(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen having a graphical user interface for messaging, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 14 is a second image in the sequence;

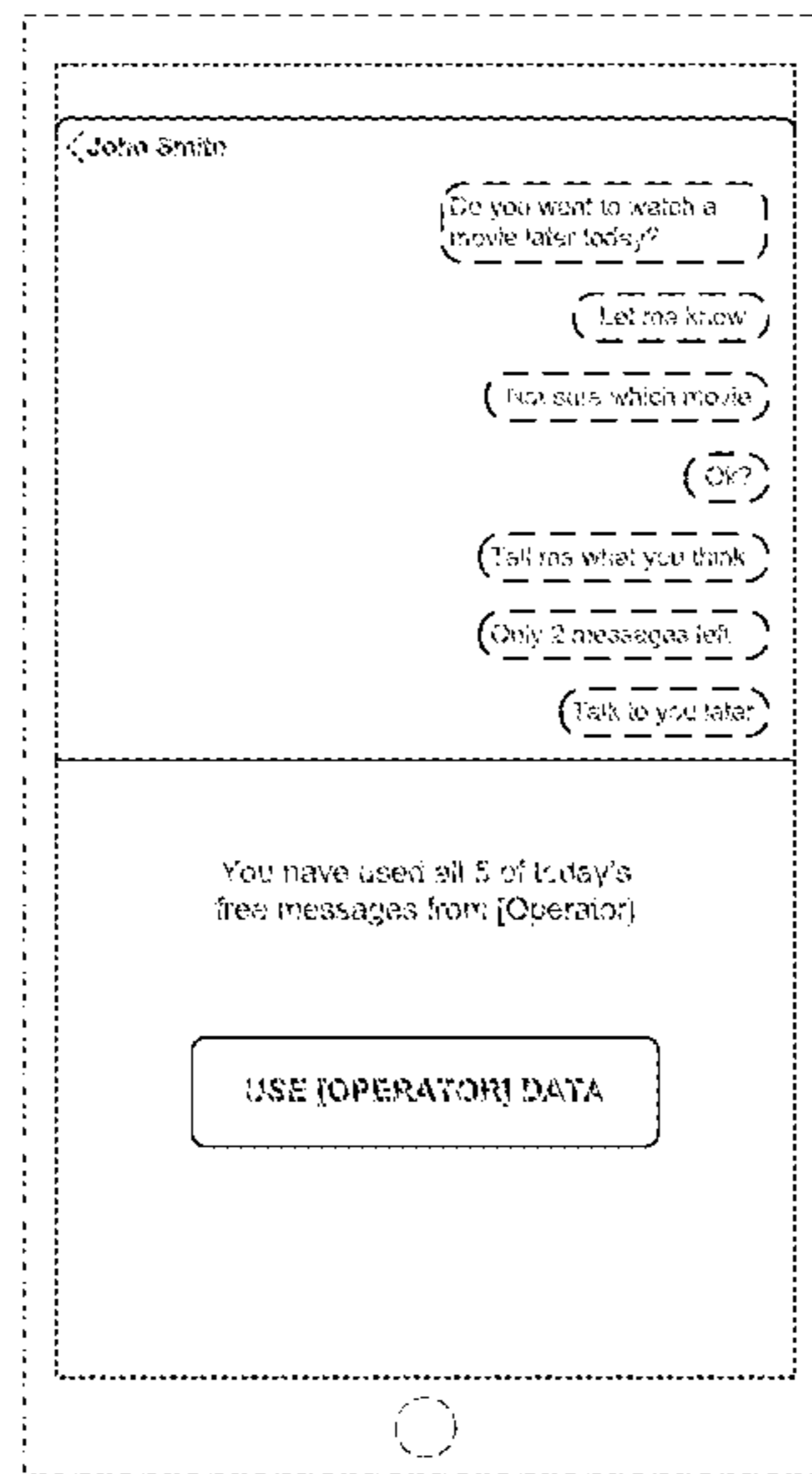
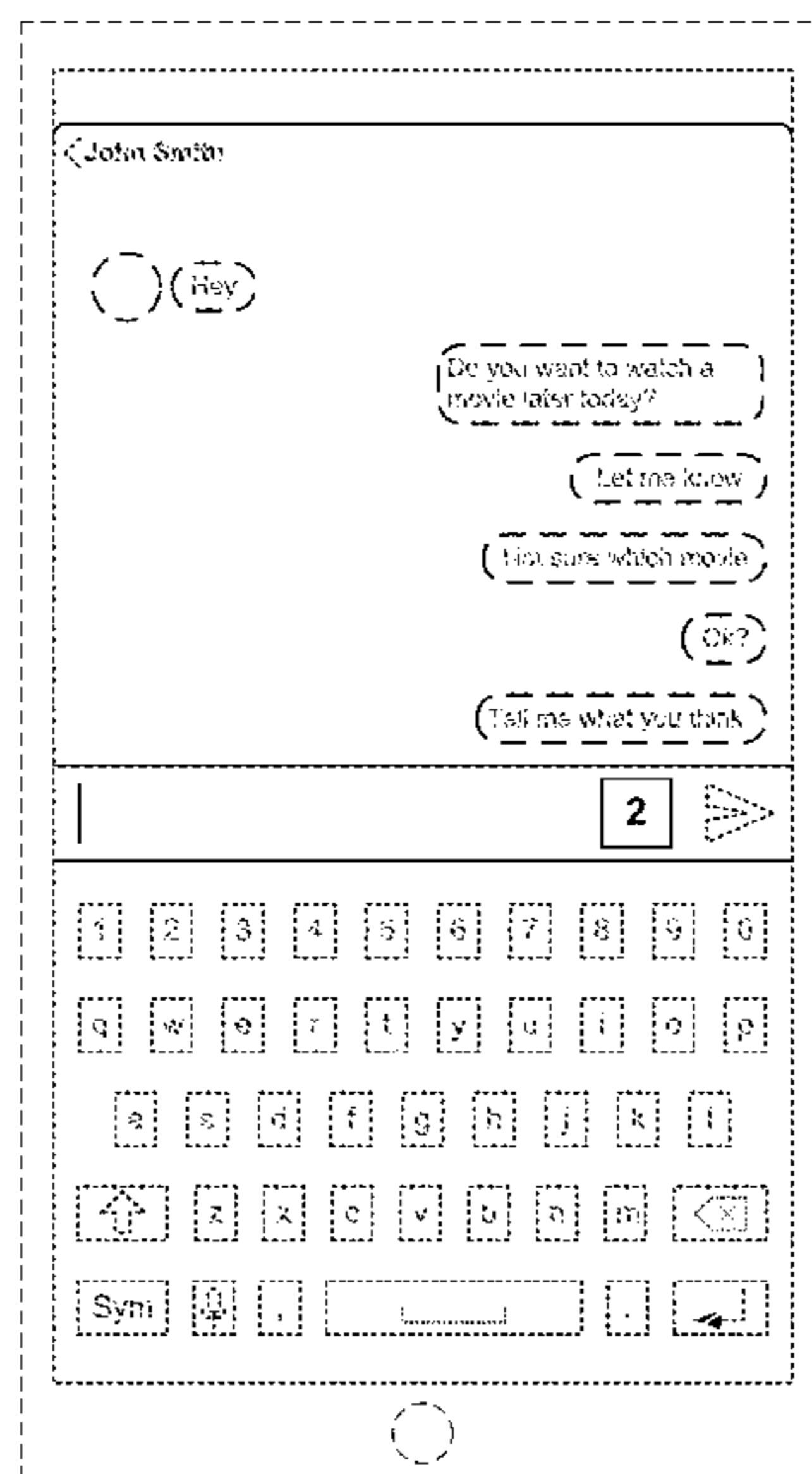
FIG. 15 is a third image in the sequence; and,

