The ornamental design for a stiletto for tripod, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a stiletto for tripod with a hole that goes all the way to the other side of the article, showing our new design.

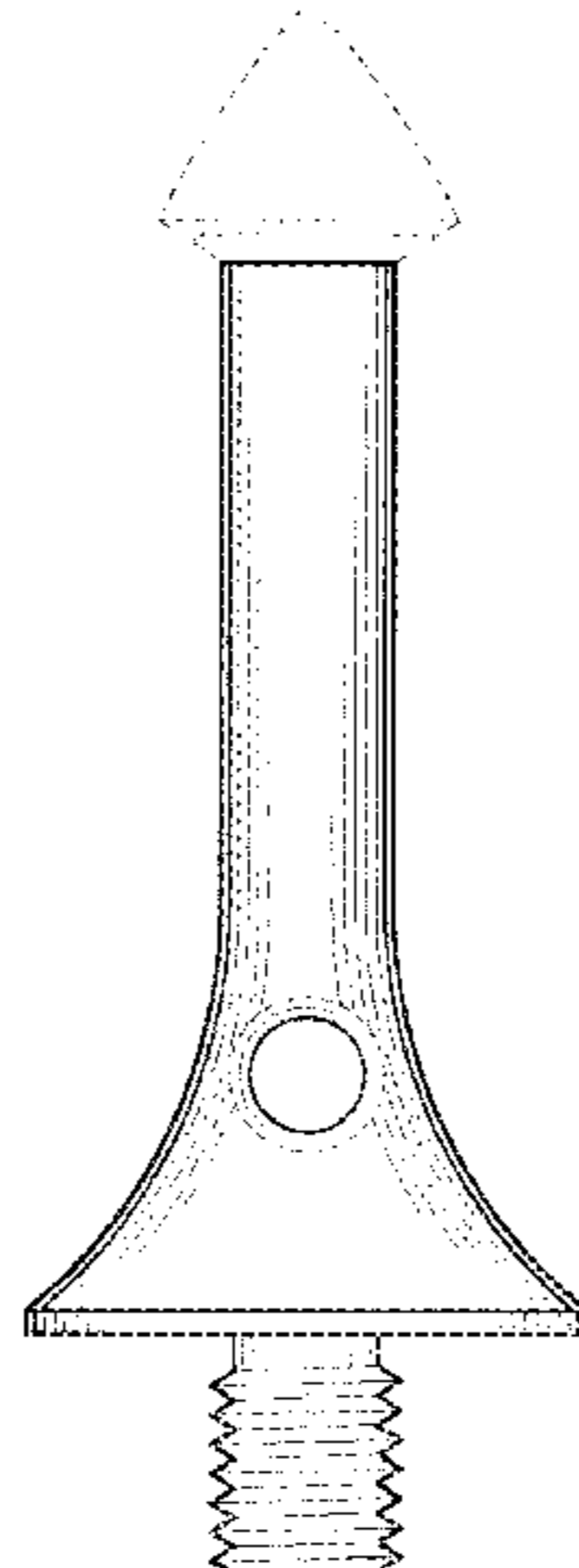
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.
