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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a food product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right perspective view of a food product showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the food product shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the food product shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view of the food product shown in FIG. 1;

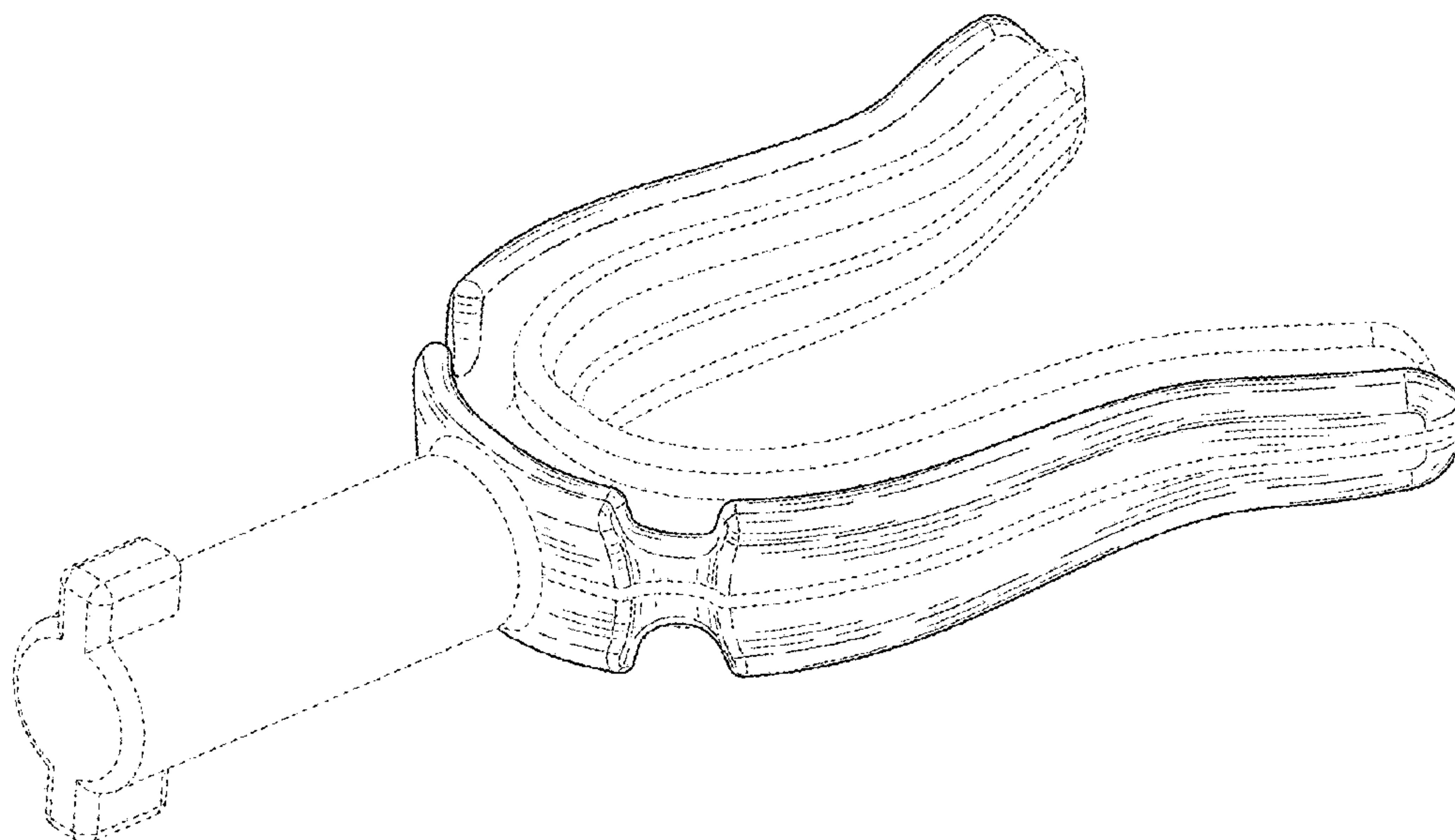
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view of the food product shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the food product shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the food product shown in FIG. 1.