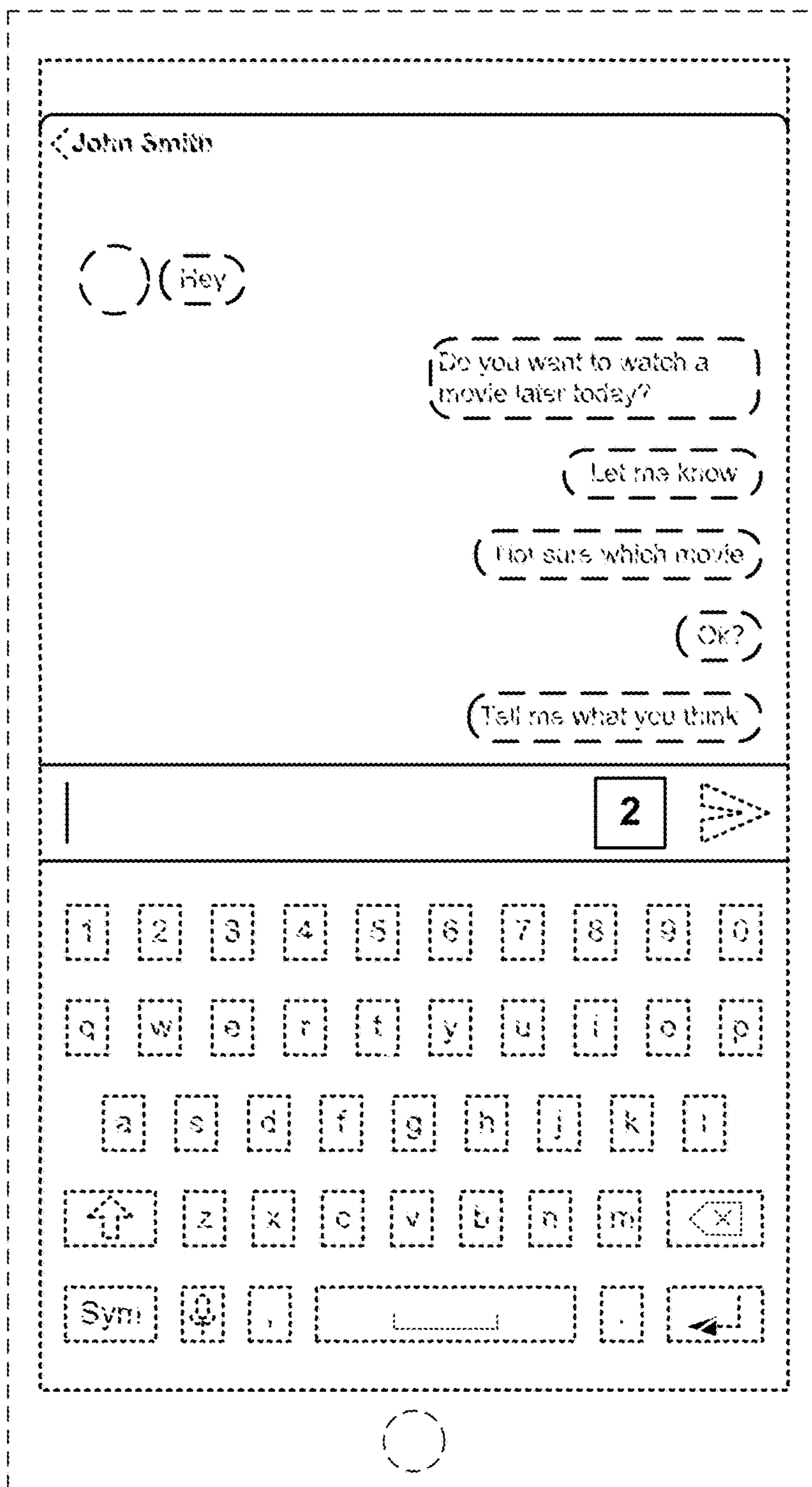

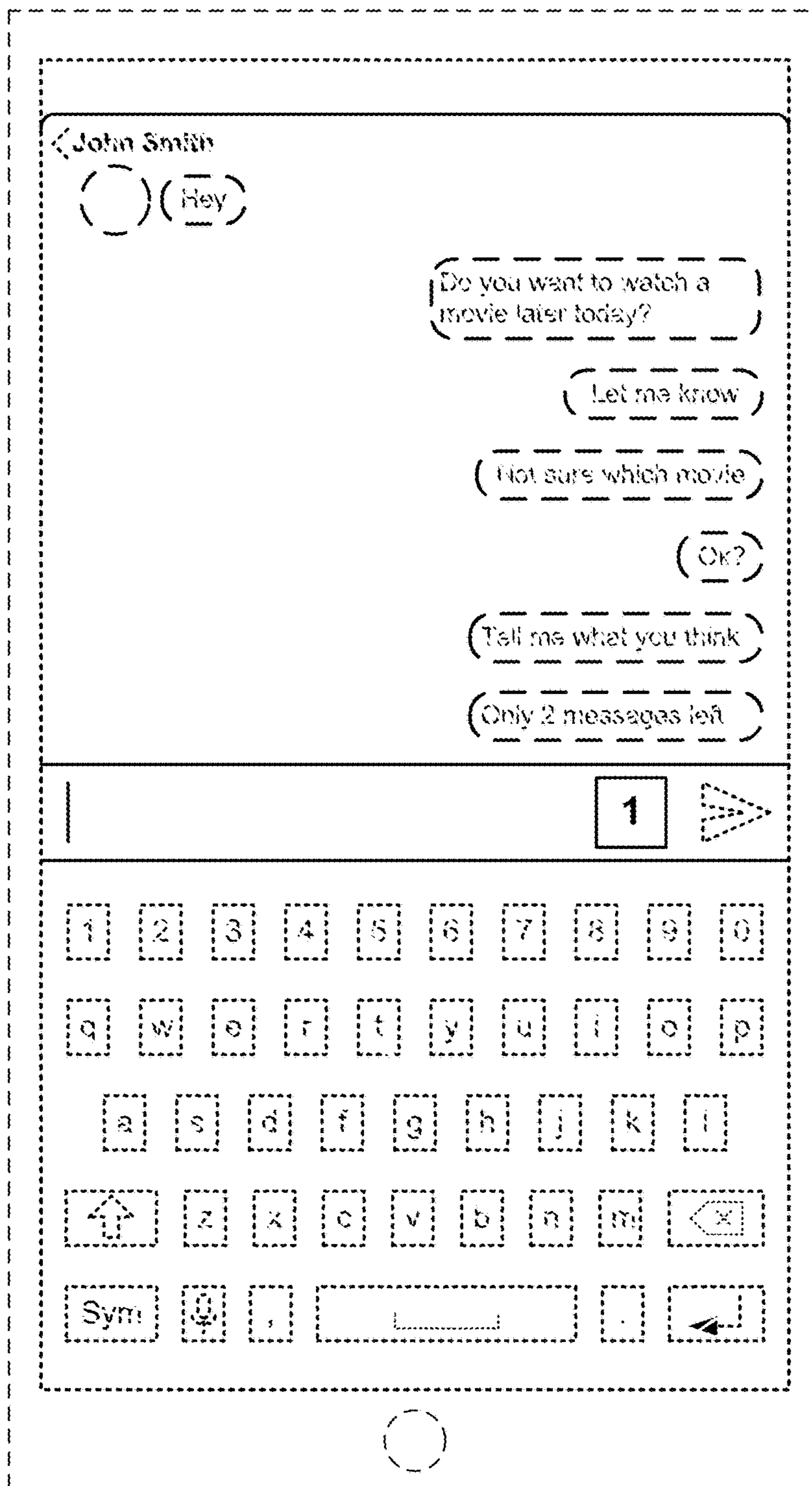

