FIG. 13 is a front, bottom, right perspective view thereof;

FIG. 14 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a partially enlarged front, top, right perspective view thereof along the lines 15-15 of FIG. 12;

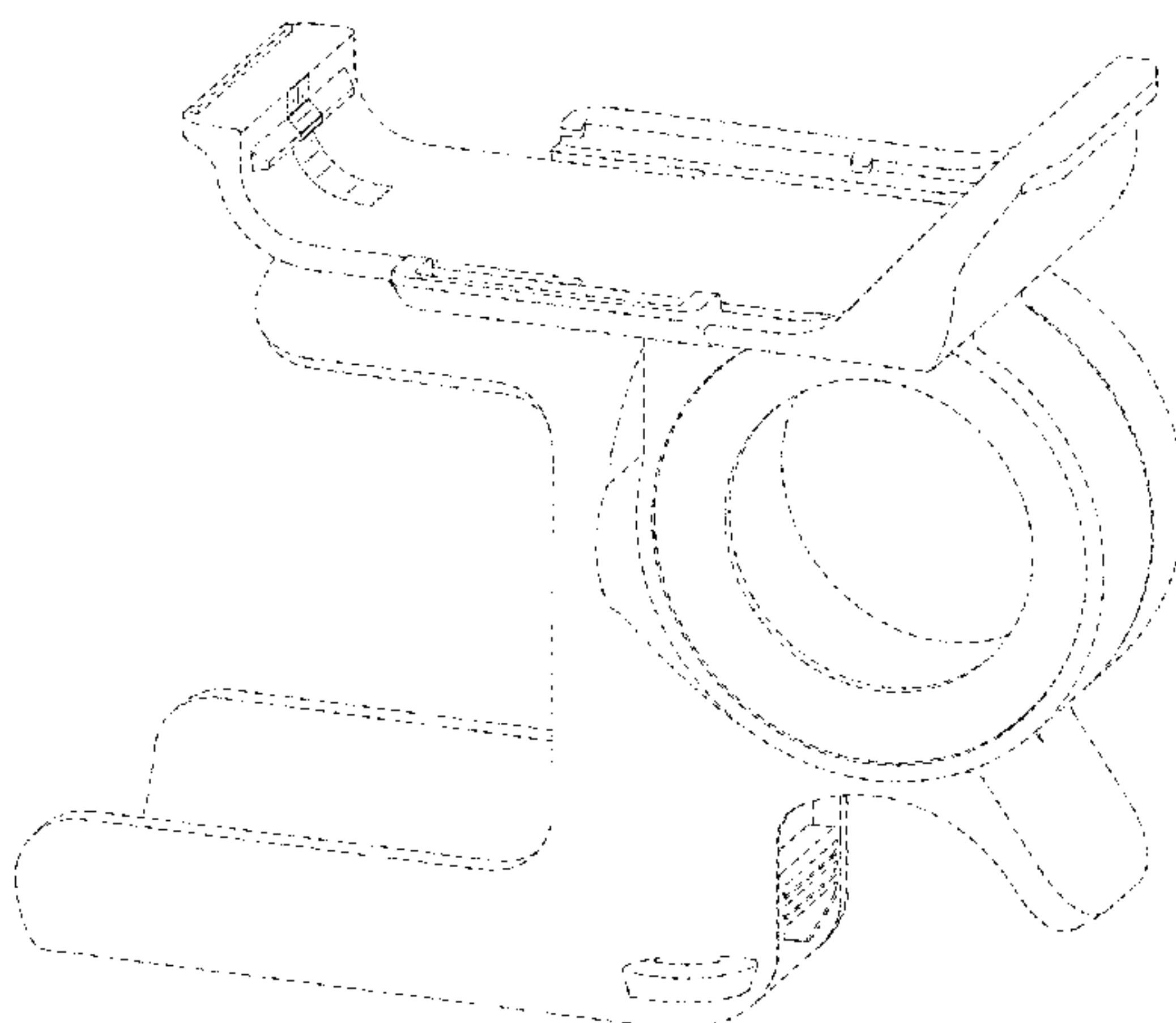
FIG. 16 is a partially enlarged front, bottom, left perspective view thereof along the lines 16-16 of FIG. 13;

