FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevational view, the right side elevational view and the left side elevational view being mirror images;

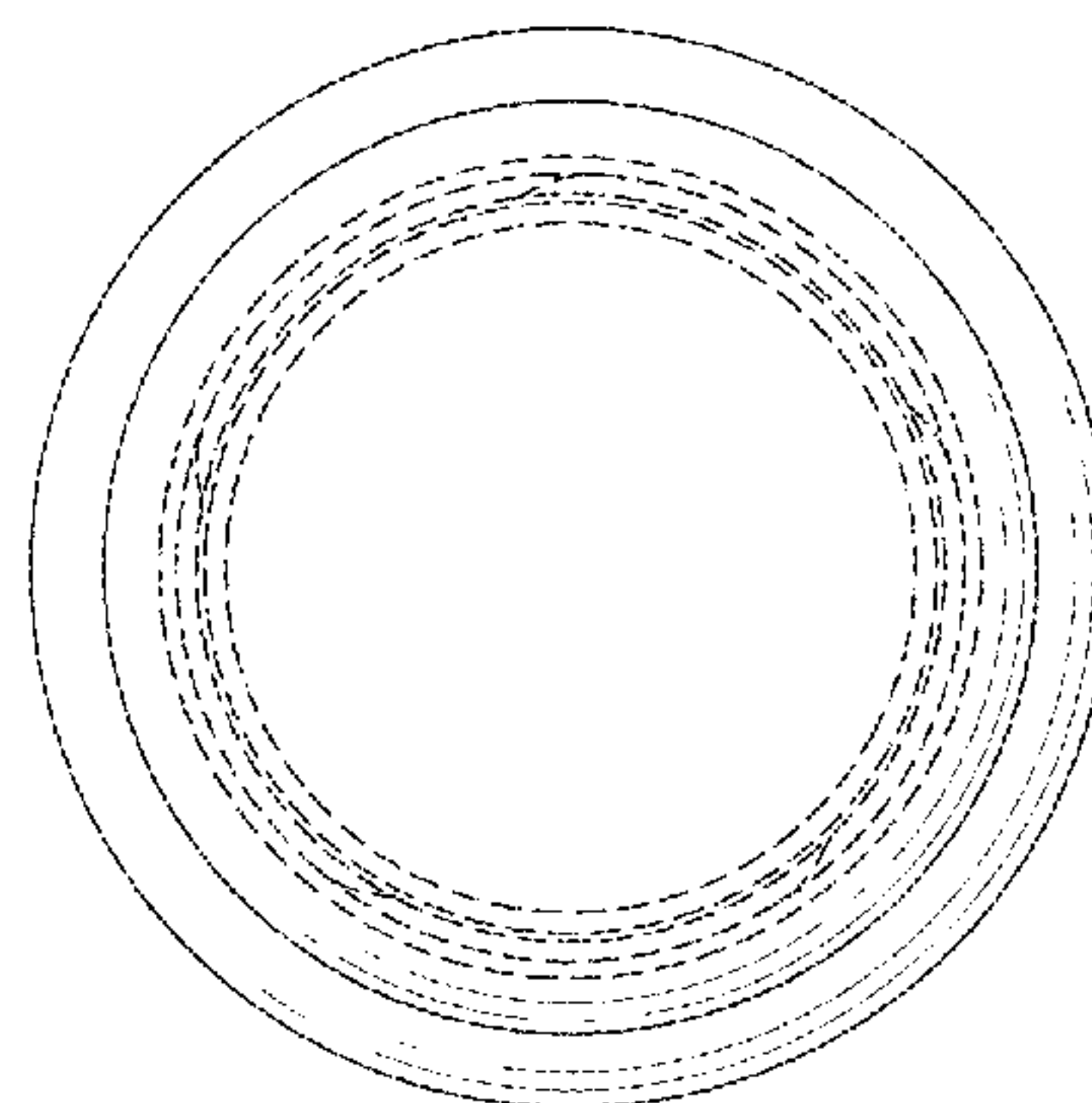
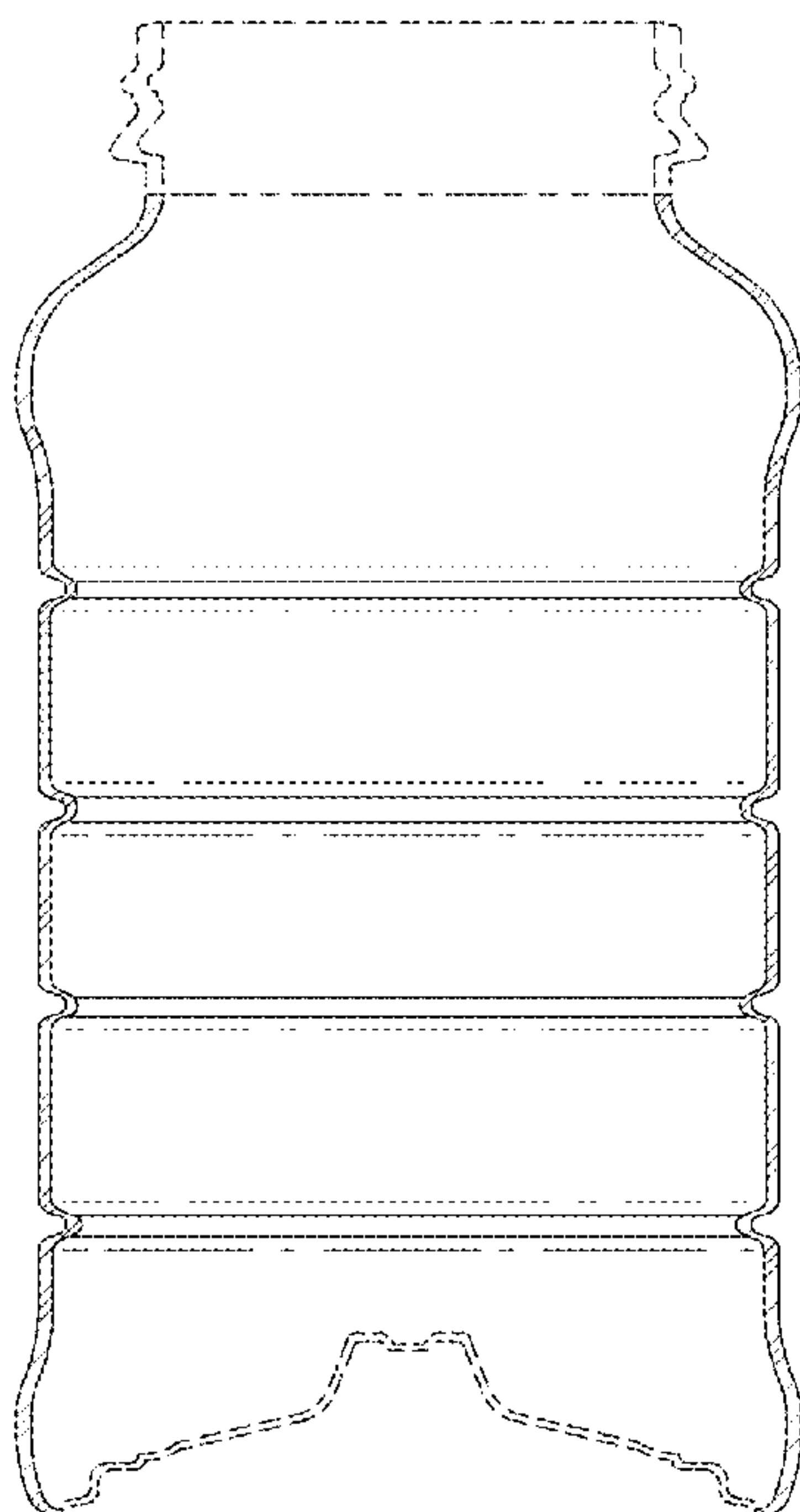
