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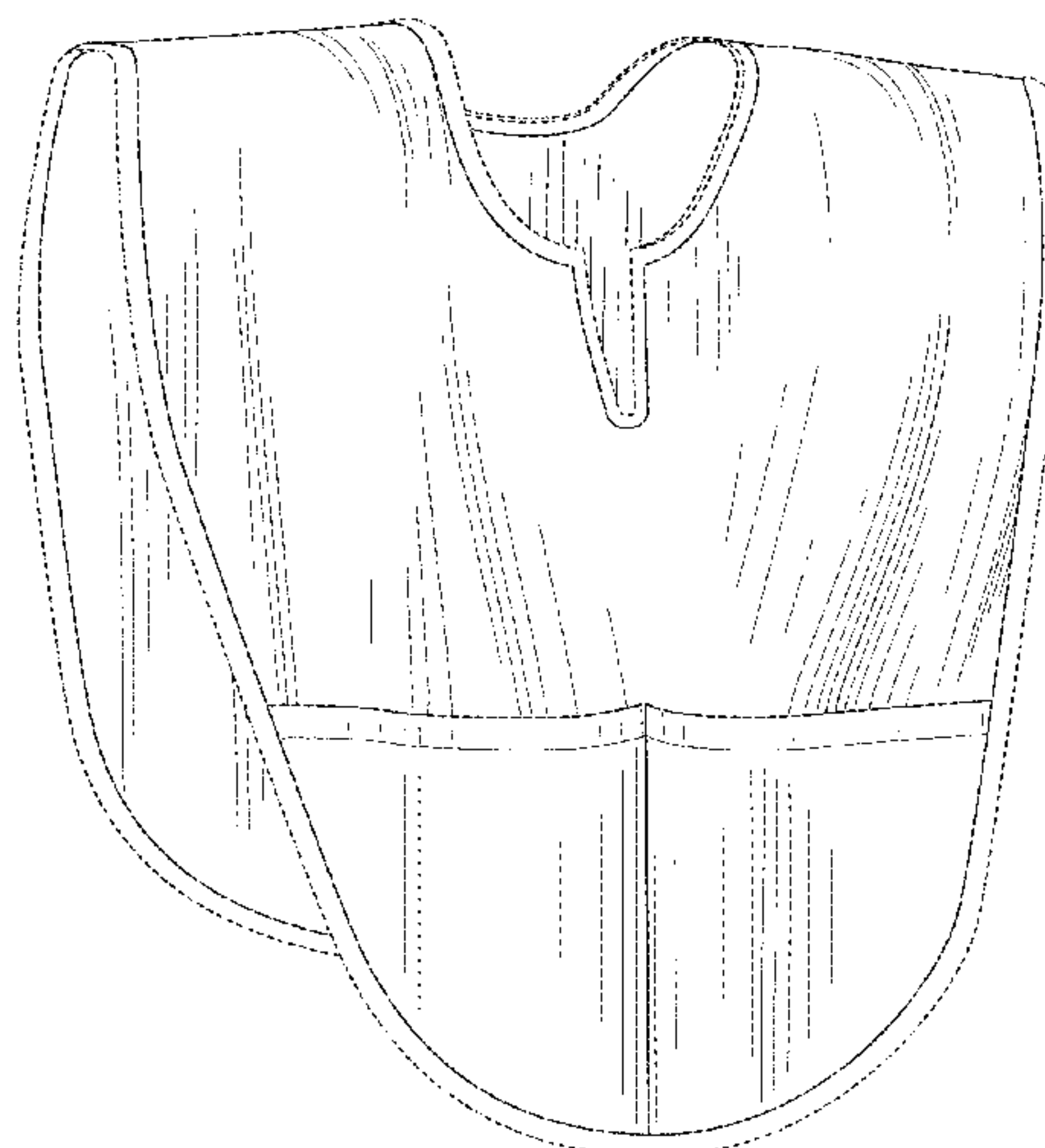
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a protective bib, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a protective bib showing the design according to a first embodiment;
FIG. 2 is a front plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear plan view thereof, which opposes the view in FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a first side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a second side view thereof, which opposes the view in FIG. 4;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof, which opposes the view in FIG. 6;
FIG. 8 is a front perspective view thereof as it appears when worn by an adult;
FIG. 9 is a rear perspective view thereof as it appears when worn by an adult;
FIG. 10 is a front perspective view of a protective bib showing the design according to a second embodiment;
FIG. 11 is a front plan view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a rear plan view thereof, which opposes the view in FIG. 11;
FIG. 13 is a first side view thereof;
FIG. 14 is a second side view thereof, which opposes the view in FIG. 13;
FIG. 15 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 16 is a bottom view thereof, which opposes the view in FIG. 15;
FIG. 17 is a front perspective view thereof as it appears when worn by an adult; and,
FIG. 18 is a rear perspective view thereof as it appears when worn by an adult.