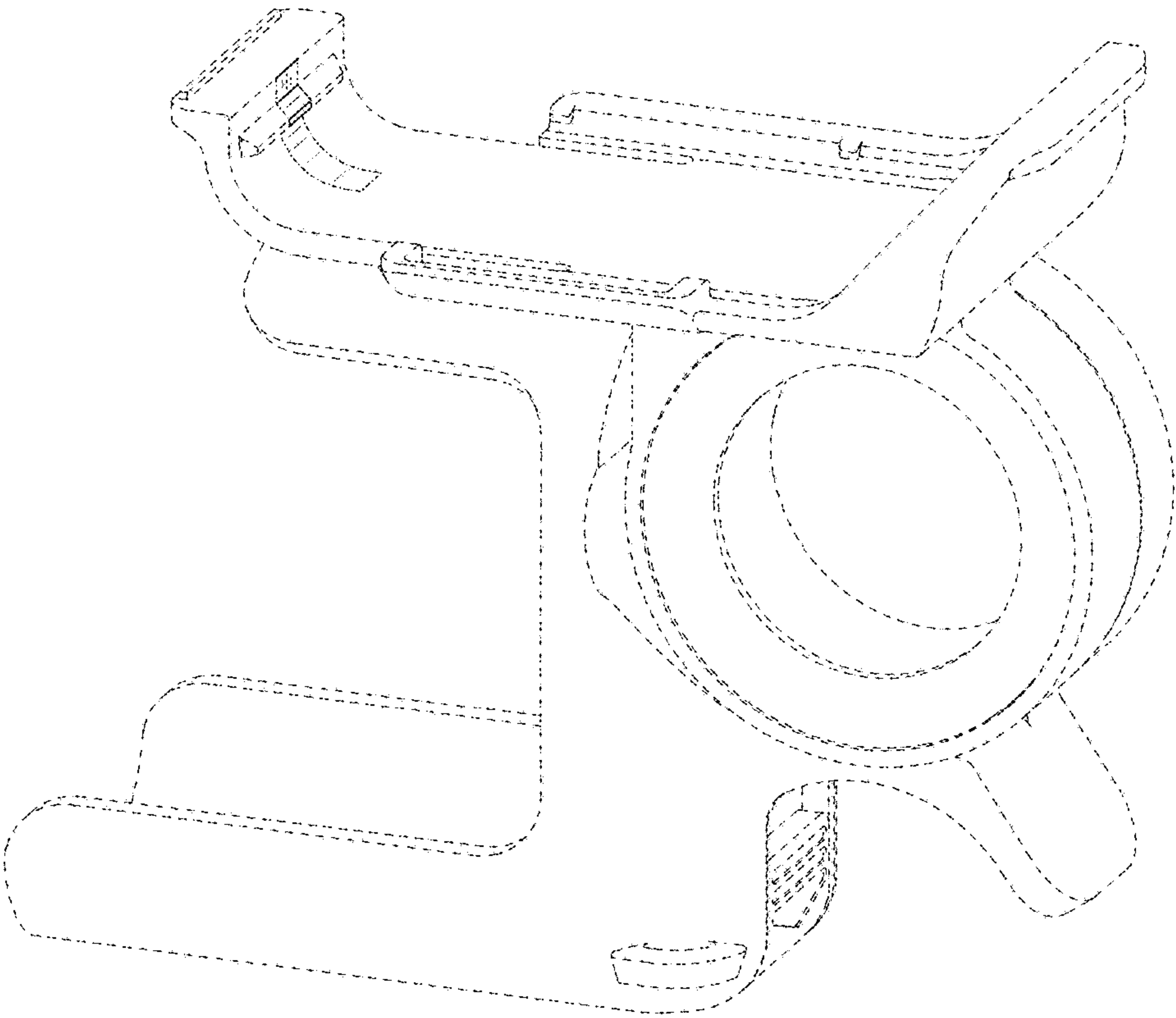

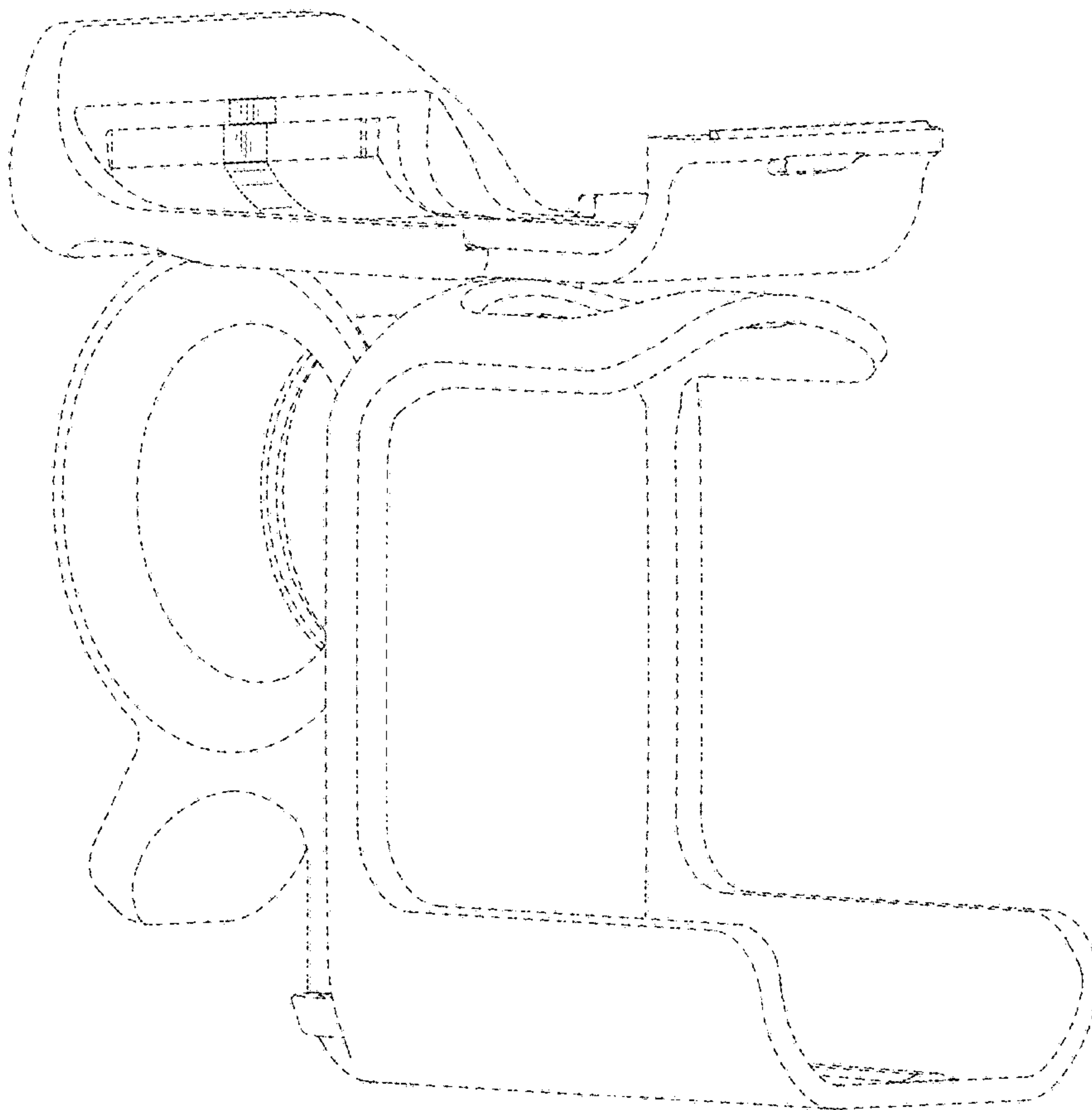