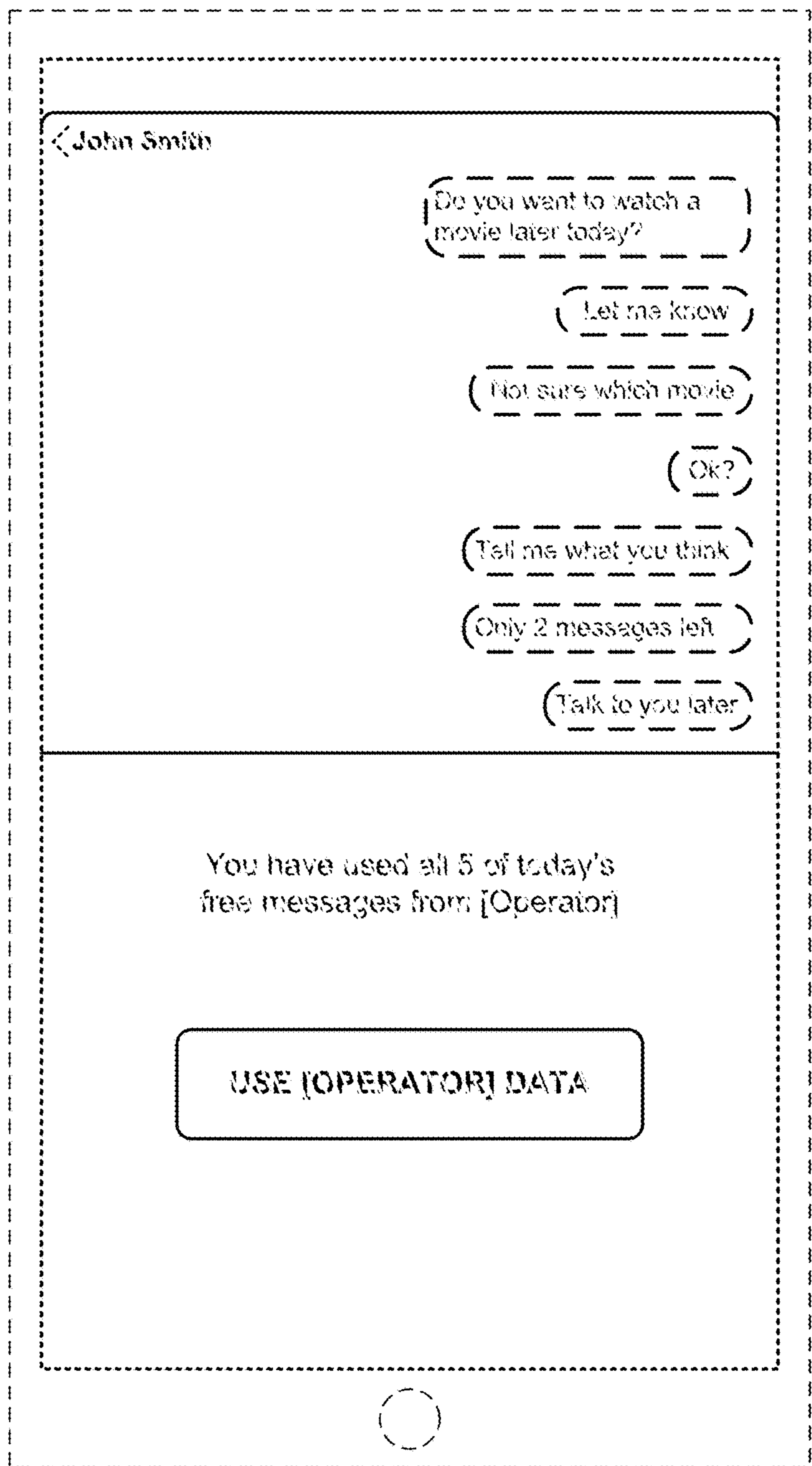

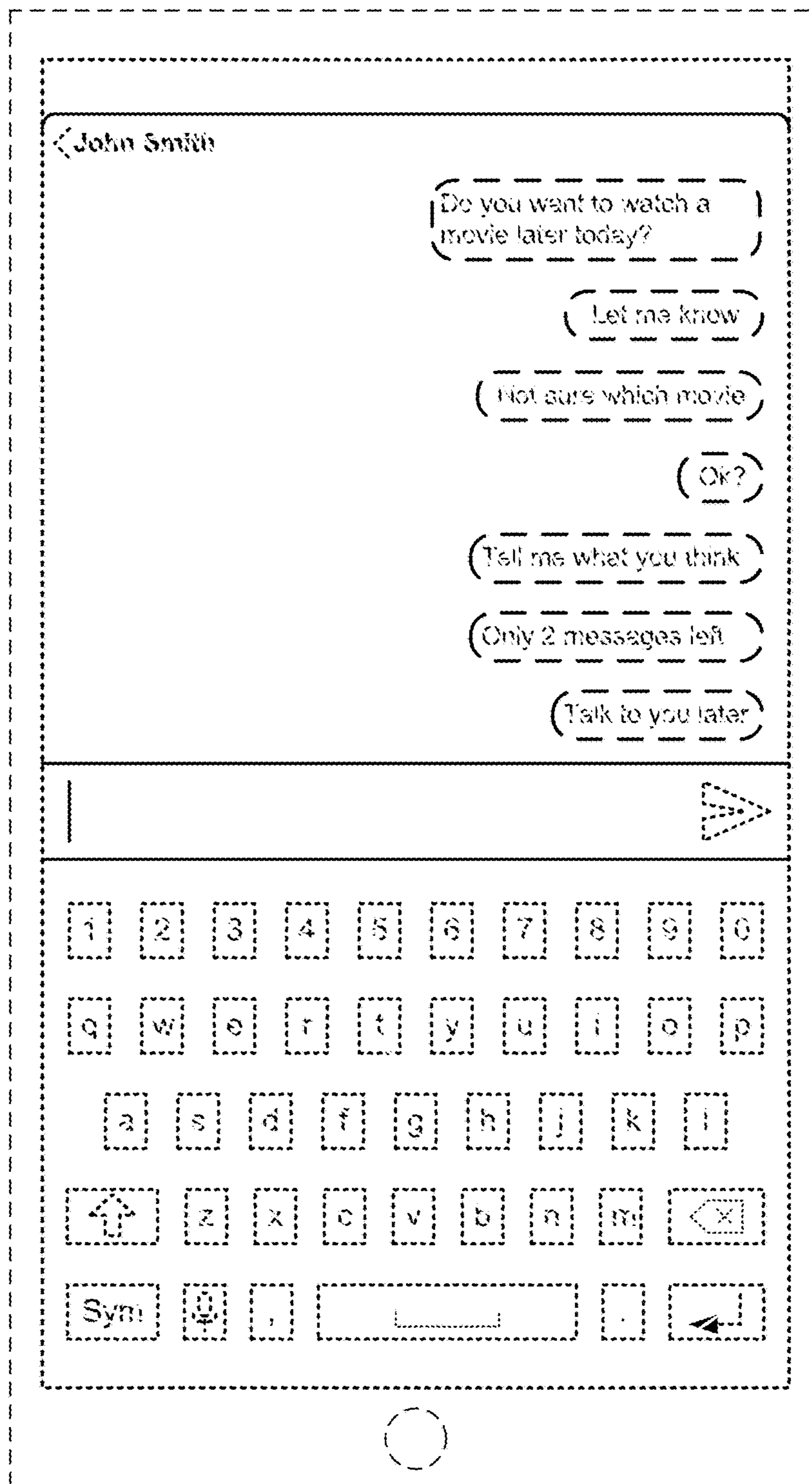

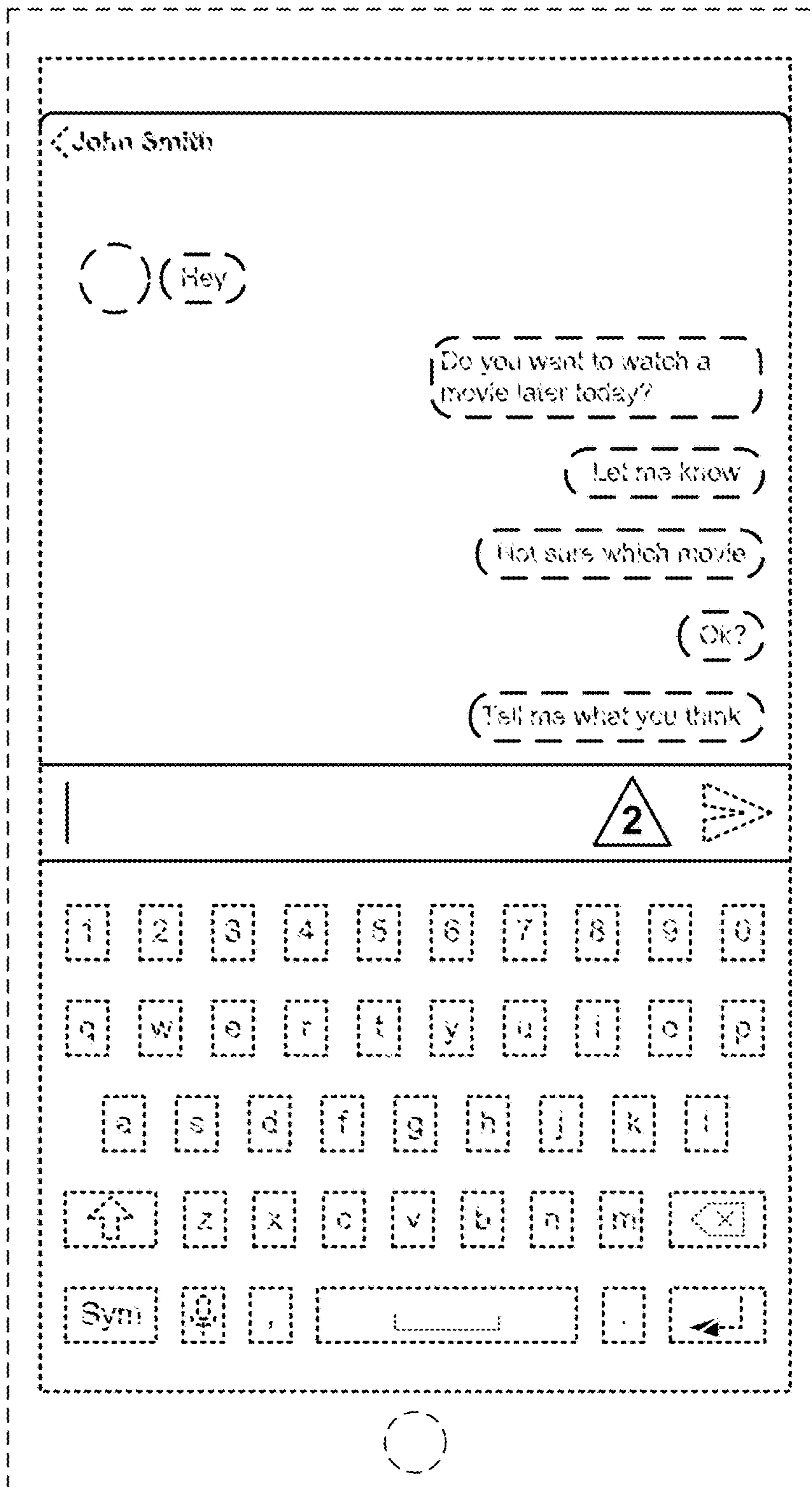

