DESCRIPTION

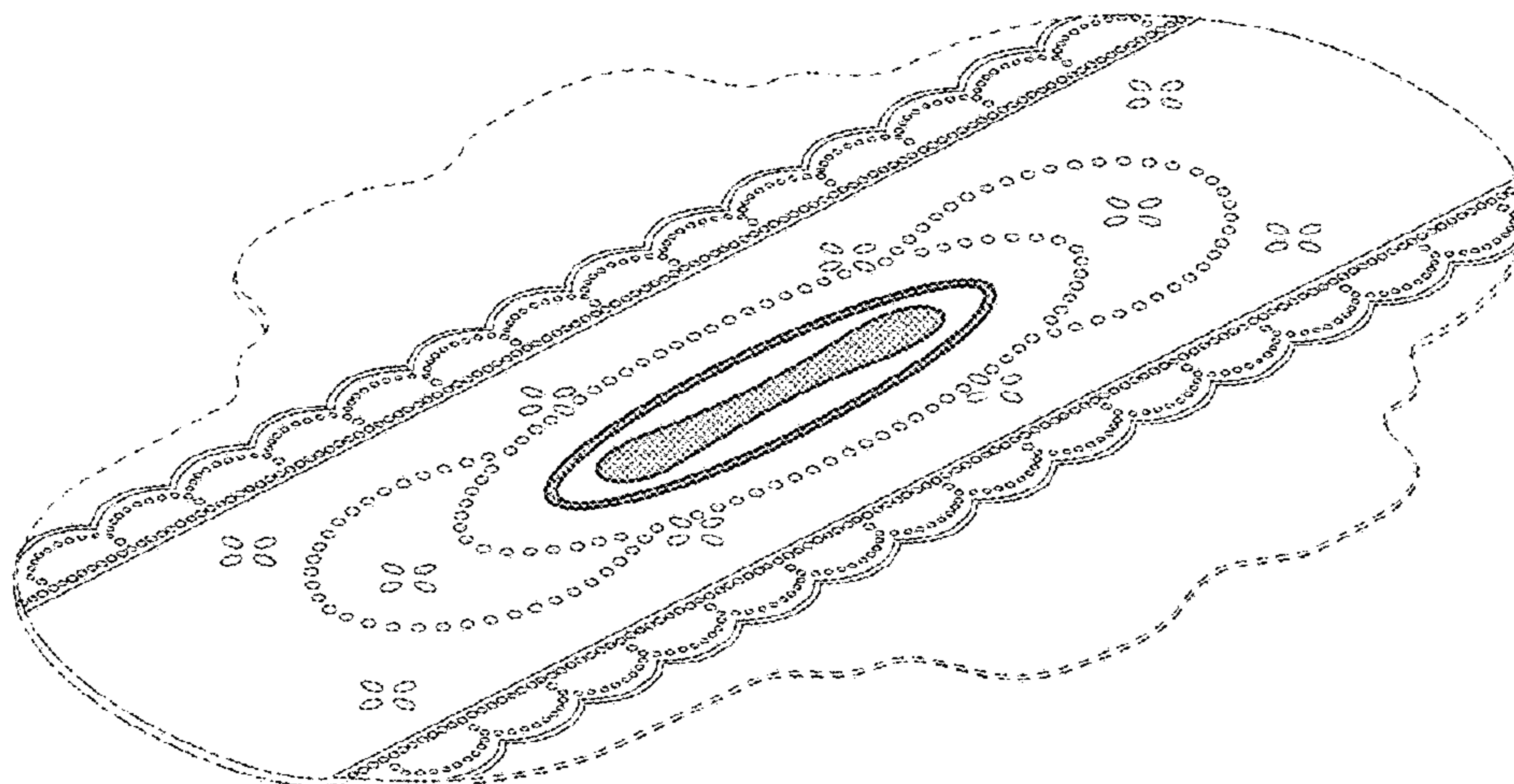
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a sanitary napkin, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a second front elevation view thereof.
