DESCRIPTION

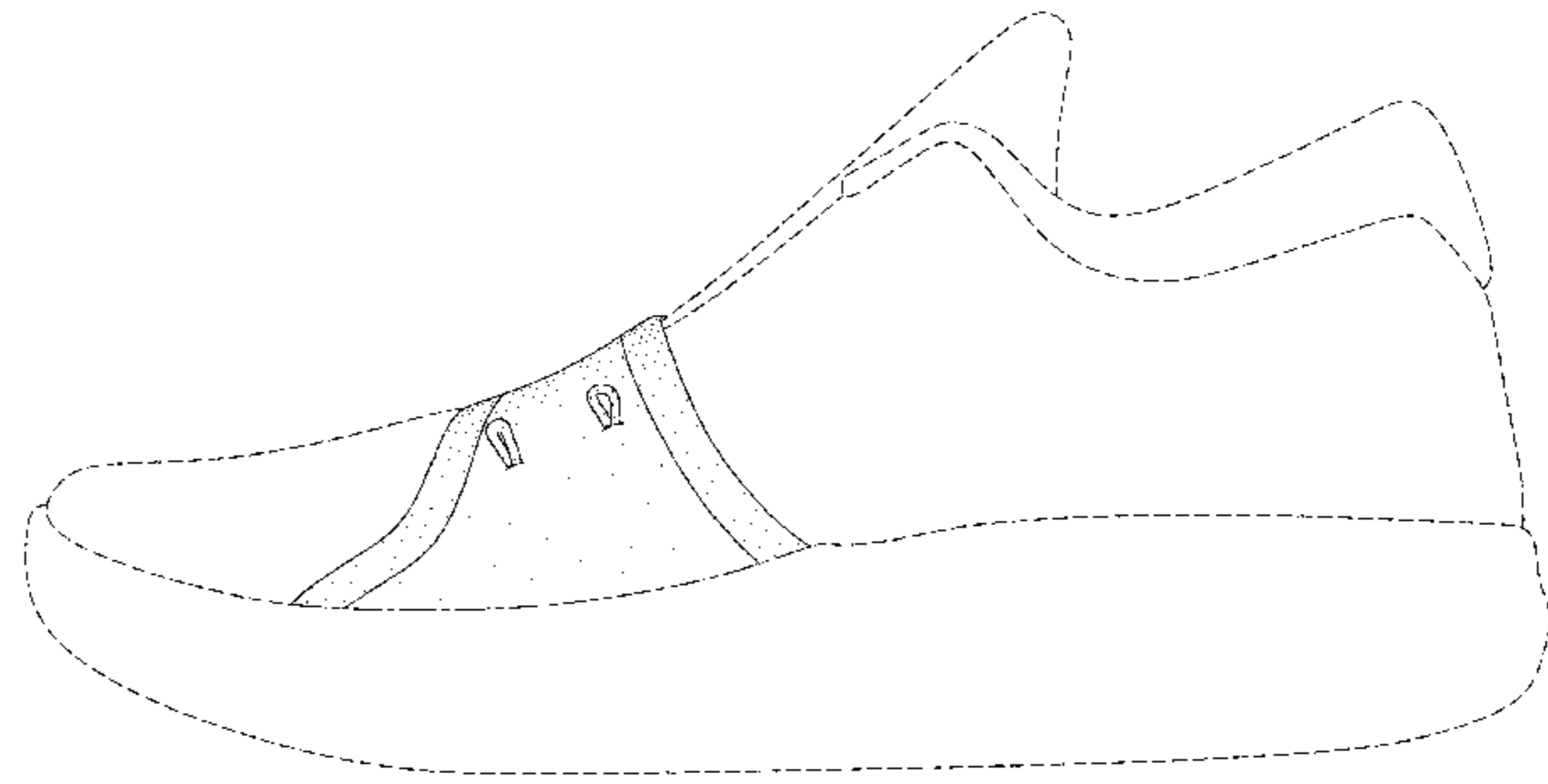
