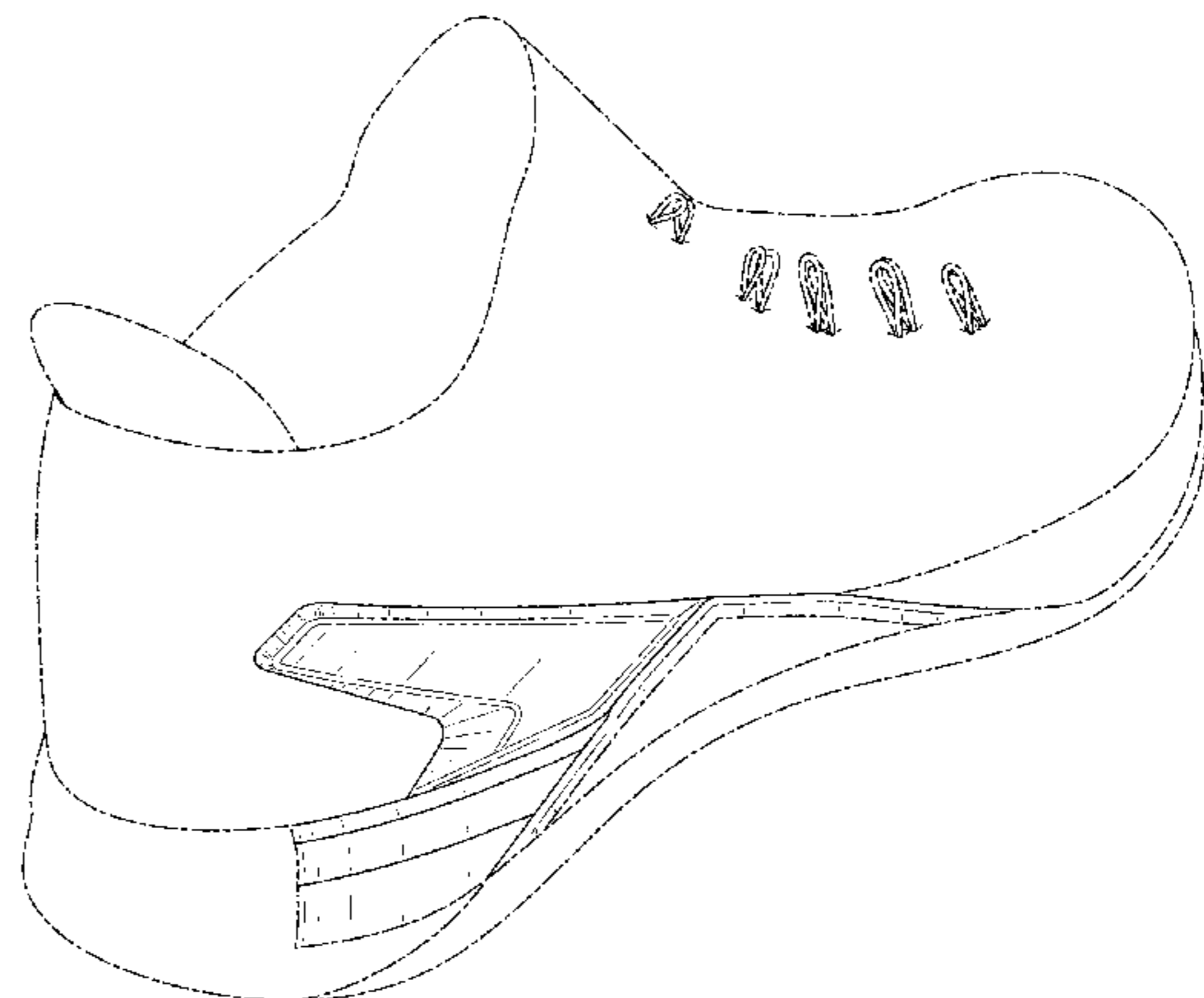
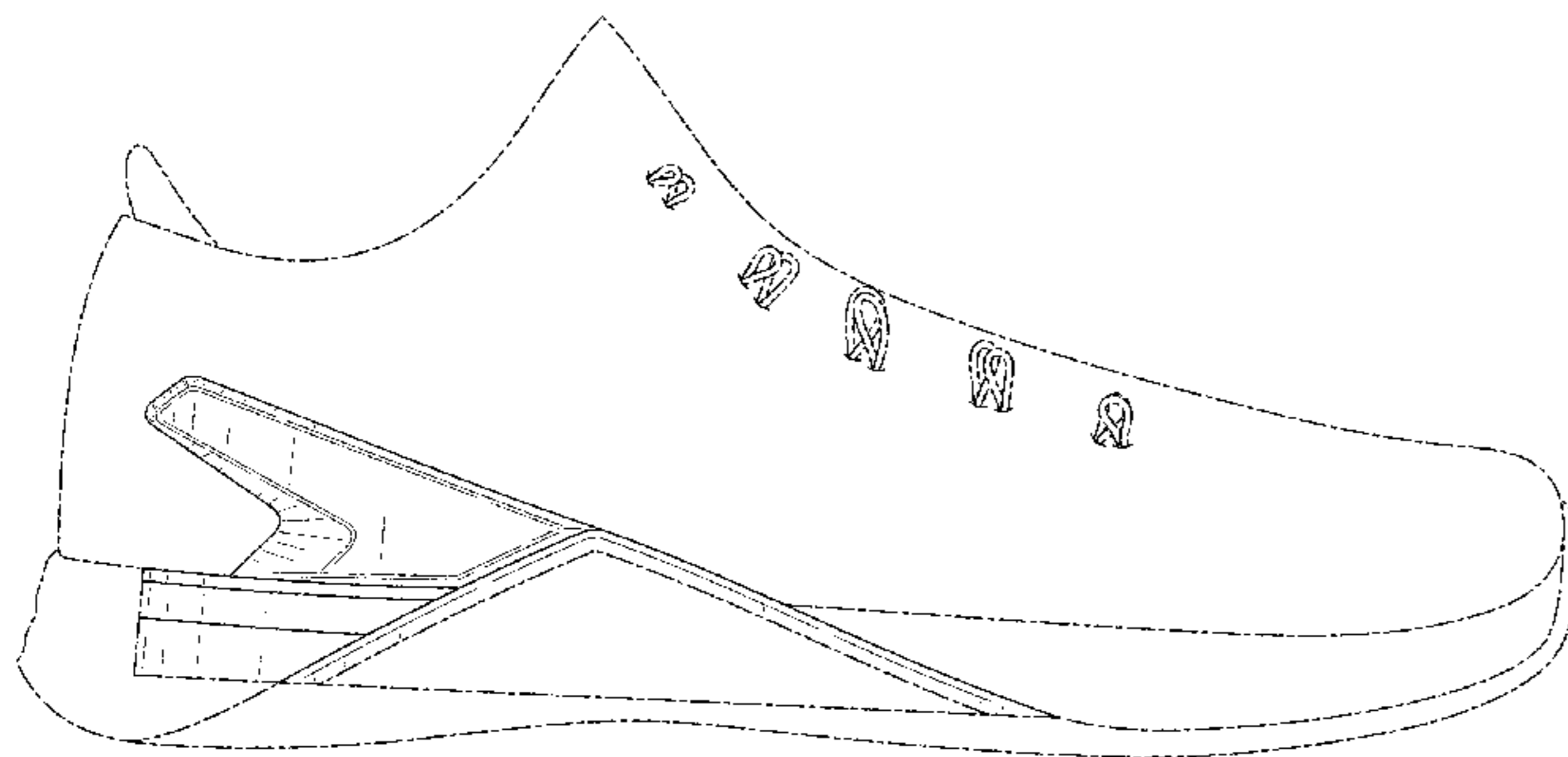