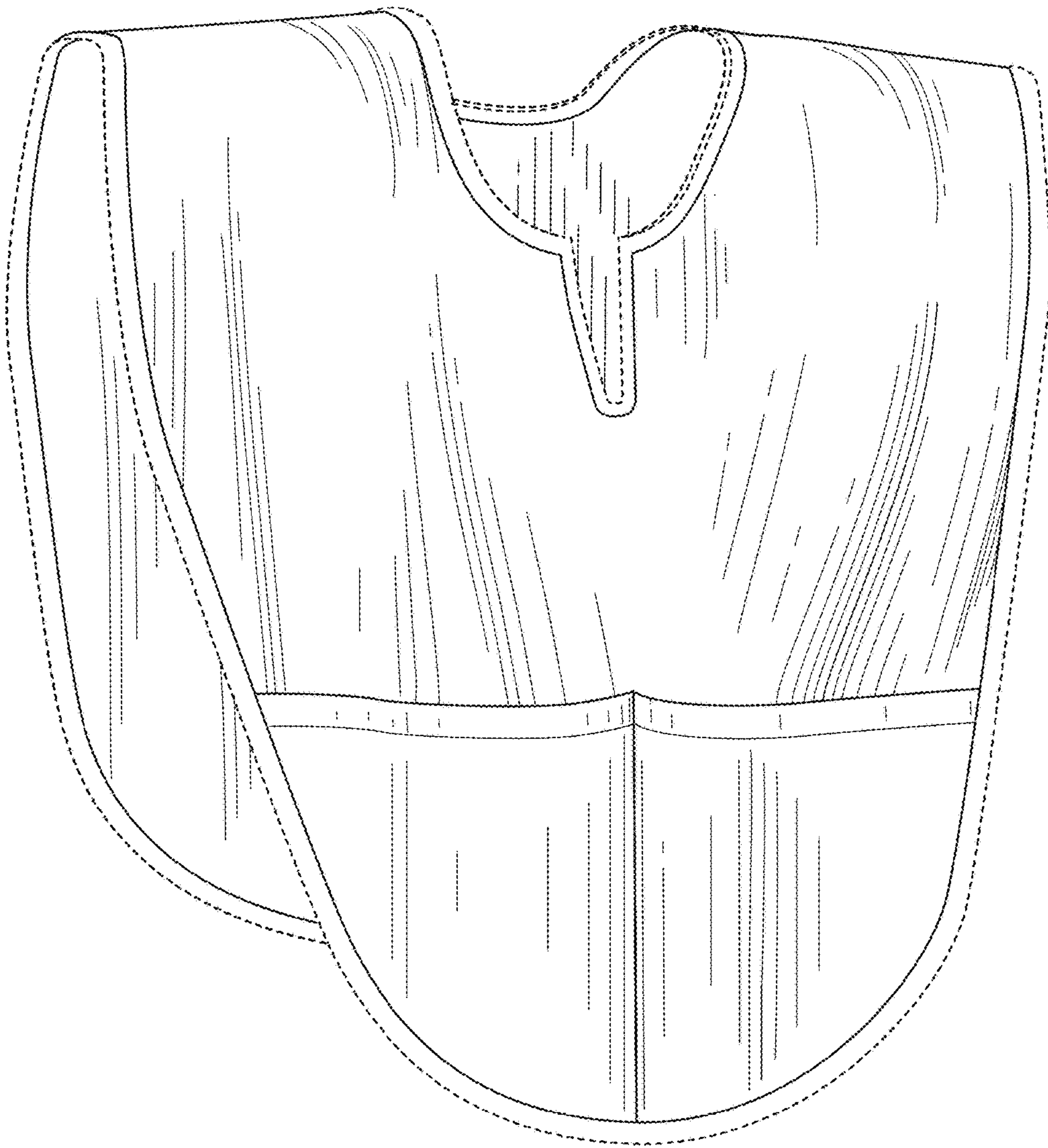

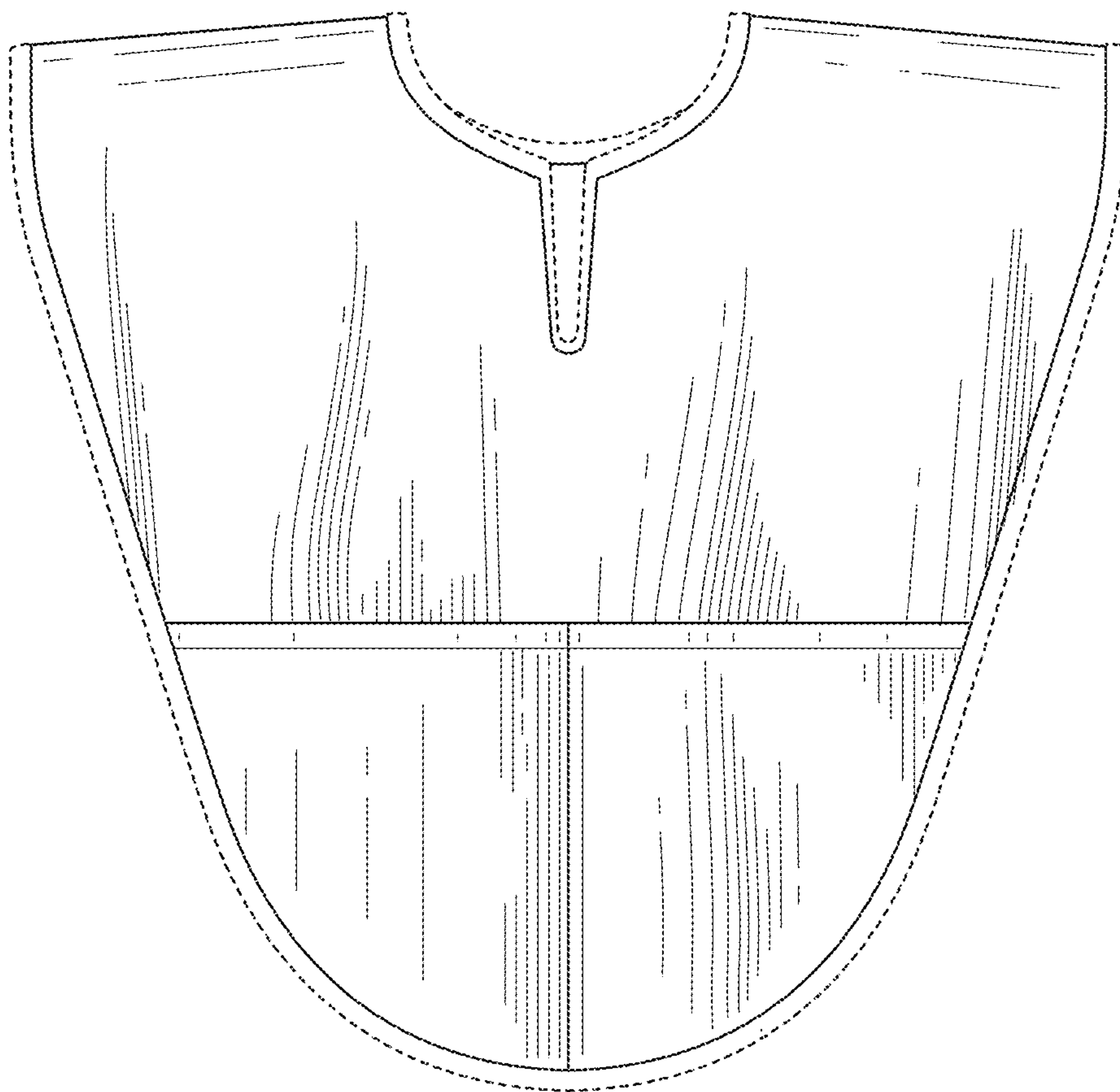

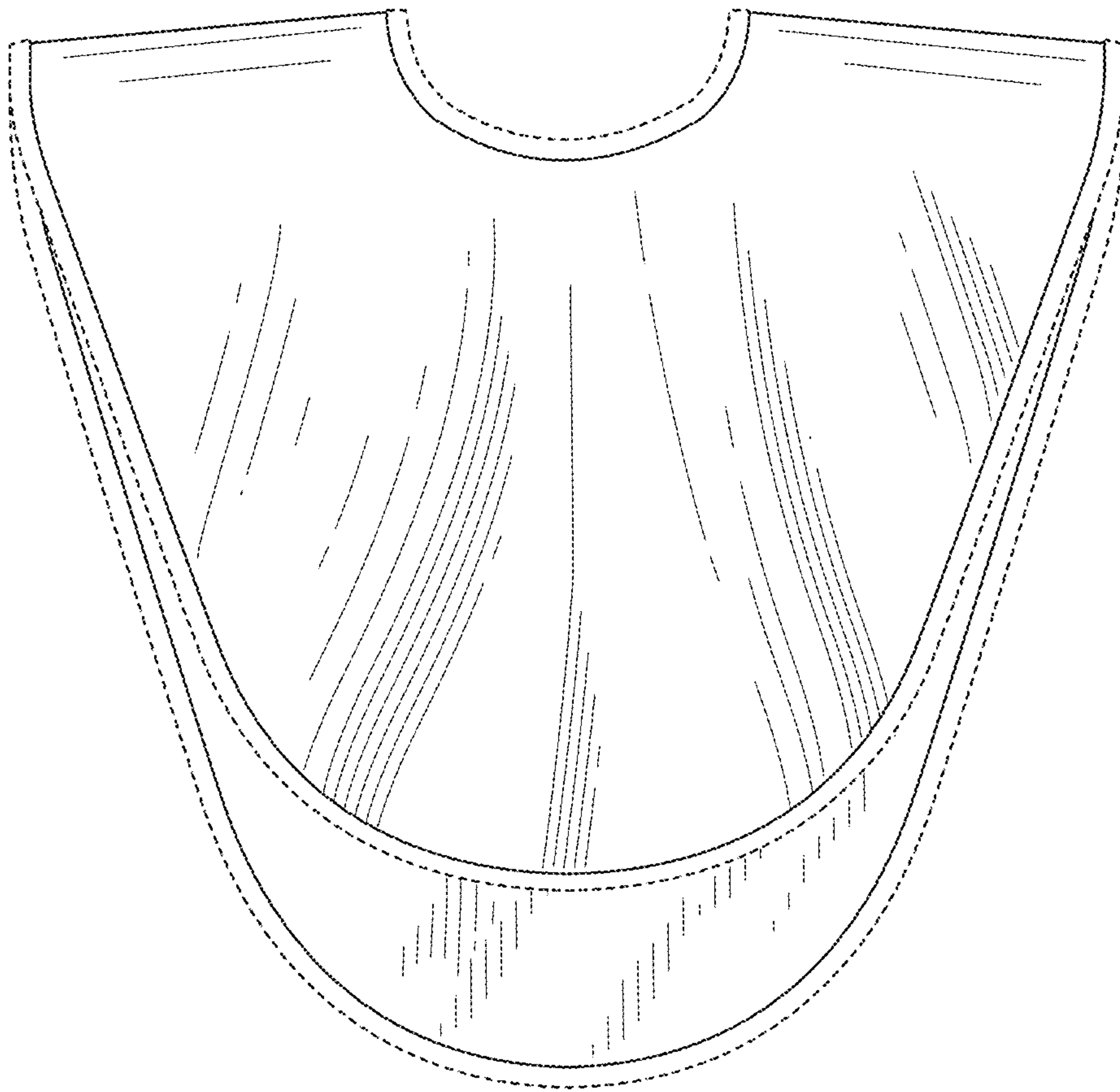

