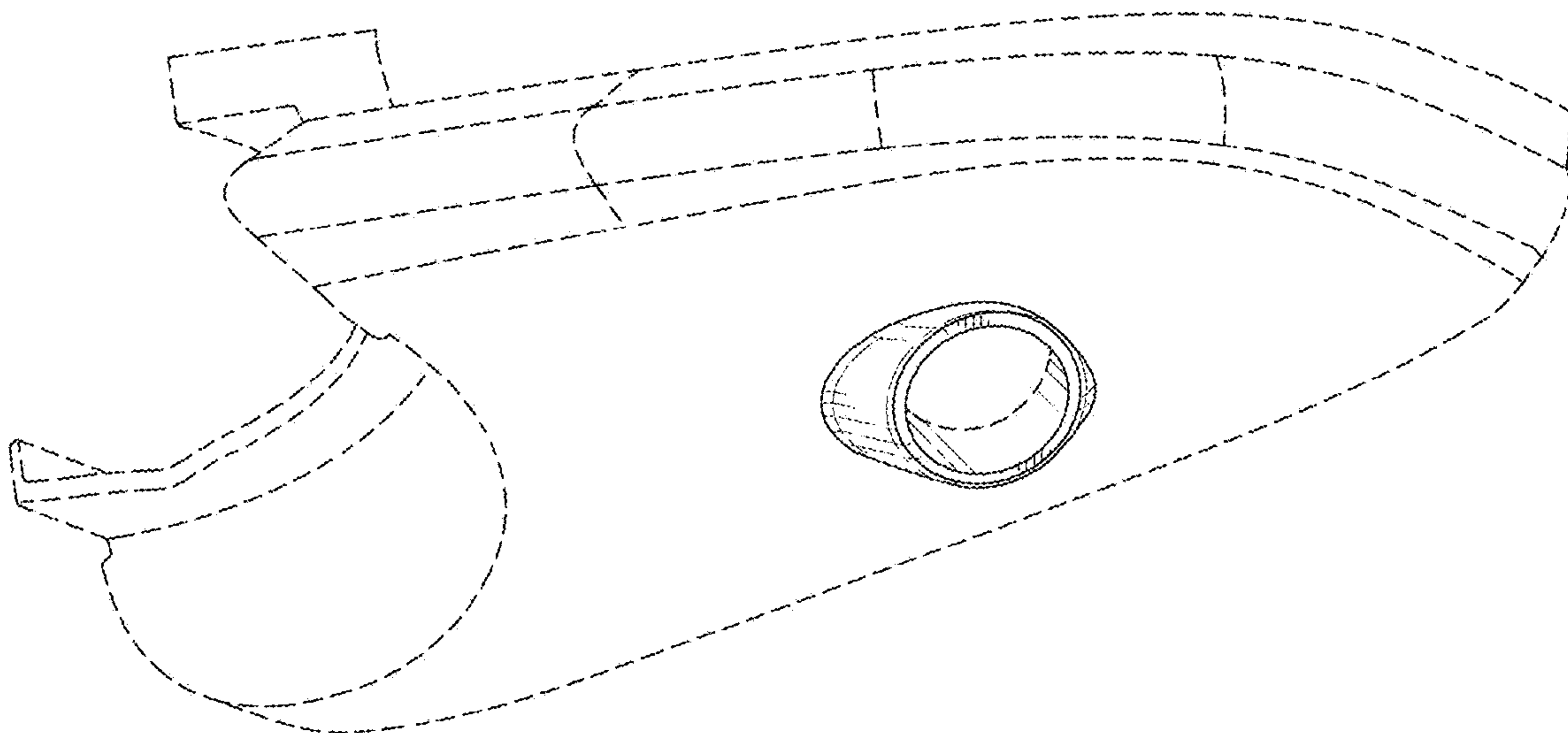
The ornamental design for a side-view mirror camera housing, as shown and described.

