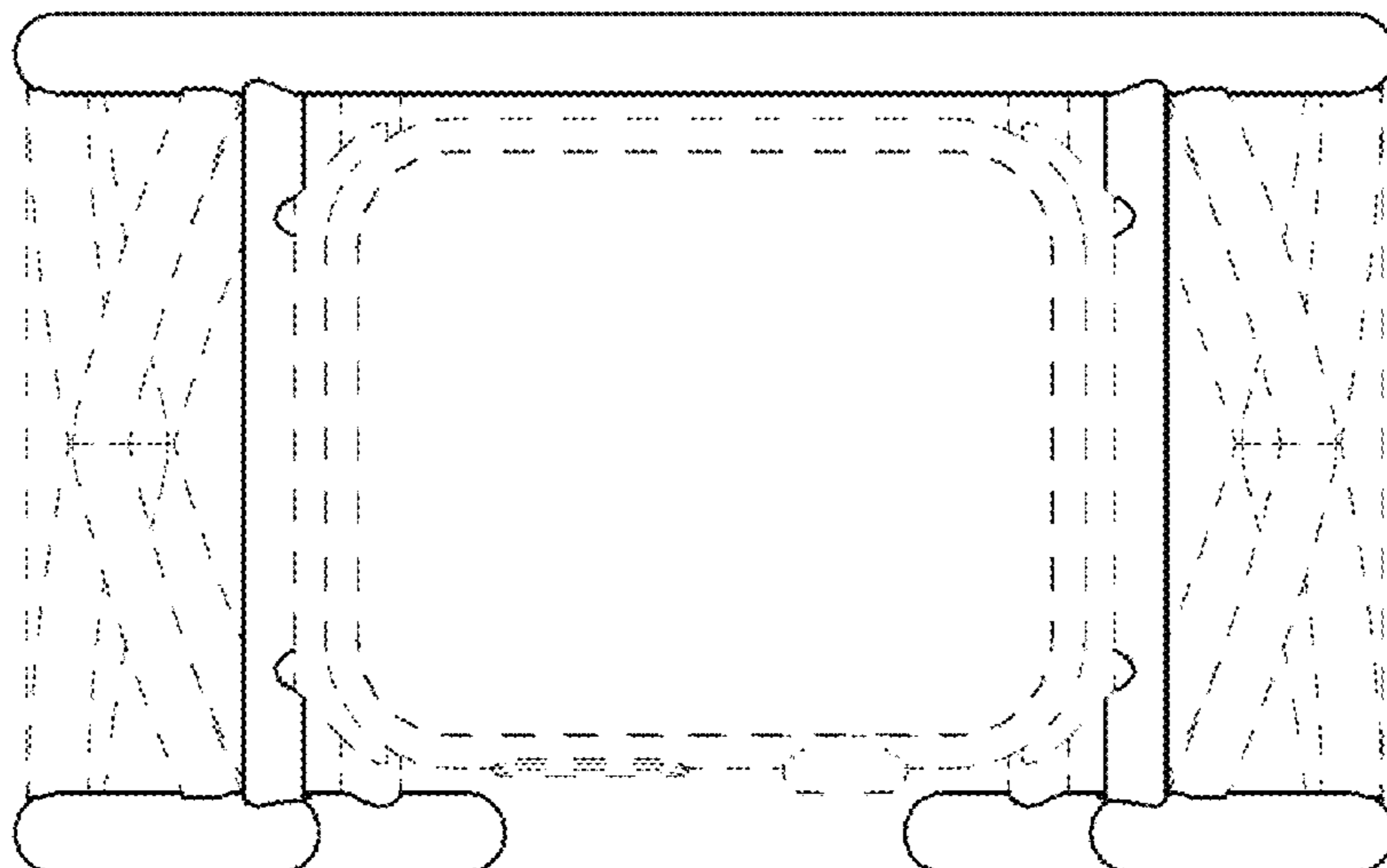
The ornamental design for a bracelet