FIG. 3 is a rear lateral perspective view thereof;

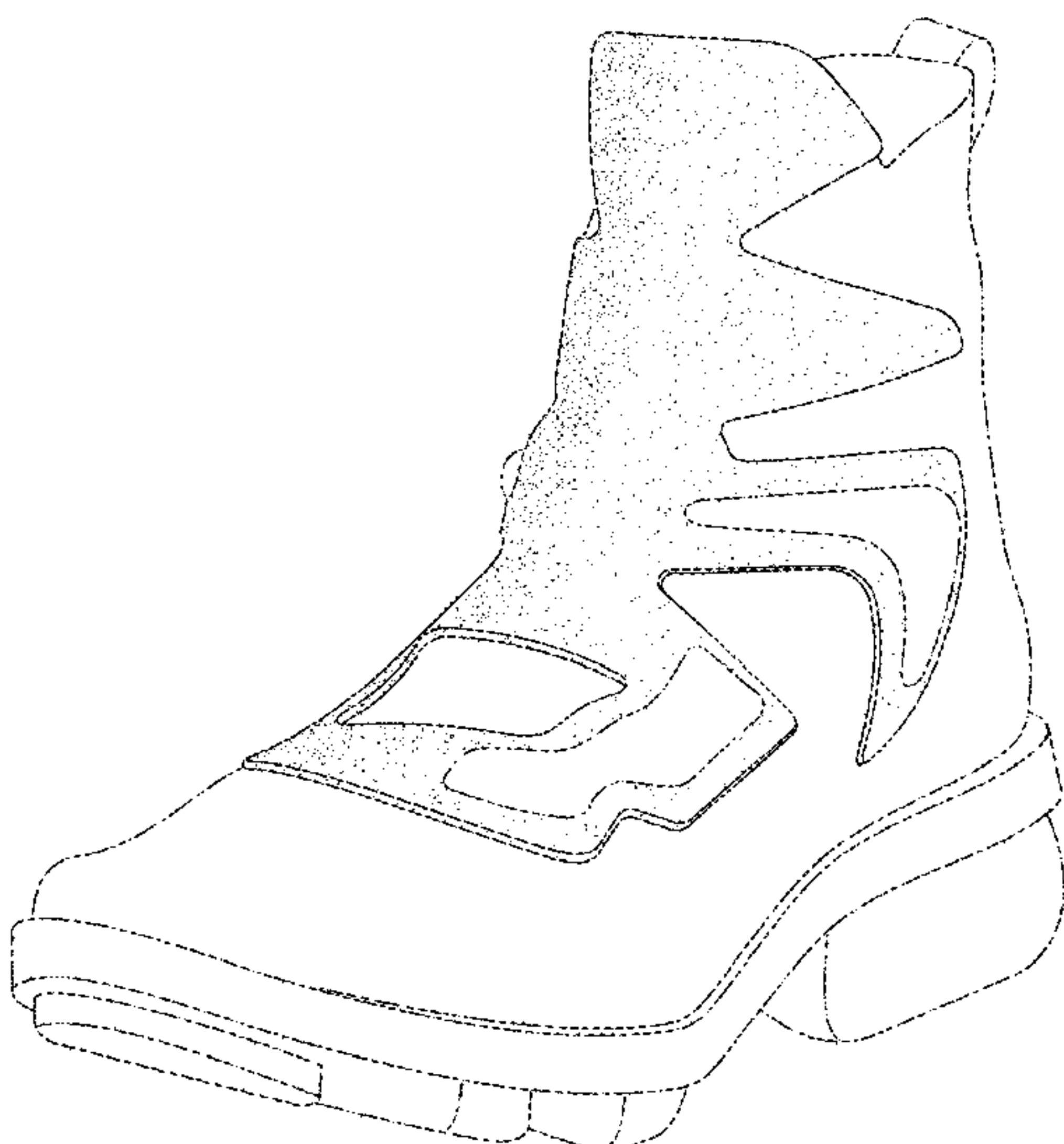
FIG. 4 is a rear medial perspective