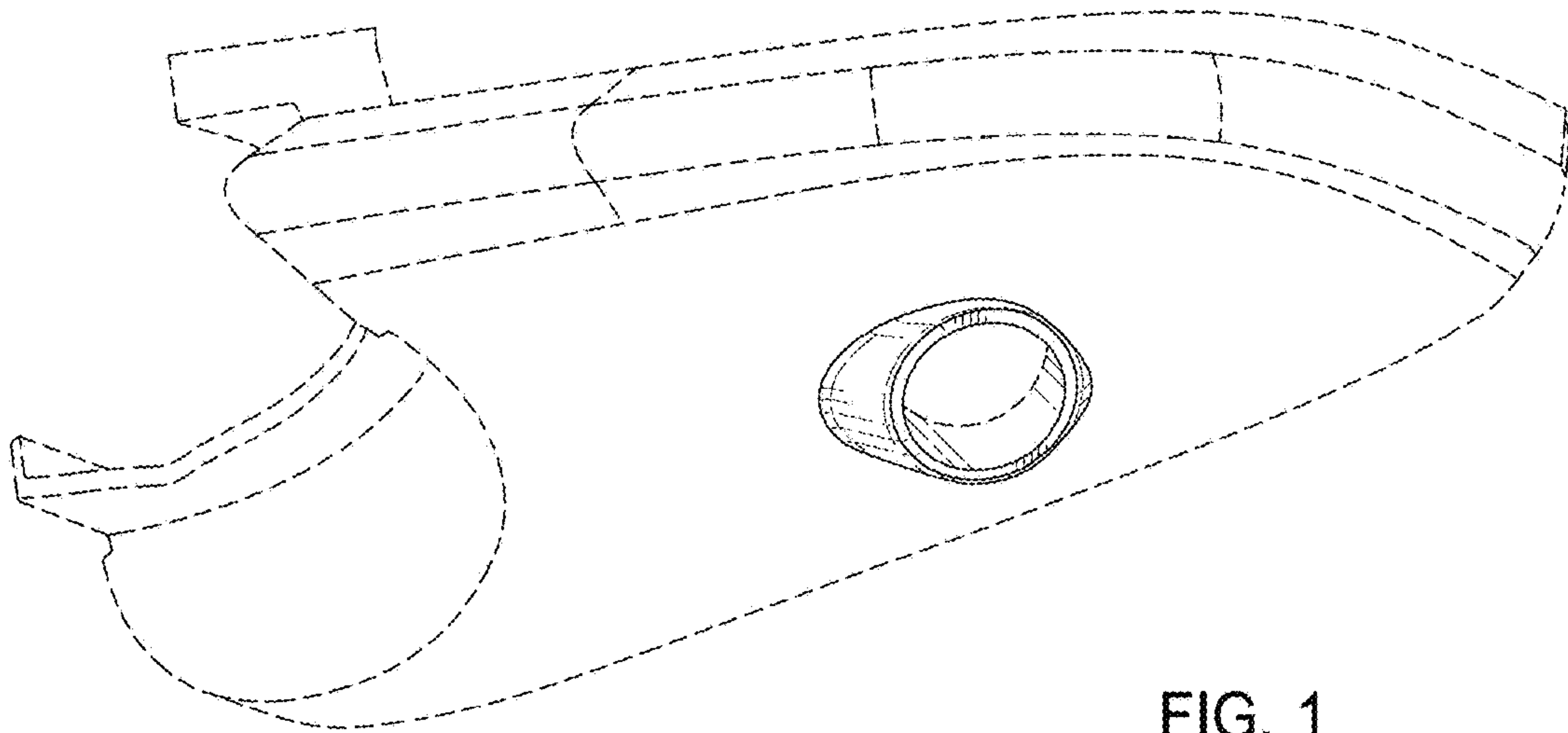