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bracelet showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an opposite side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is another side view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

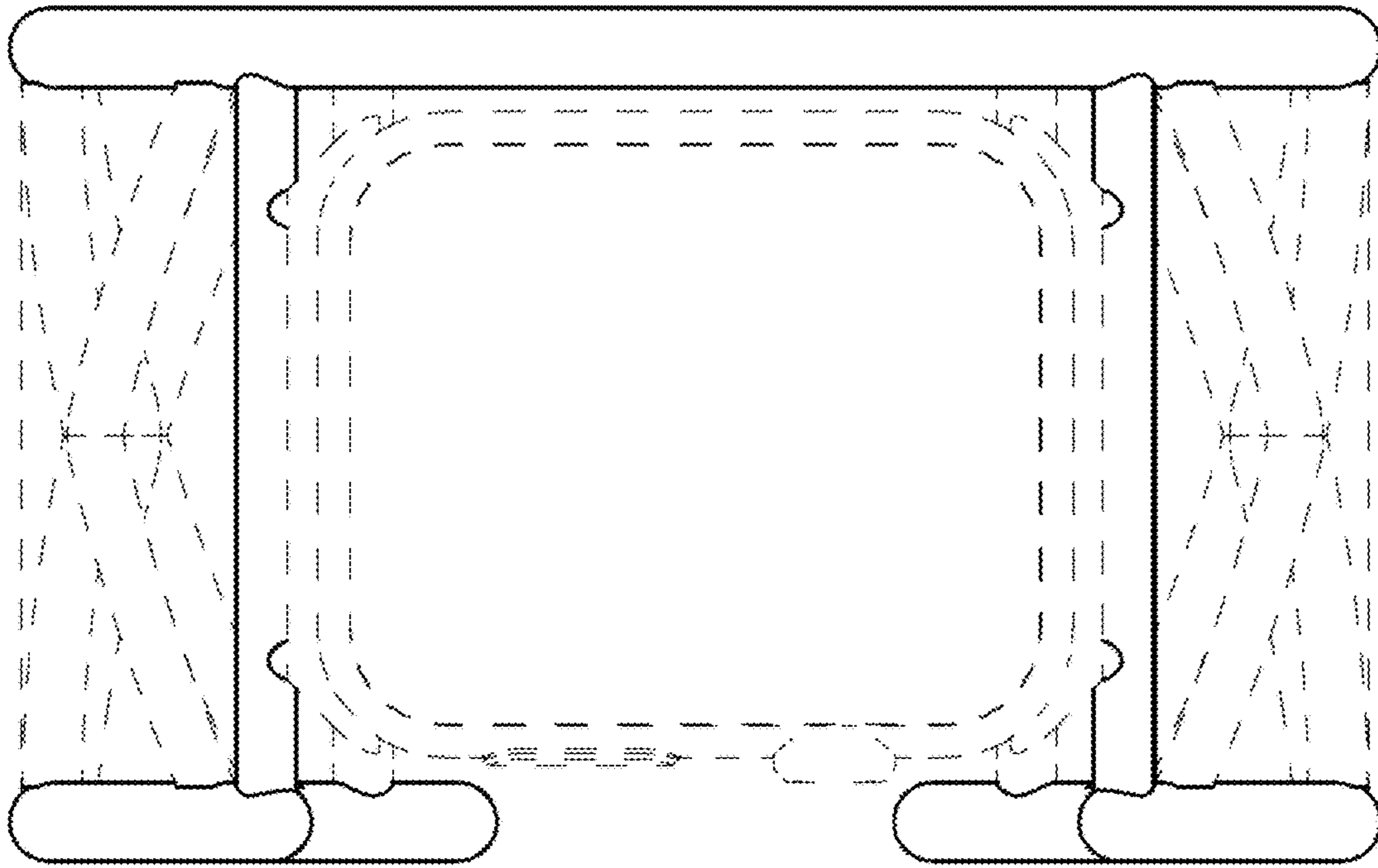

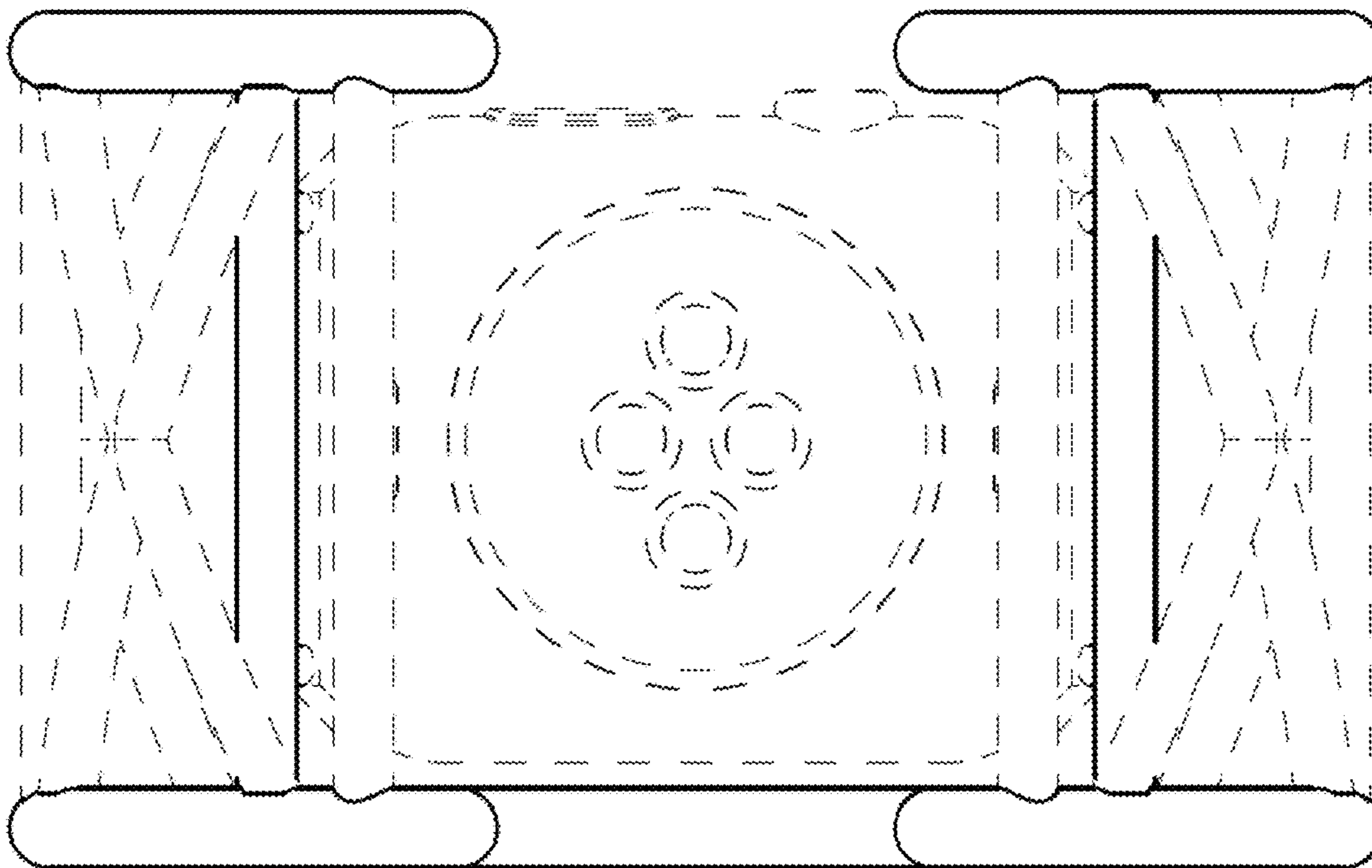

