FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 5.

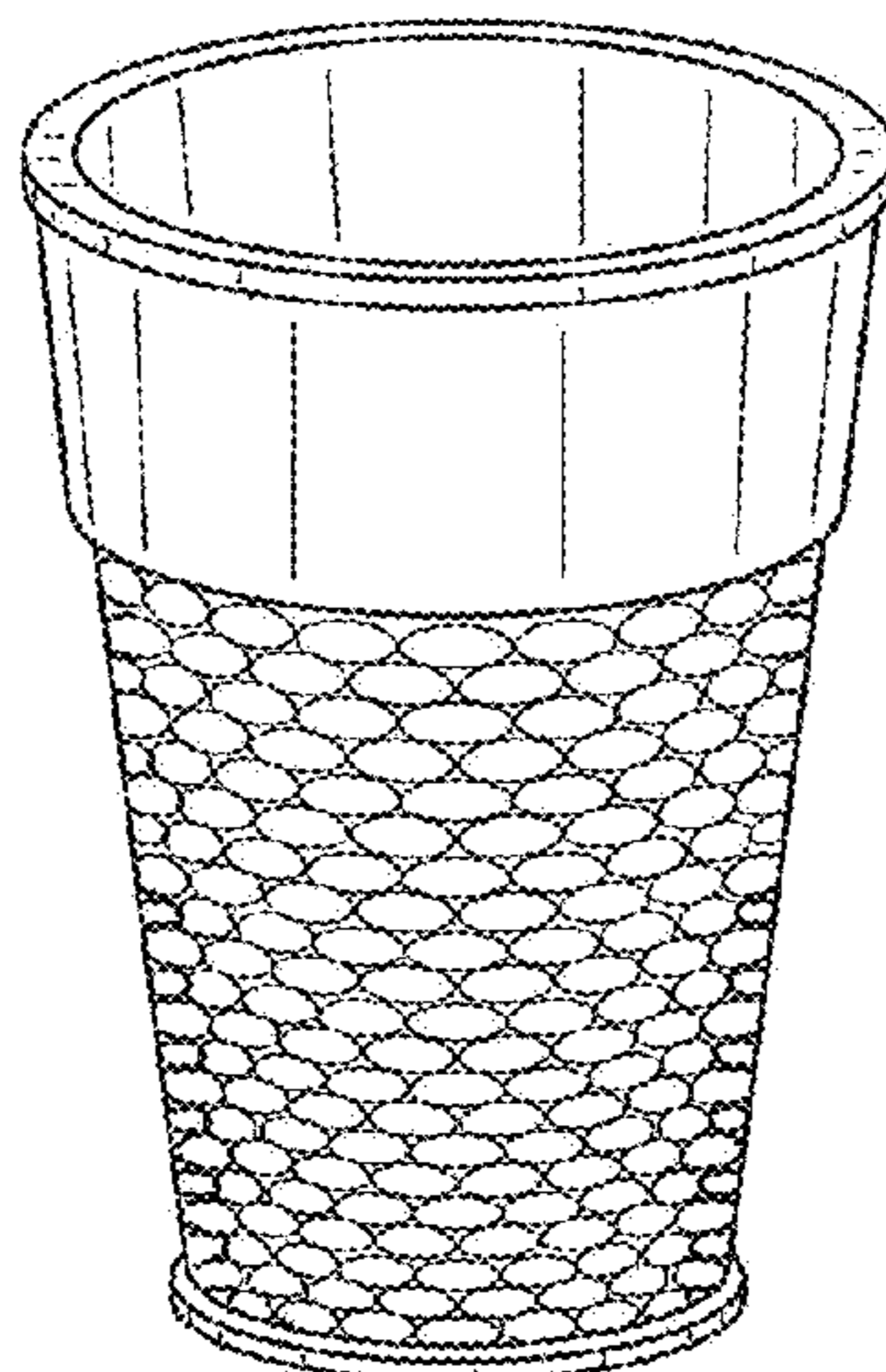
The children's drinking cup of FIGS. 1-9 has a hammered textured pattern applied over a portion of its exterior.