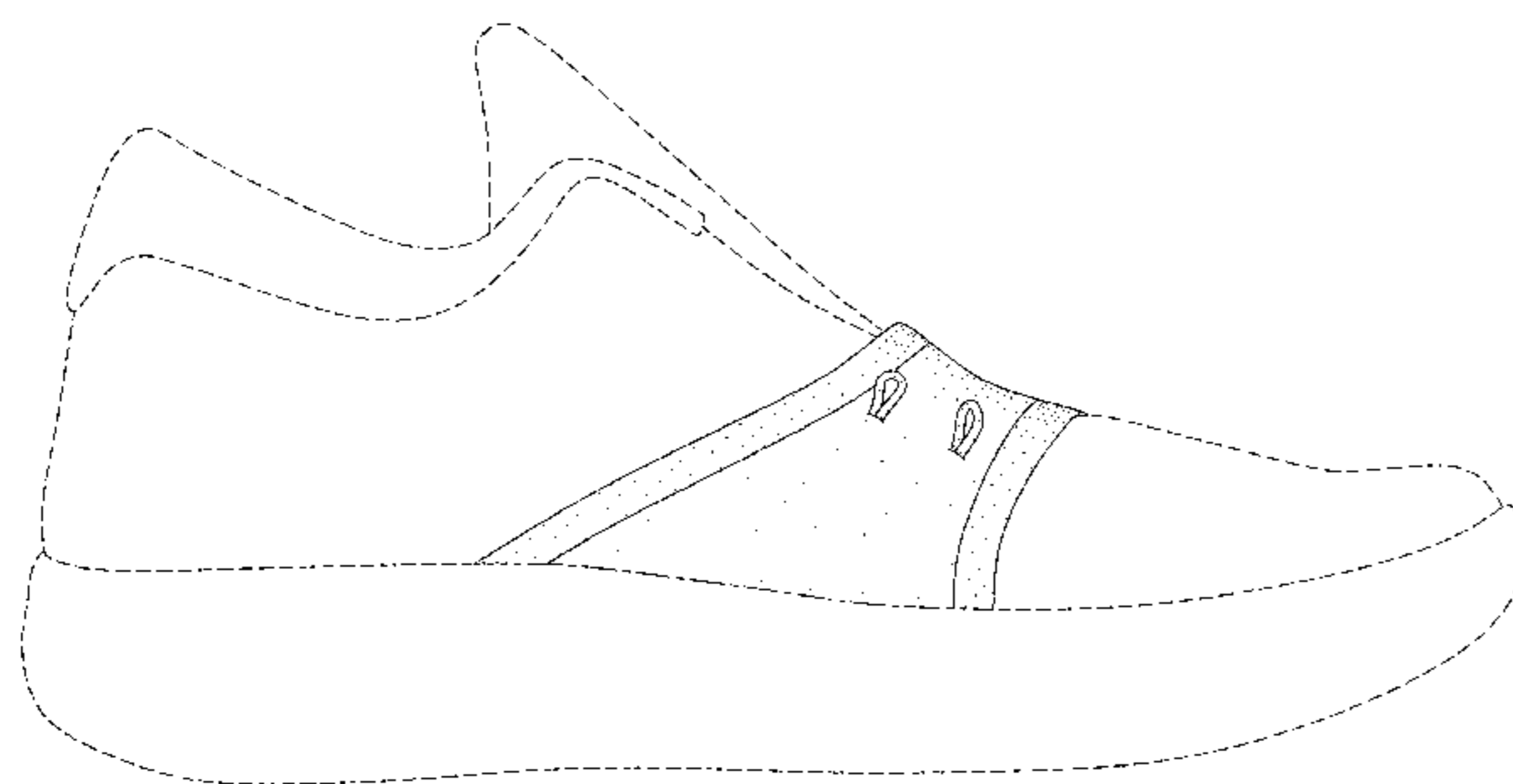
FIG. 1 is the first front perspective