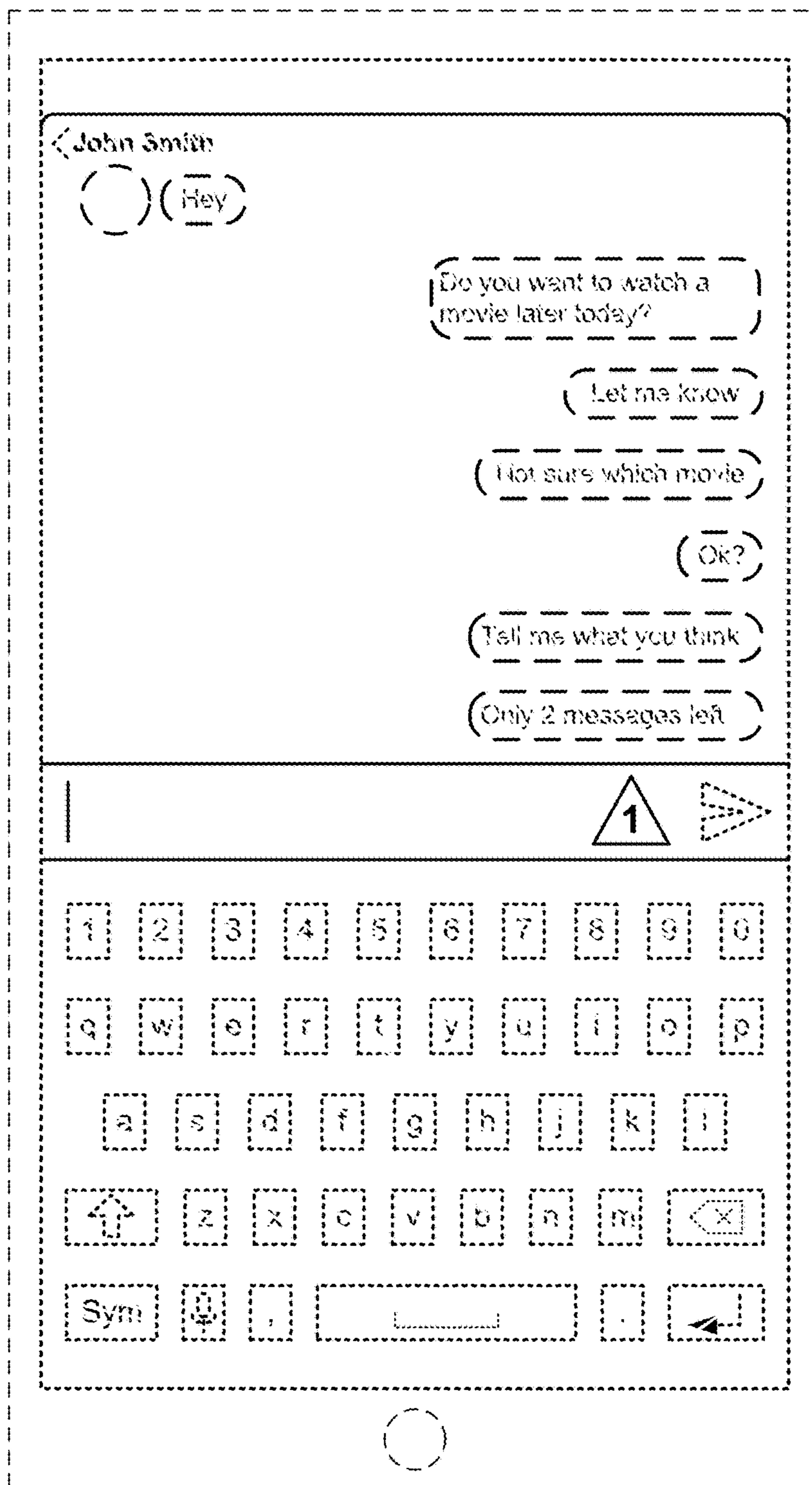

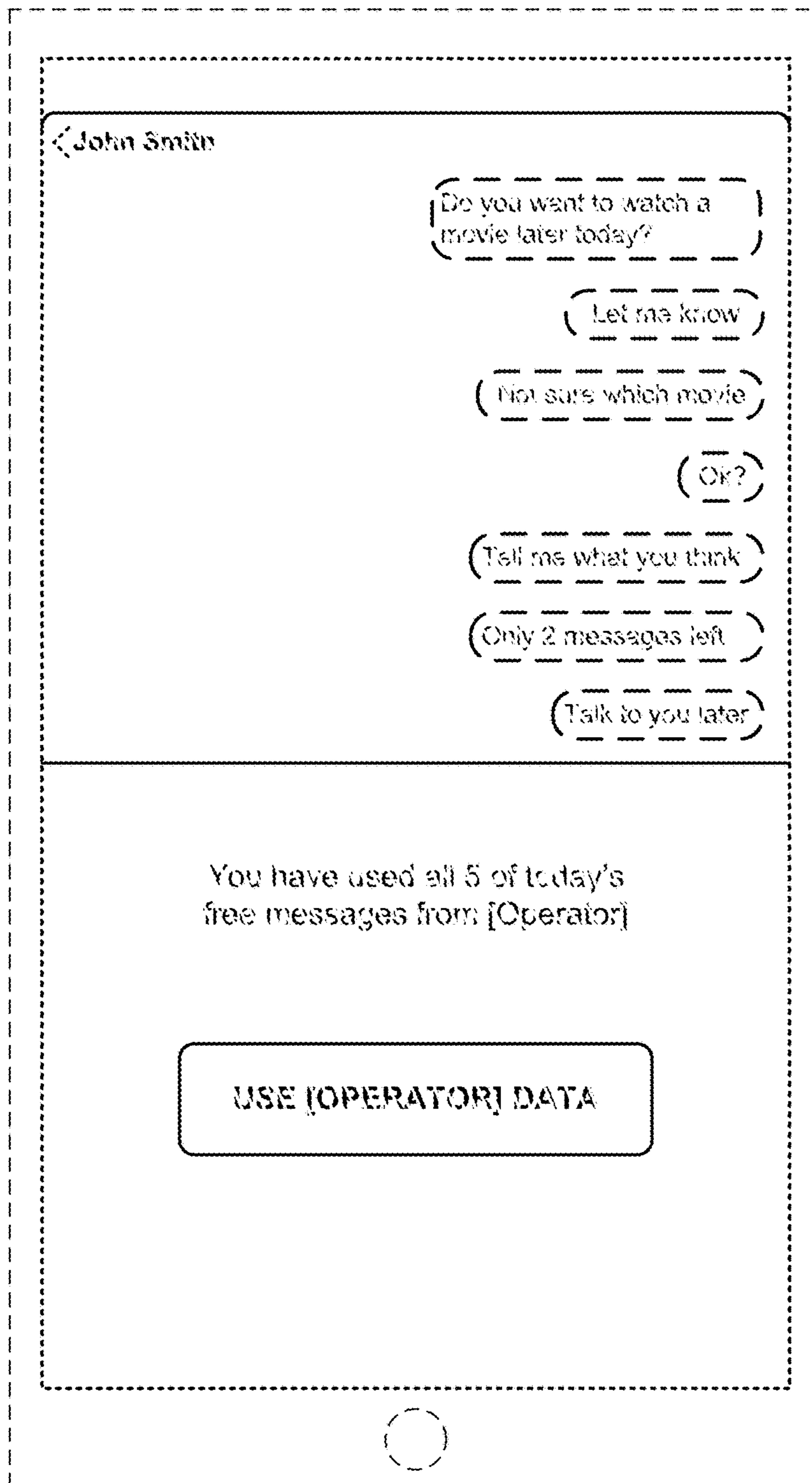

