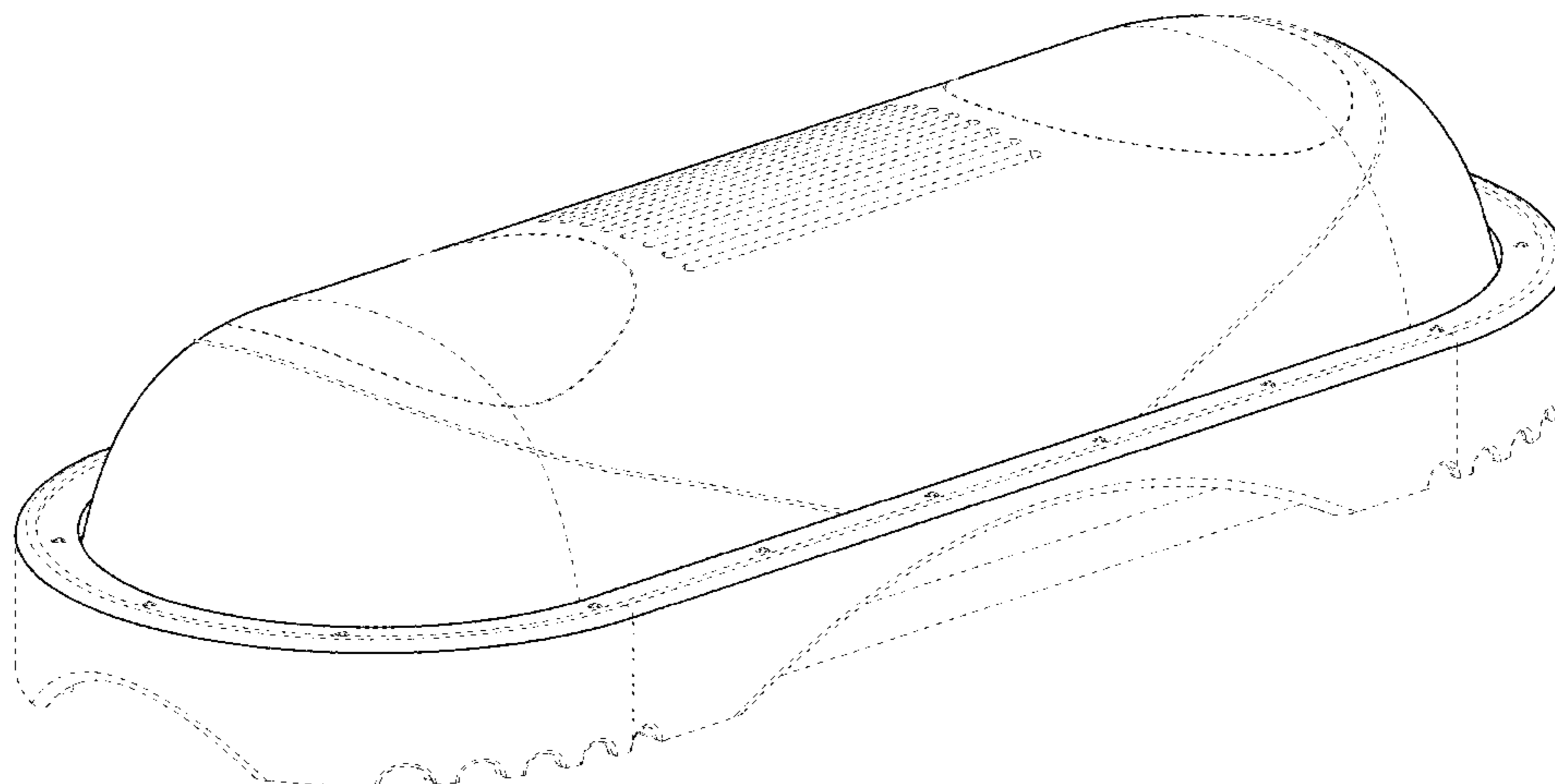
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a step exercise apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