The ornamental design for a trolling bait holder, as shown and described.

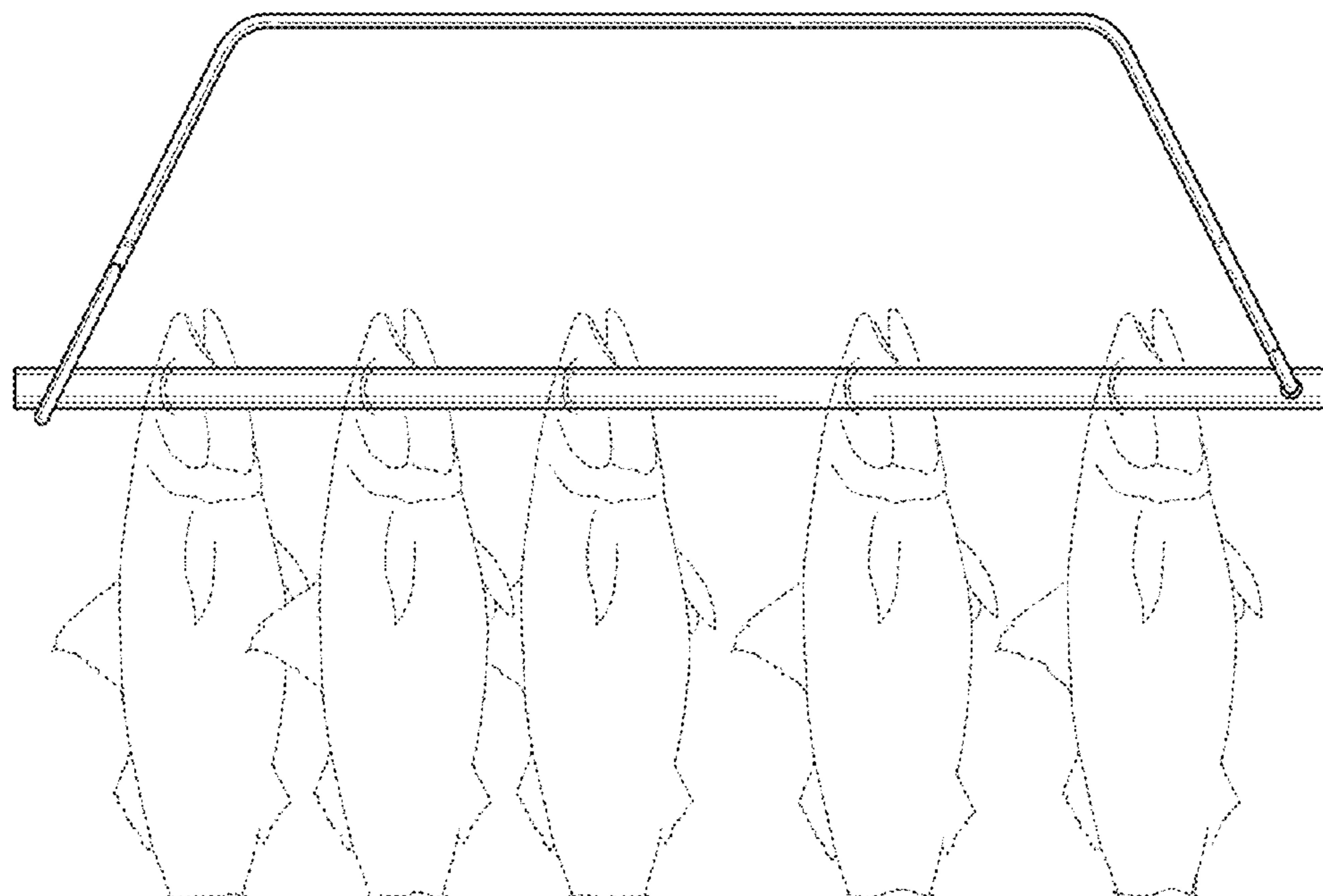
DESCRIPTION

- 1. Trolling bait holder
- 1.1 : Left
- 1.2 : Top
- 1.3 : Right
- 1.4 : Bottom
- 1.5 : Back
- 1.6 : Front
- 1.7 : Unfolded