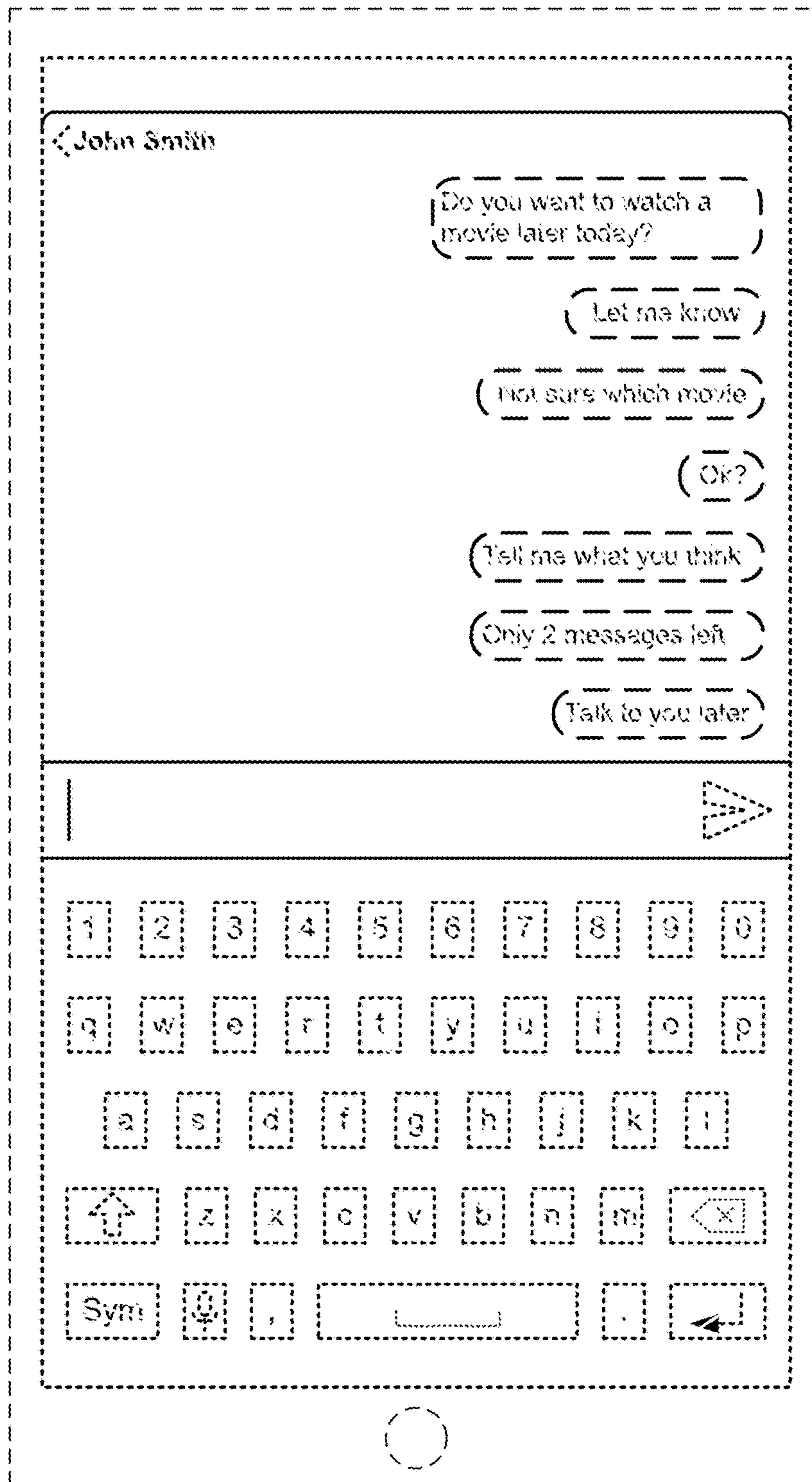

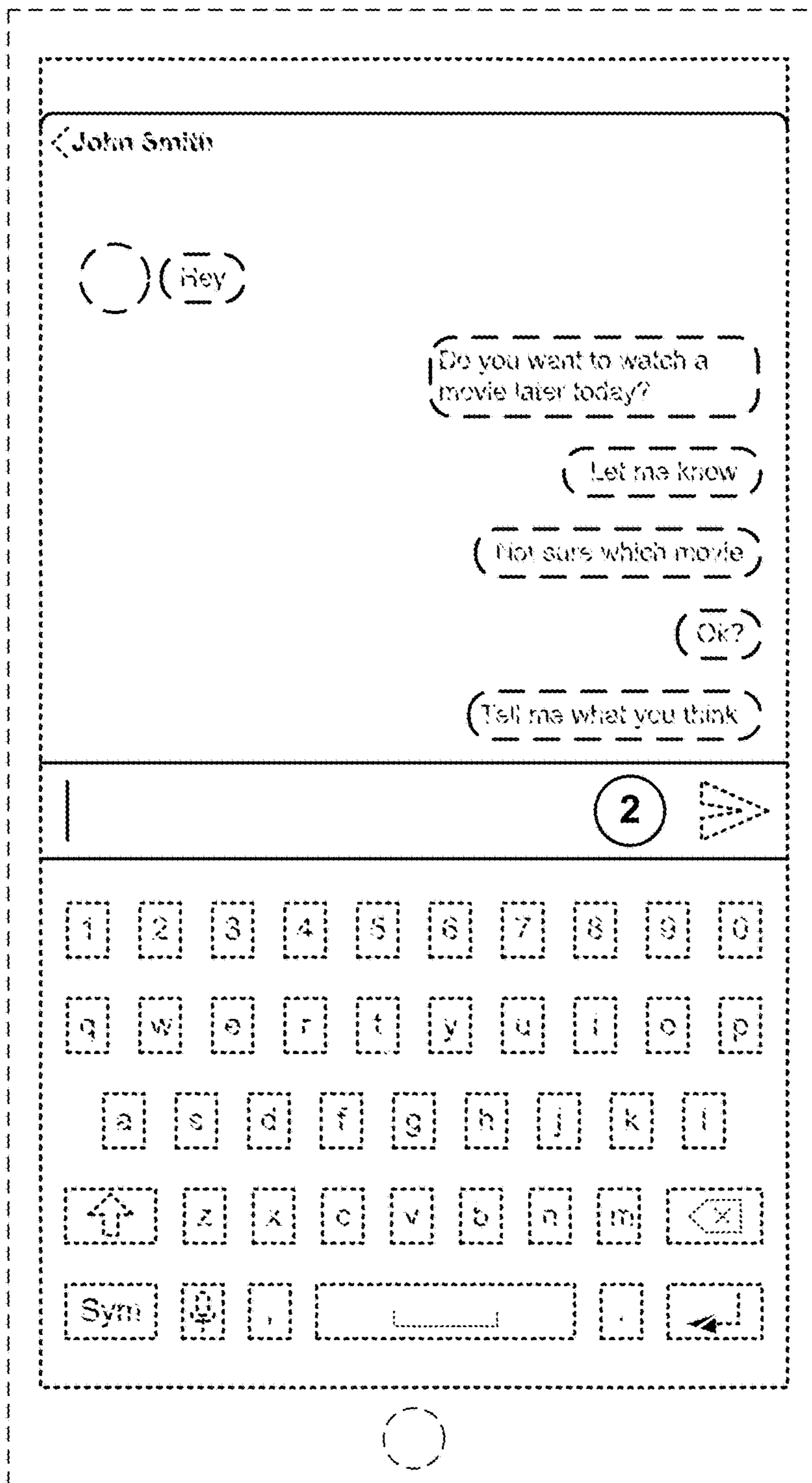