The dash-dash broken lines, depicting sanitary napkin wings, side and rear edges and an absorbent core, represent unclaimed portions of the sanitary napkin.
The dot-dash broken lines represent a boundary to the claimed surfaces of the sanitary napkin and forms no part of the claimed design.

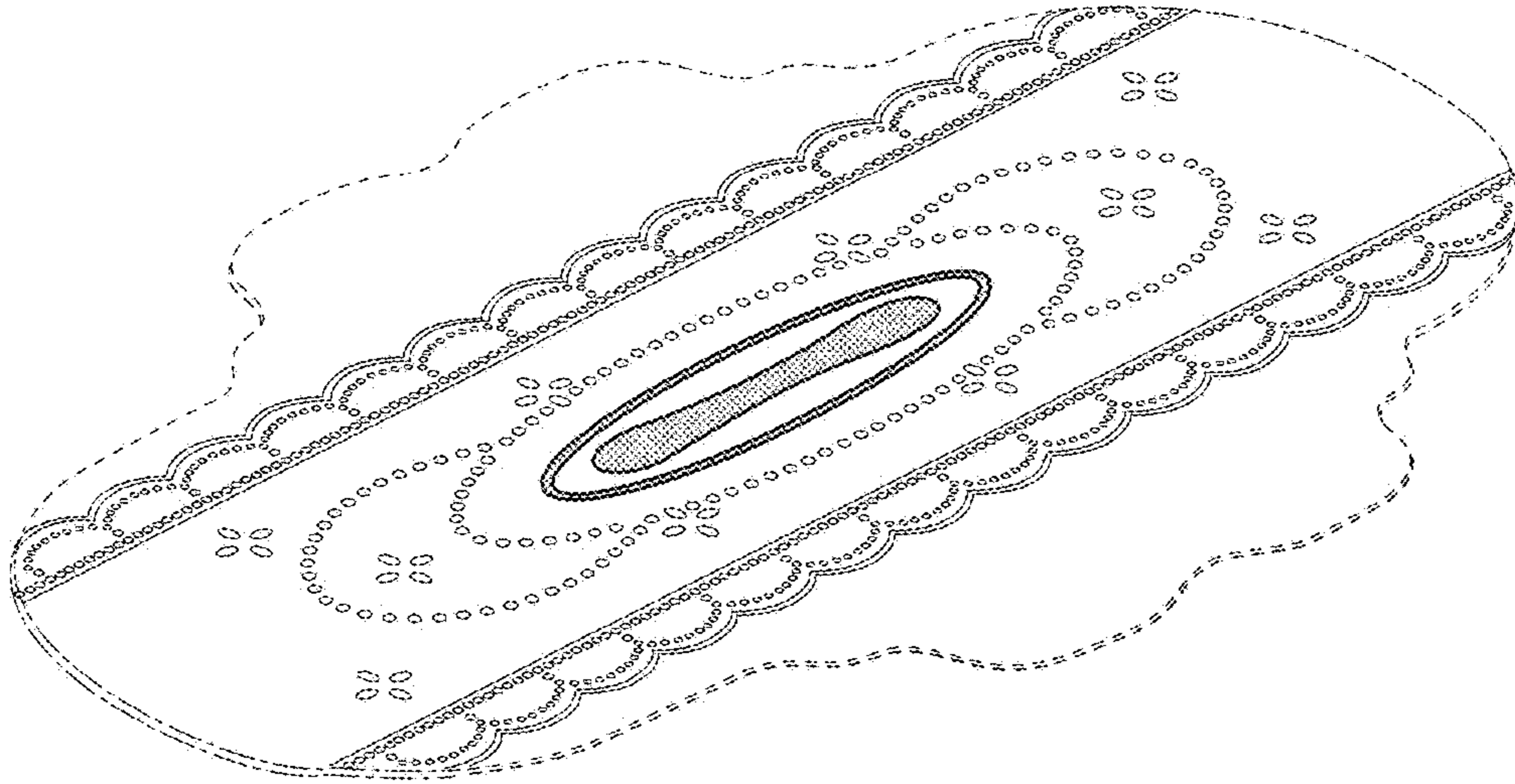