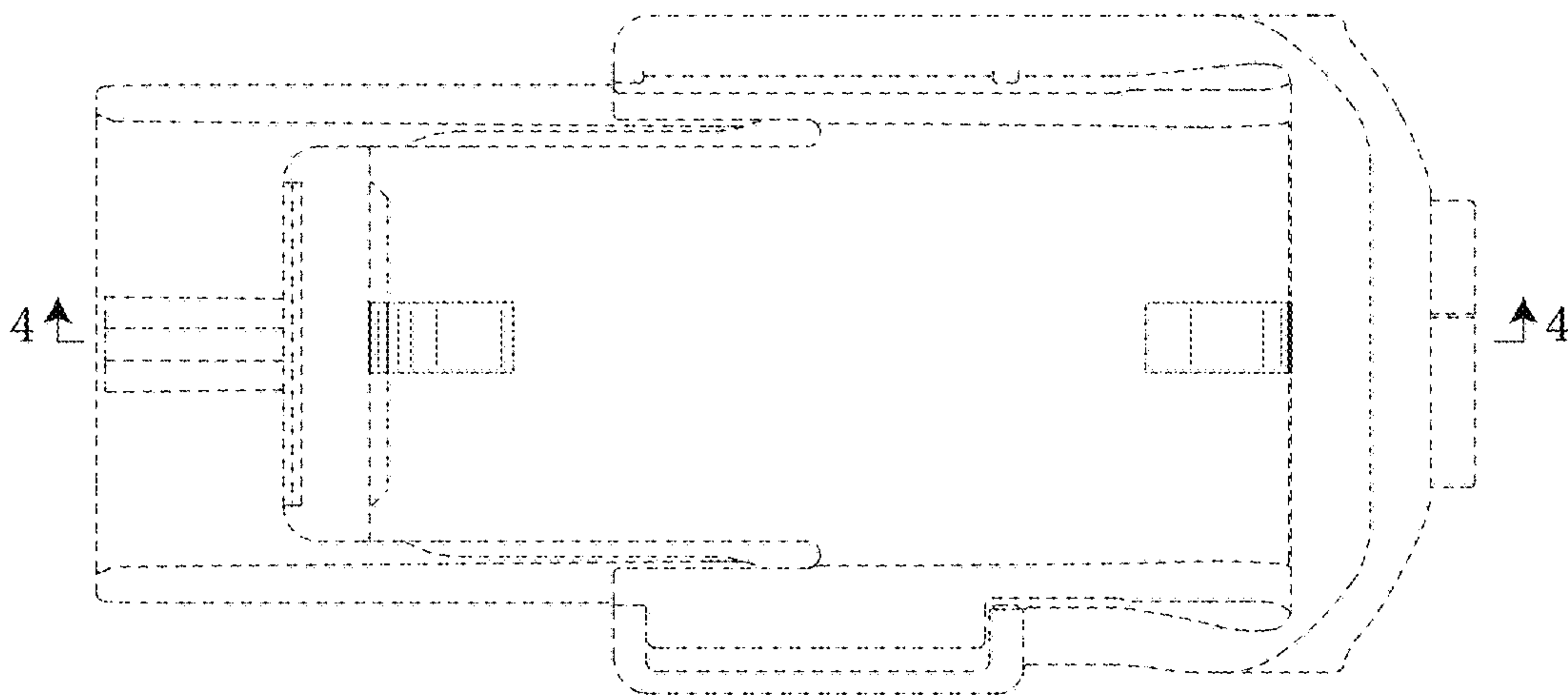

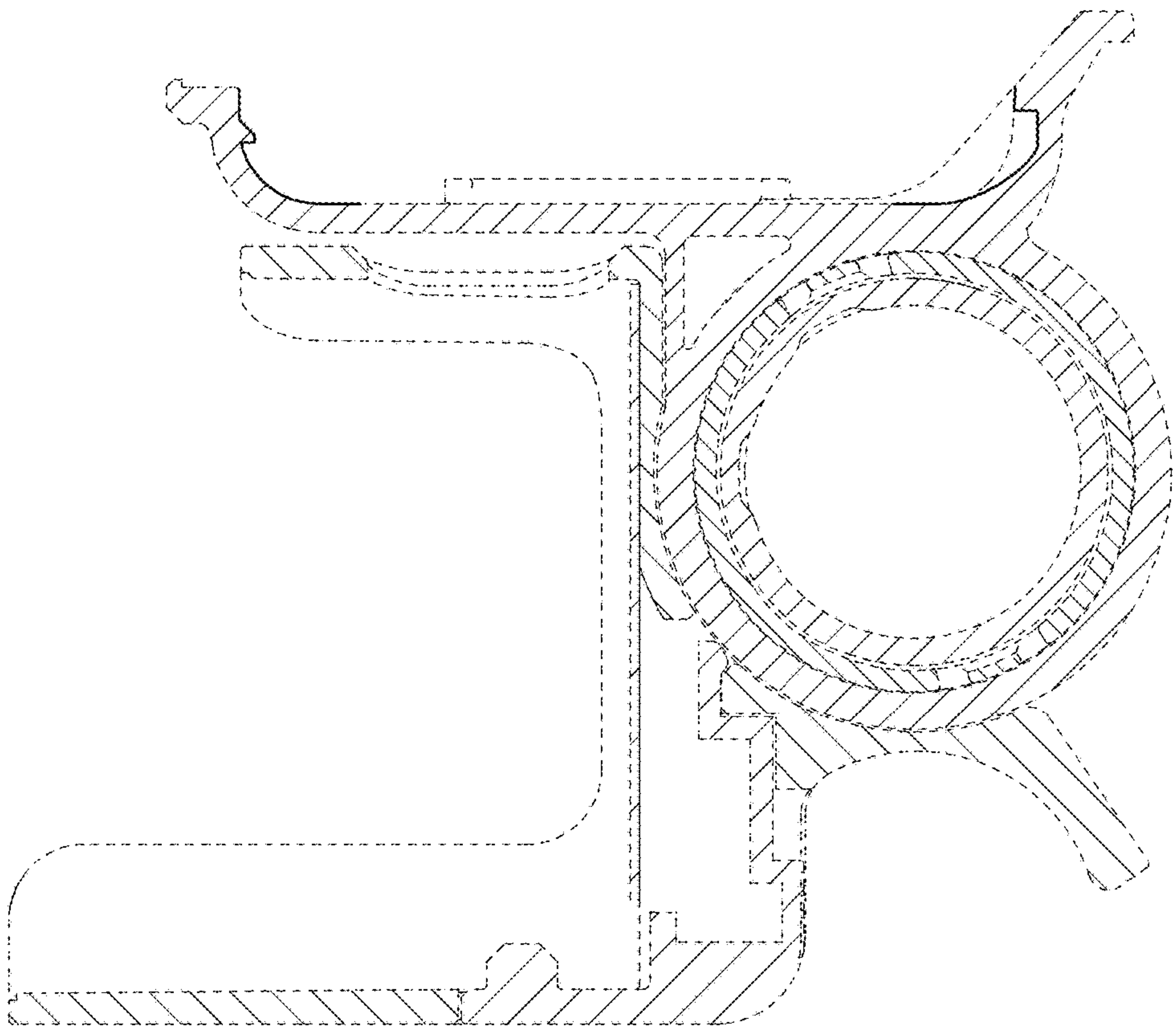

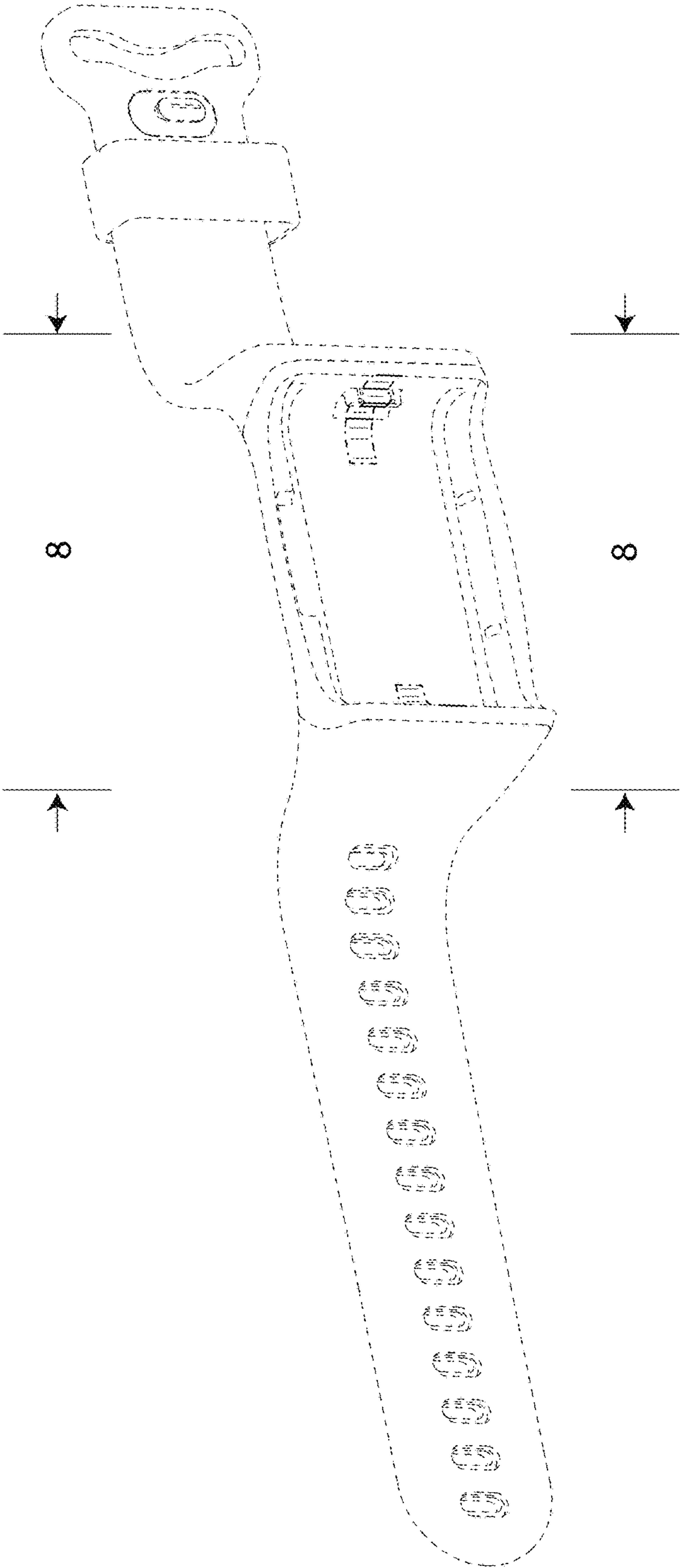