view thereof;

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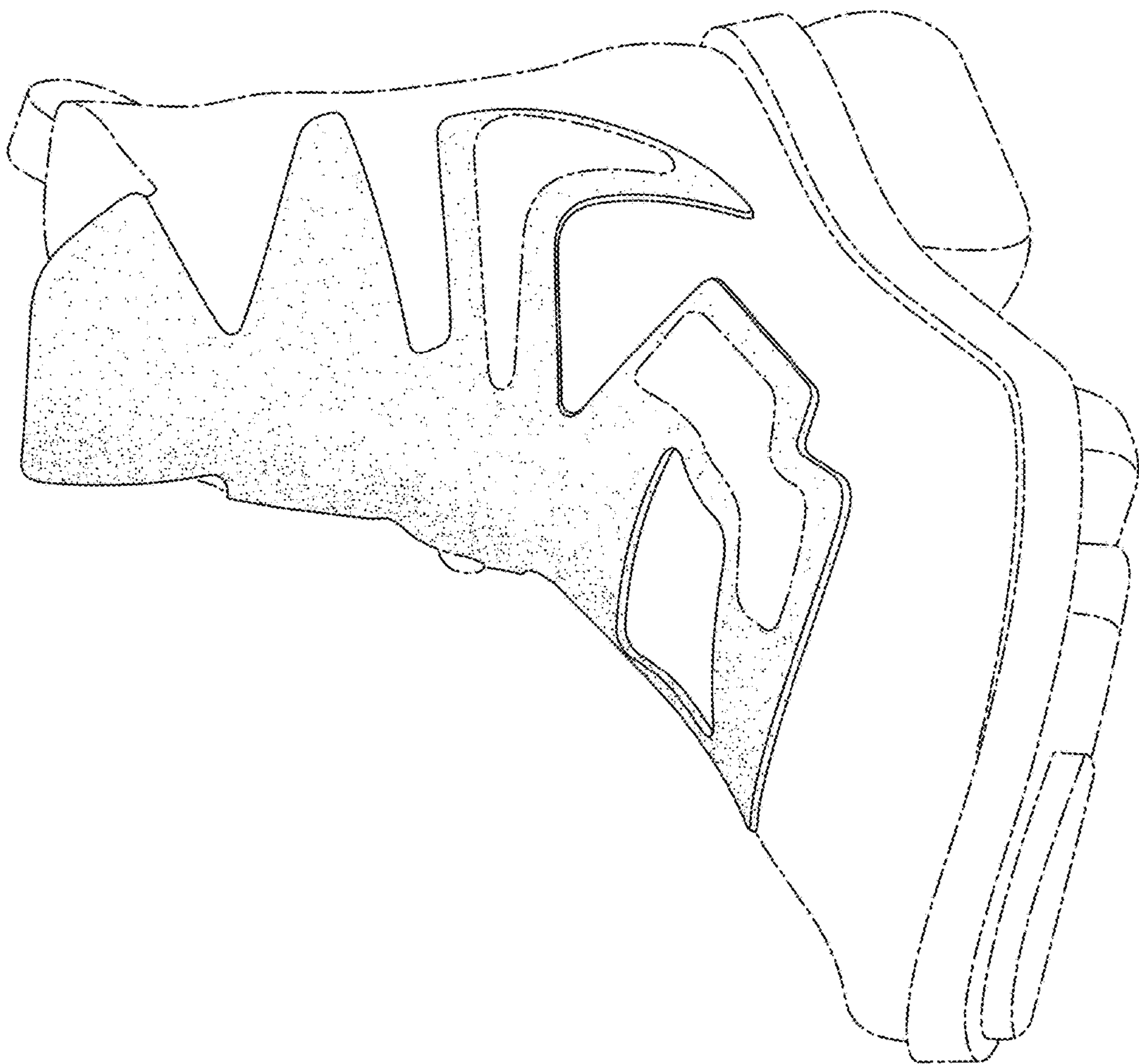