view of the shoe upper showing my new design;

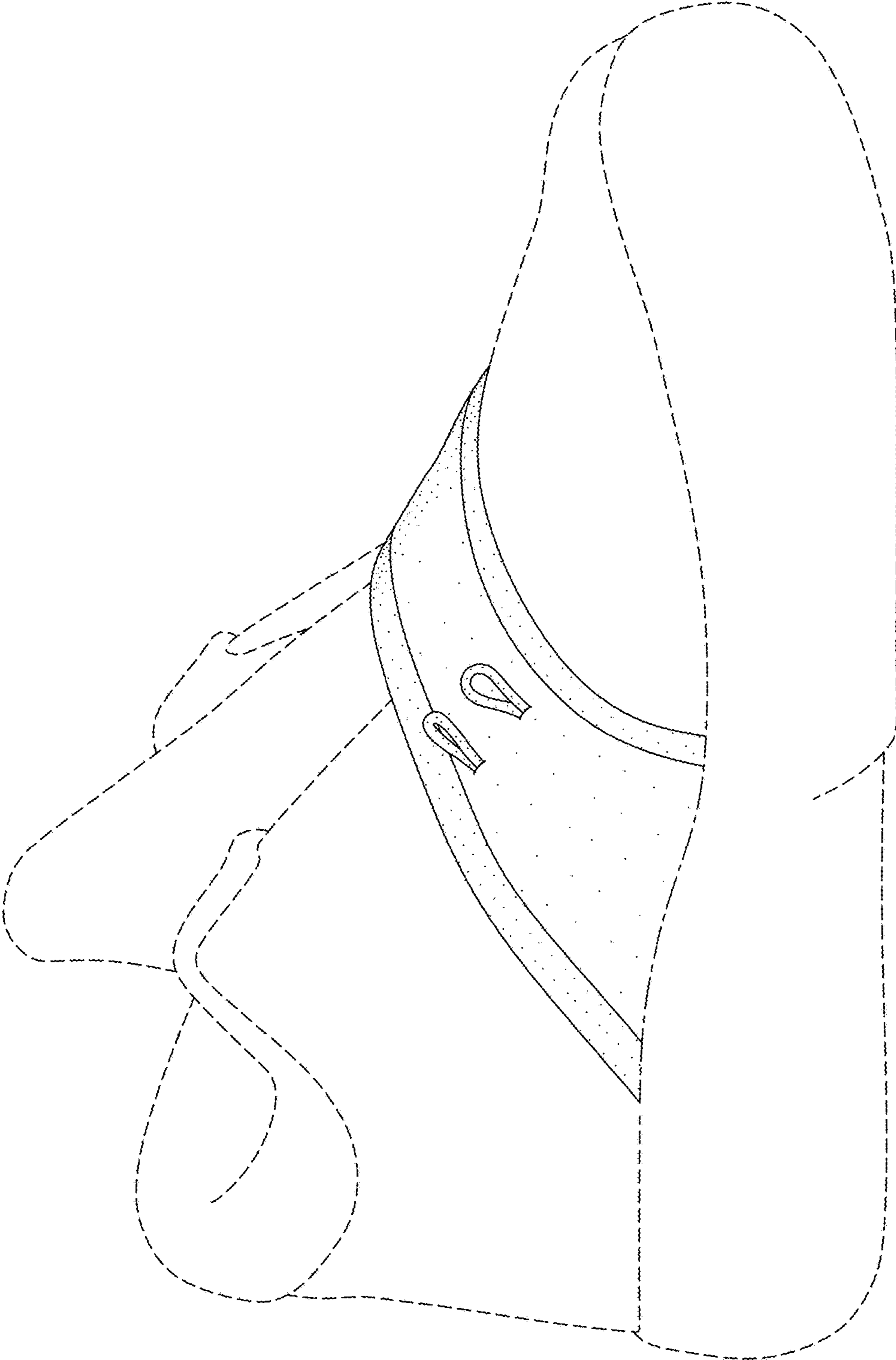

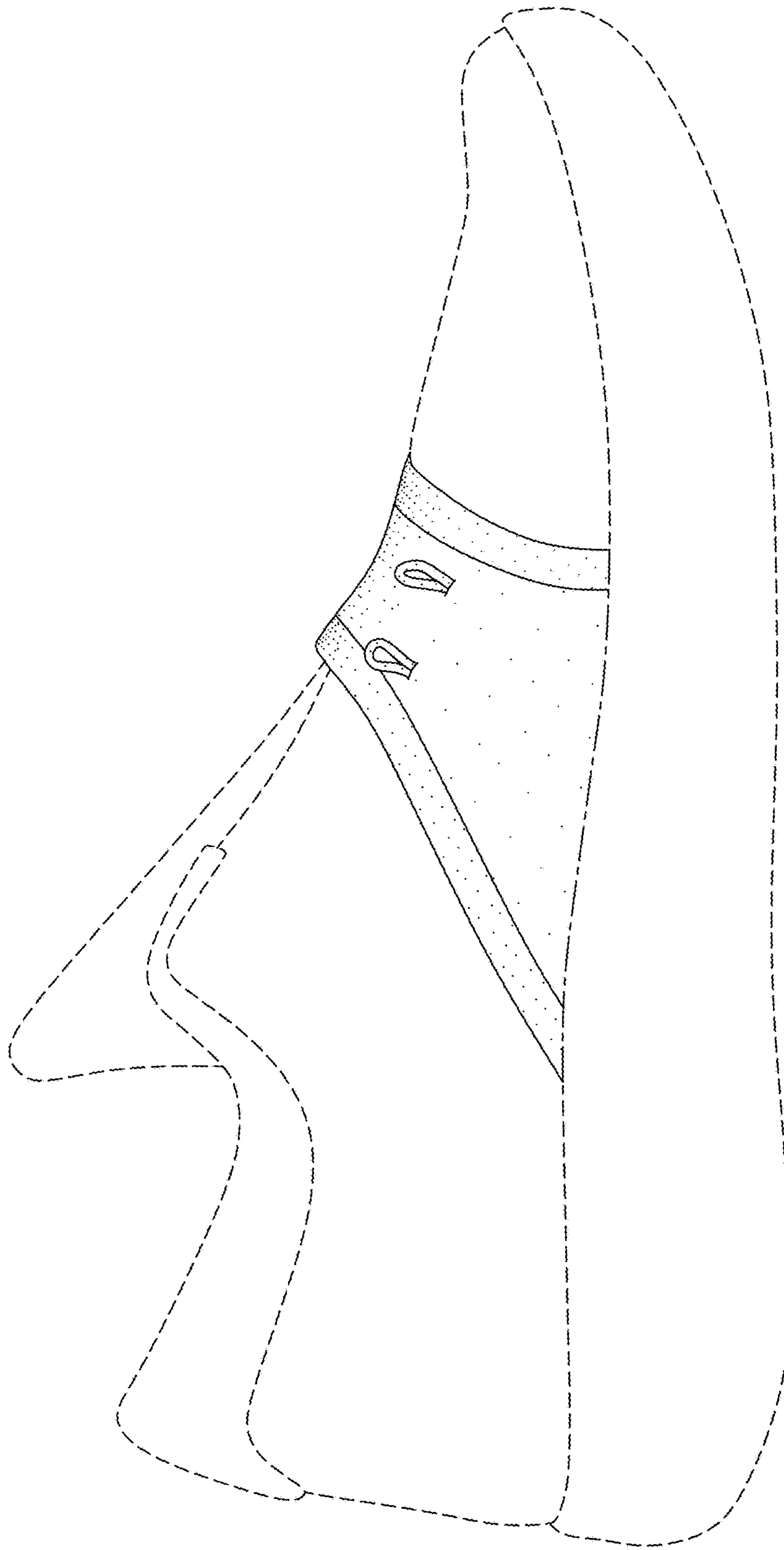