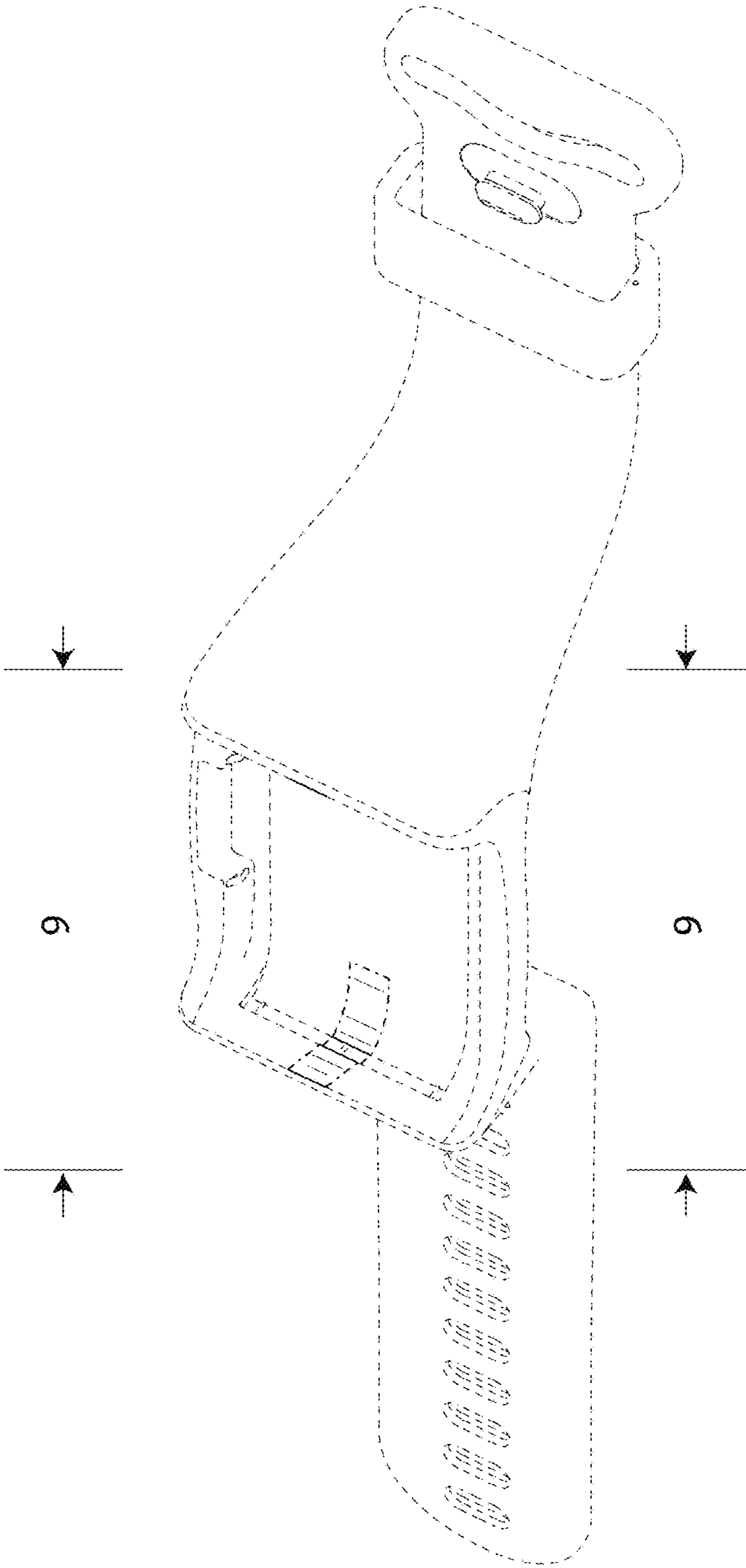
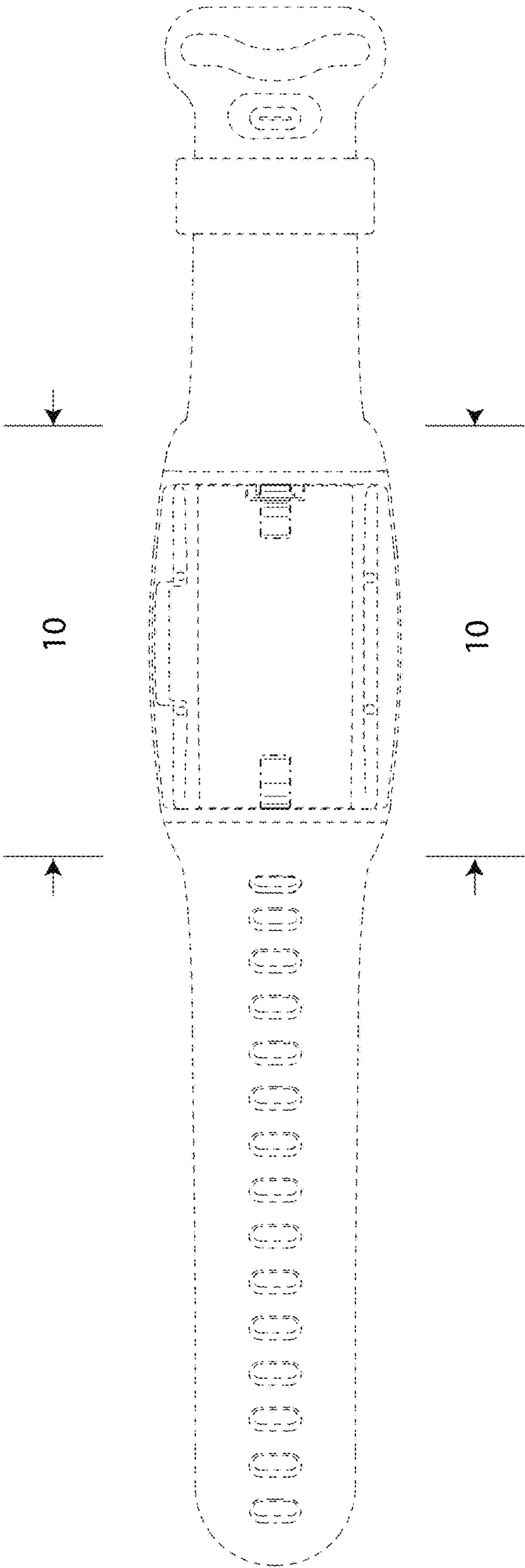

