FIG. 1;

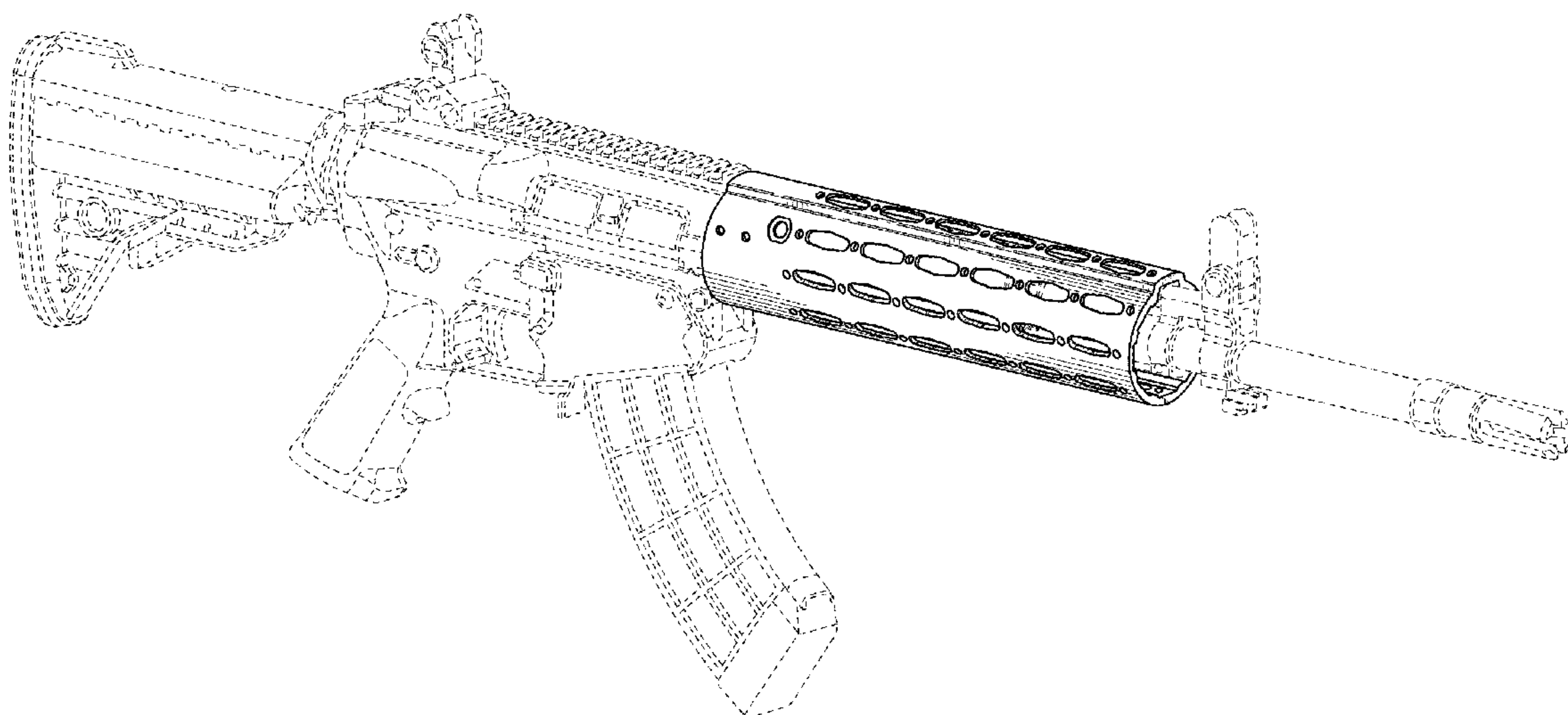
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the firearm rail of FIG.