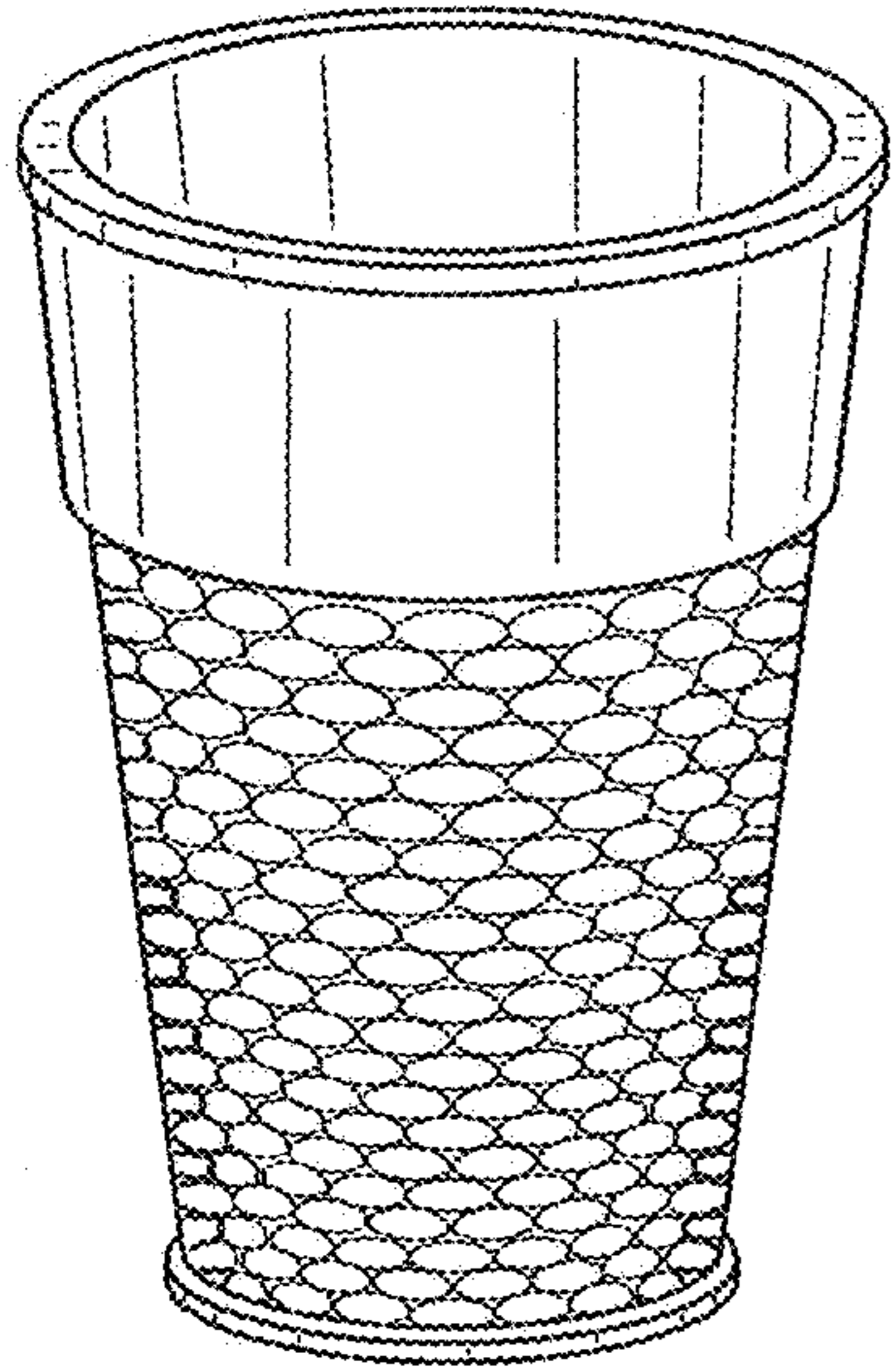