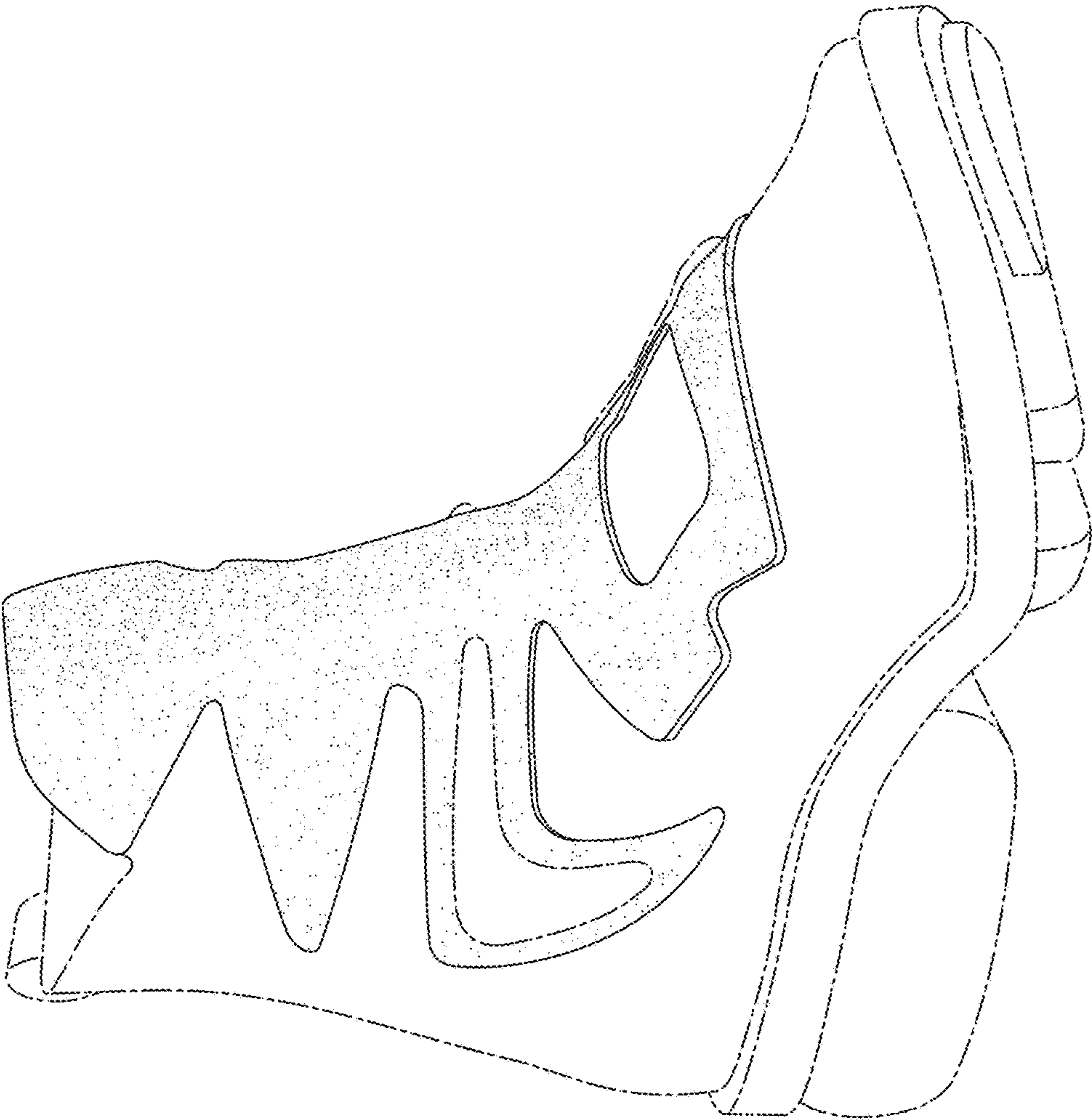

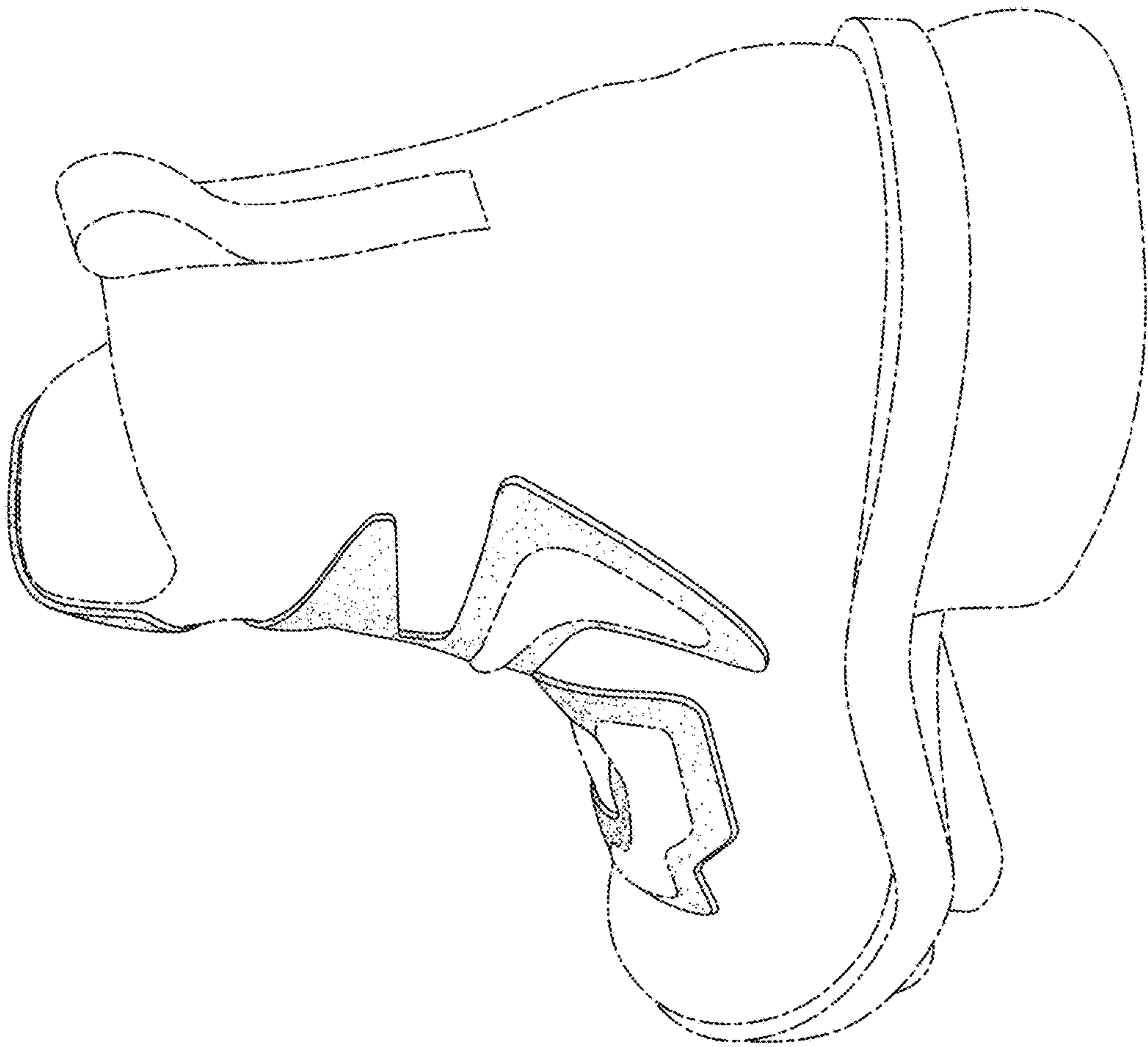