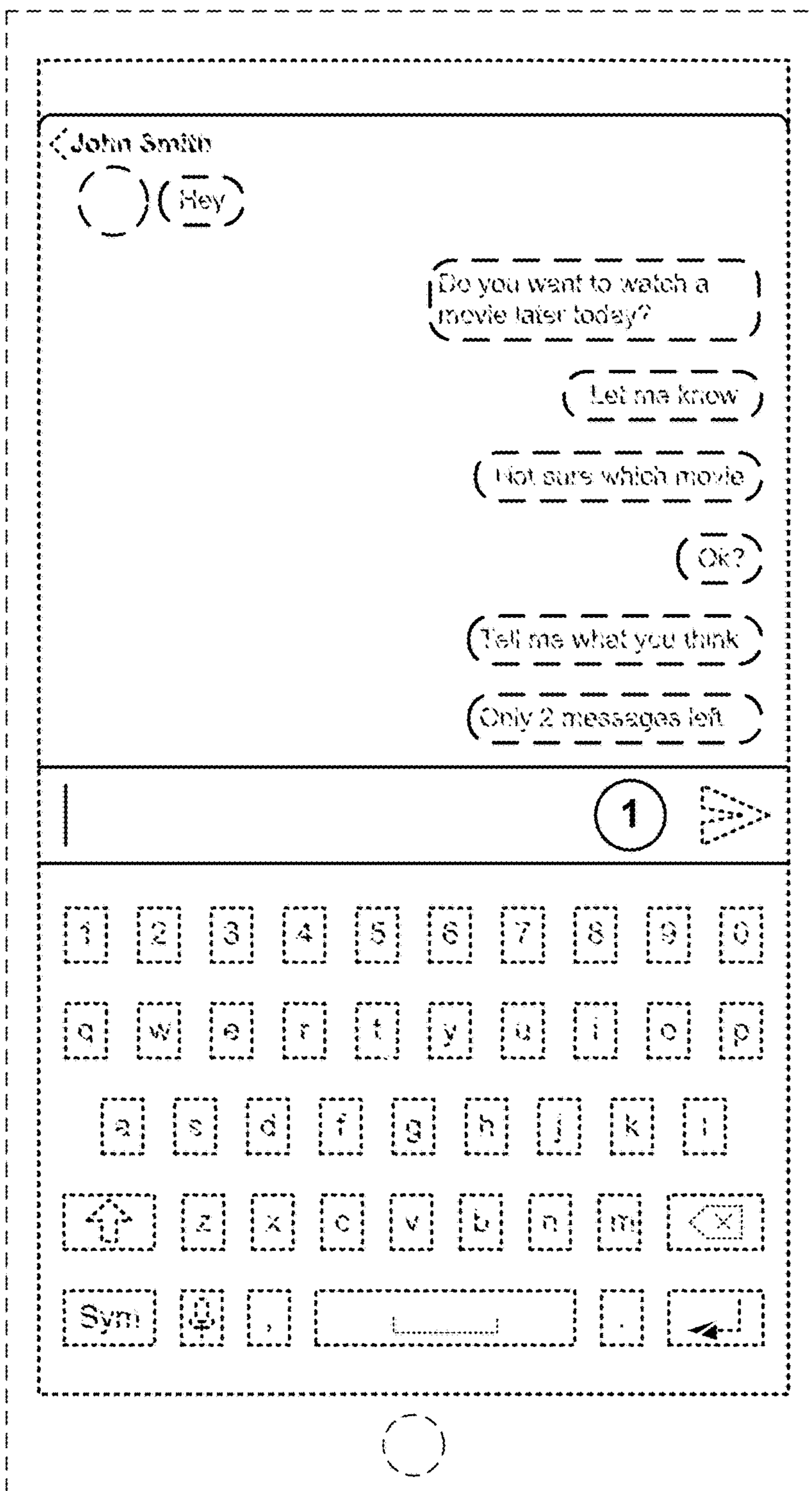

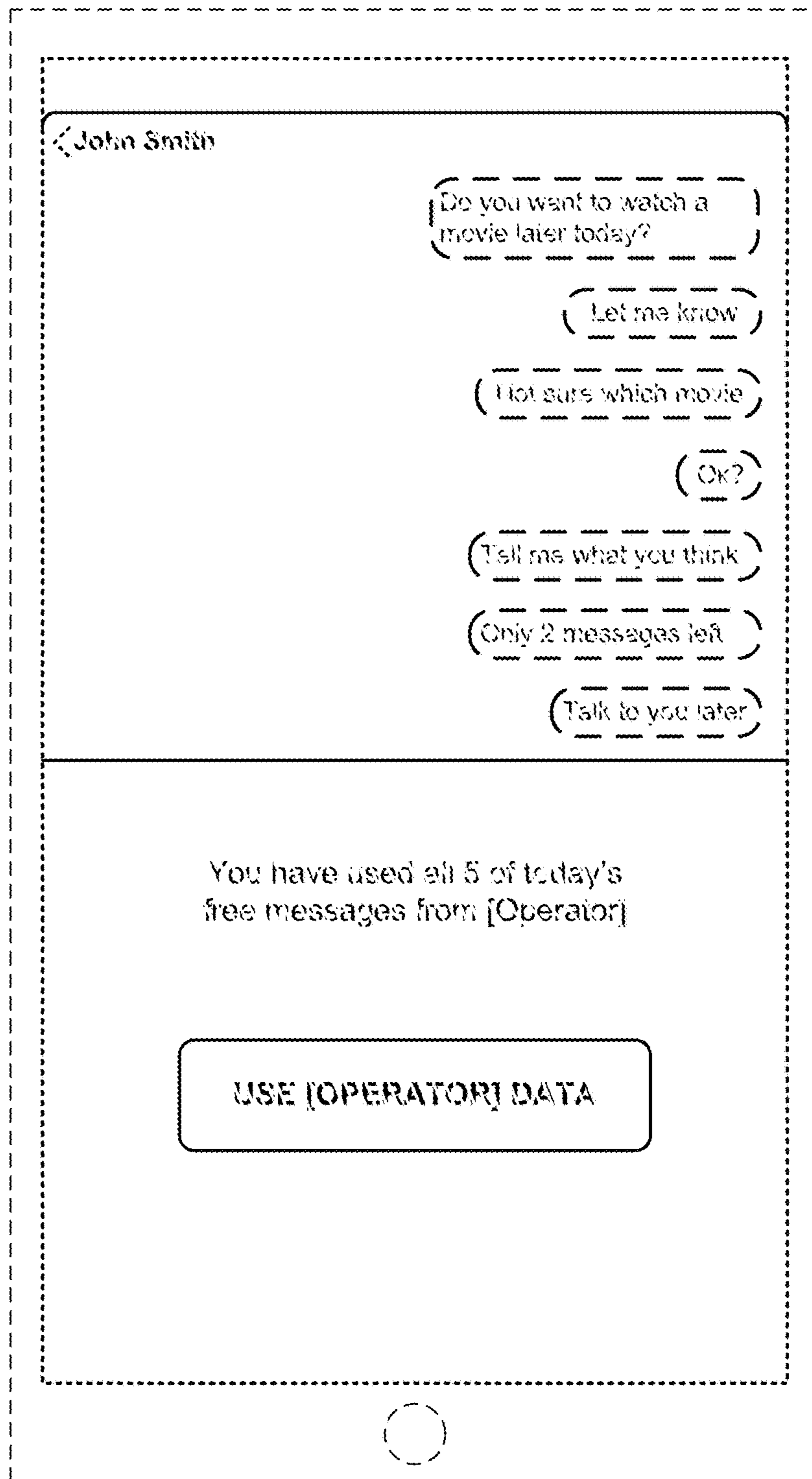