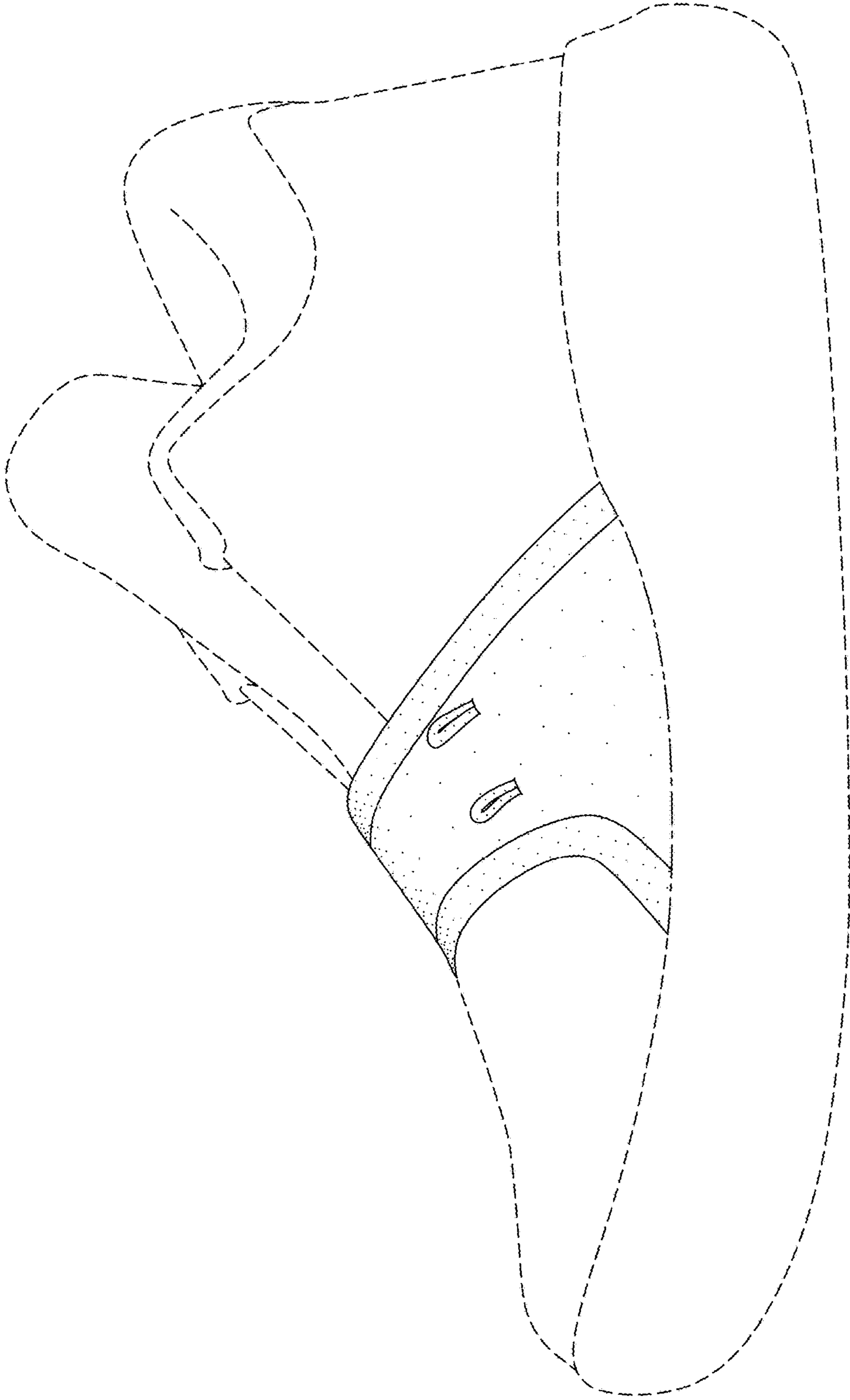