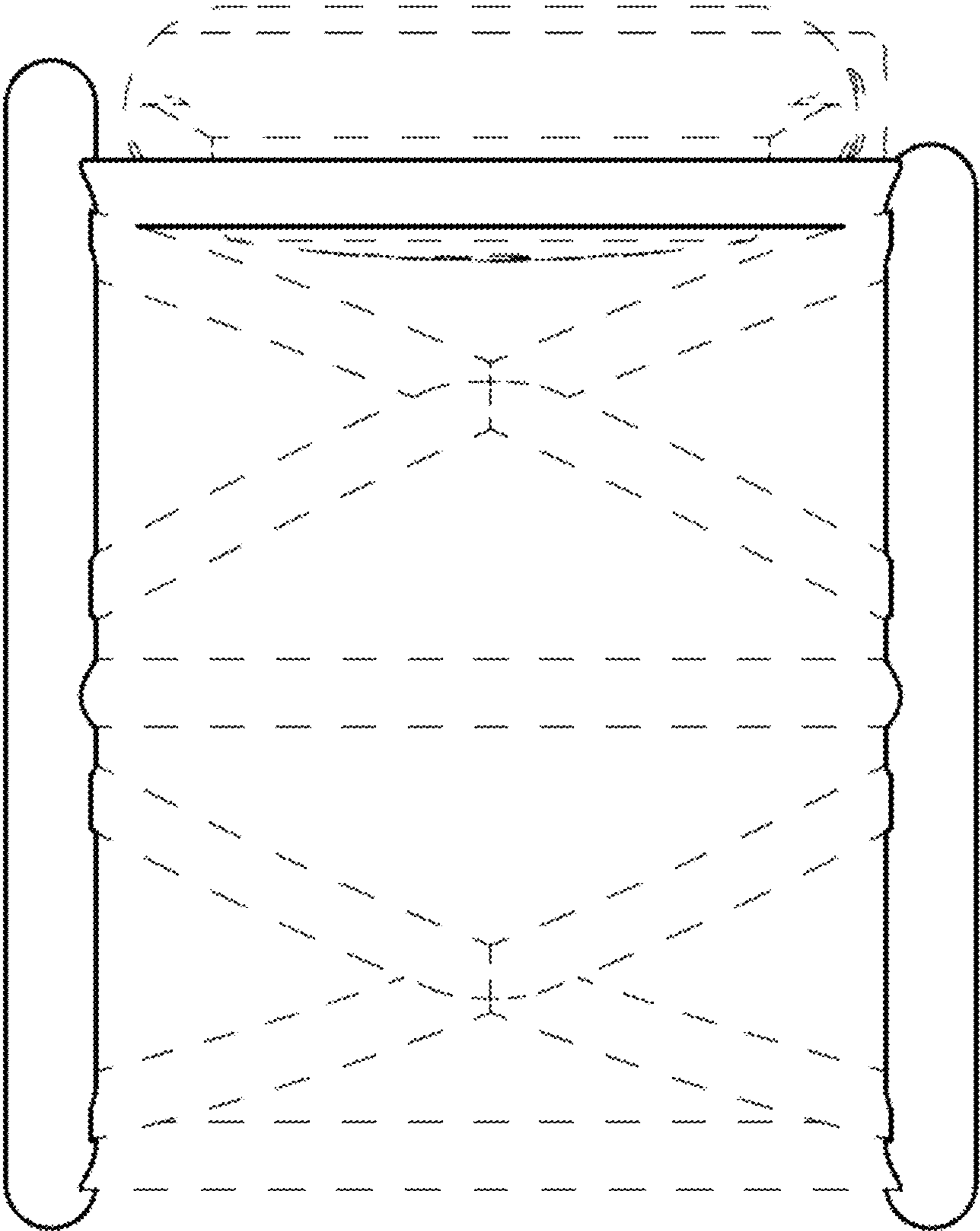

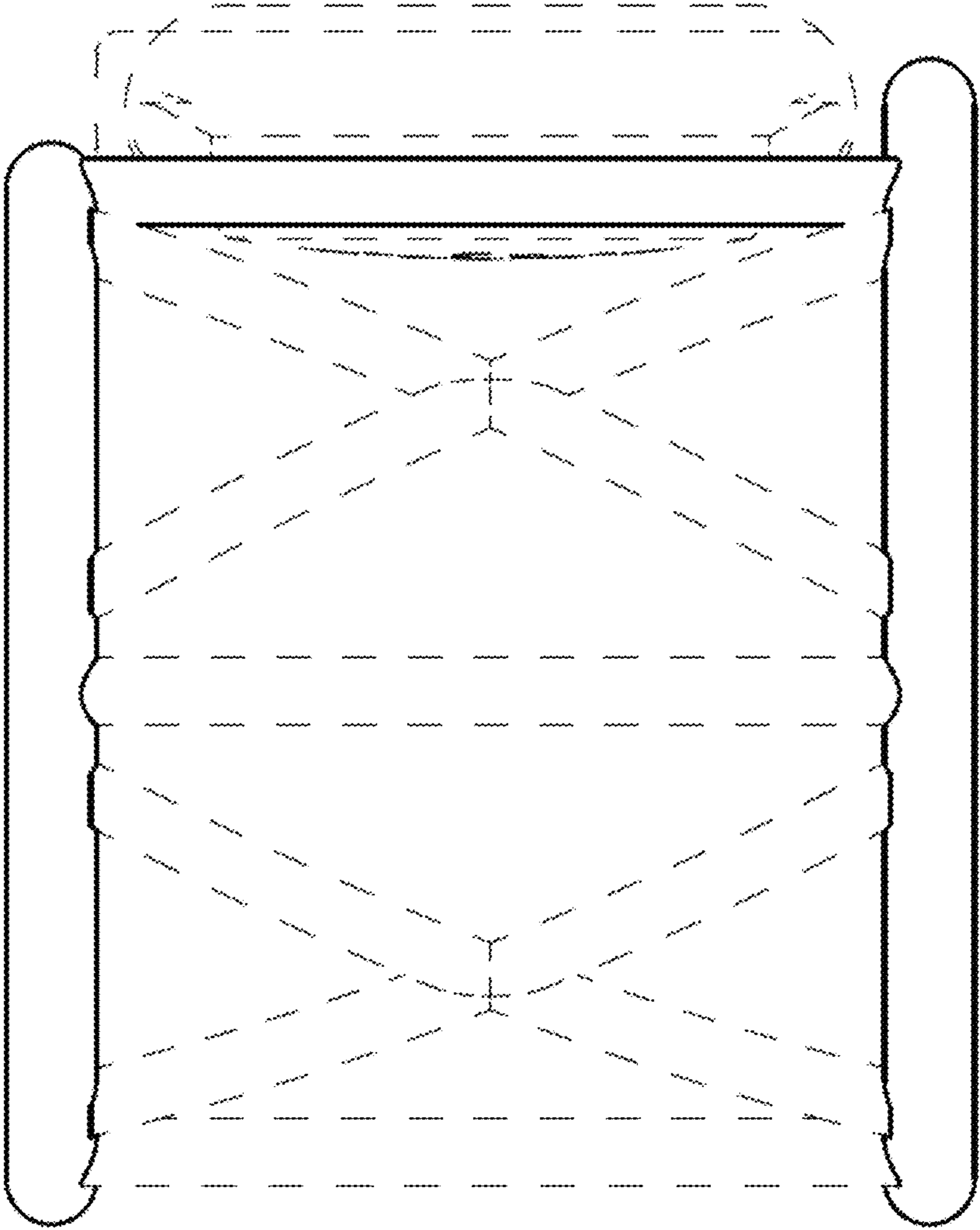

