**DESCRIPTION**

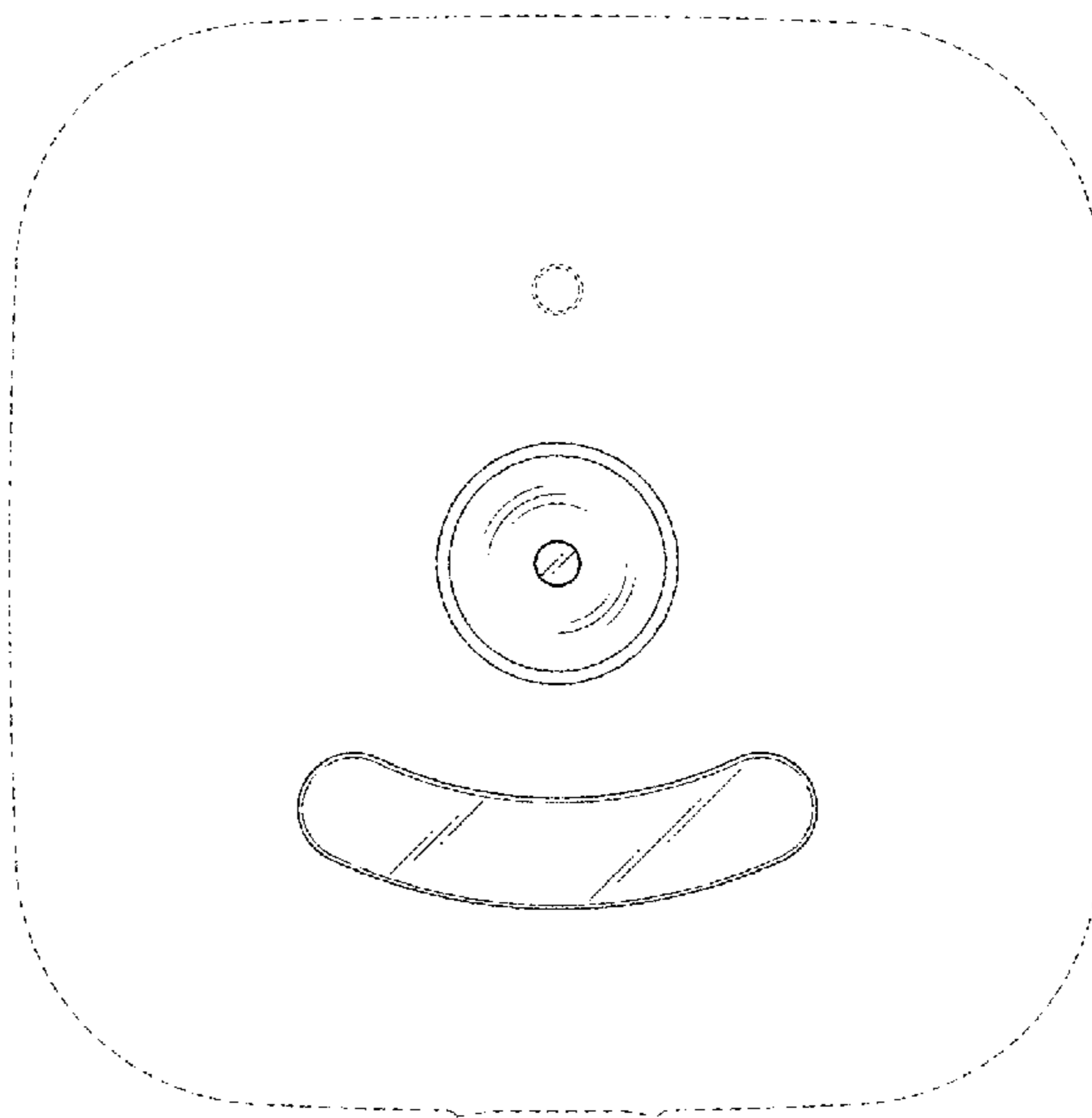