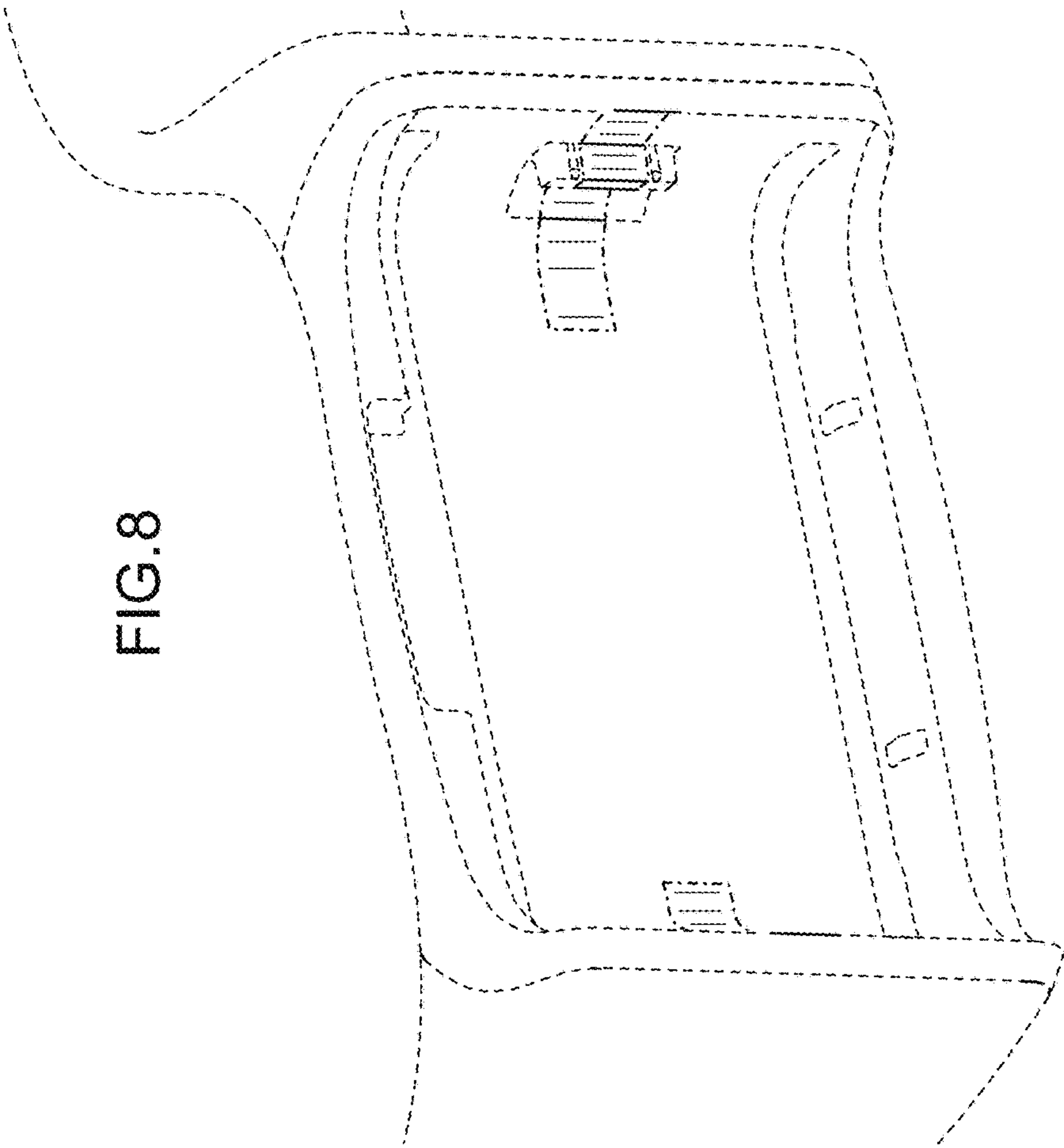

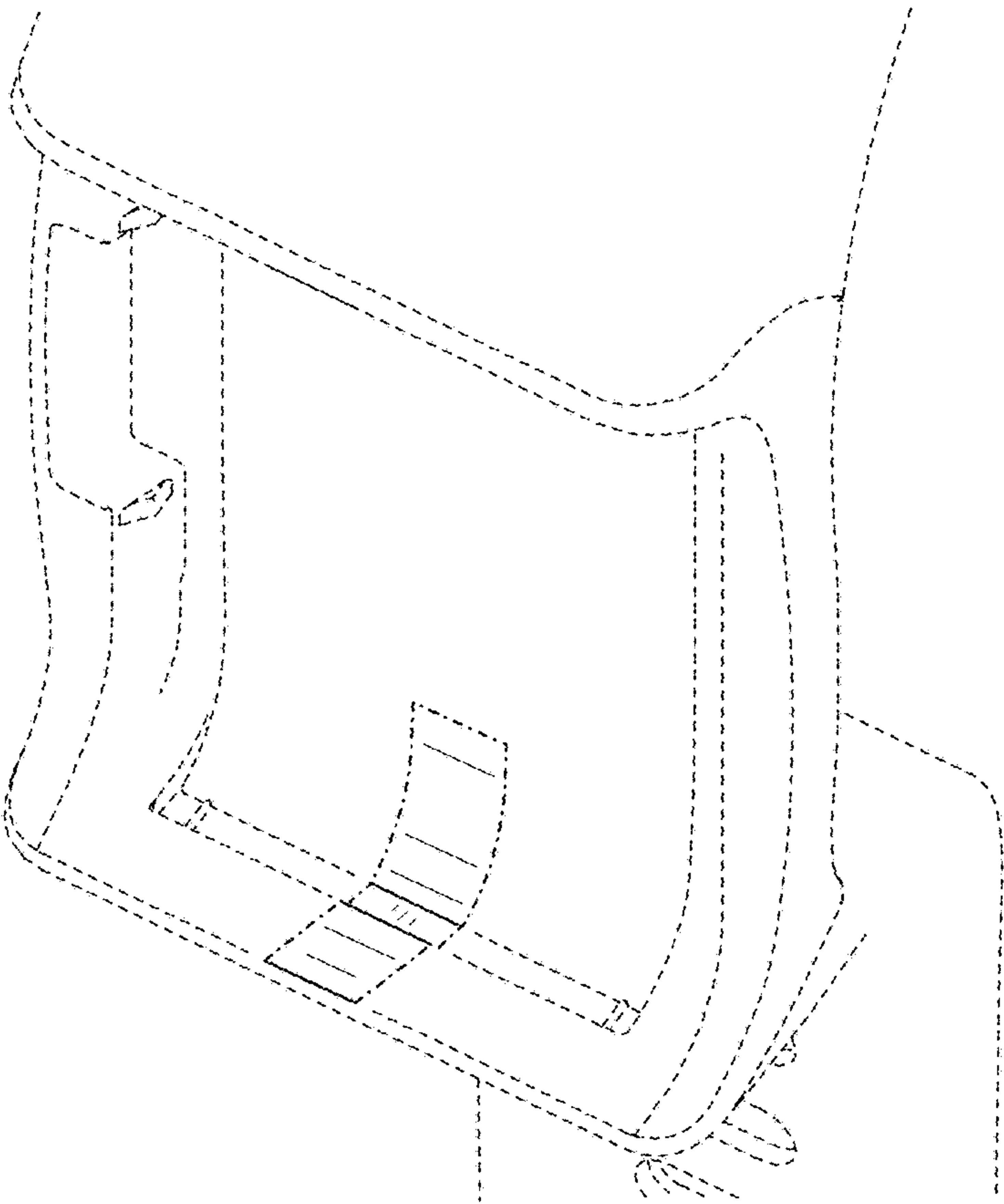

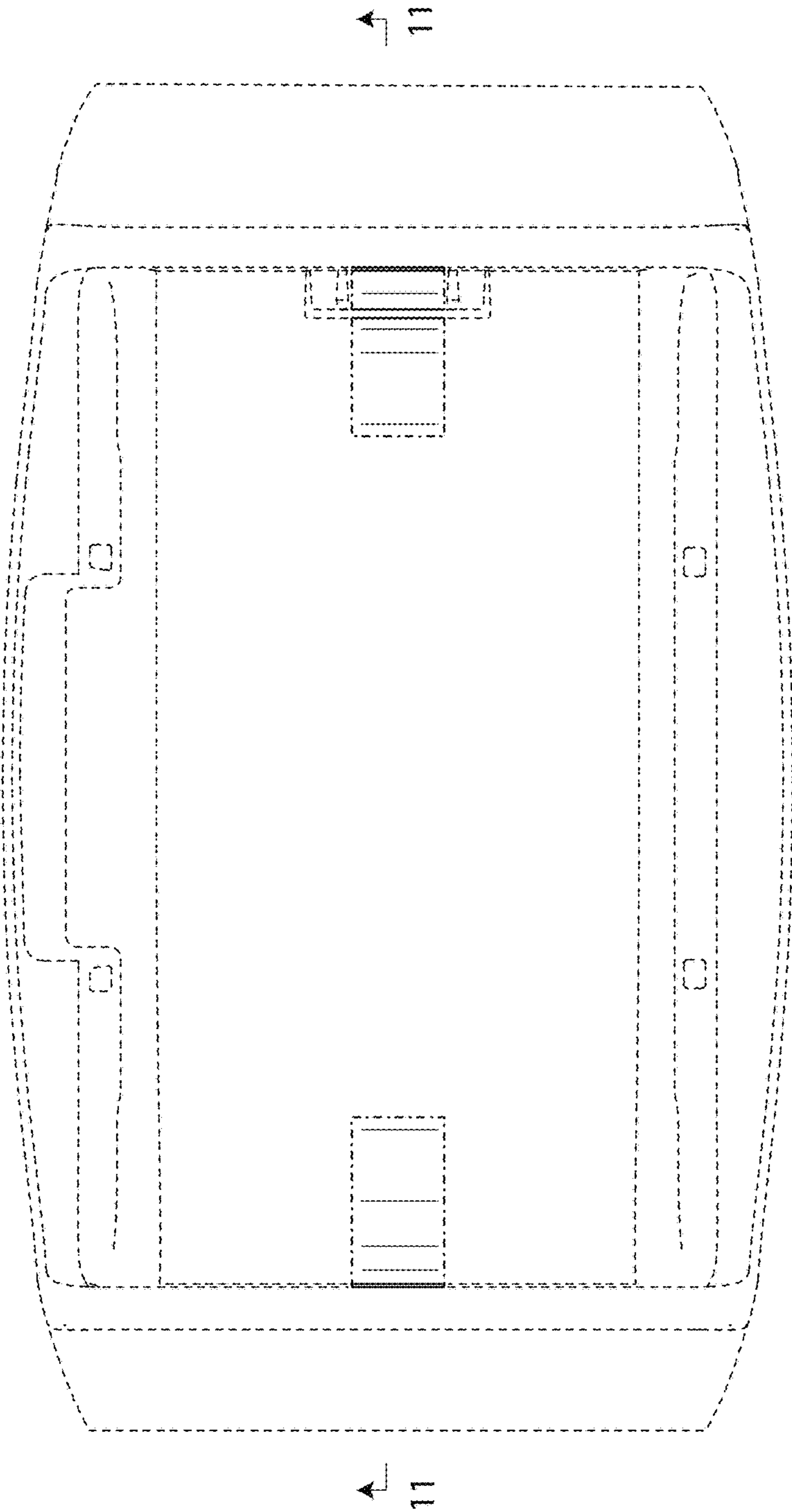