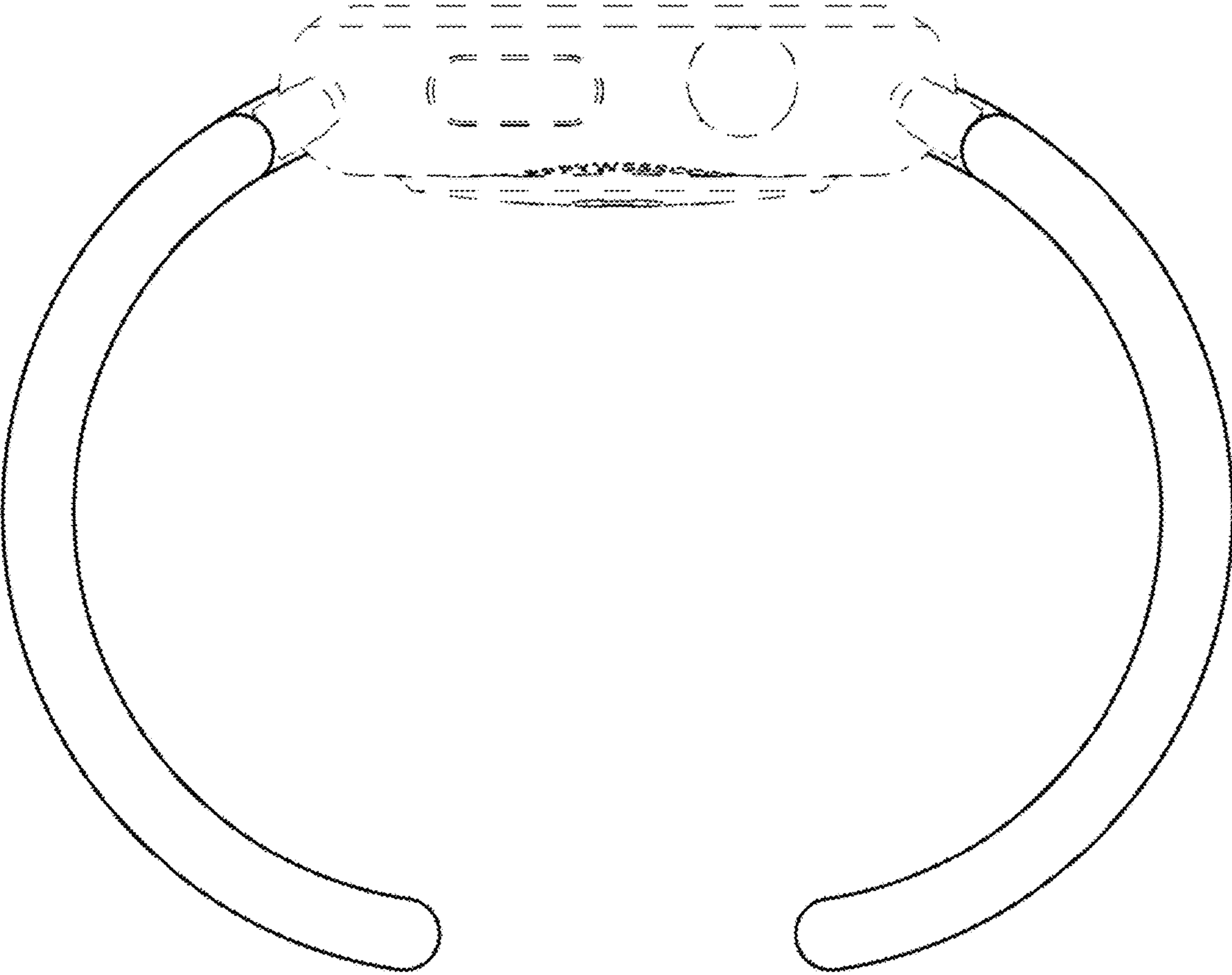

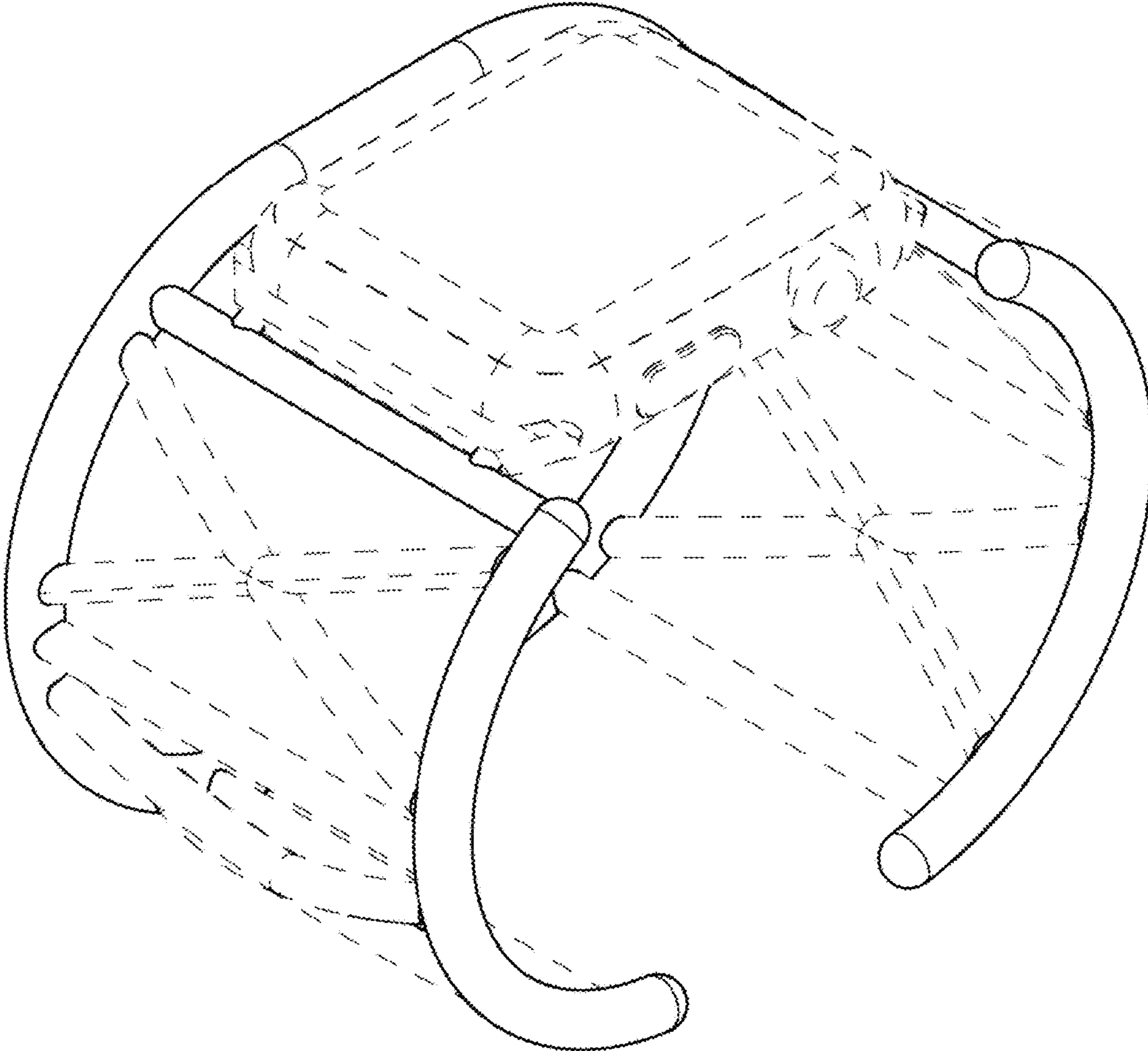