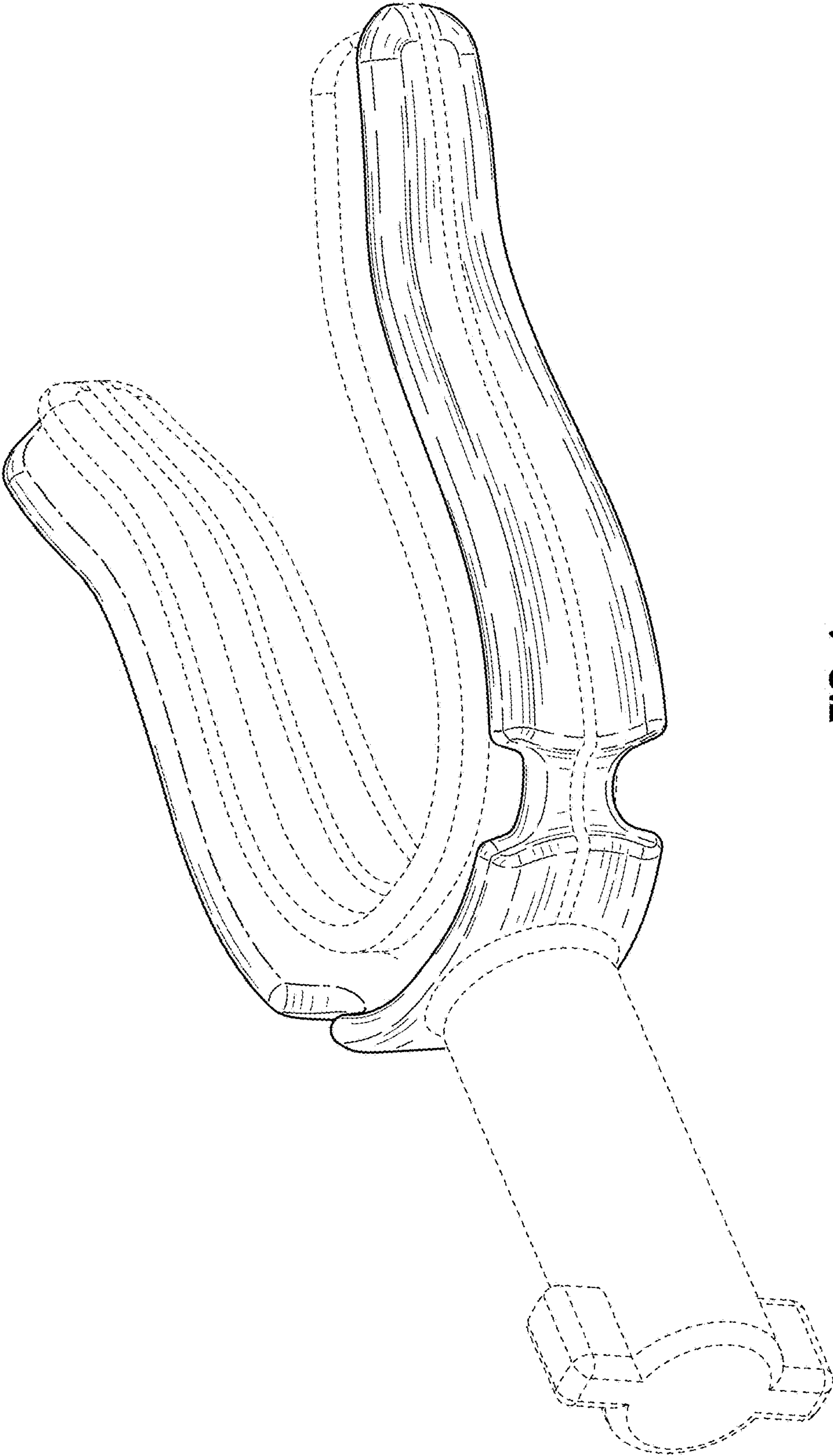