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view of the container along line 3-3 of FIG. 2;

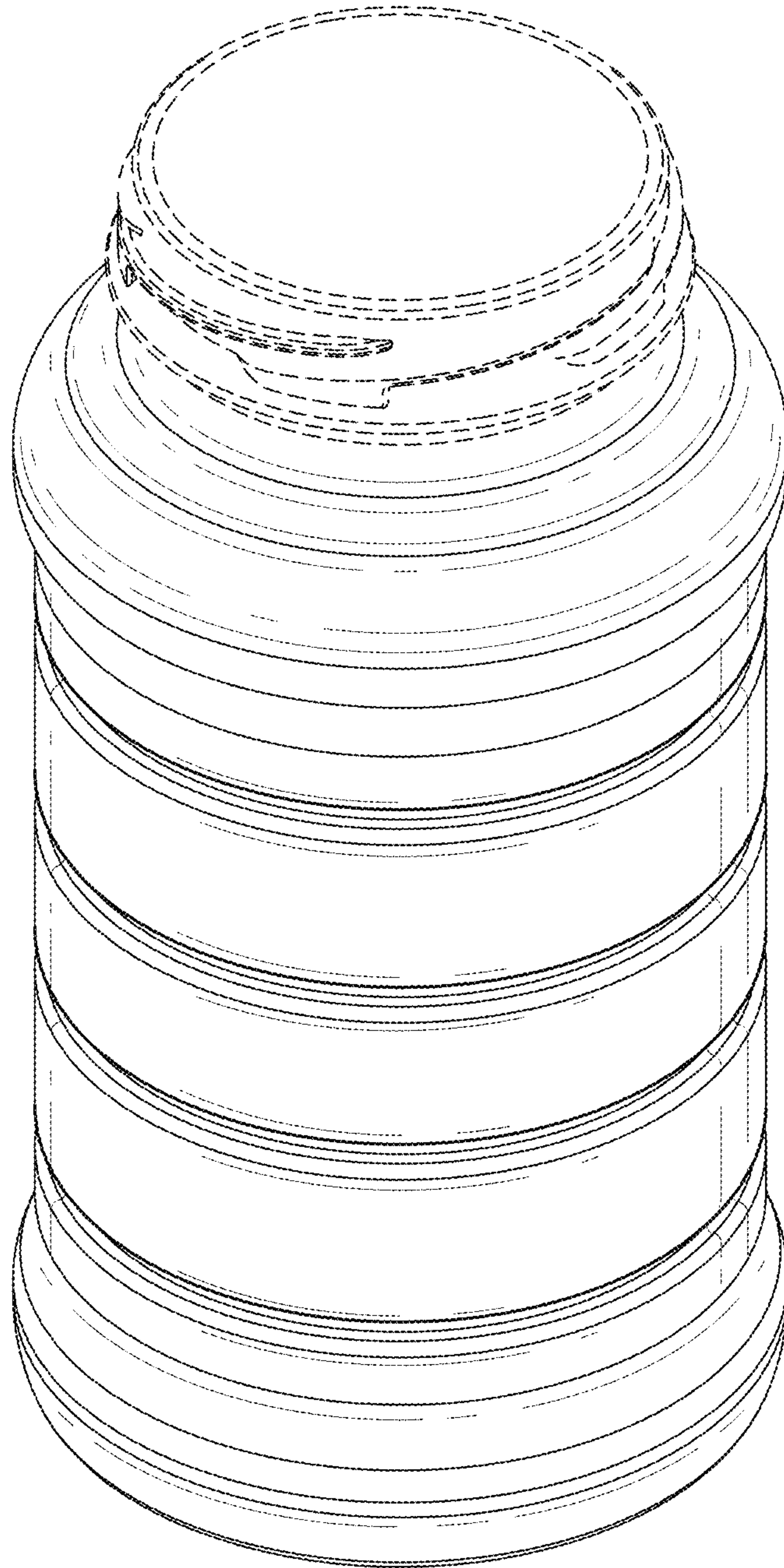