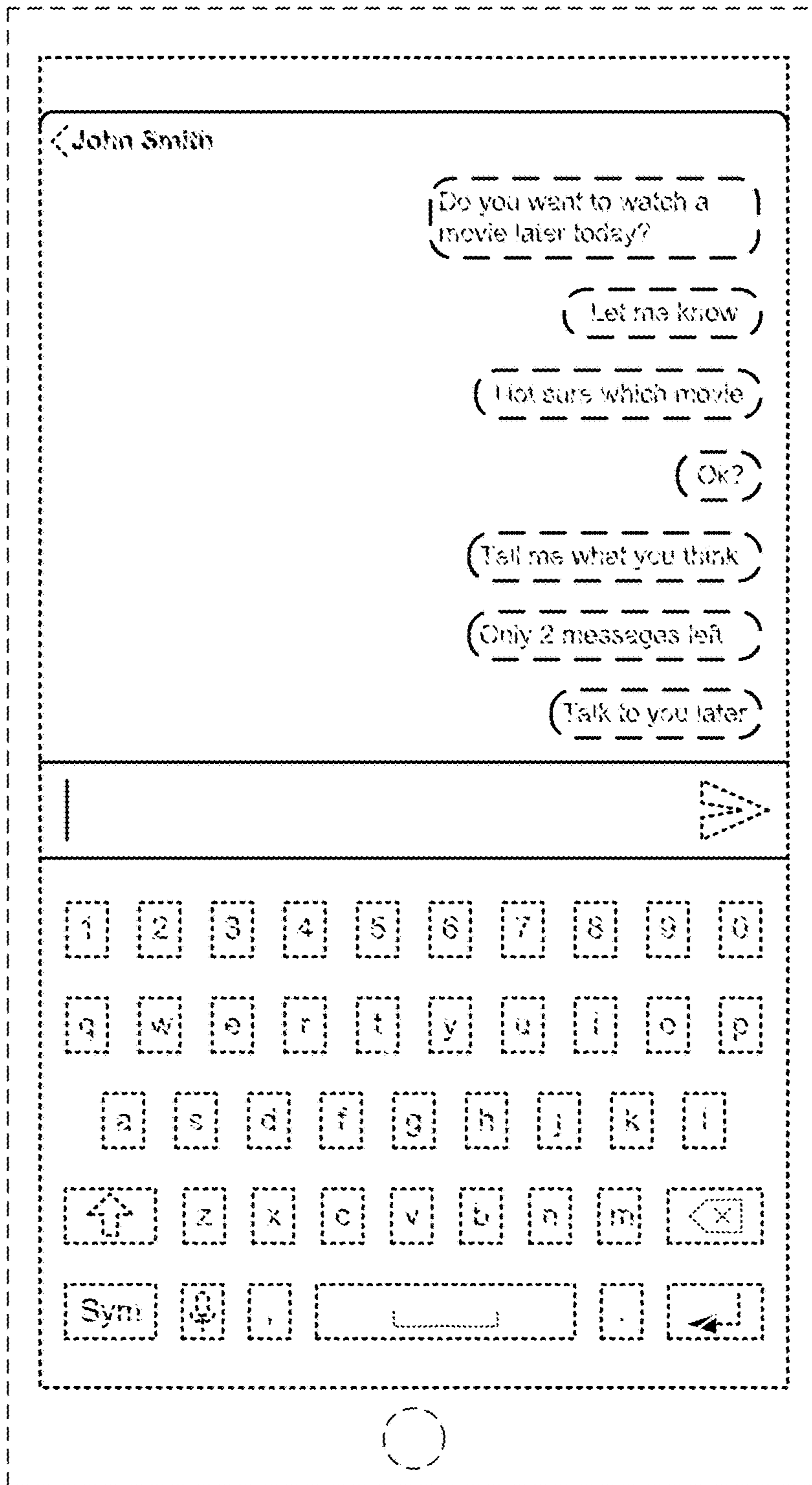

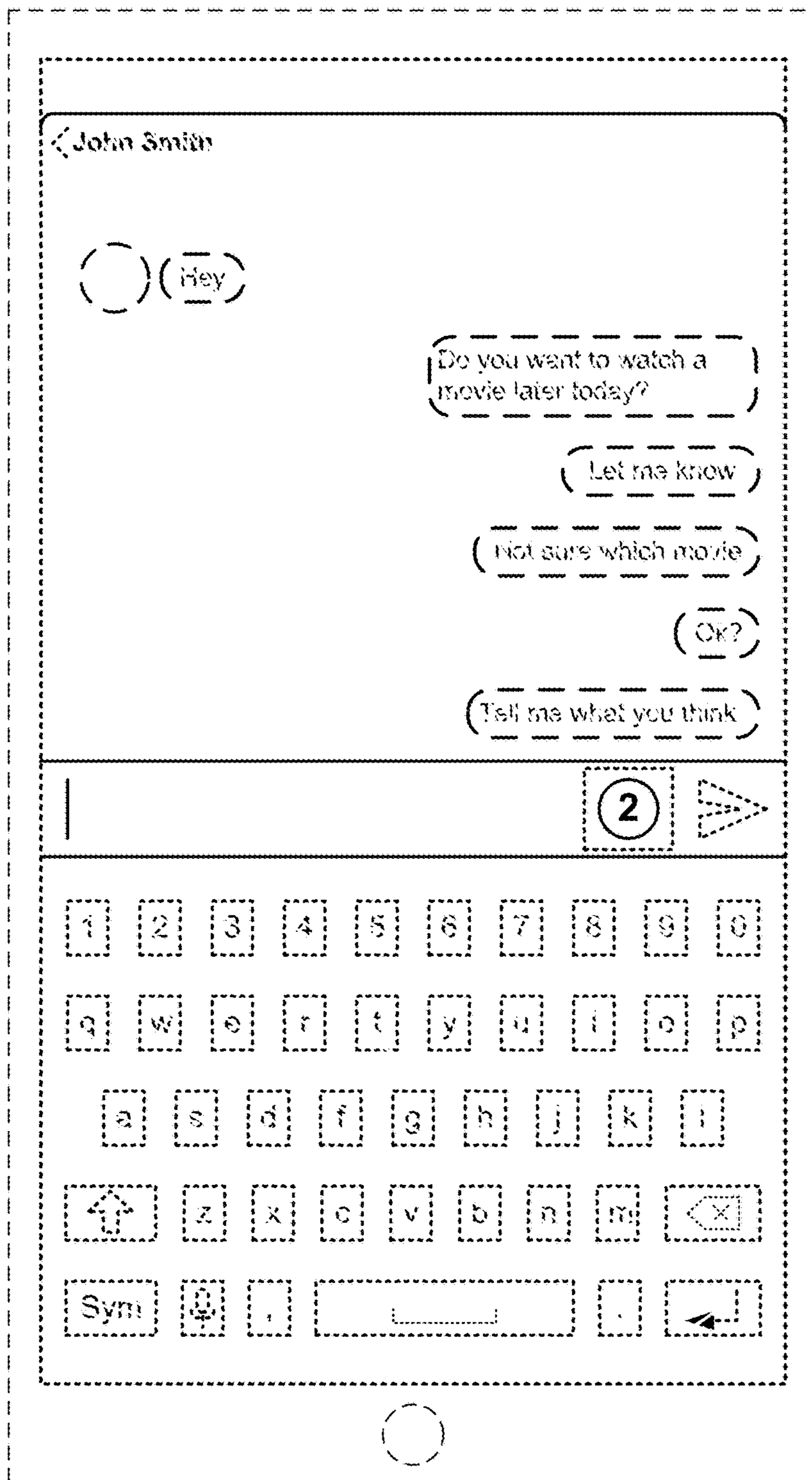

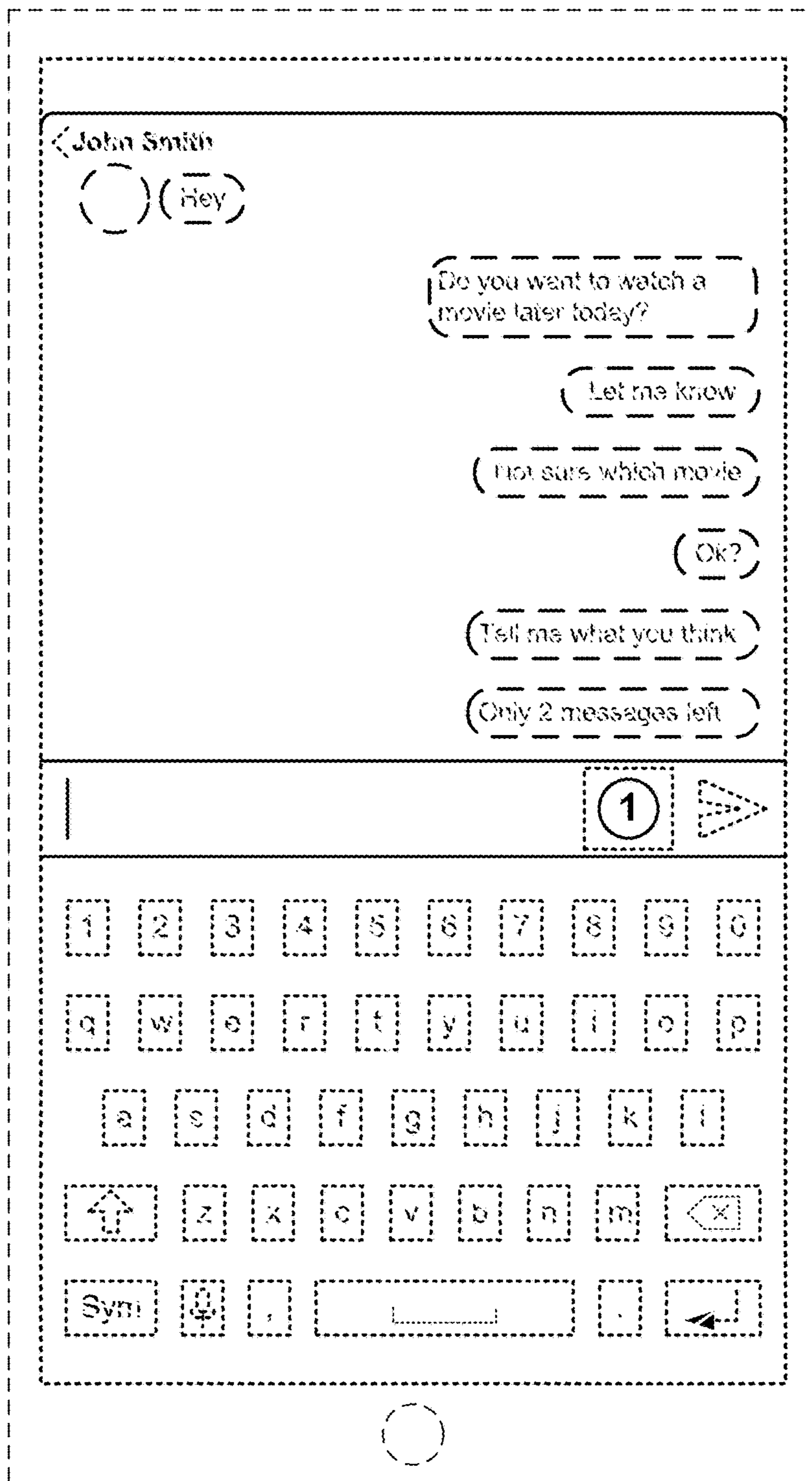