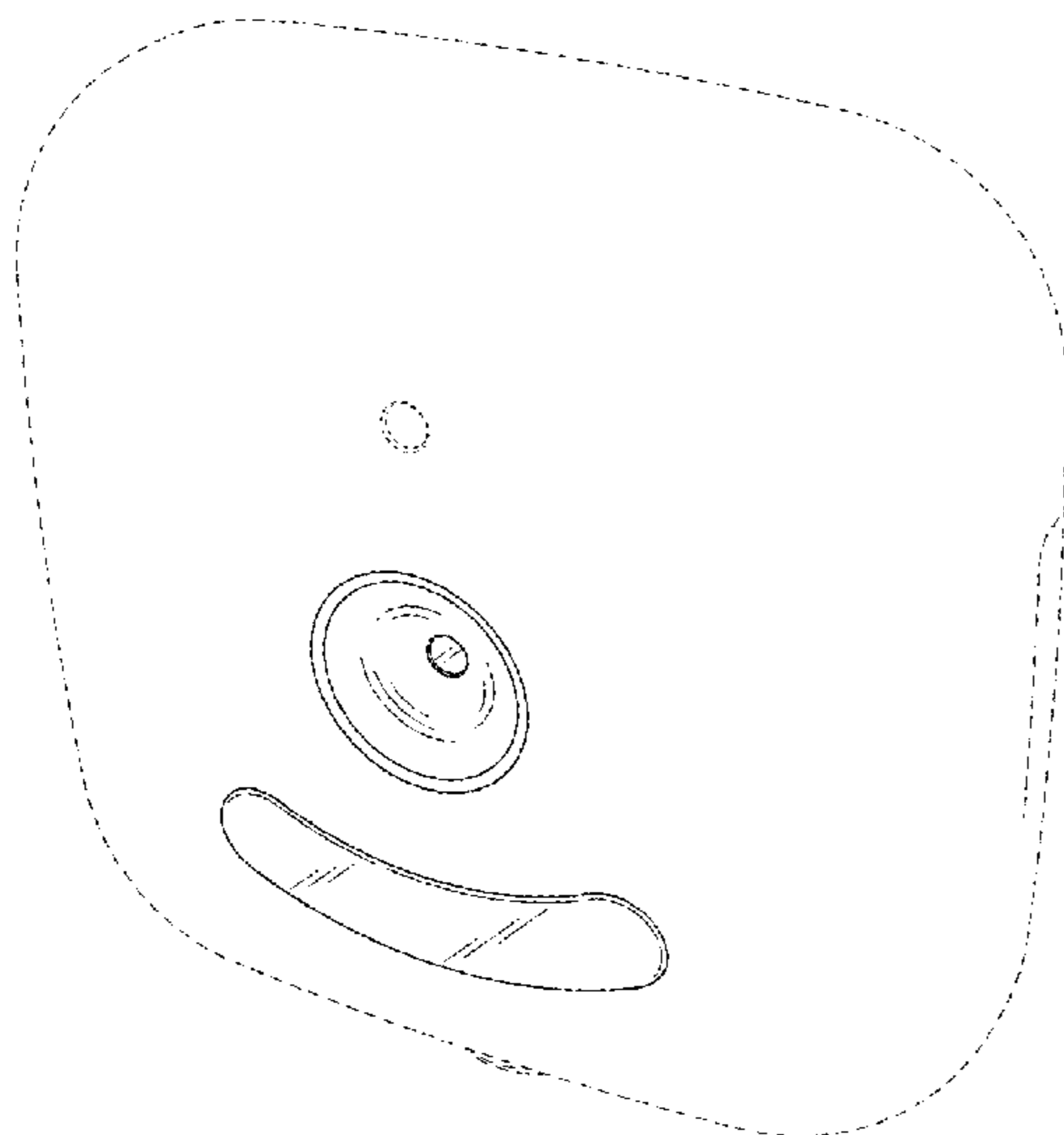