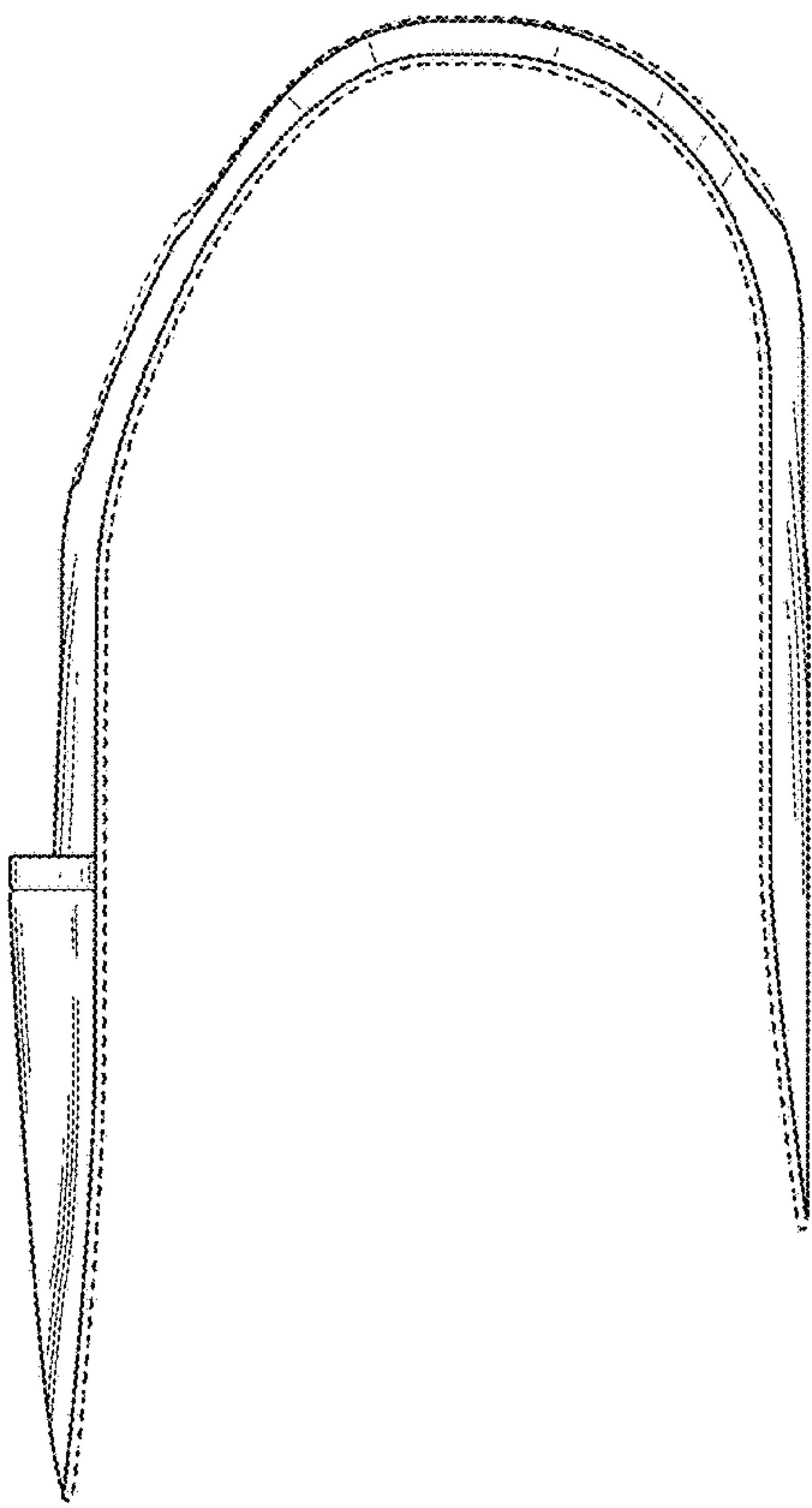

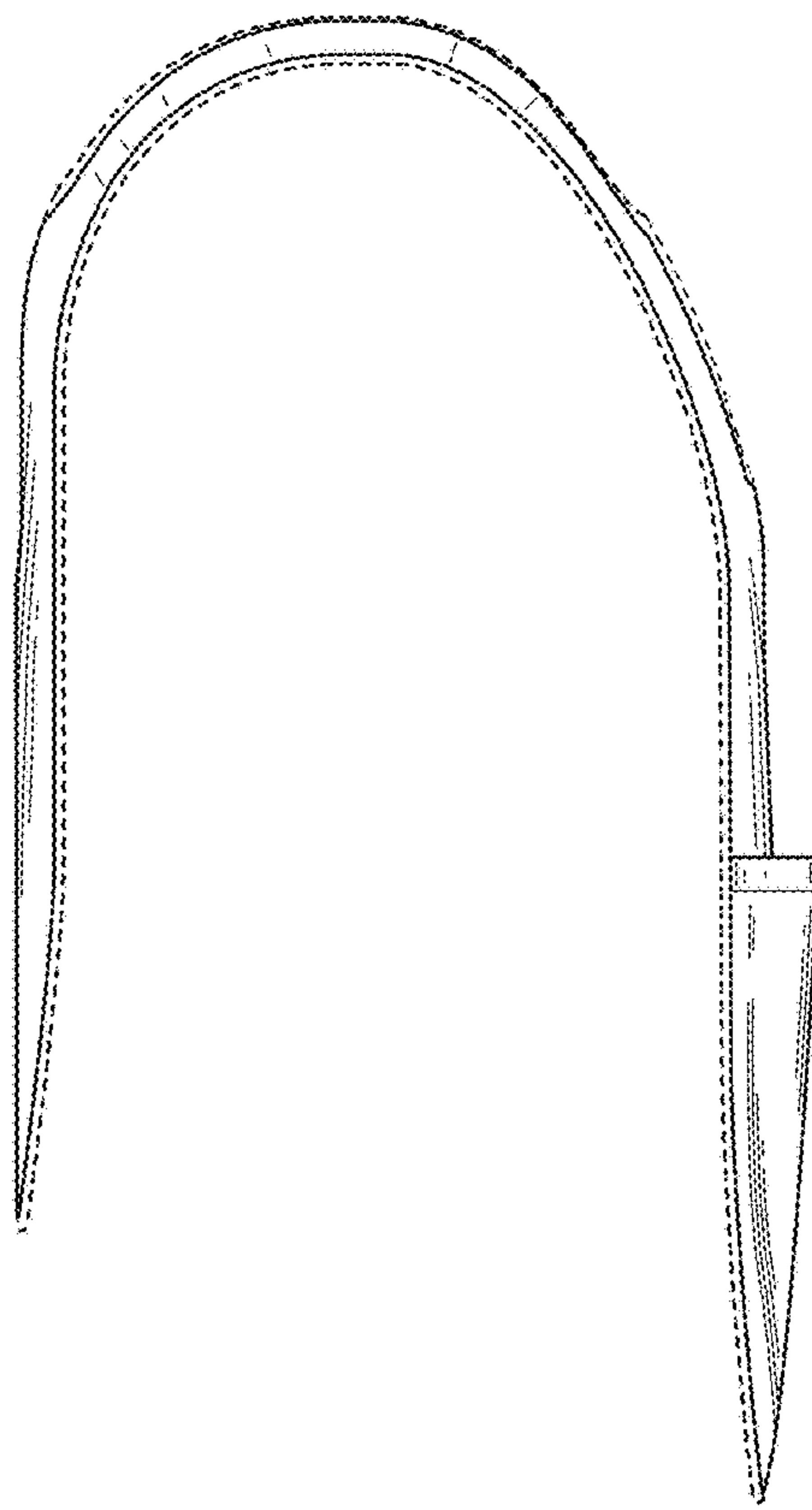