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe midsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe midsole showing my new design;

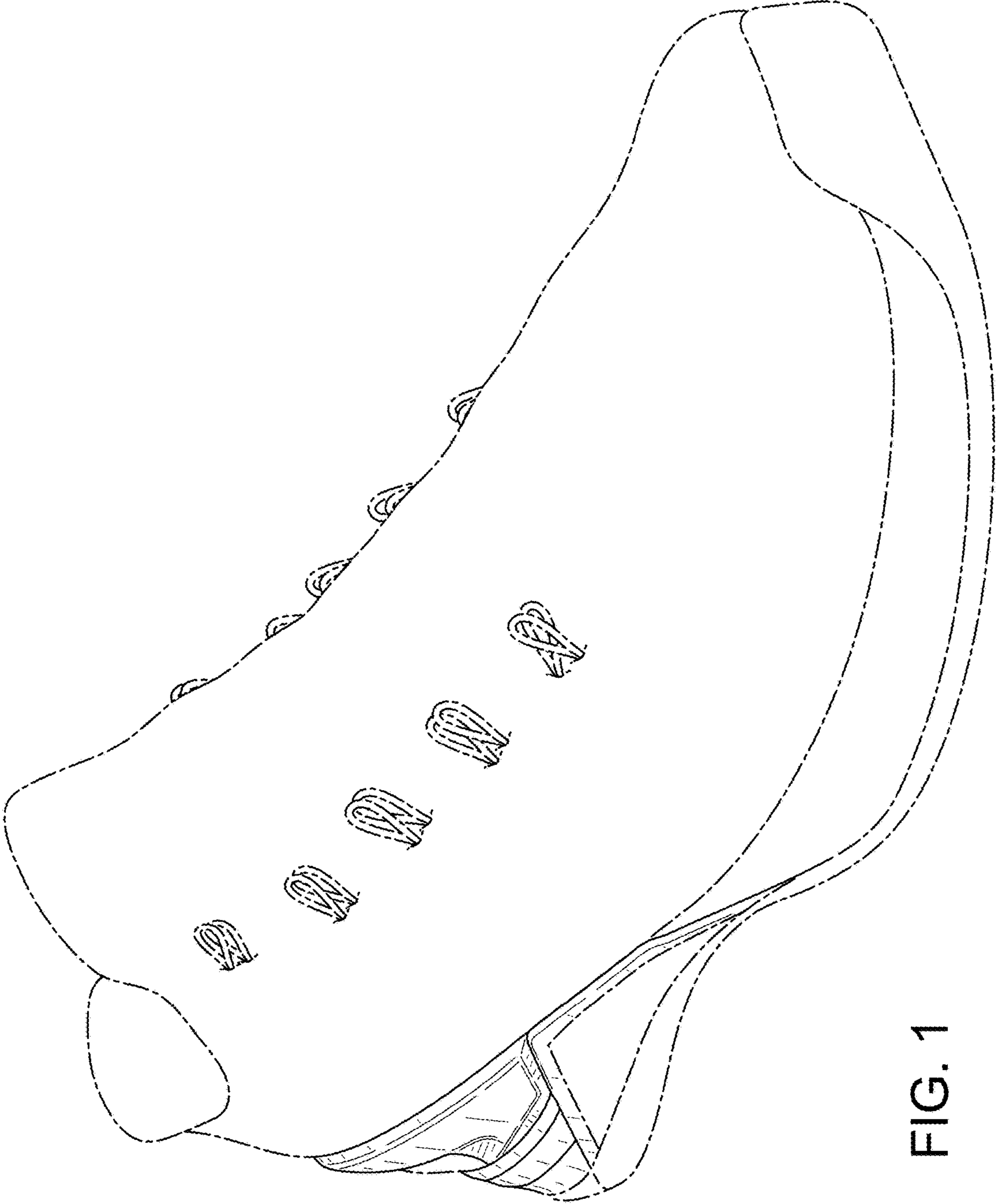