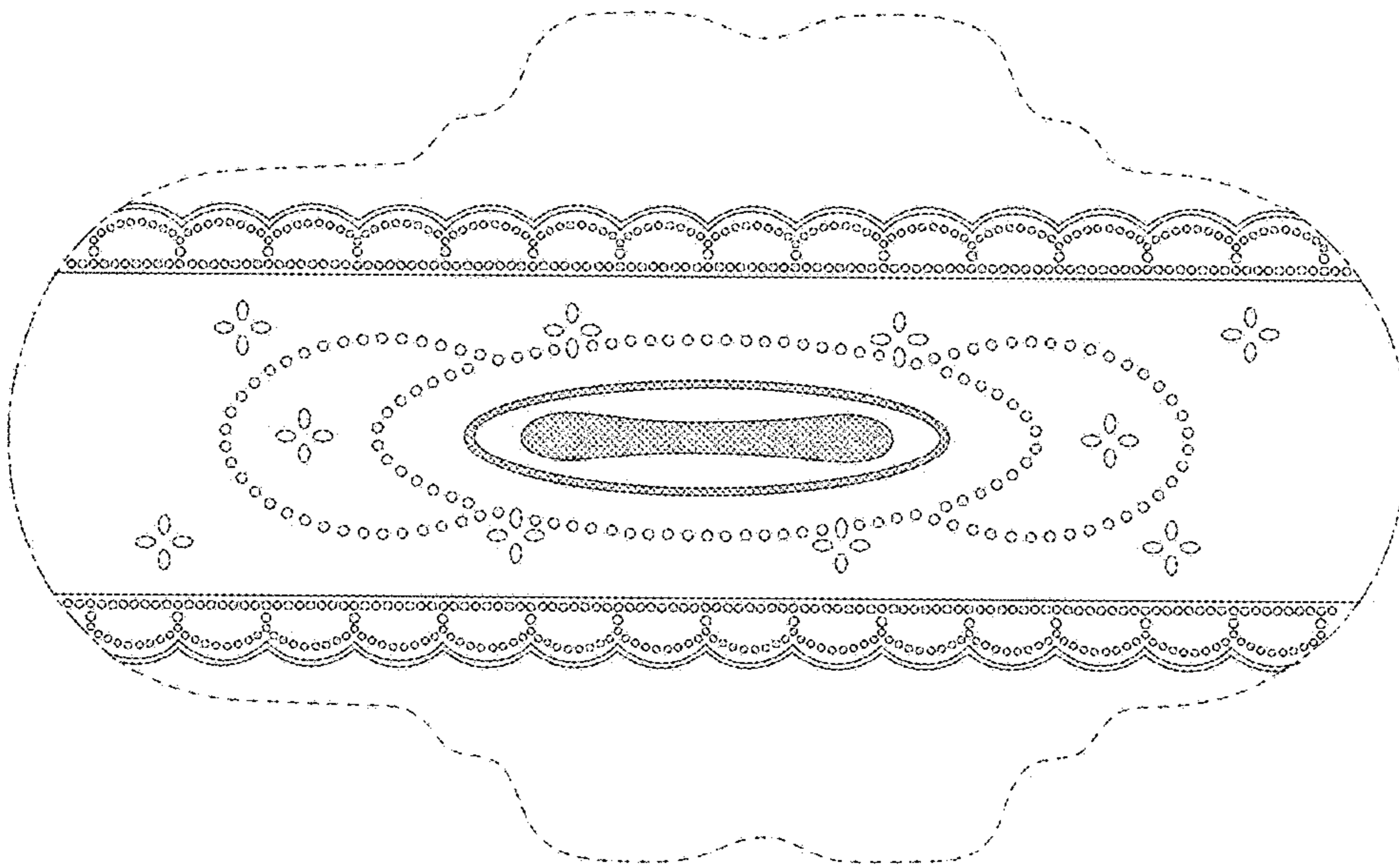

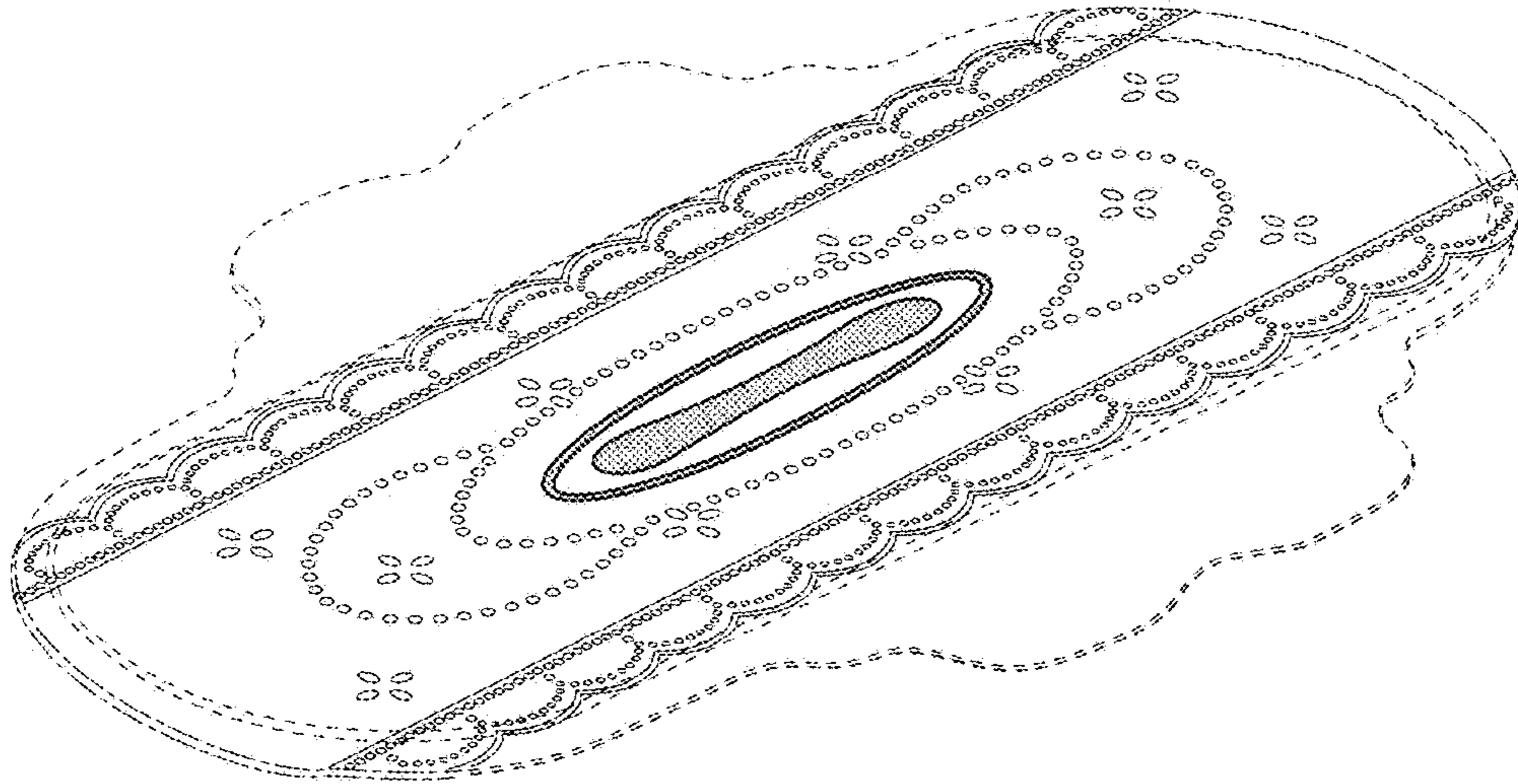

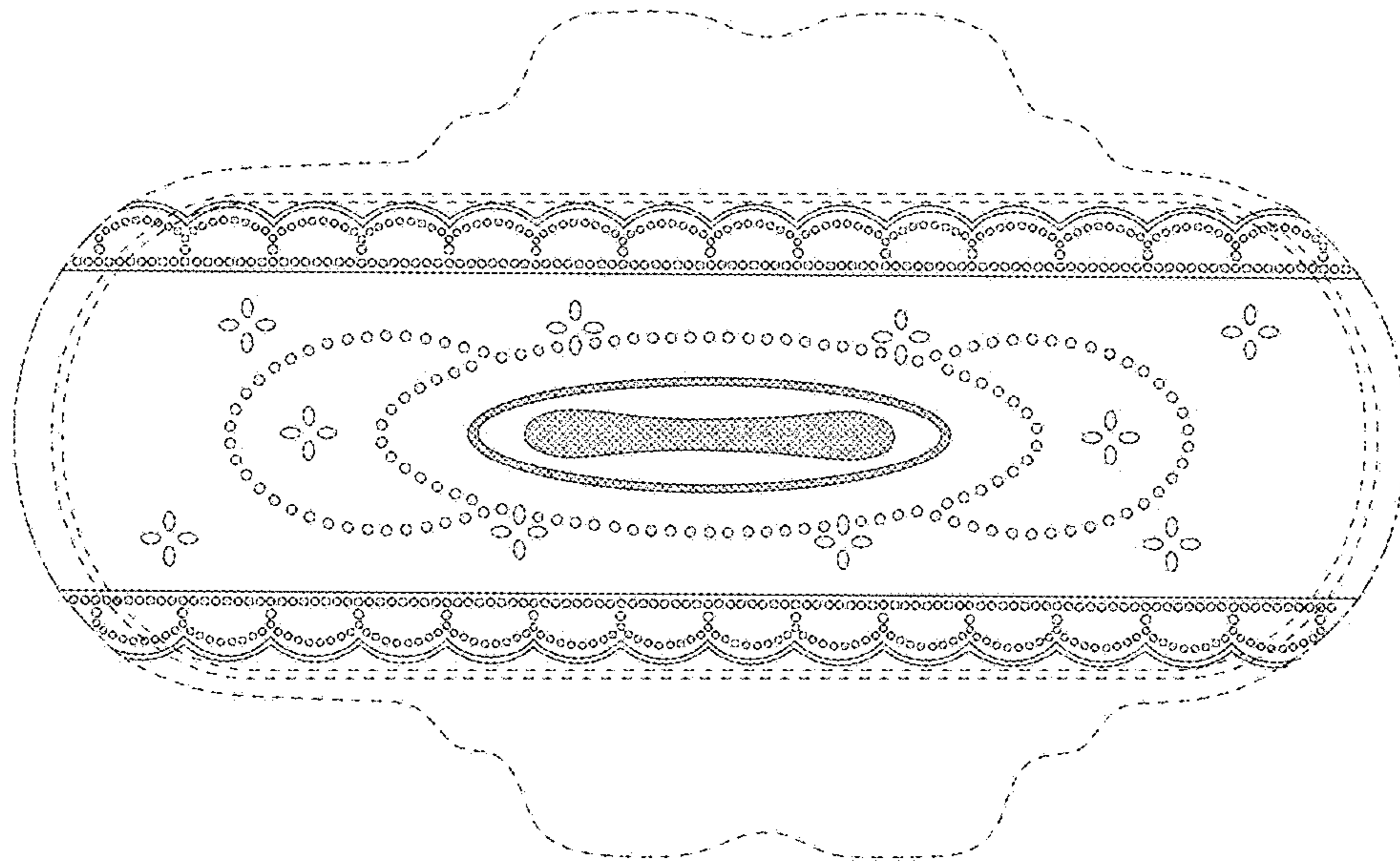