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a biological information sensor;

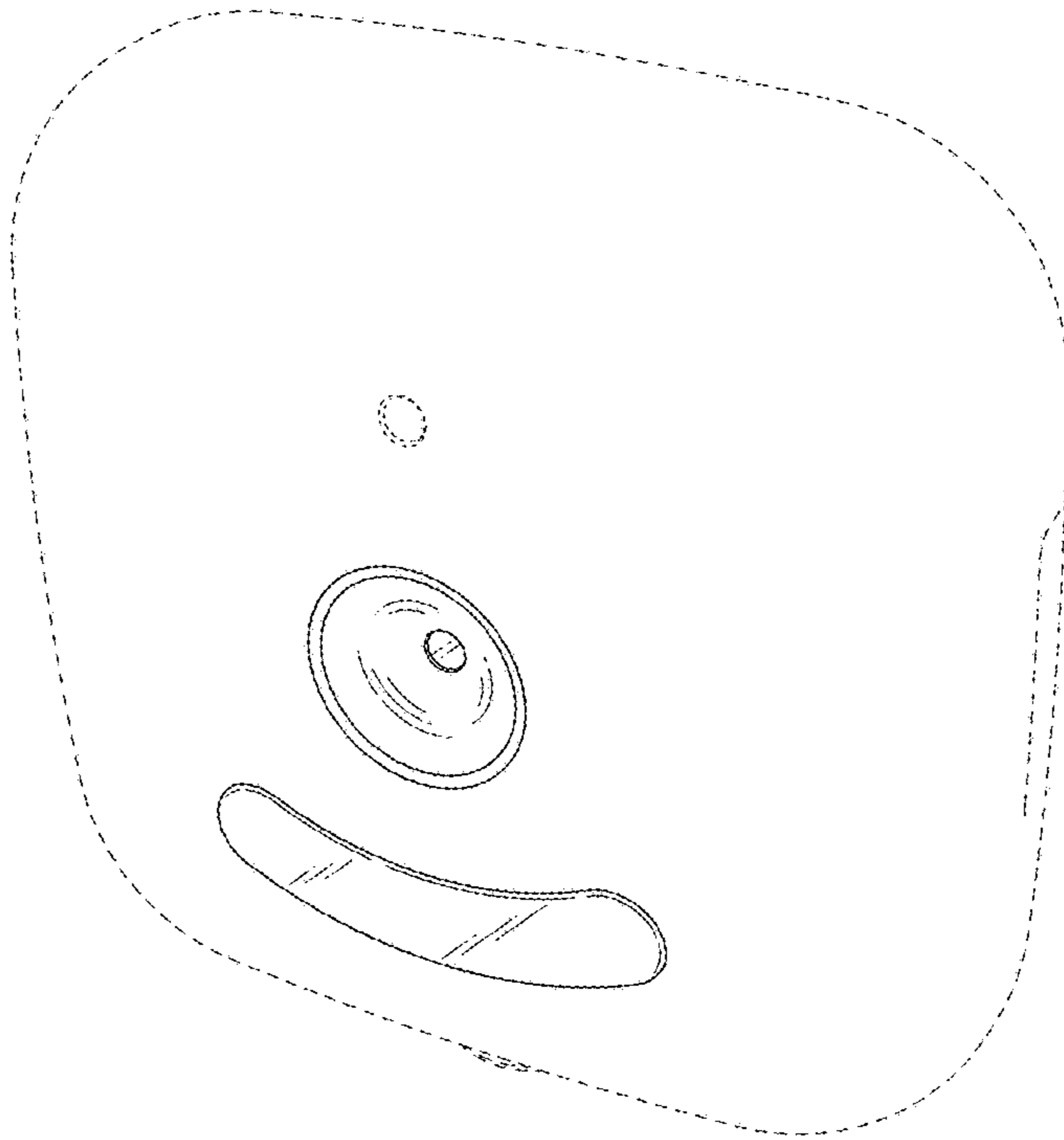