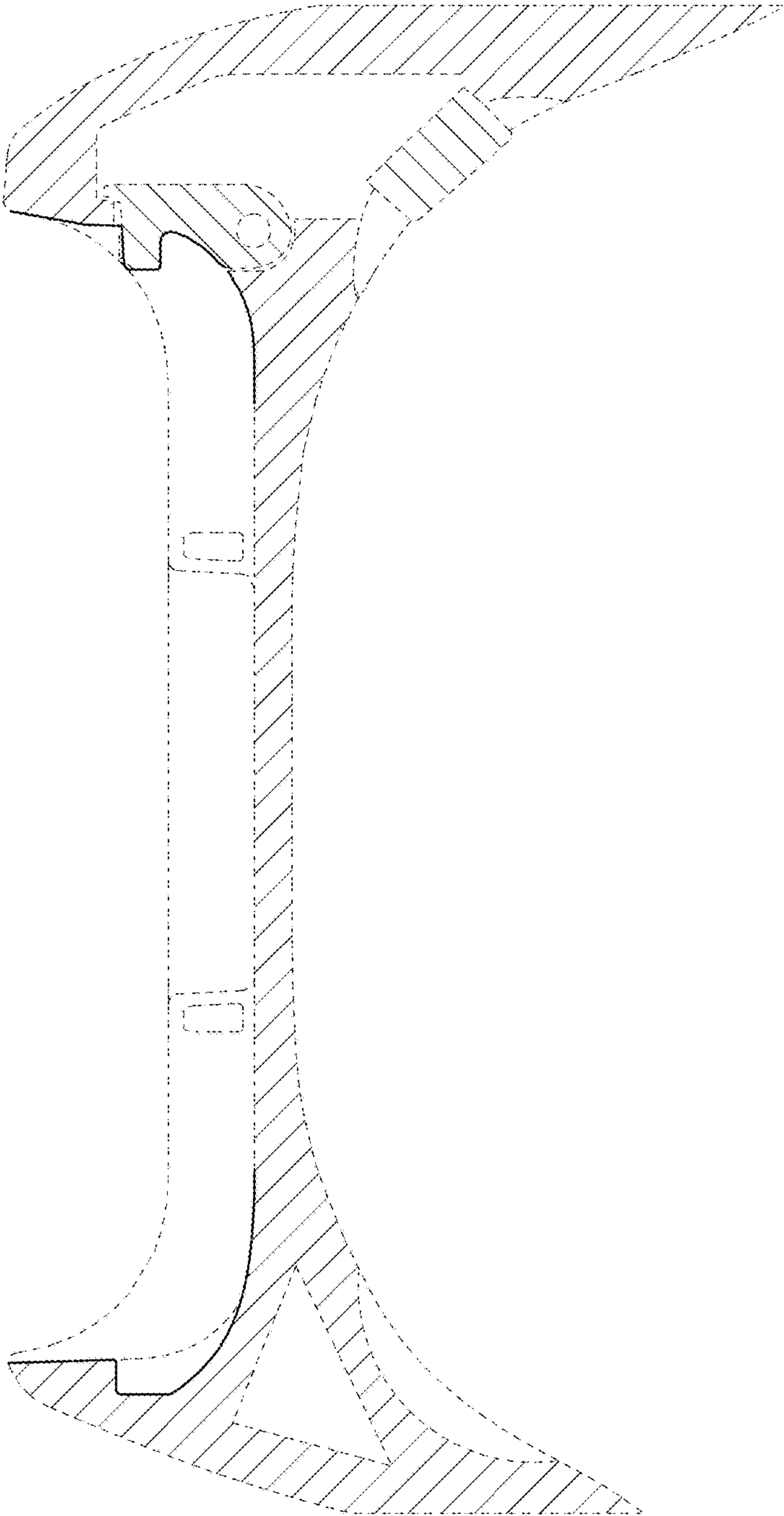

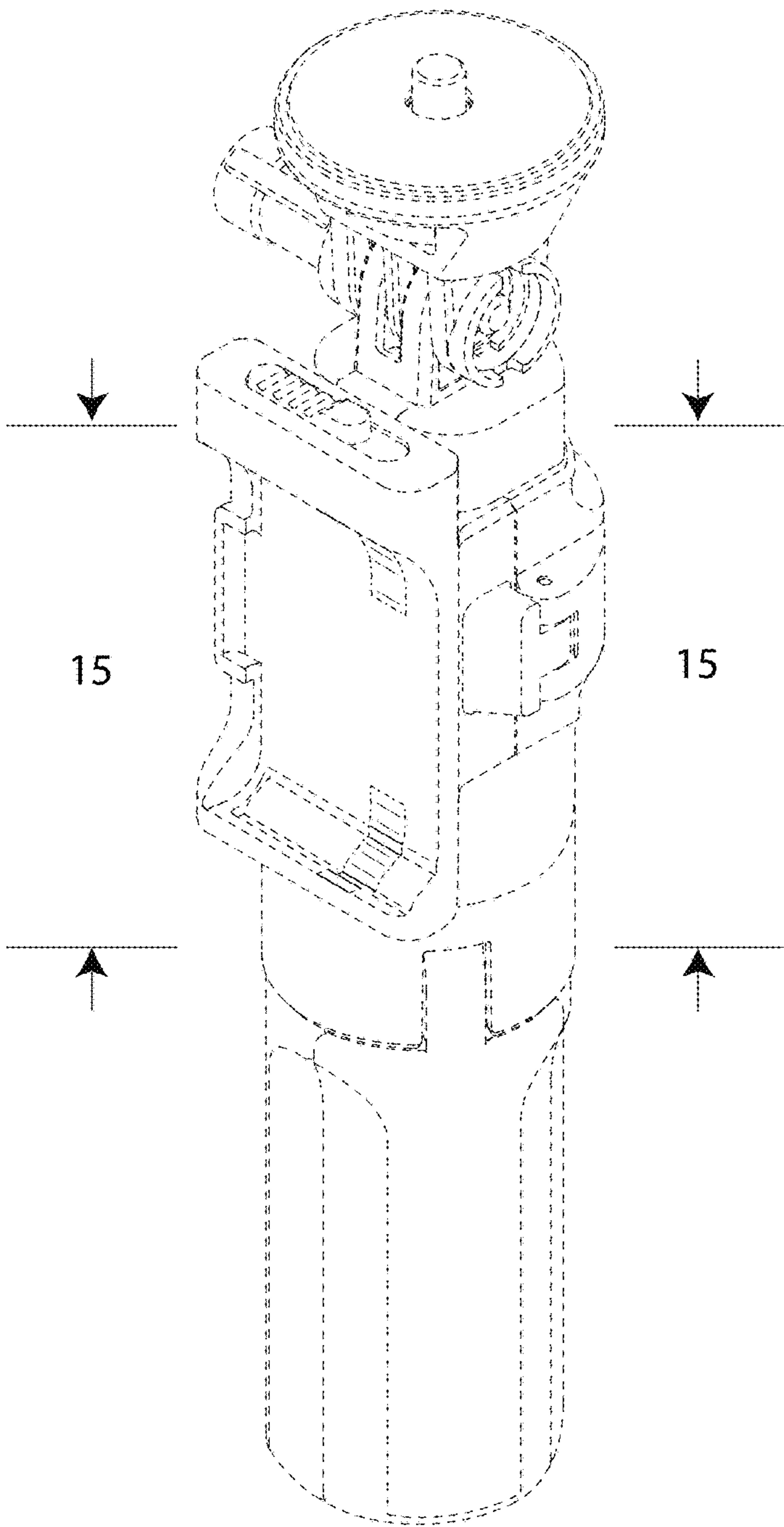