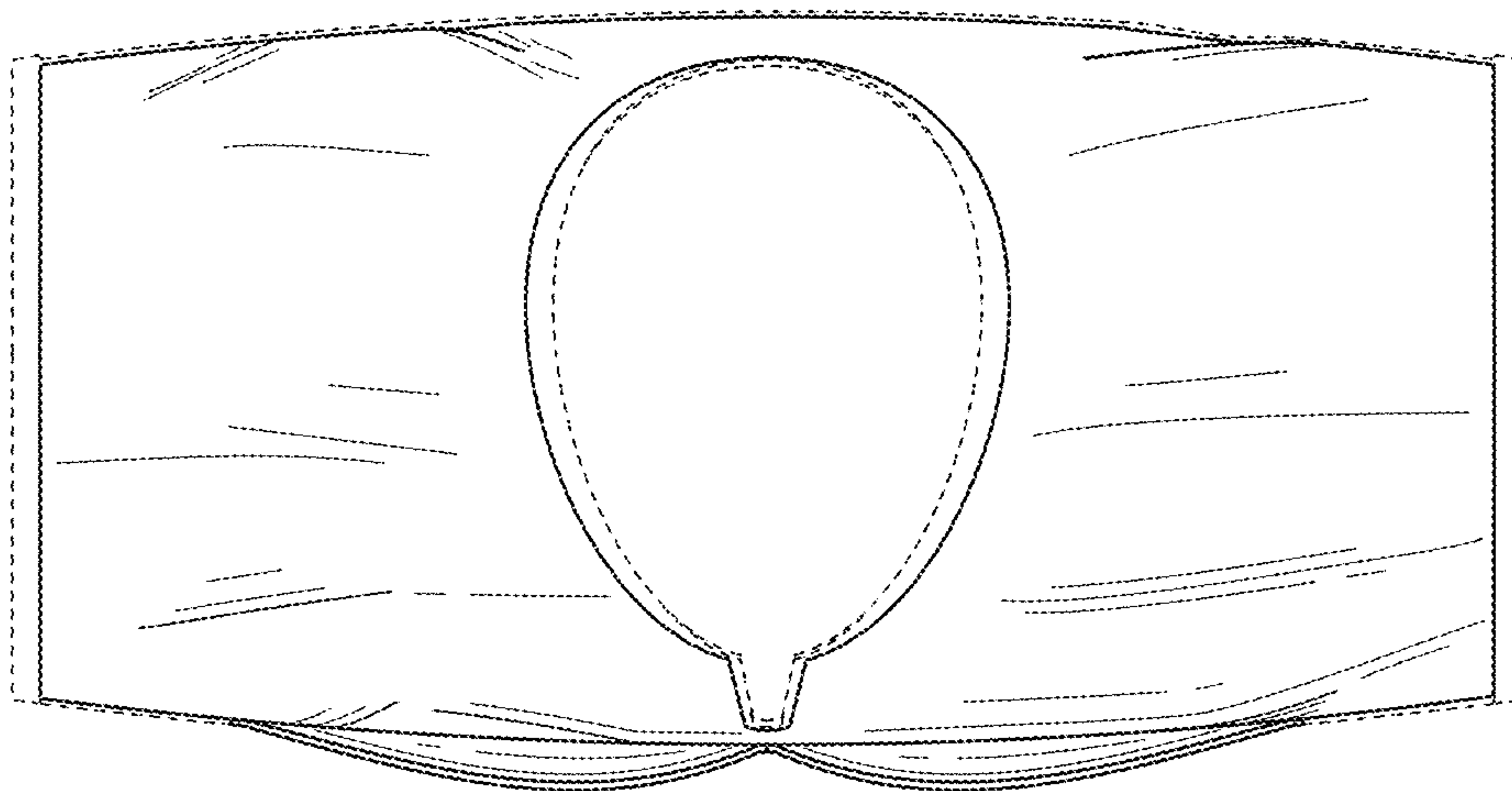

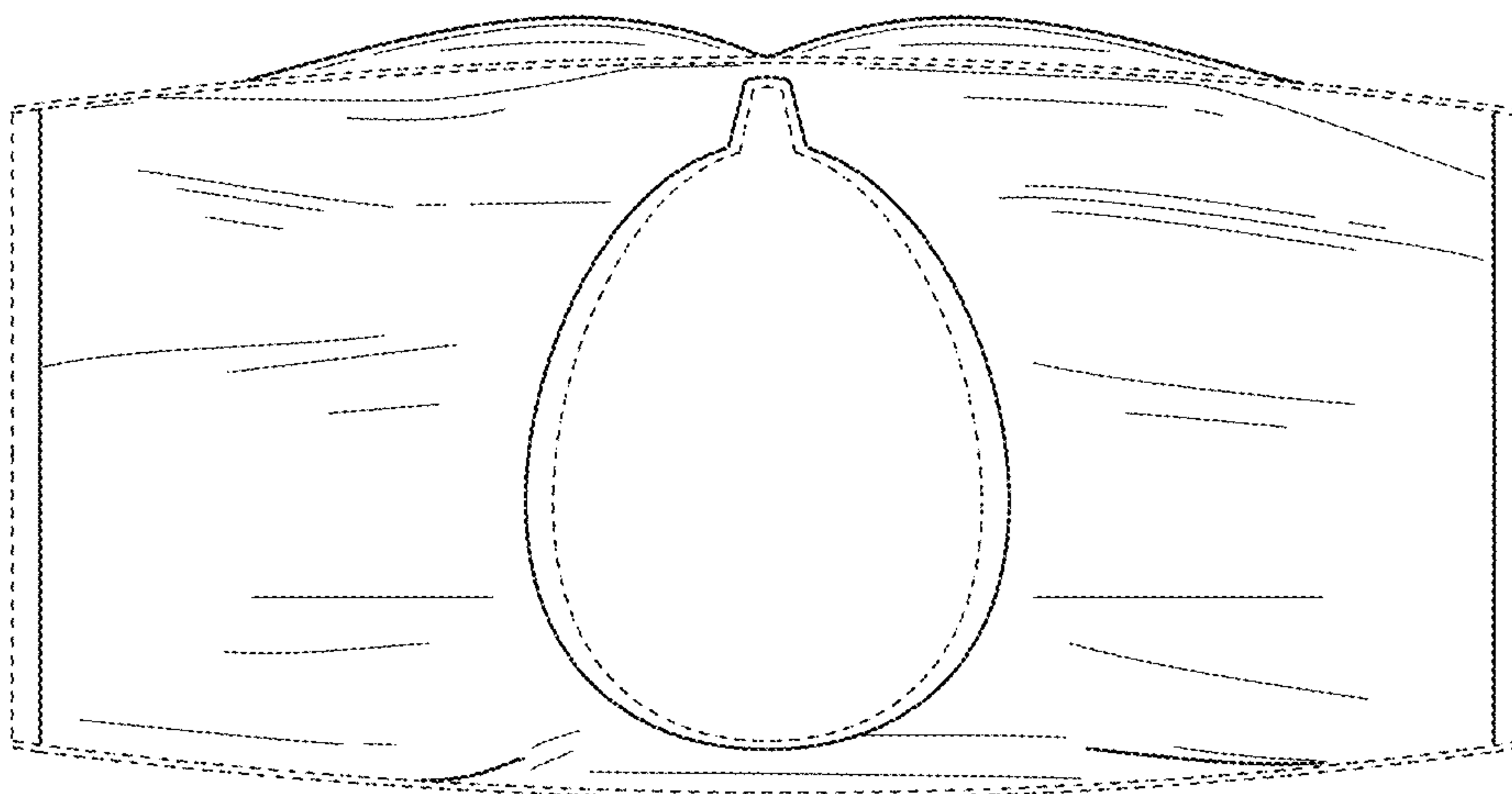

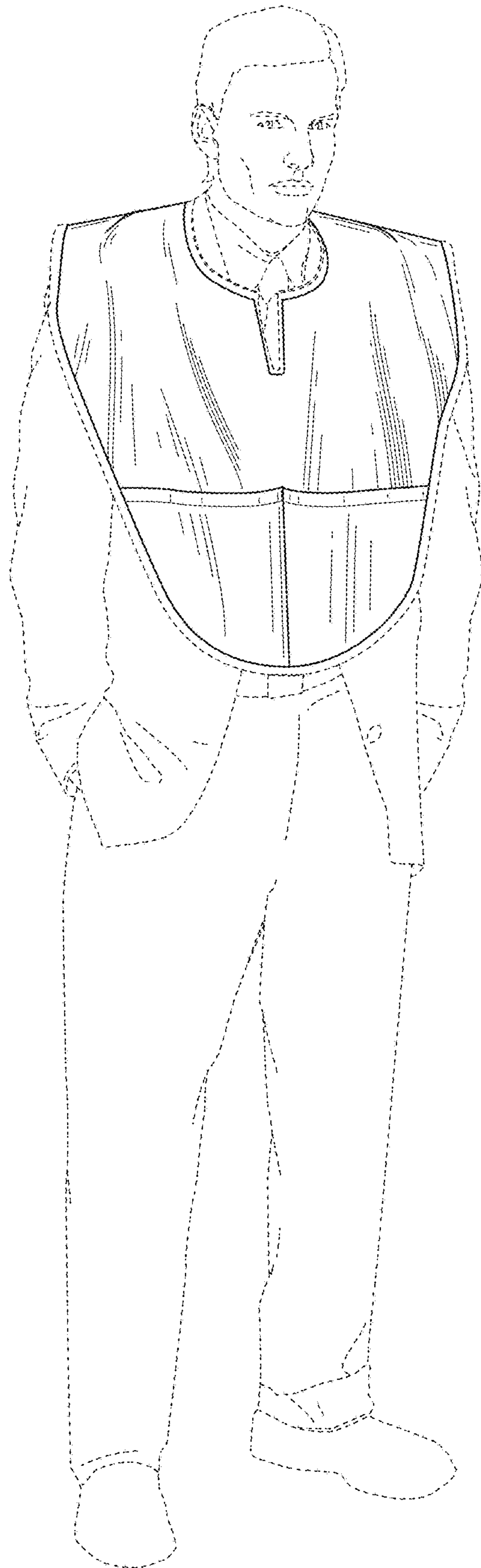