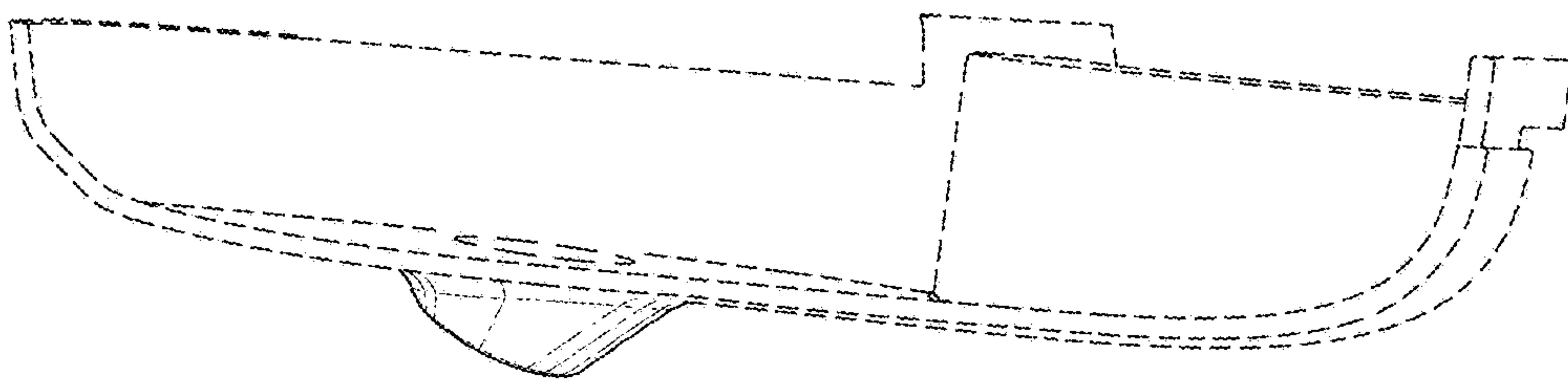

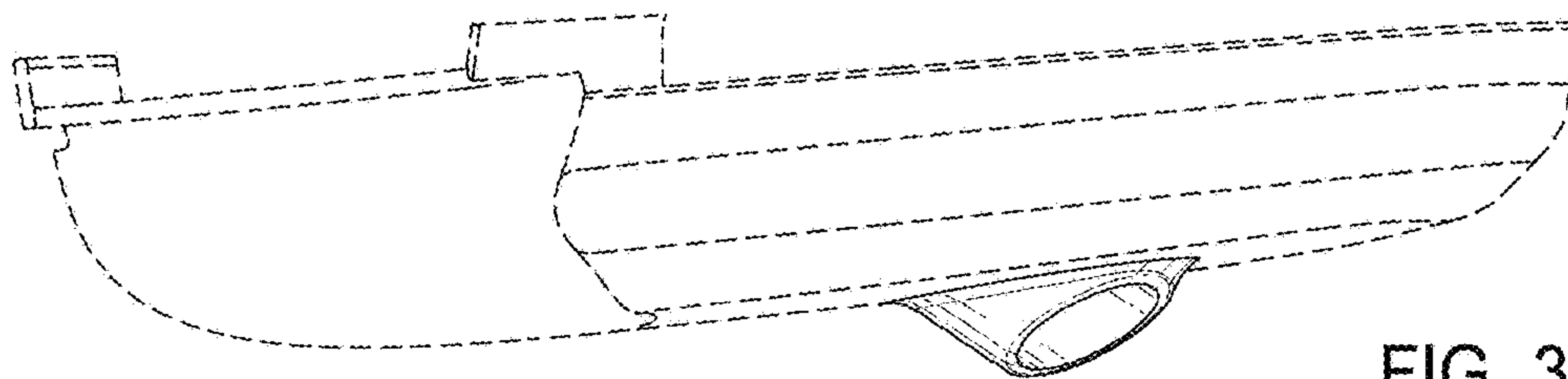