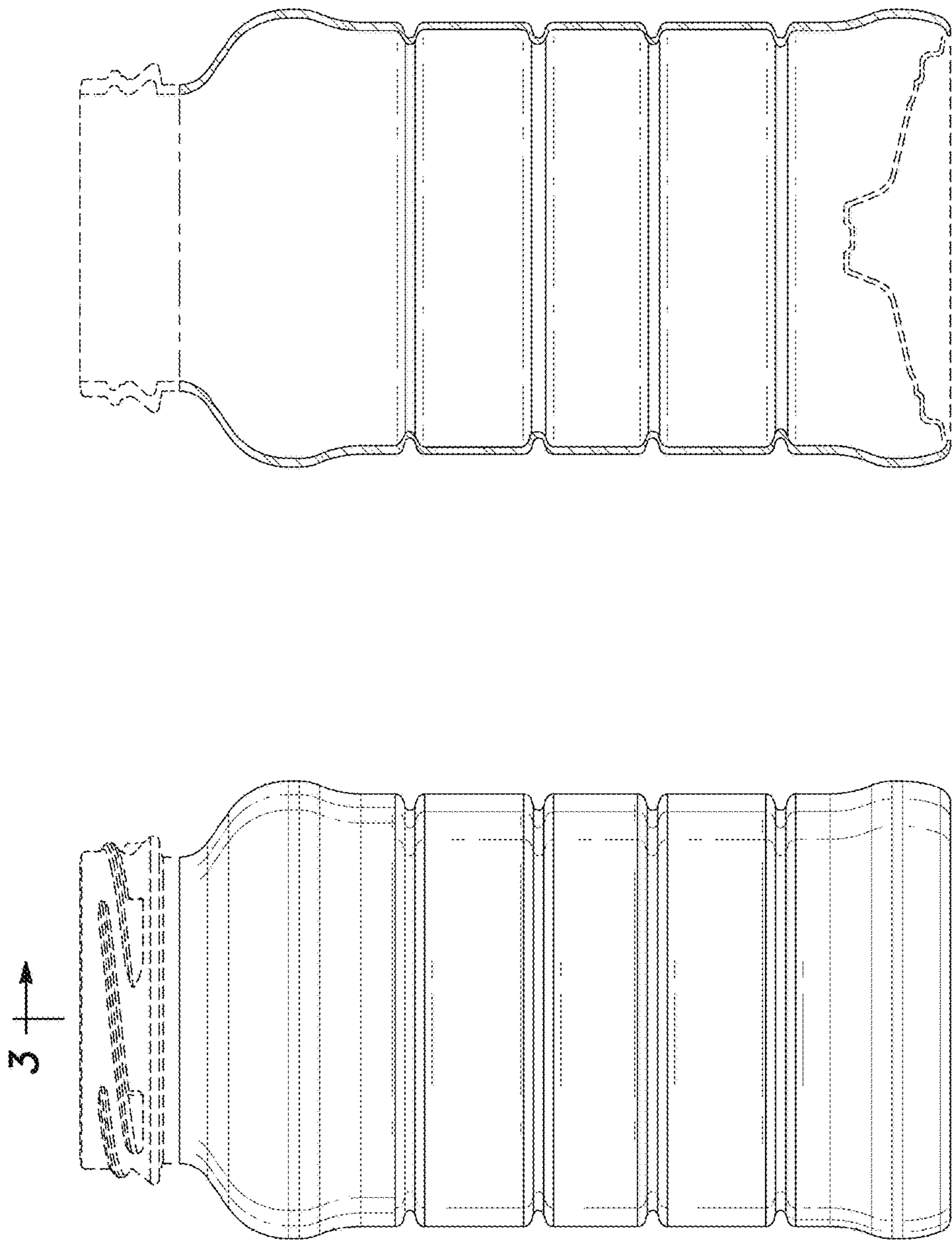

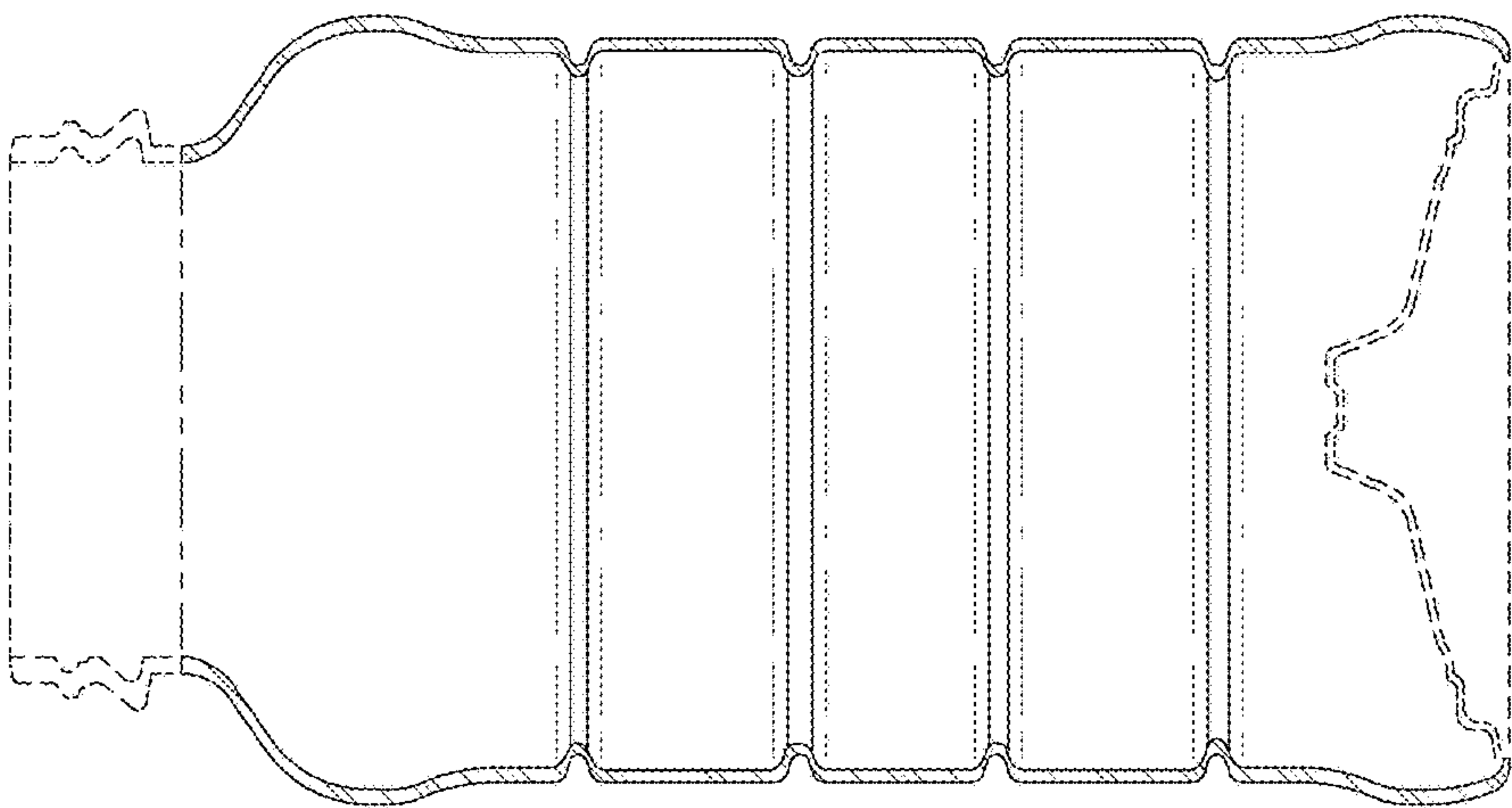