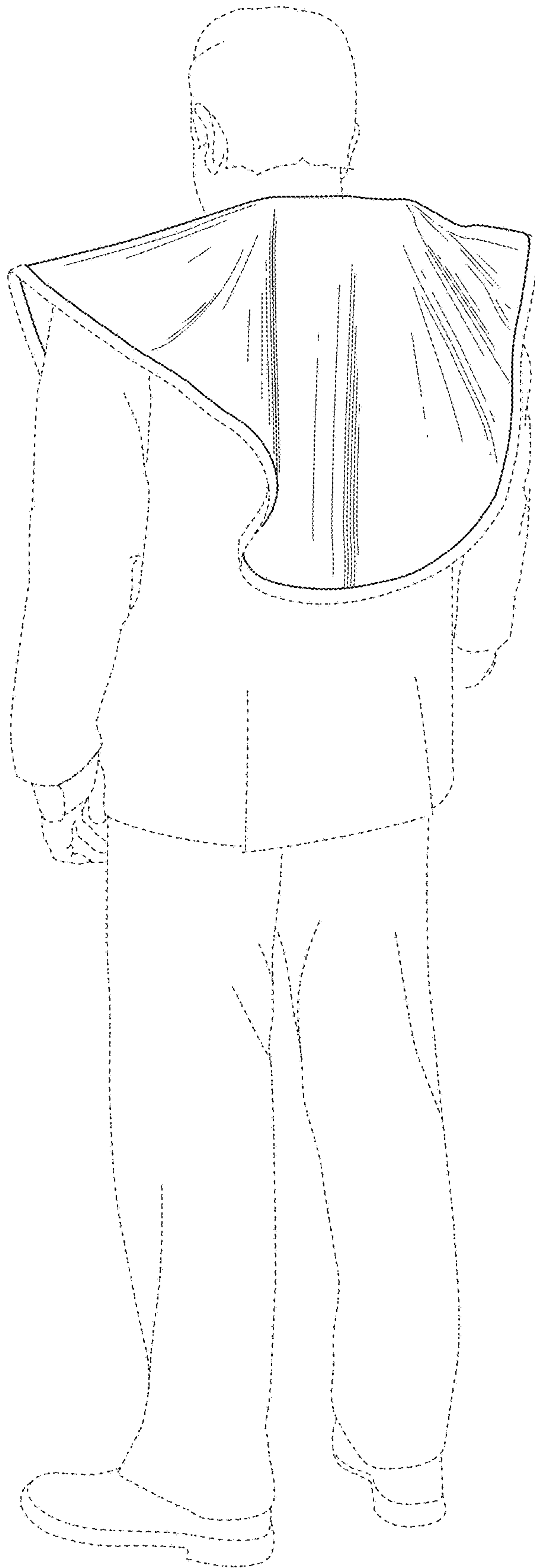

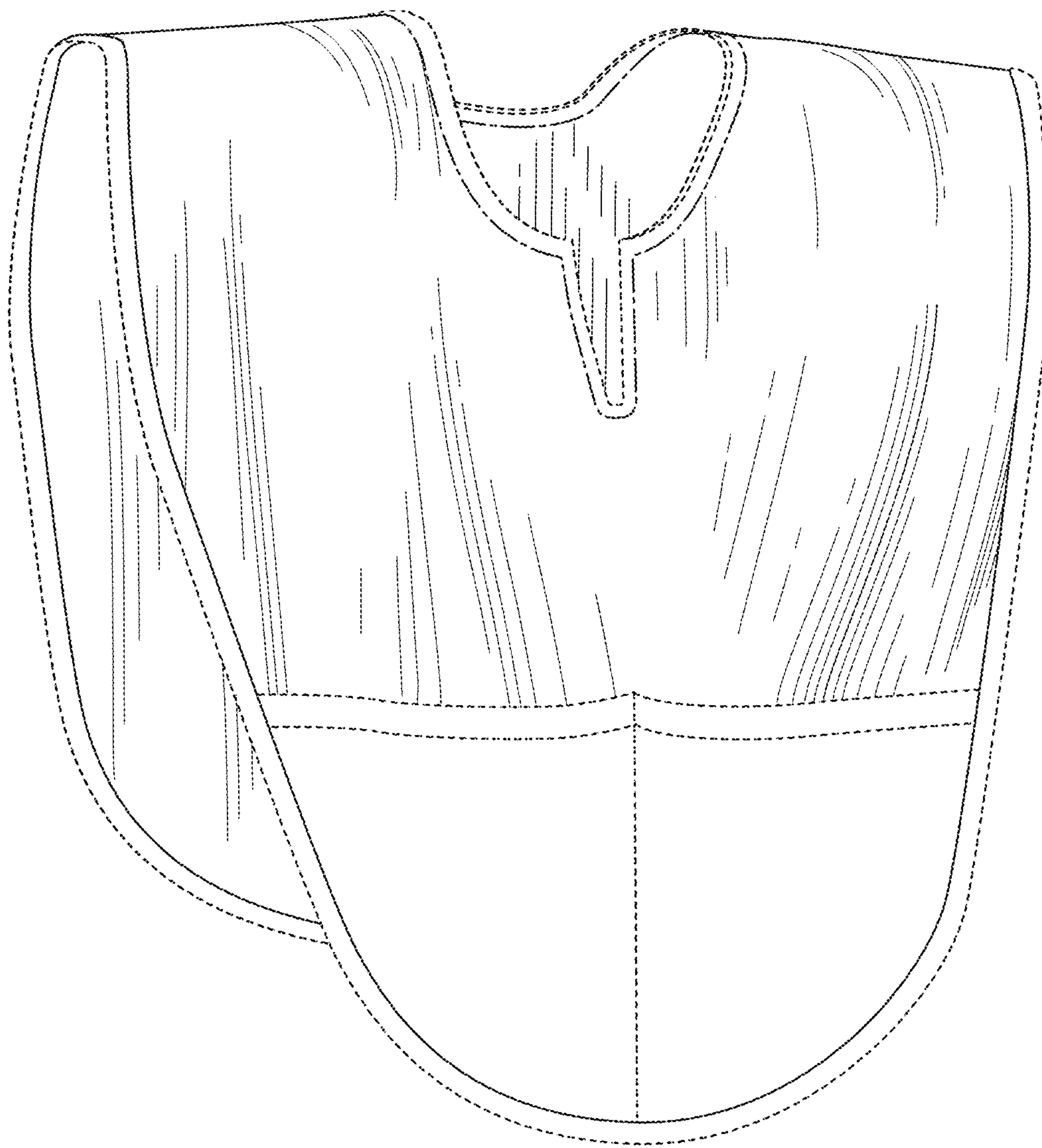