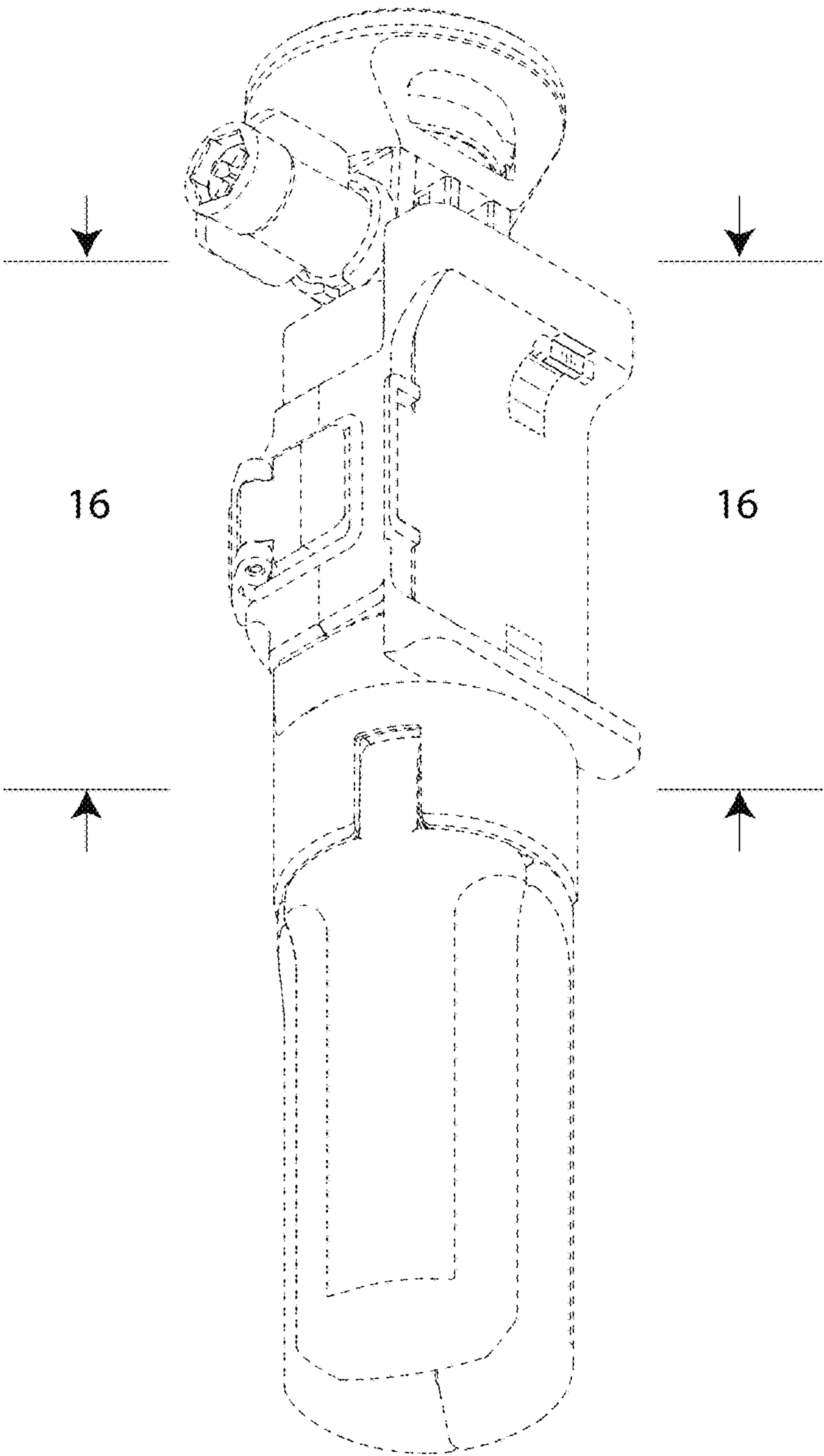

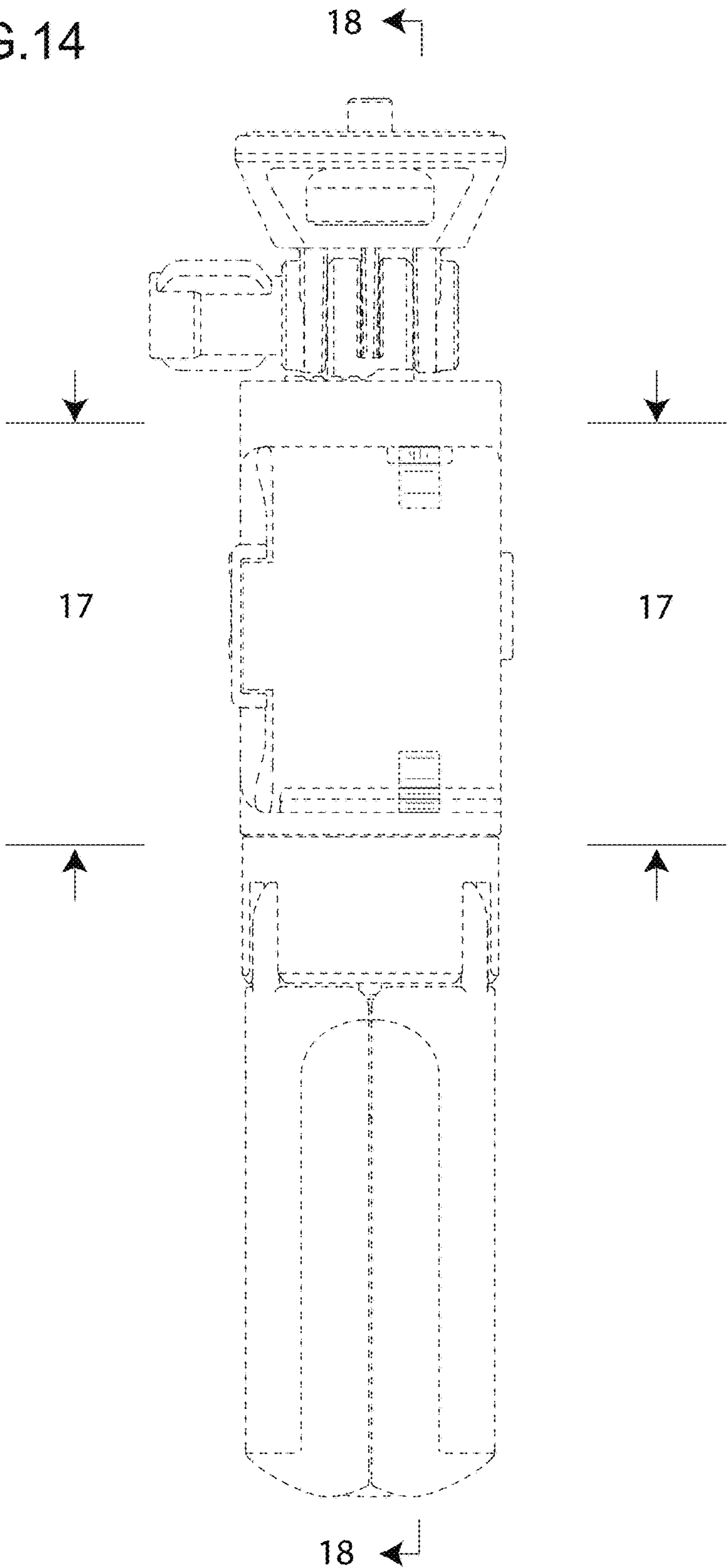