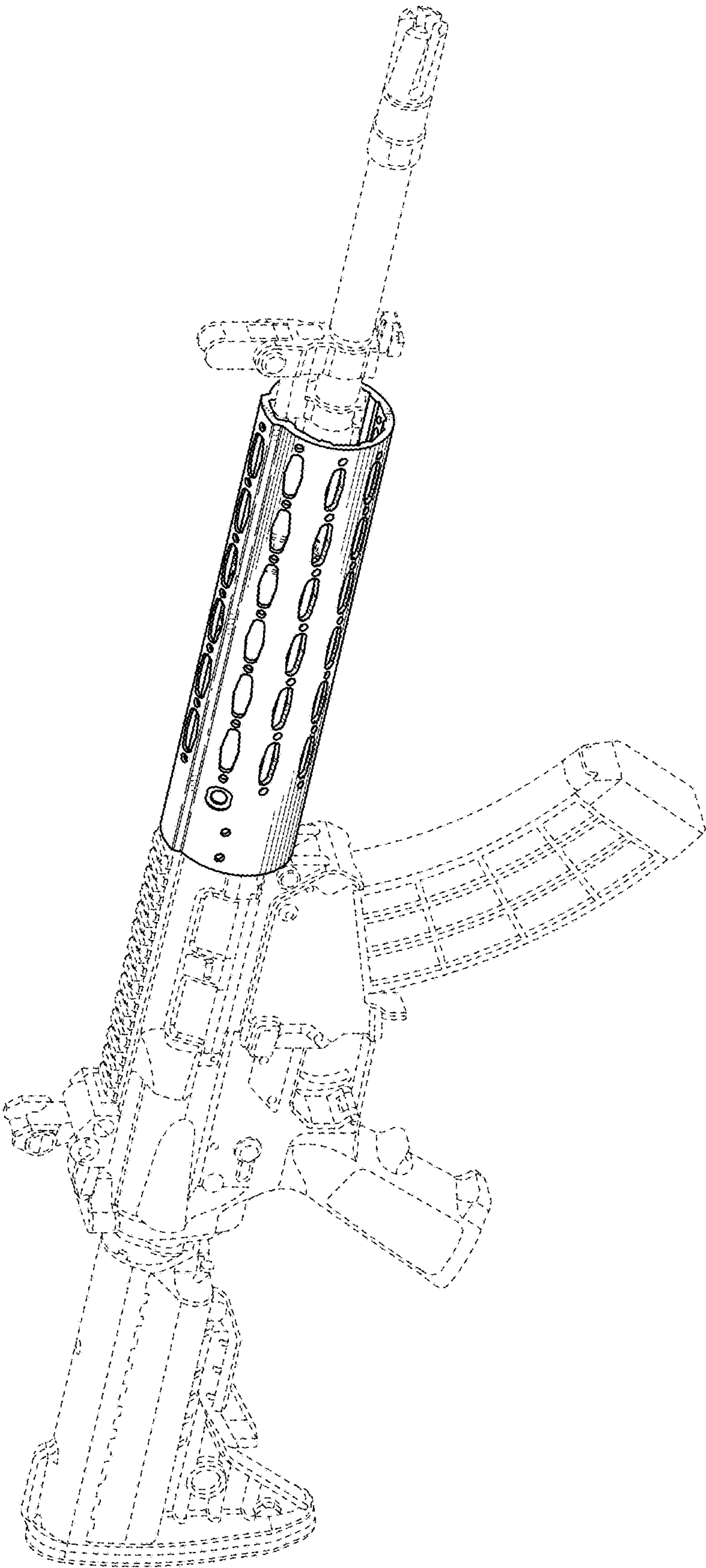

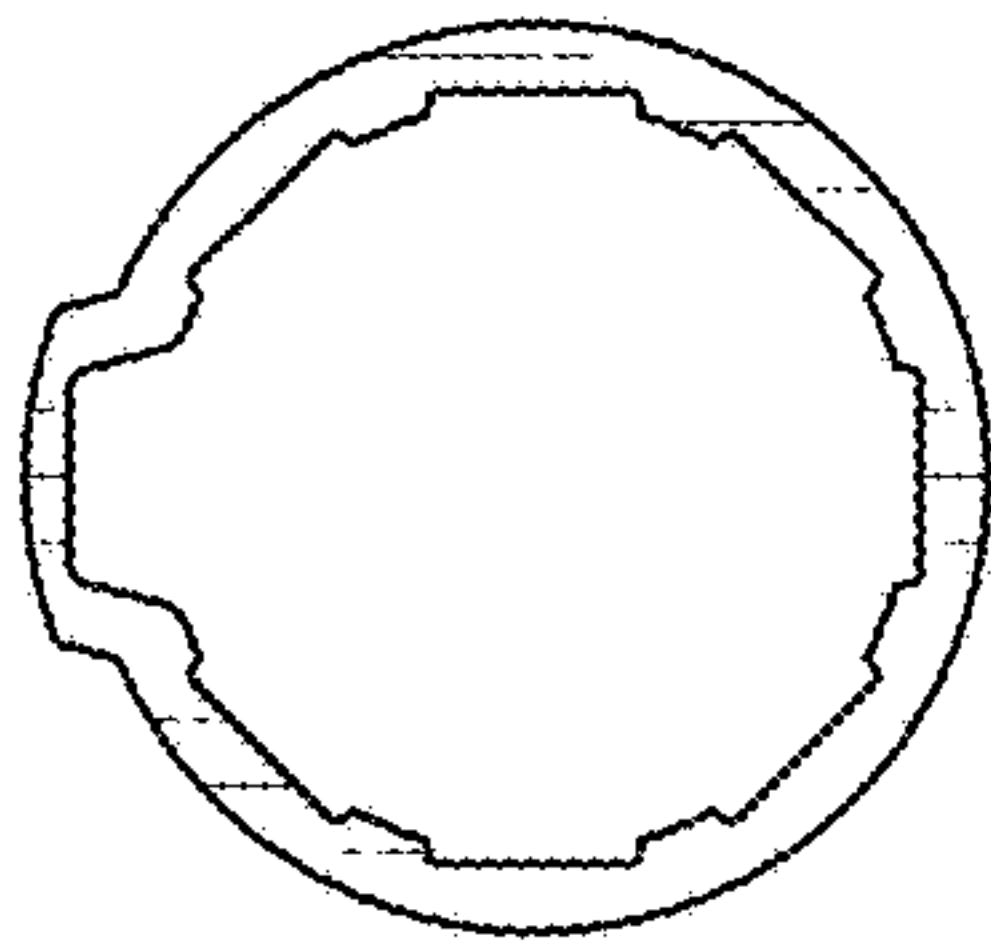

