(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a backpack with flip cover concealed zipper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right, top perspective view of a backpack with flip cover concealed zipper, illustrating the novel design.

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a back view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a top view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is an alternative view of the front, right, top perspective view thereof, with the flip cover opened, exposing the zipper, illustrating the novel design in detail.

The broken lines in the drawings depict unclaimed portions of the backpack with flip cover concealed zipper only and form no part of the claimed design. The fabric pattern is fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration. It is understood that the fabric pattern is uniformly continuous over the surface of the backpack with flip cover concealed zipper and forms no part of the claimed design.

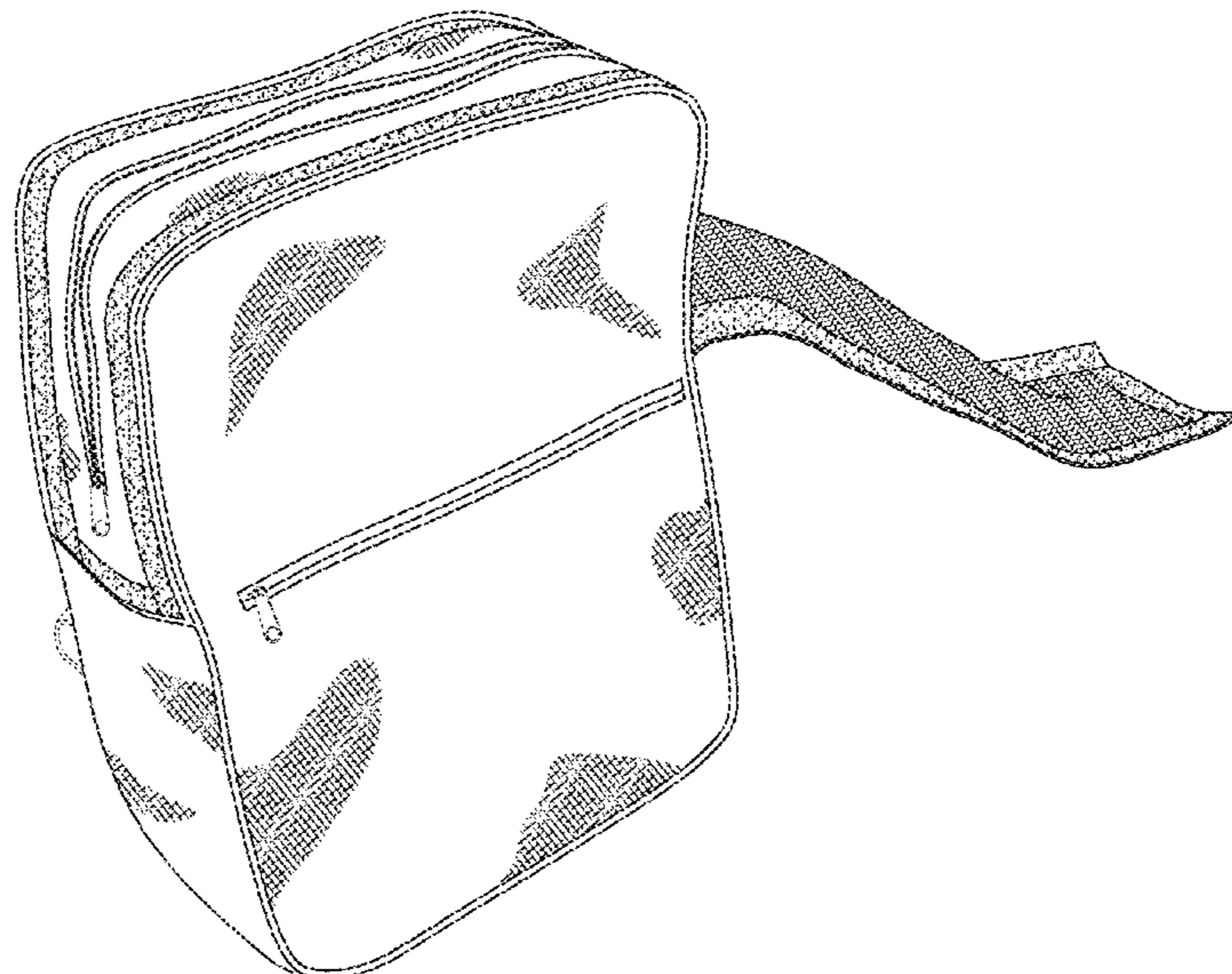

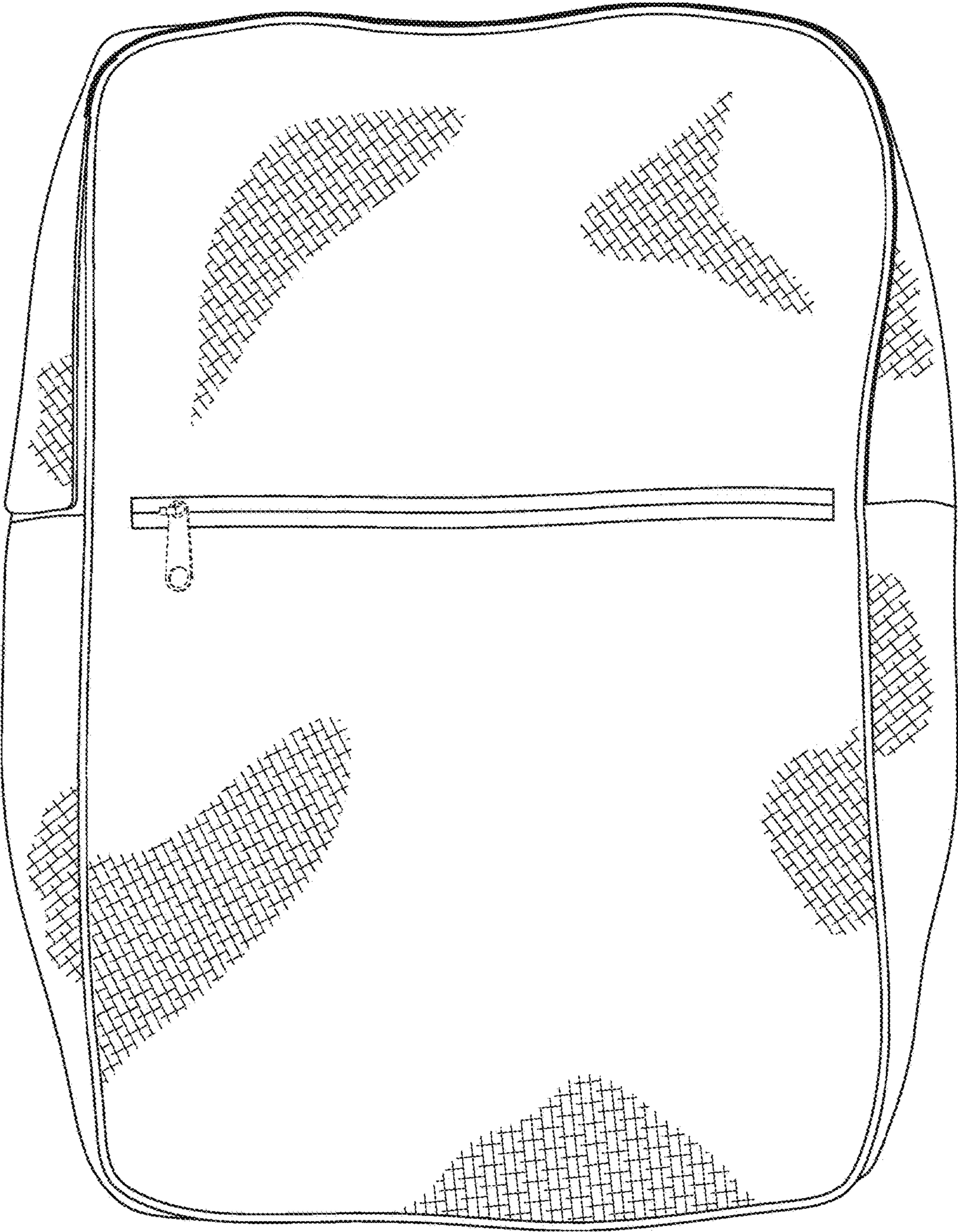

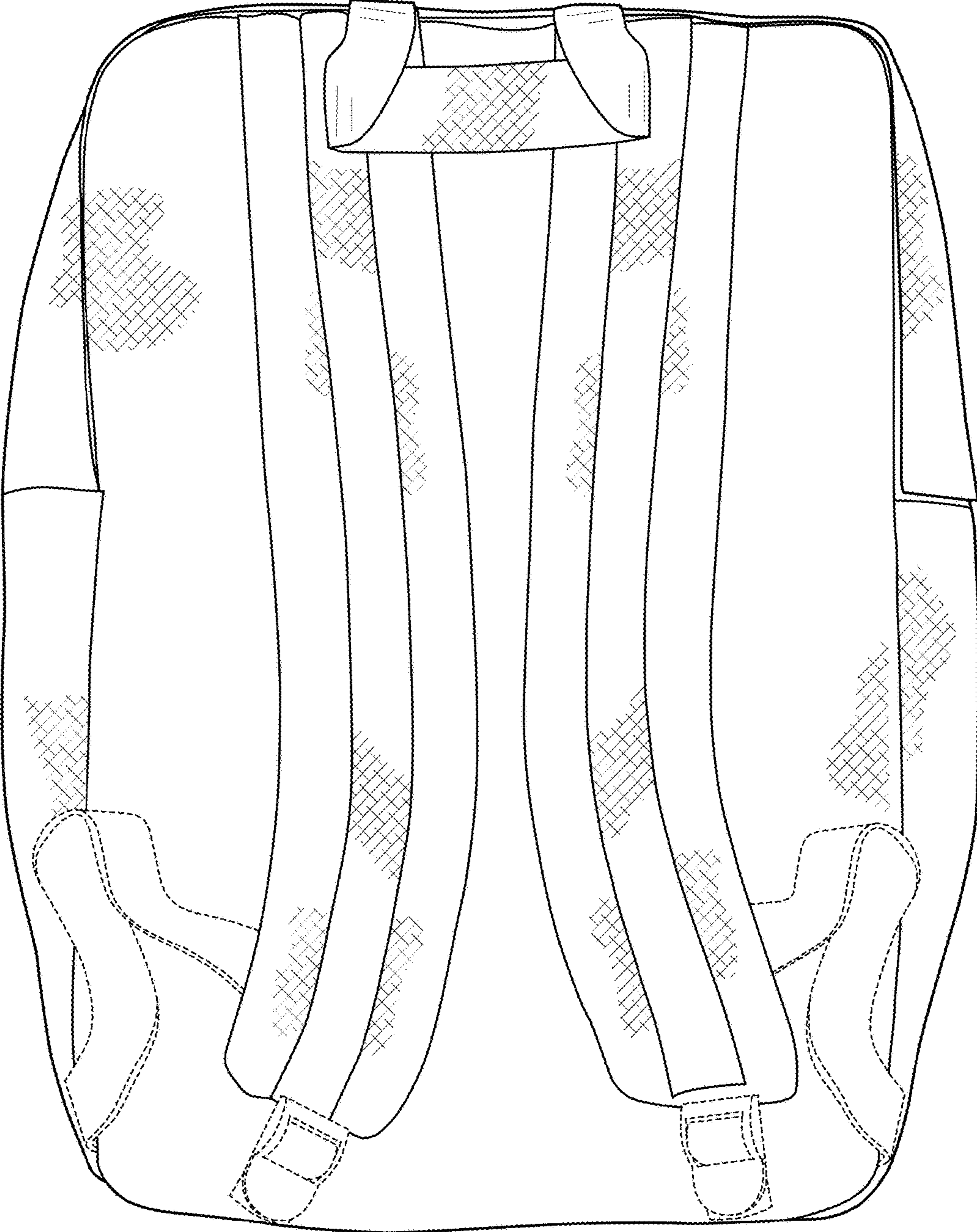

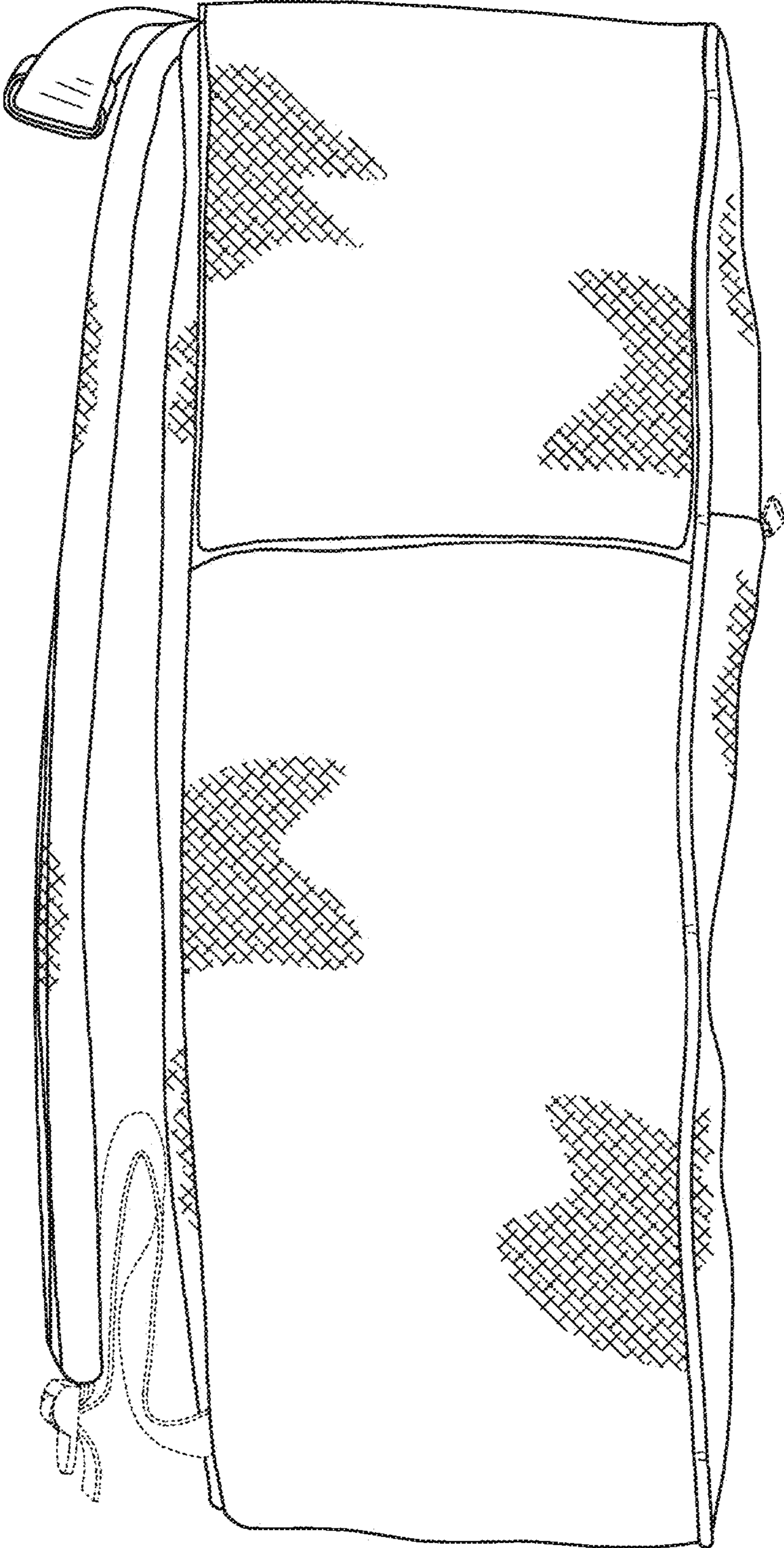