the step exercise apparatus, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right view of the step exercise apparatus of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a left view of the step exercise apparatus of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front view of the step exercise apparatus of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the step exercise apparatus of FIG. 1;

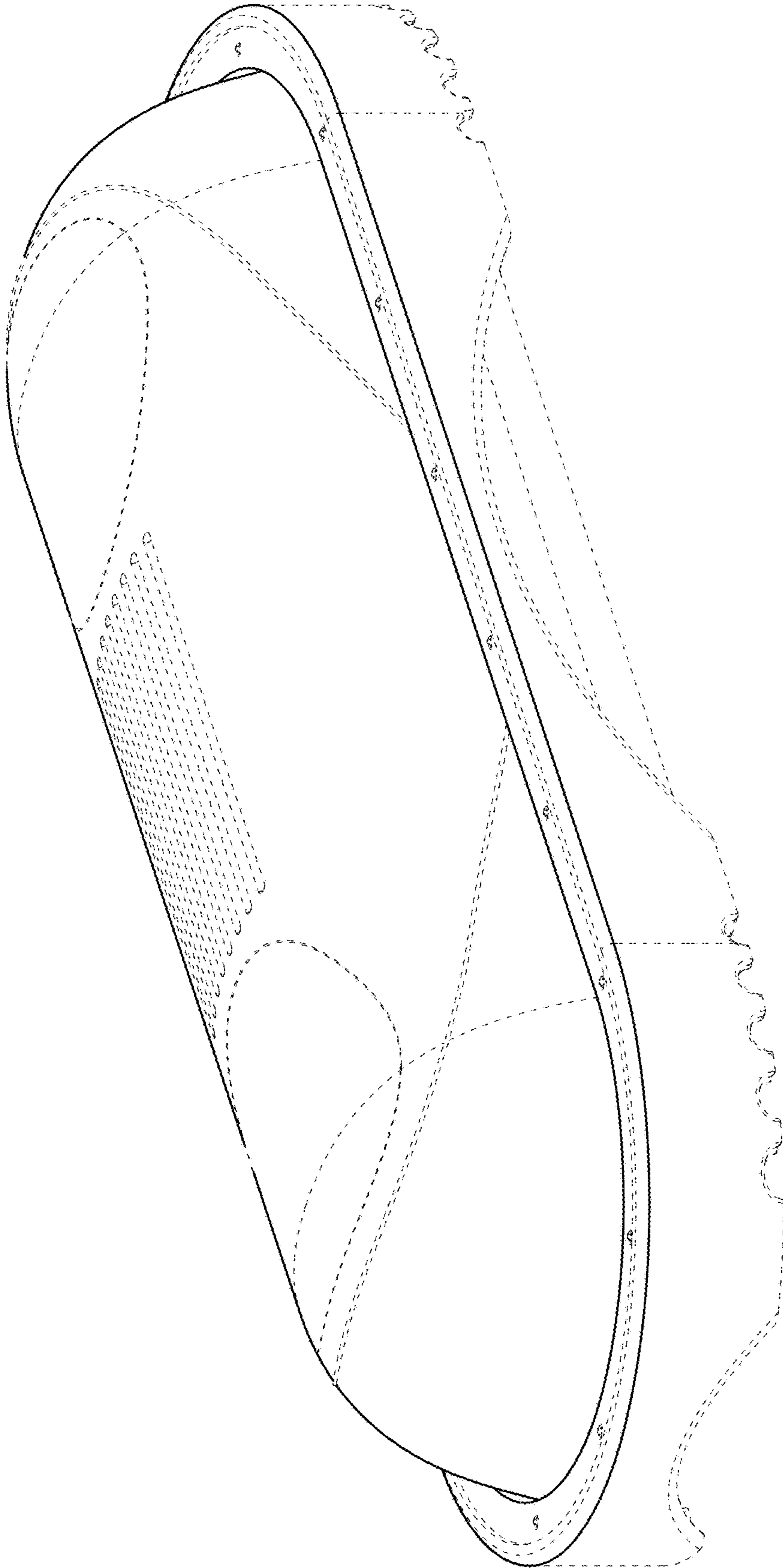

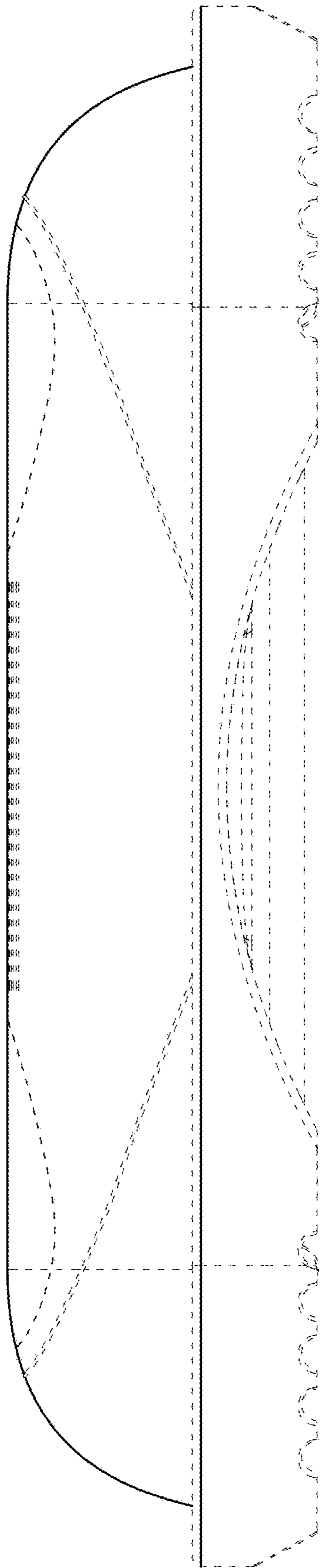

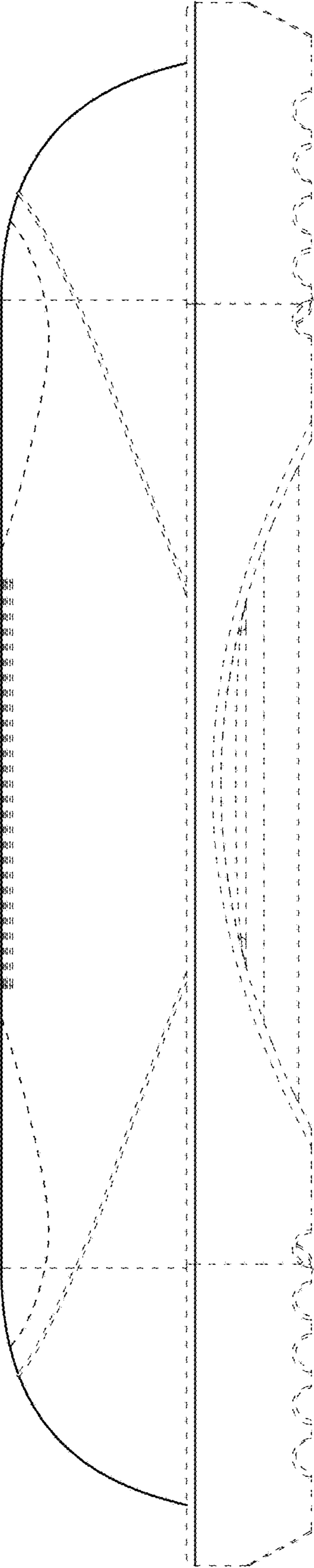

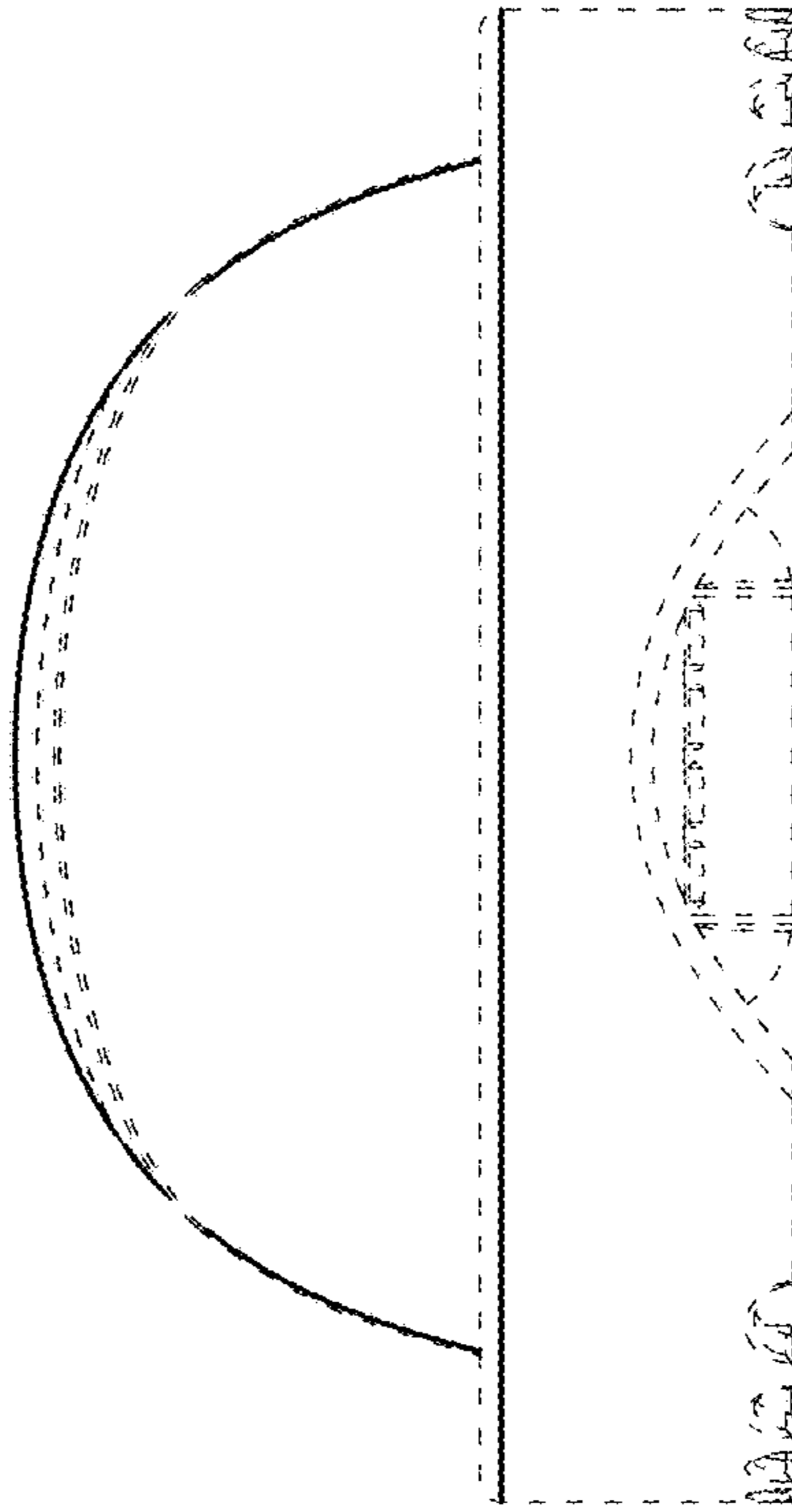