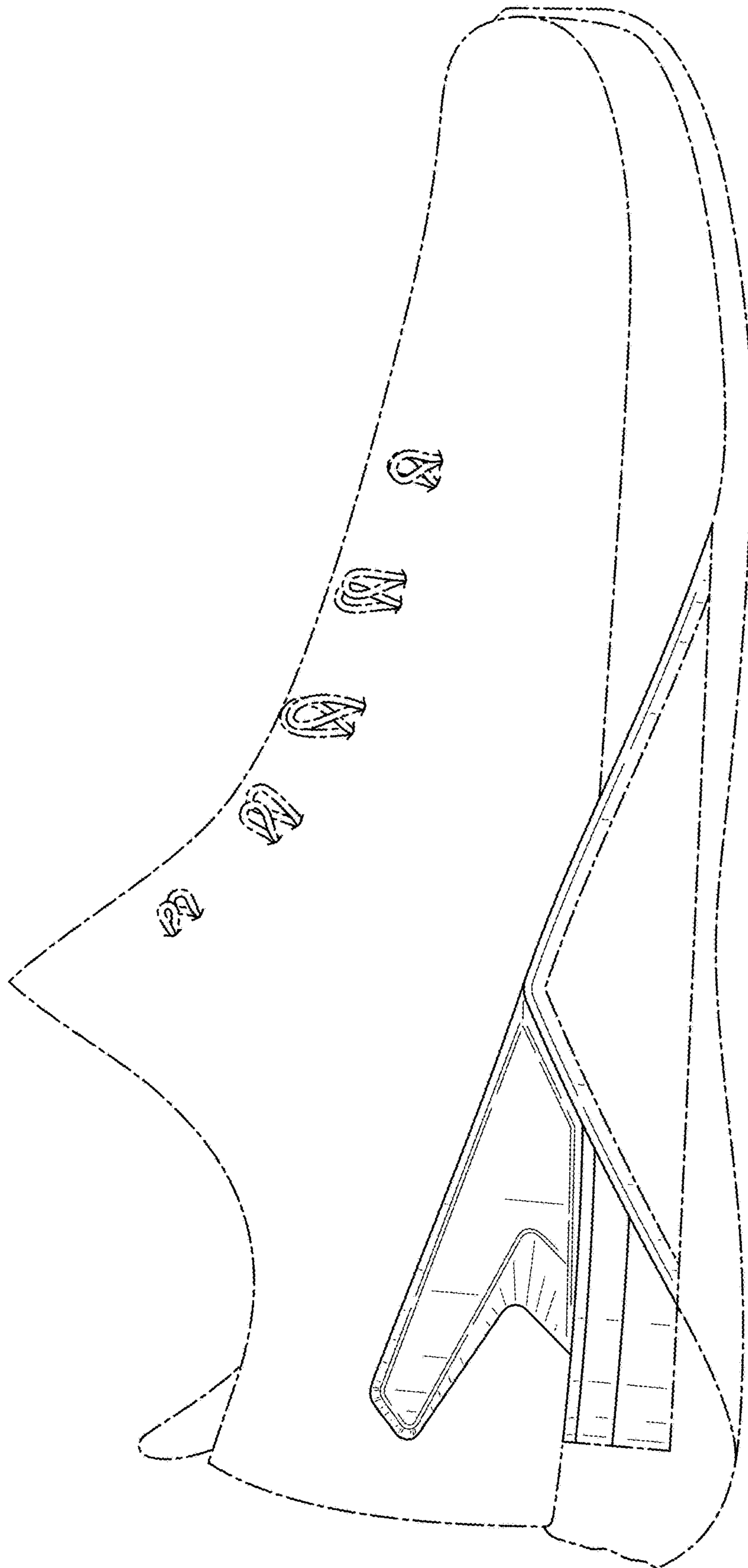

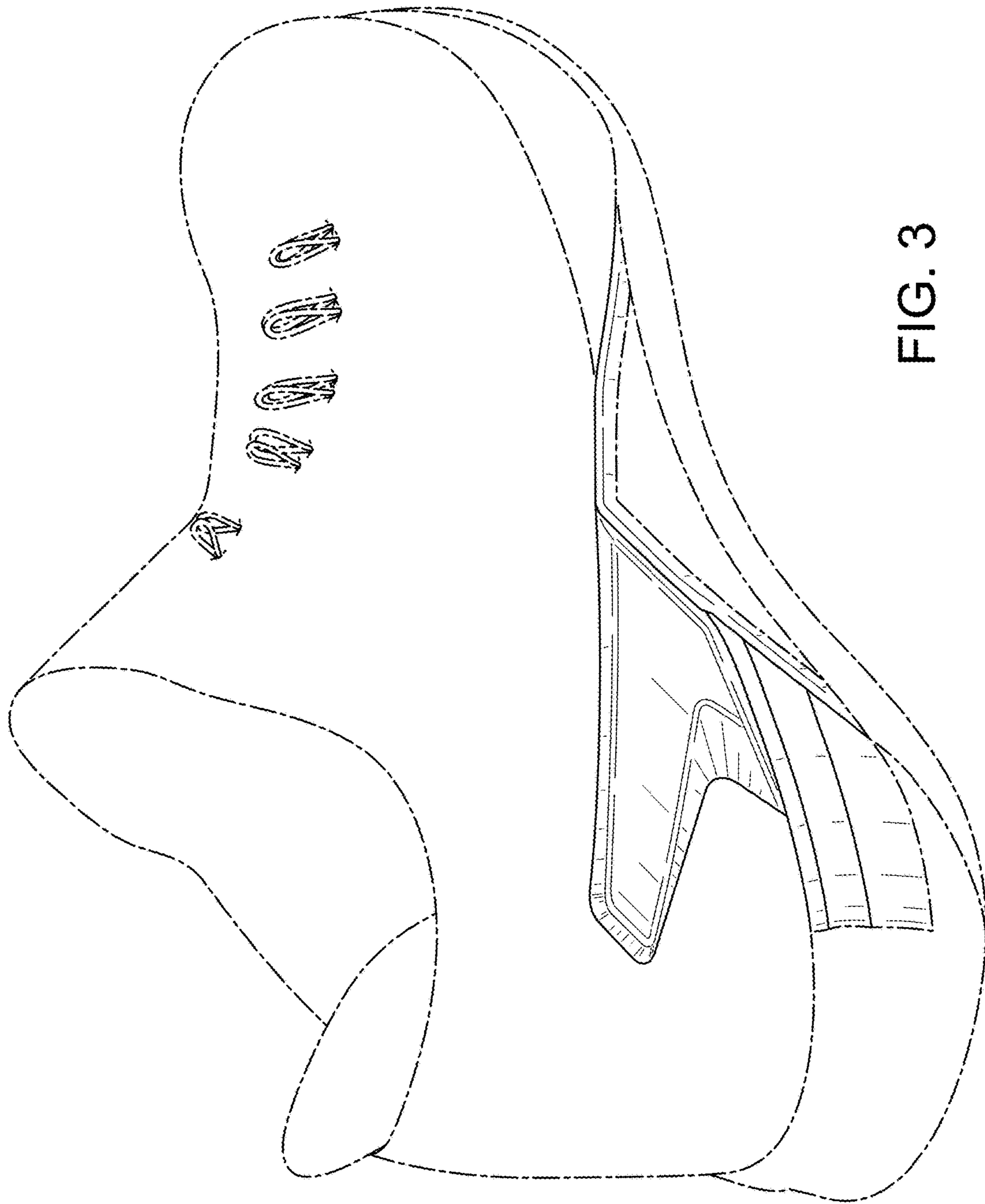