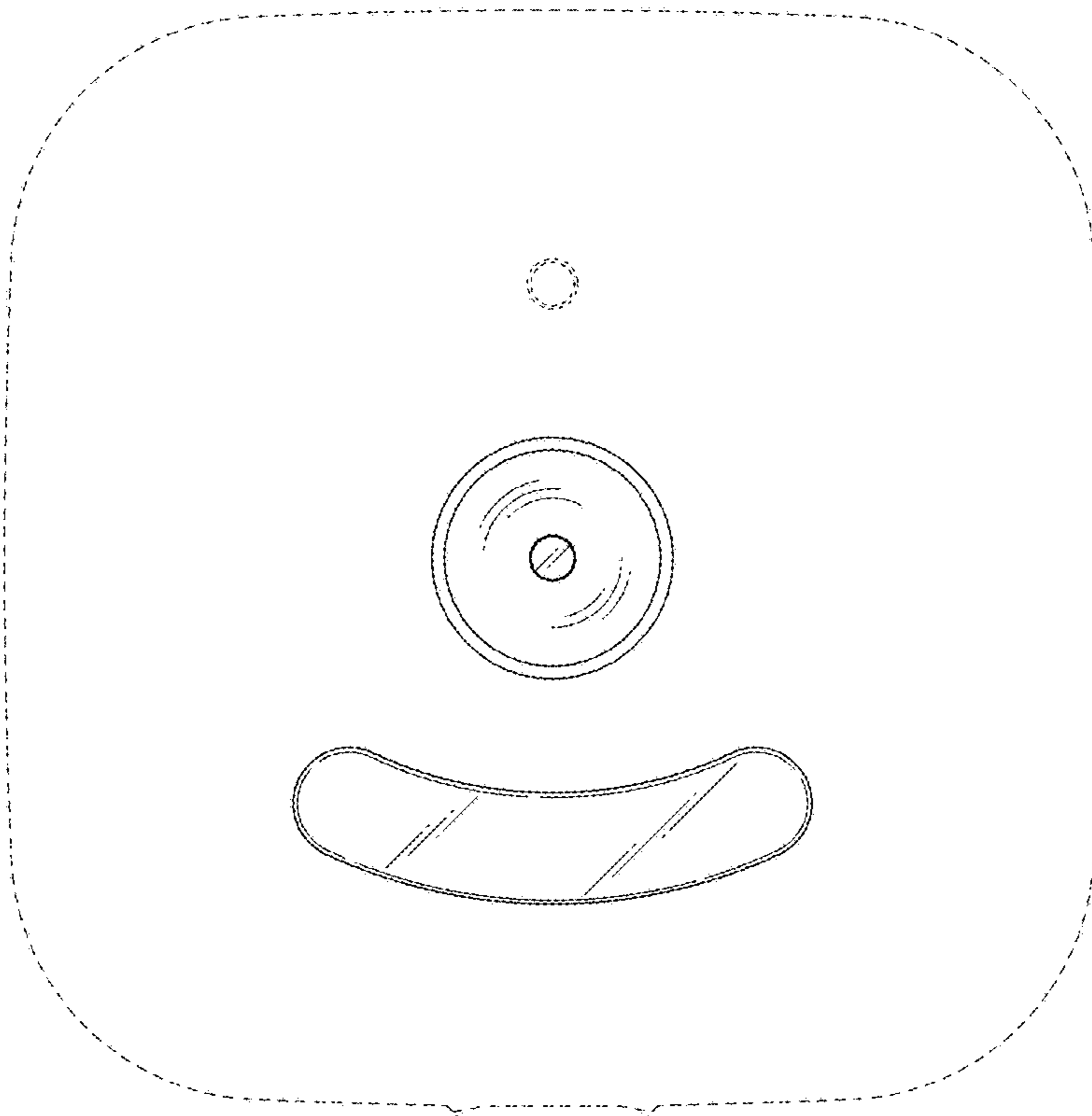

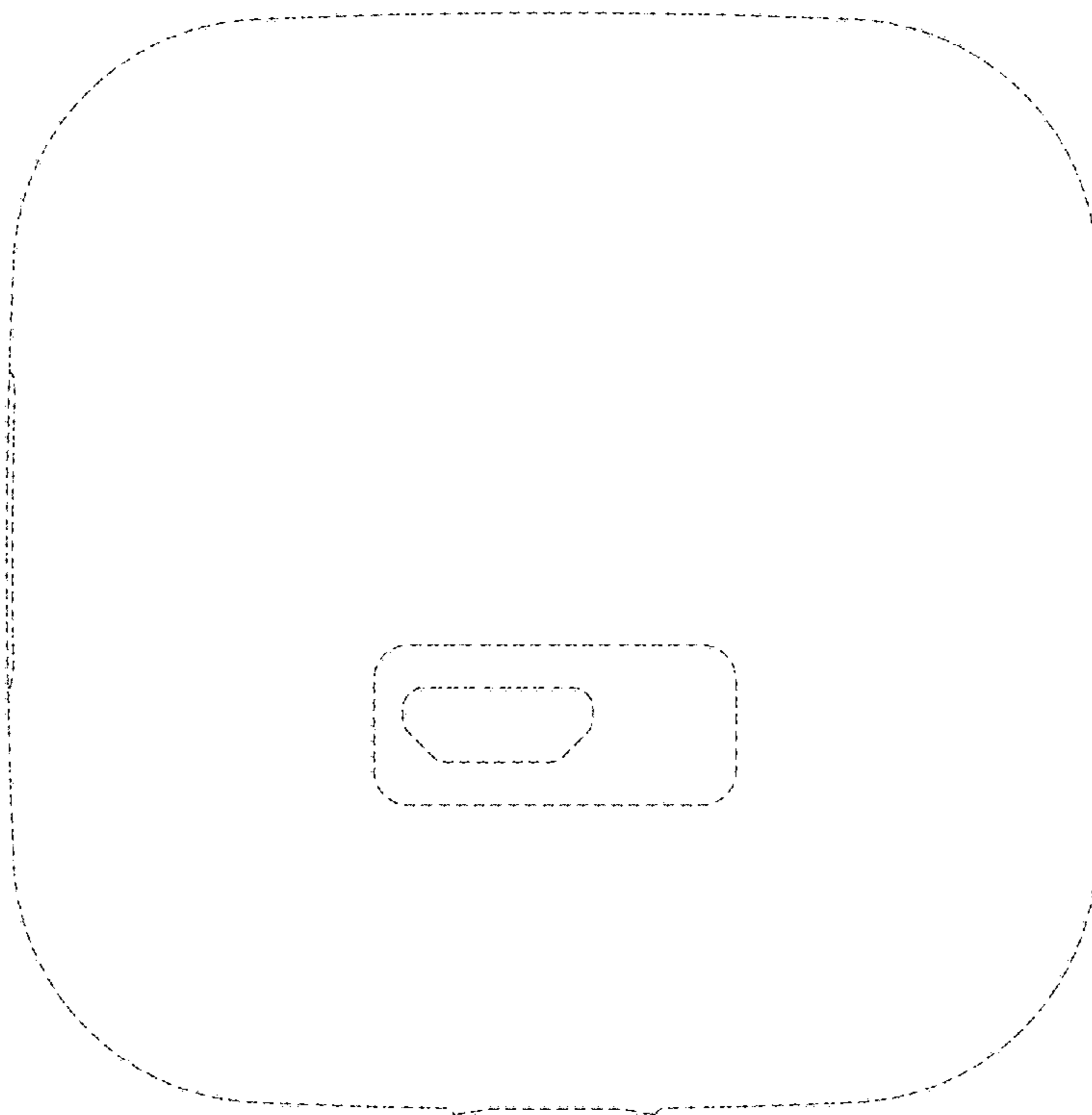