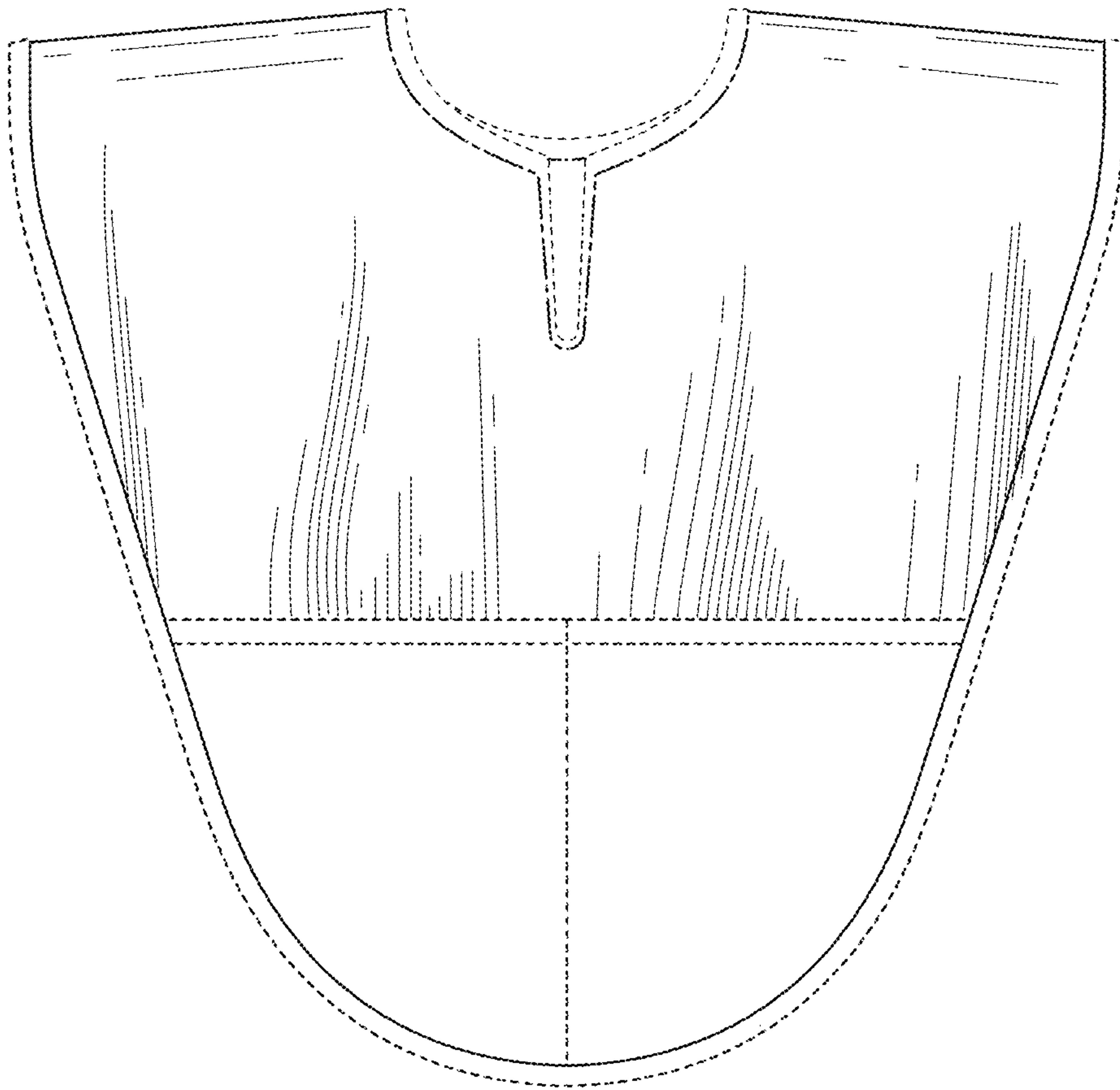

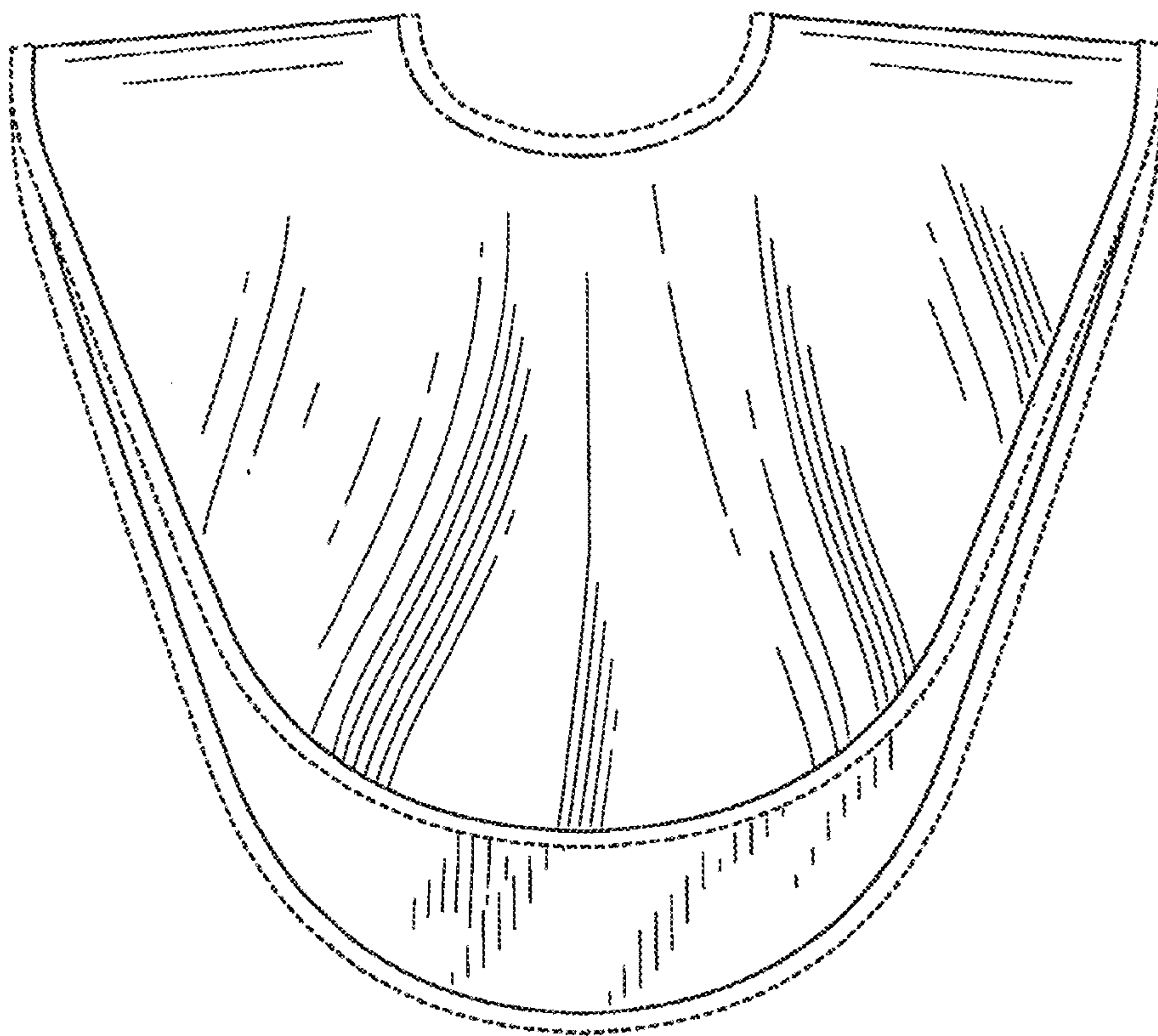

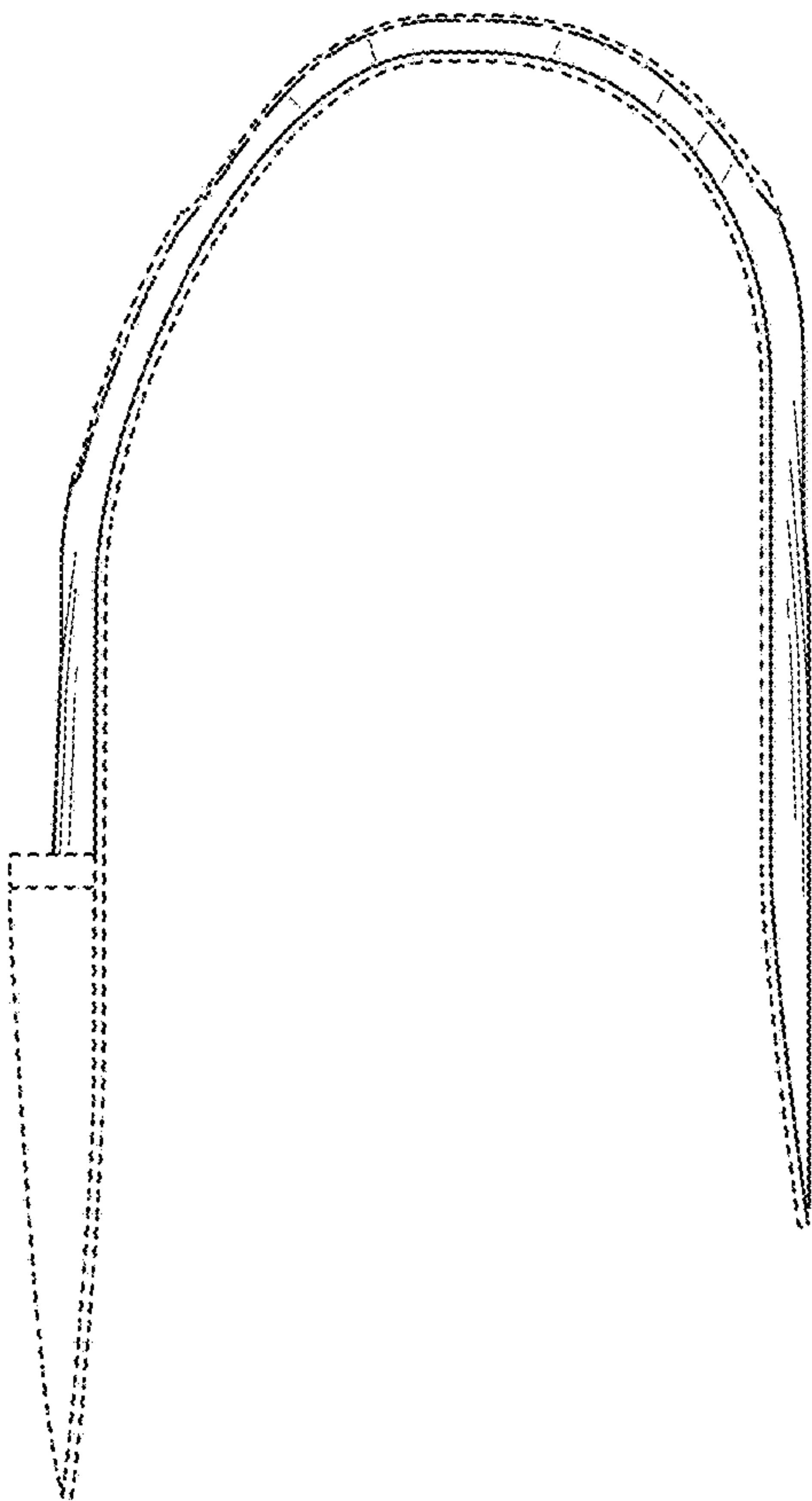