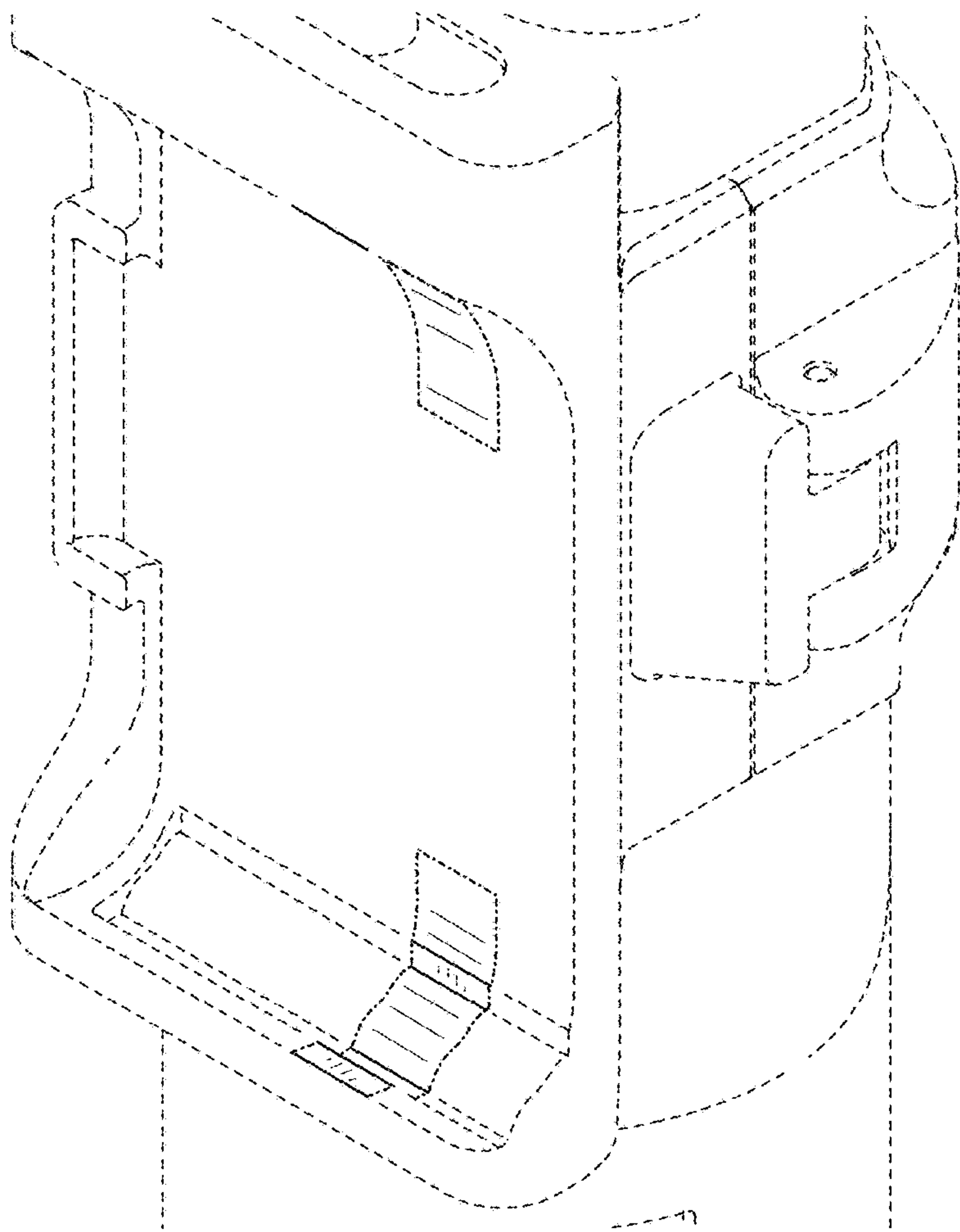

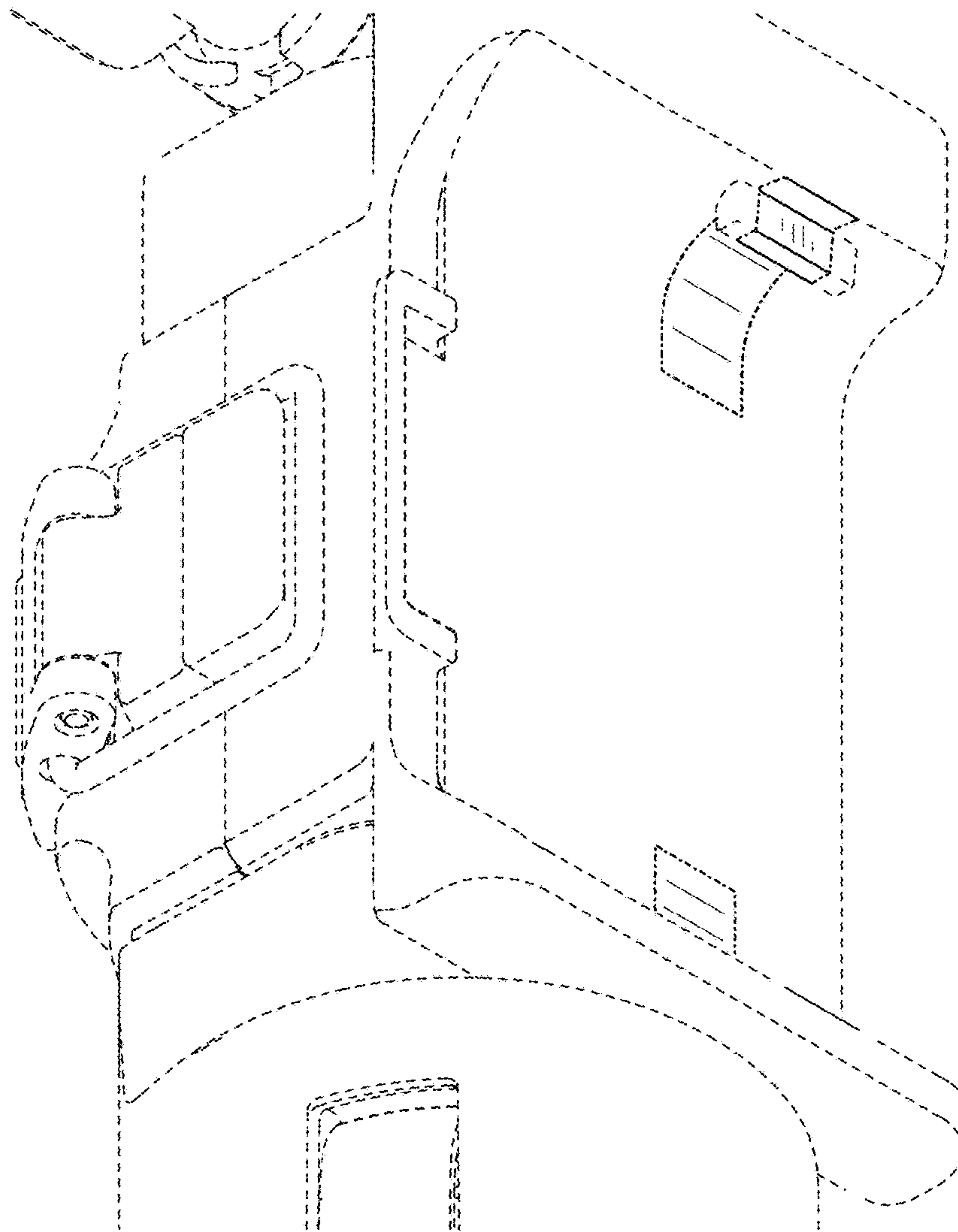

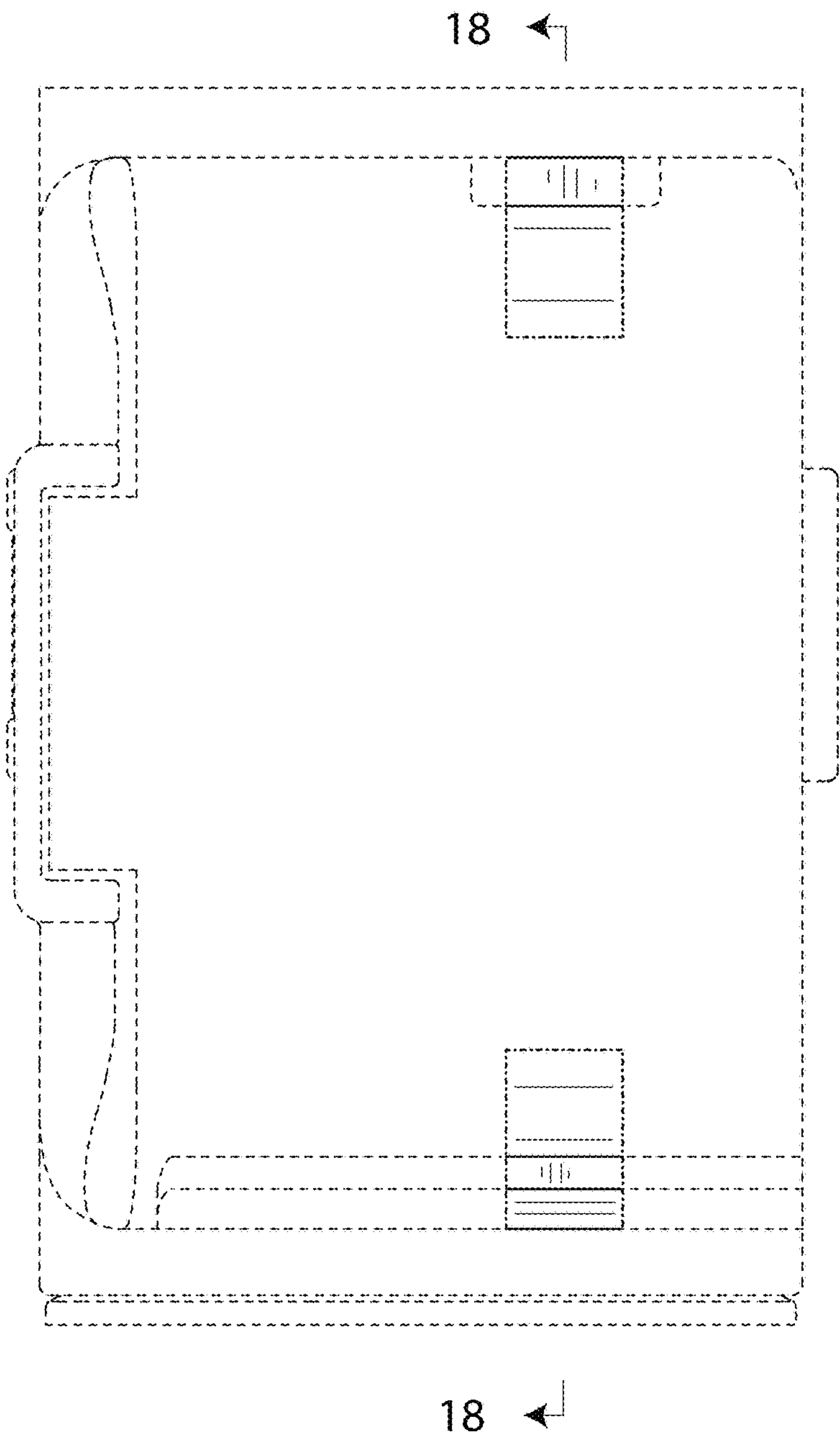