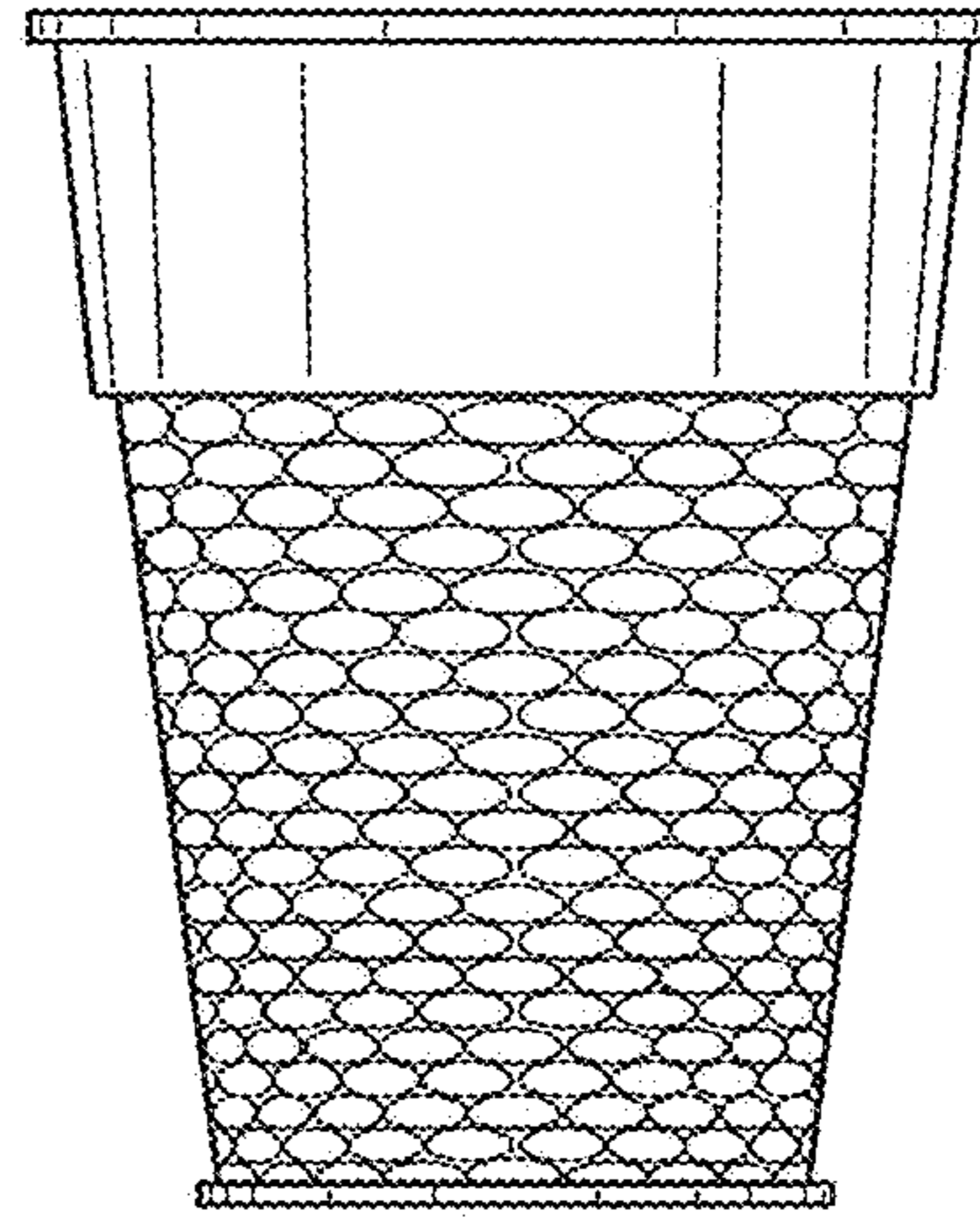

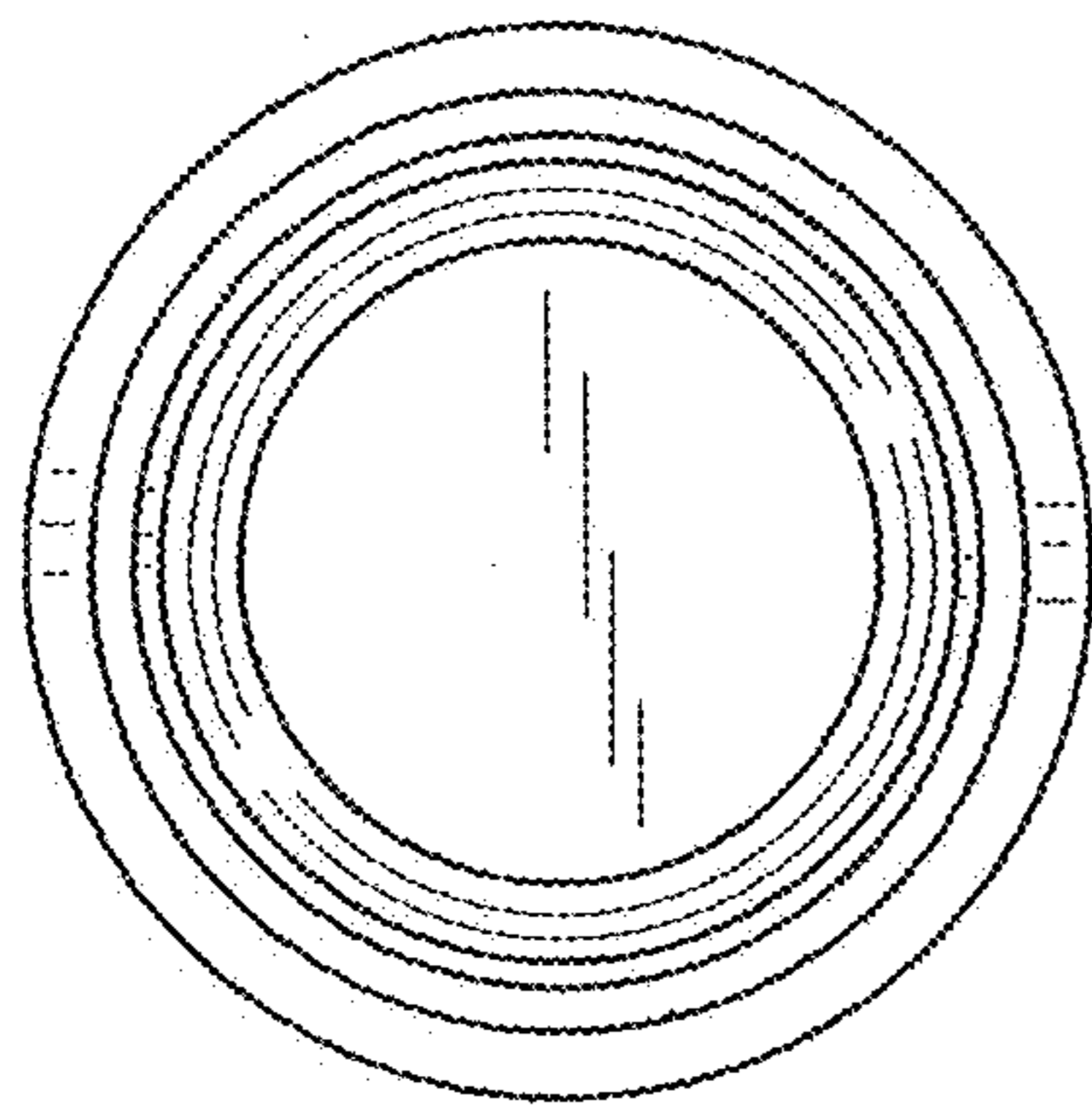