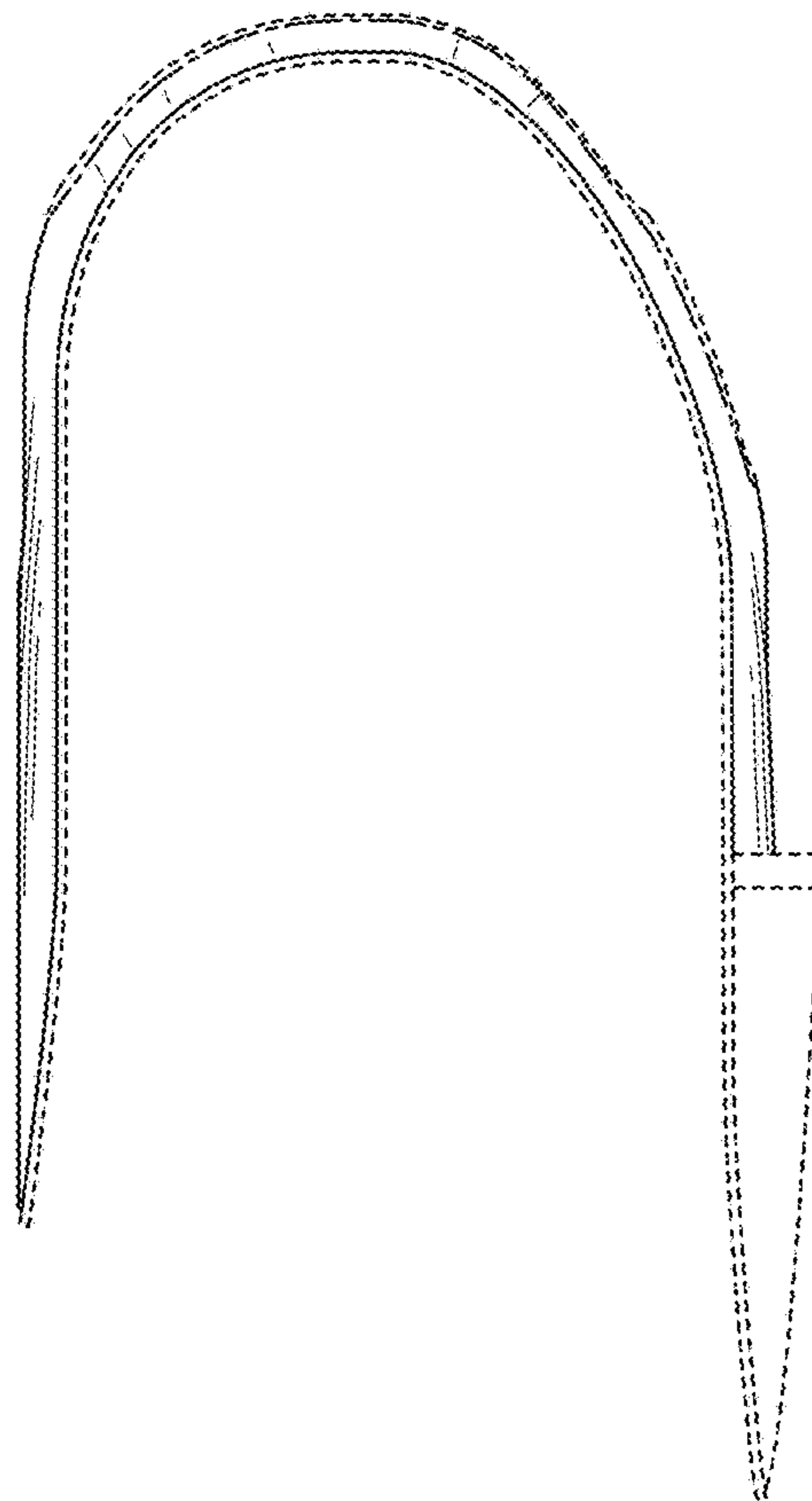

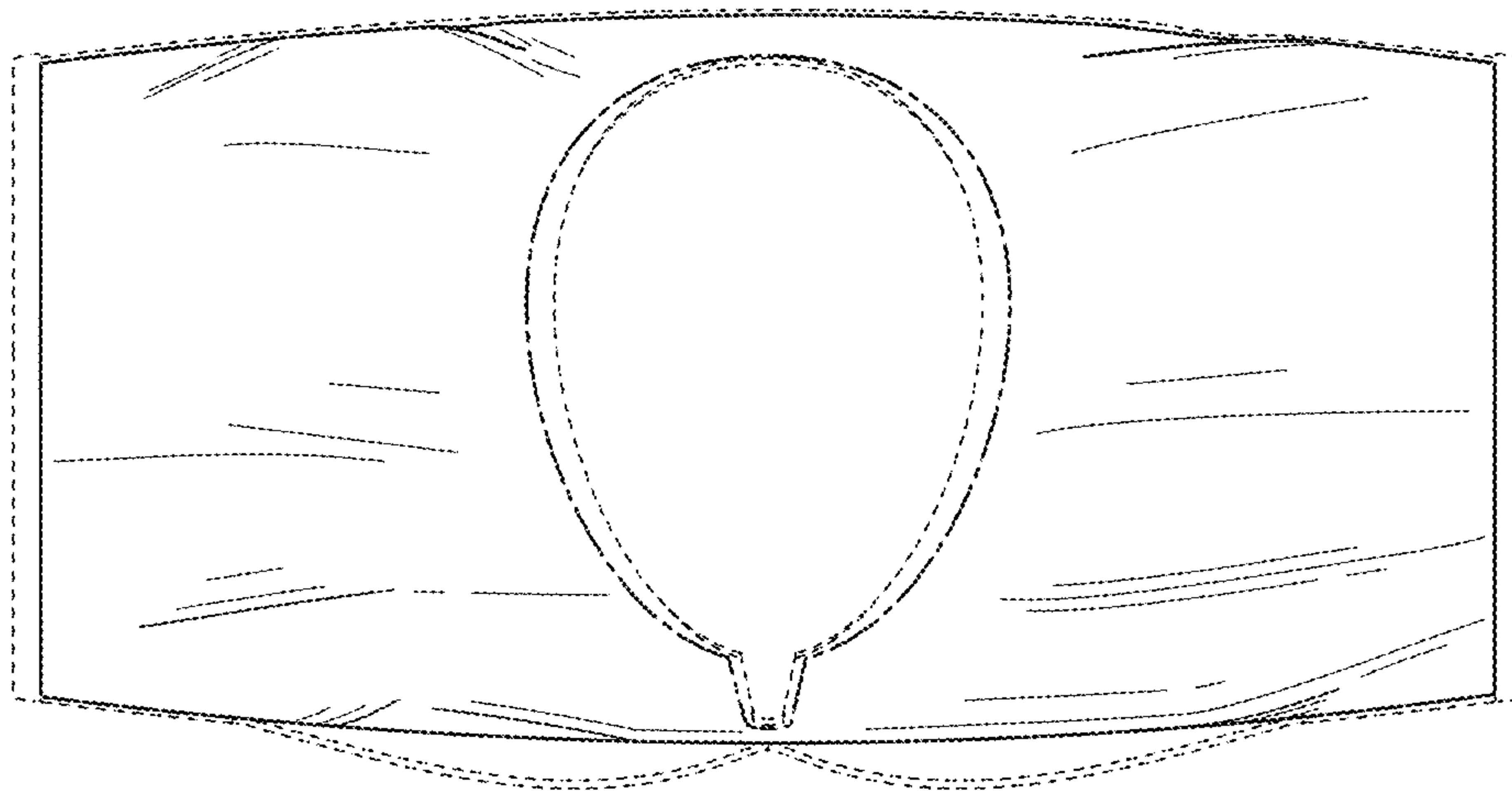