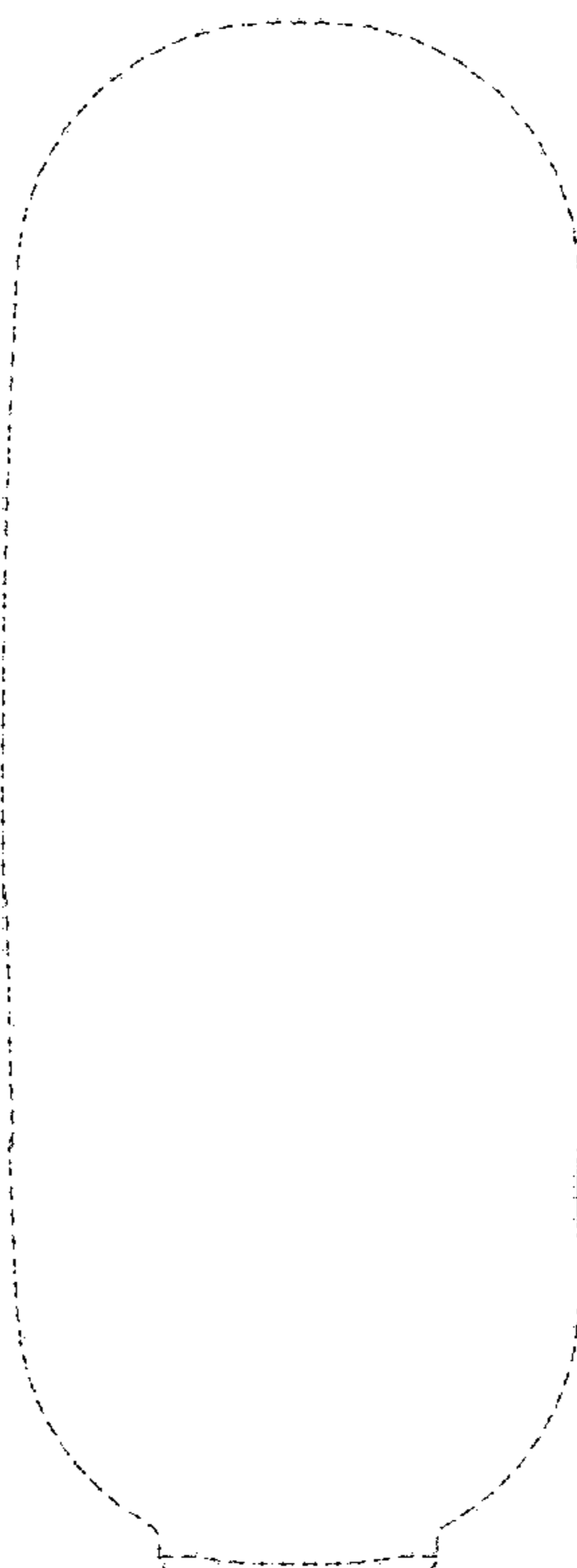