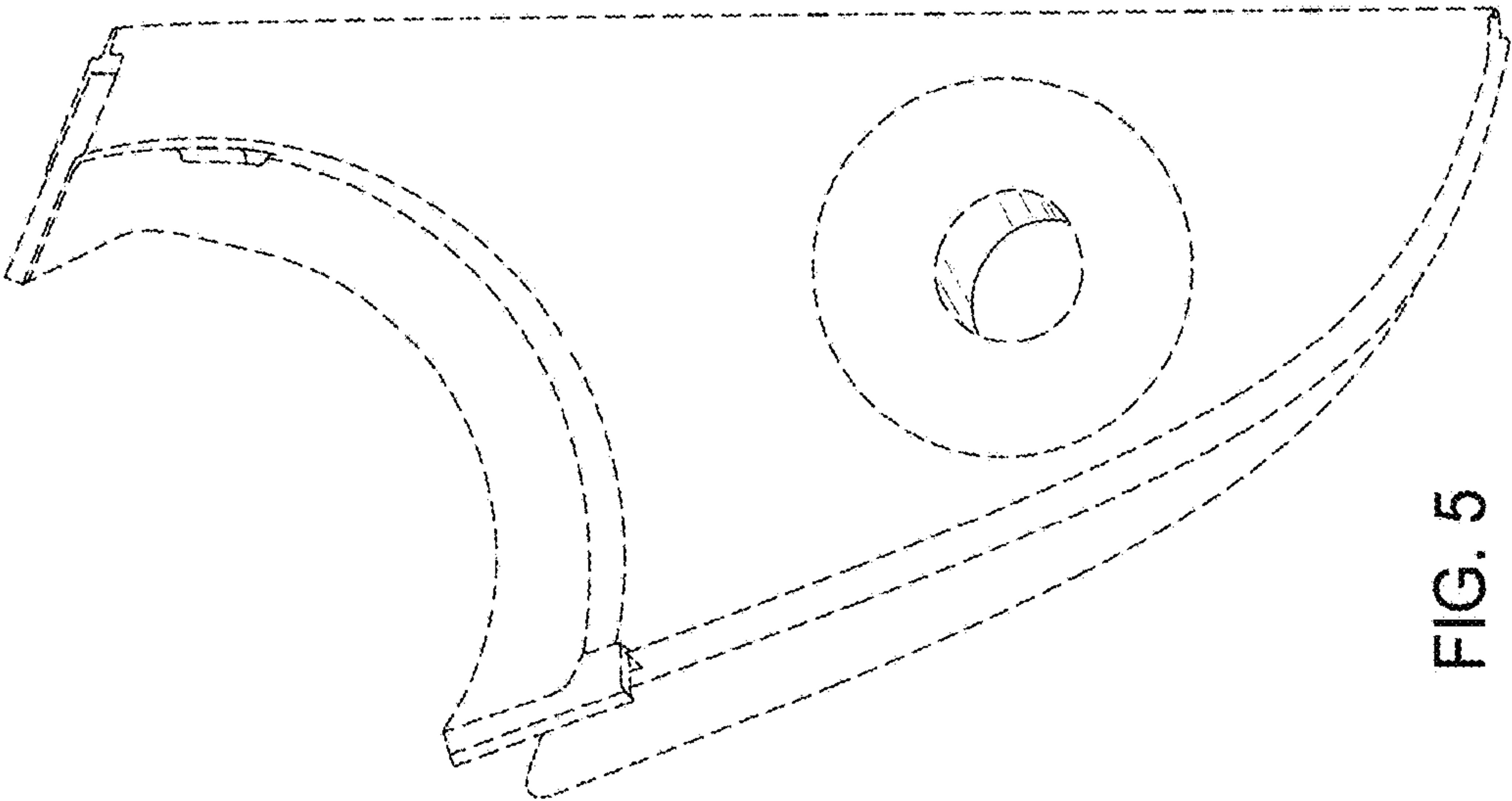