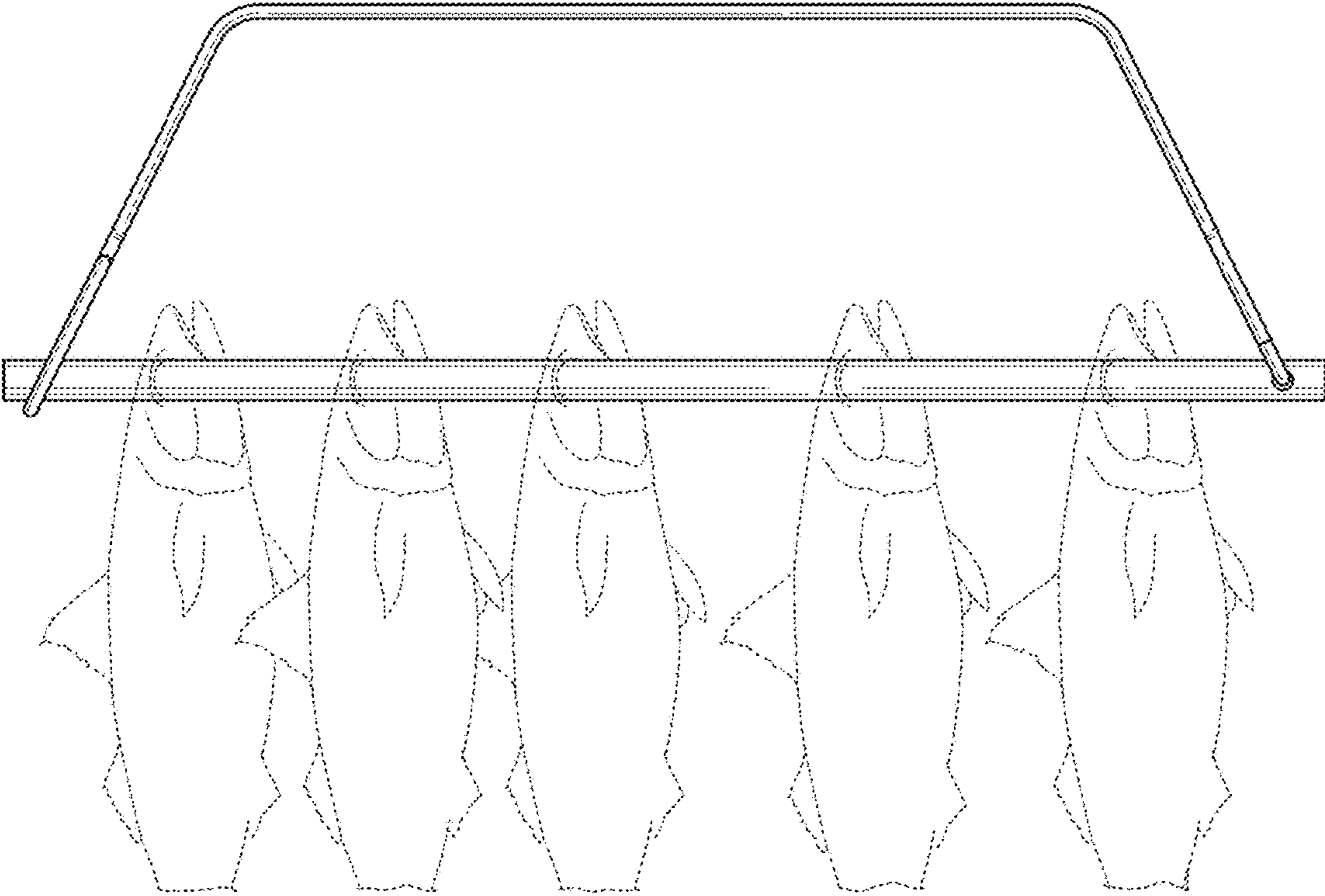
A holder for use in holding trolling bait prior to use of the bait in trolling; a rod passes through the eye sockets of the bait, which are empty, and which bait are individually releasable from the handle as bait is needed.