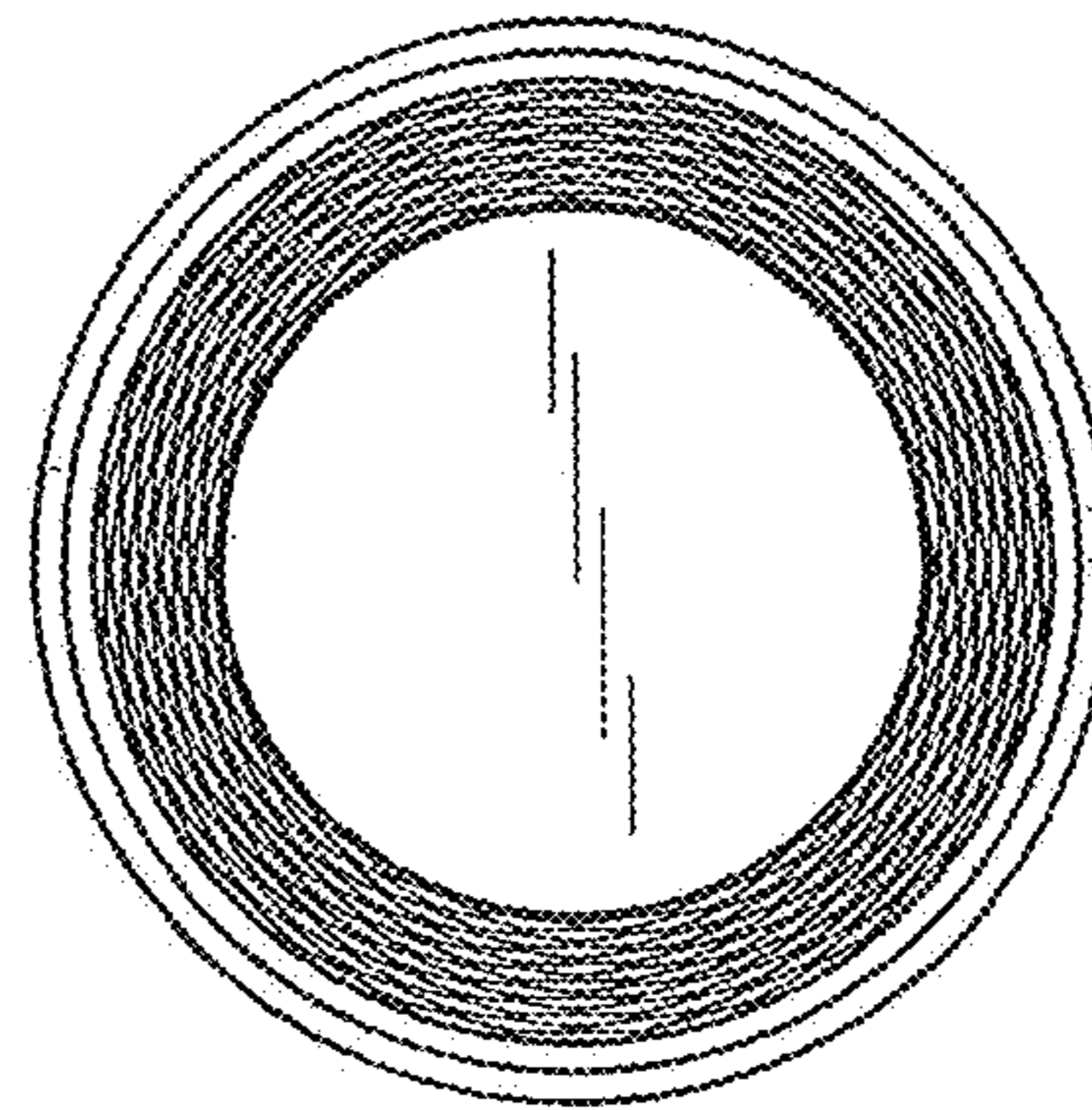