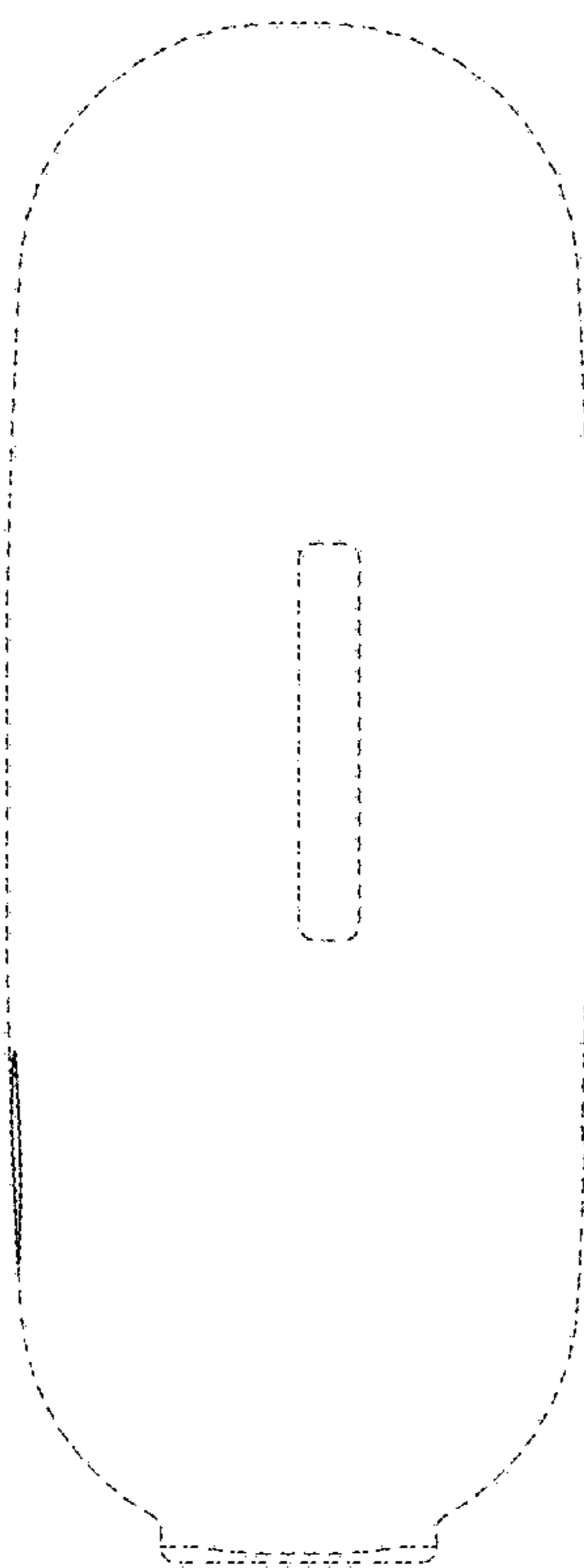

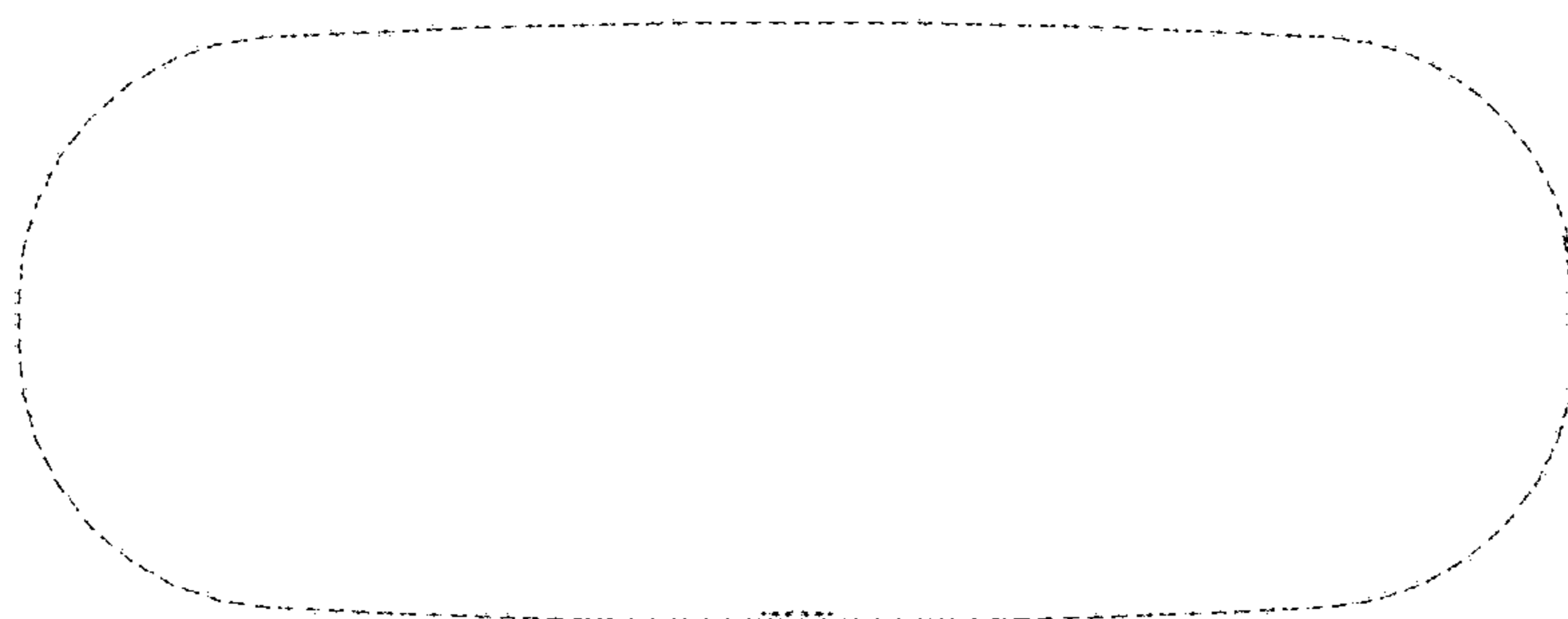