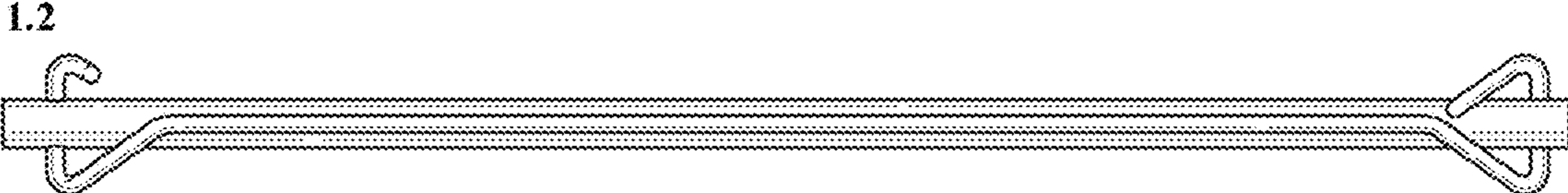
The broken line showing of 5 bait fish in figure 1.1 is included for the purpose of illustrating environment and forms no part of the claimed design.

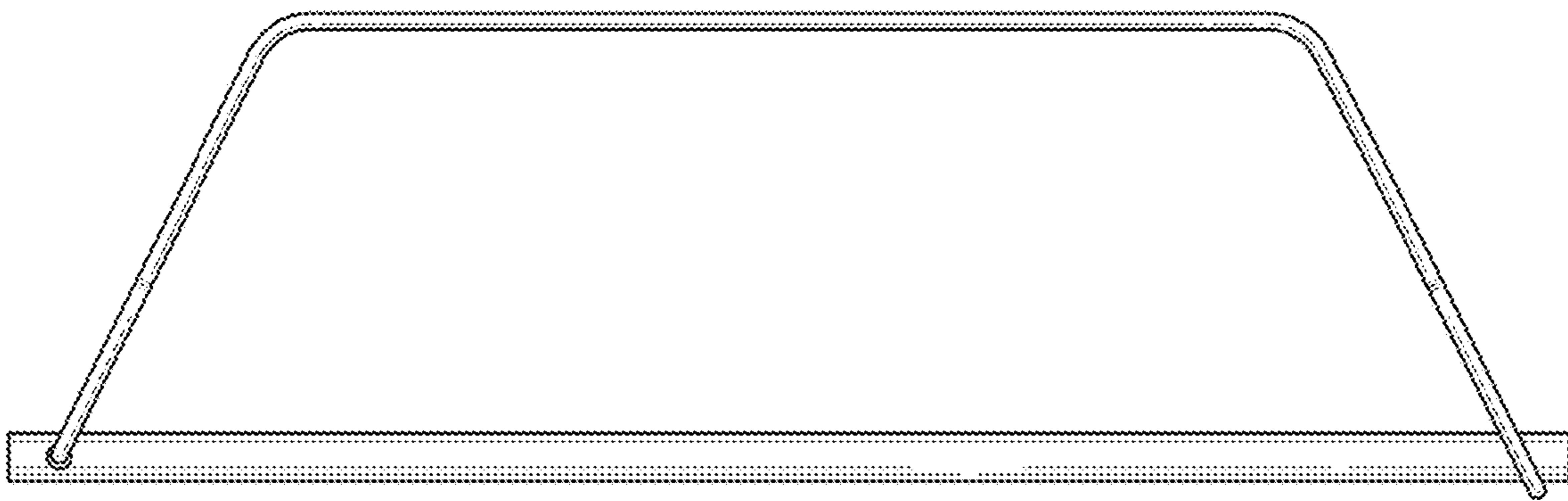

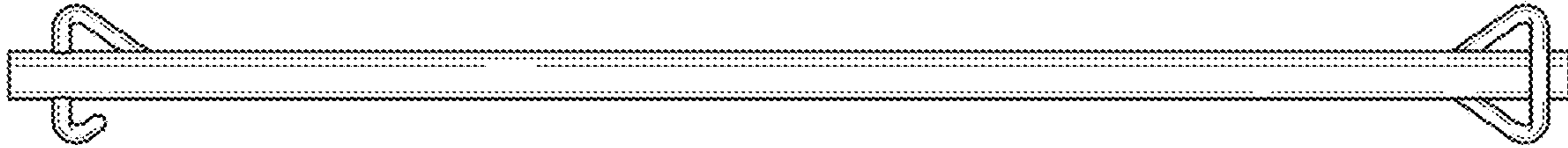




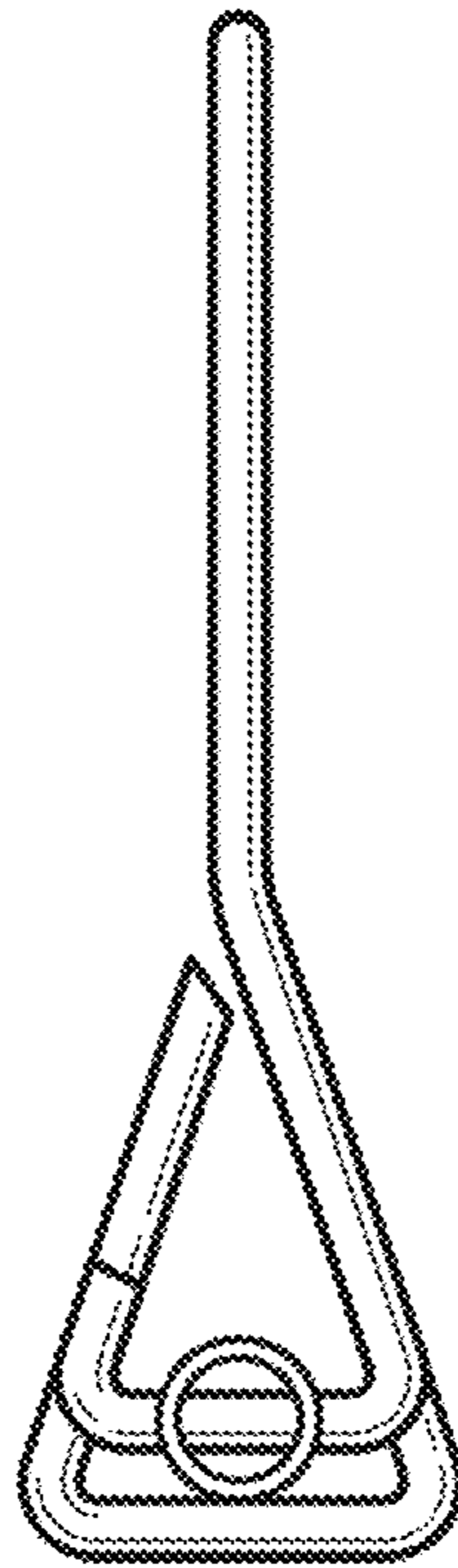

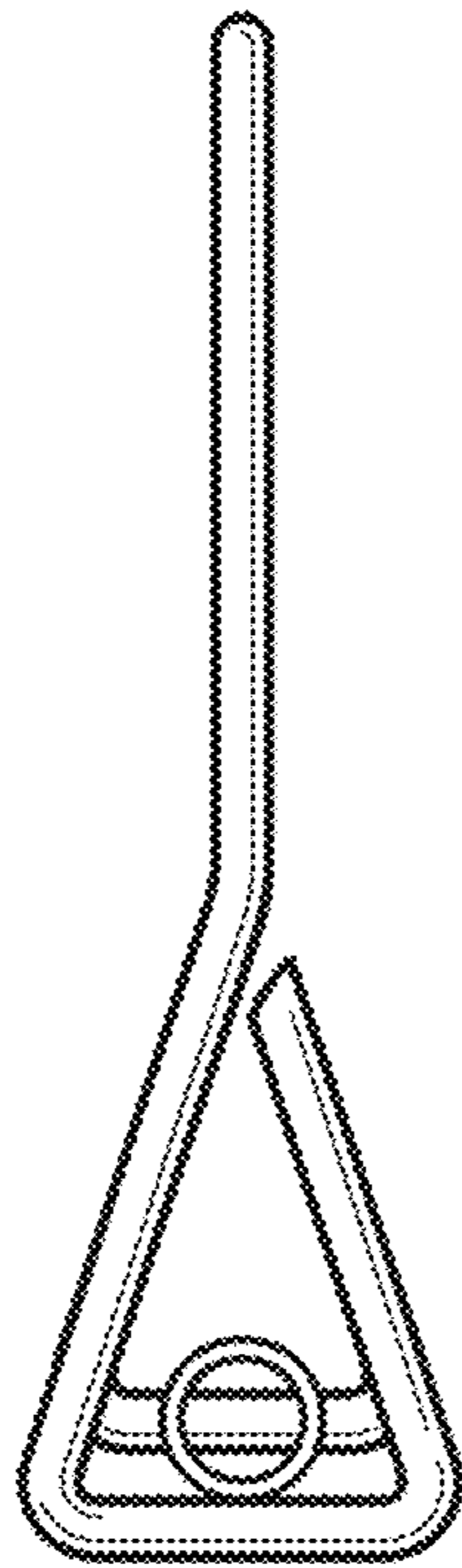