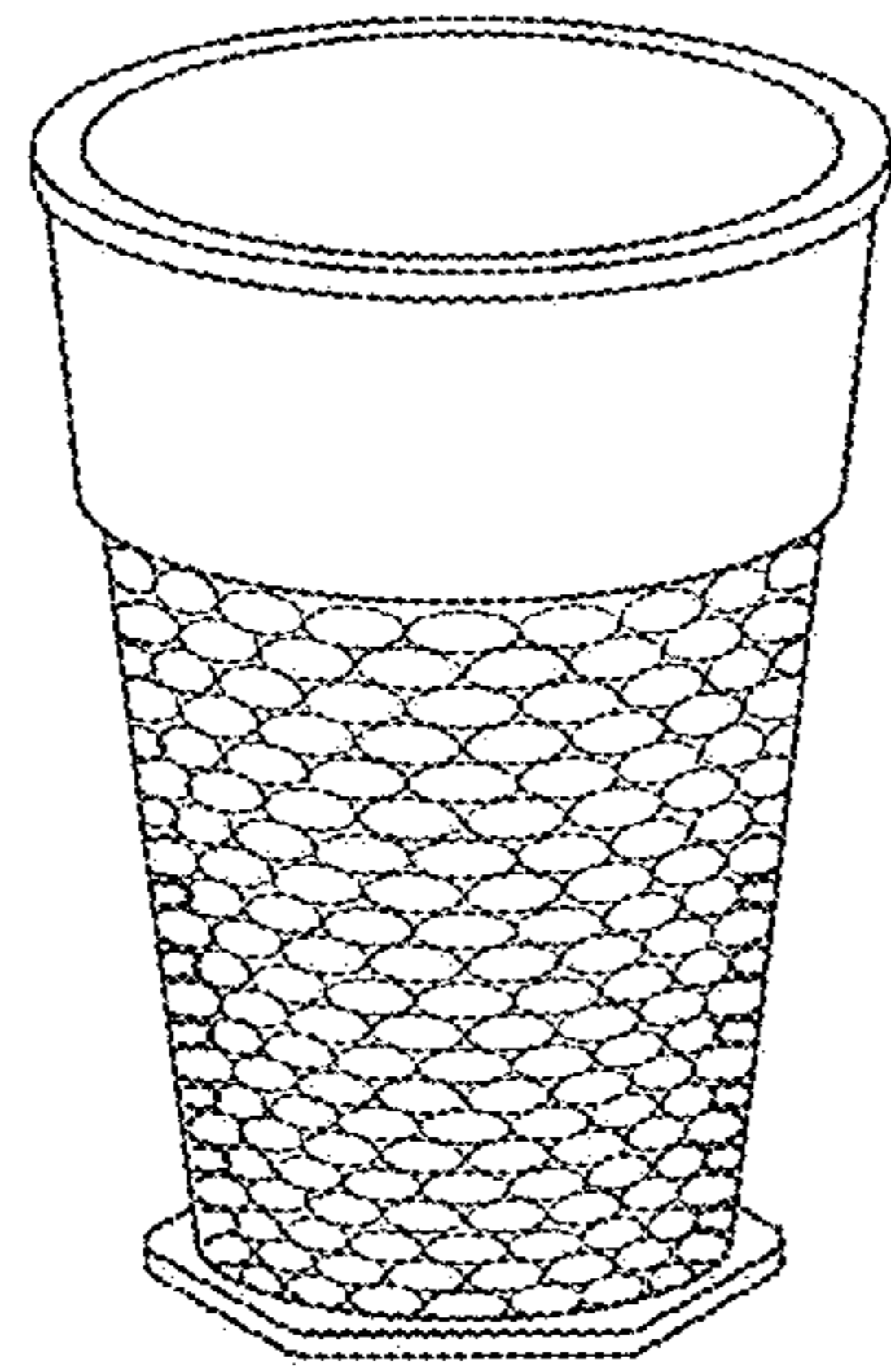