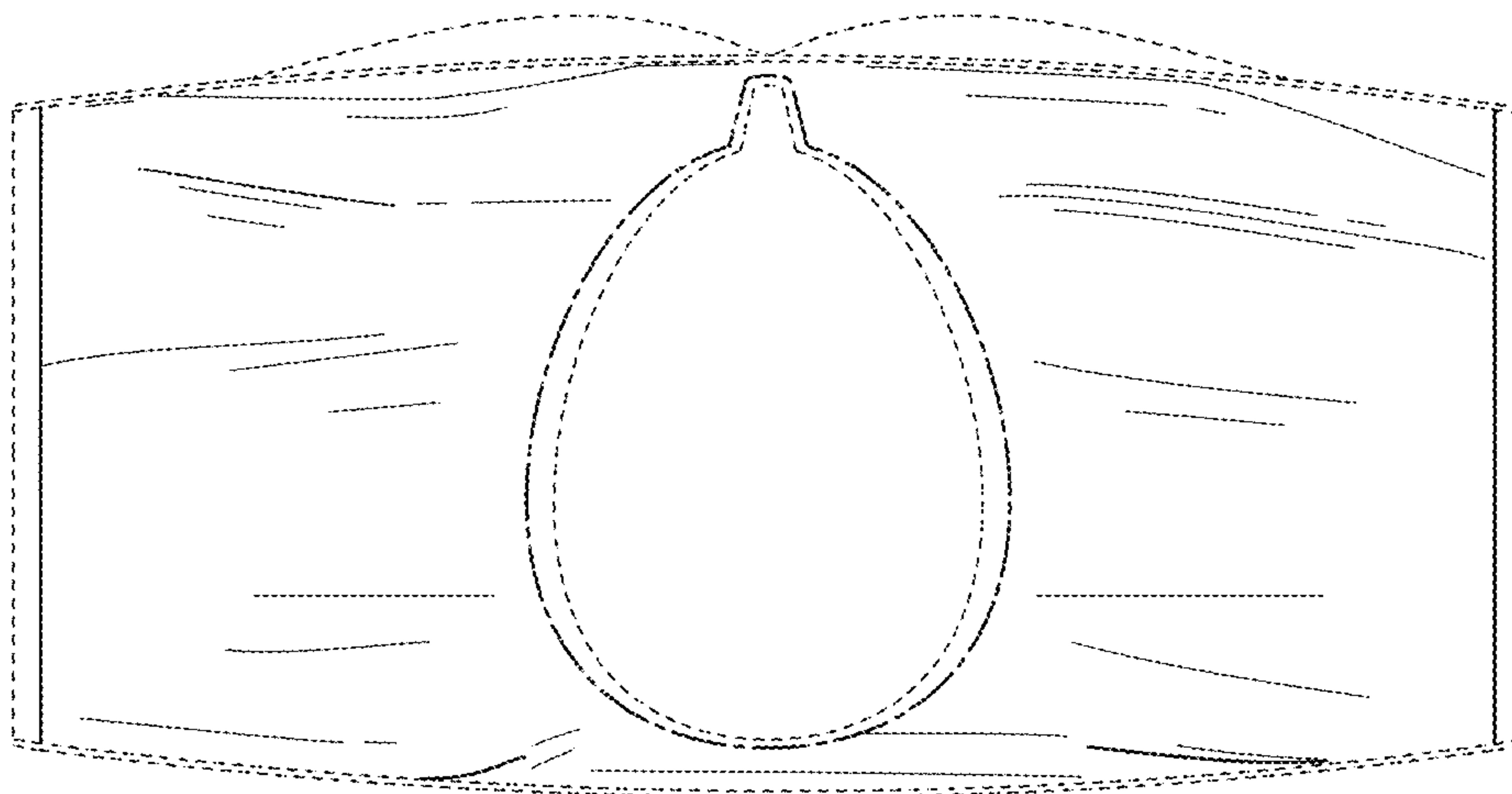

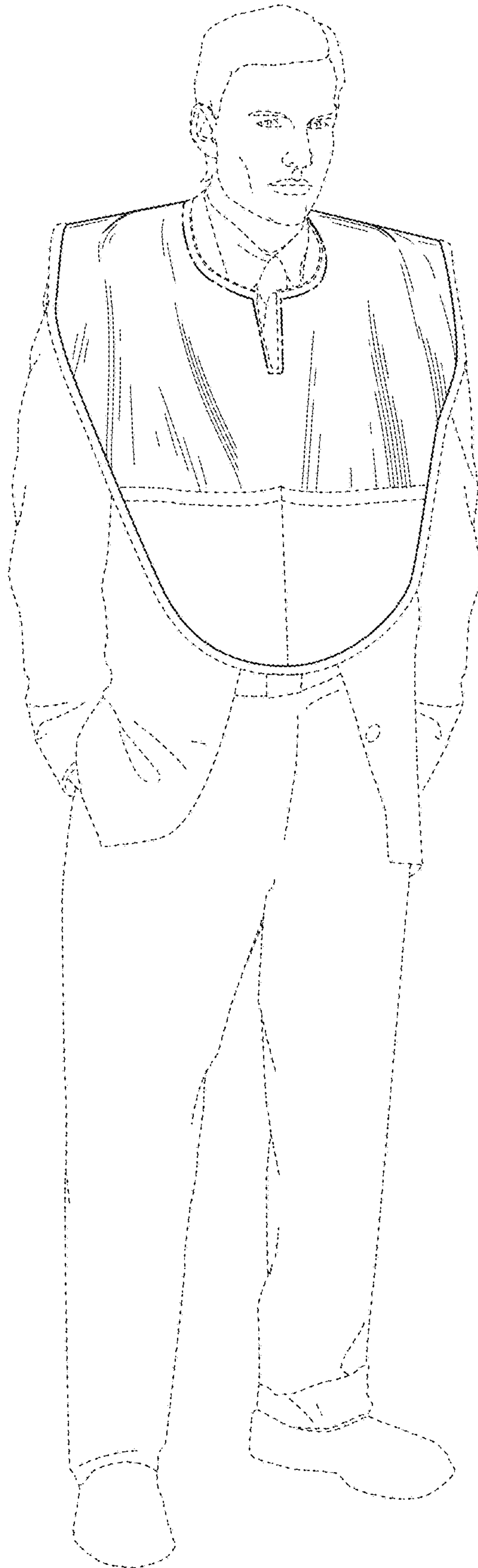

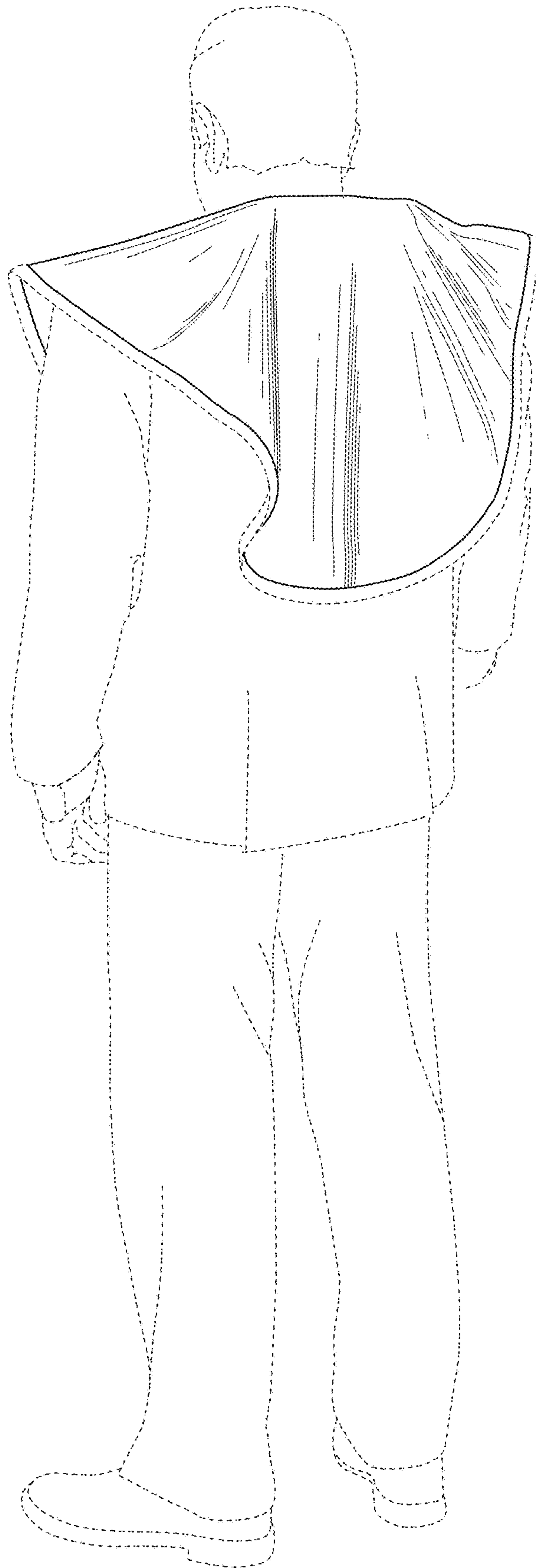