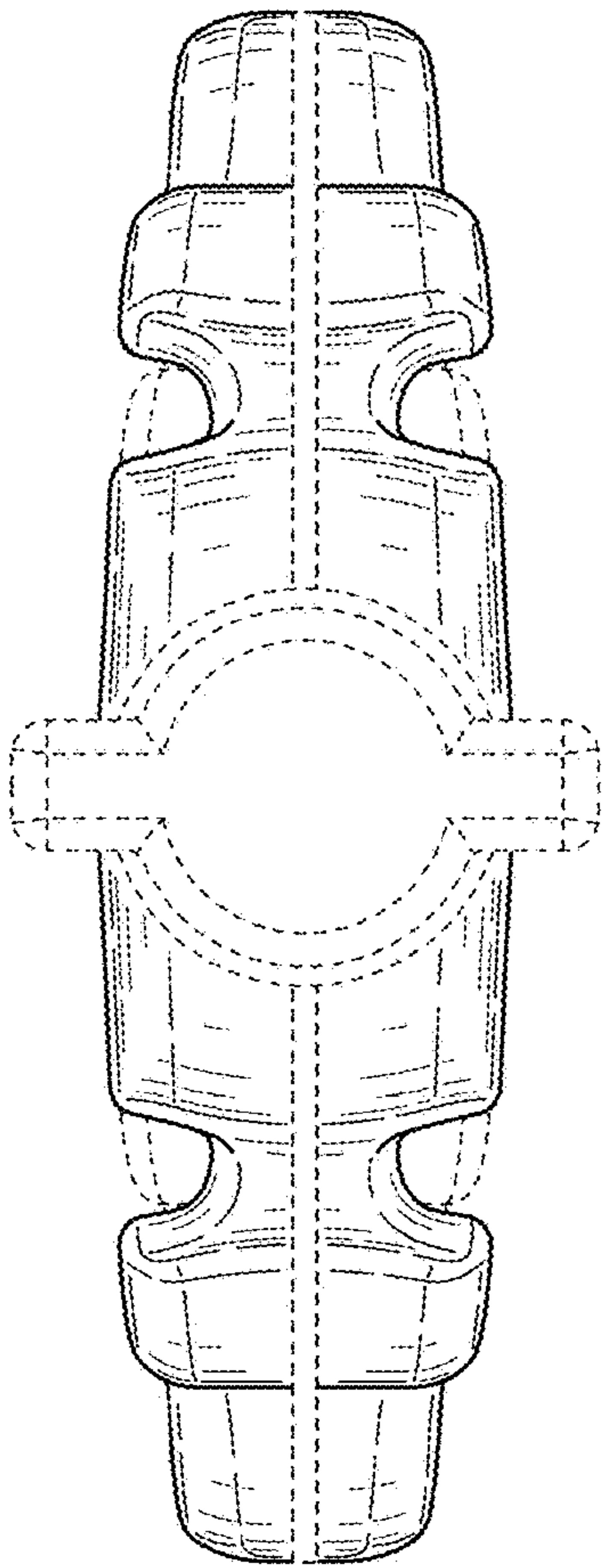

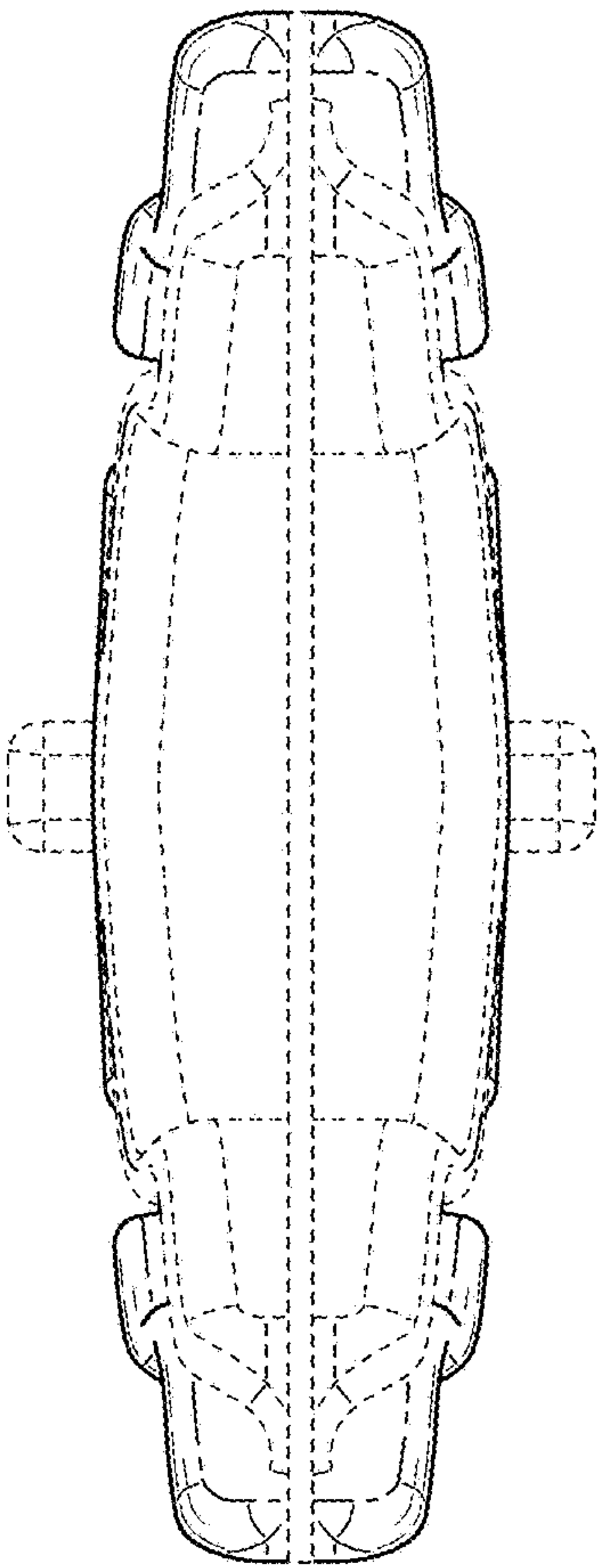