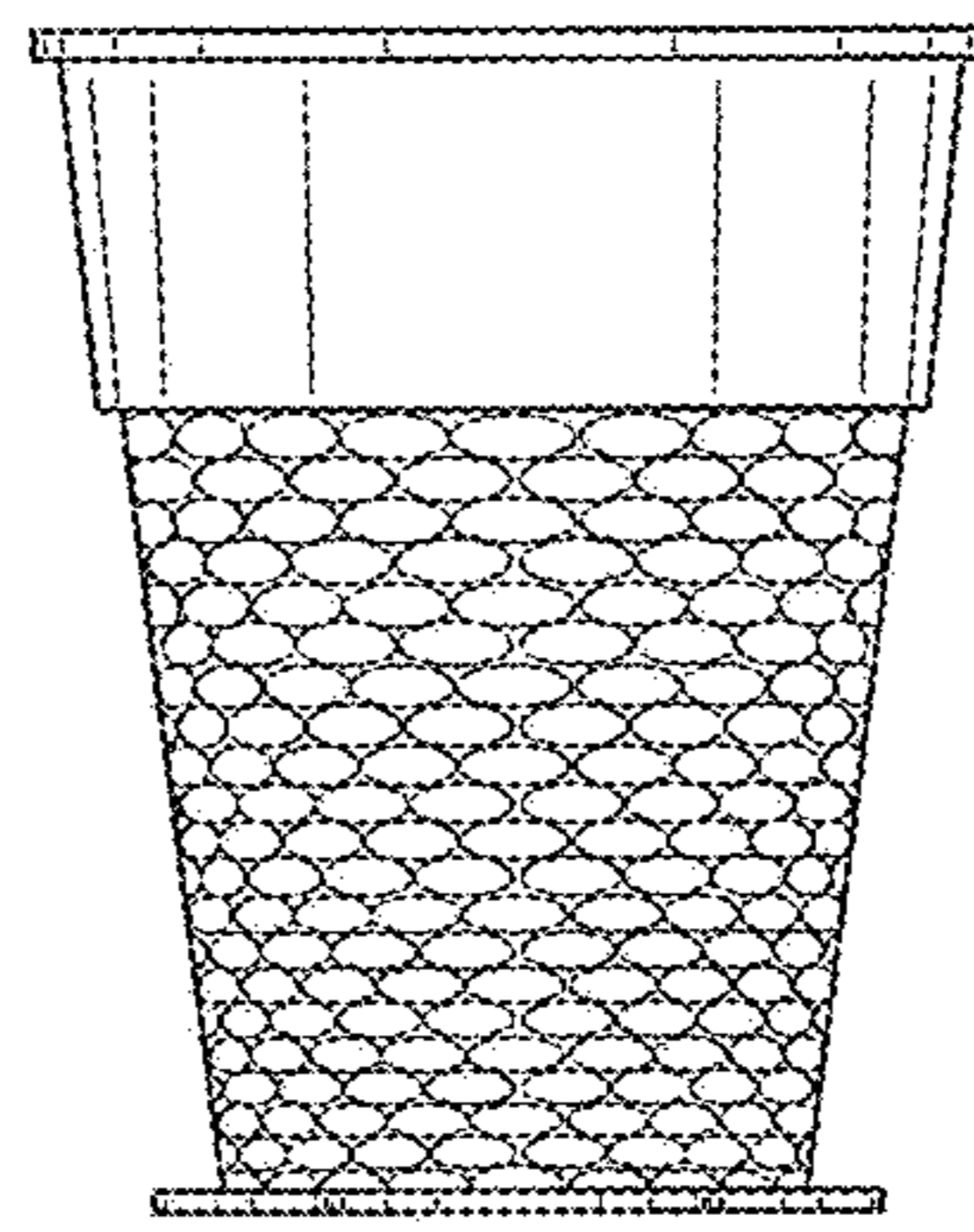