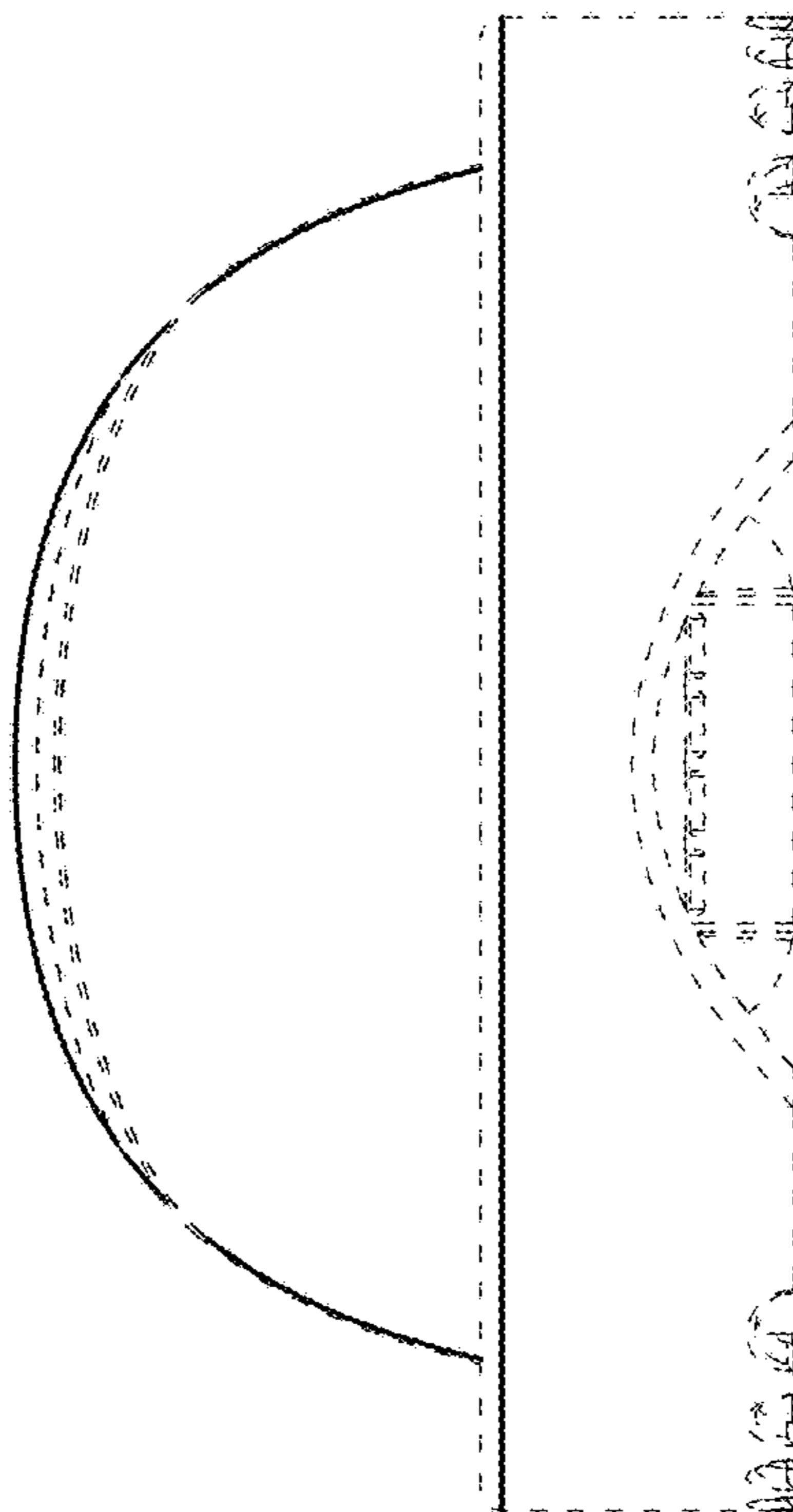

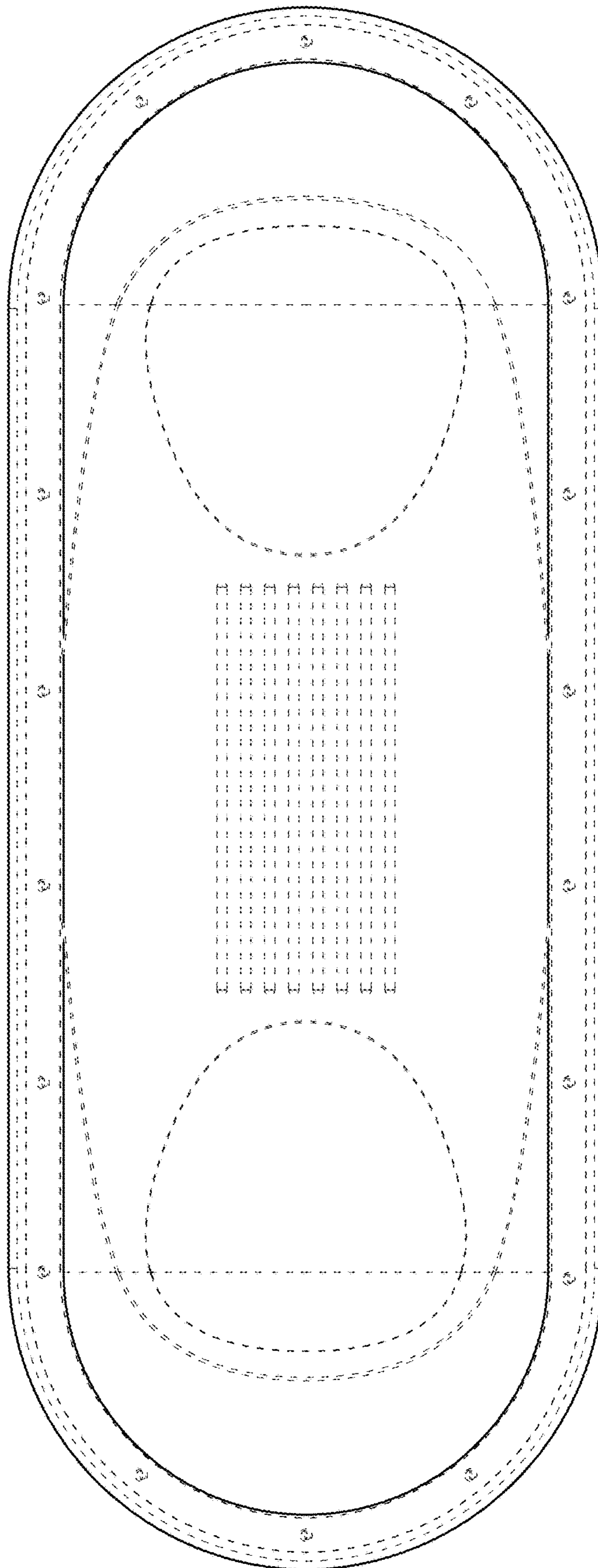

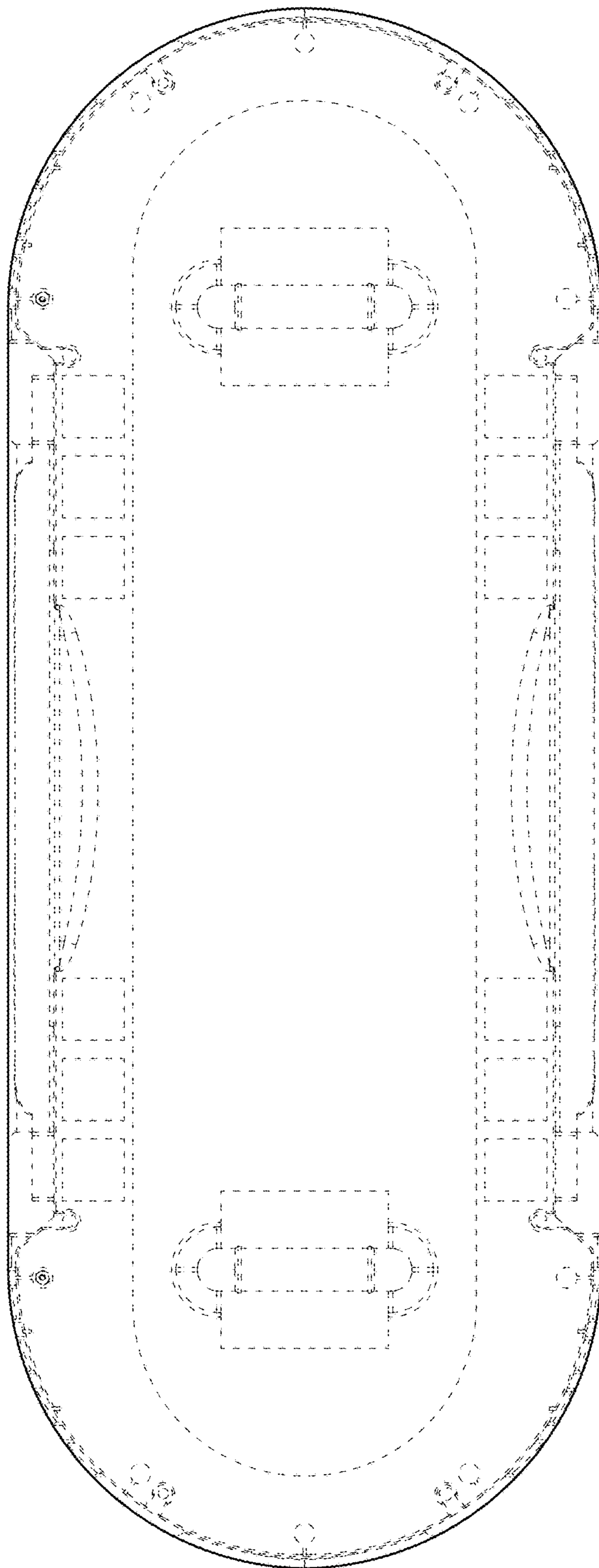