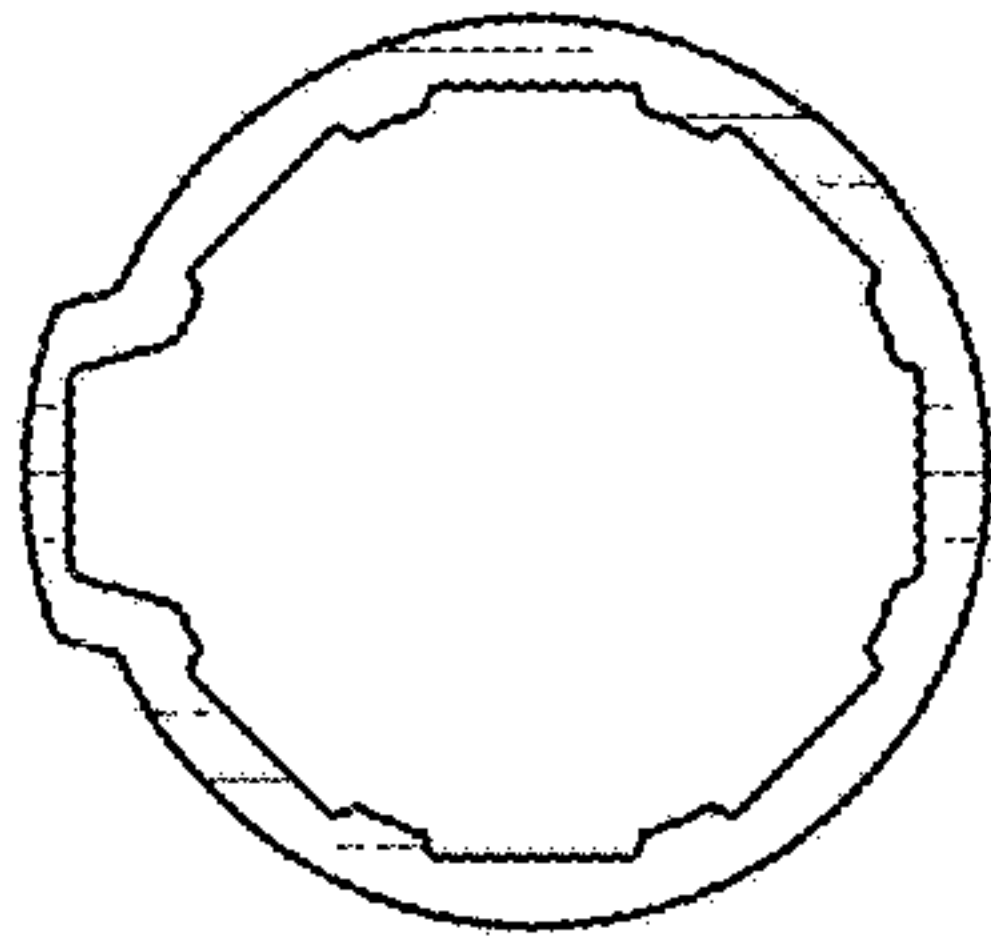

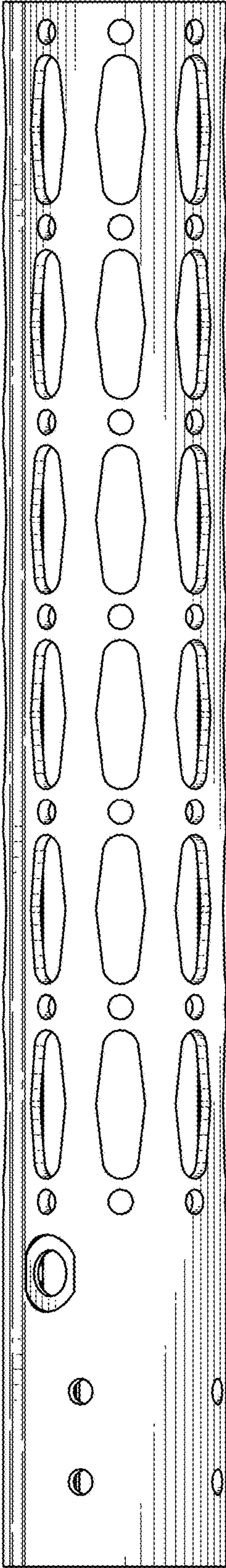

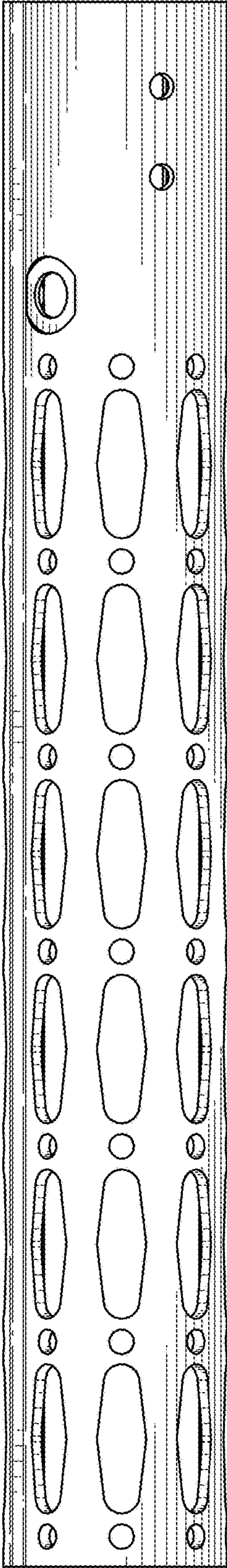