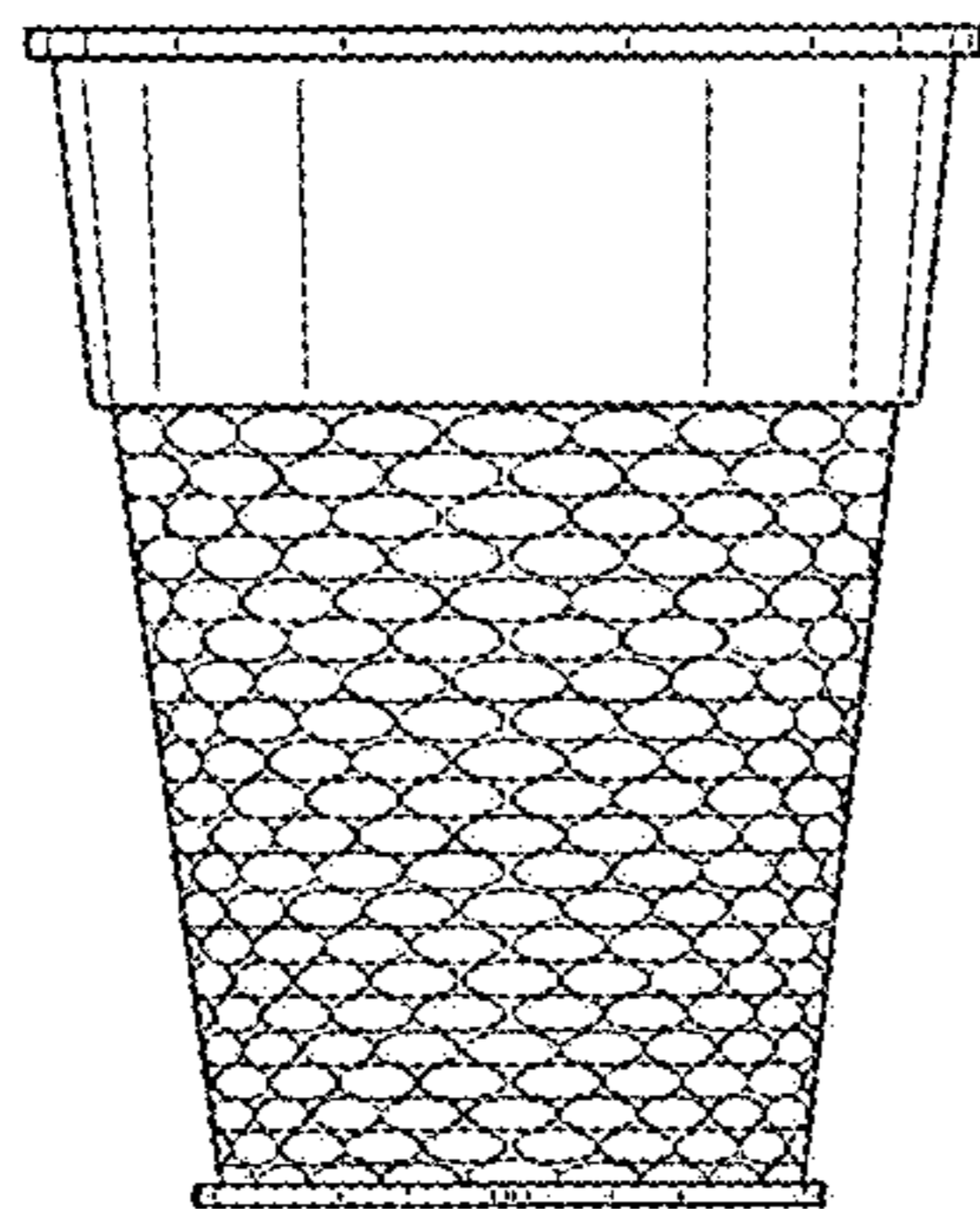

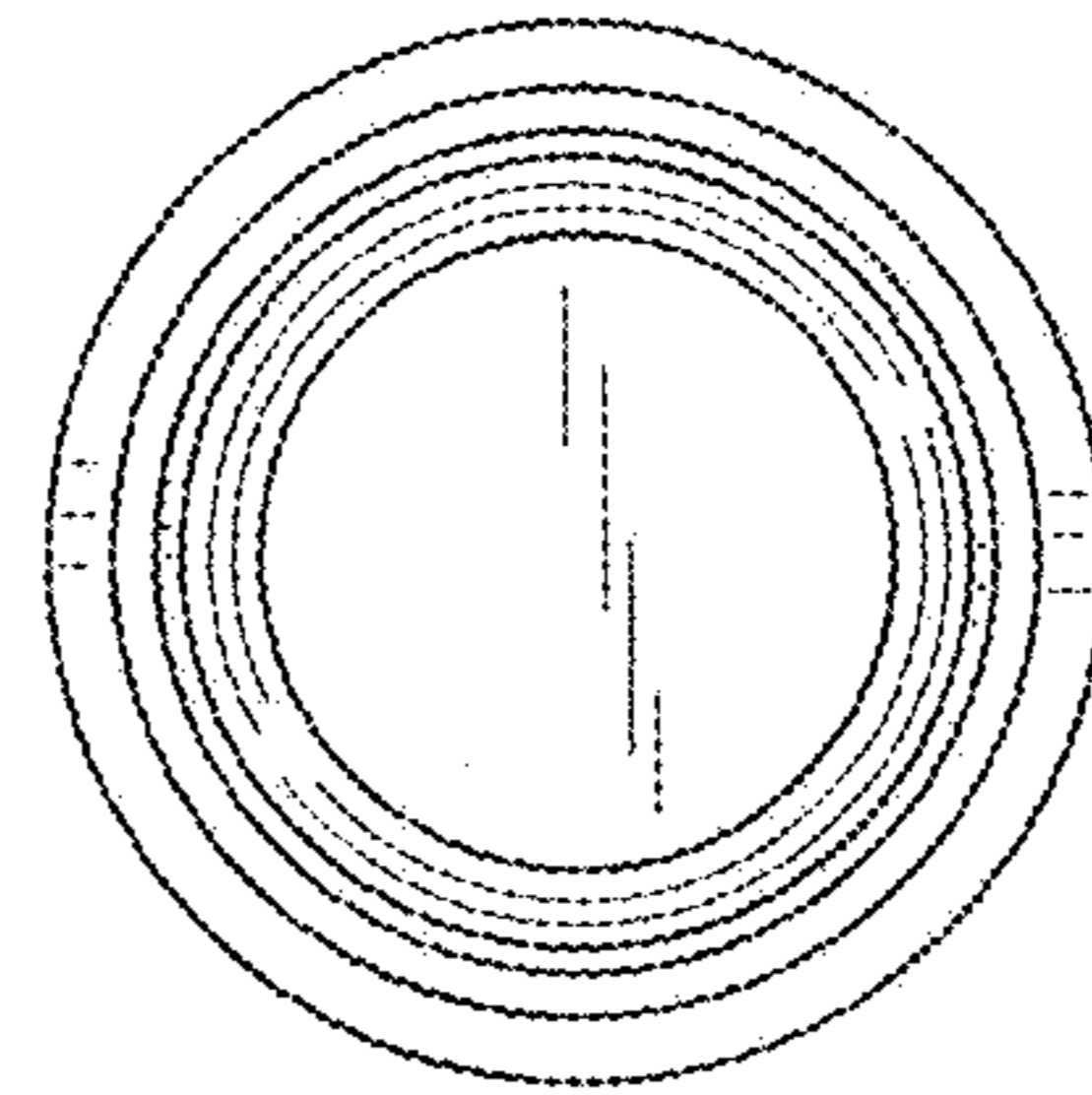