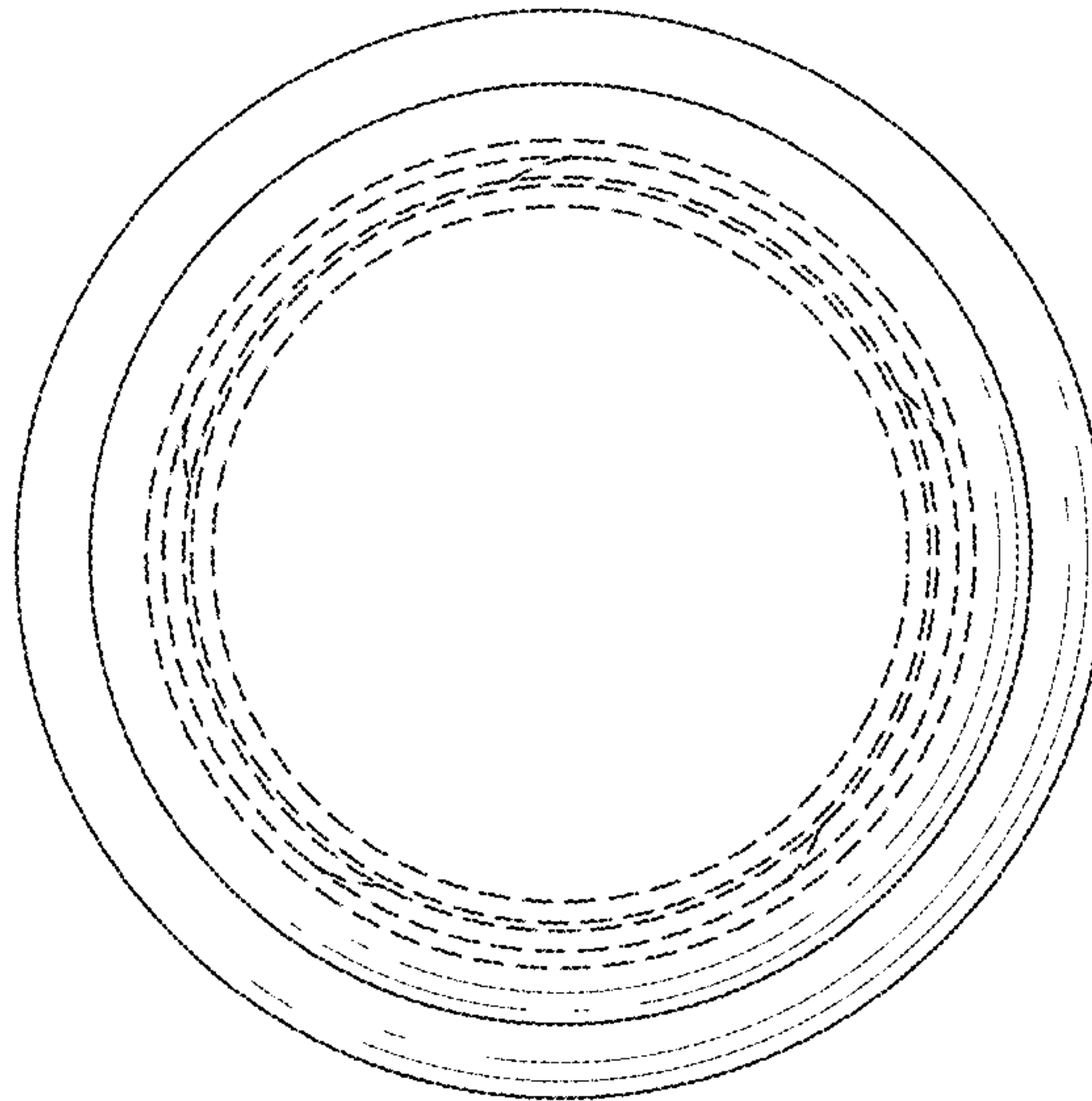

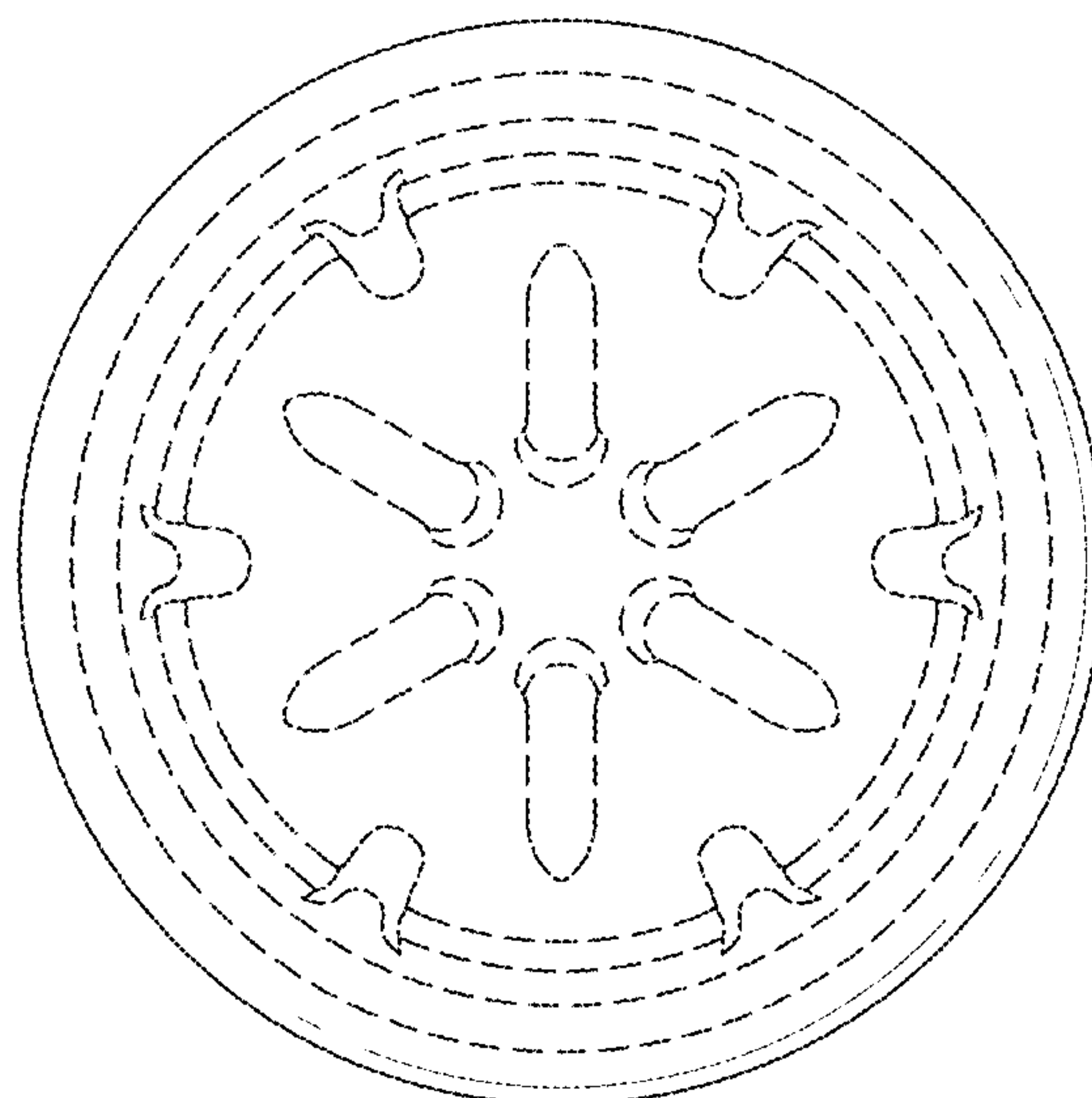