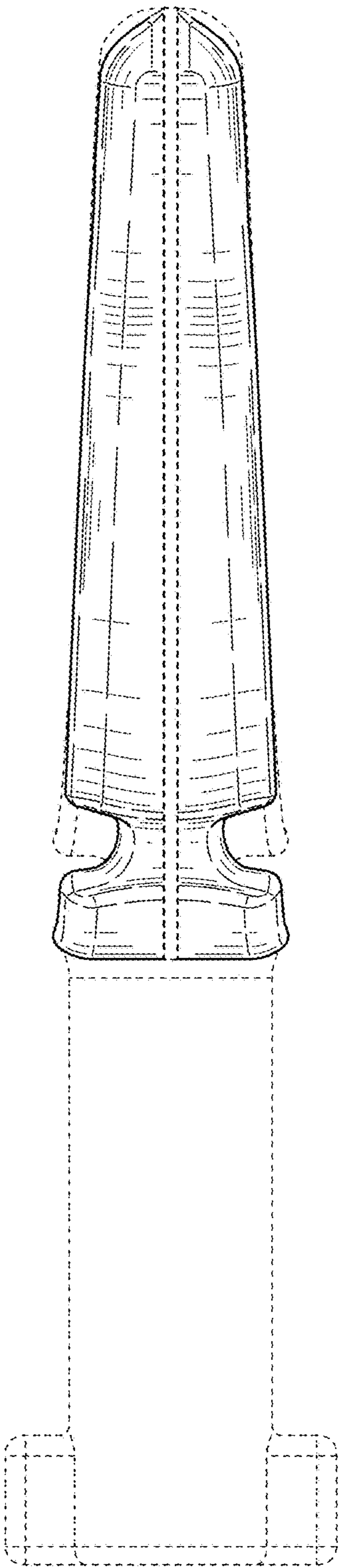