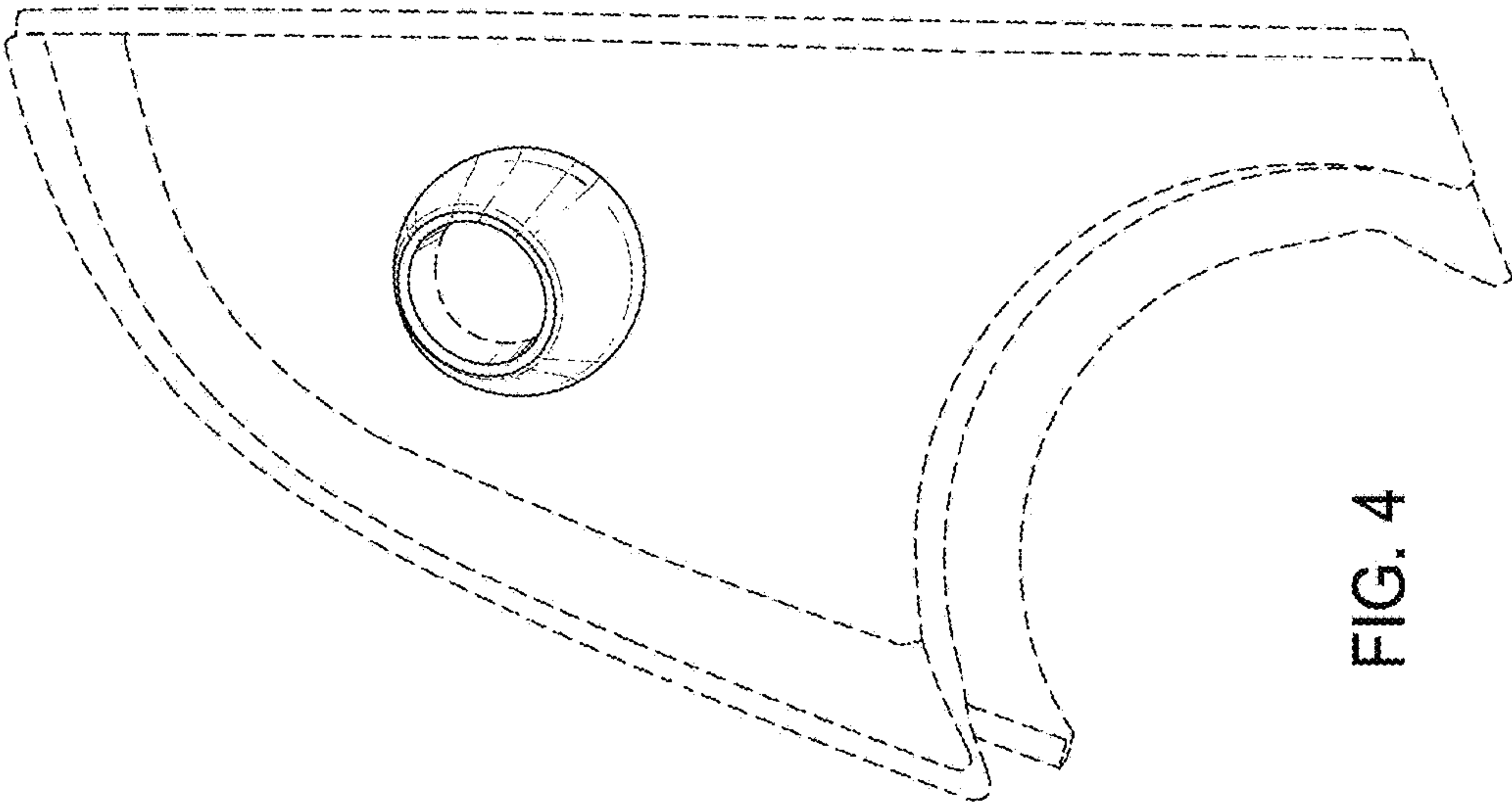

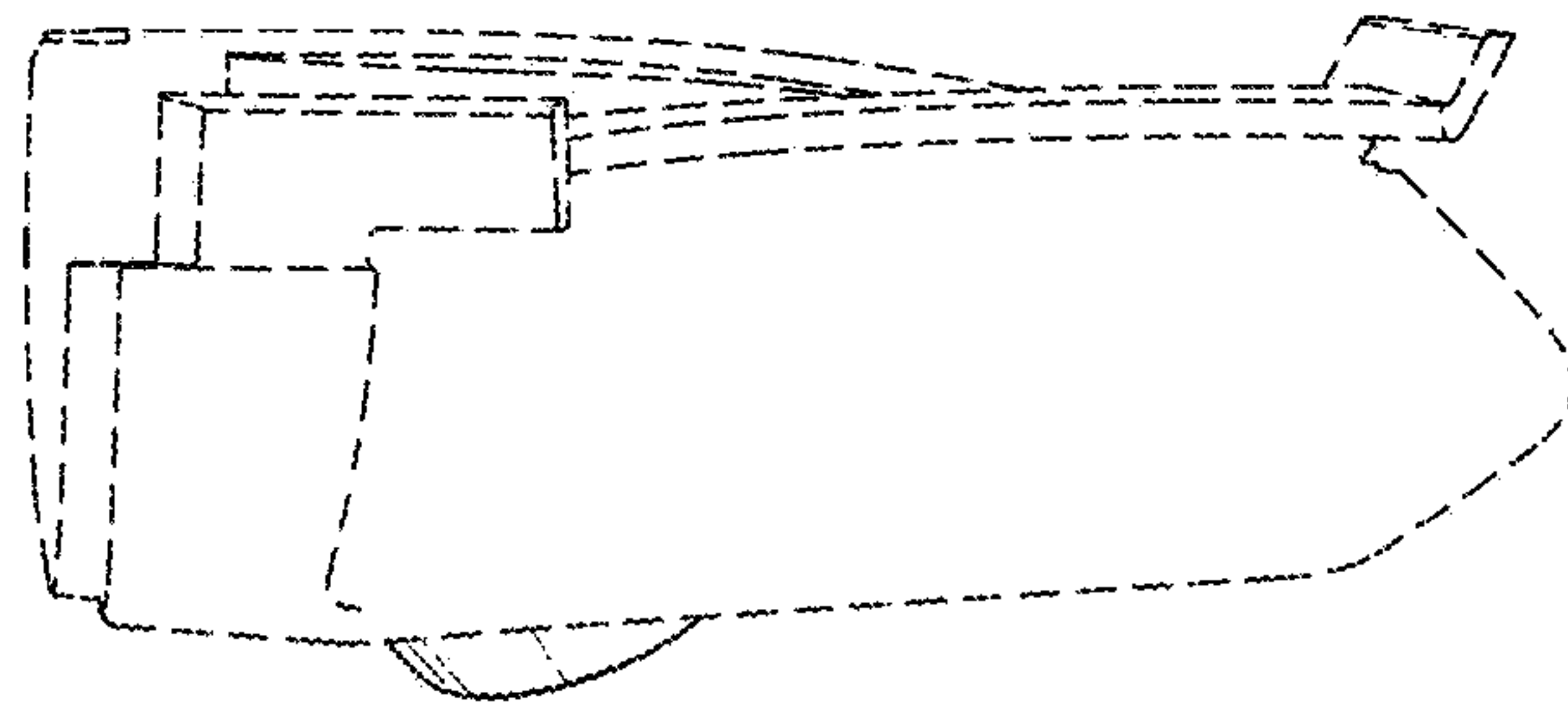