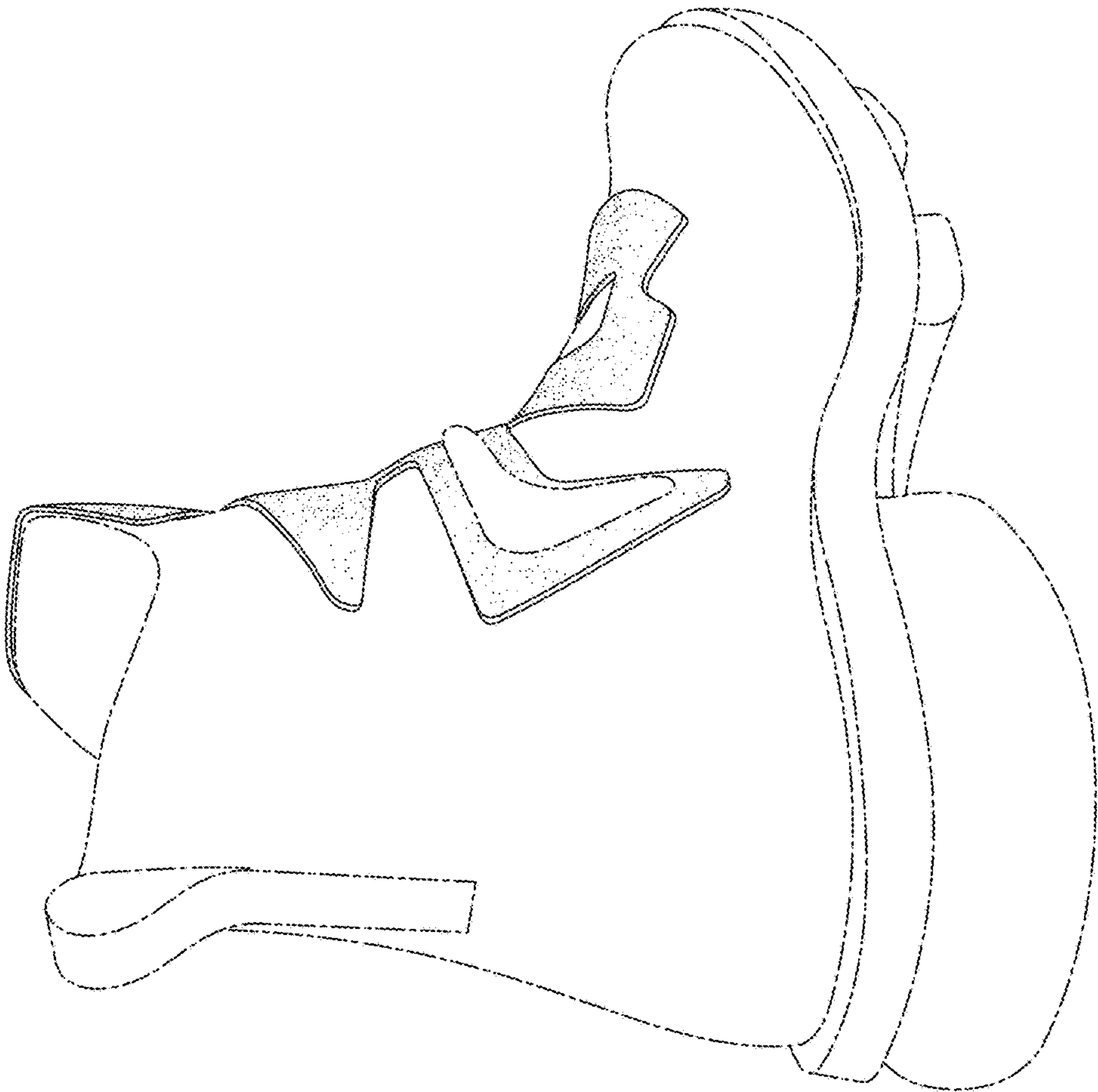