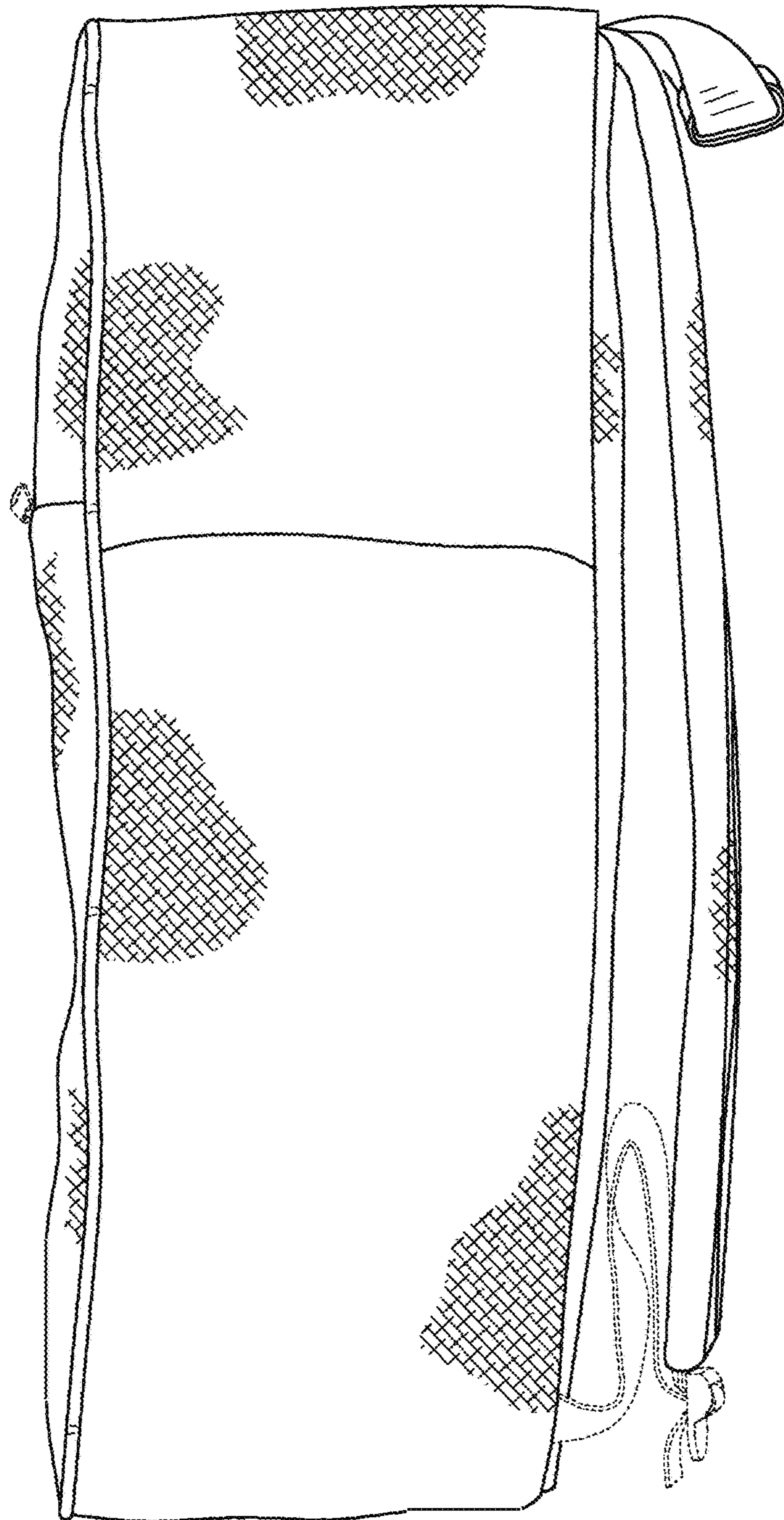

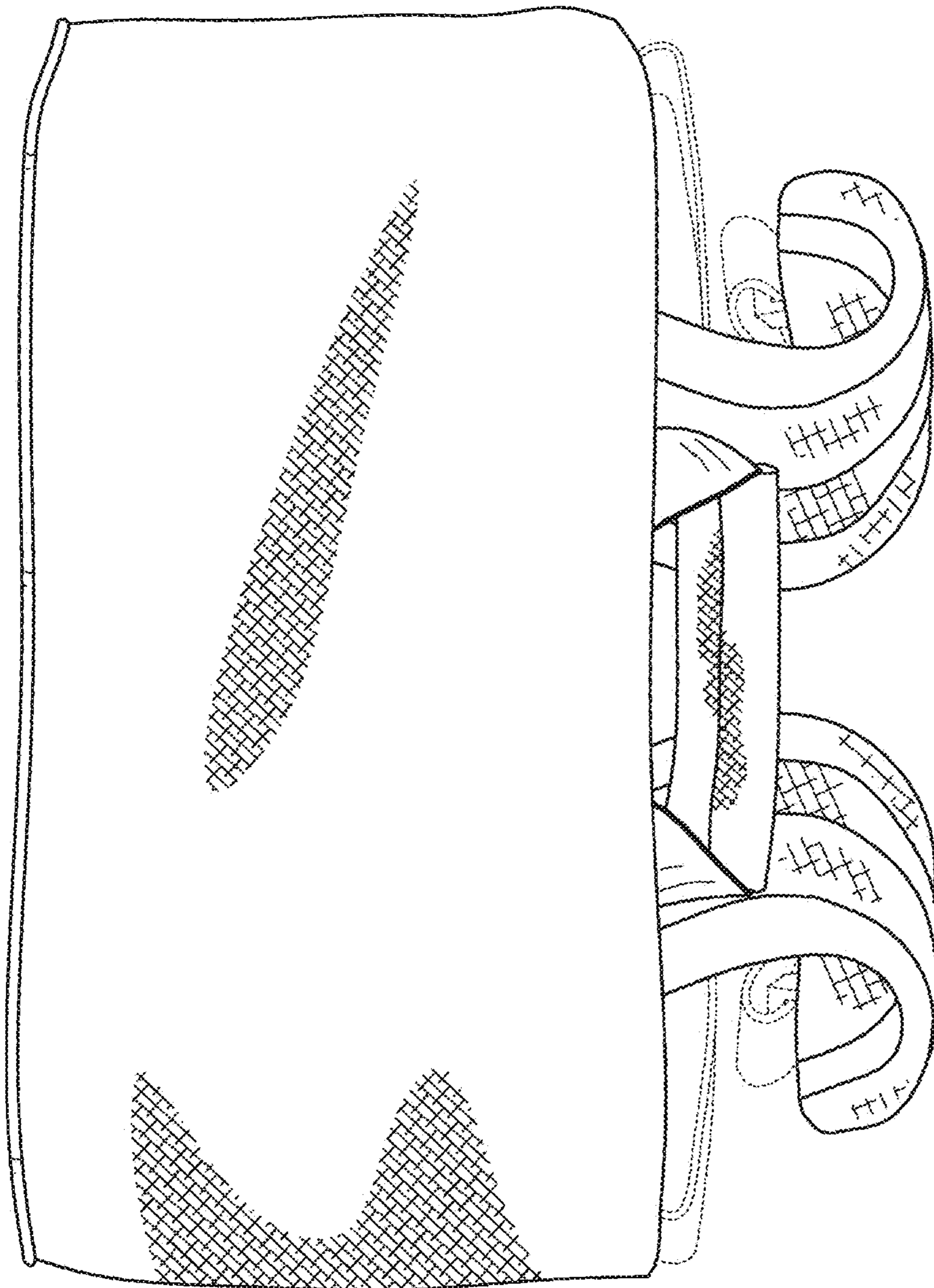

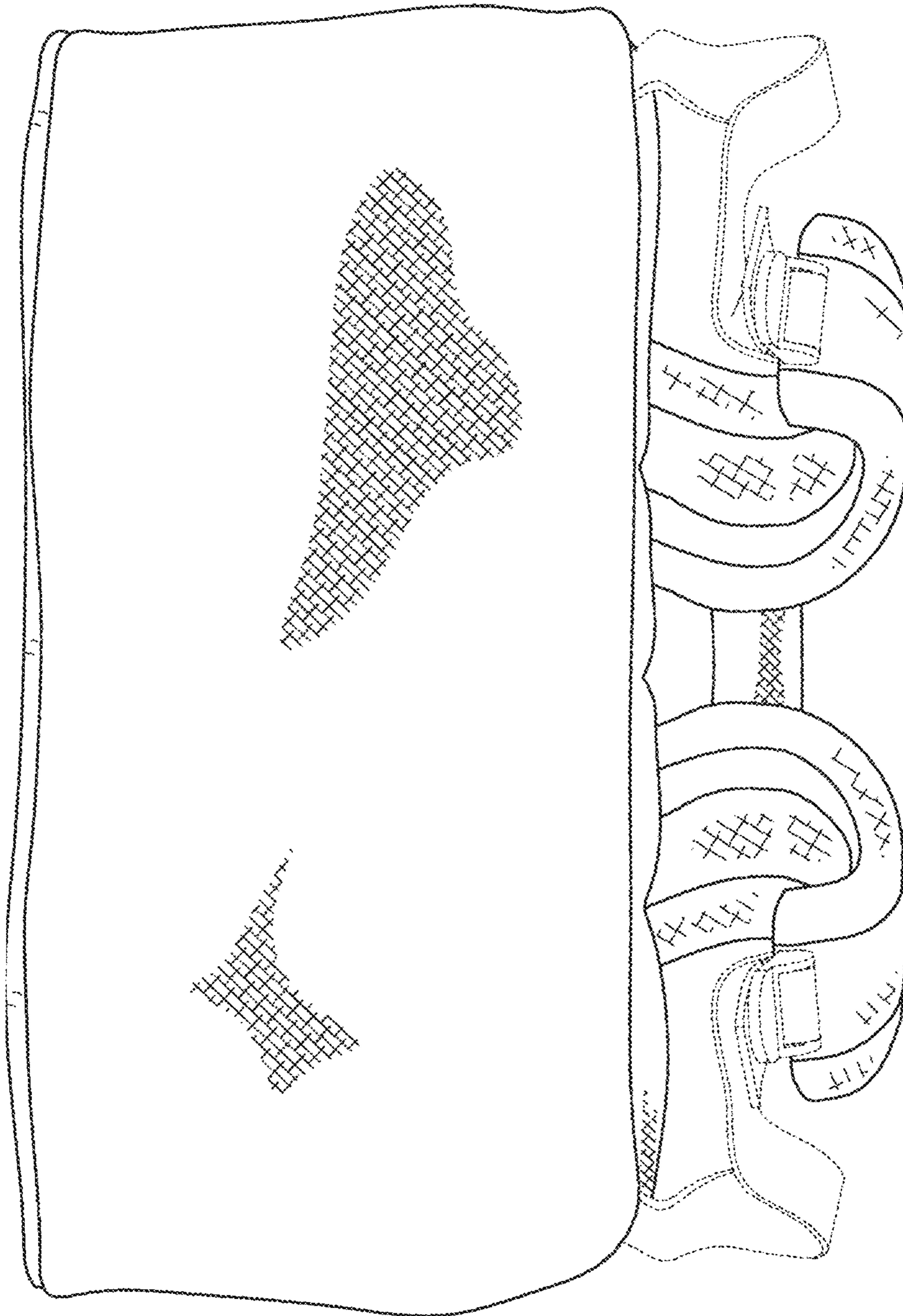

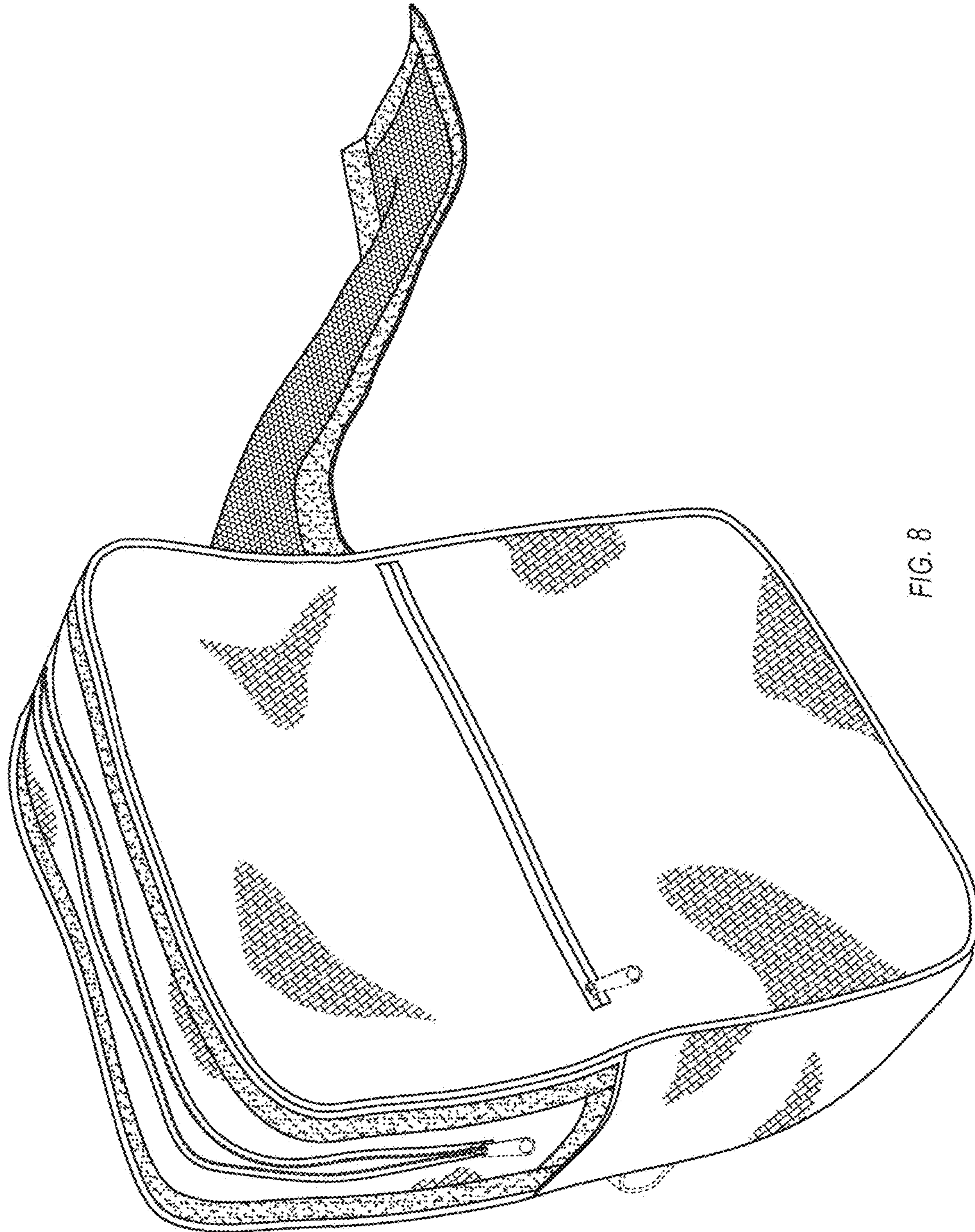