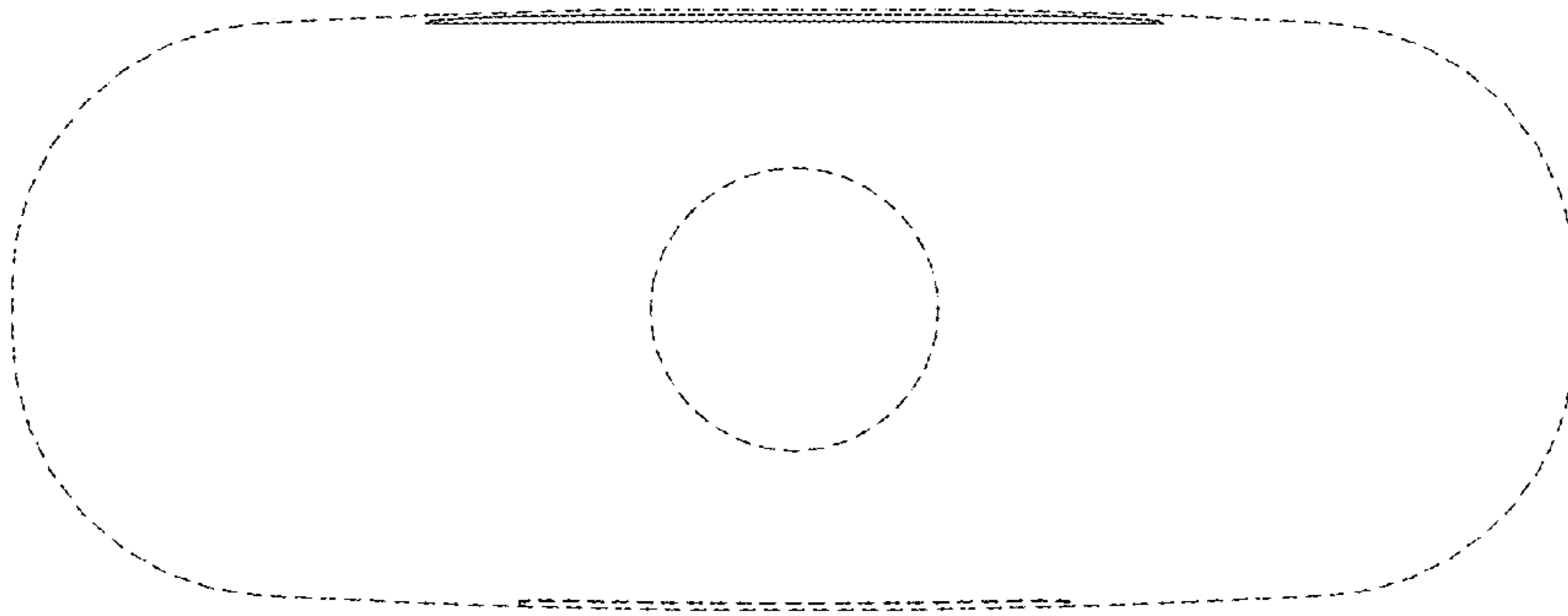