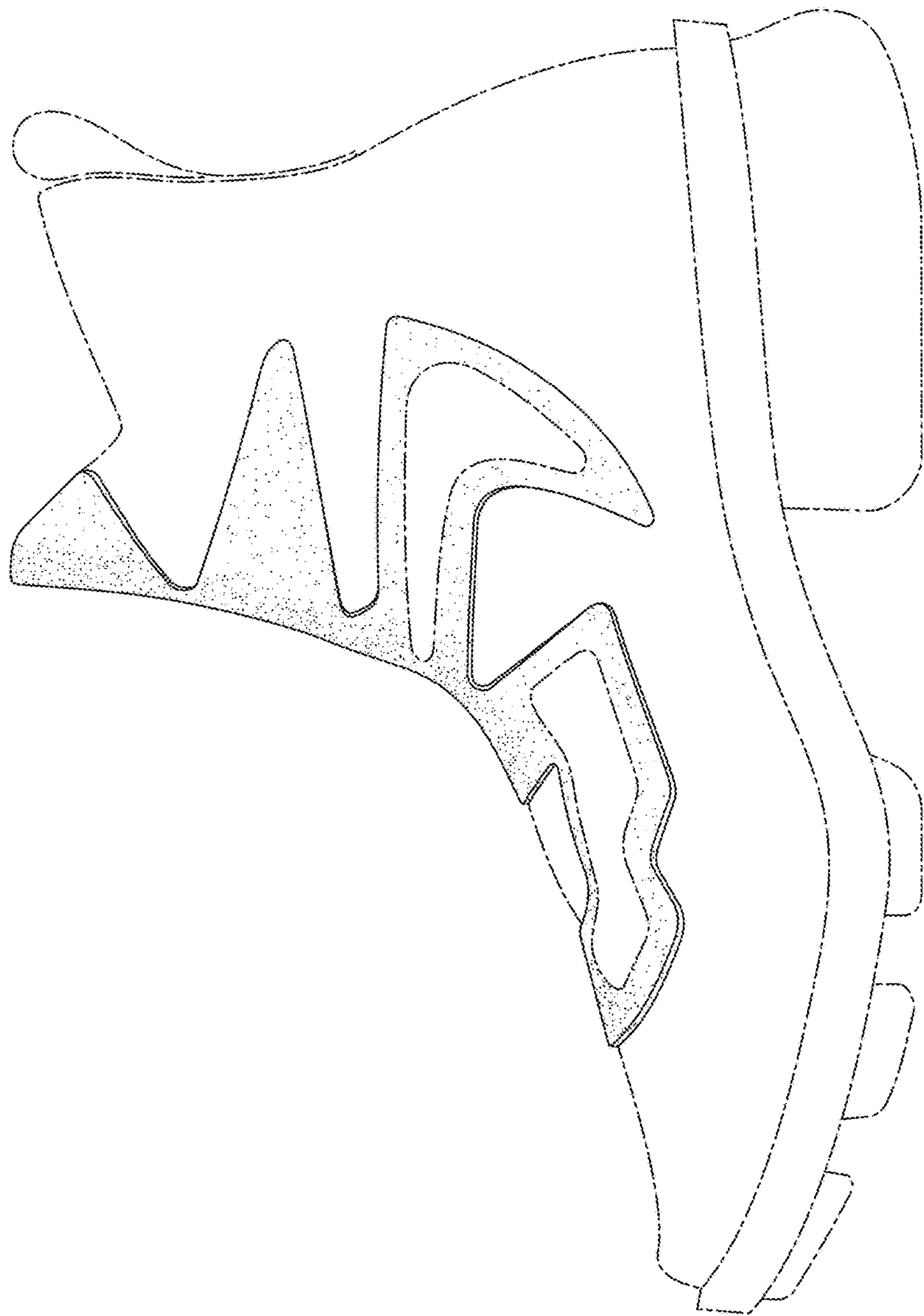

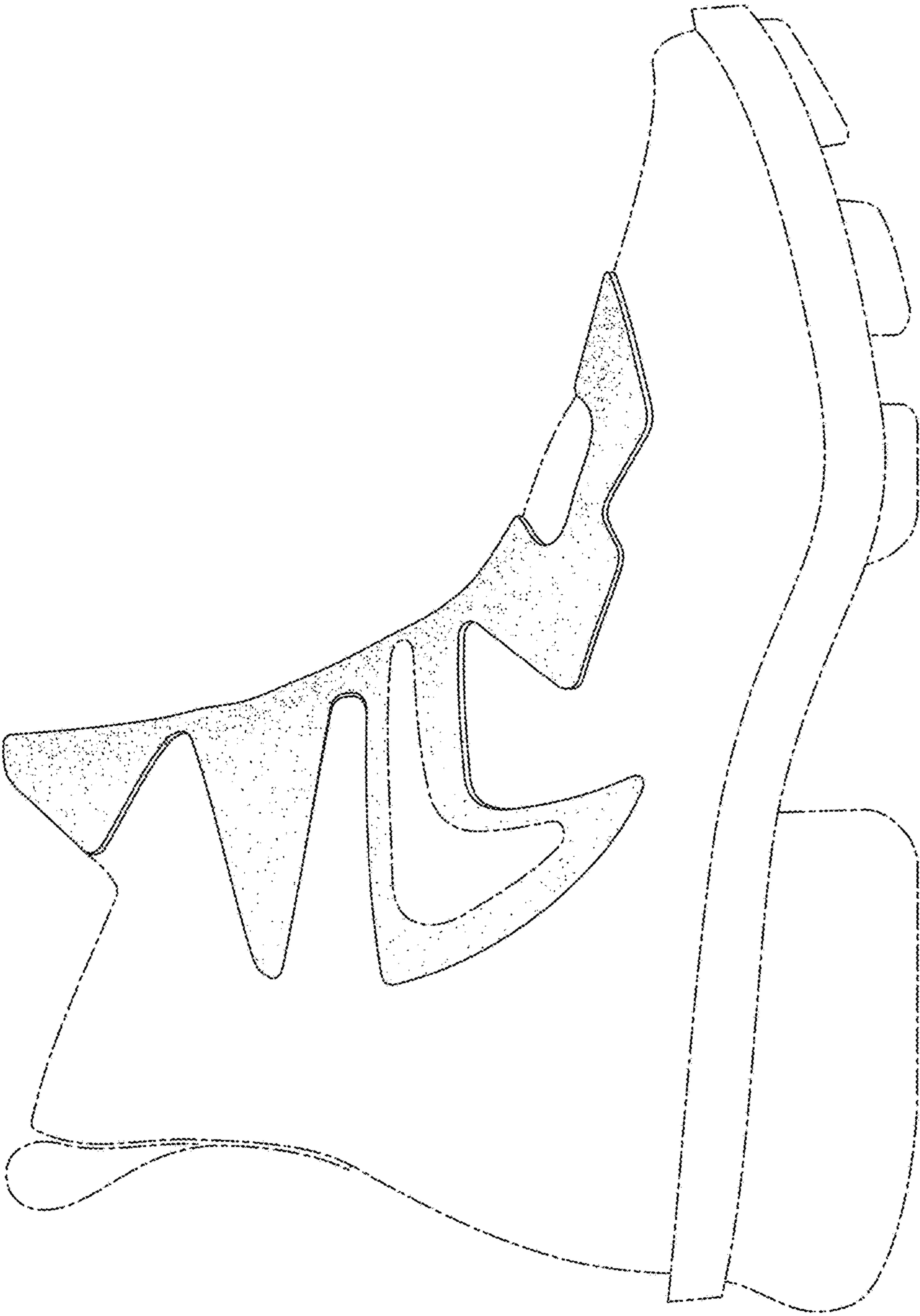