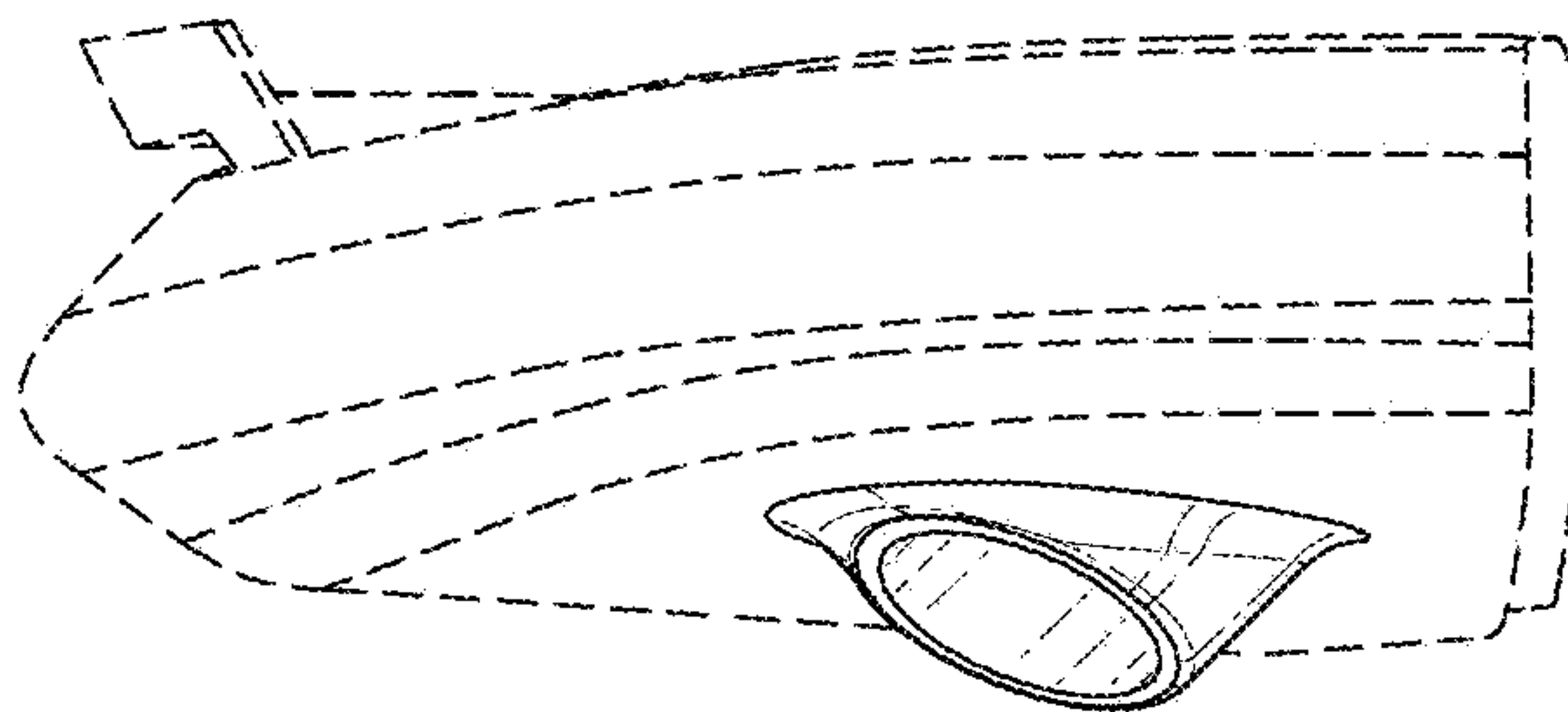