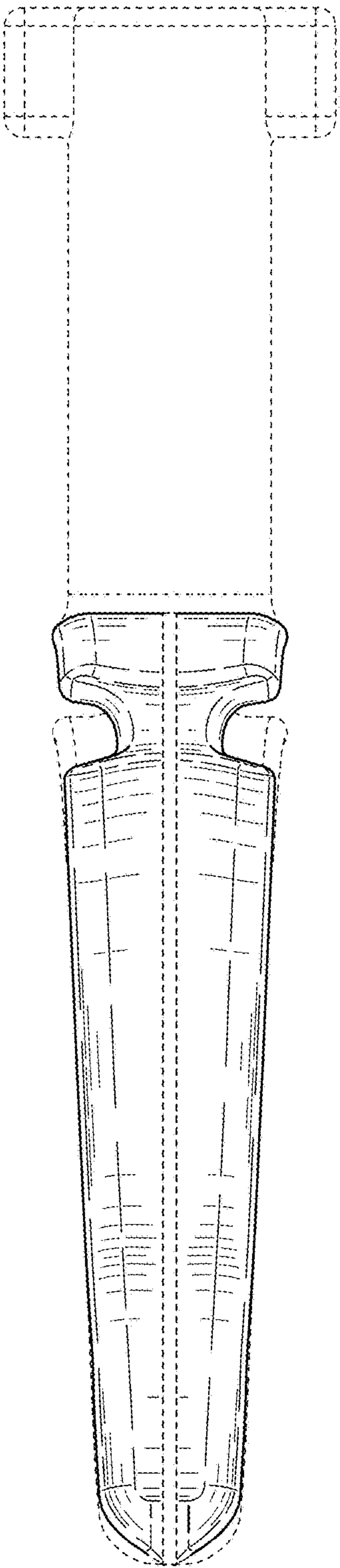

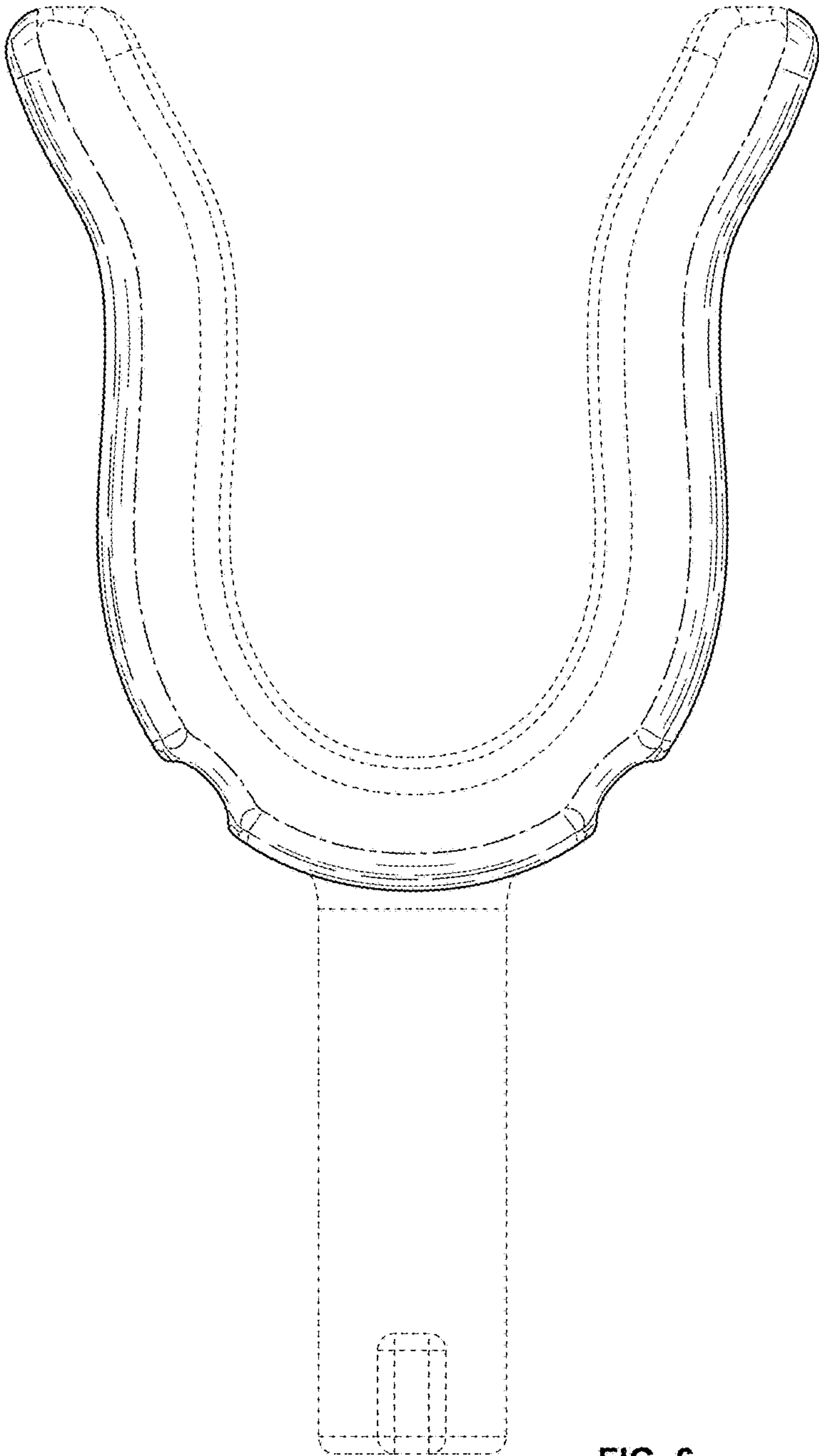