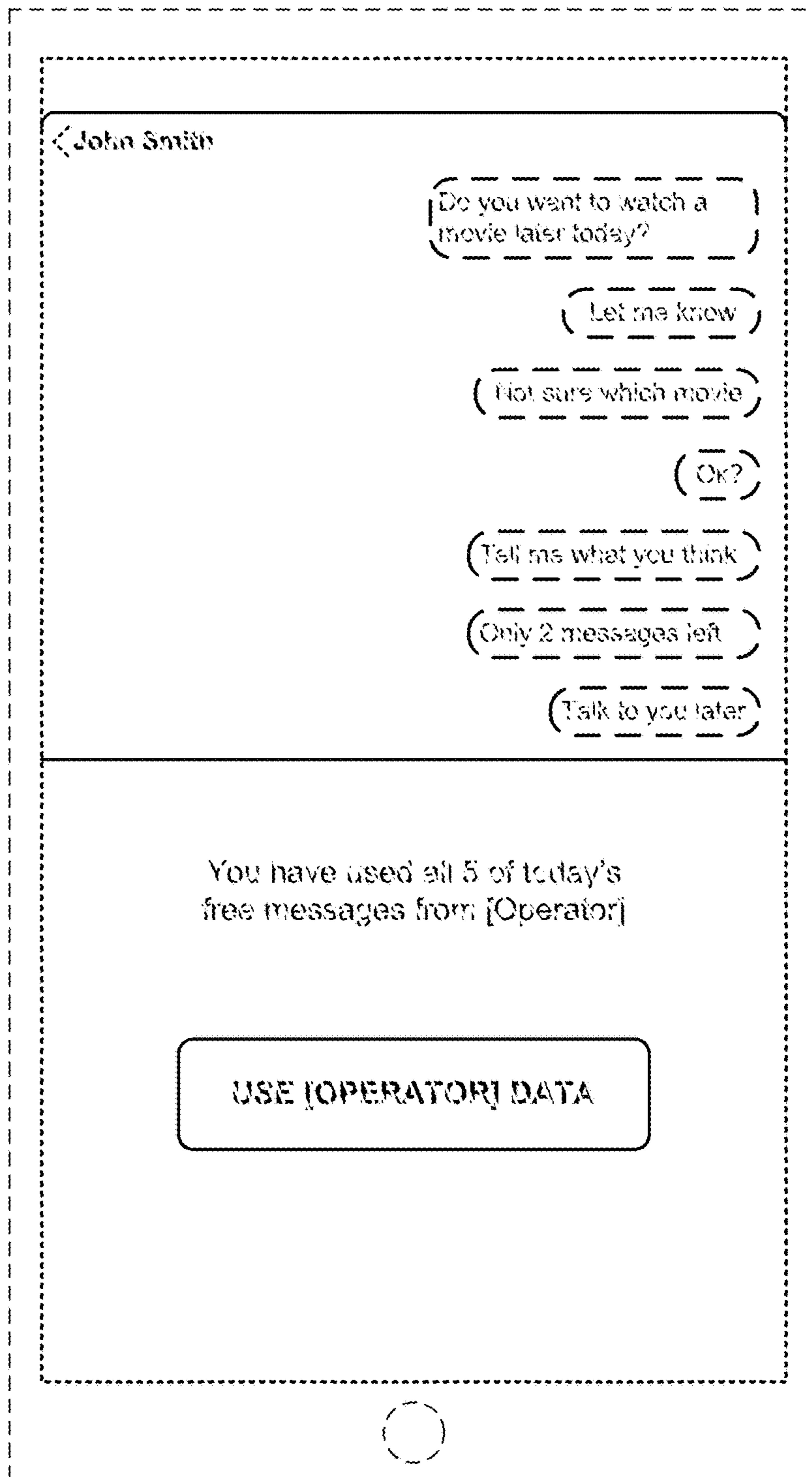

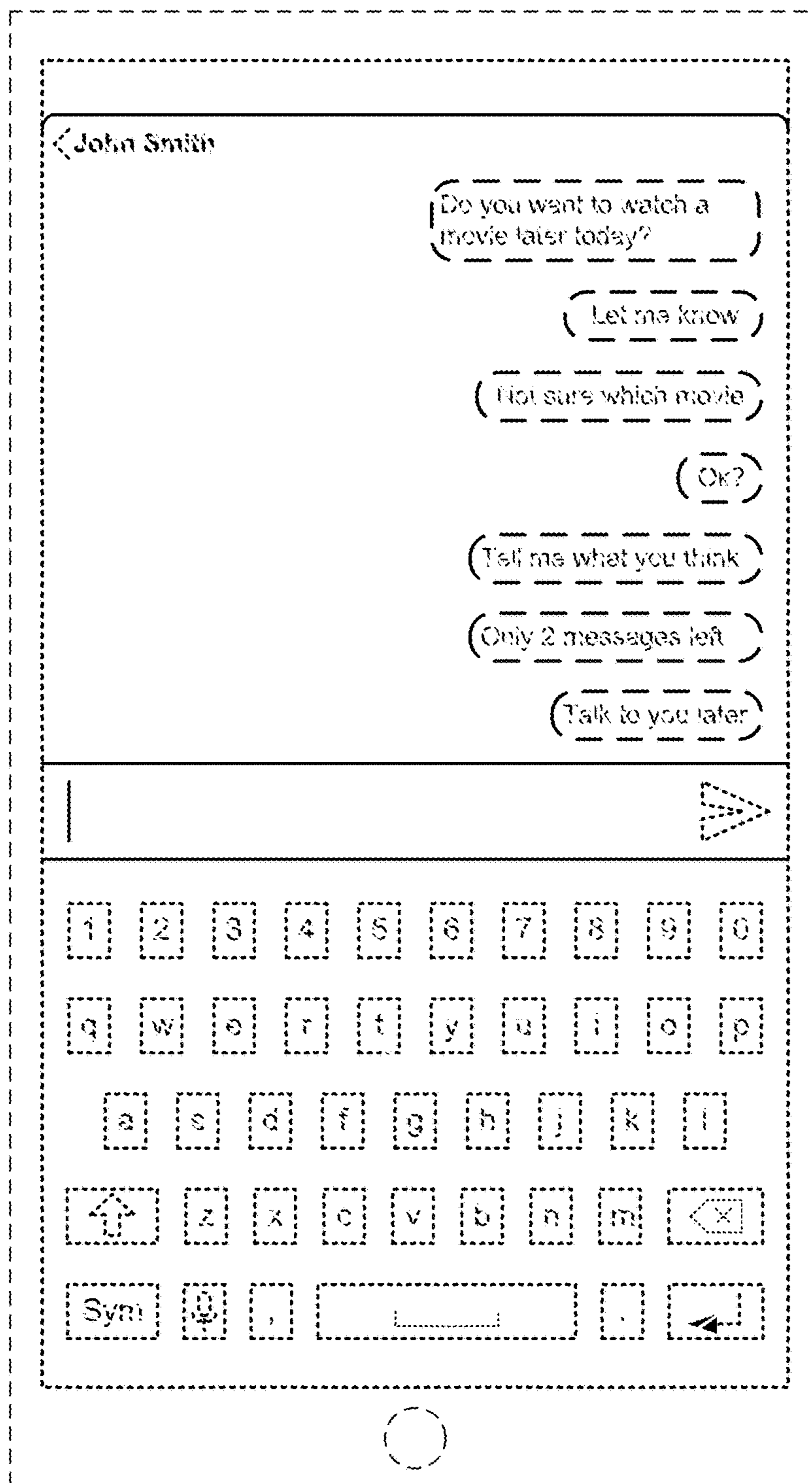