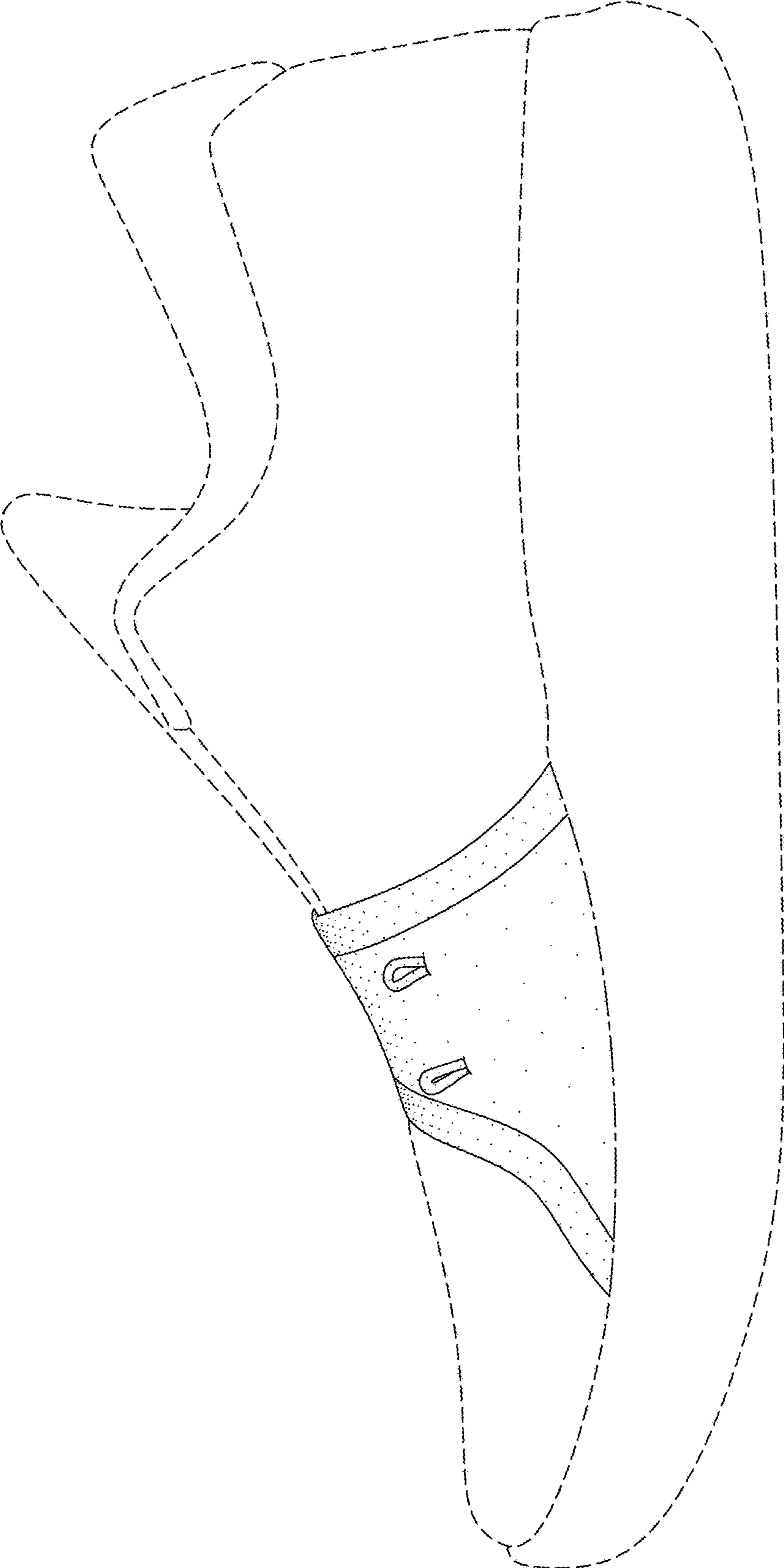

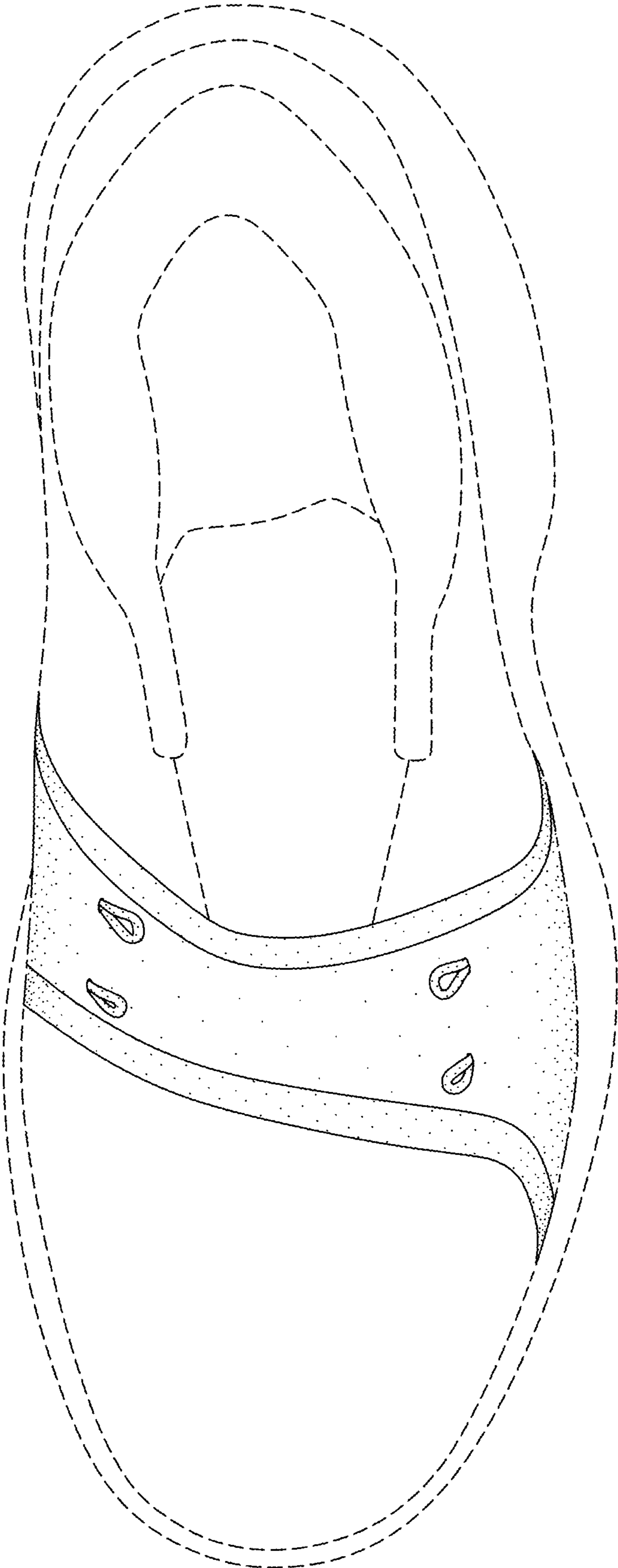