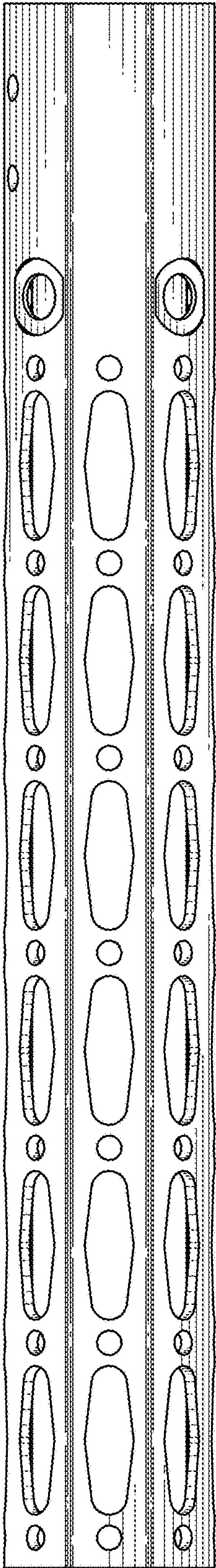

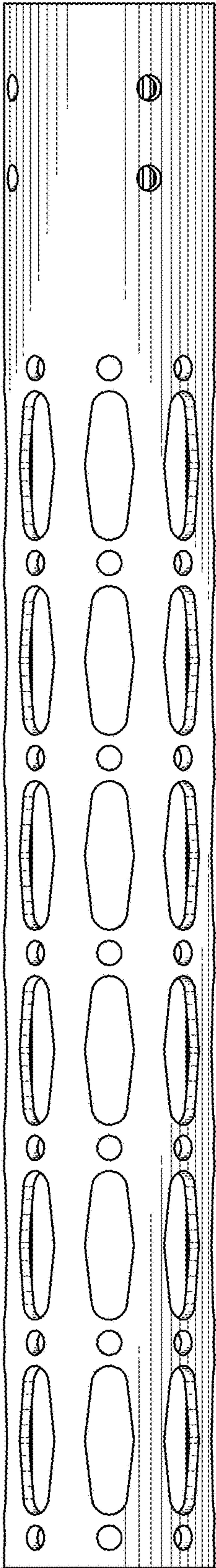