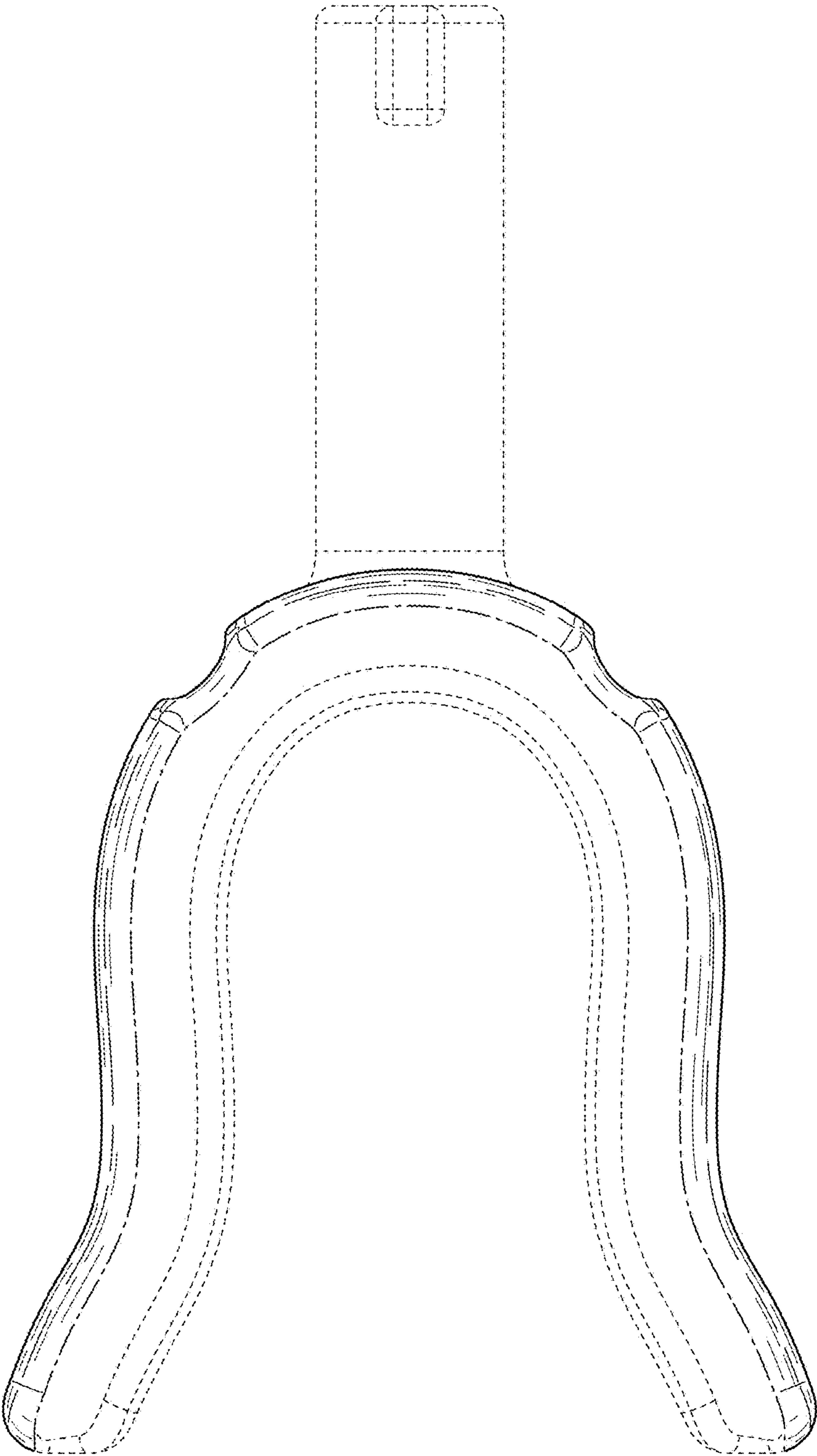
