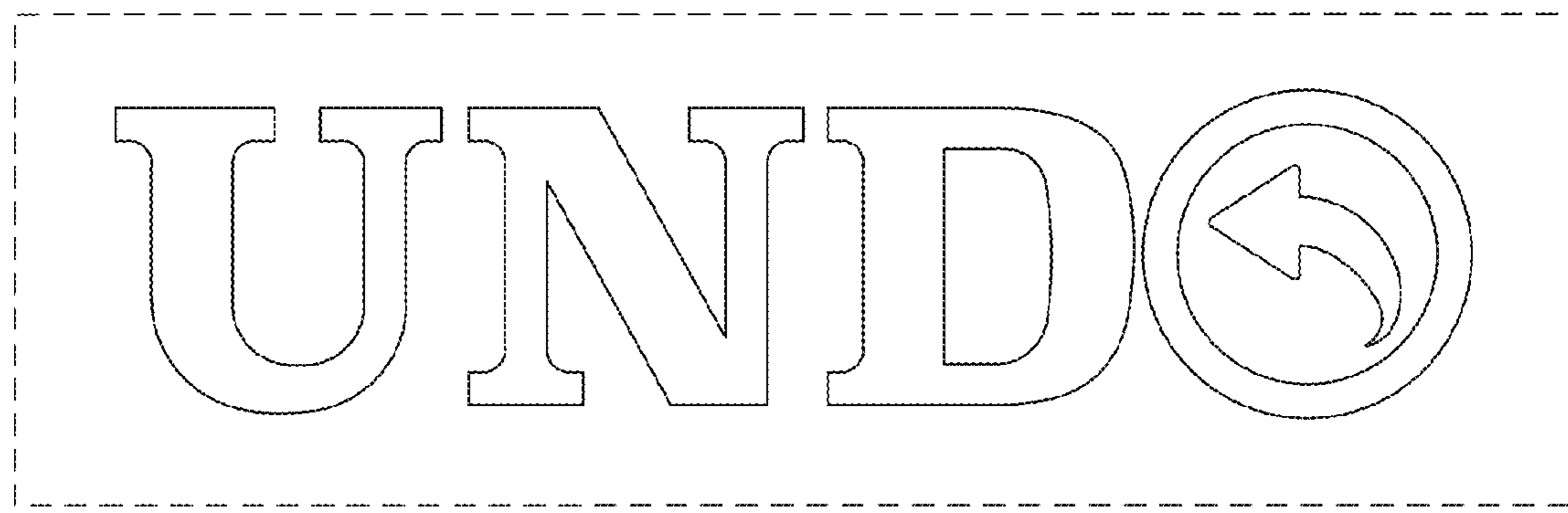

(57) **CLAIM**  
The ornamental design for an appliqué for textiles, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**  
FIG. 1 is a front view of an appliqué for textiles; and, FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of FIG. 1, shown in use. The broken lines showing an article of textile and a wearer thereof in FIG. 2 depicts environmental subject matter that forms no part of the claimed design. The space between the broken lines and the solid forms are not part of the claim. Surfaces without shading form no part of the design claim. The broken lines shown surrounding the design are depicting environmental possibilities and are no part of the claim. The broken lines are not claimed to the design, only solid lines are claimed.

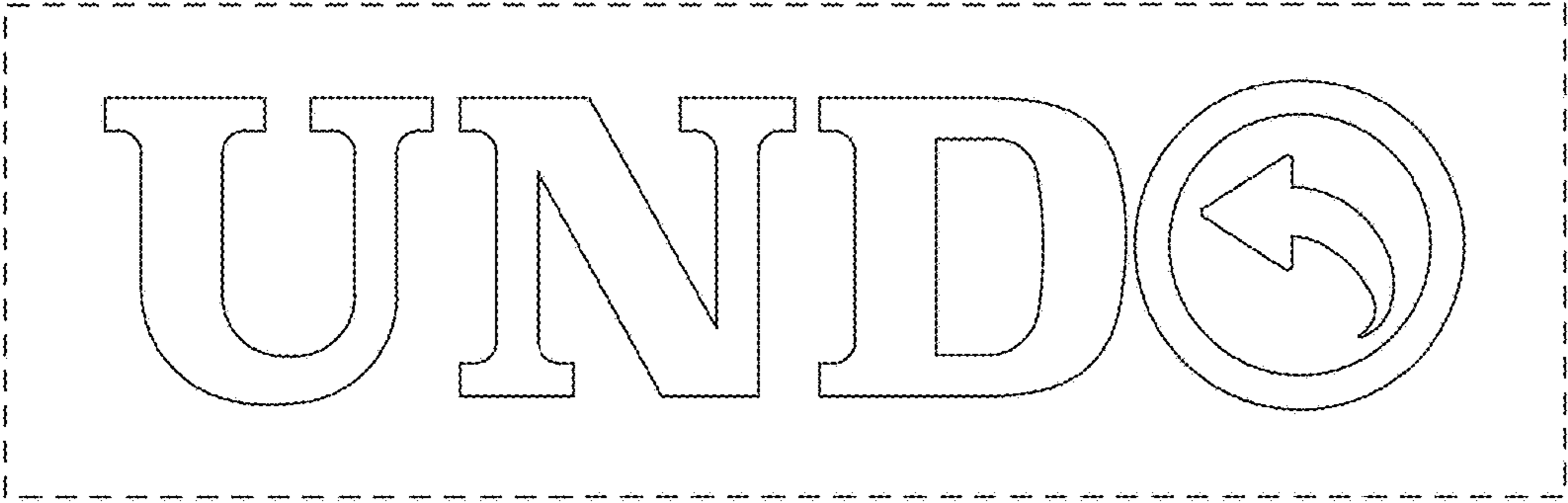