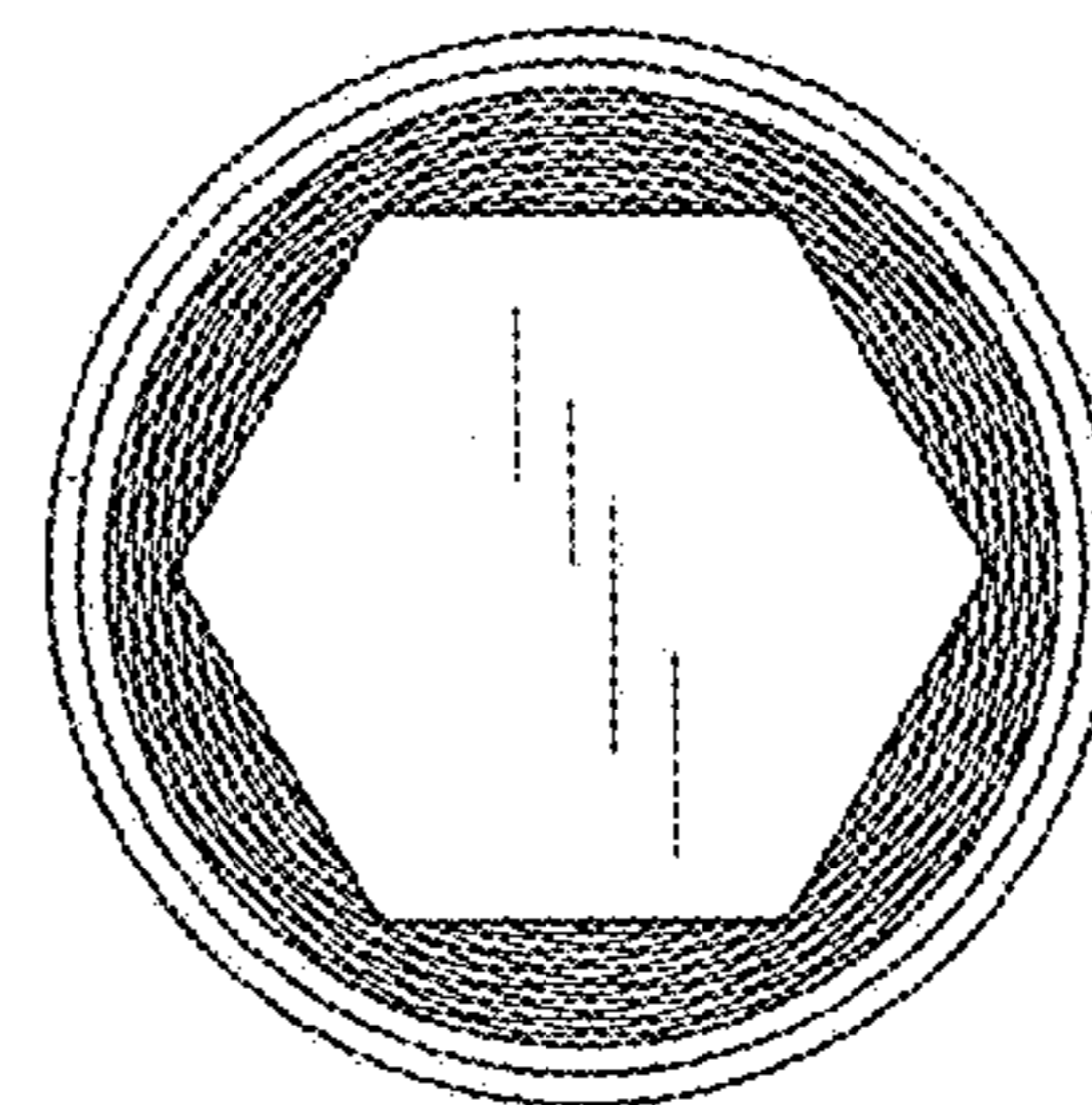
